FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the cutting blade shown in FIG. 1.

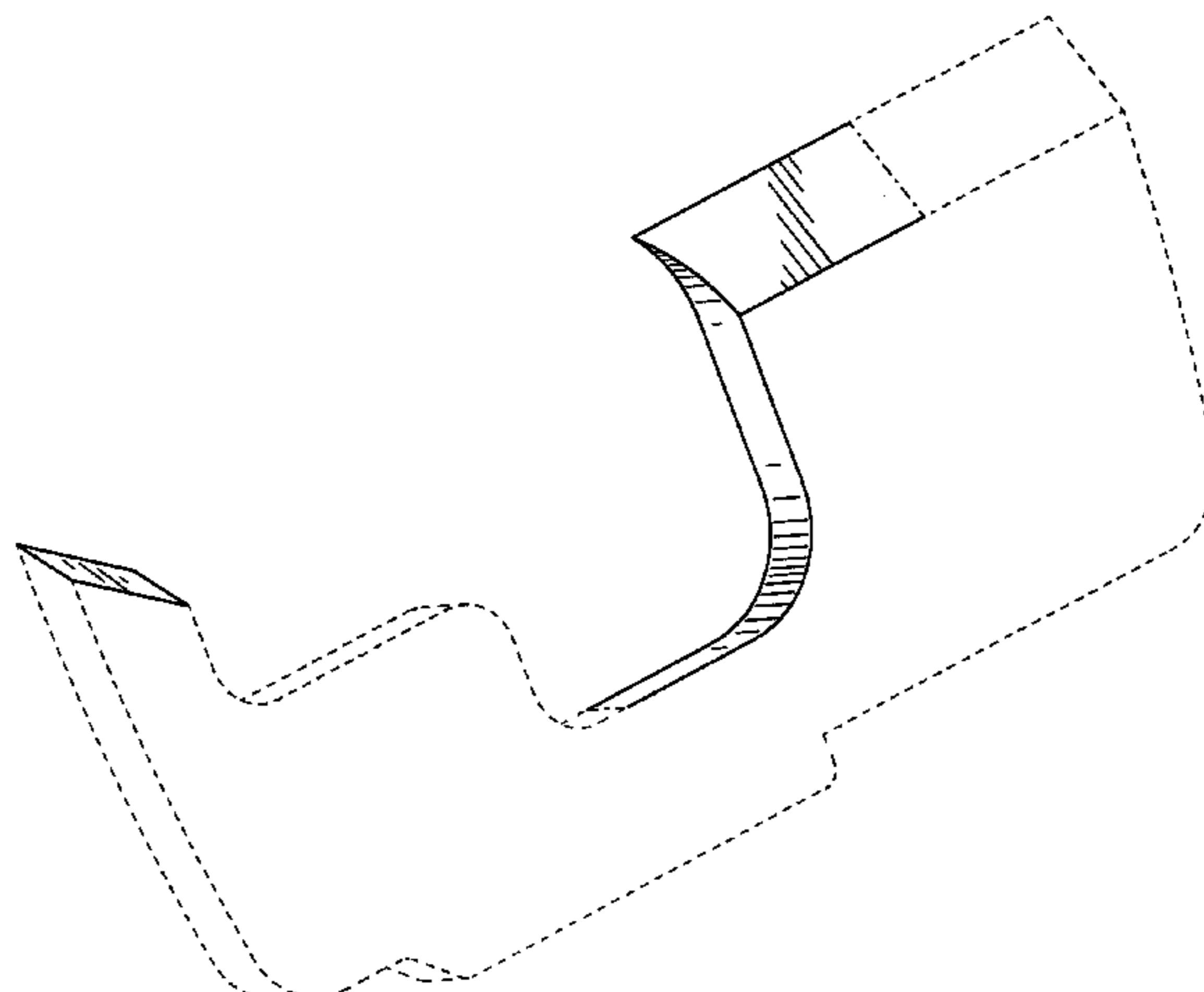
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the cutting blade shown in FIG. 1.

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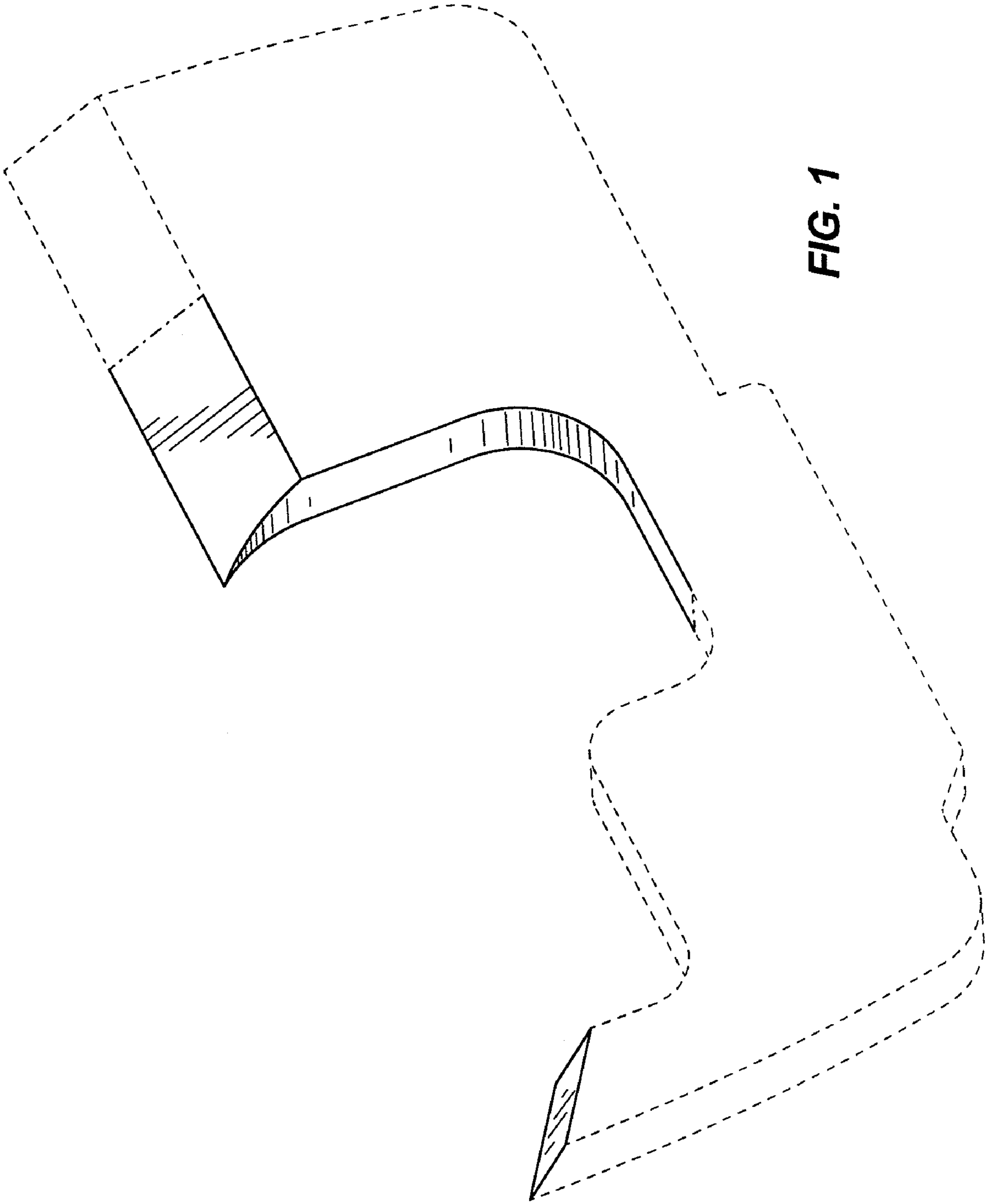

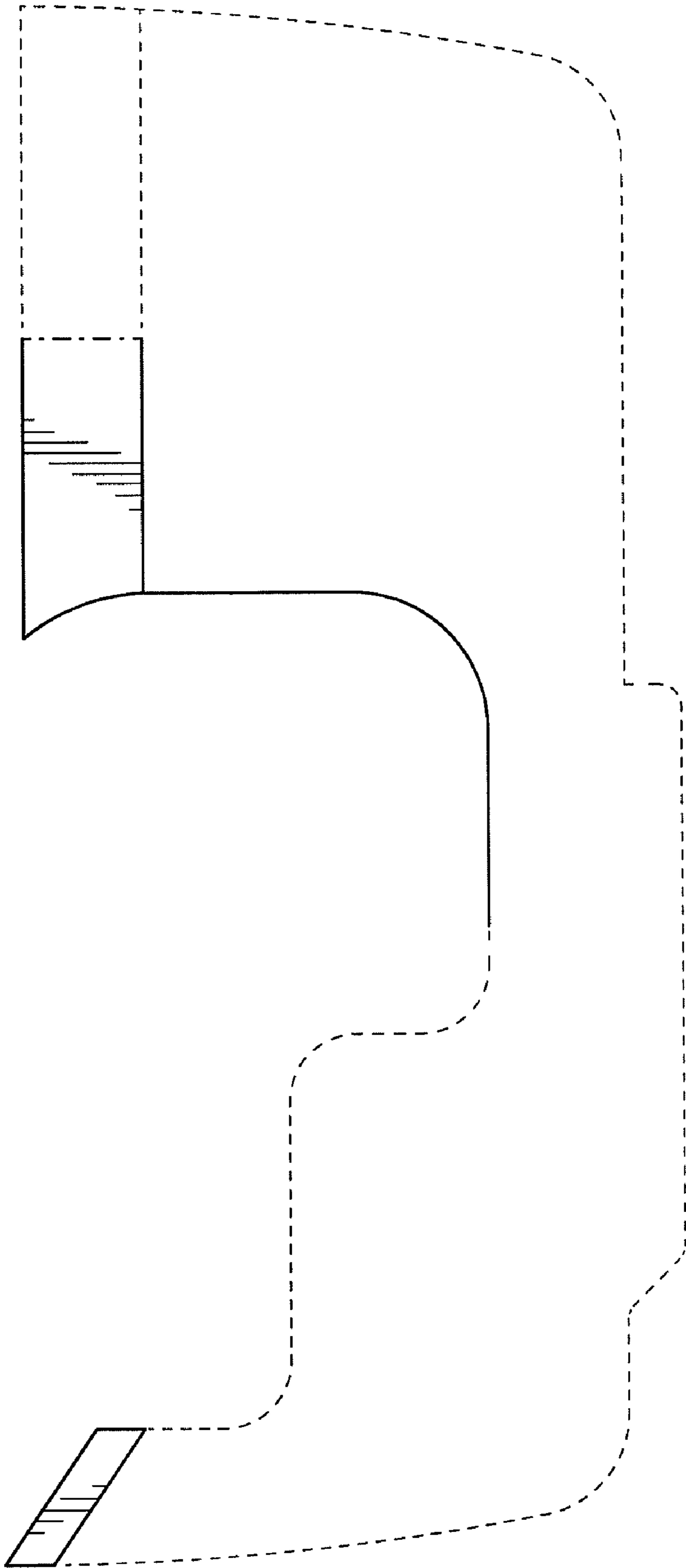

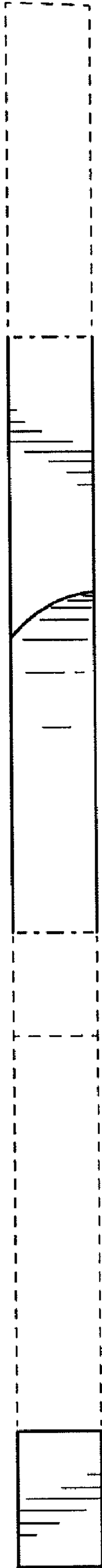

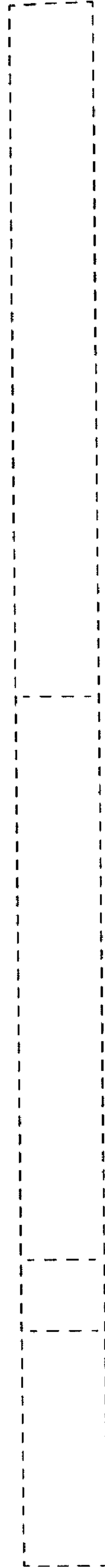

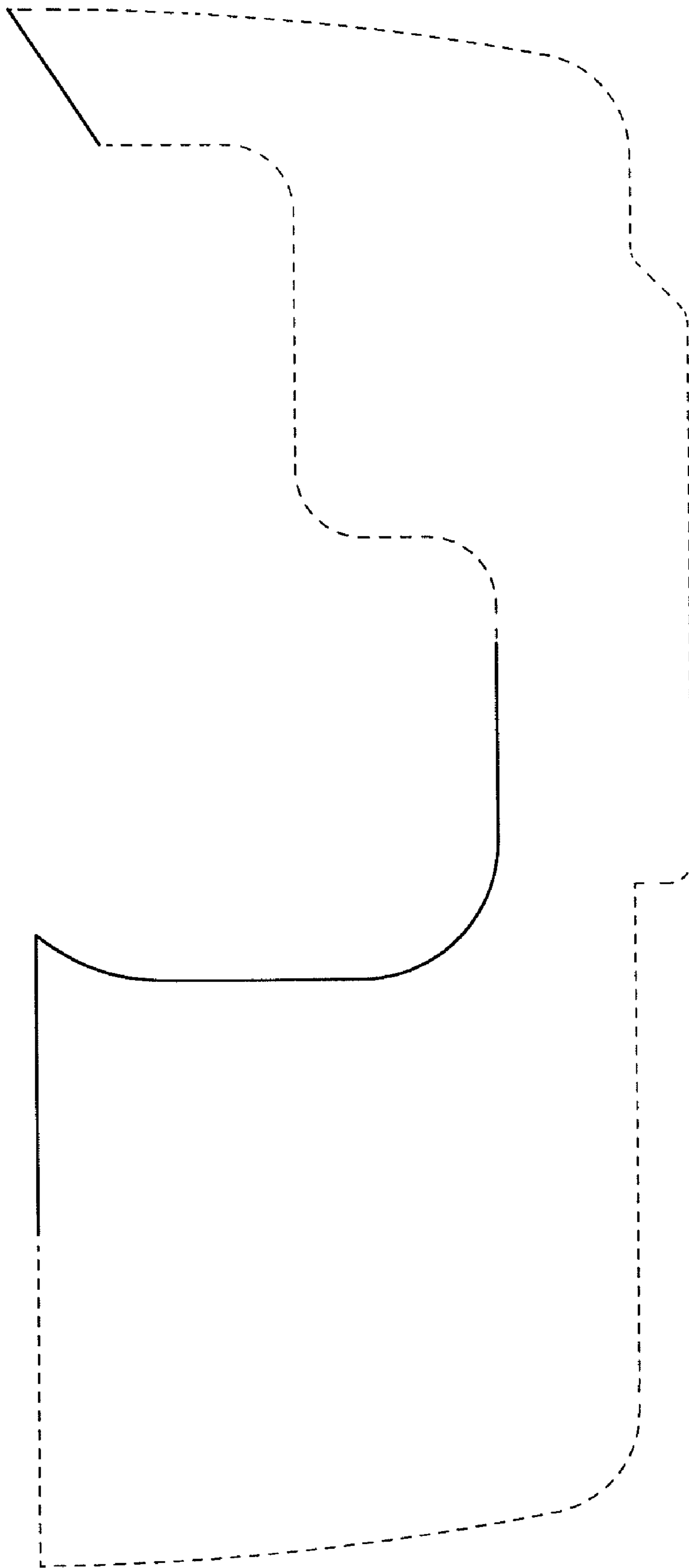

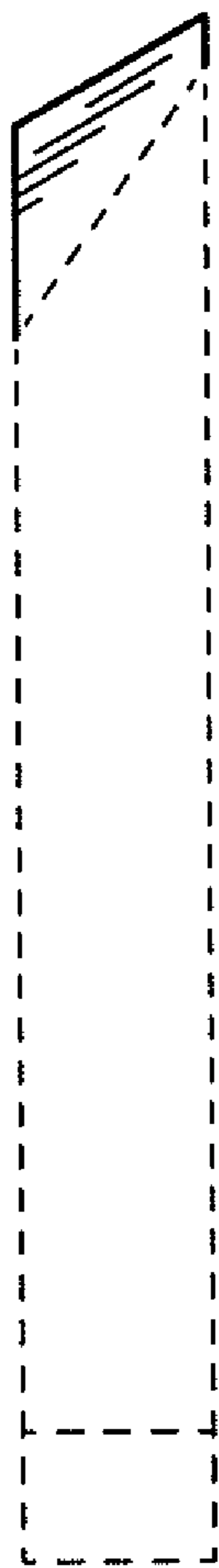
