FIG. 1;

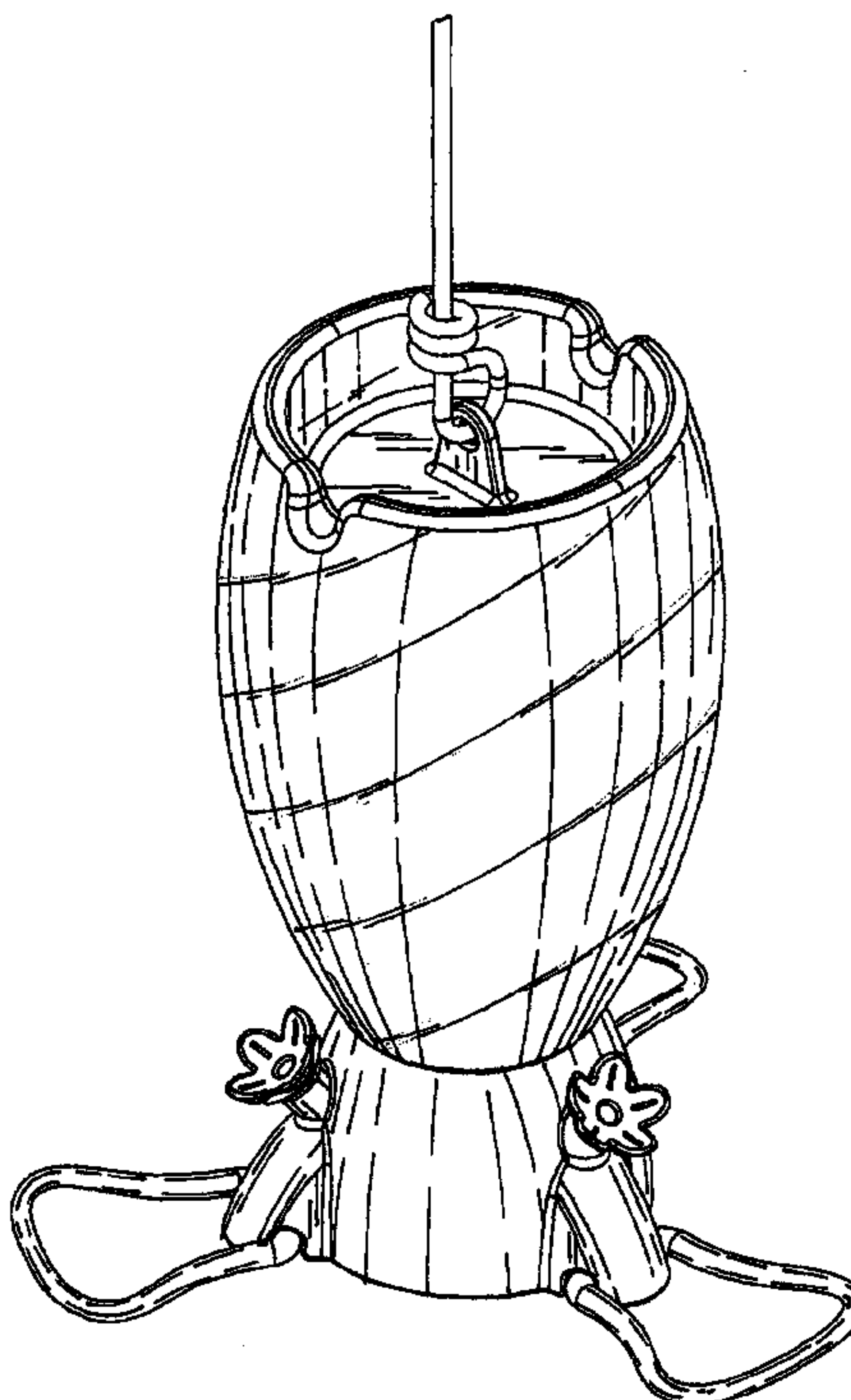
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the disposable hummingbird feeder

FIG. 8 is an exploded front elevation view of the disposable
hummingbird feeder of FIG. 1 showing a top portion and a
bottom portion, said bottom portion having a cut-away show-
ing internal threads that mesh and lock with outer threads of
the top portion.

extent of liquid levels are for illustrative purposes only and
form no part of the claimed invention.

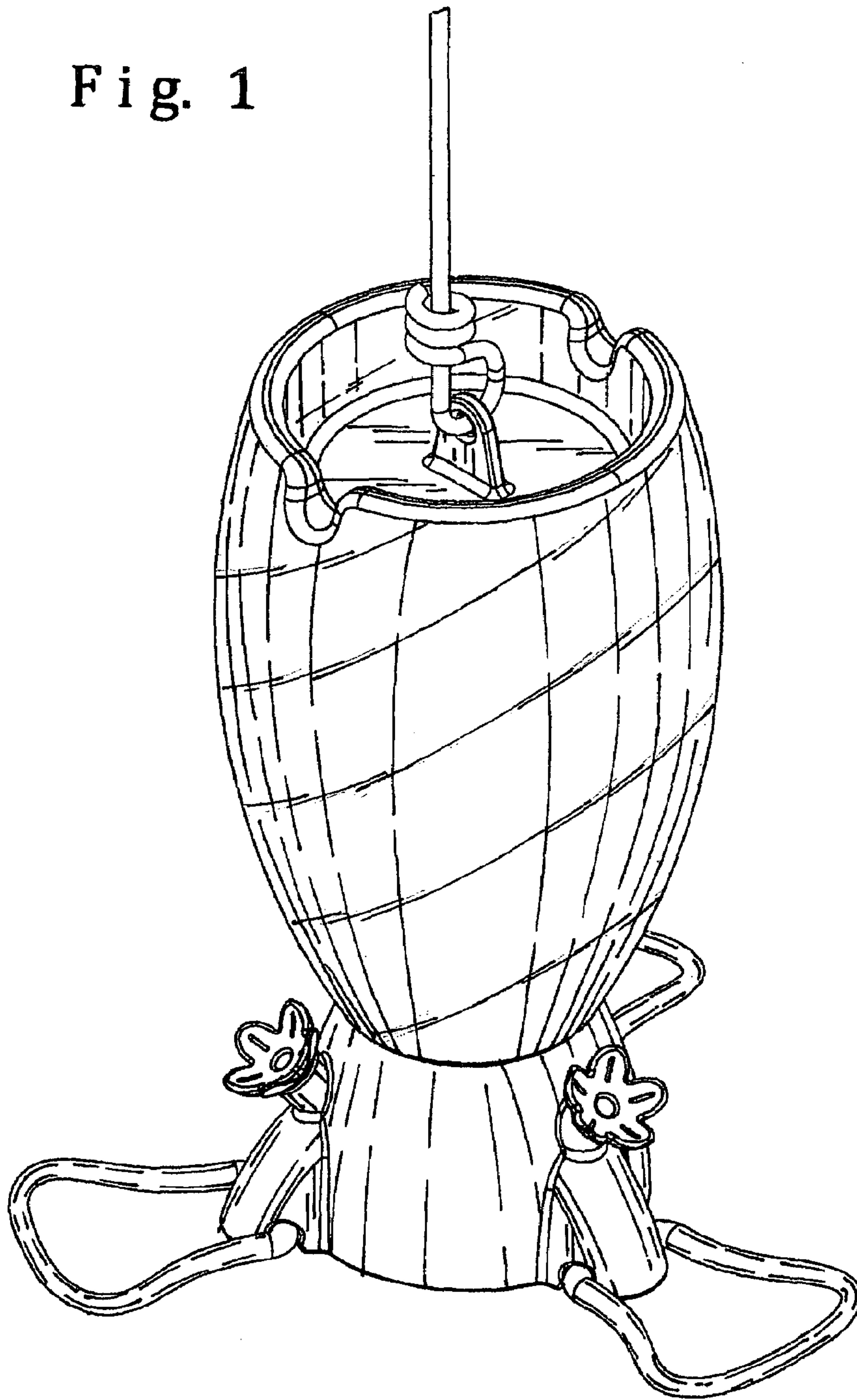

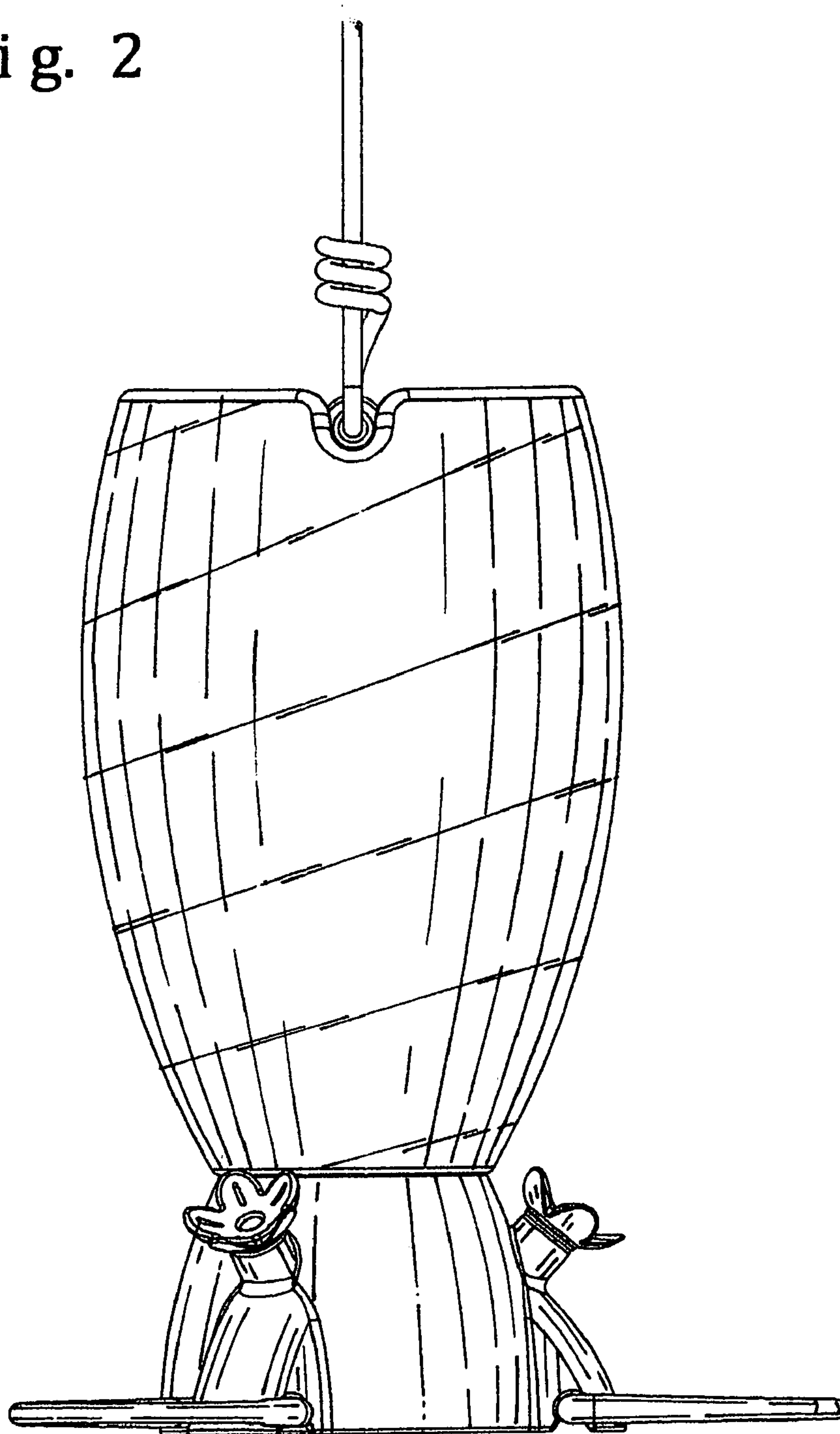

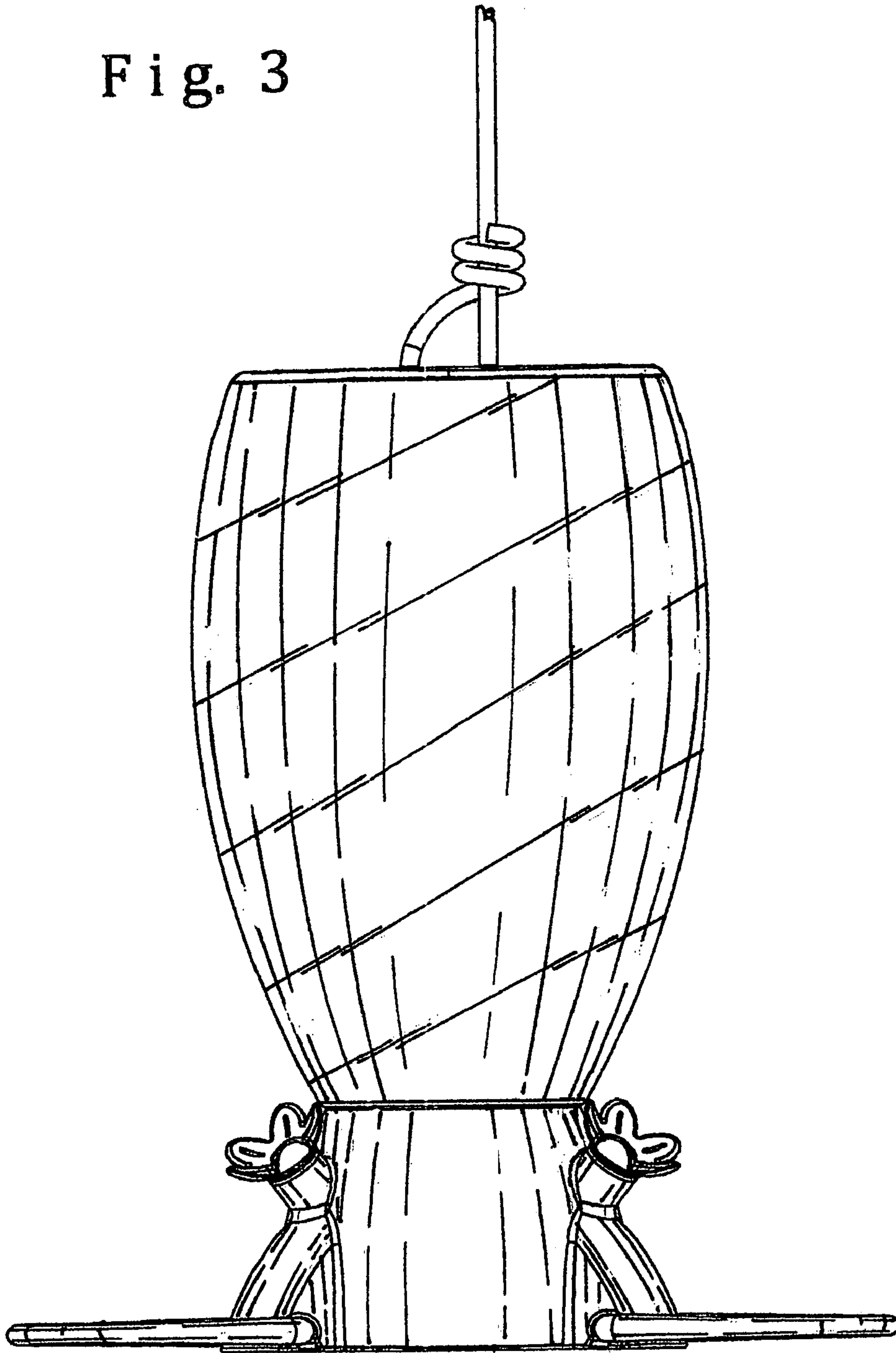

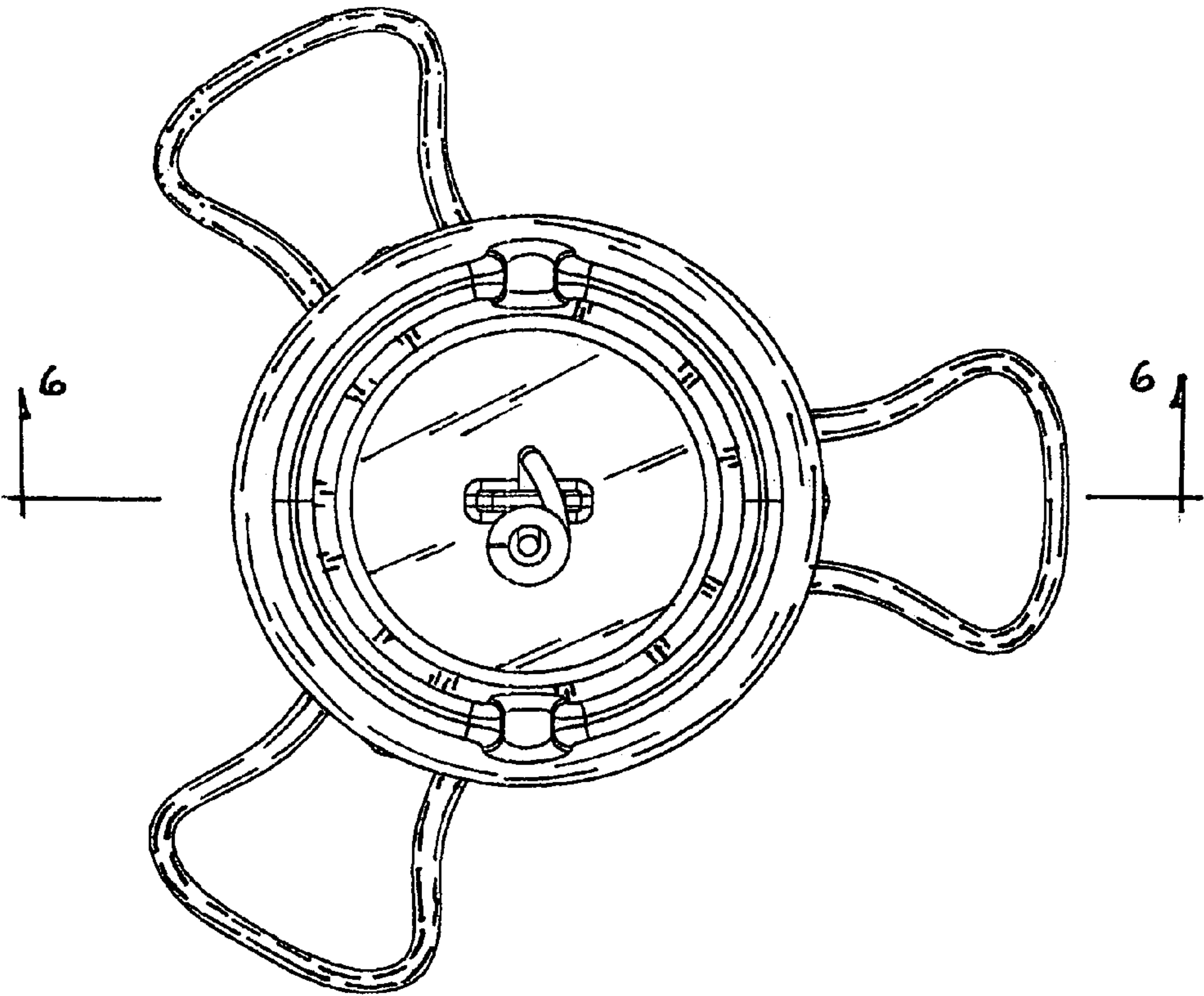

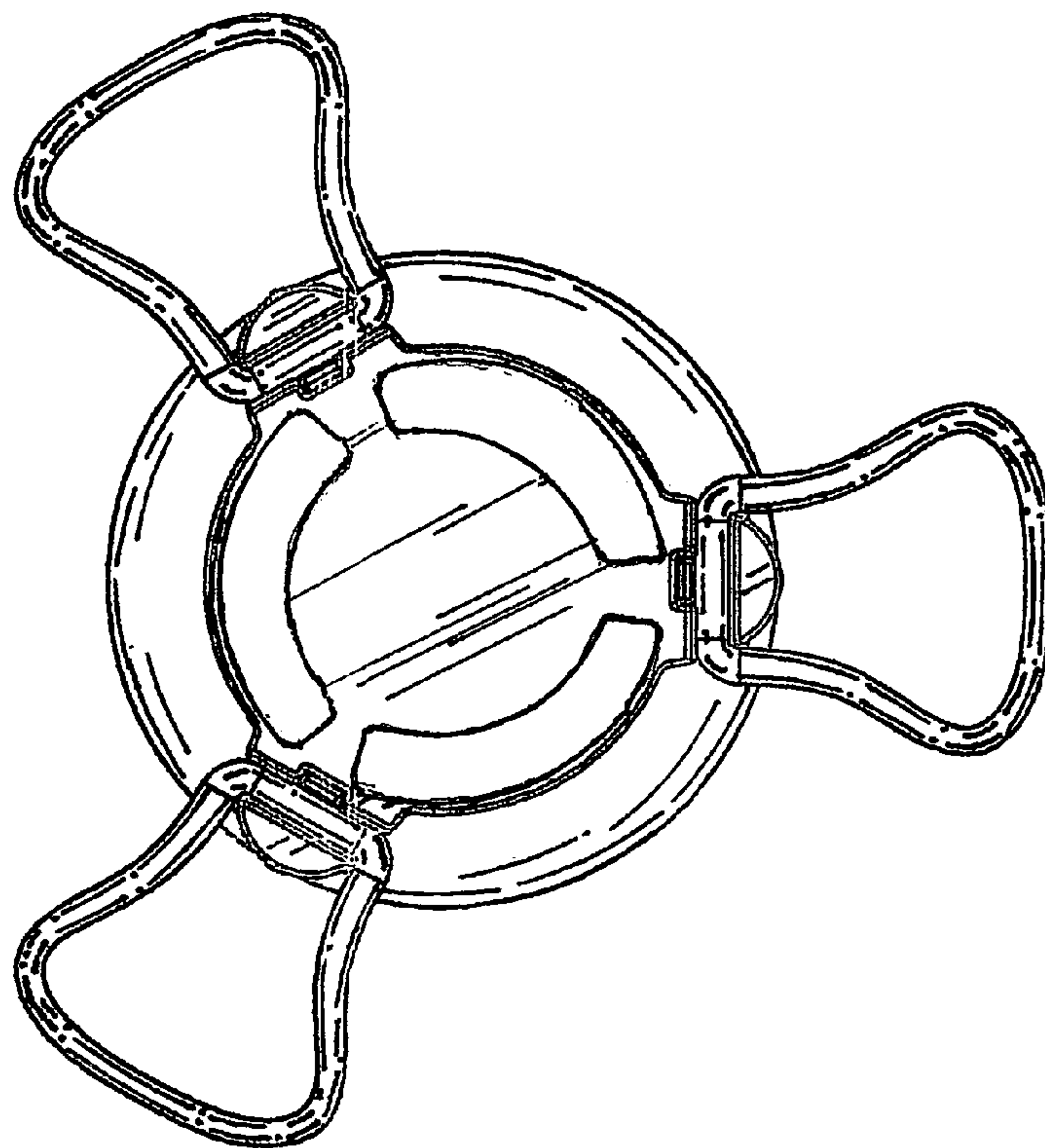

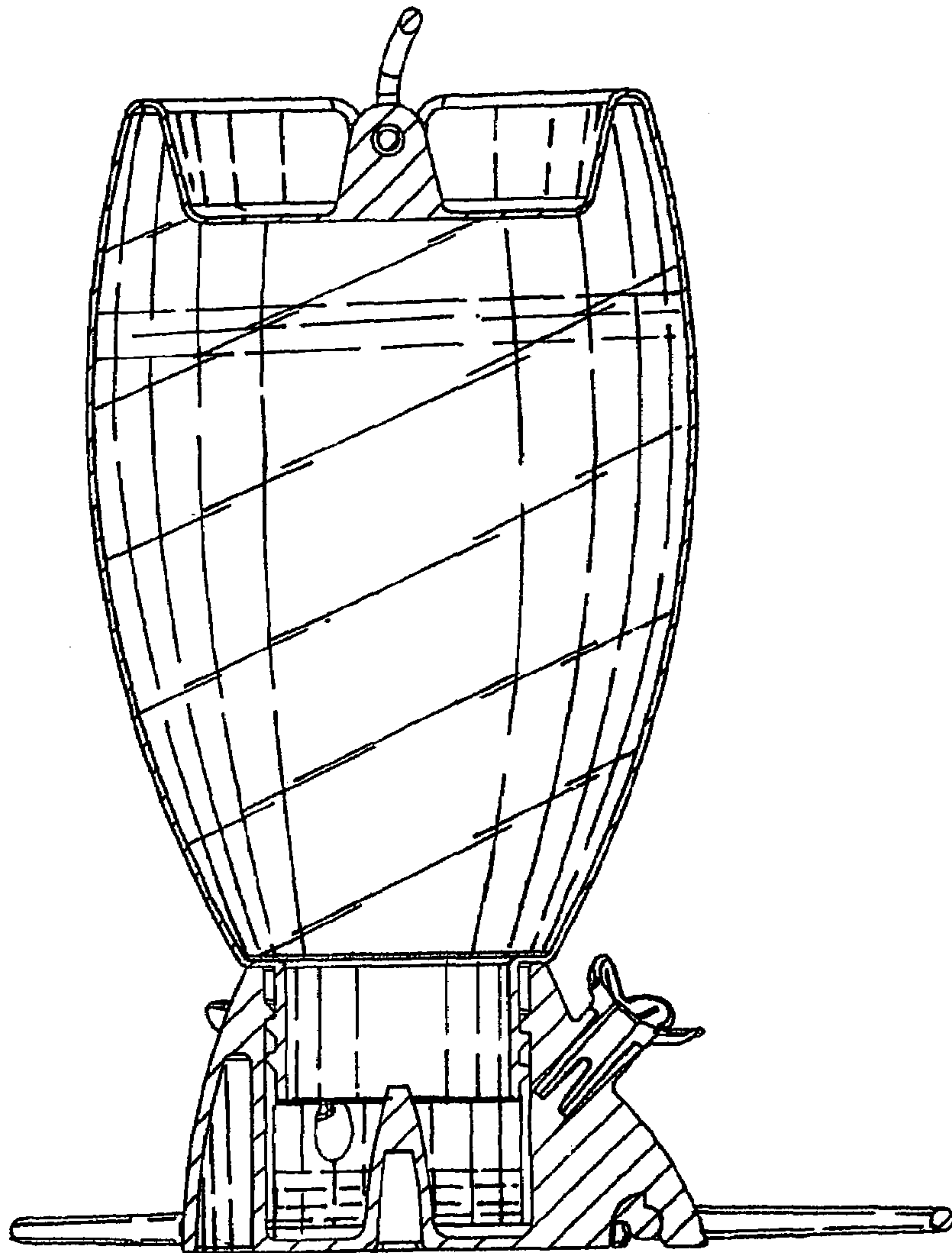

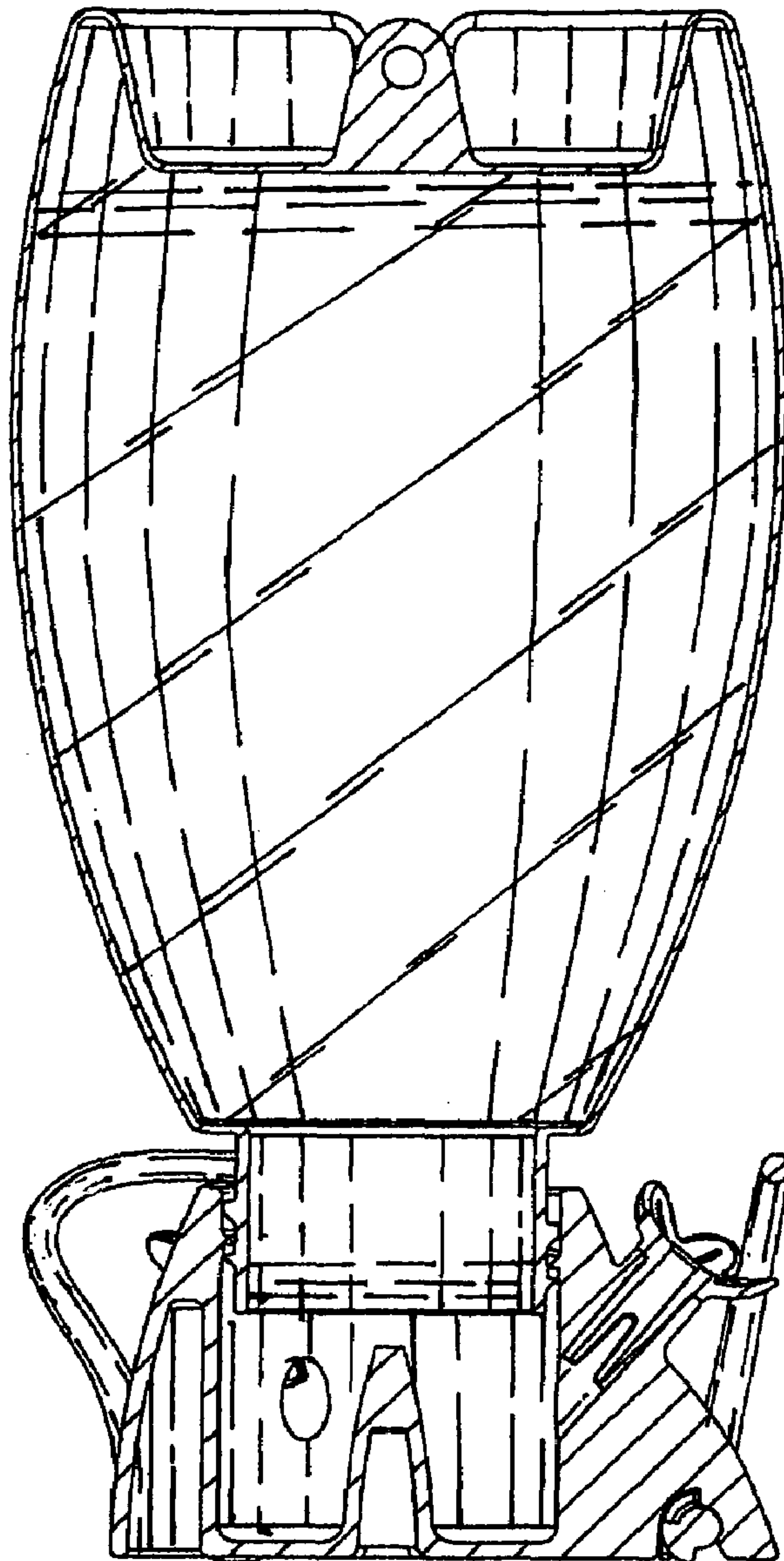
