DESCRIPTION

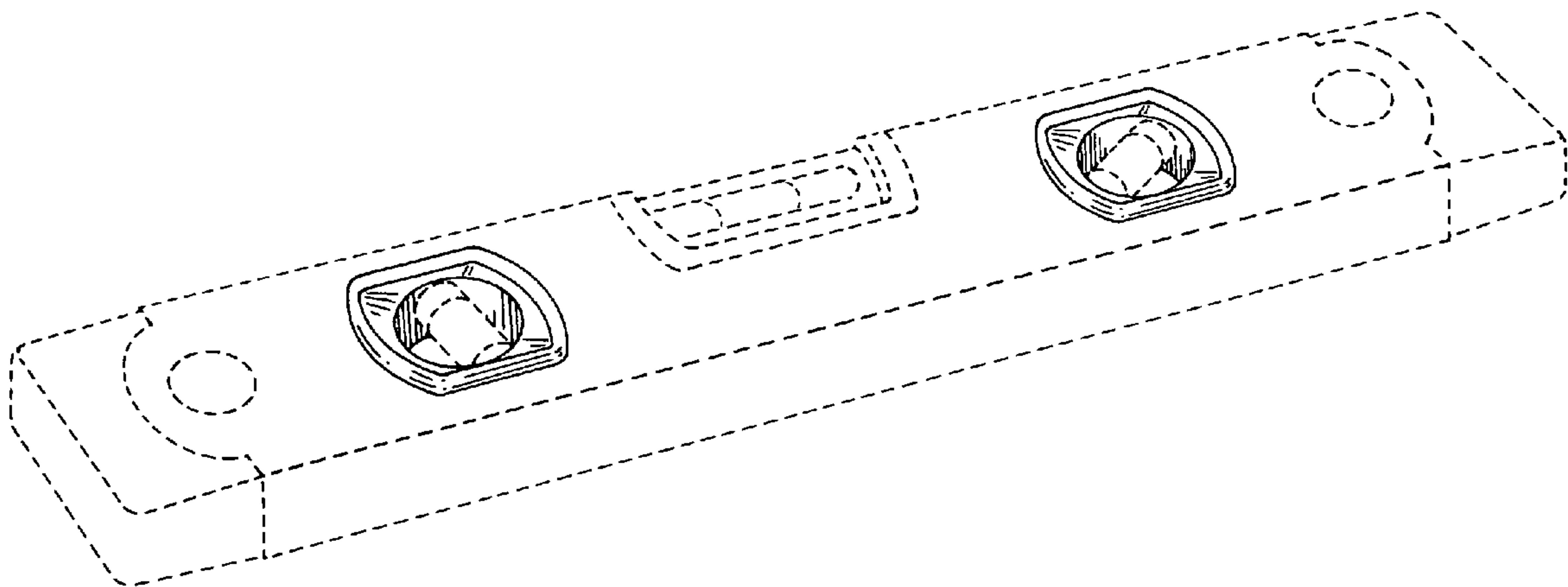
FIG. 1 is a front, bottom perspective view of our new, original and ornamental design for a vial support assembly, with the broken lines showing a level for illustrative purposes;

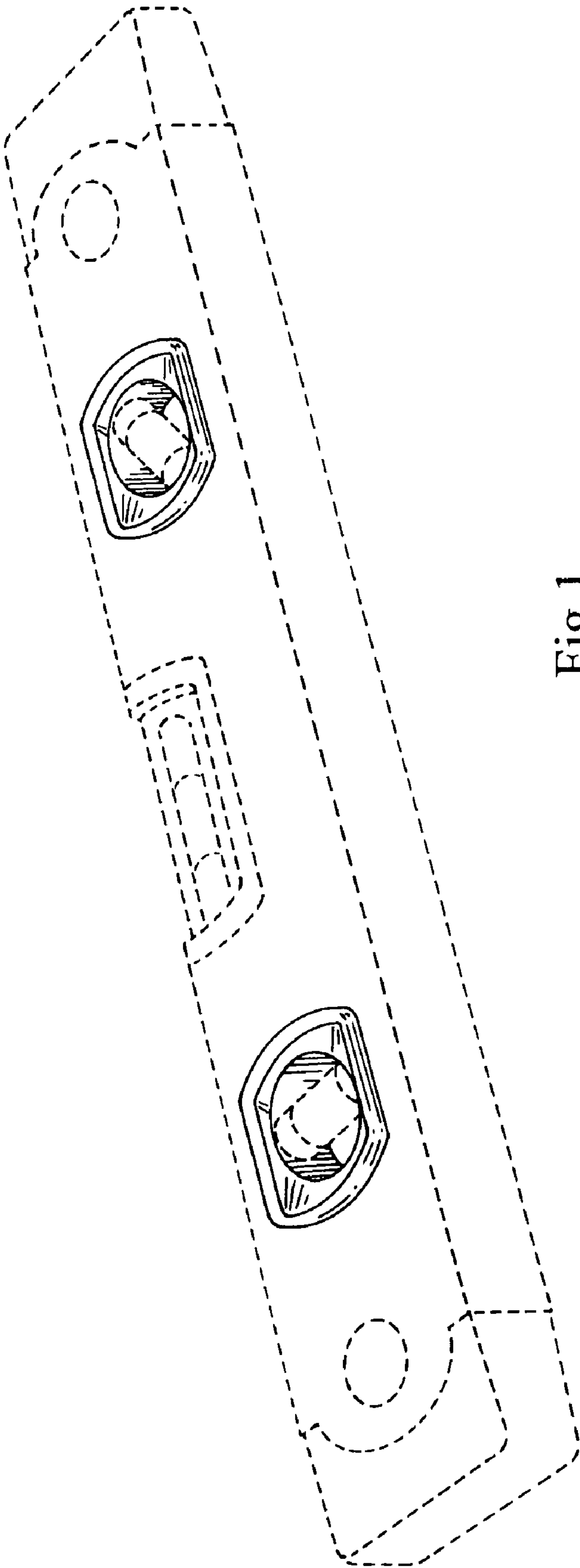

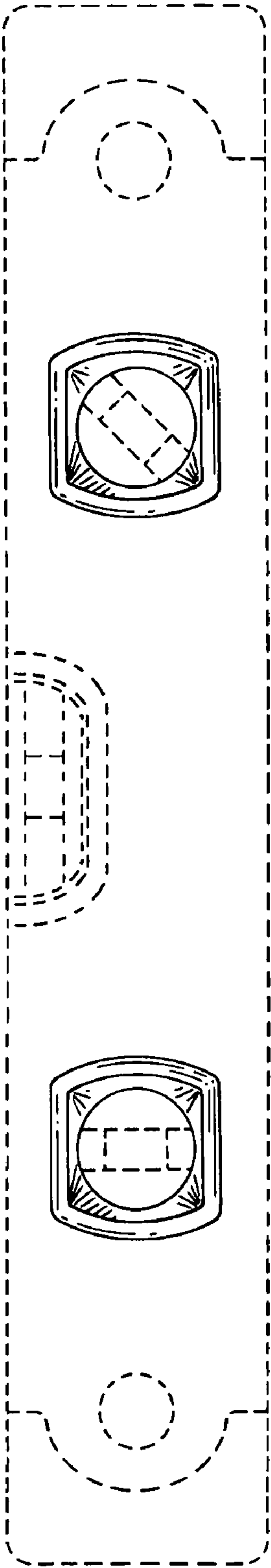

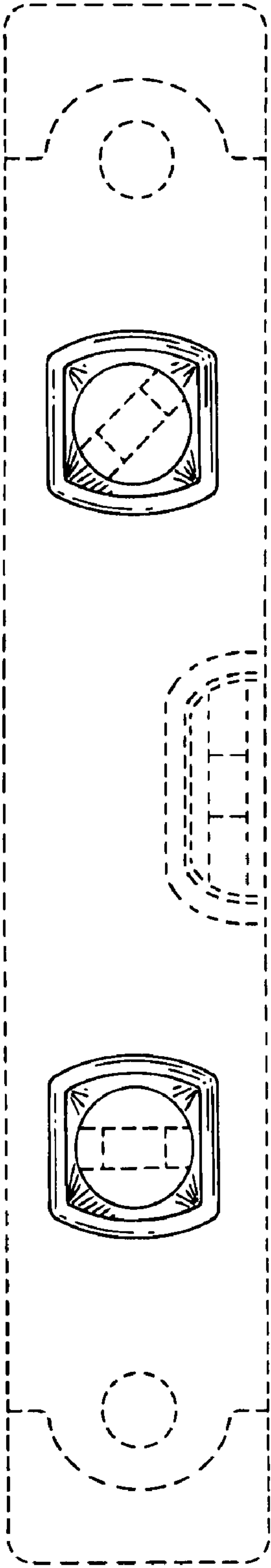
