(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pouch for a cloth, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pouch for a cloth showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

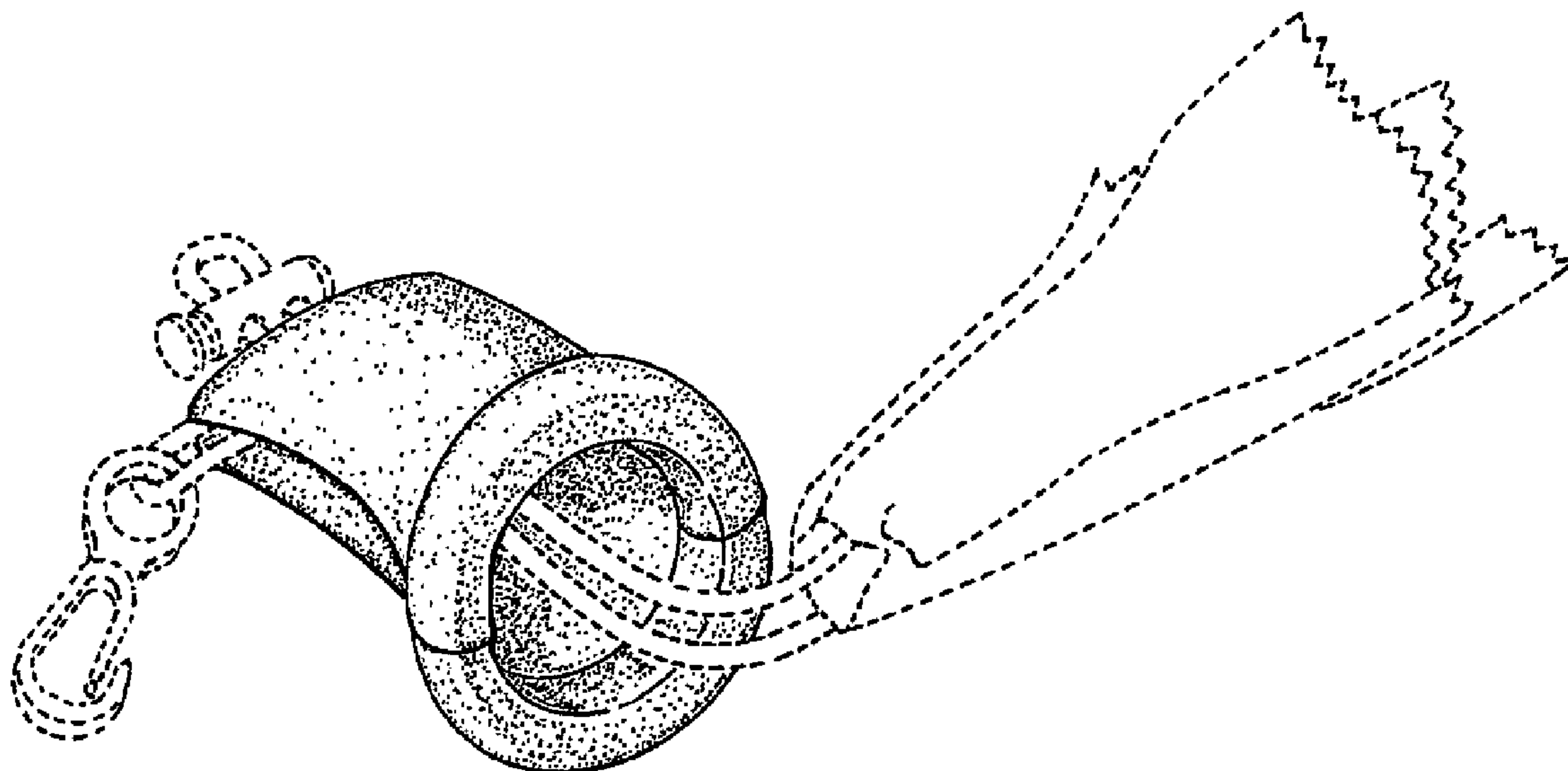
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1; and,

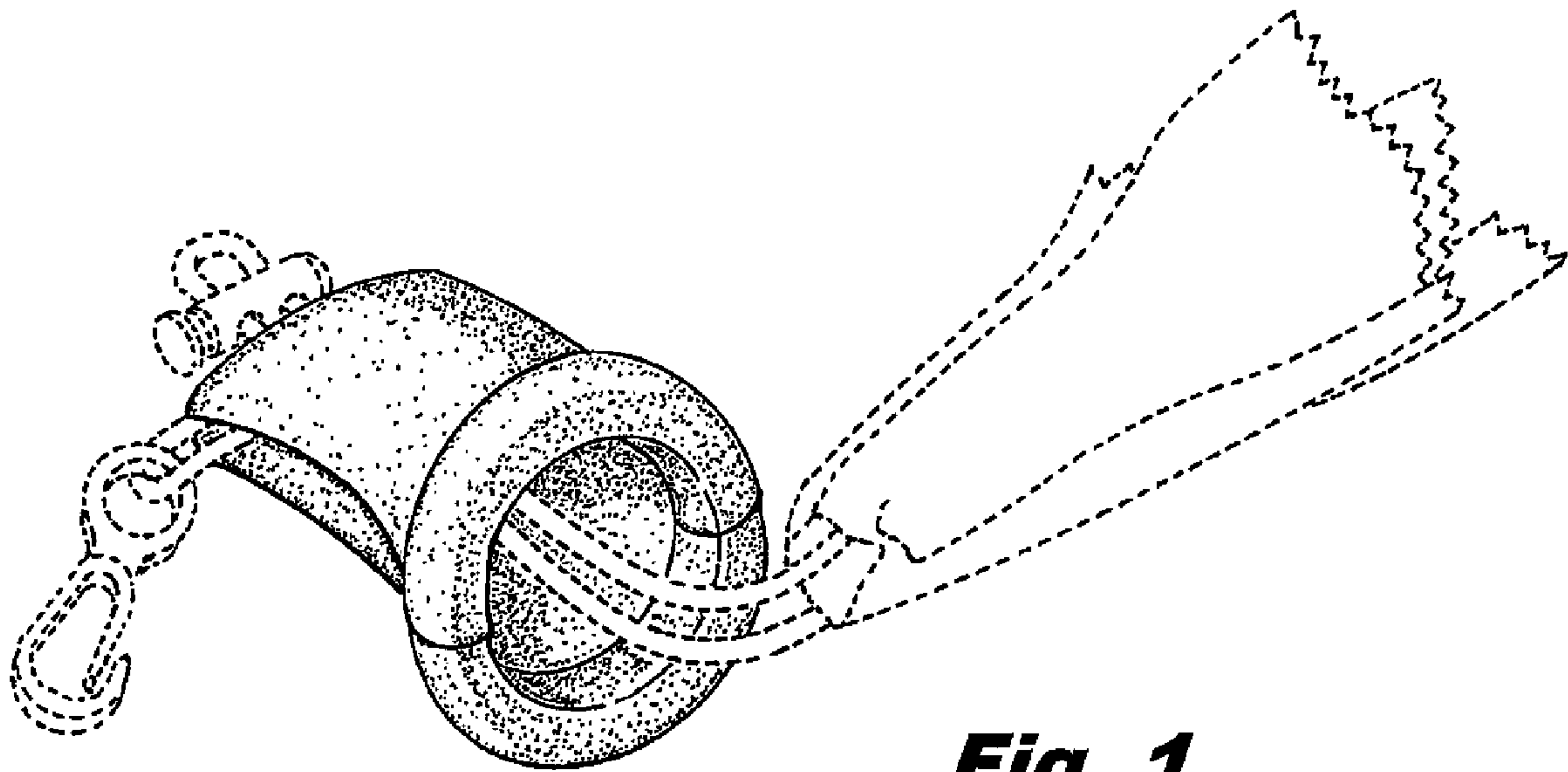
FIG. 7 is an opposite side elevational view of FIG. 1.

The dotted lines are intended to show features that are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.

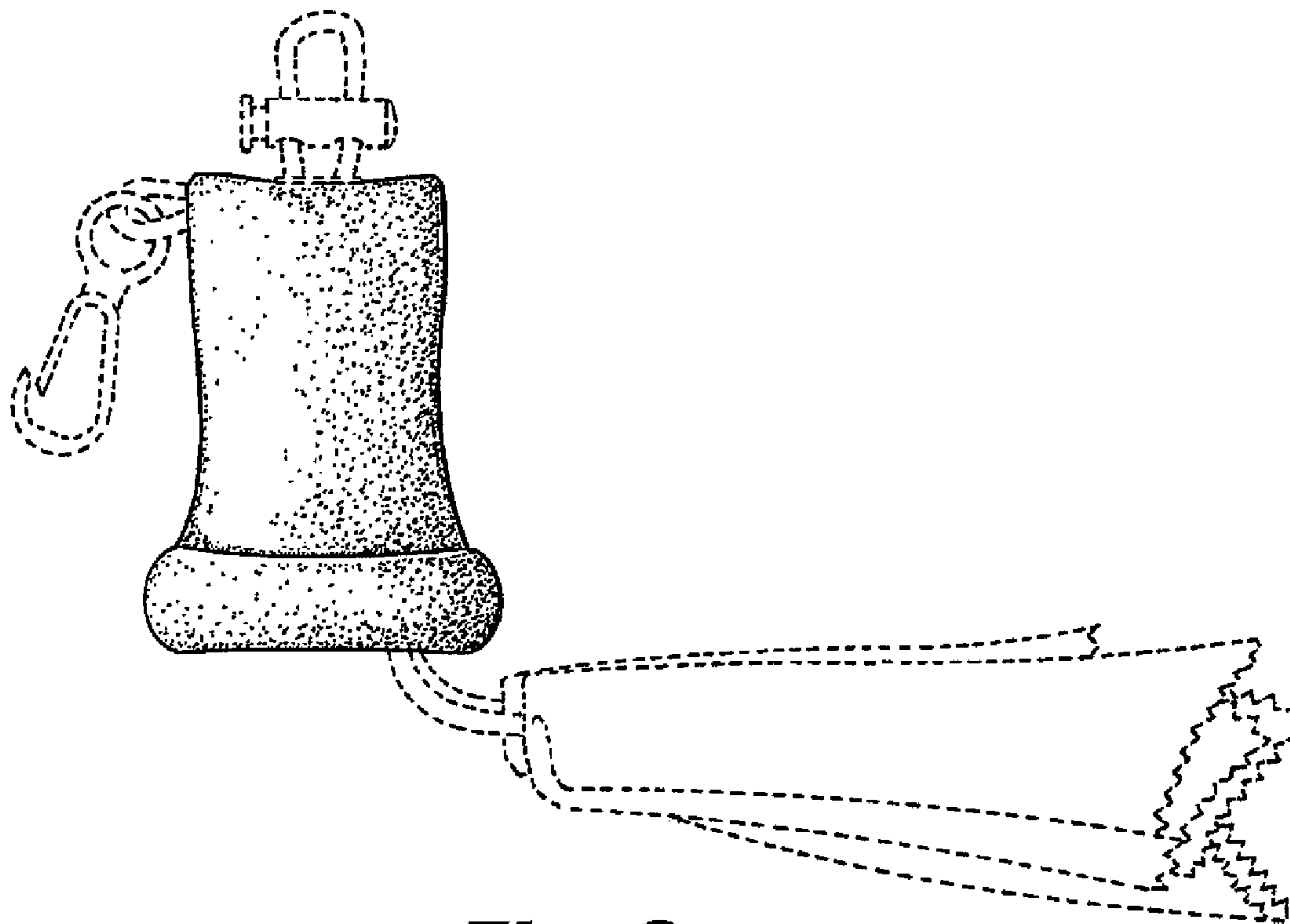

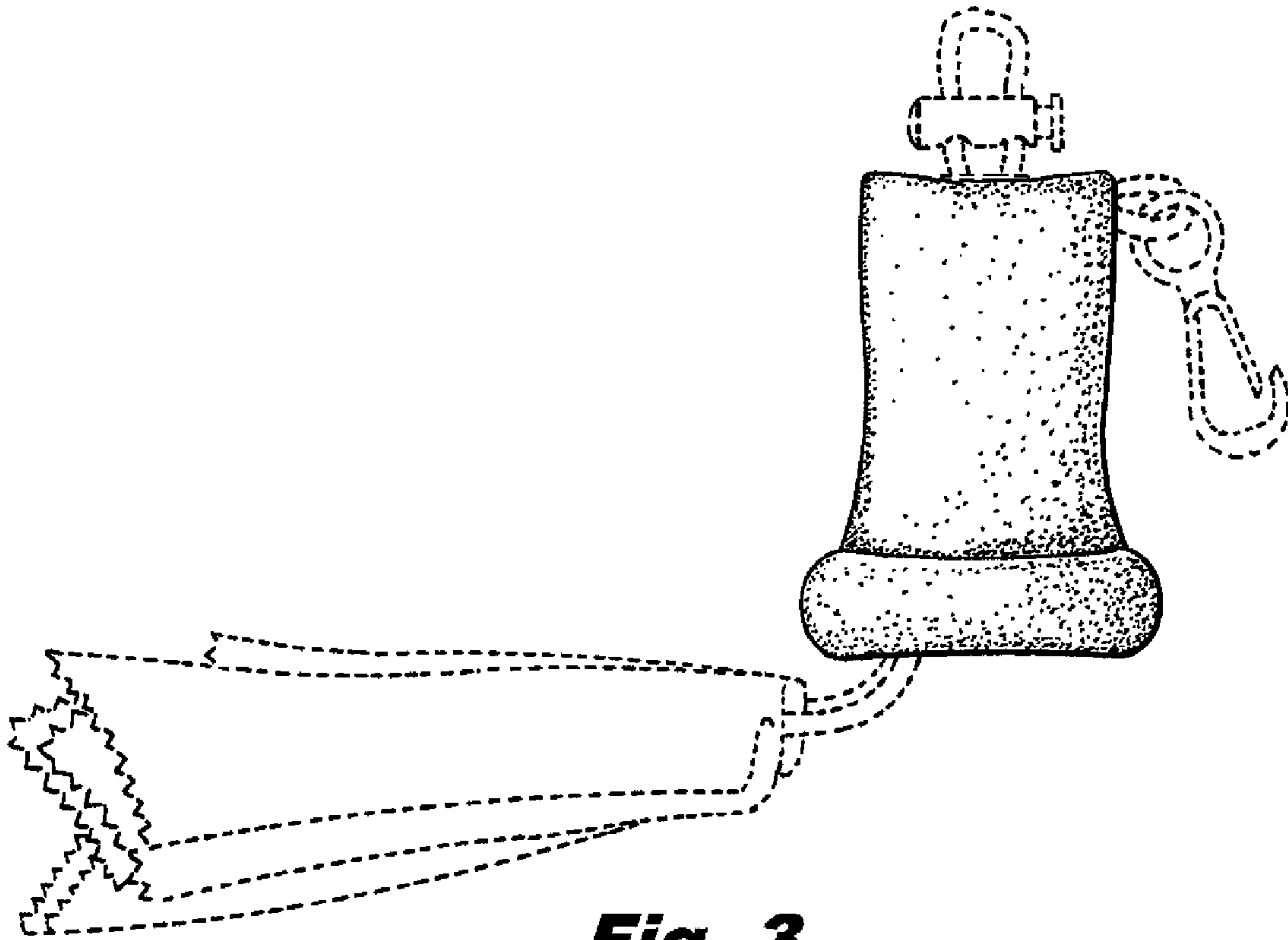




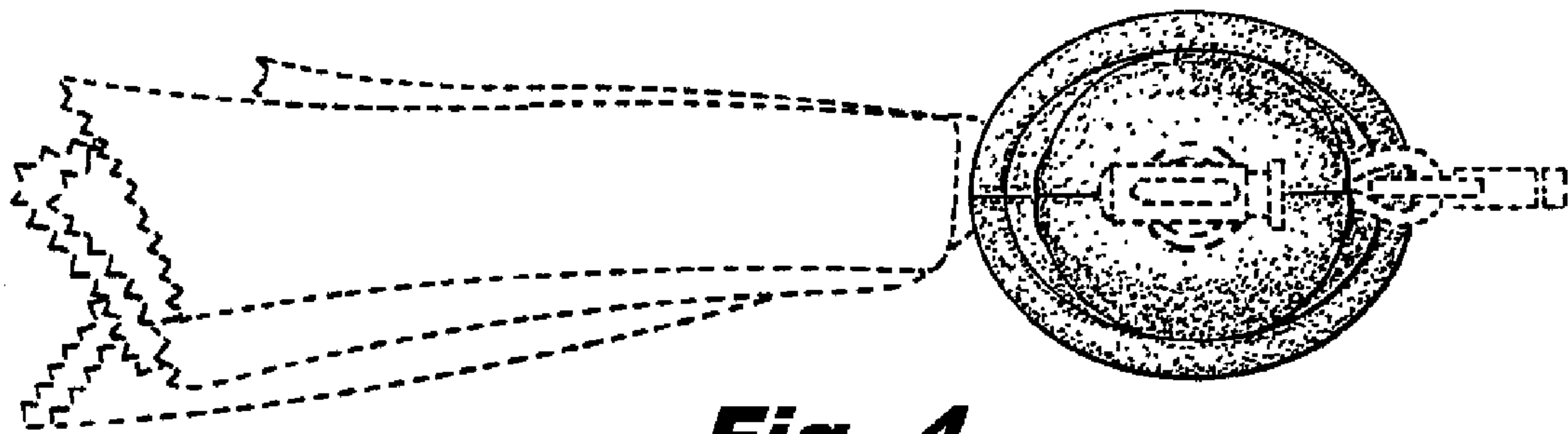

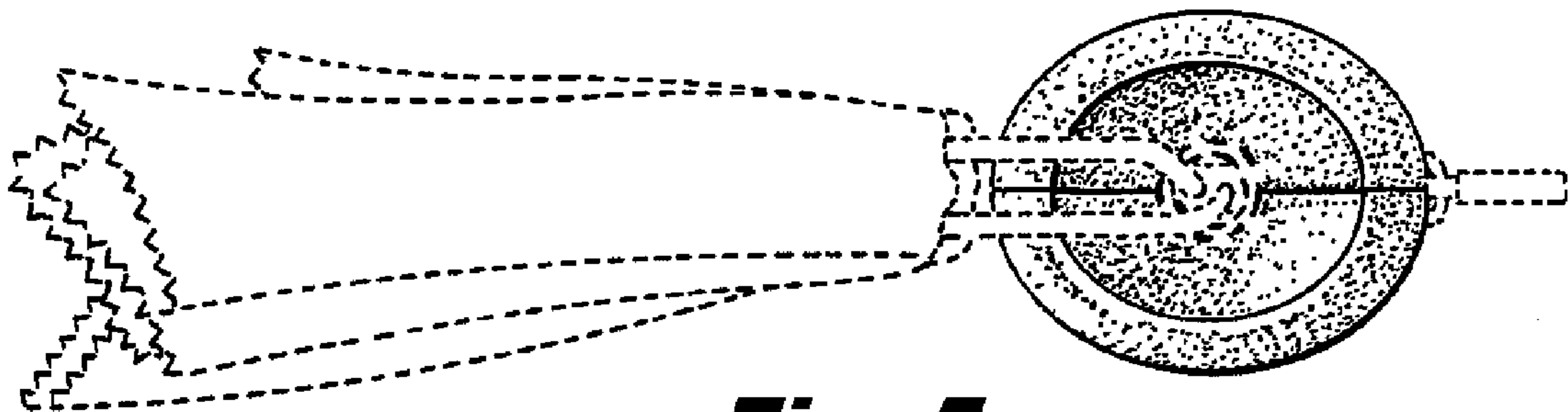

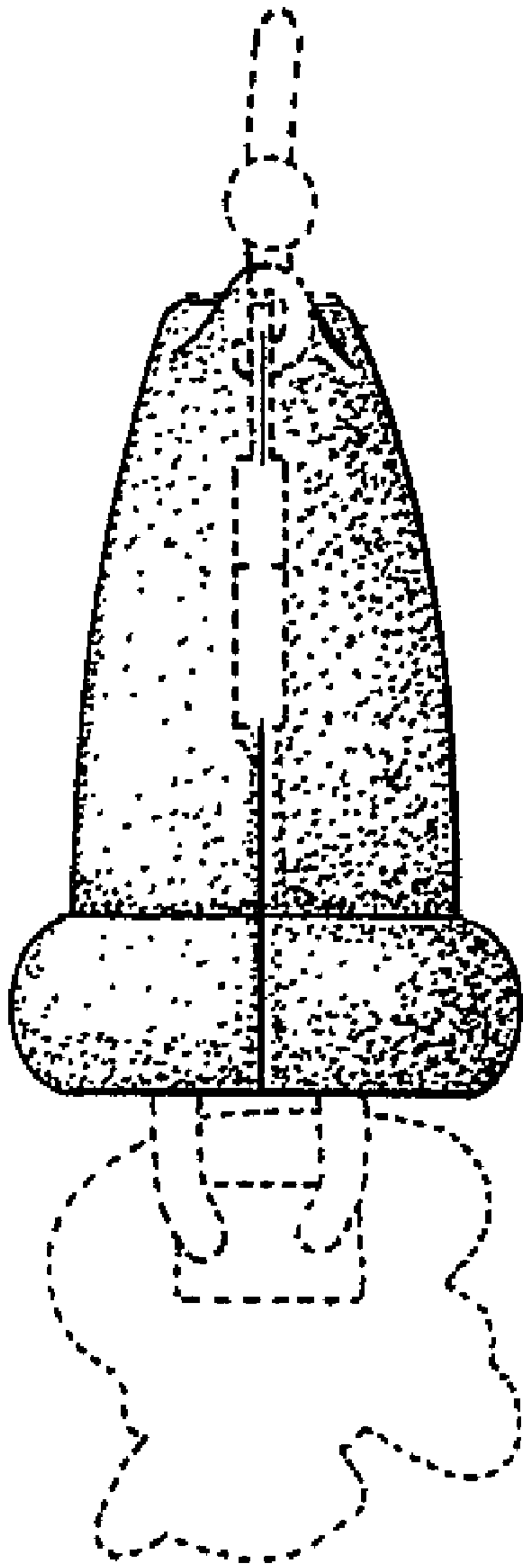

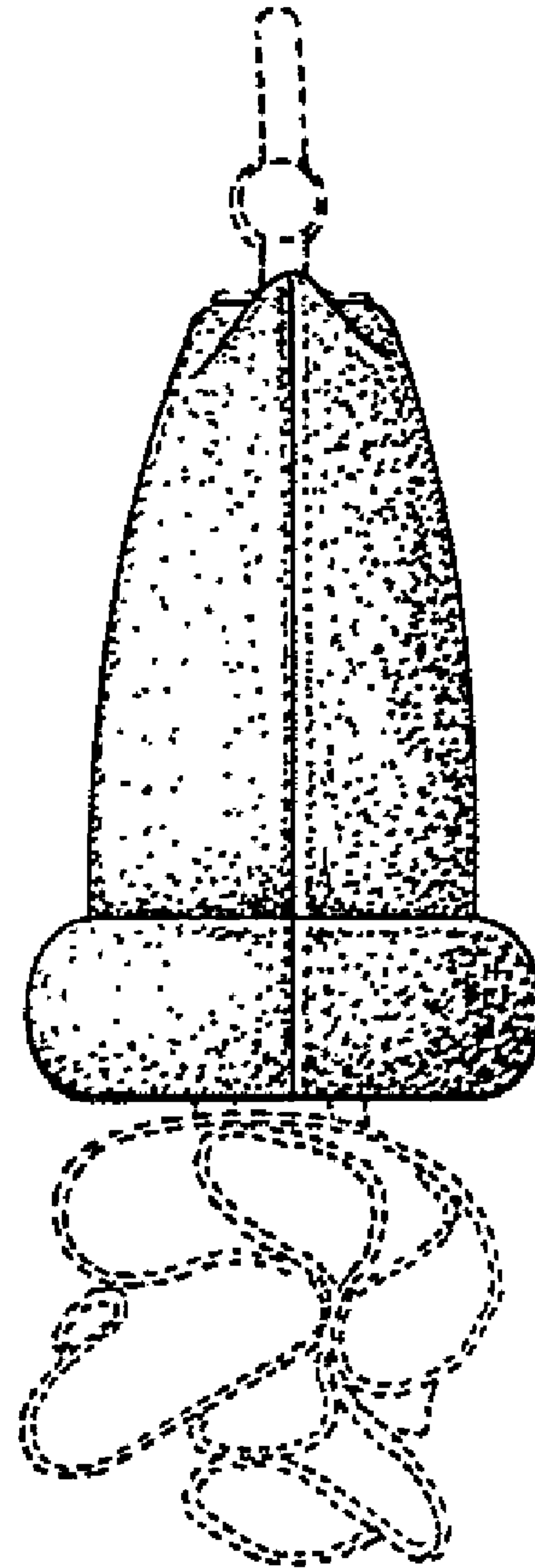
