(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pendant, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom, front, right side perspective view of the pendant;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the back view being identical thereto;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

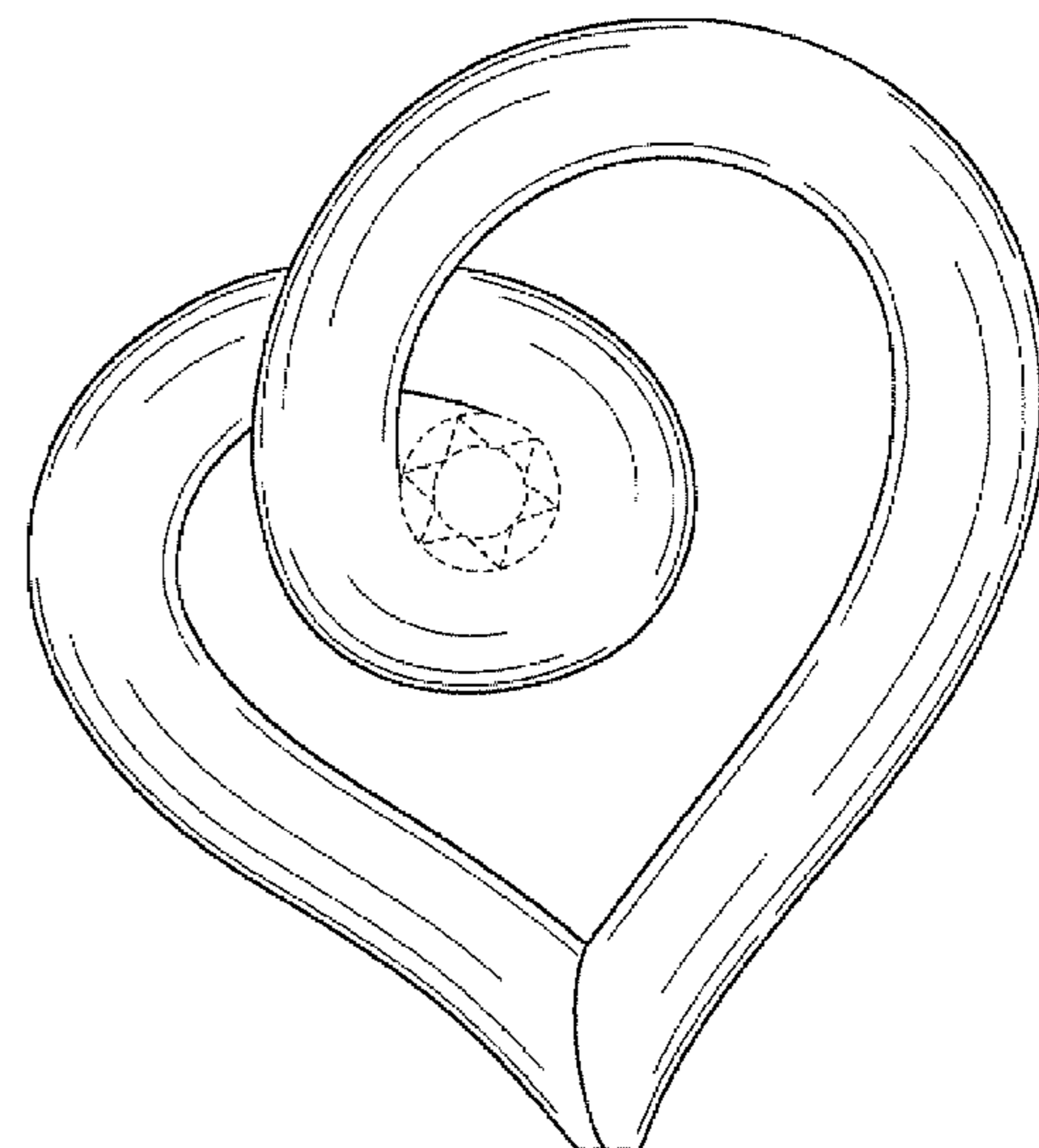
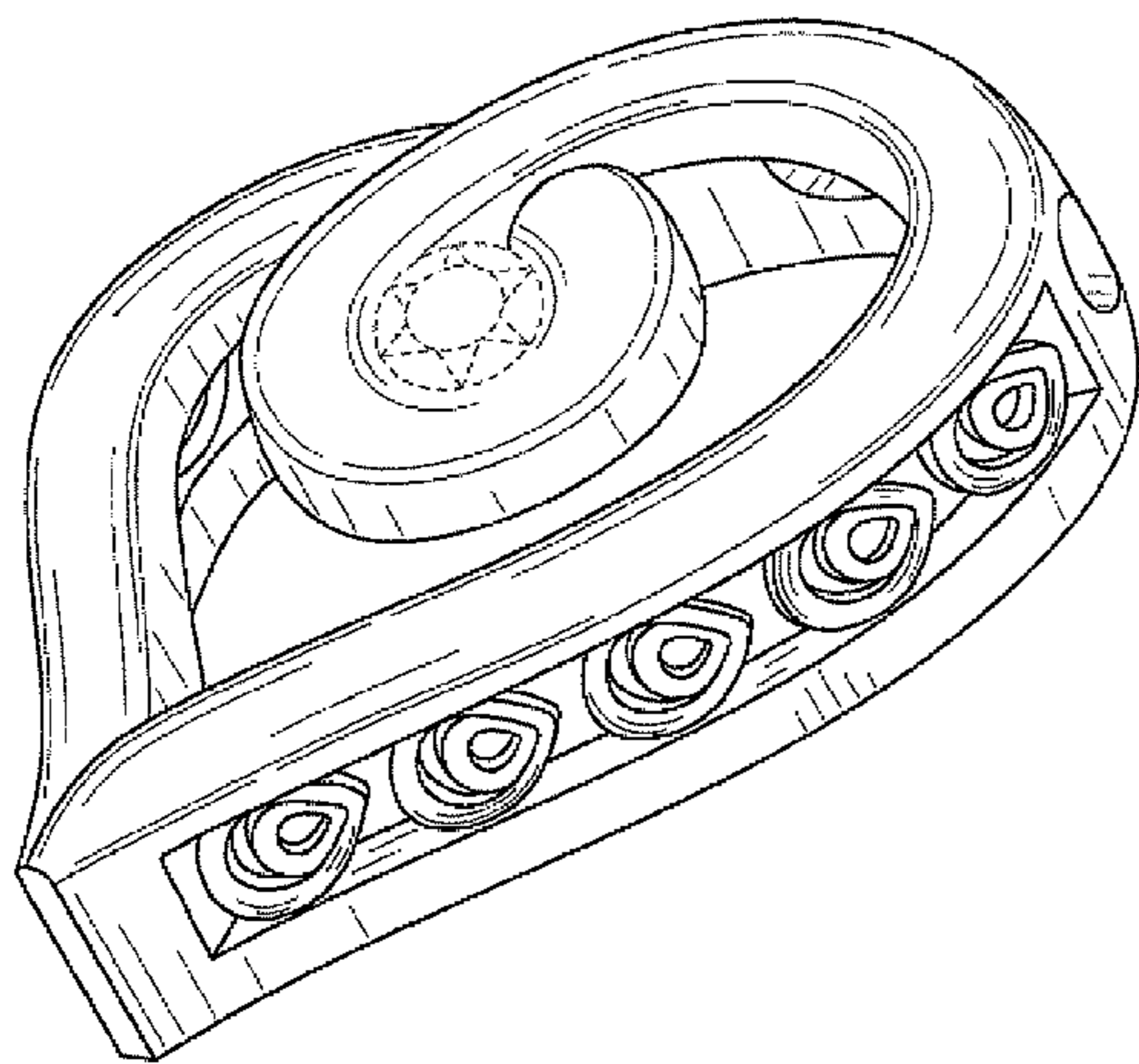
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

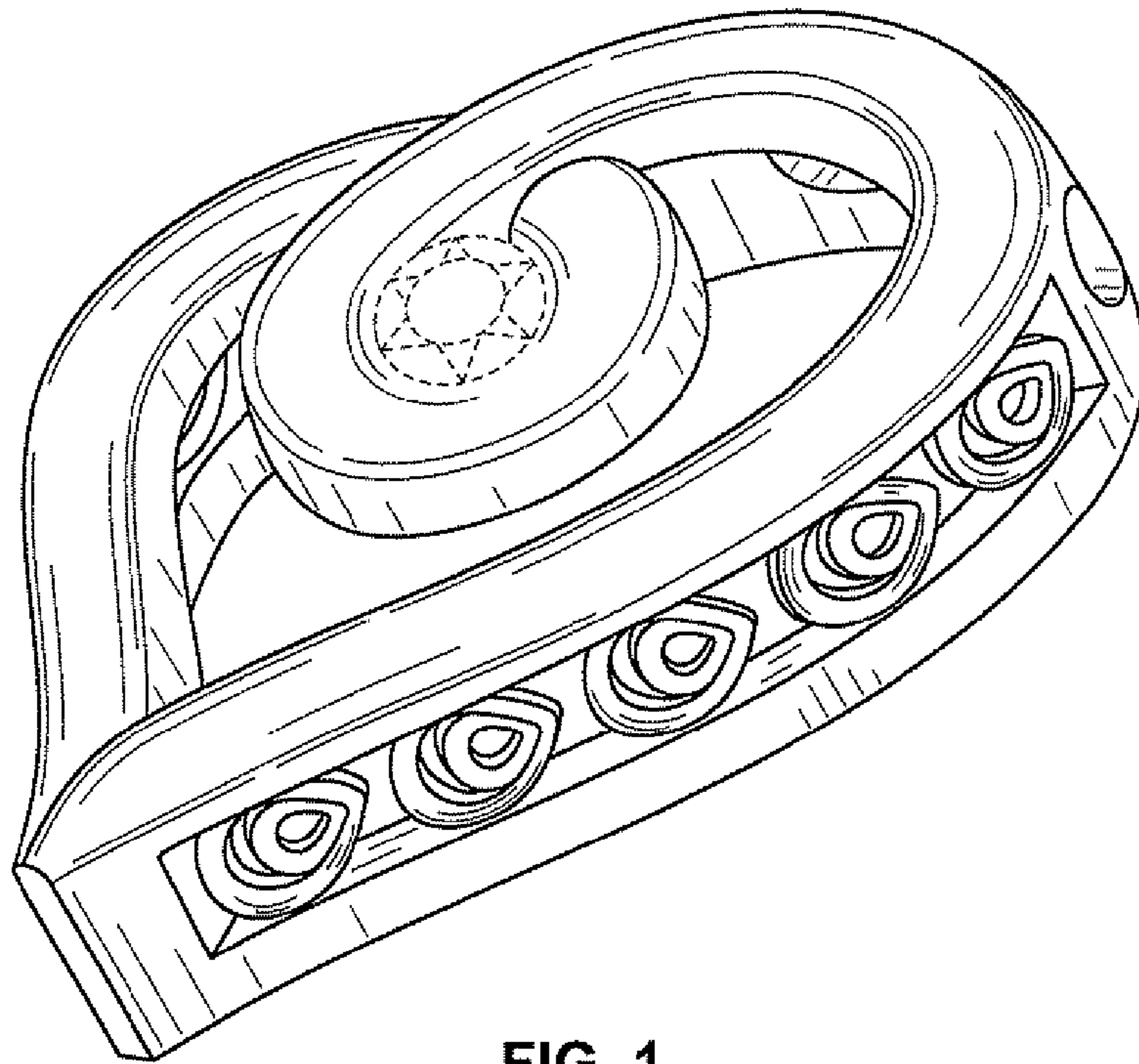

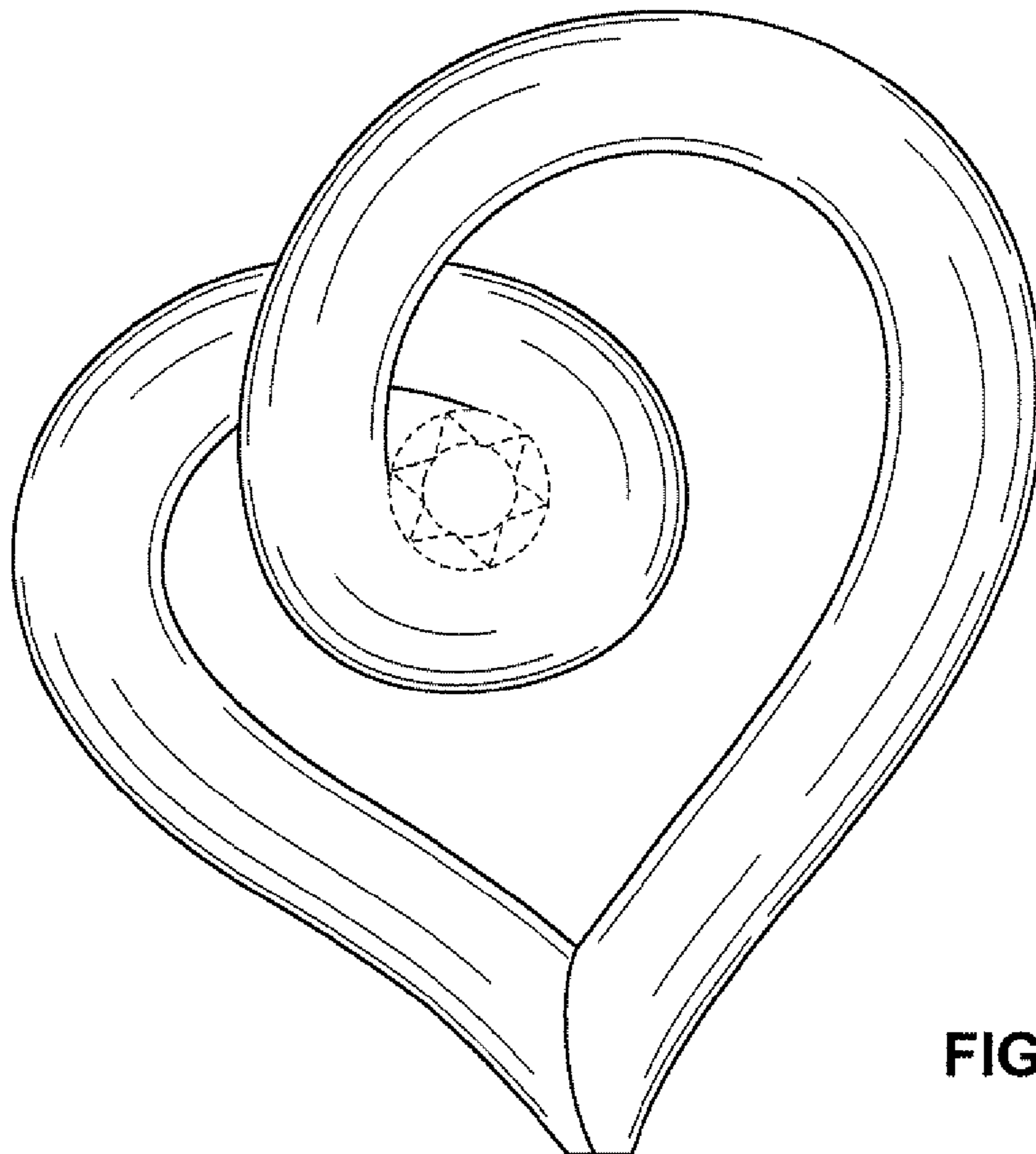
