FIG. 4 is a top elevation view thereof;

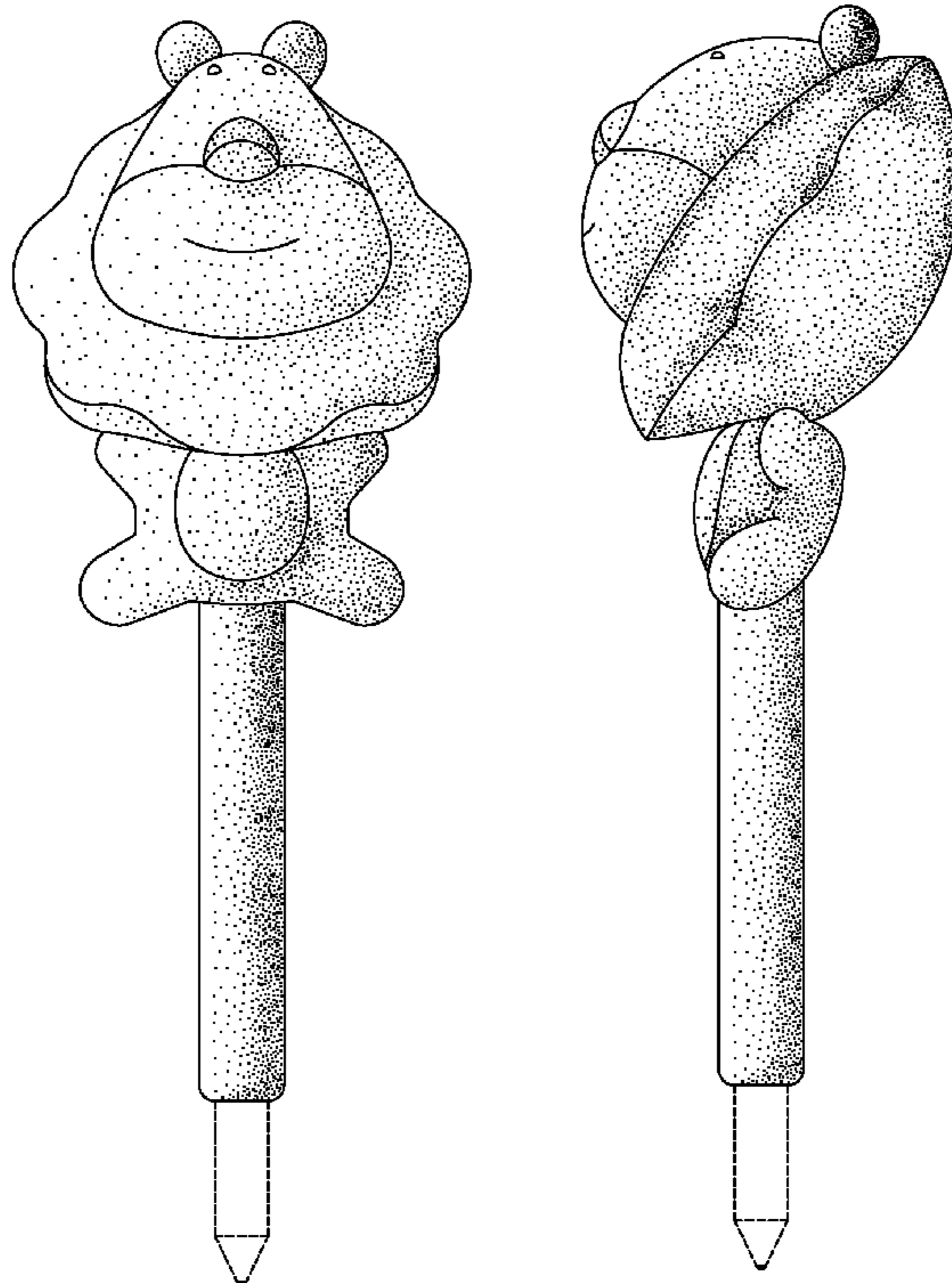
FIG. 5 is a bottom elevation view thereof;

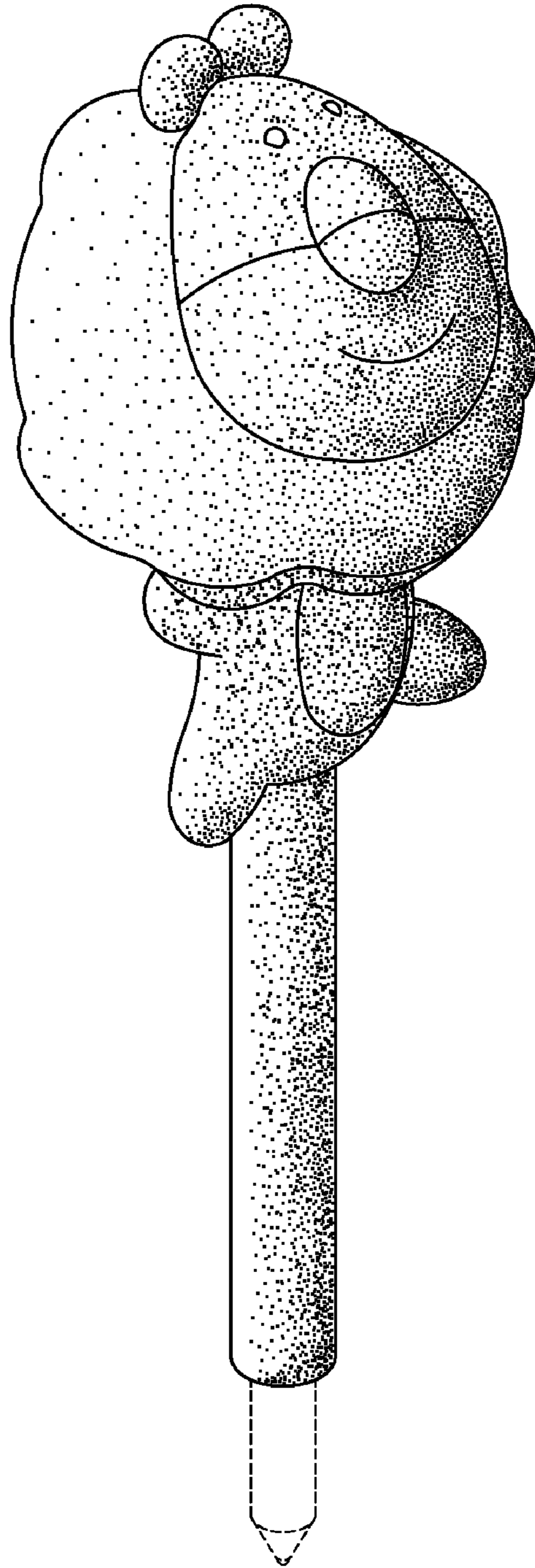

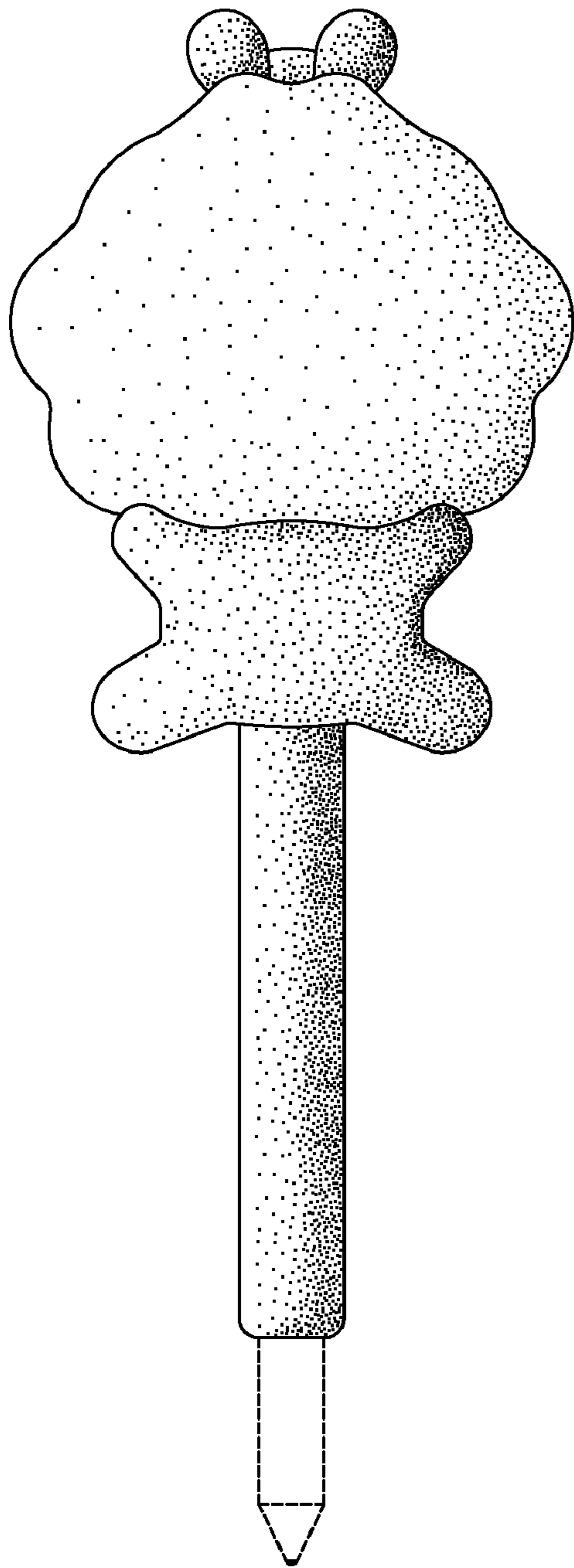

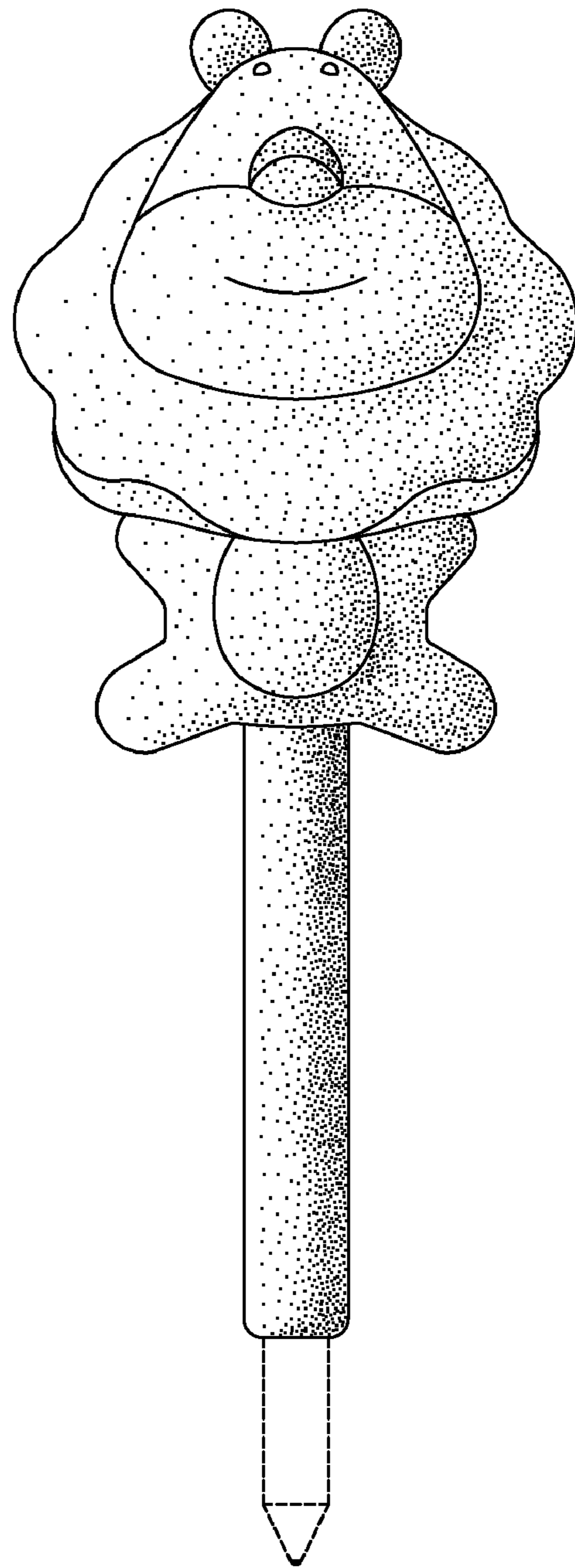

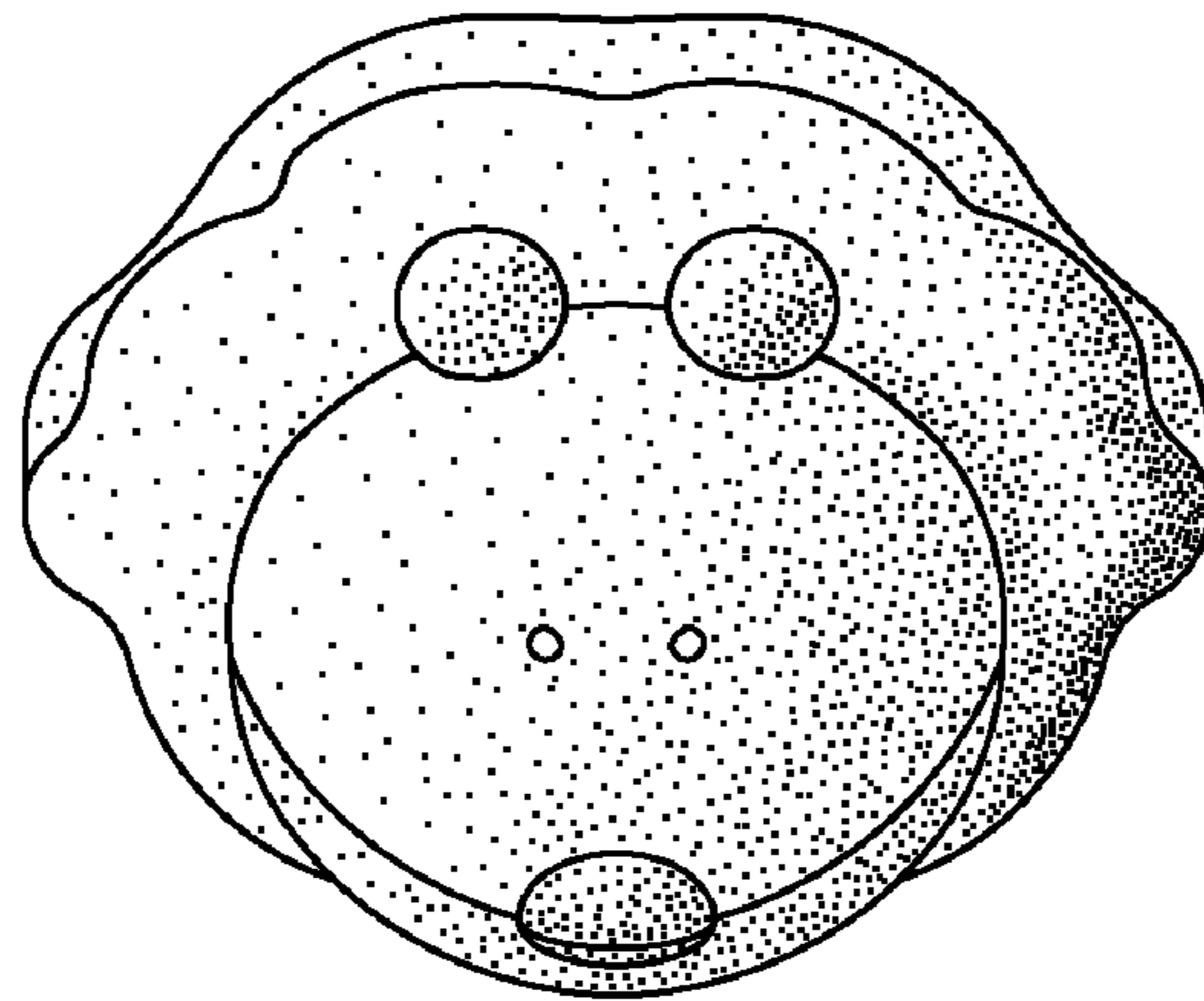

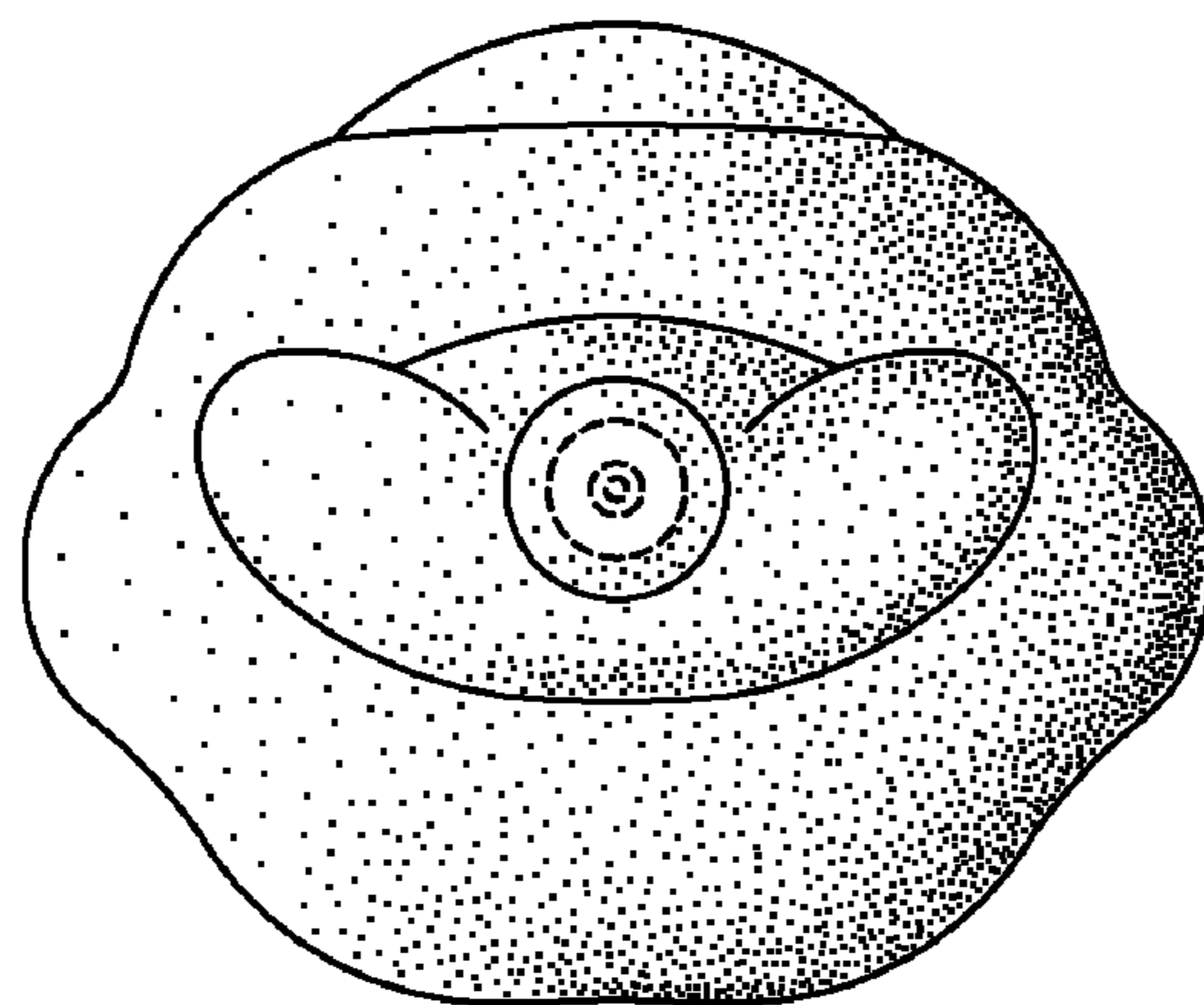

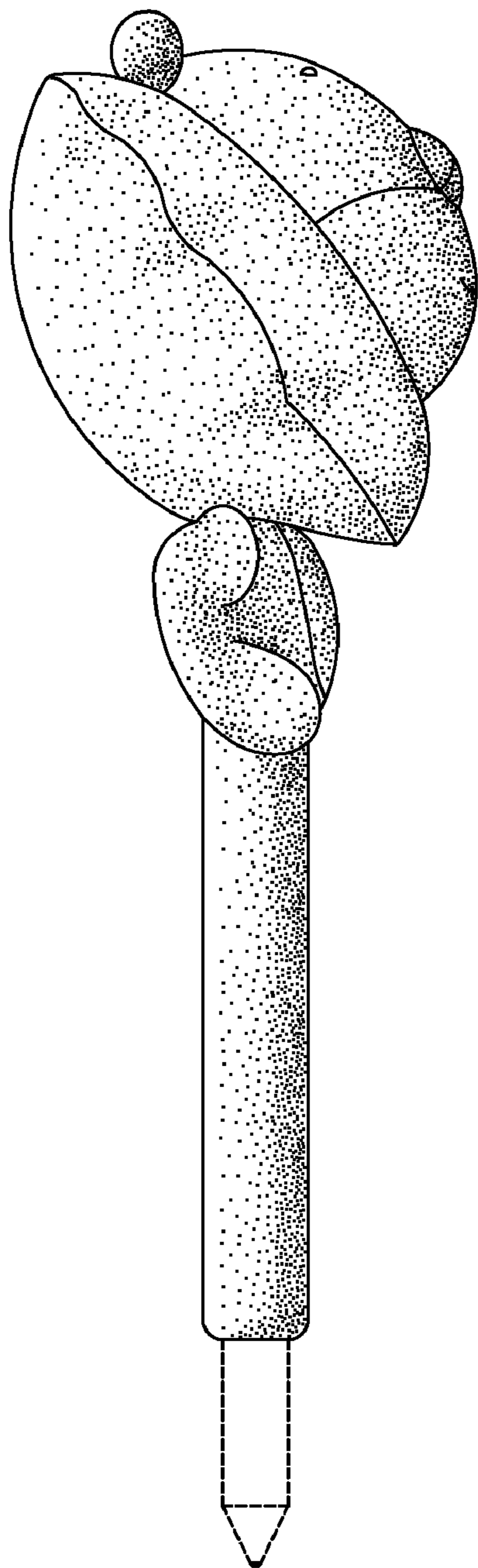

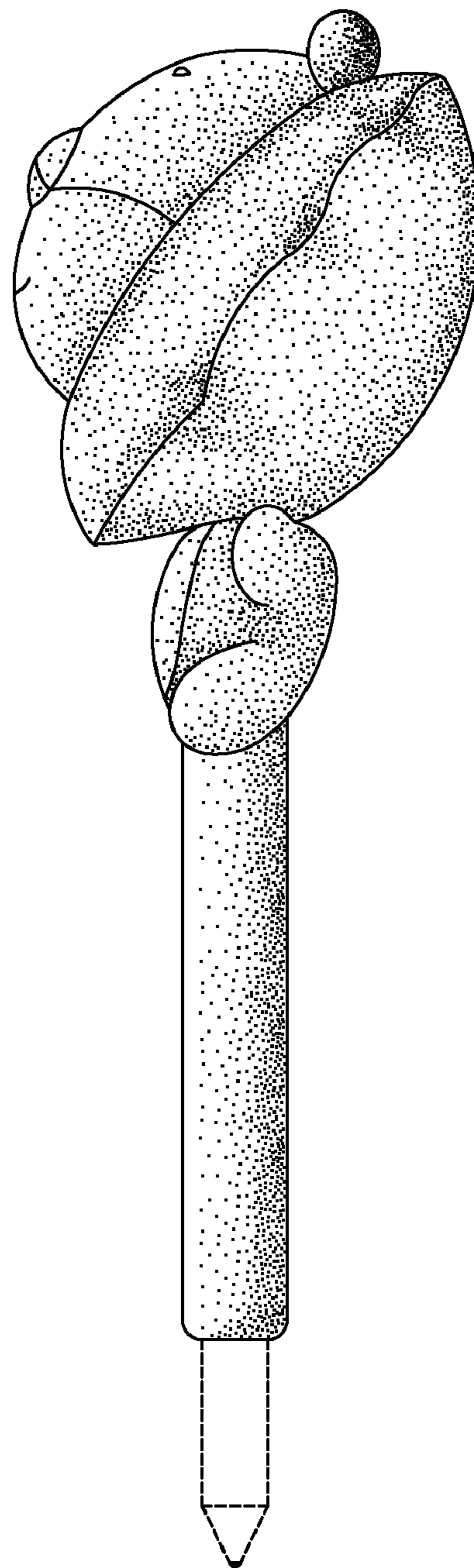
