FIG. 2 is a first elevational view of the golf tee shown in FIG. 1;

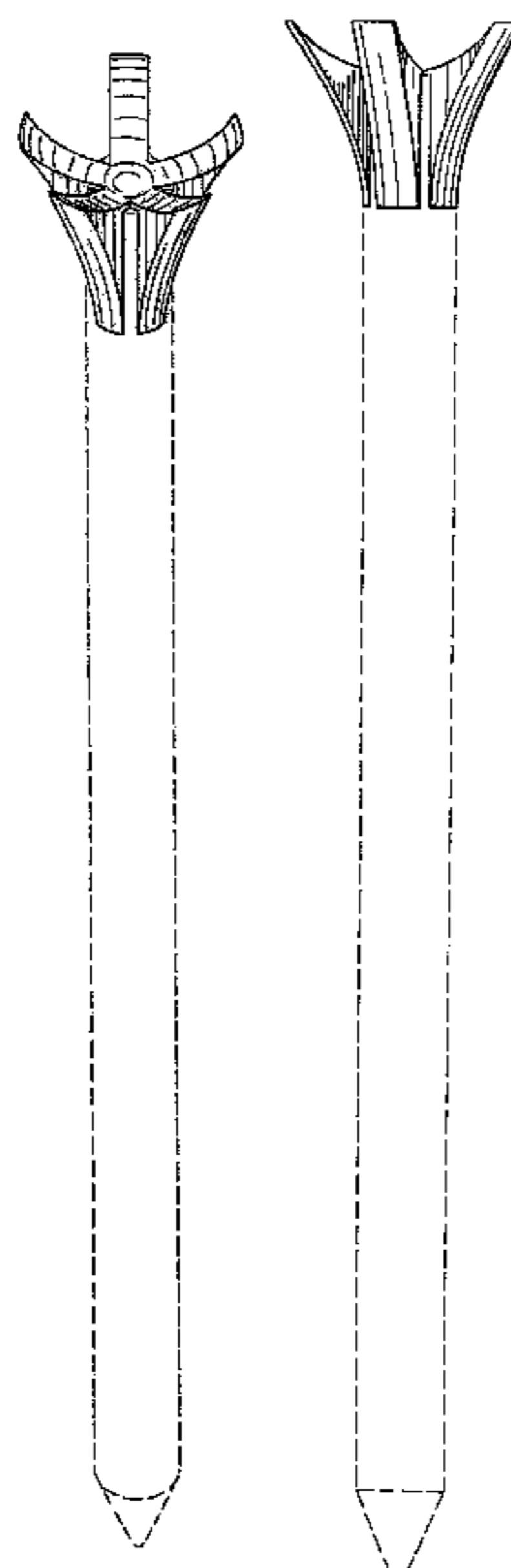
FIG. 3 is a second elevational view of the golf tee shown in FIG. 1;

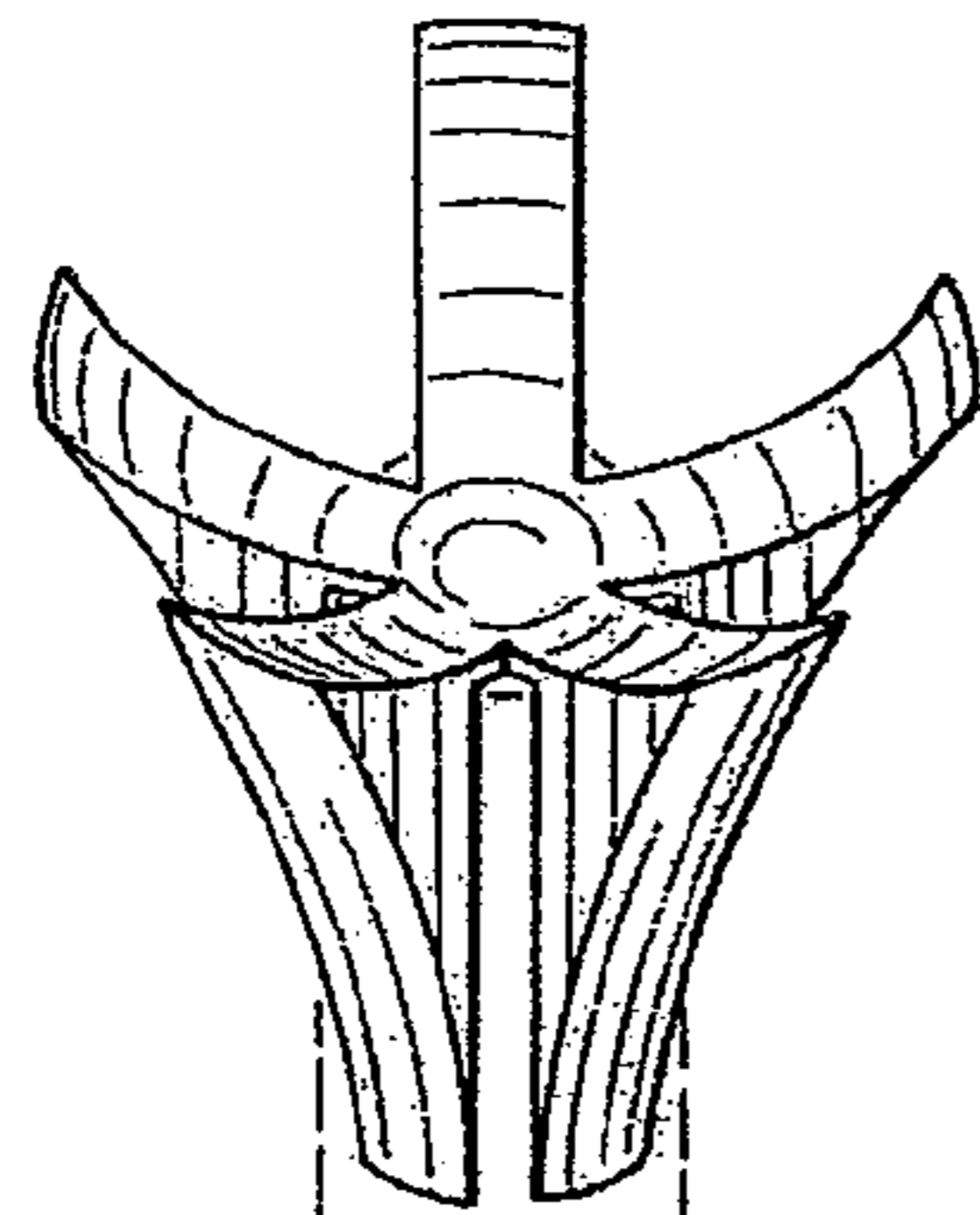

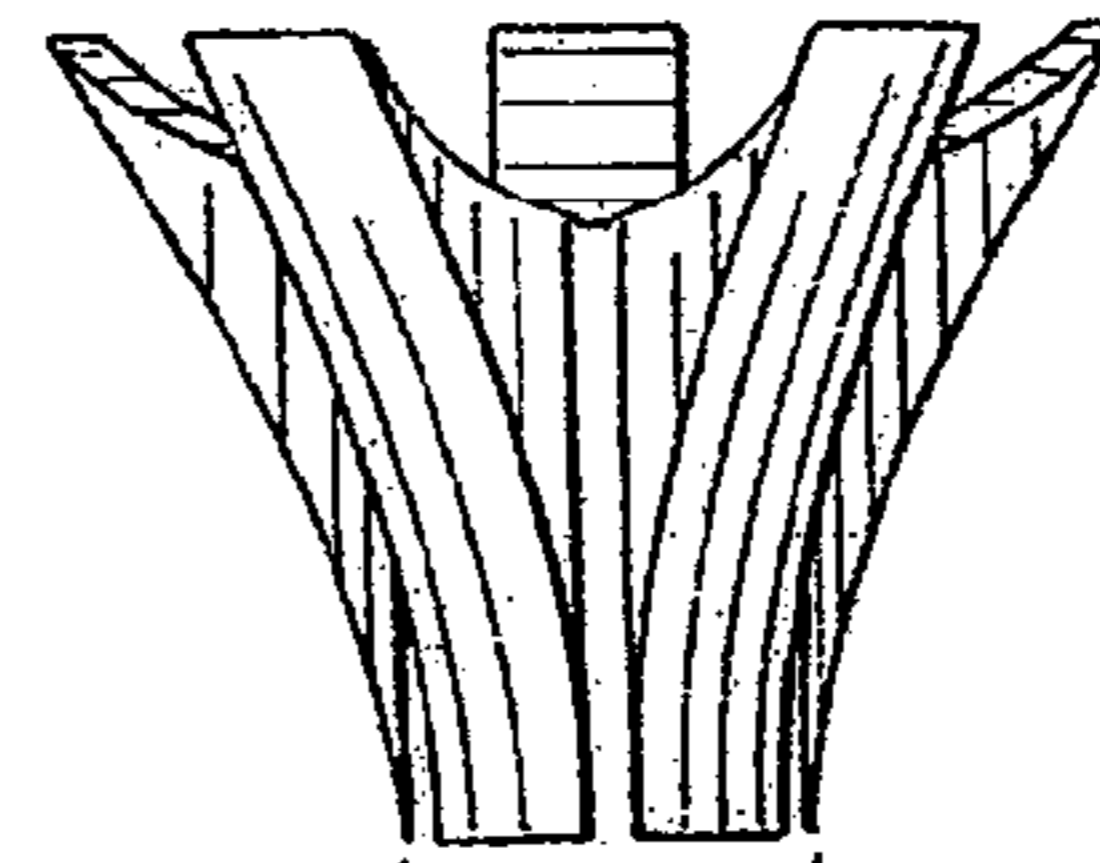

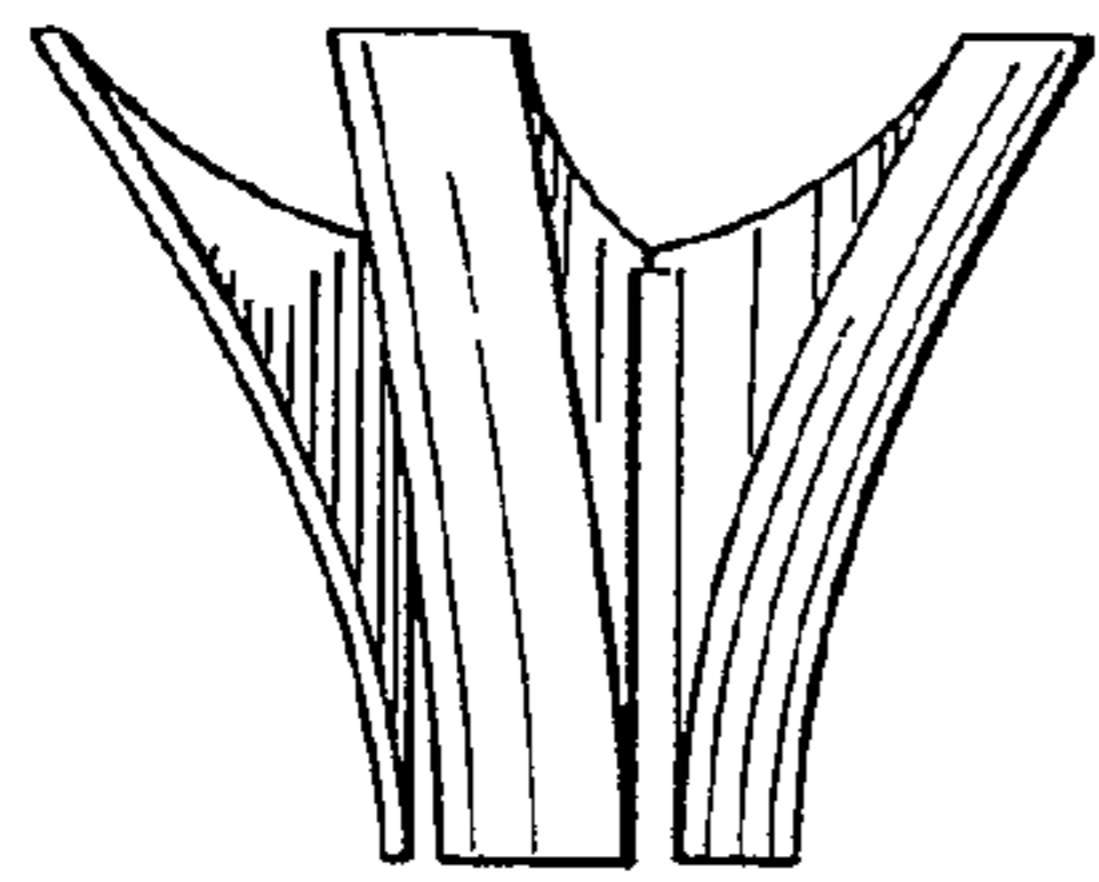

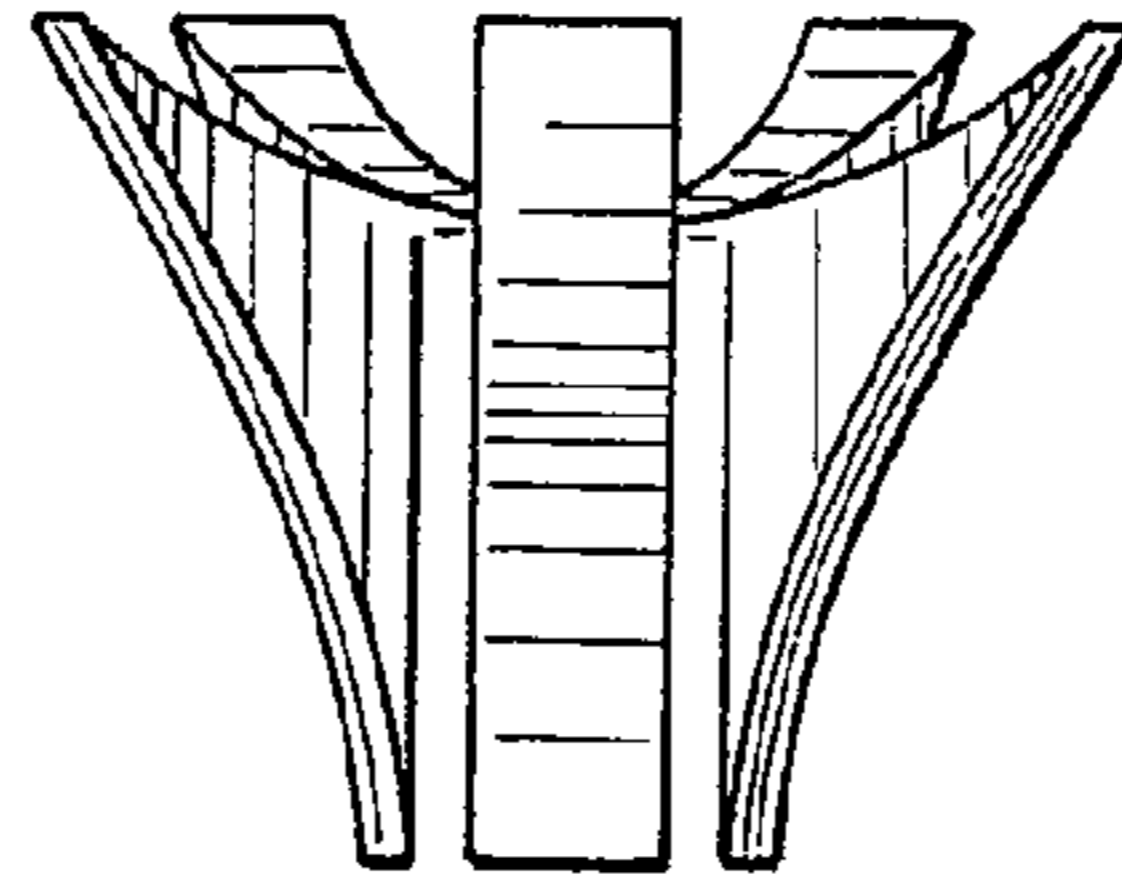

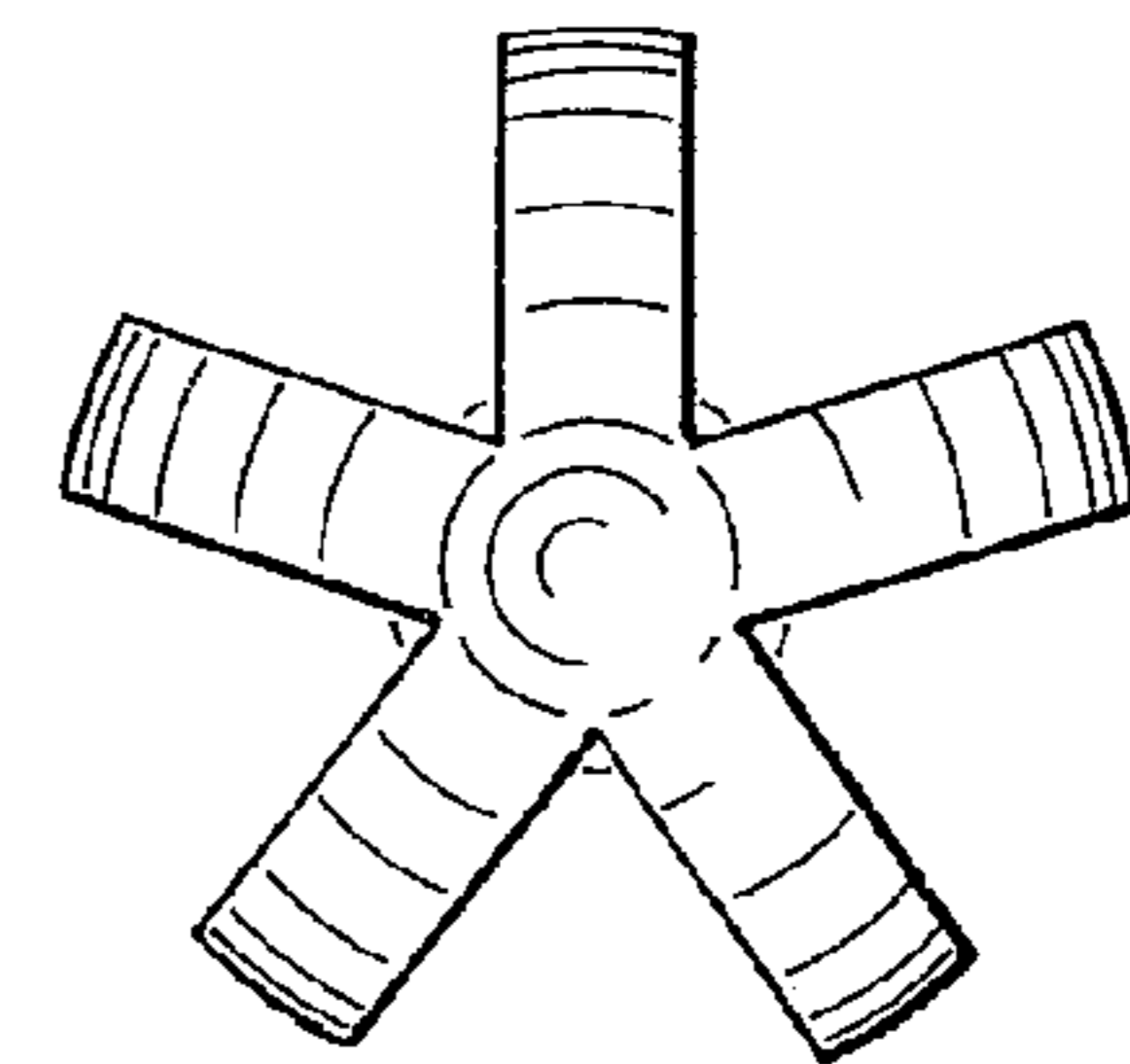

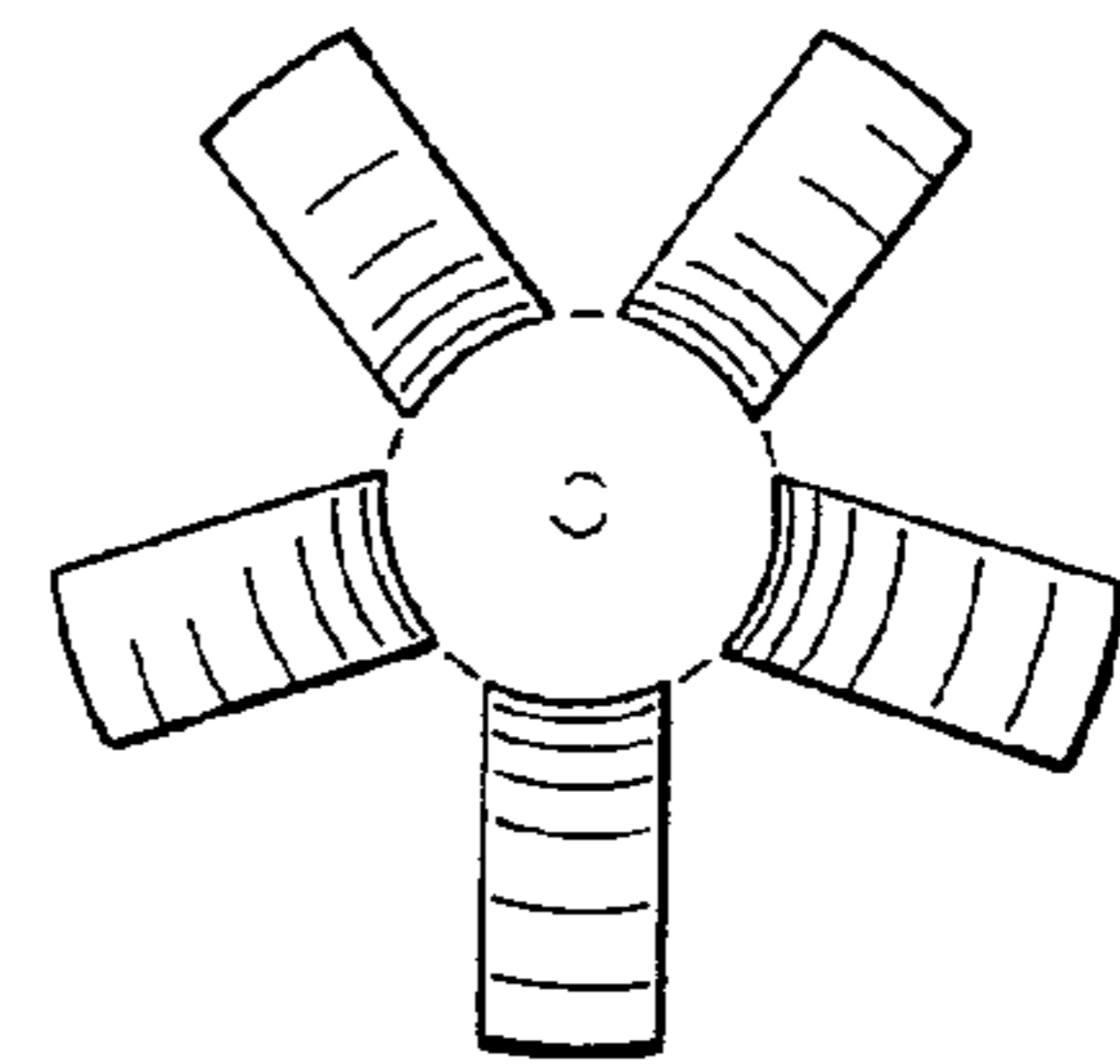
