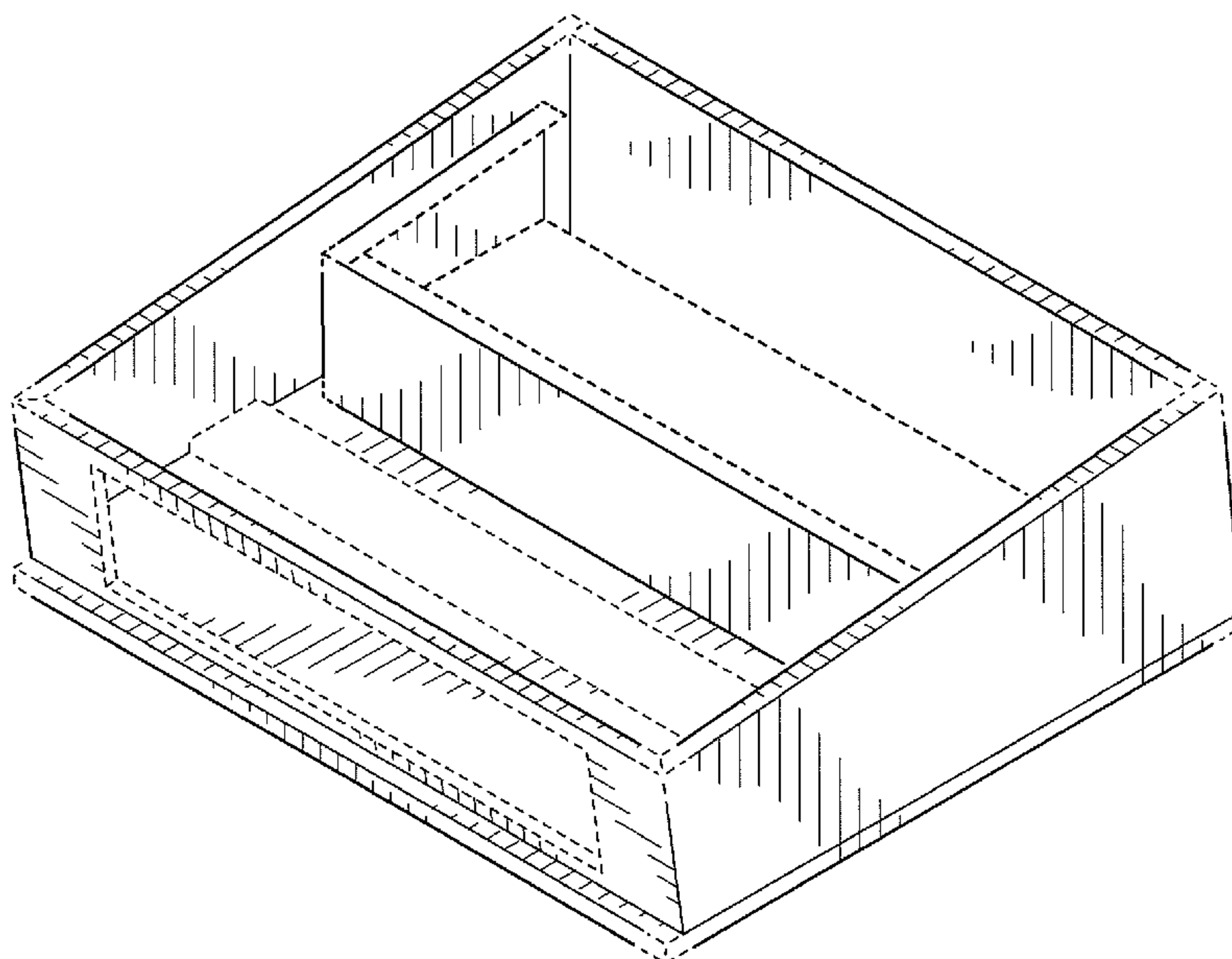
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the shop desk with hutch of

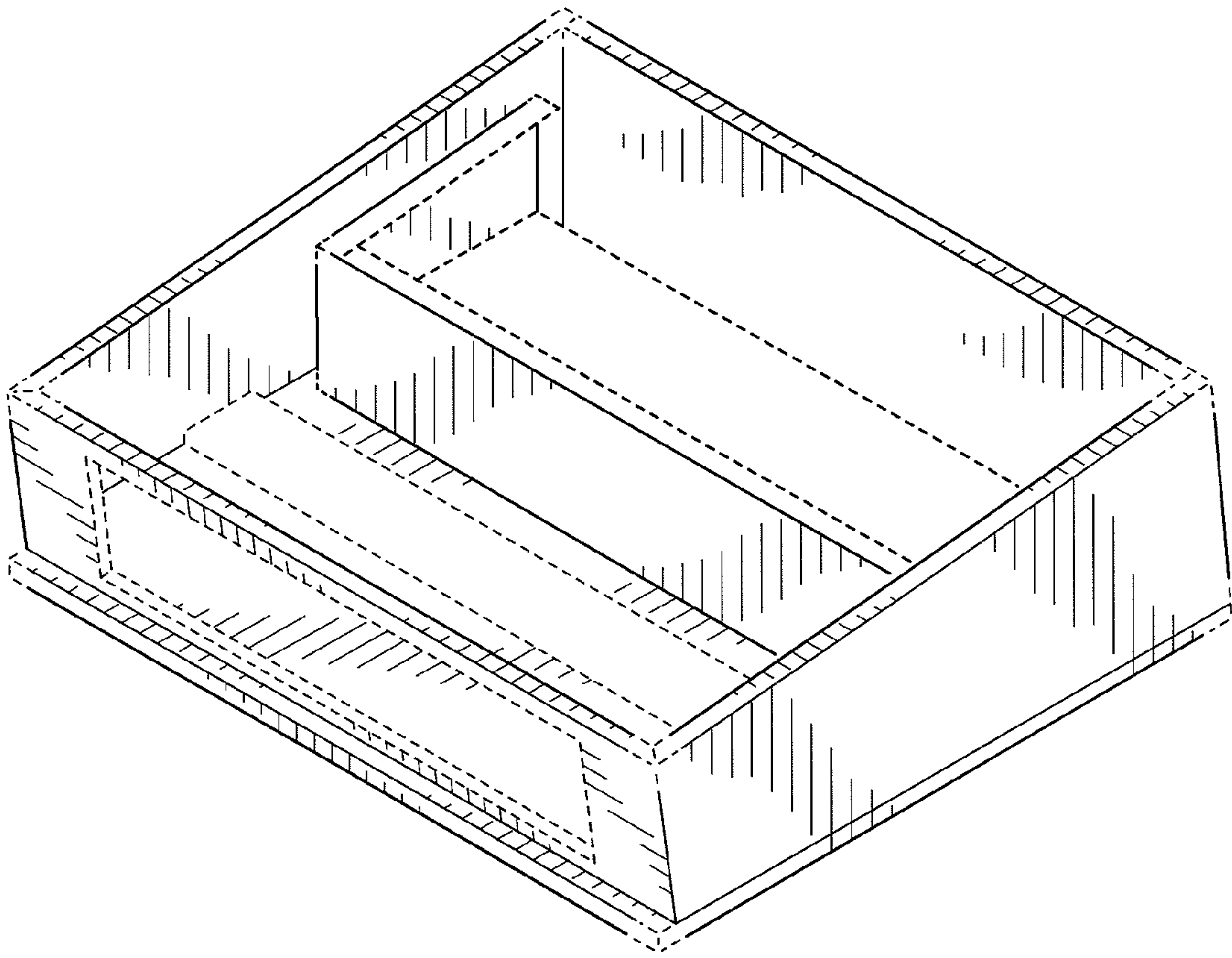

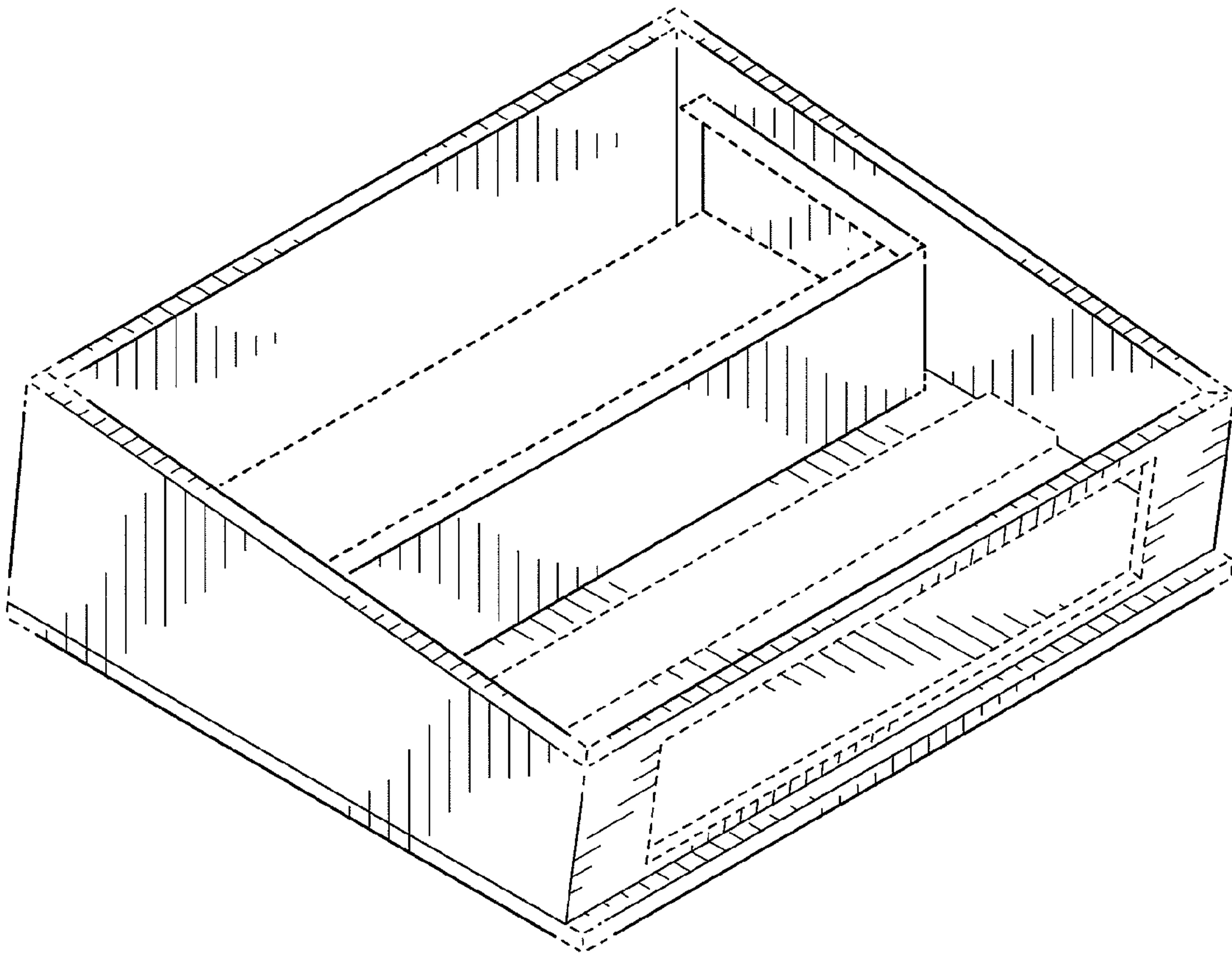

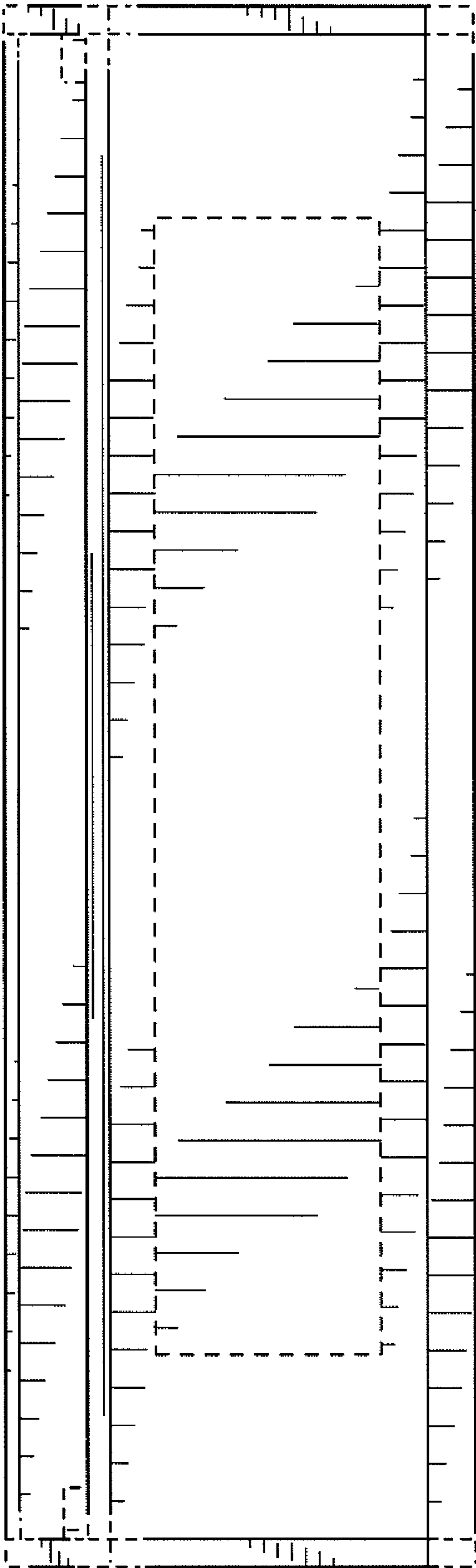

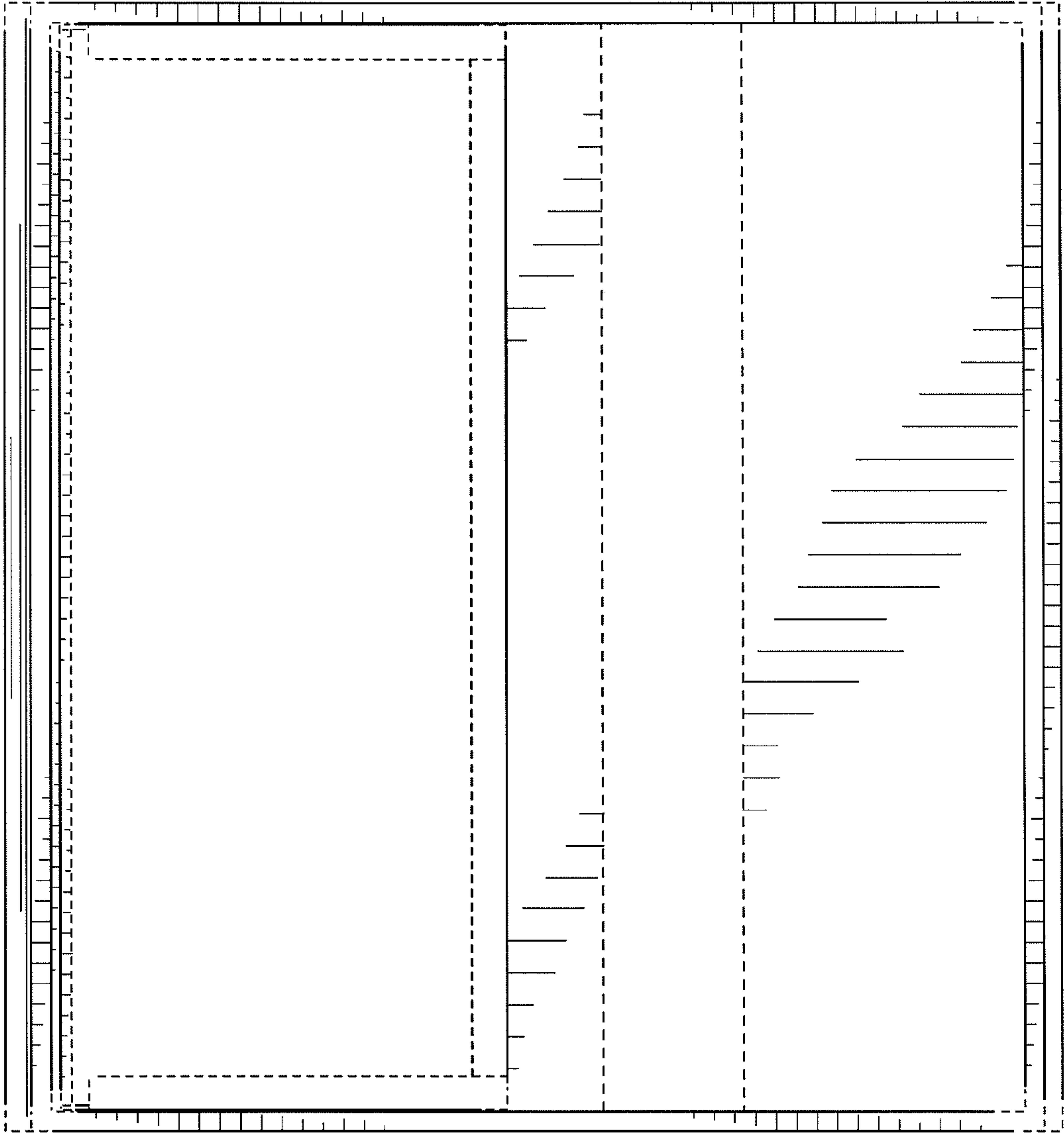

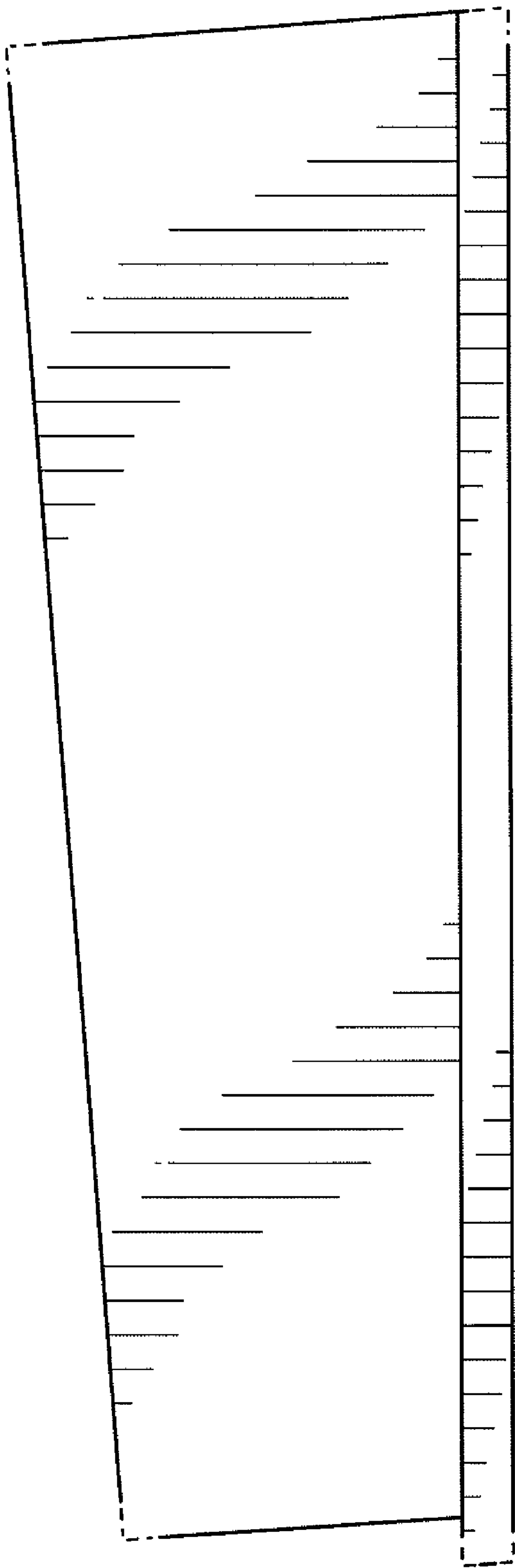

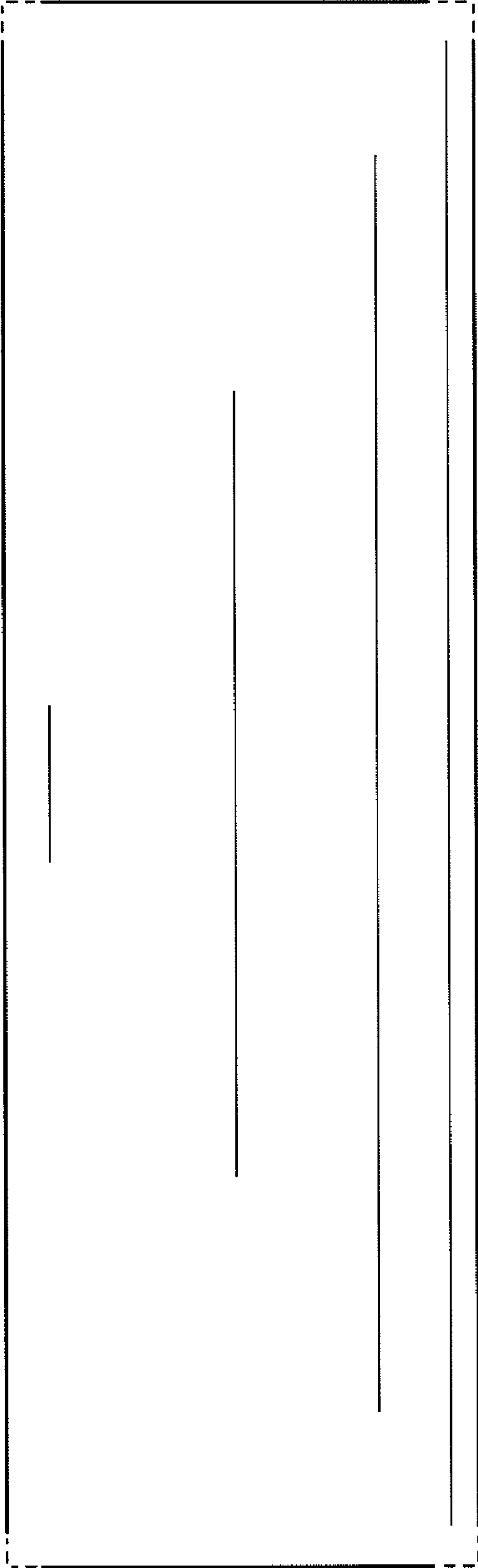

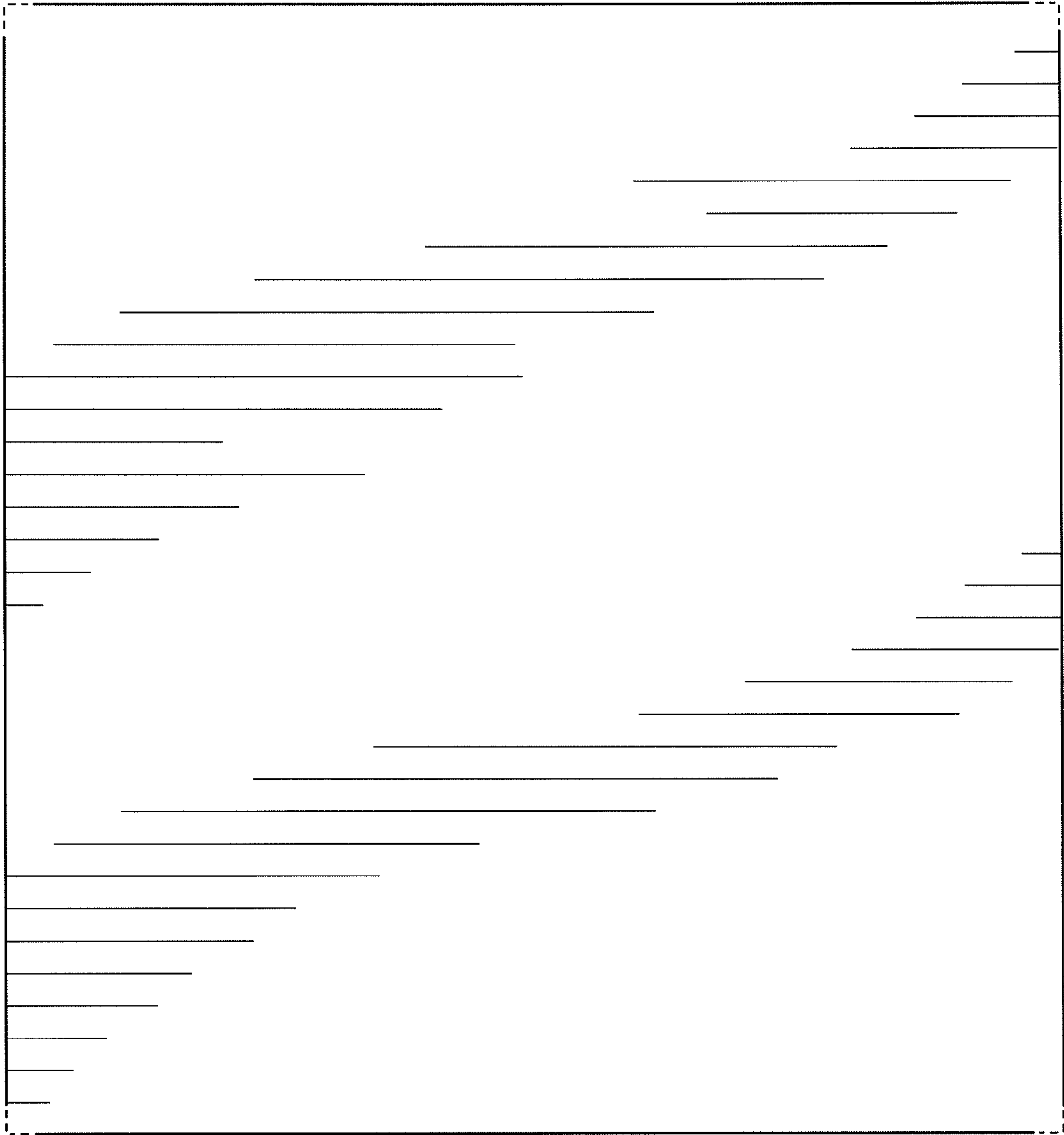
