The ornamental design for a simulated cork ornamented screw cap, as shown and described.

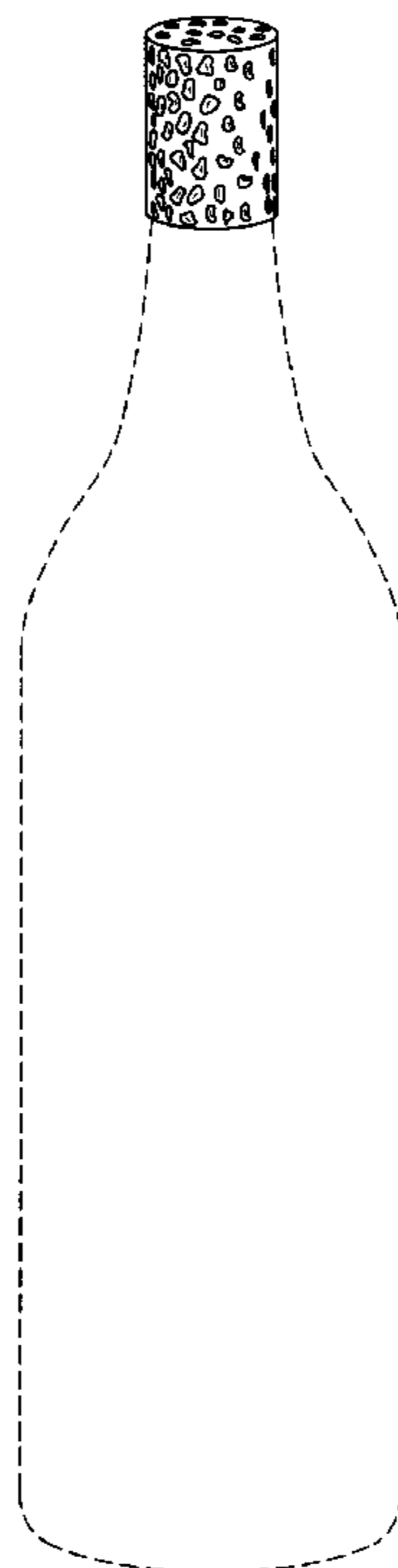
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bottle with the simulated cork ornamented screw cap at the top of the bottle. The bottle does not form part of the design; and,

FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view of the simulated cork ornamented screw top at the top of the bottle.

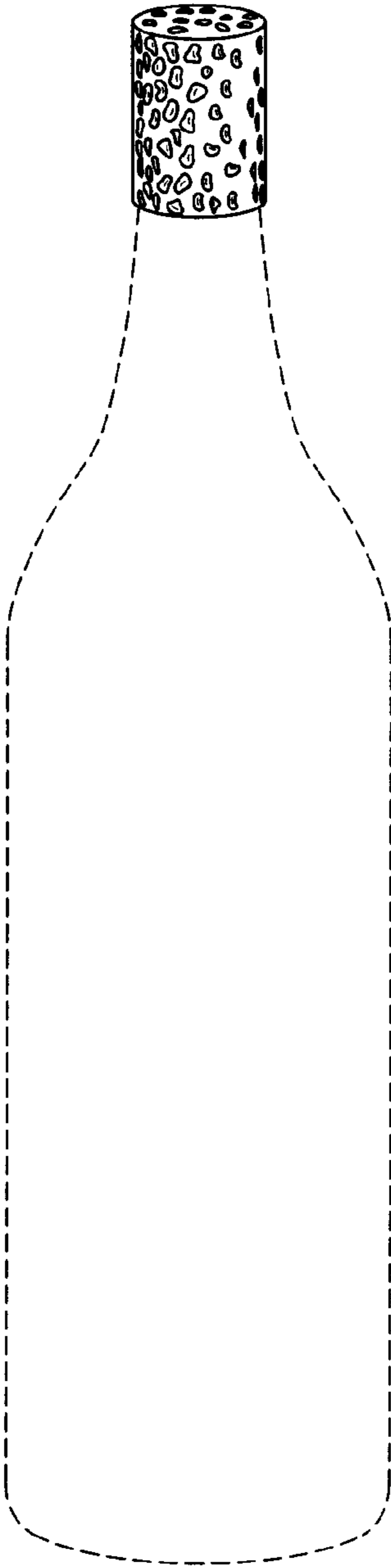

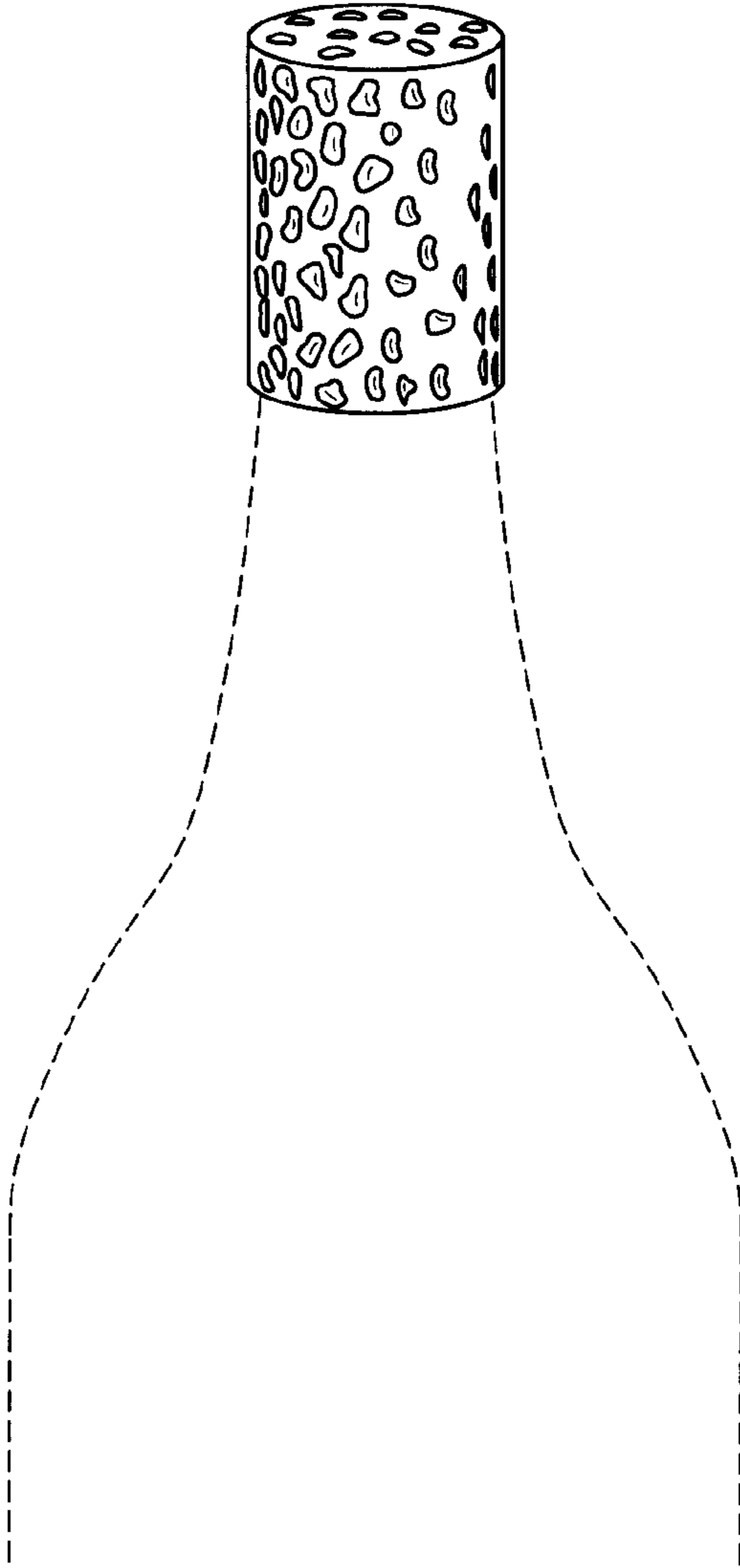
