(57) **CLAIM**

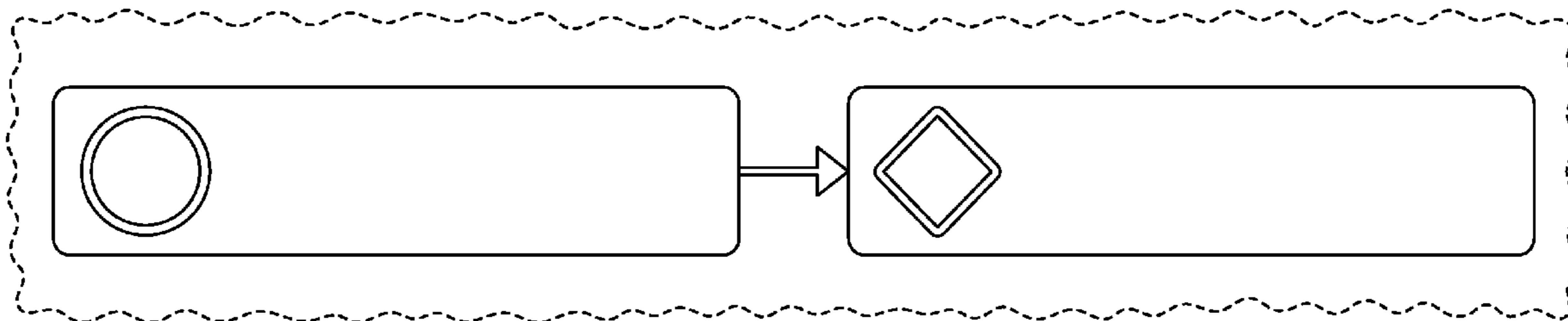
The ornamental design for a user interface for a display screen, as shown and described.

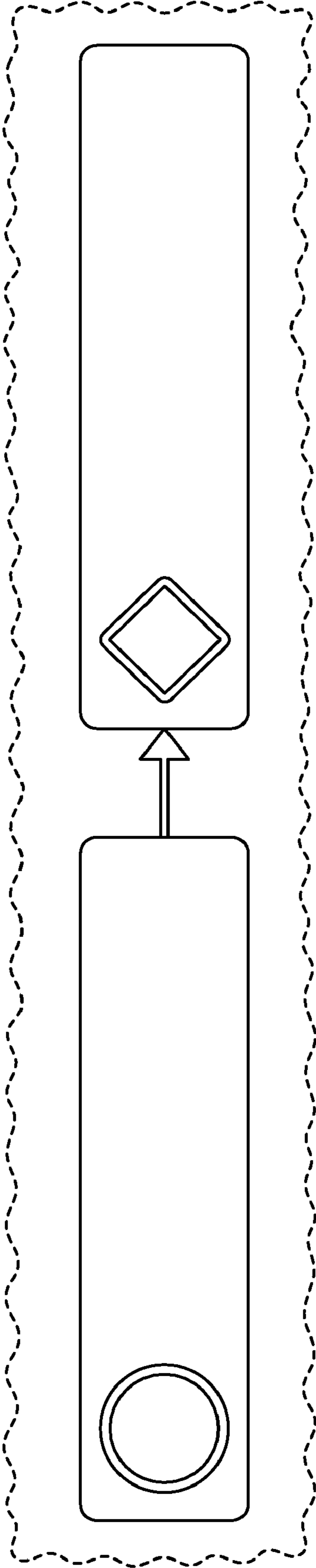
DESCRIPTION
