FIG. 2 is a side view thereof;

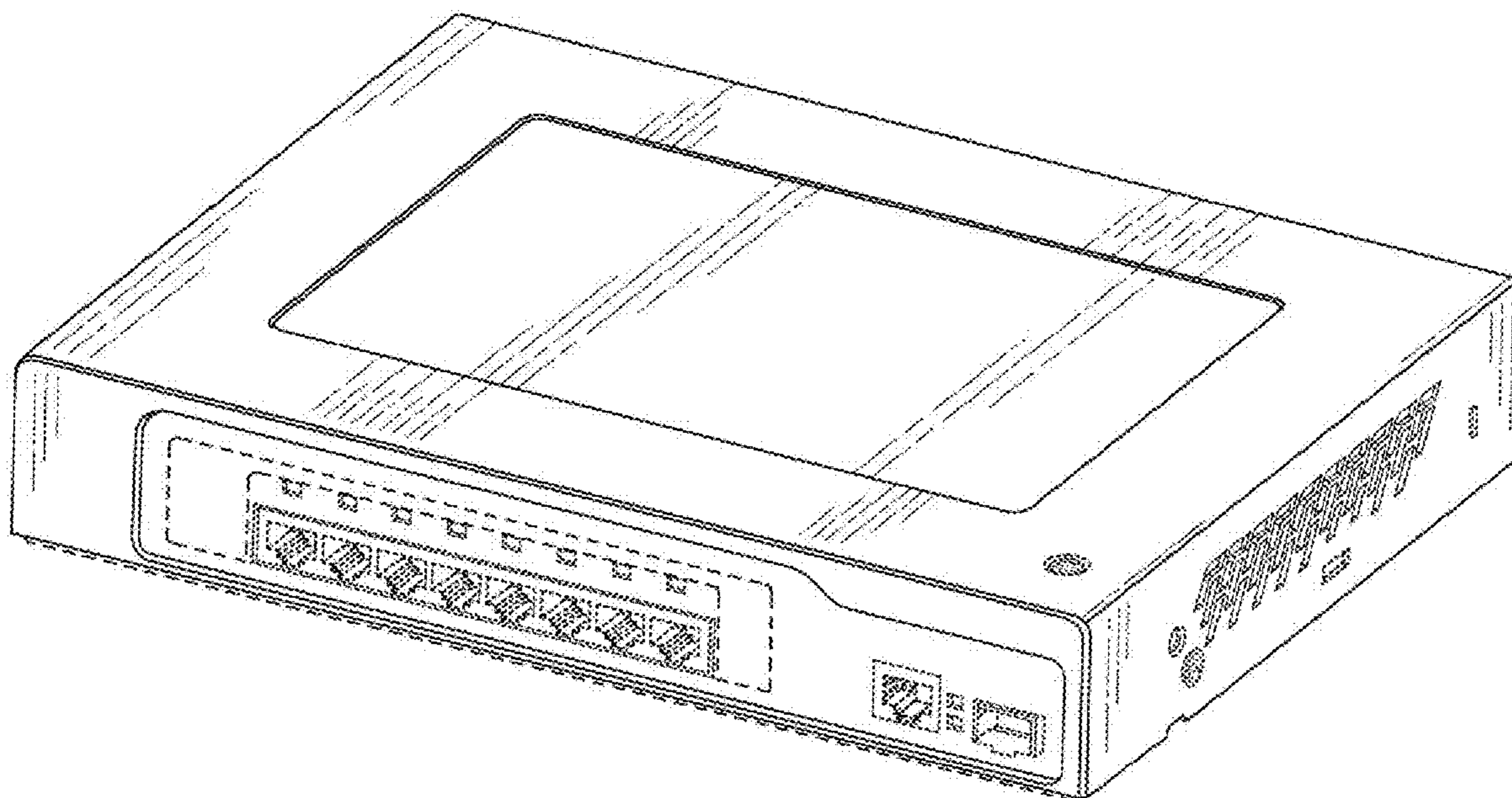
FIG. 3 is another side view thereof;

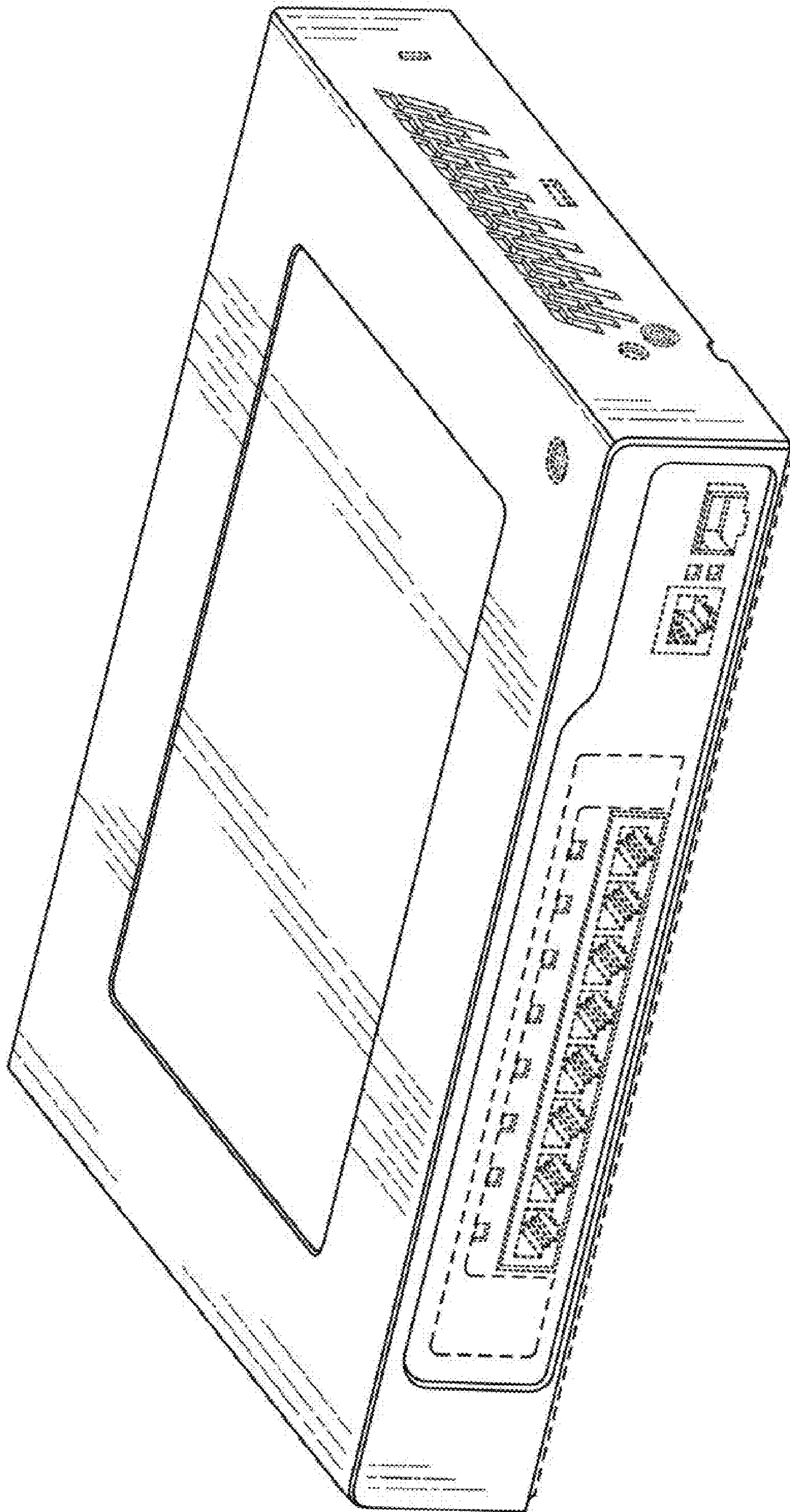

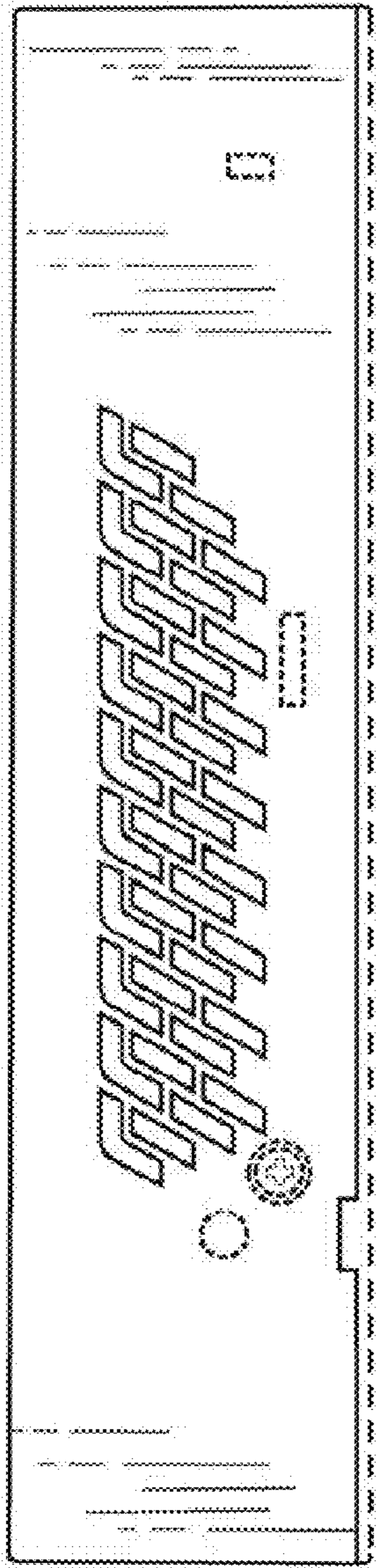

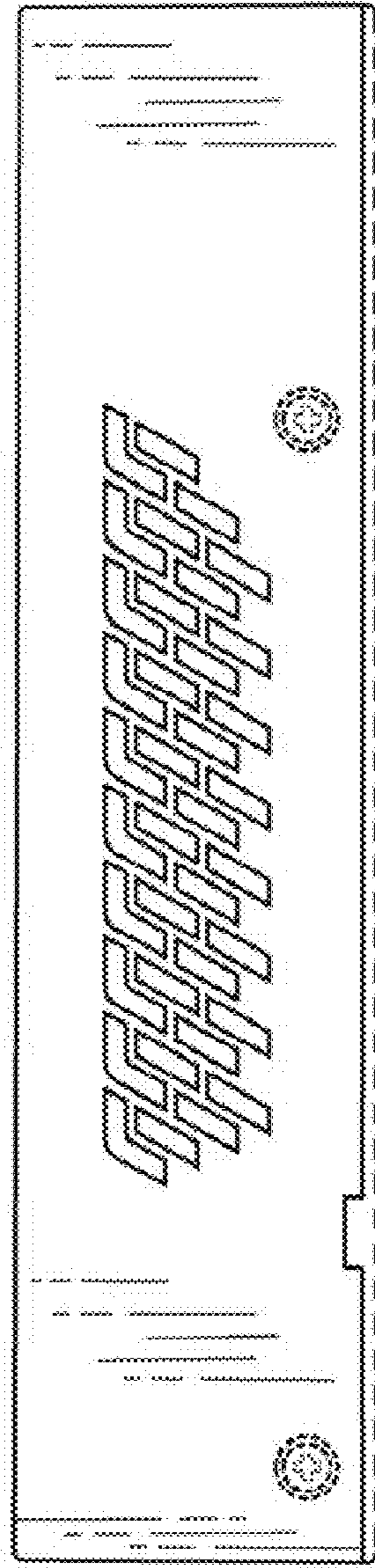

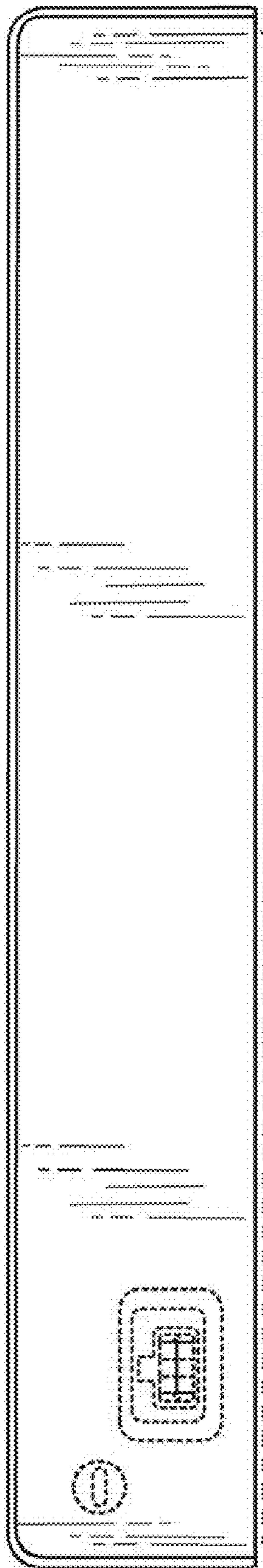

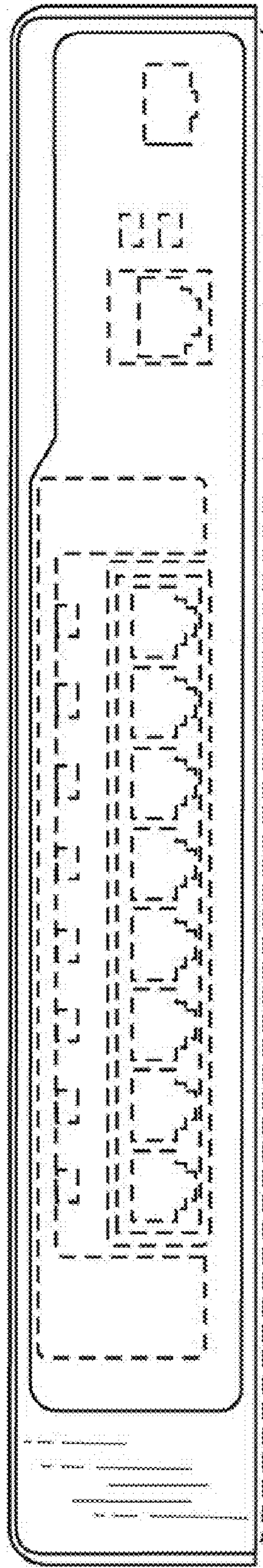
