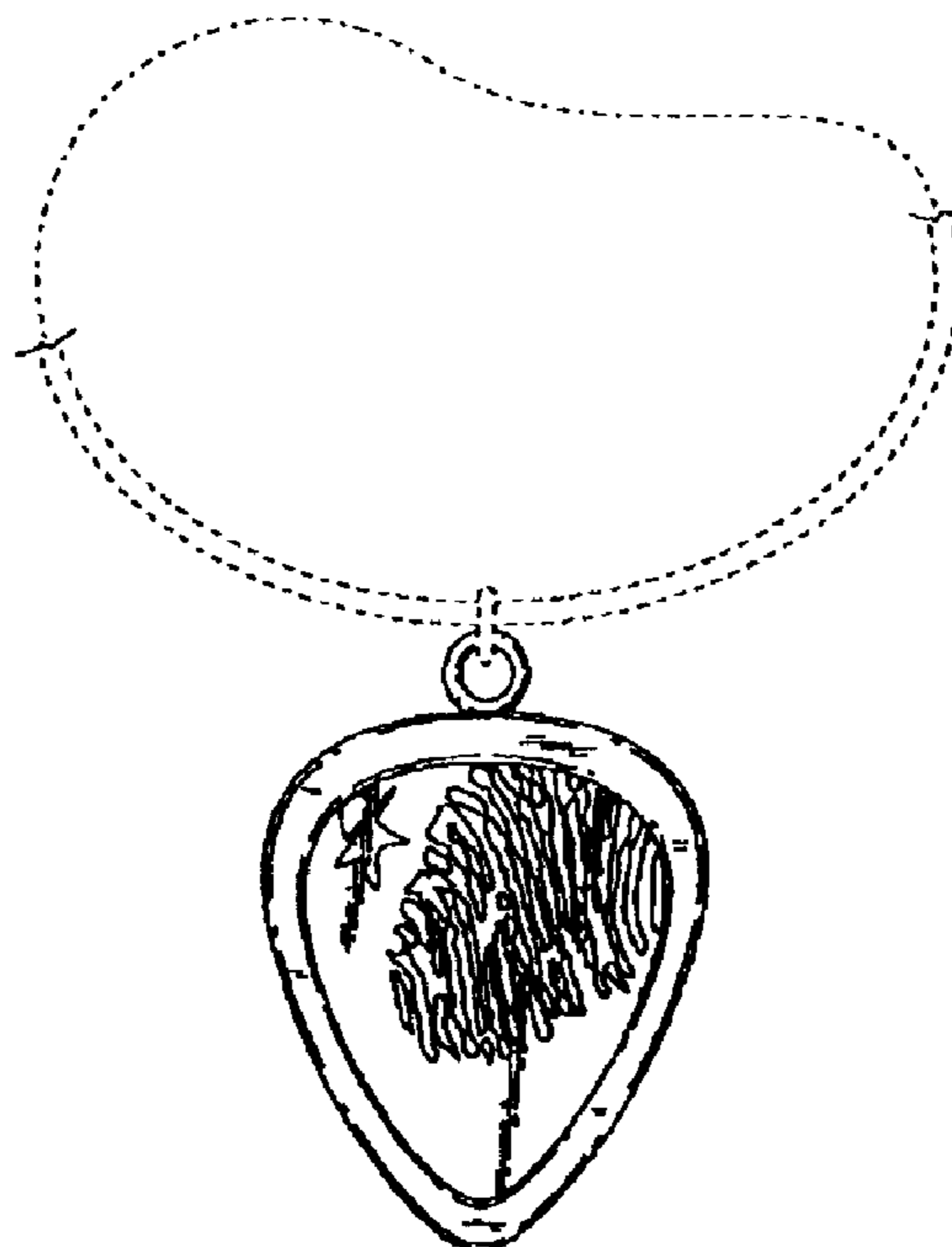
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a pick holder jewelry article as shown in FIG. 4 but now in a position of use as an earring;

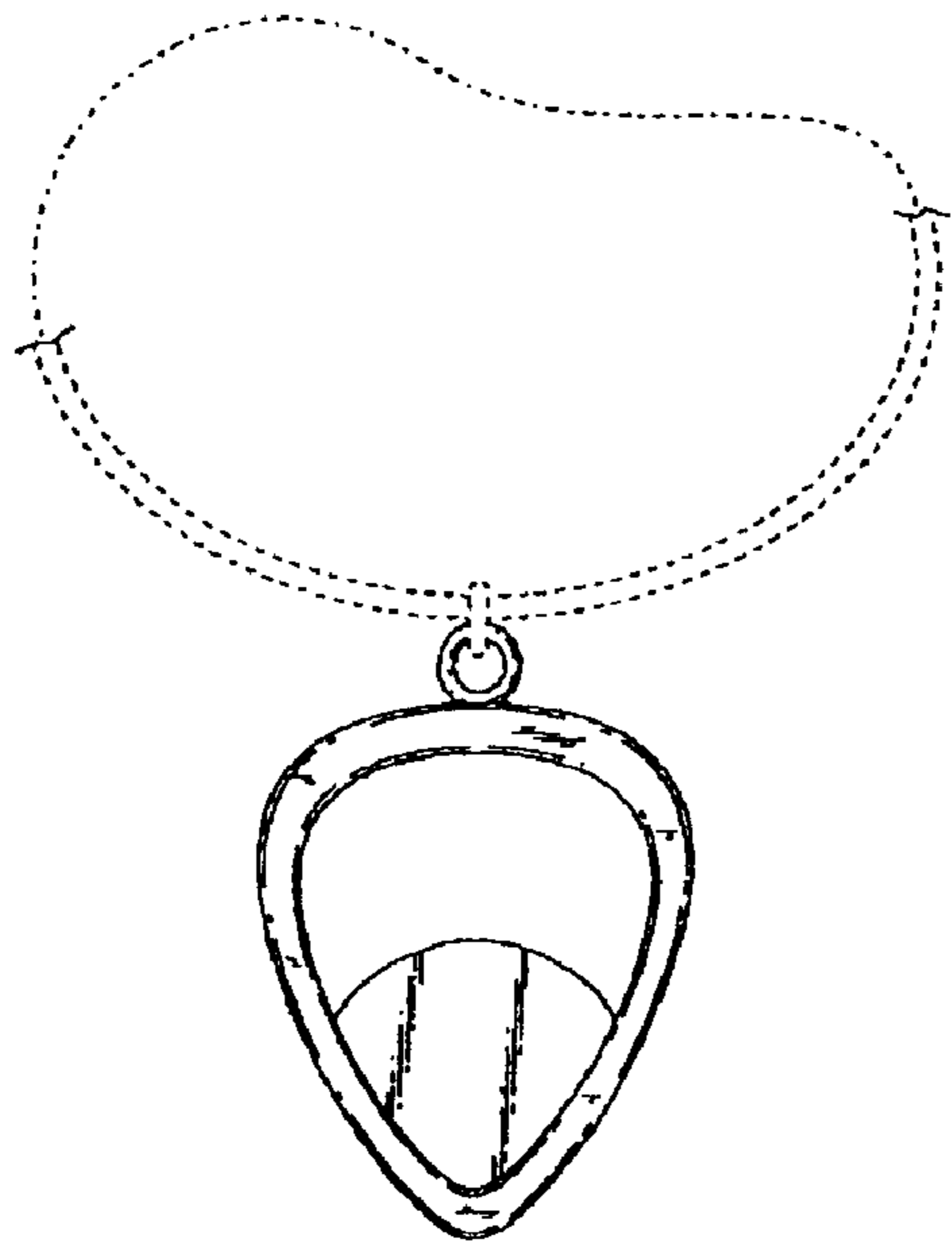

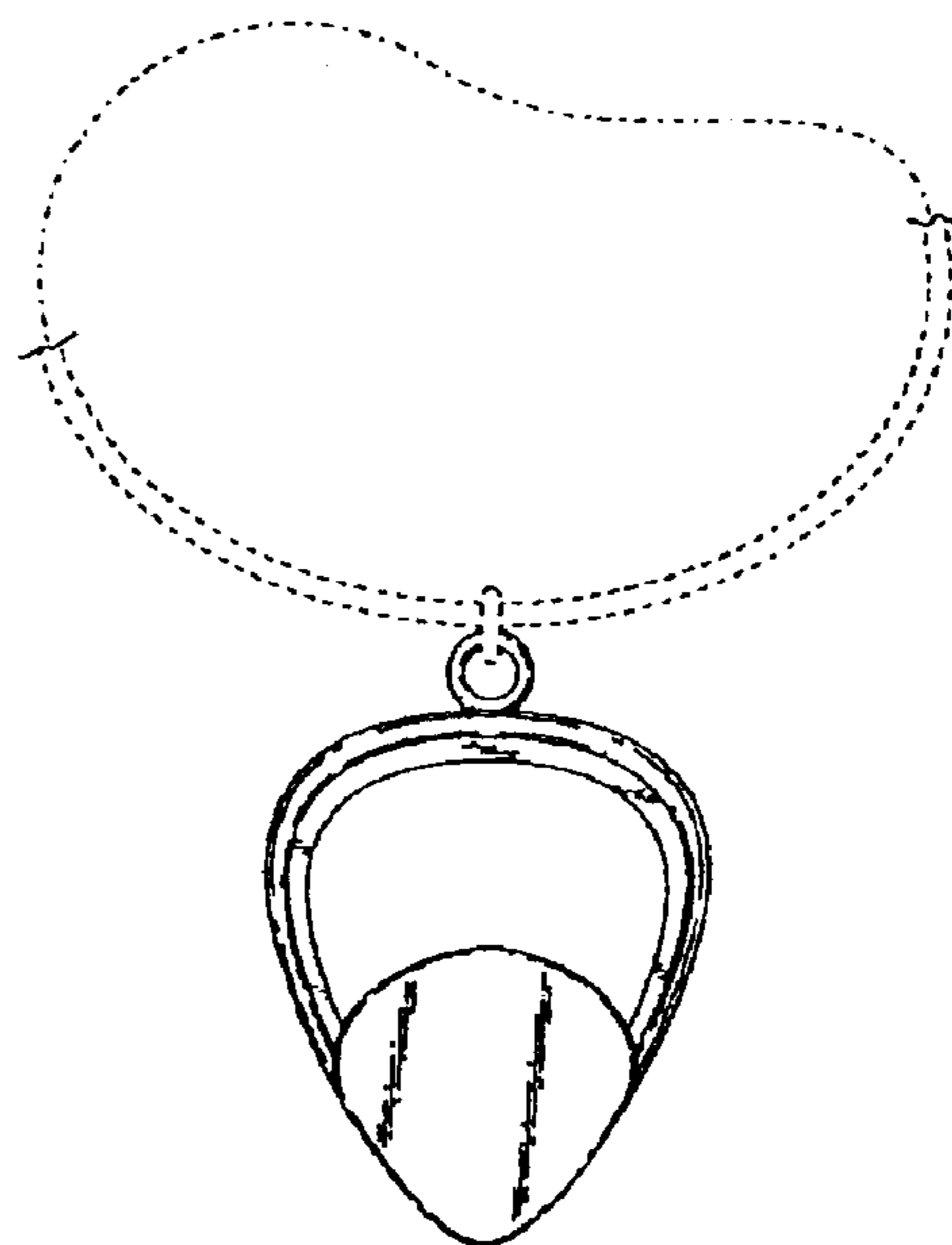

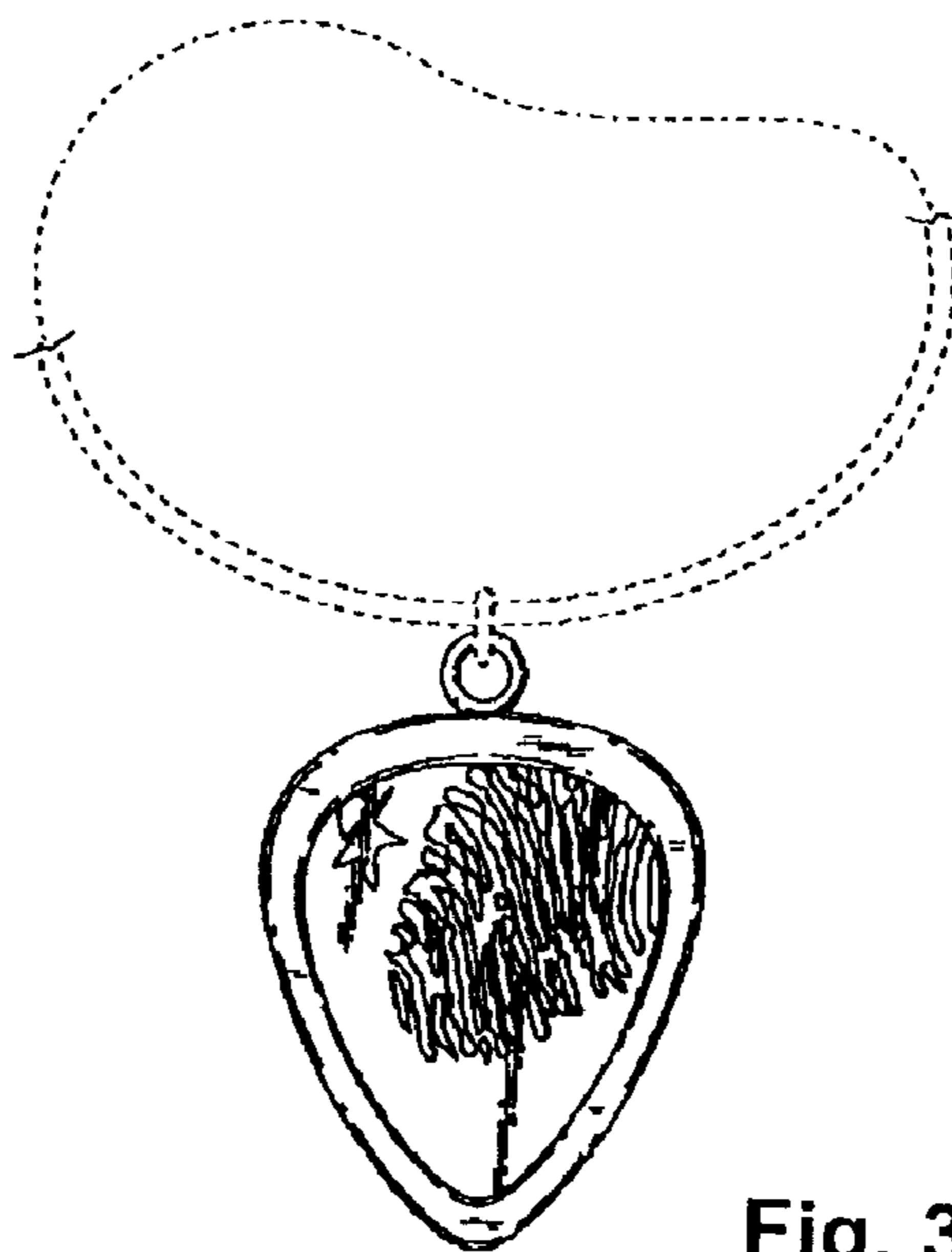

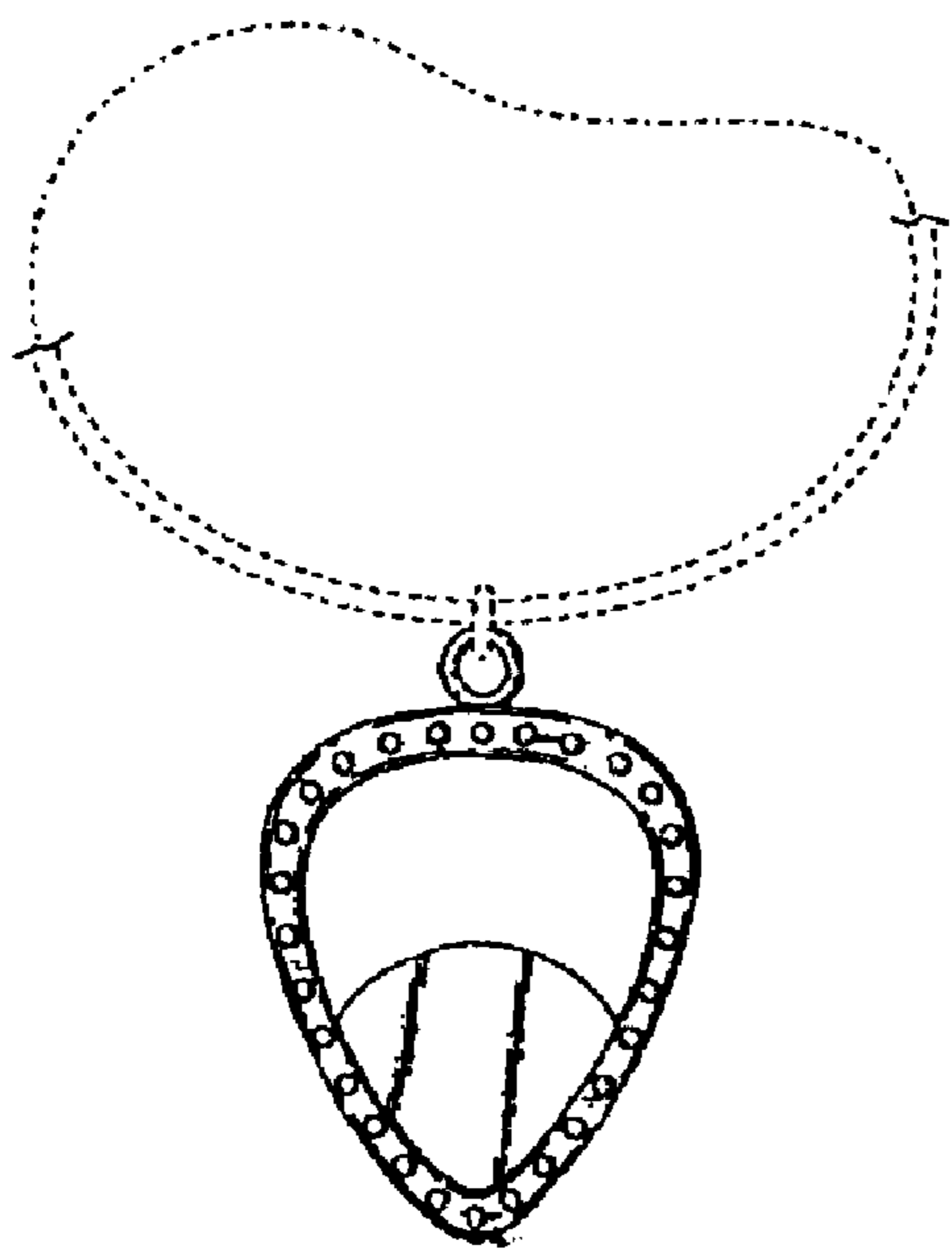

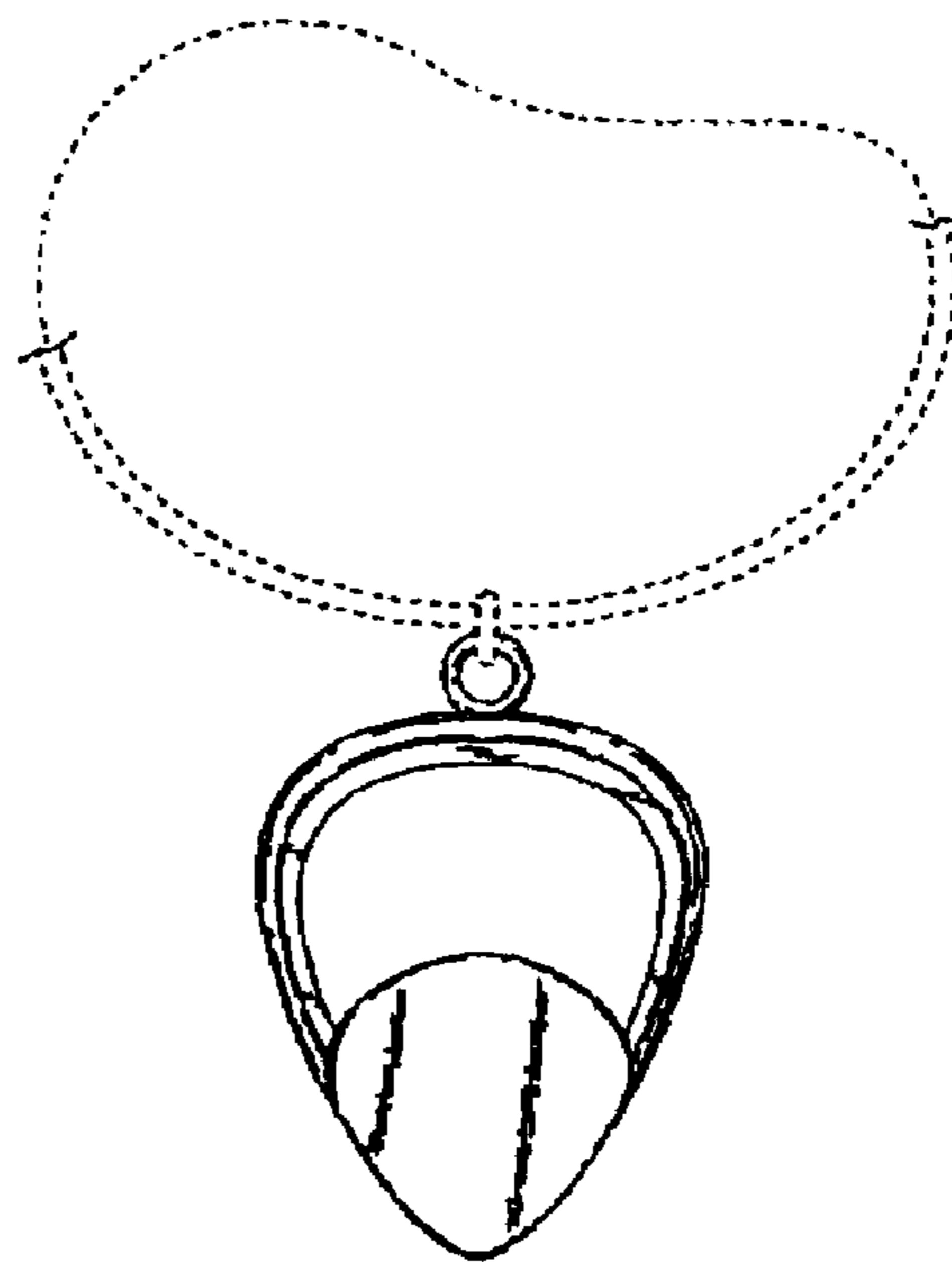

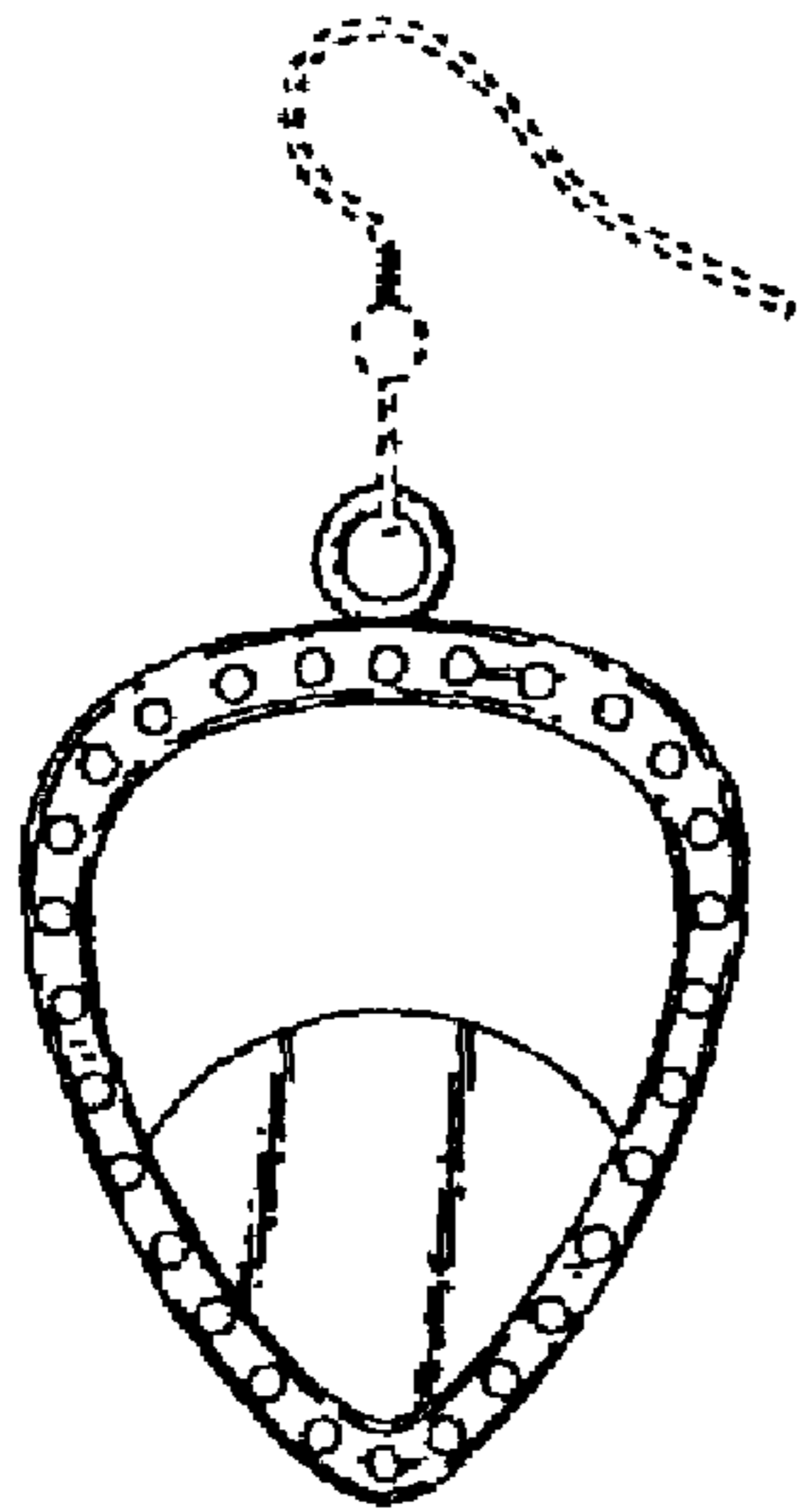

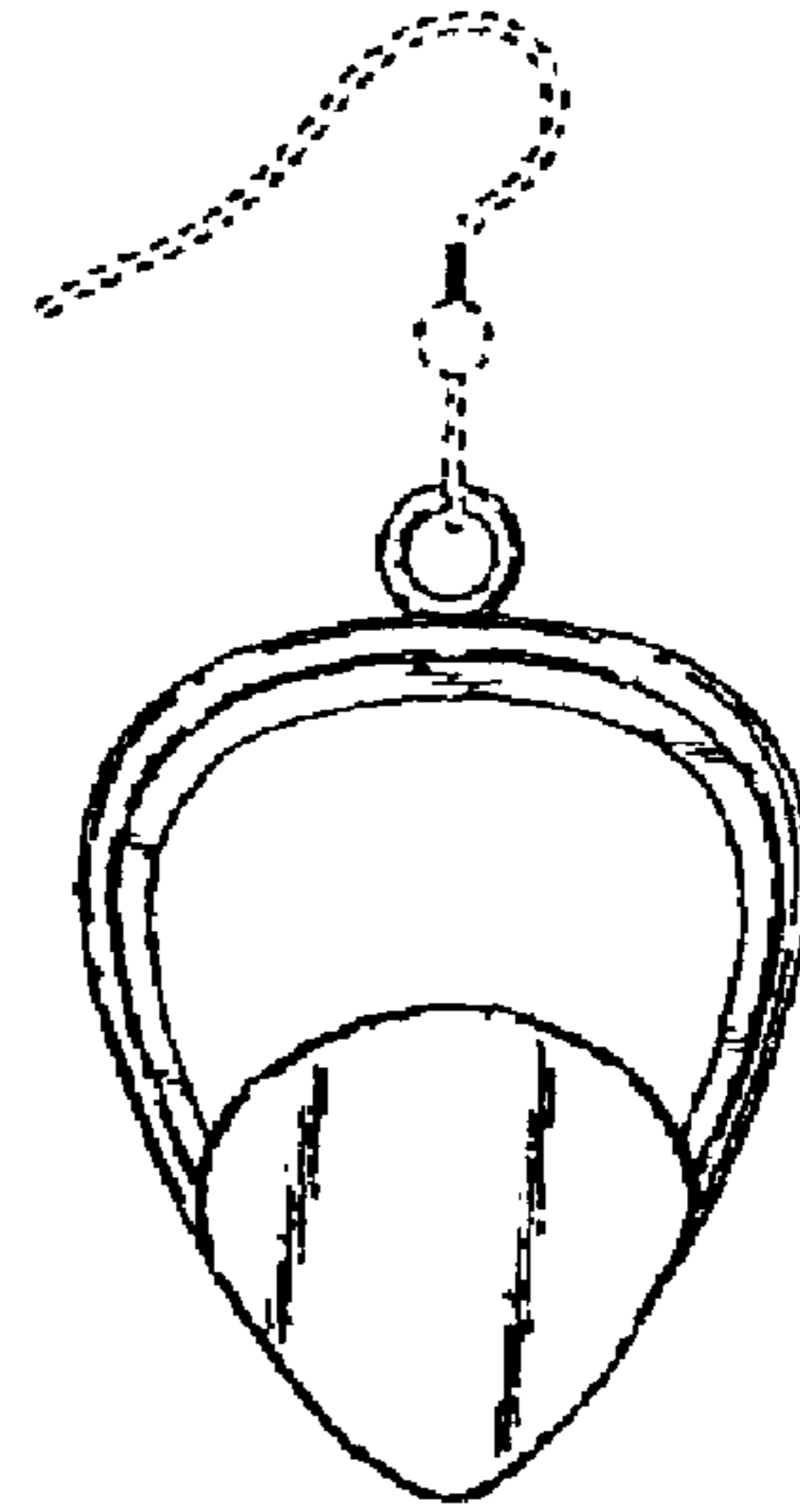

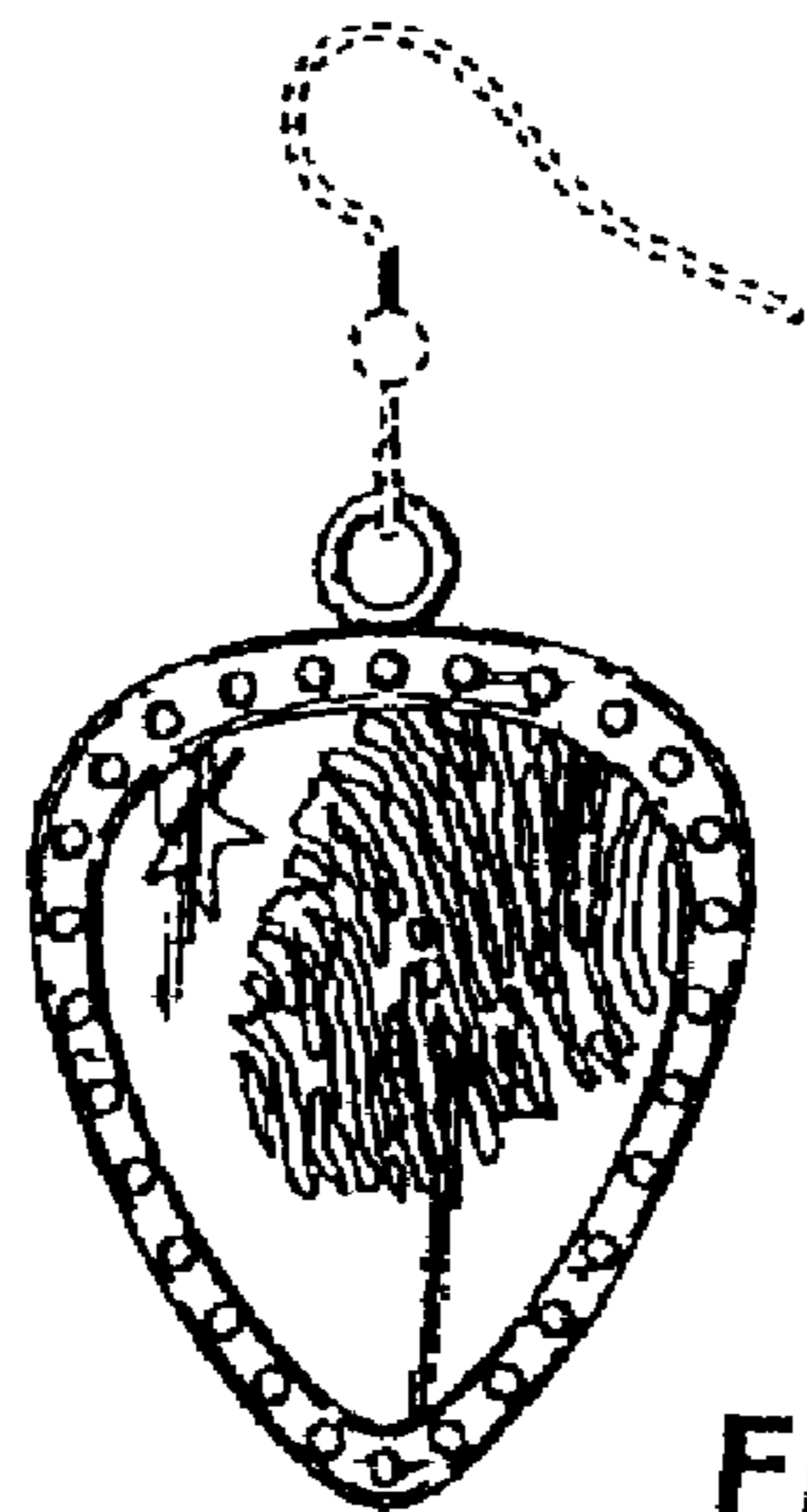
