(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a trail marker, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a trail marker showing my new design, the back being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a left side view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an open view of the trail marker, as shown in FIG. 1, shown in an alternate position;

FIG. 6 is a front view of the trail marker shown in FIG. 1, shown in an alternate position;

FIG. 7 is a back view of the trail marker thereof;

FIG. 8 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a thereof;

FIG. 11 is a bottom view of thereof;

FIG. 16 is a right side view thereof;

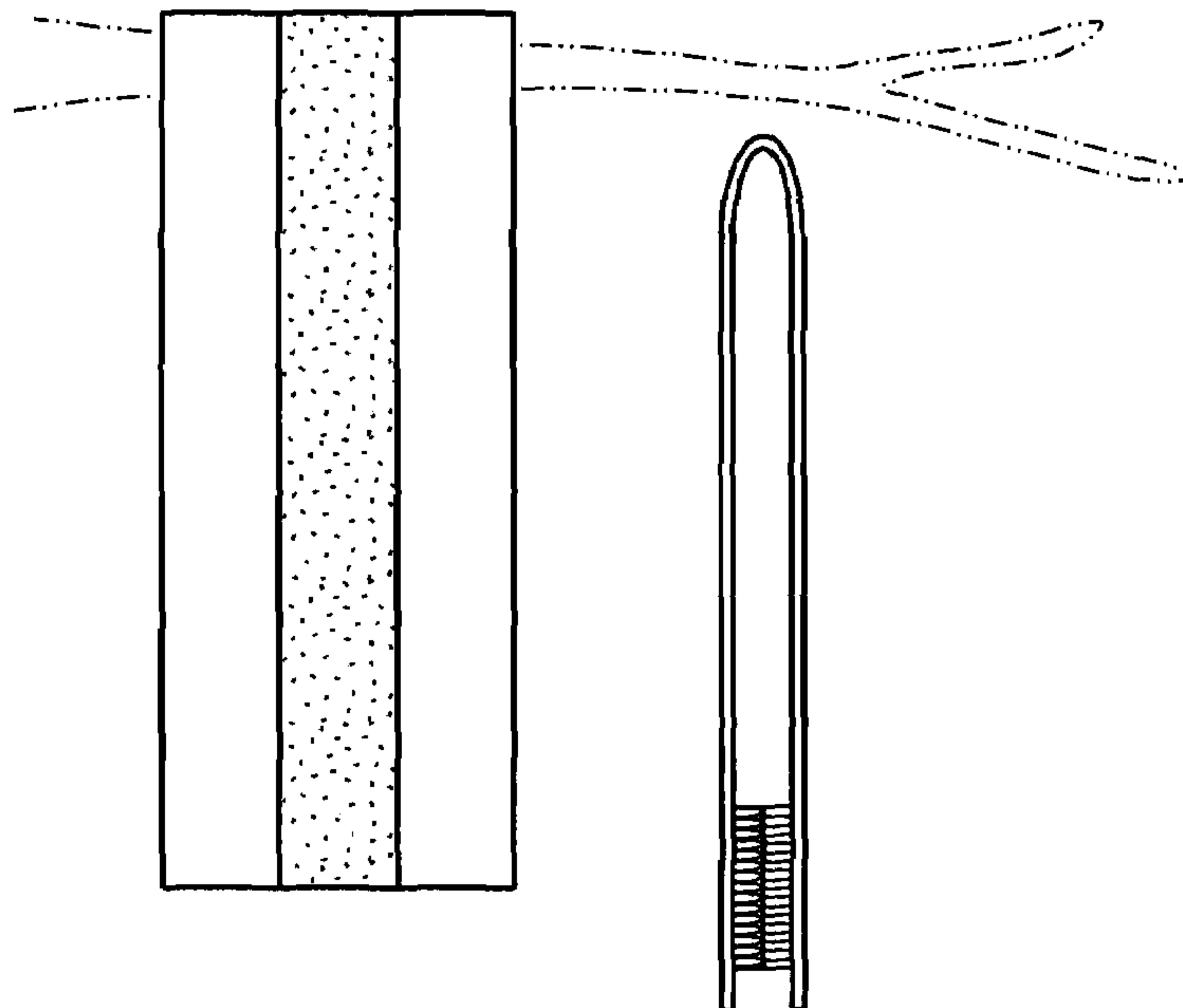
FIG. 17 is a top view thereof;

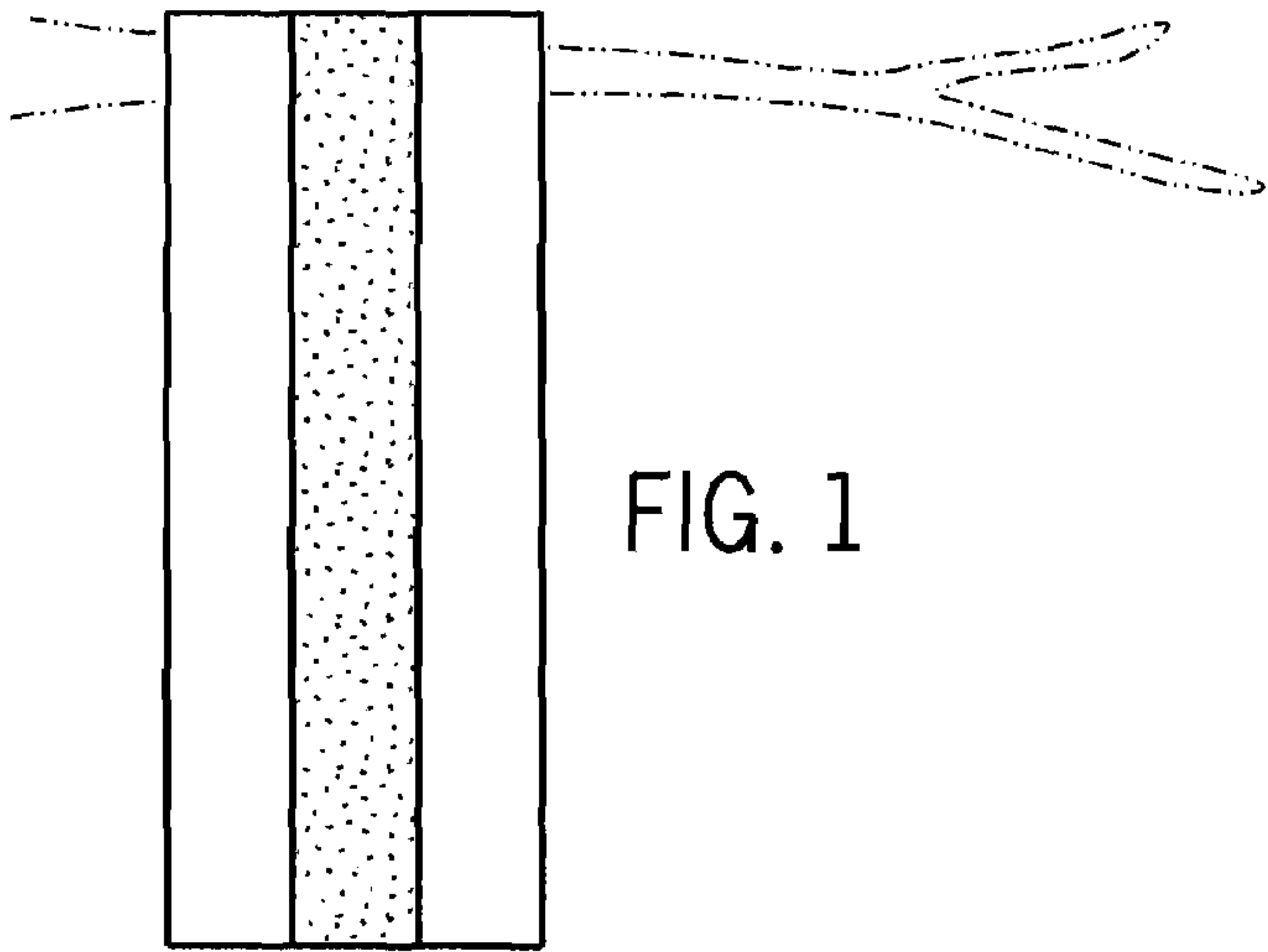

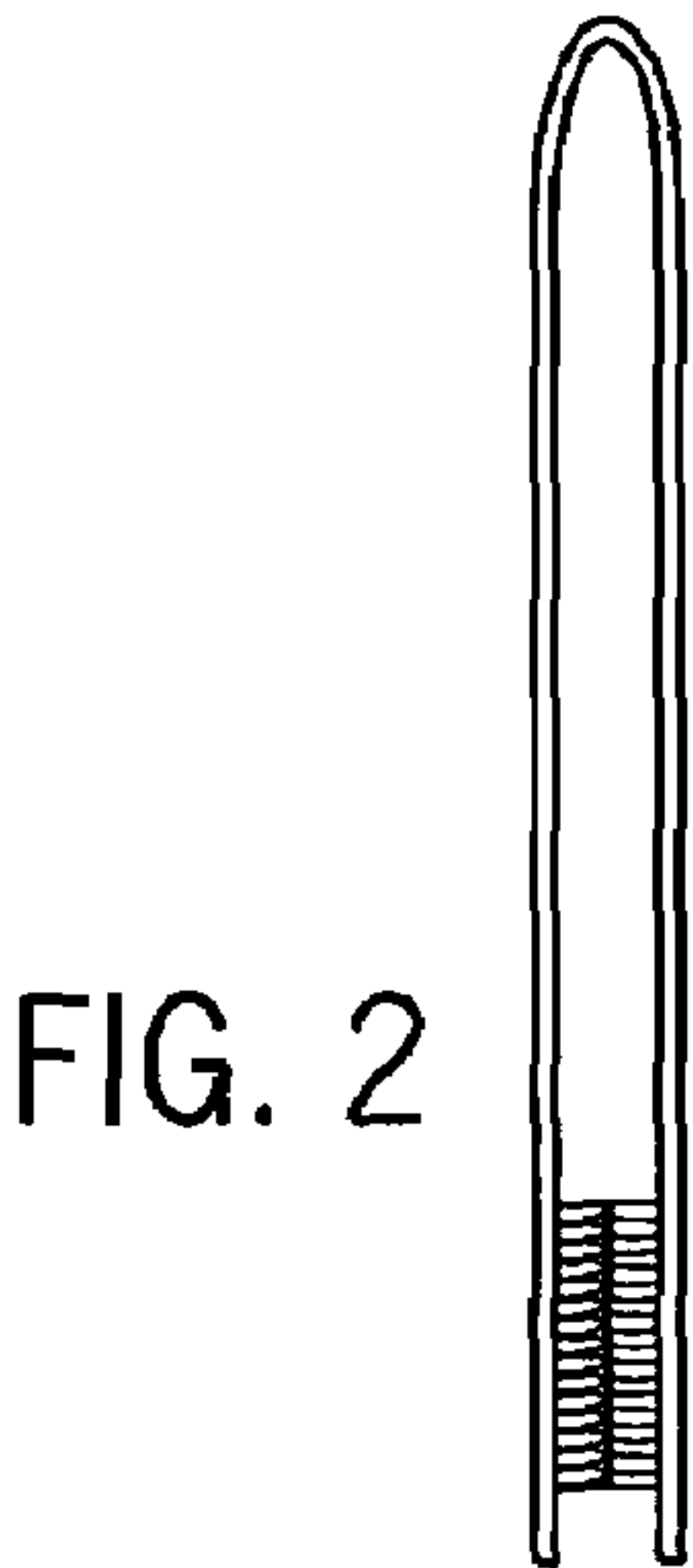

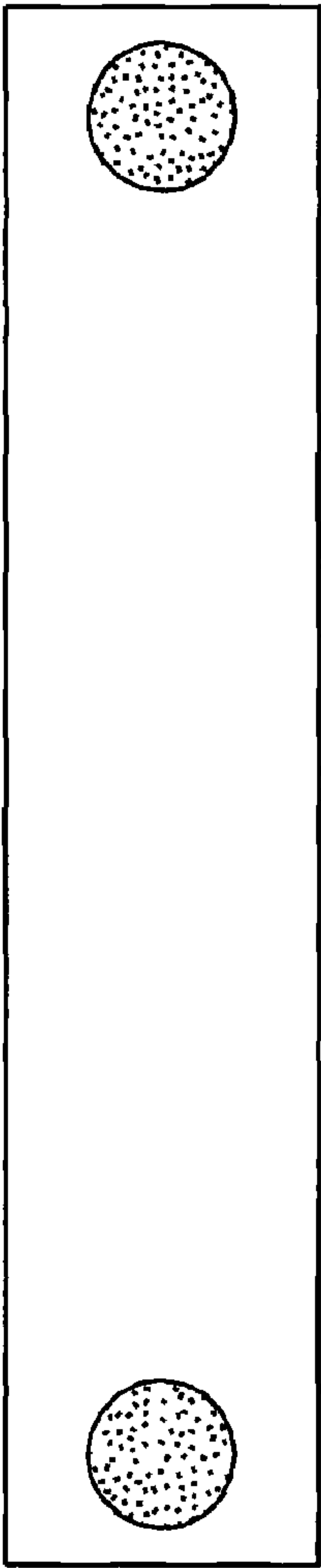

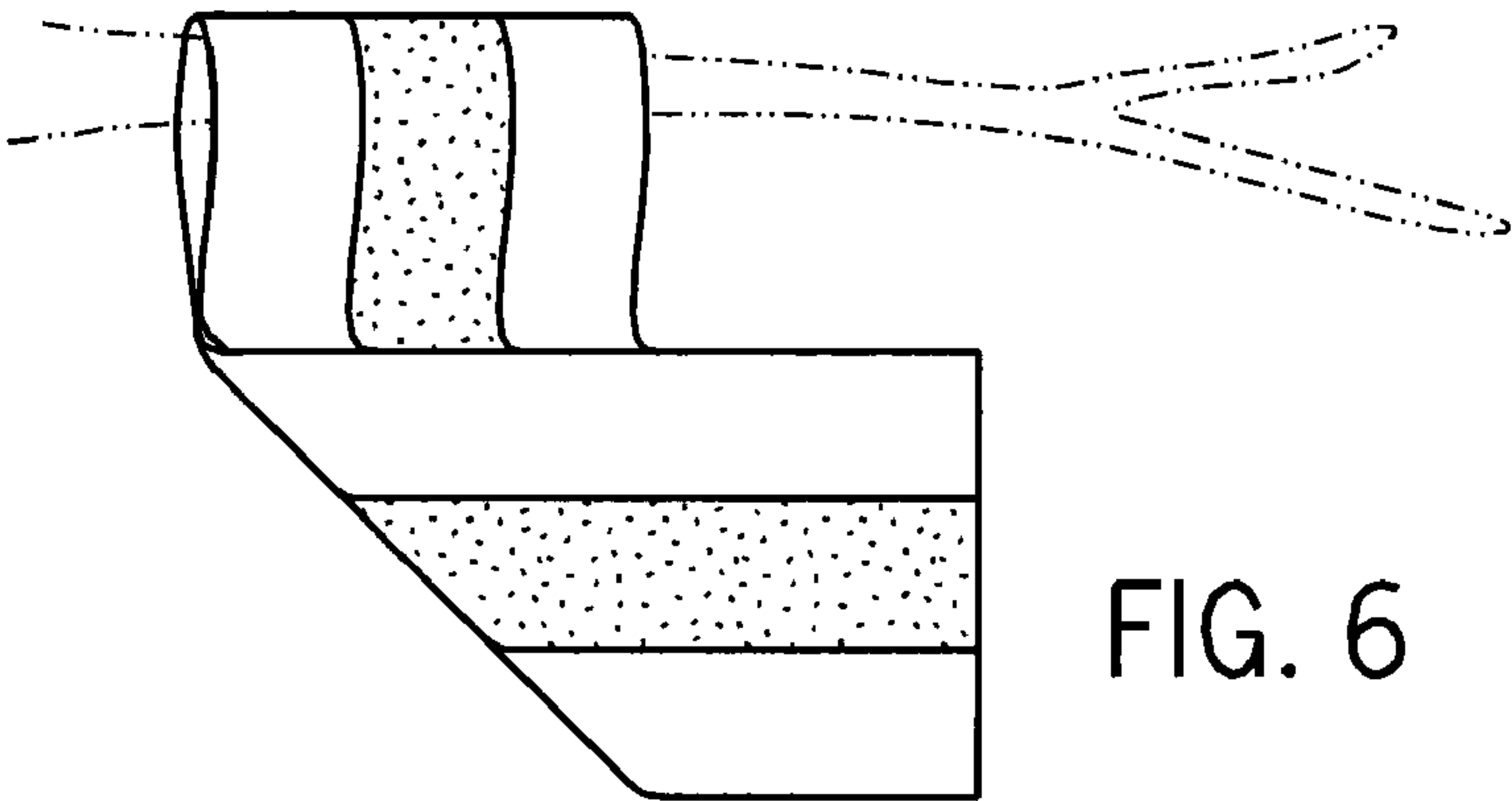

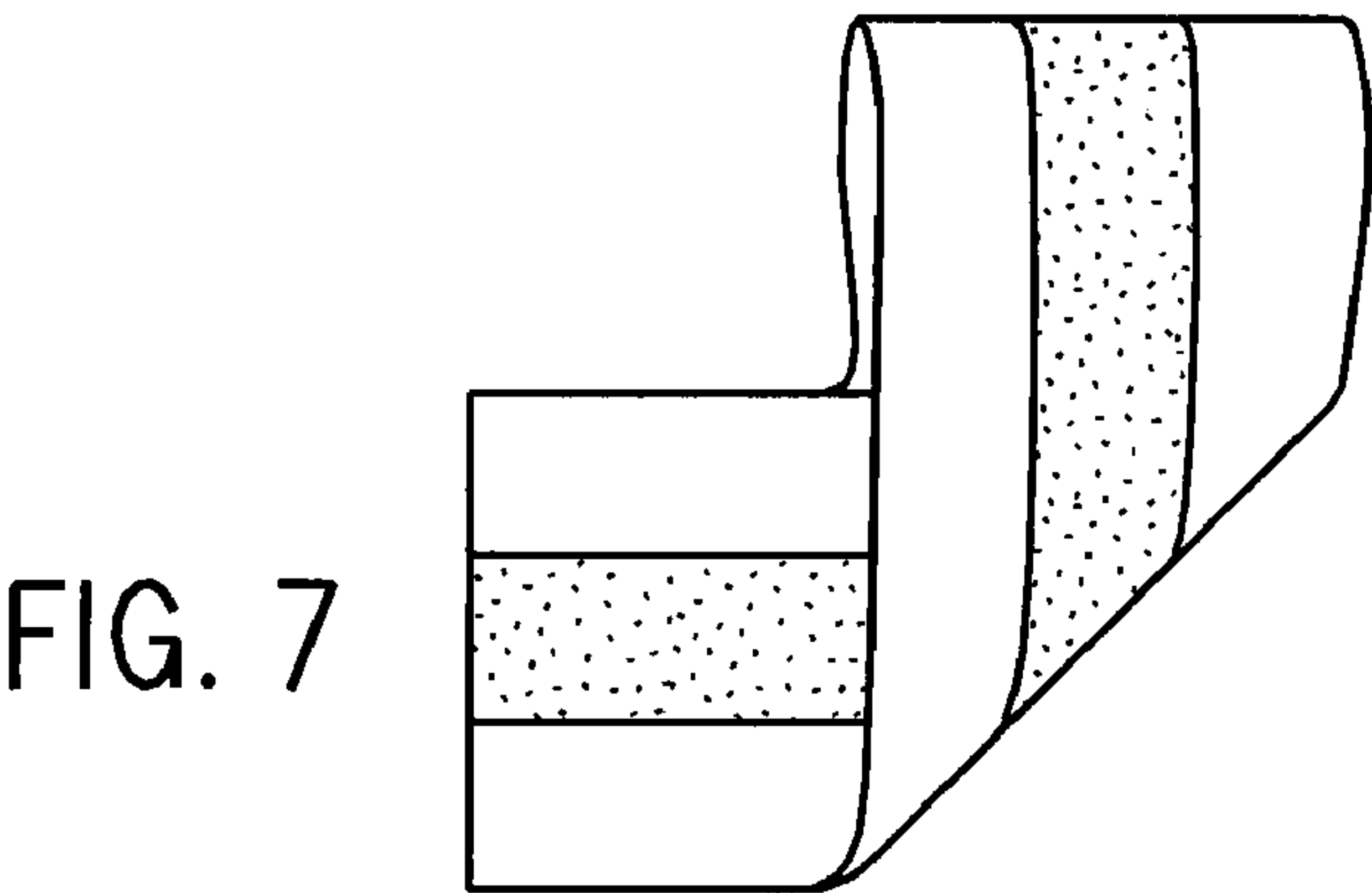

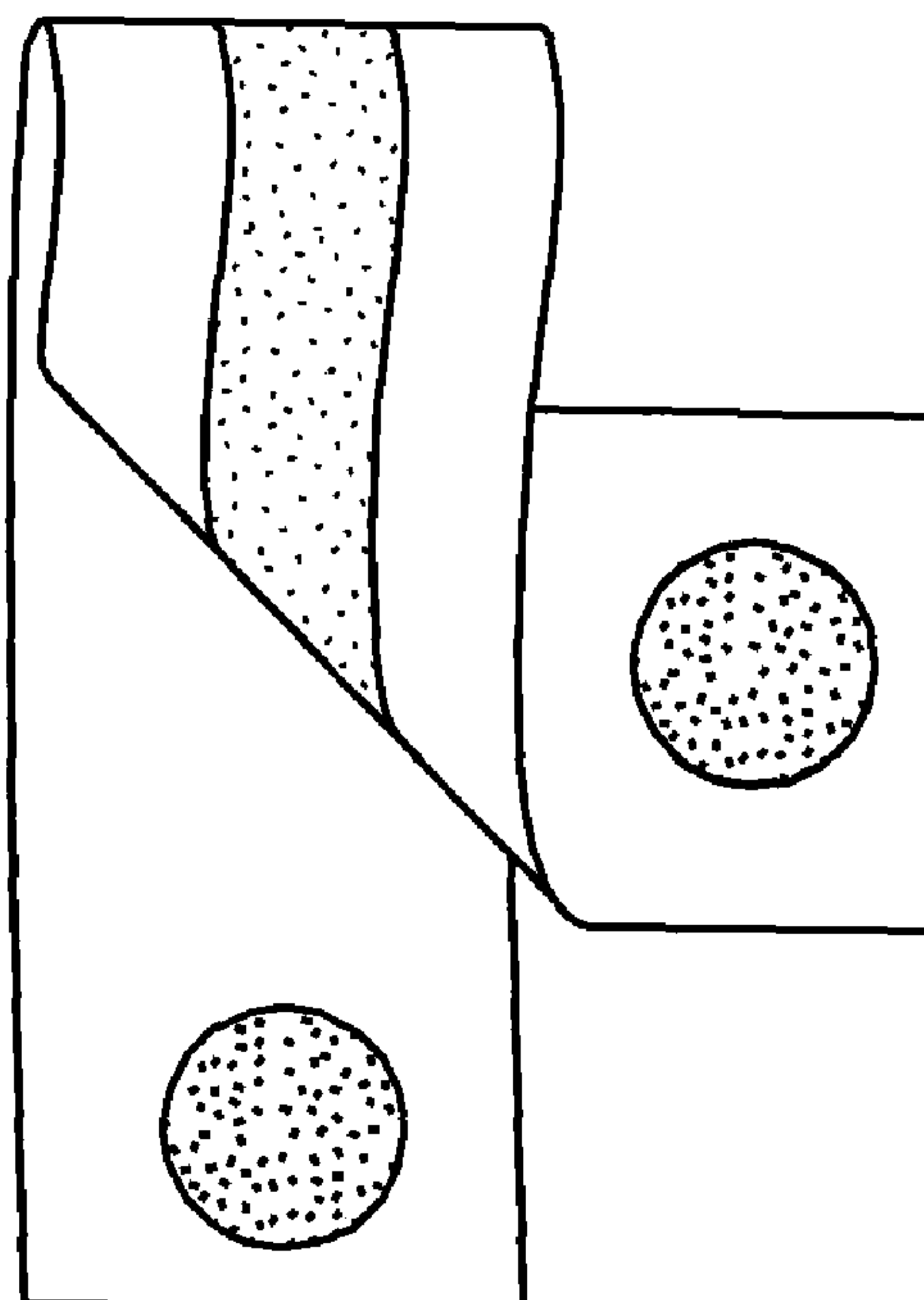

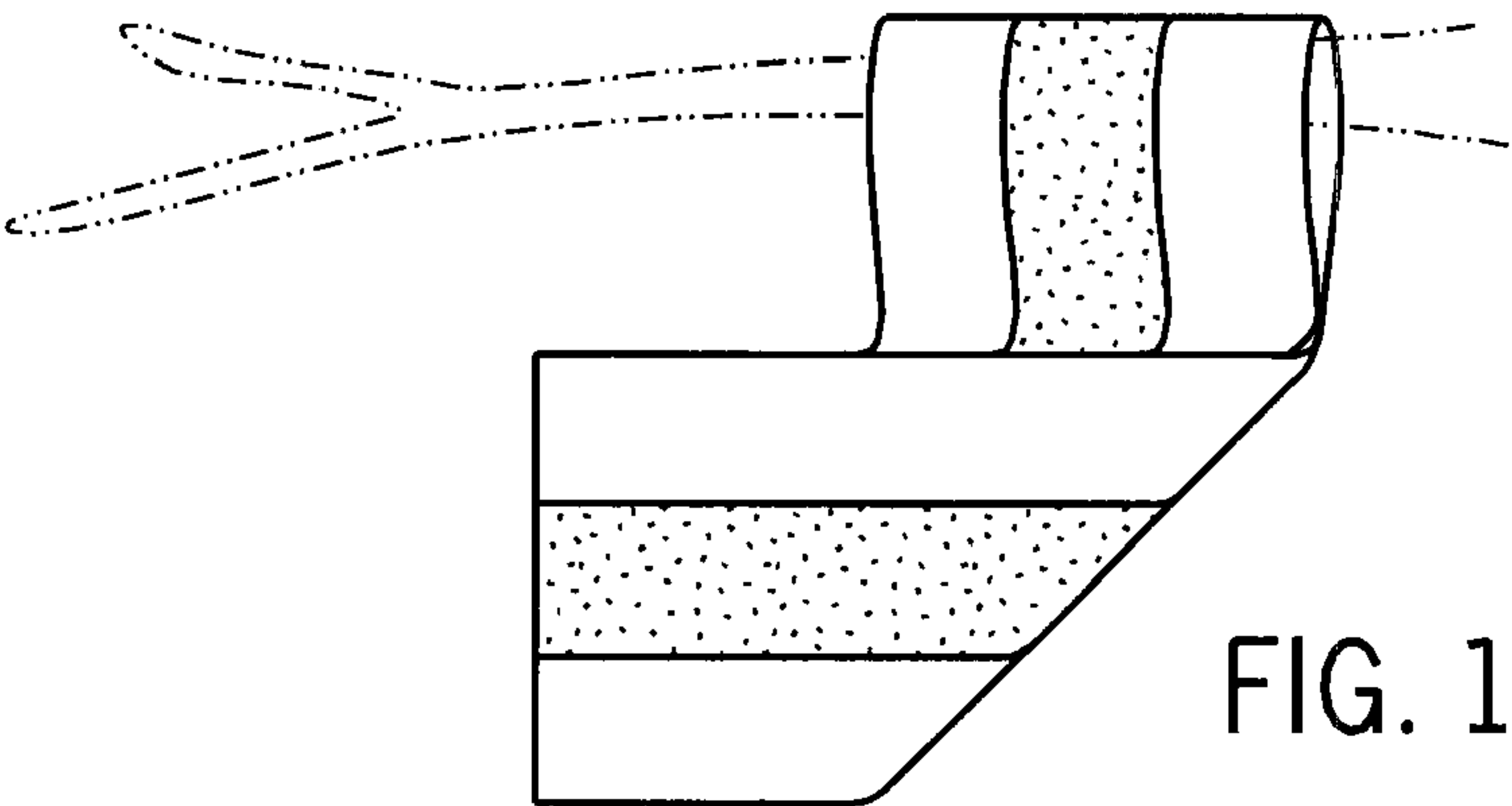

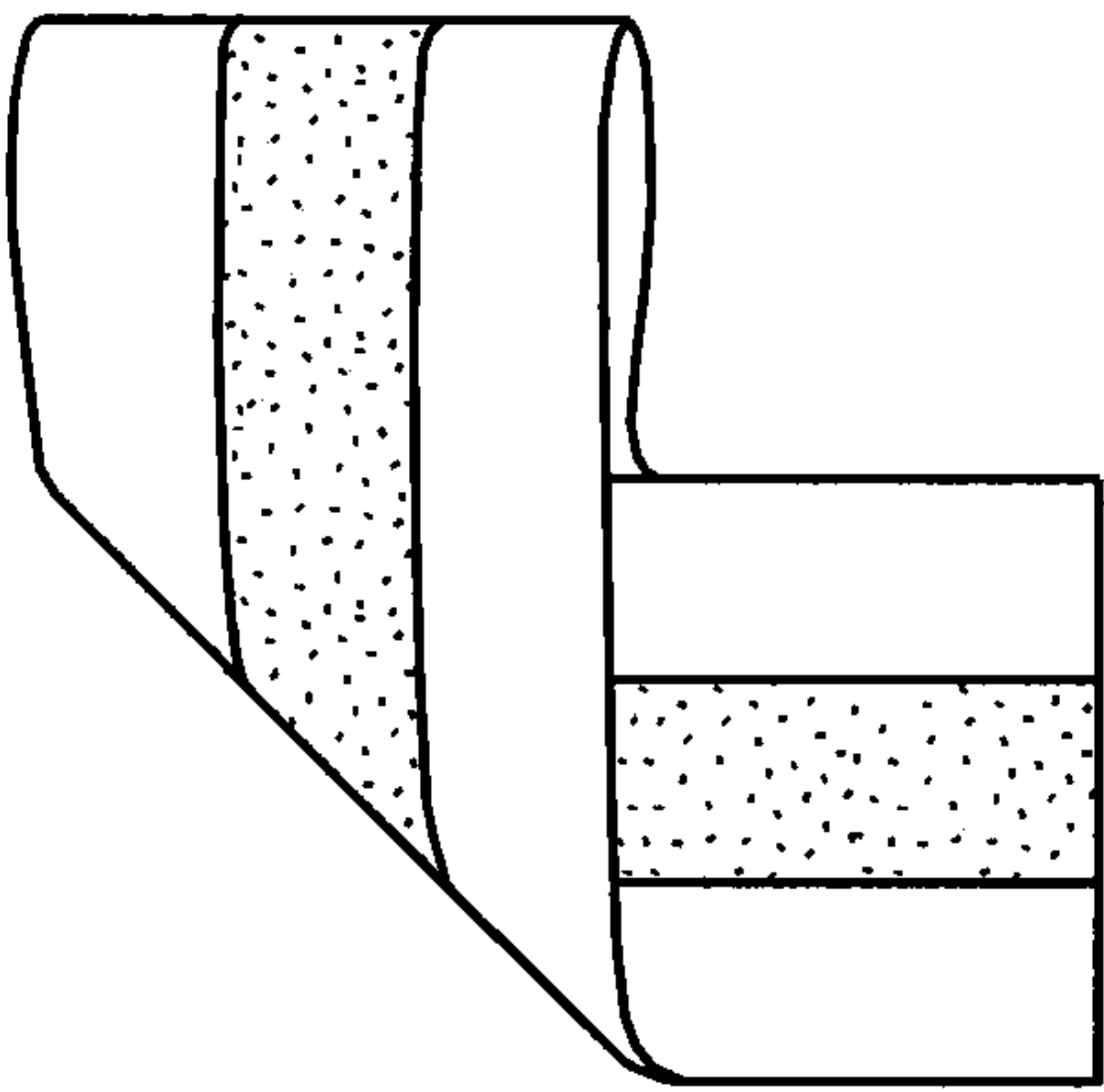

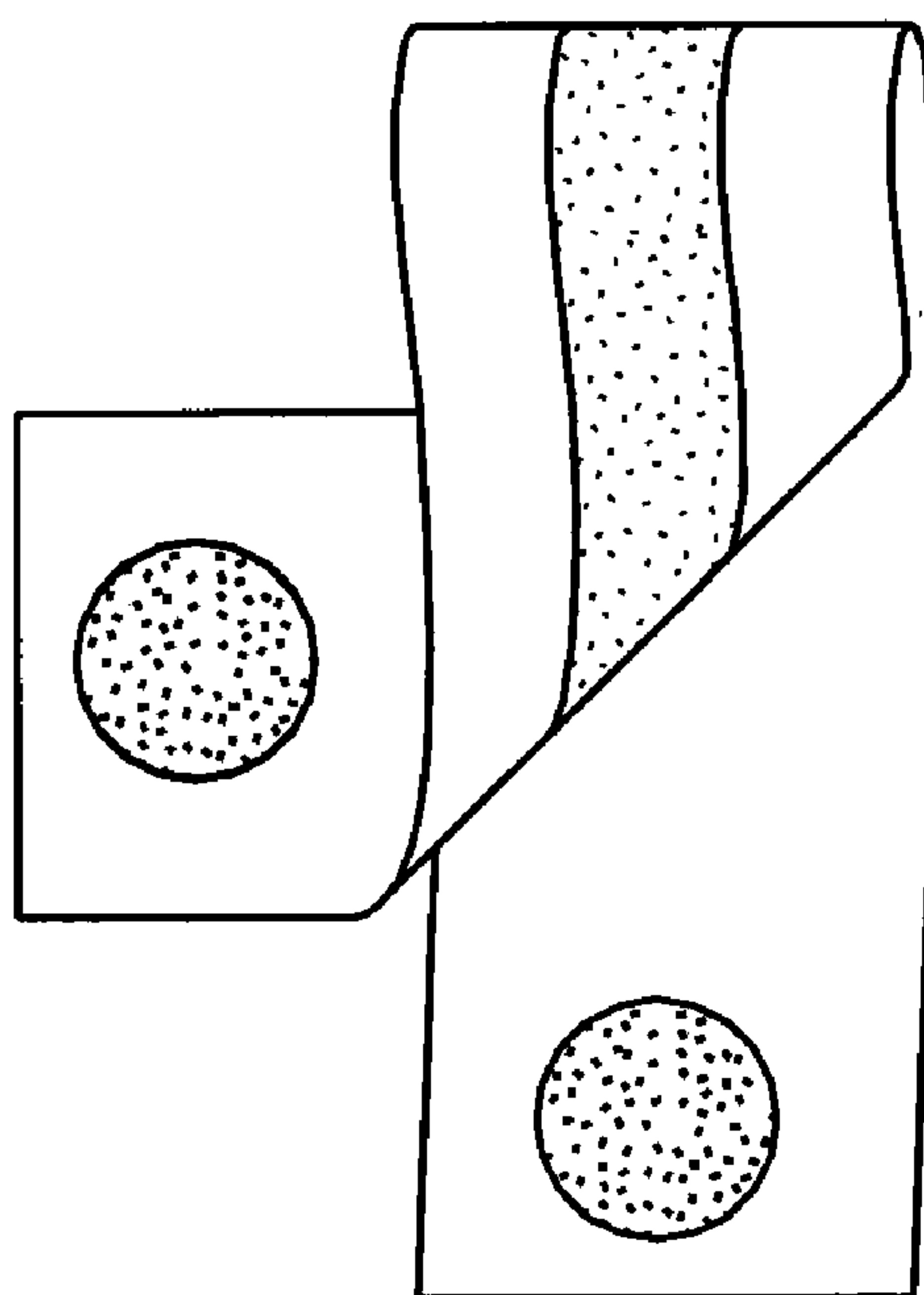
