(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pants inseam zipper opening, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of our new pants inseam zipper opening having the zipper unzipped;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view having the zipper unzipped;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view on an enlarged scale having the zipper unzipped;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation;

FIG. 6 is a right sectional view taken on the line 6—6 of FIG. 4;

FIG. 7 is a left sectional view taken on the line 7—7 of FIG. 4;

FIG. 8 is a bottom elevation on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 9 is a top elevation on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 10 is a sectional view taken on line 10—10 of FIG. 8; and,

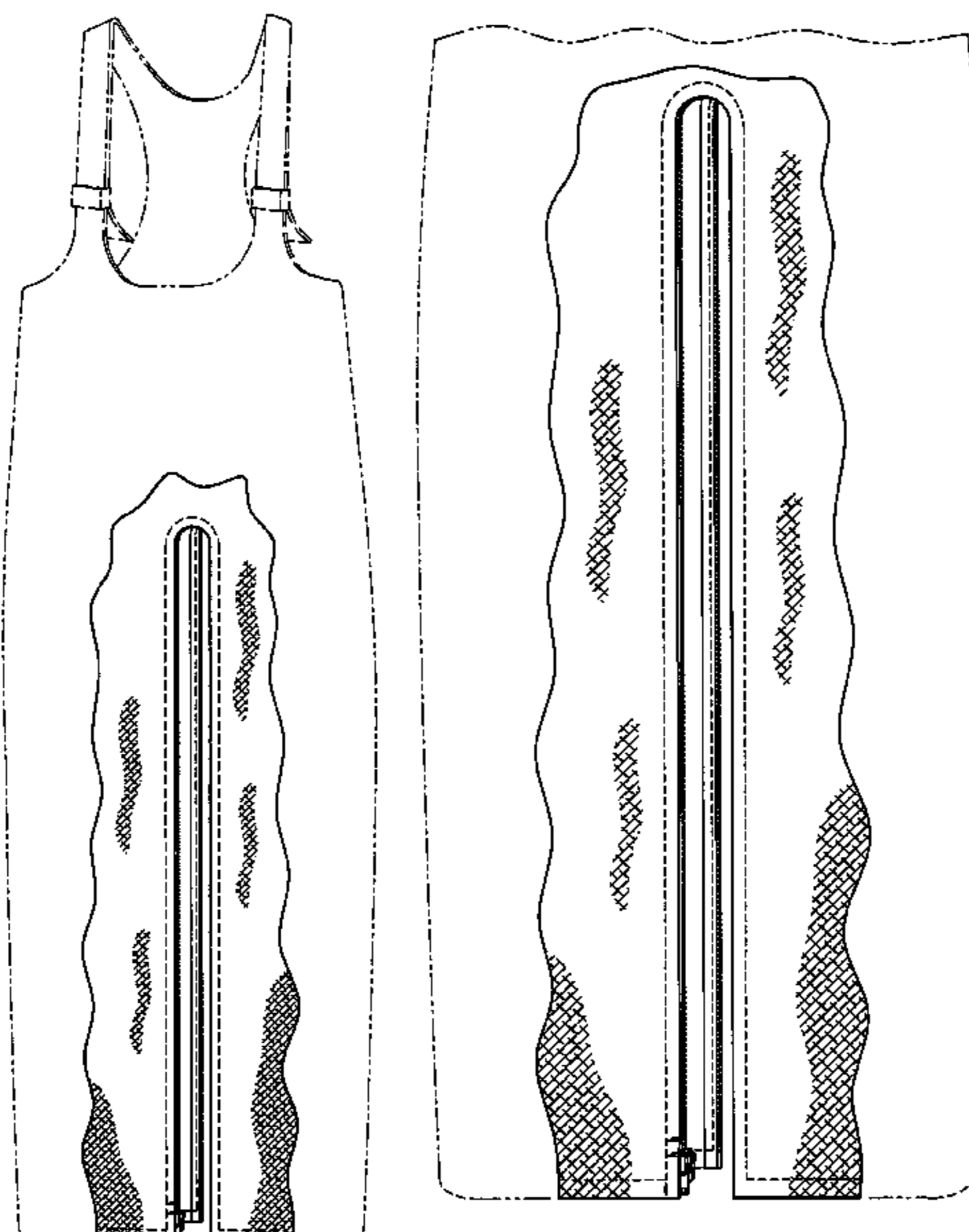
FIG. 11 is a sectional view taken on line 11—11 of FIG. 8.

The broken lines showing portions of pants in FIGS. 1–11 are illustrating environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design.

The broken lines on the surfaces of FIGS. 1–5 represent stitching.

The uneven outlining, immediately adjacent to the shaded portion of the pant's inseam in FIGS. 1–11, represents the boundaries of the design.

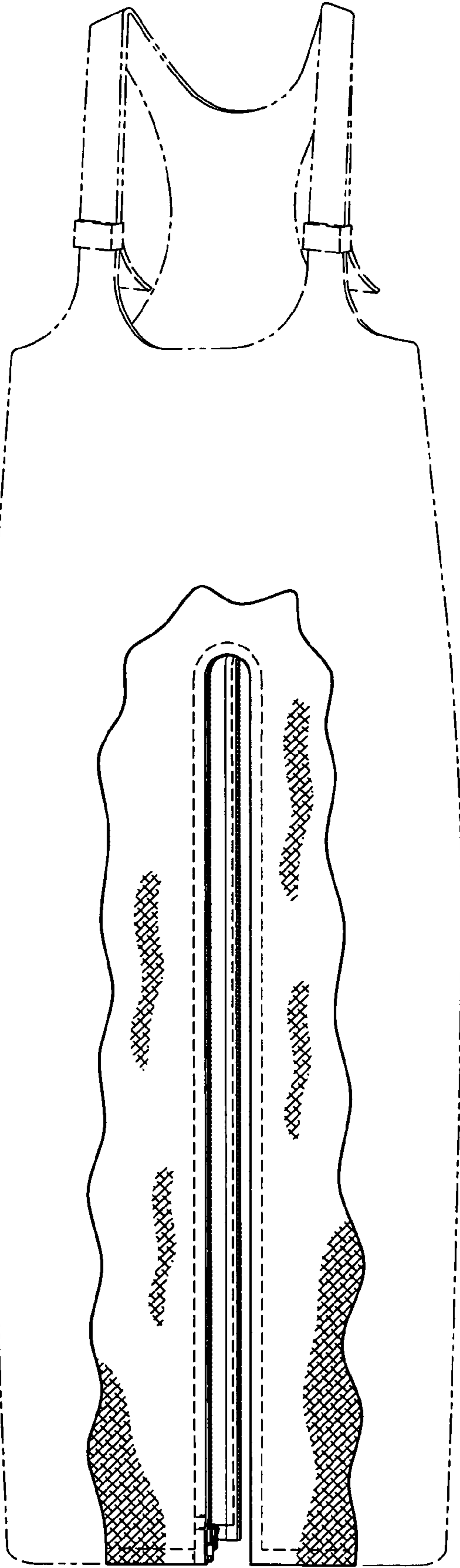

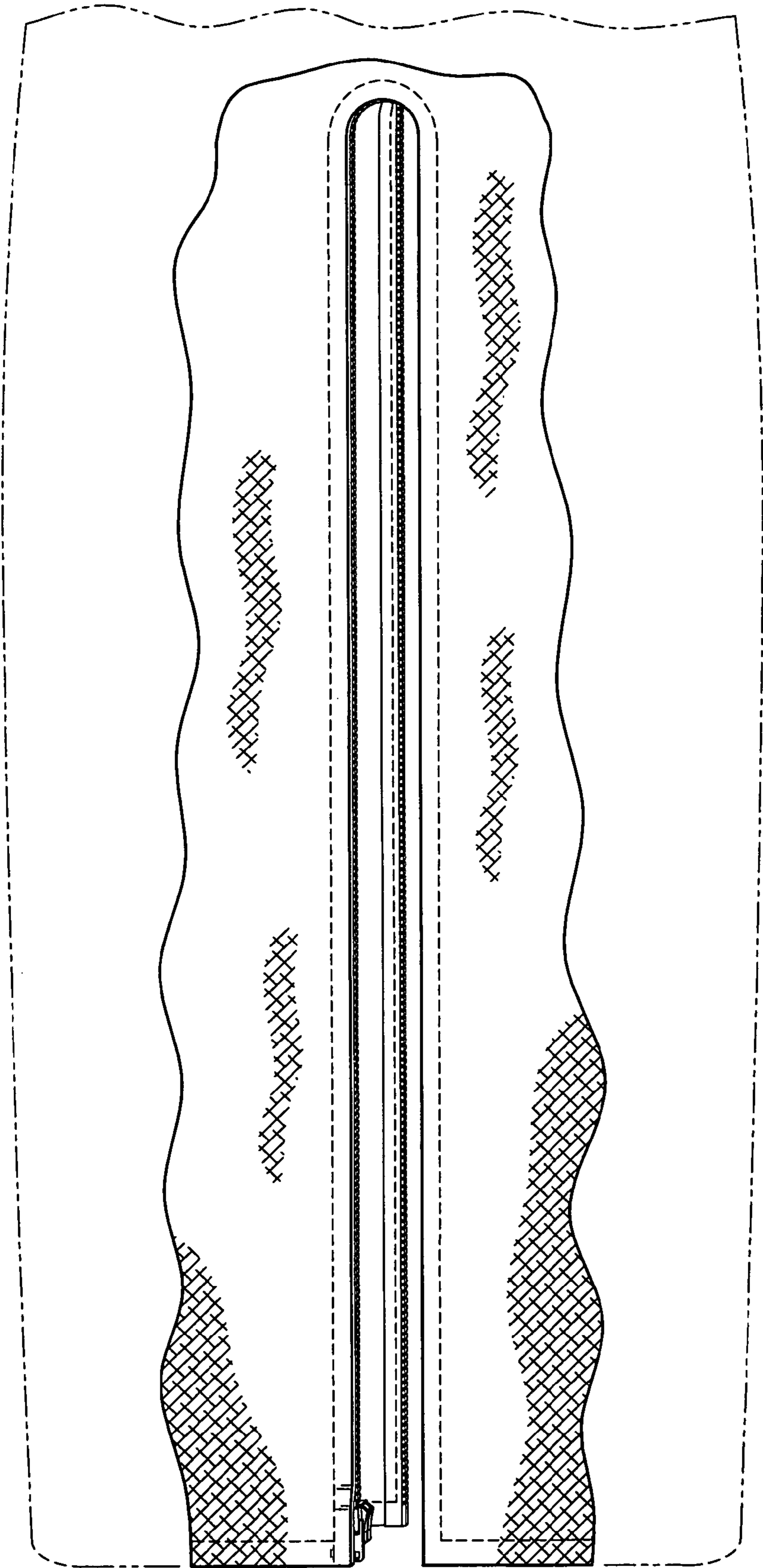

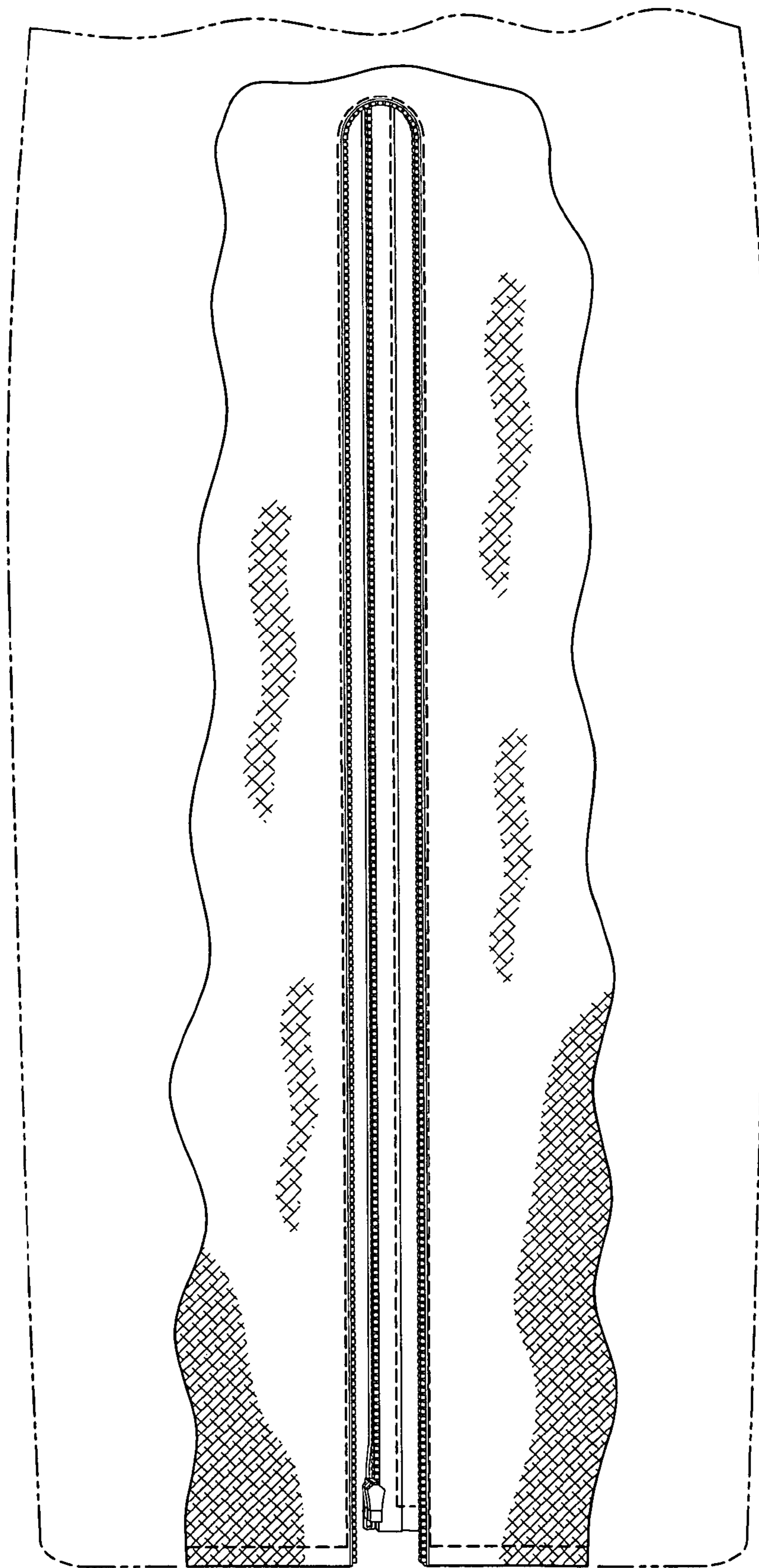

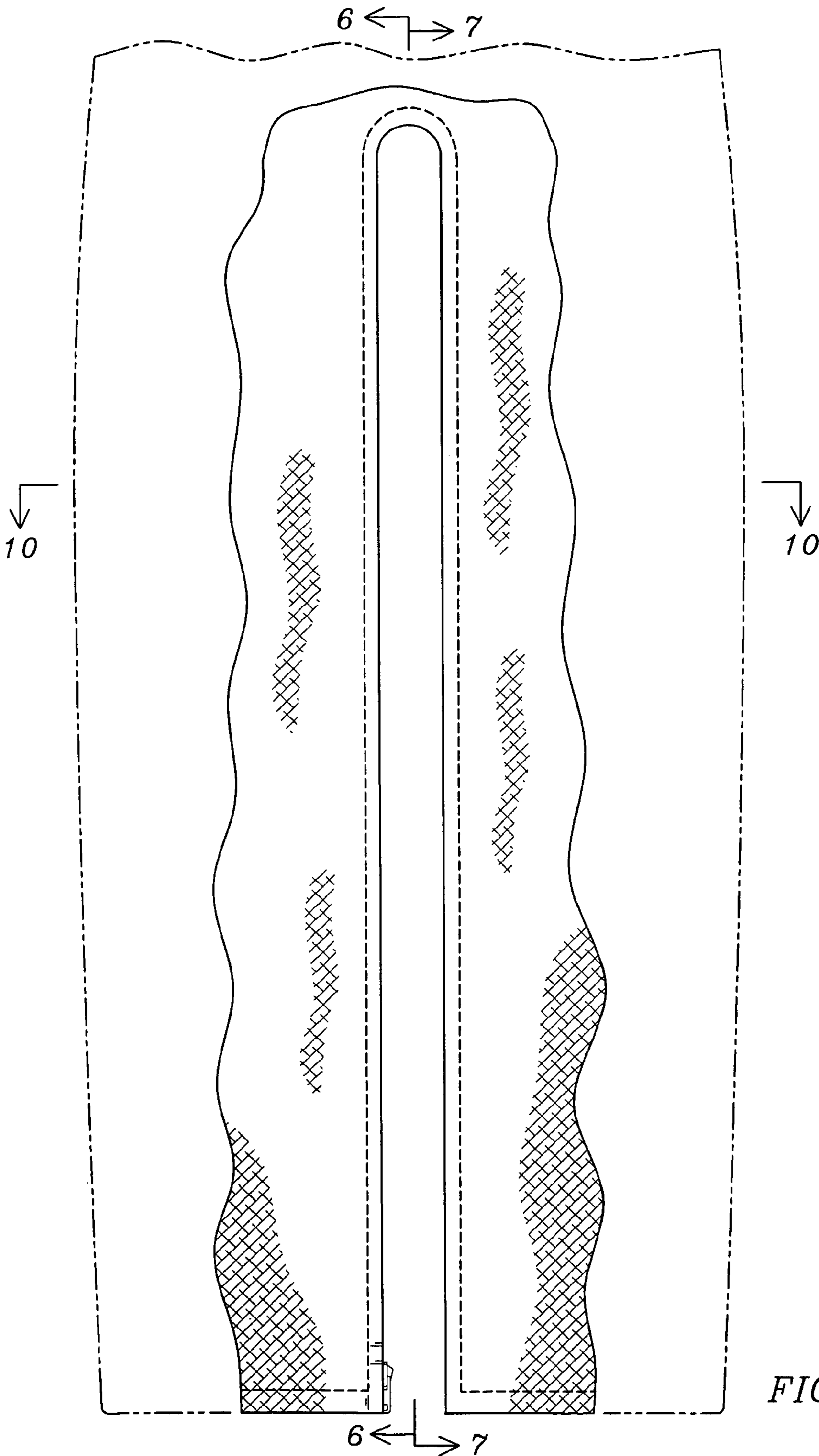

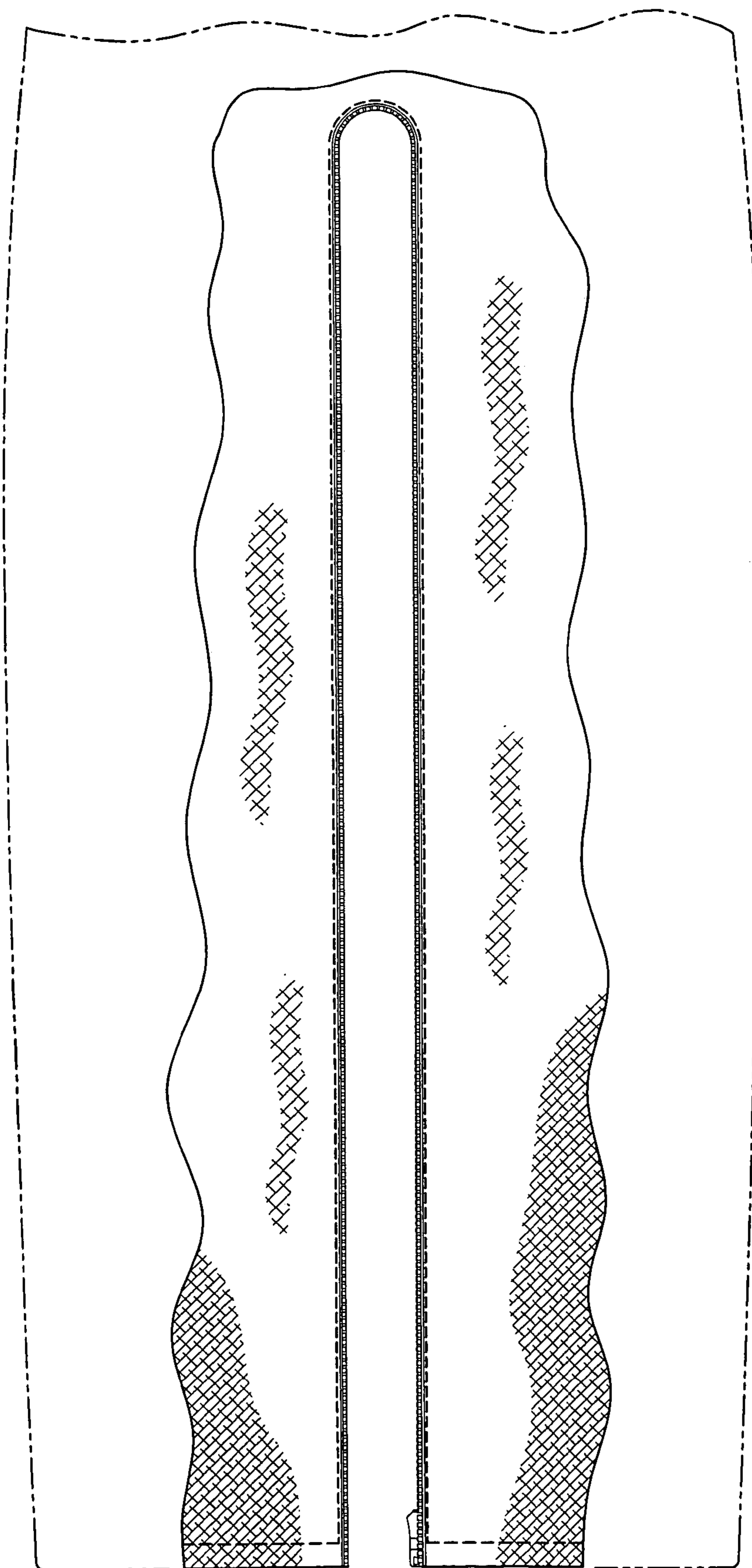

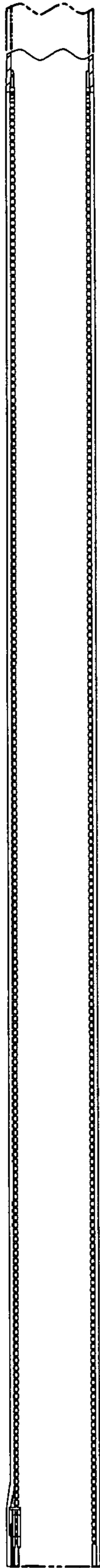

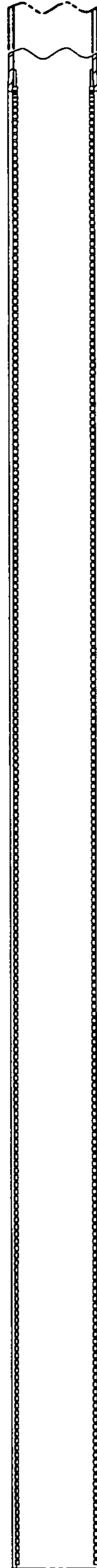

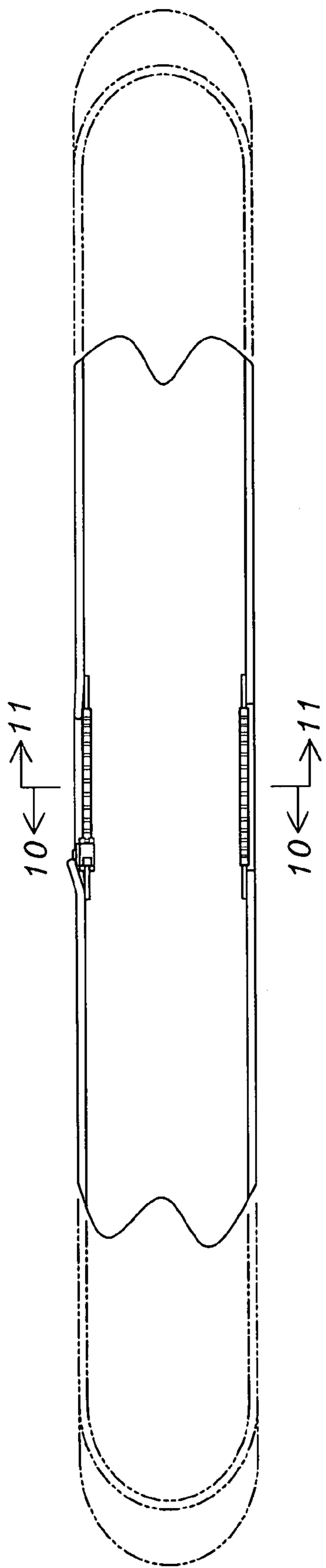

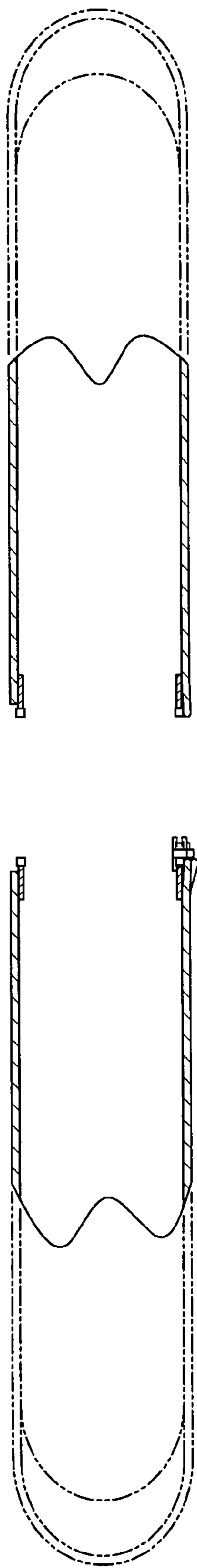

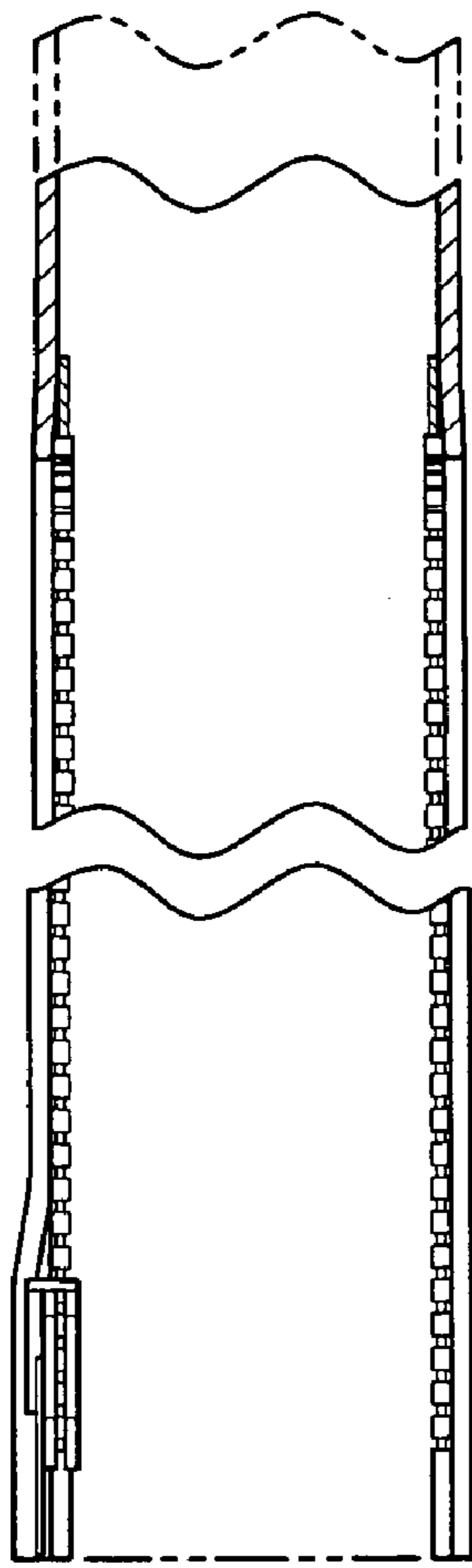

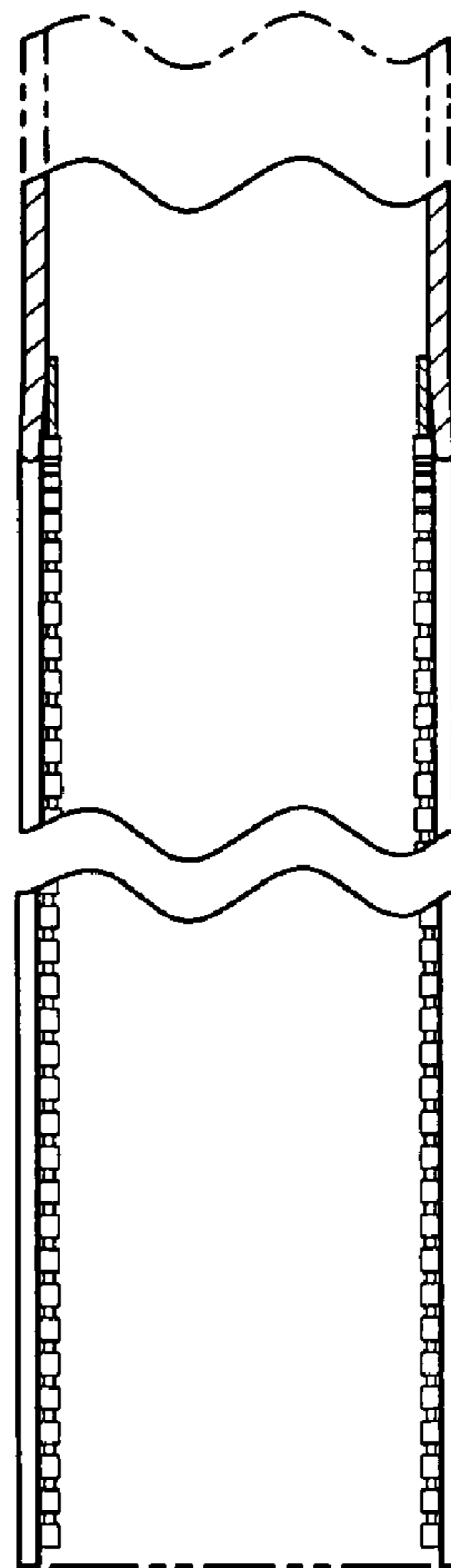
