FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of my new design with the slidable cover in the closed position.

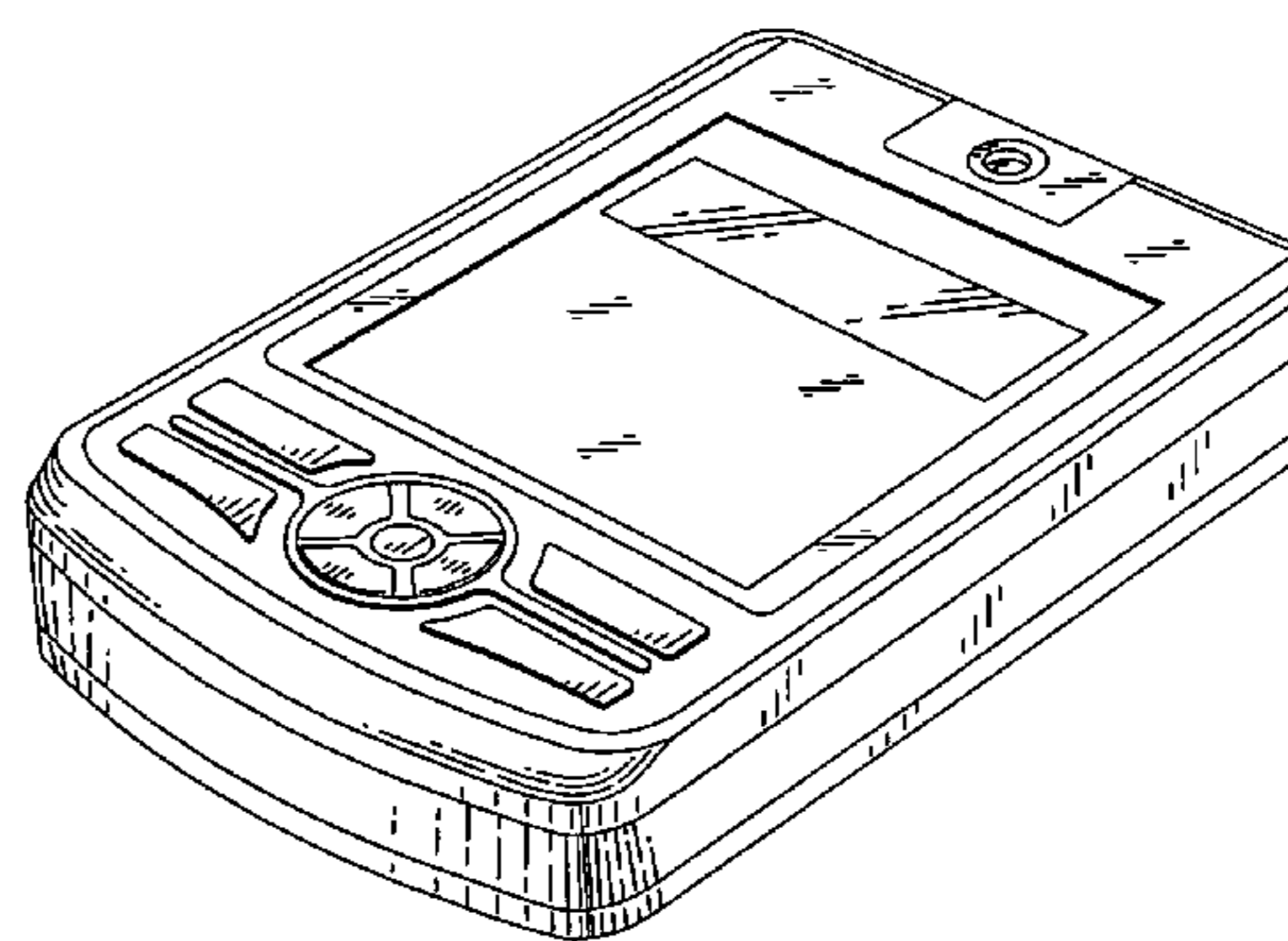
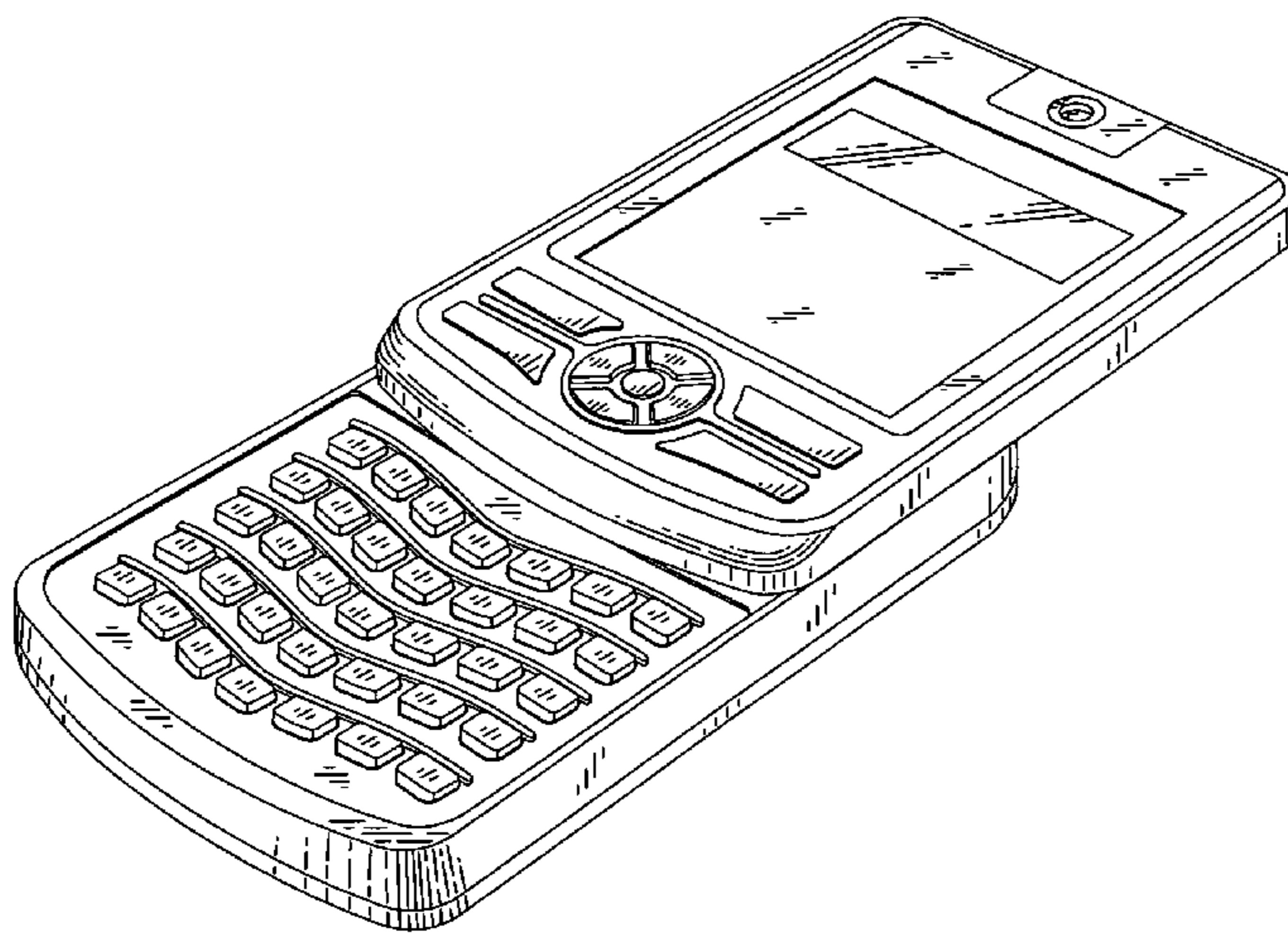

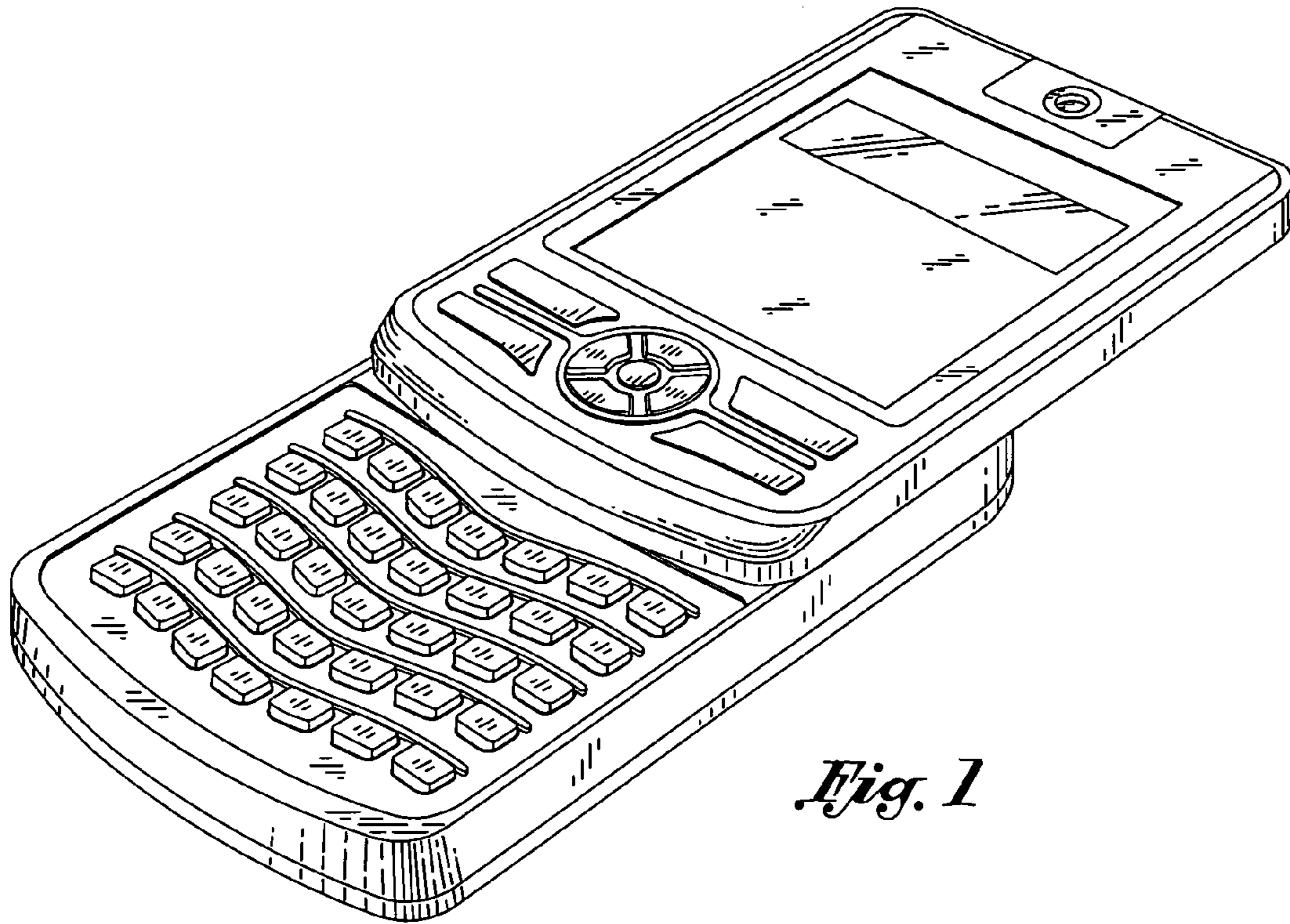

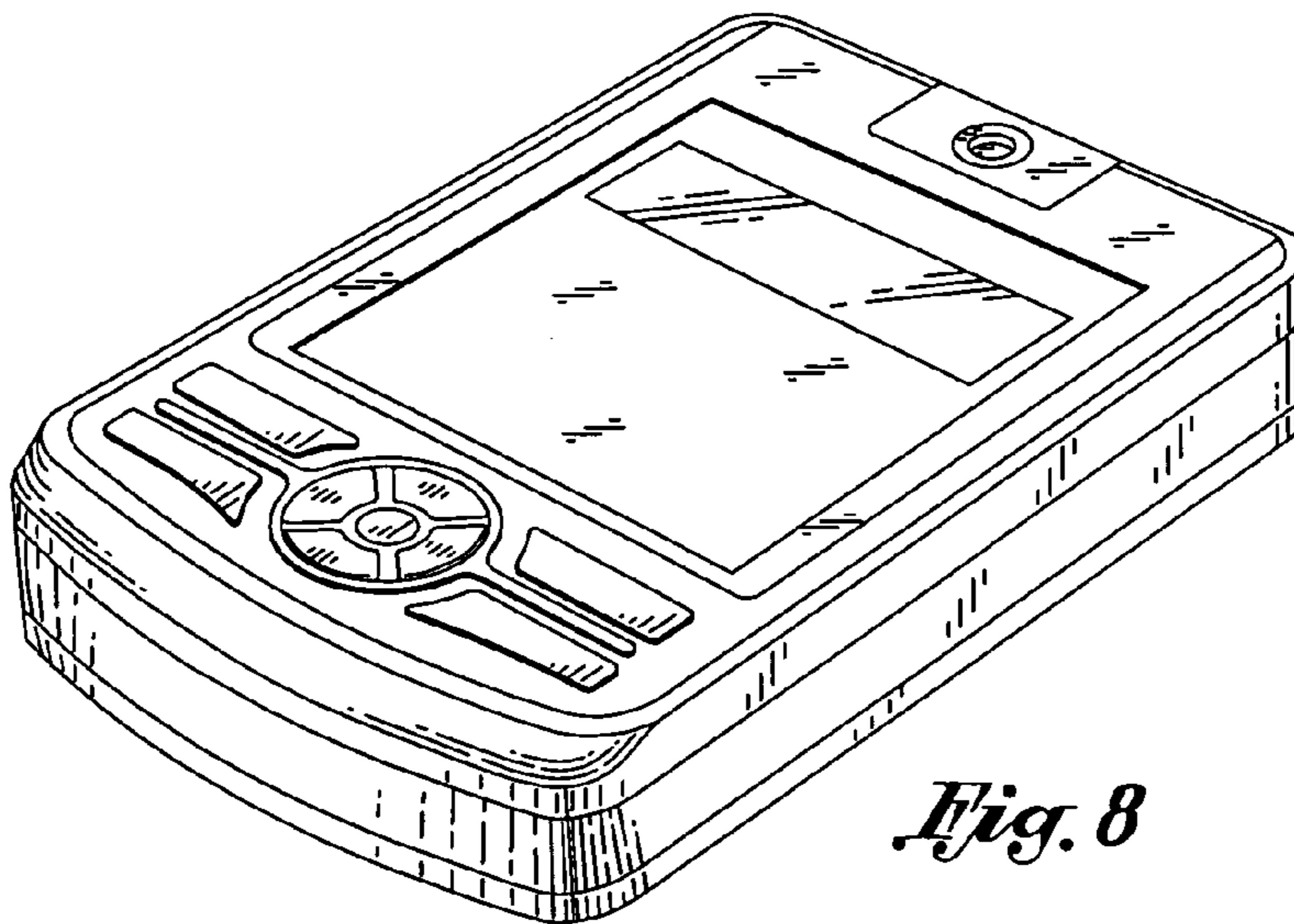

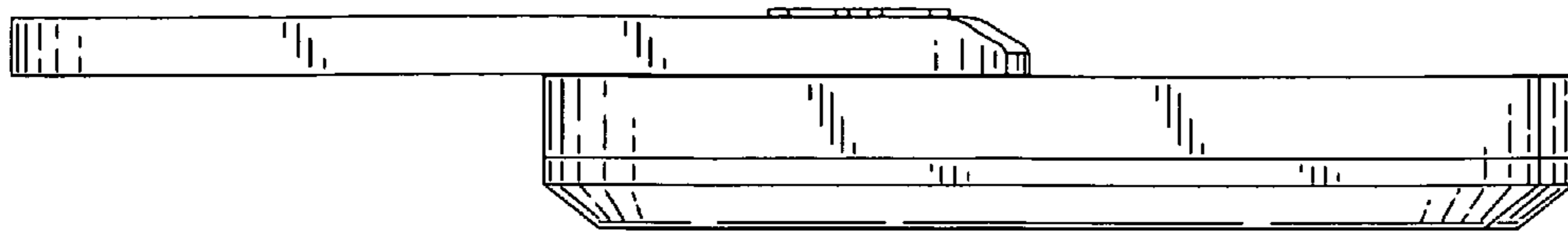




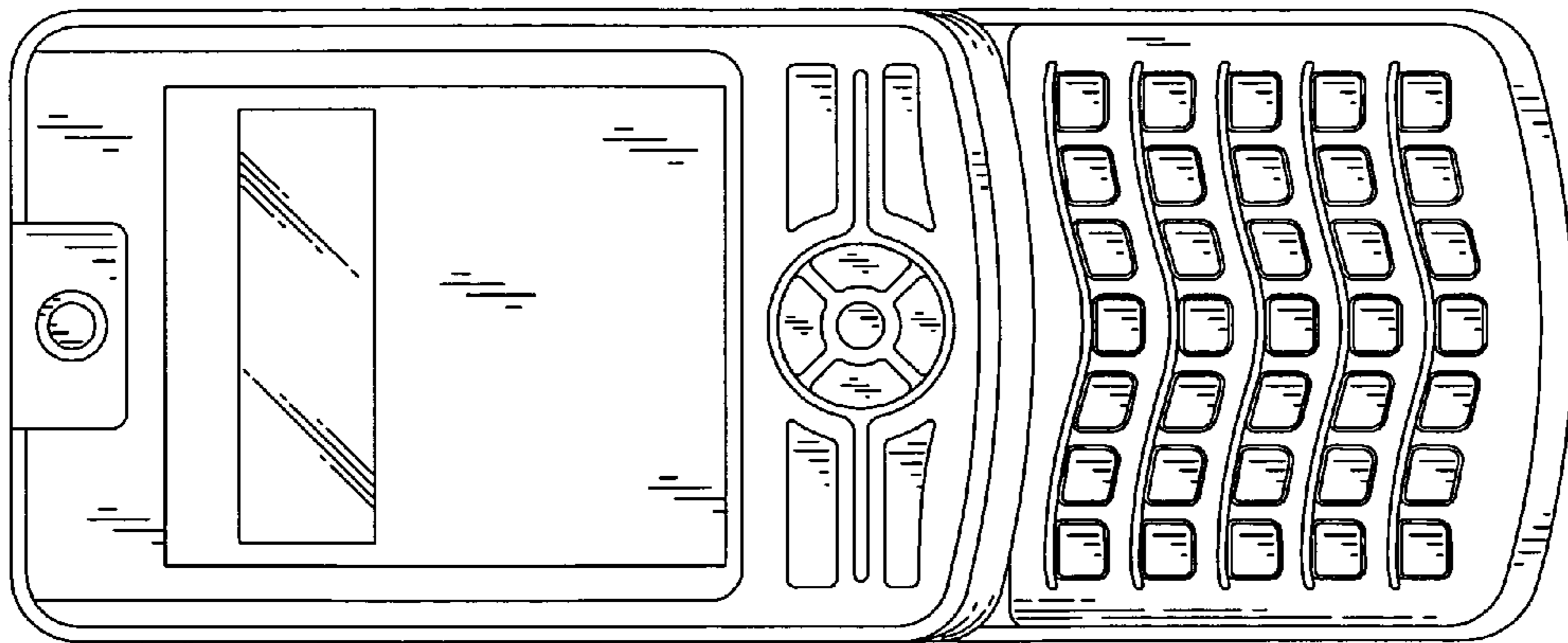

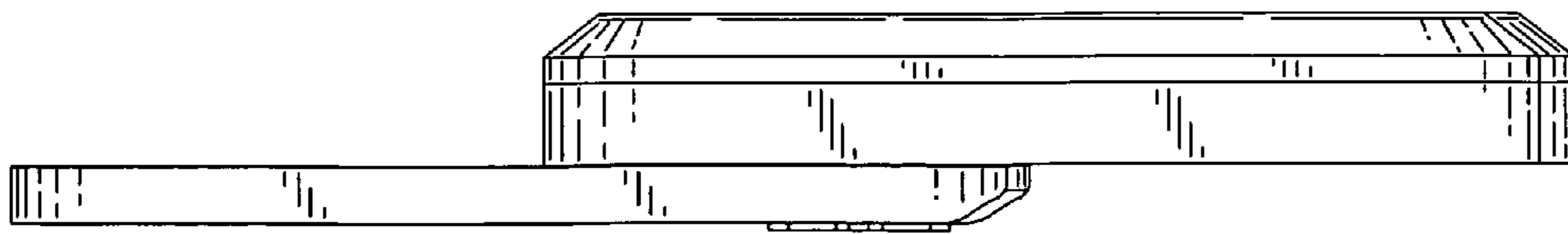

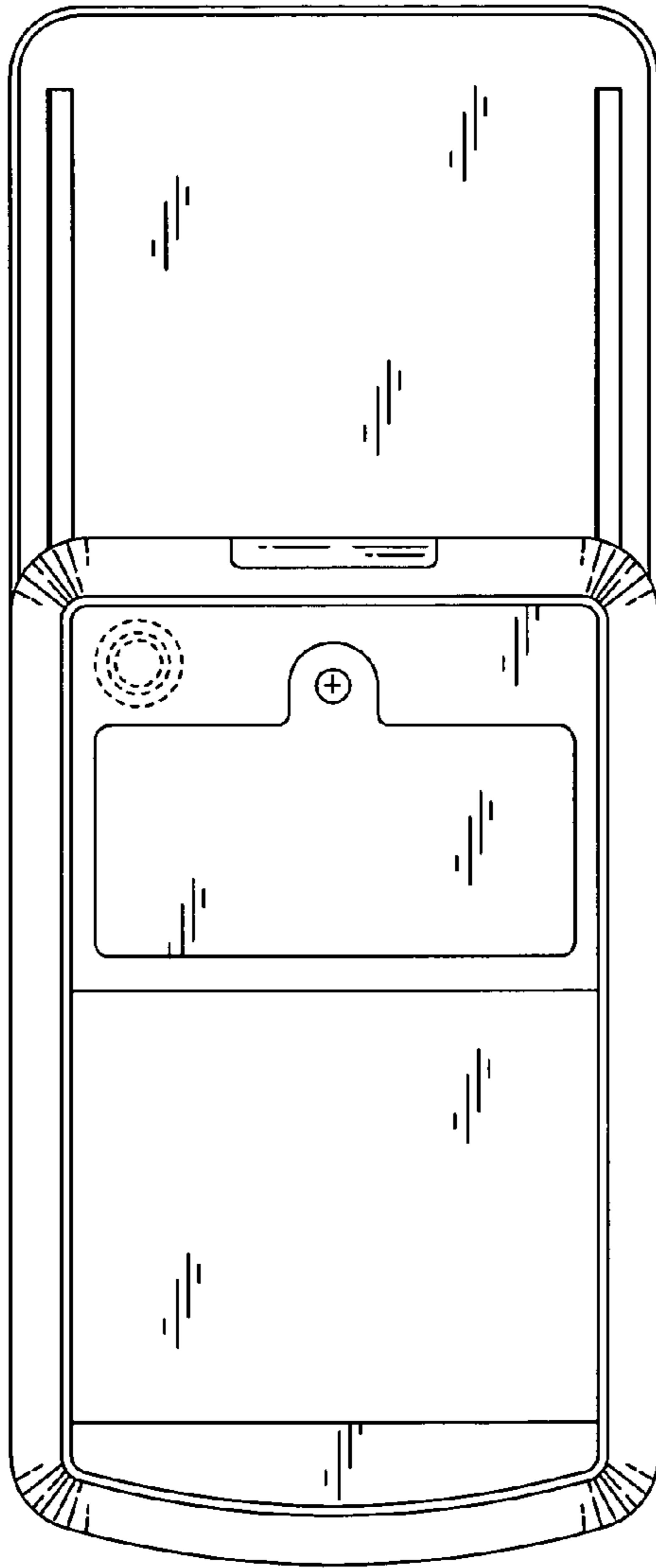

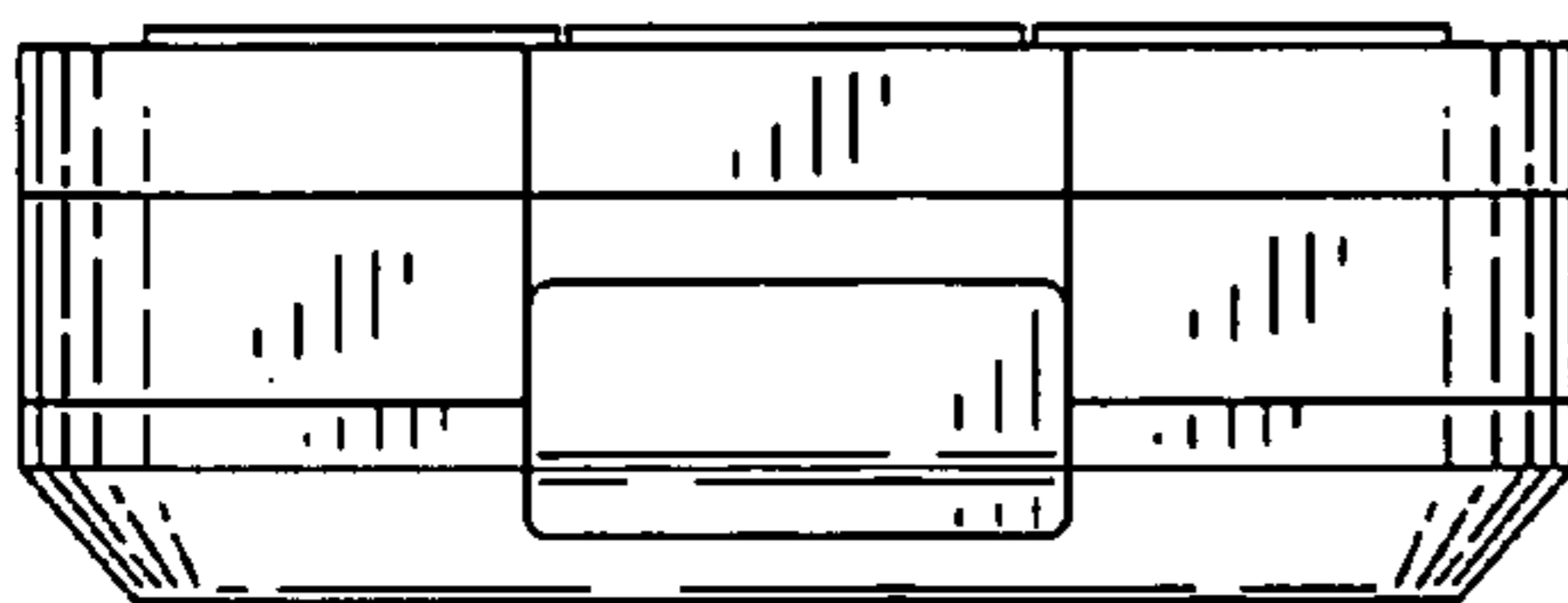

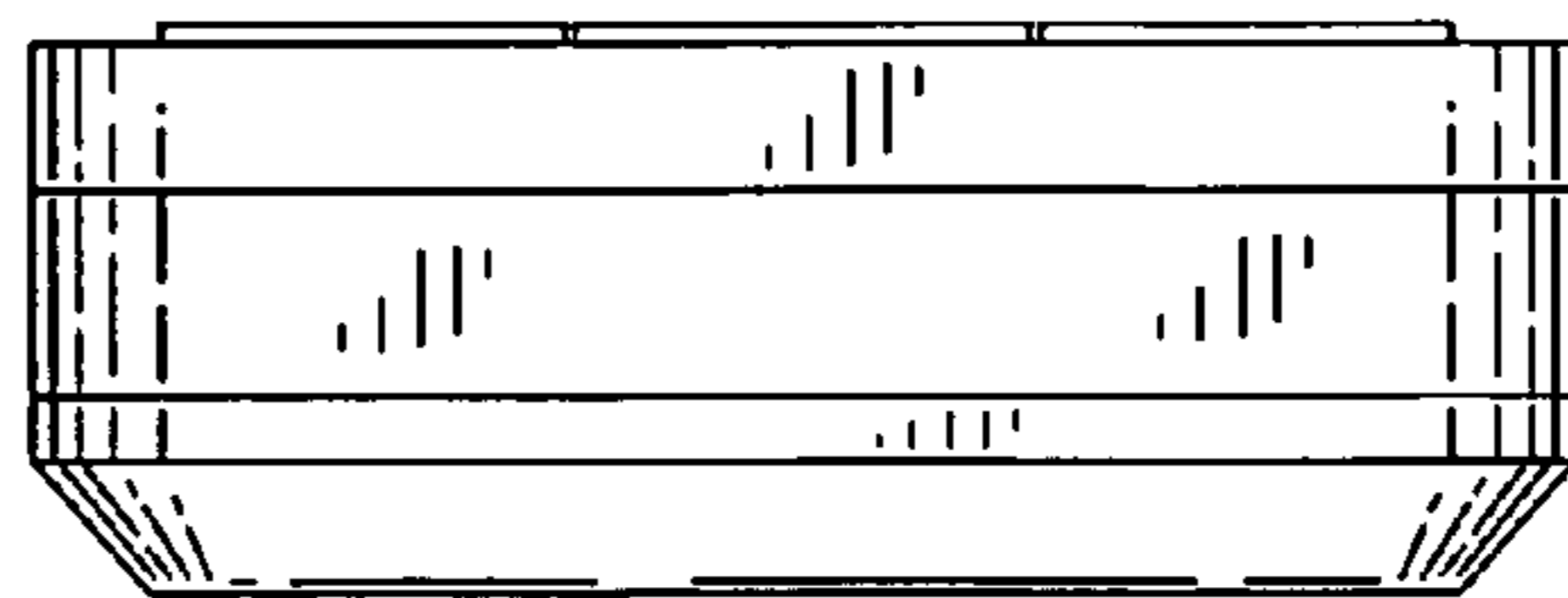
