The ornamental design for a utensil handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a utensil handle showing our new design;

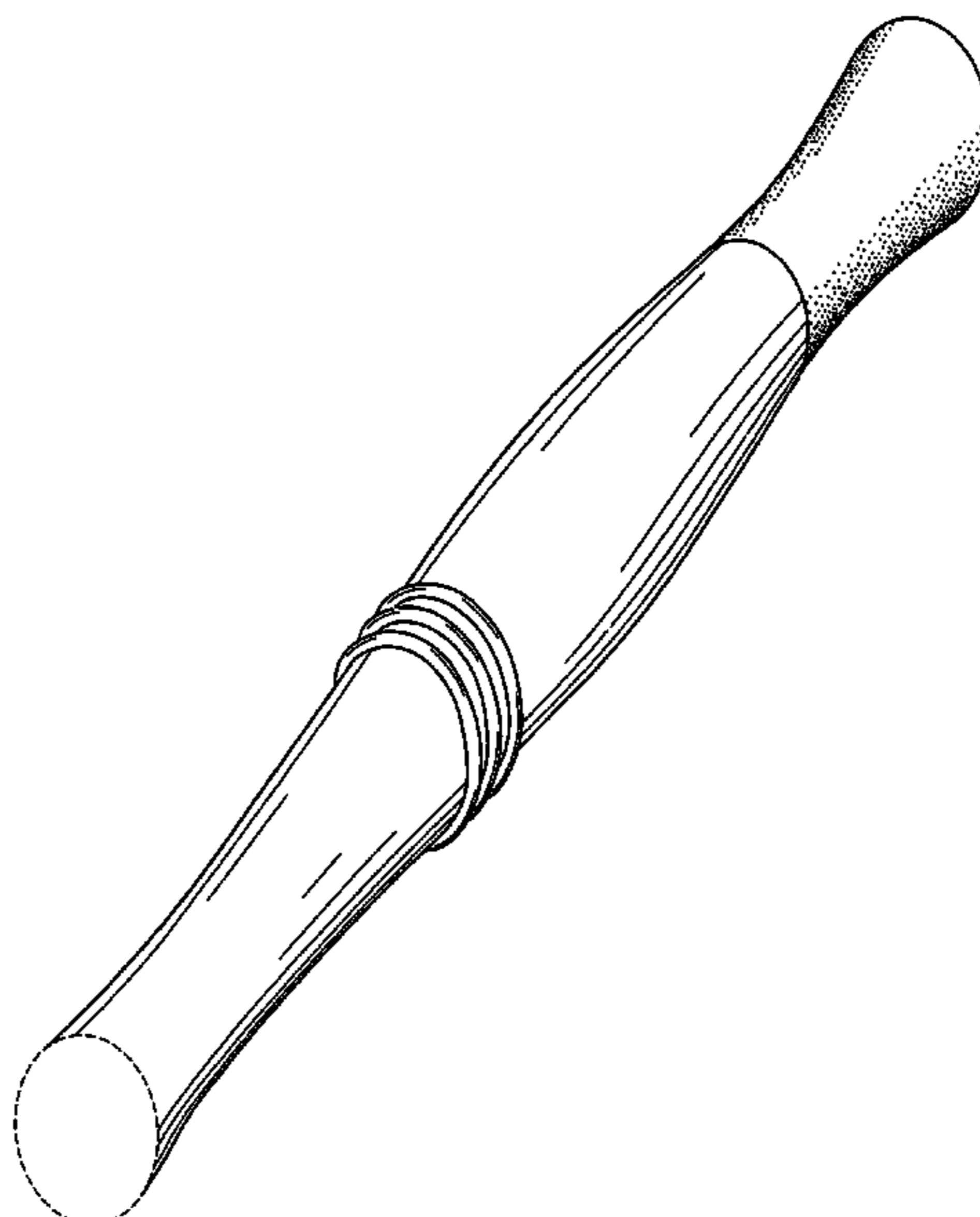
FIG. 2 is a left side, elevational view of the utensil, handle of FIG. 1, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the utensil handle shown in FIG. 1; the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof;

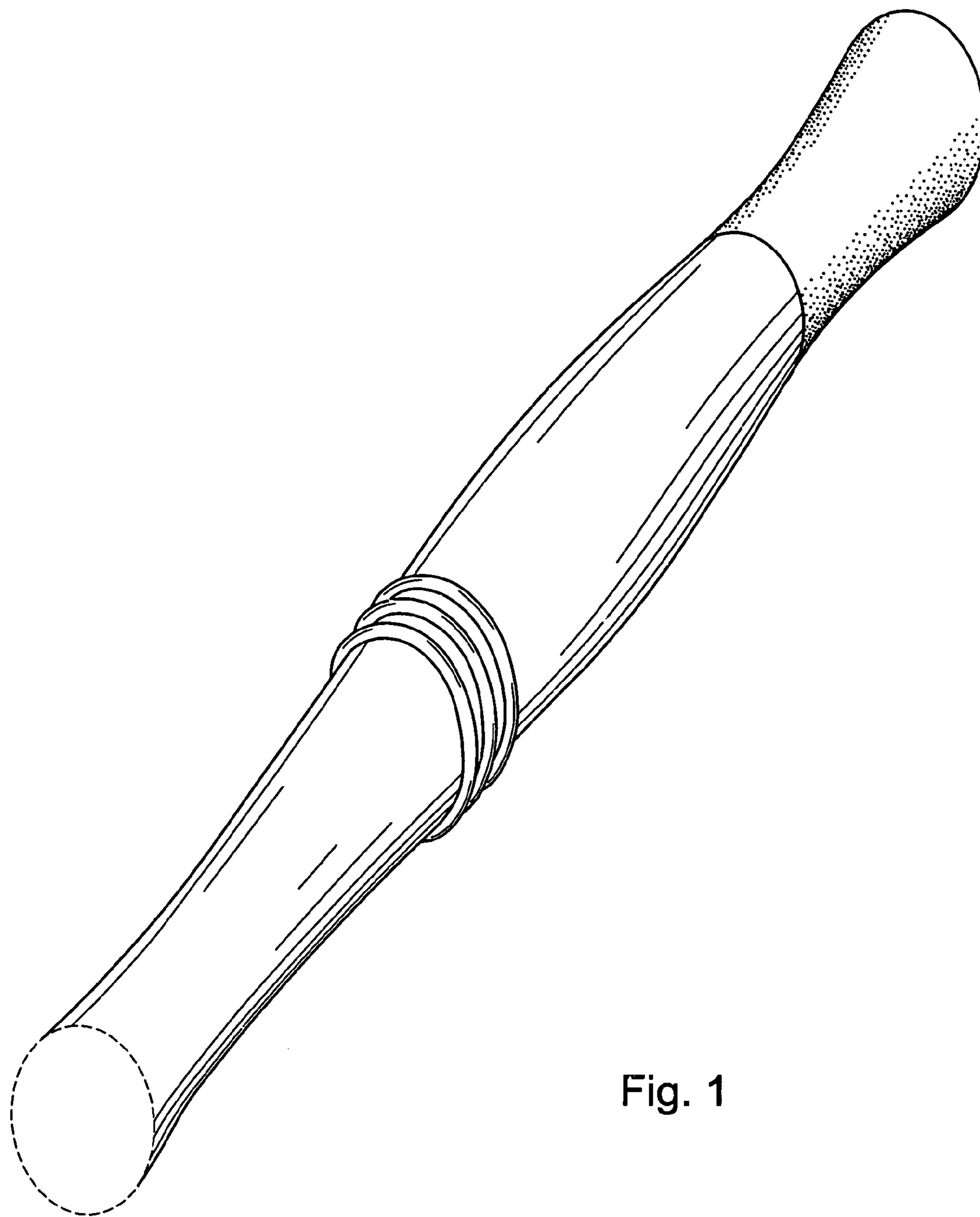

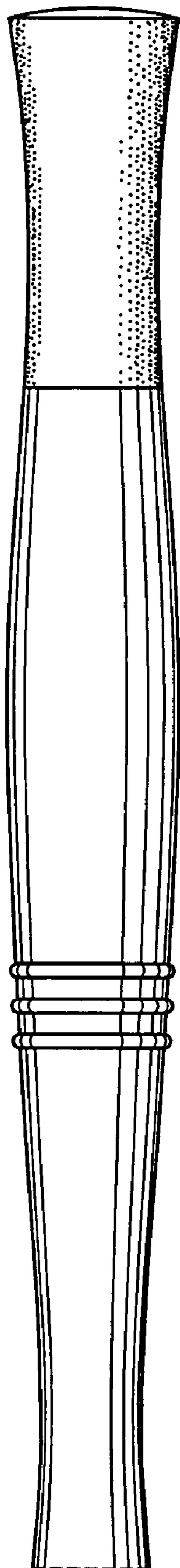

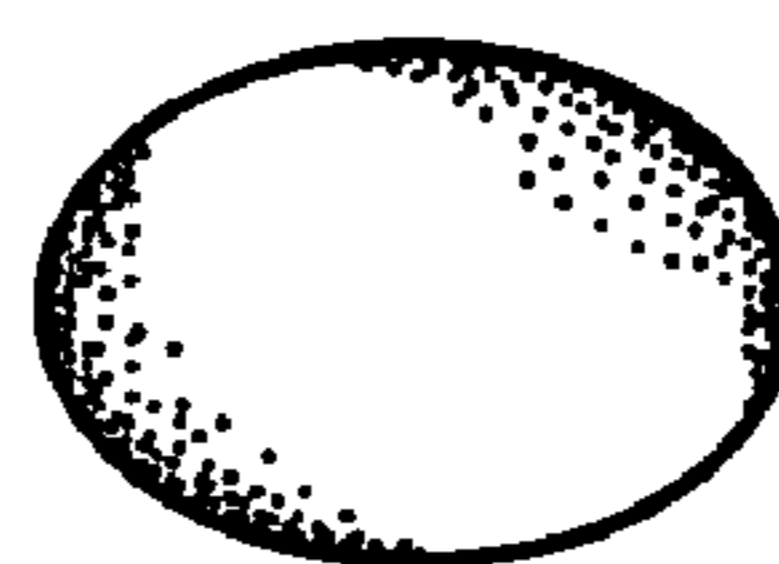
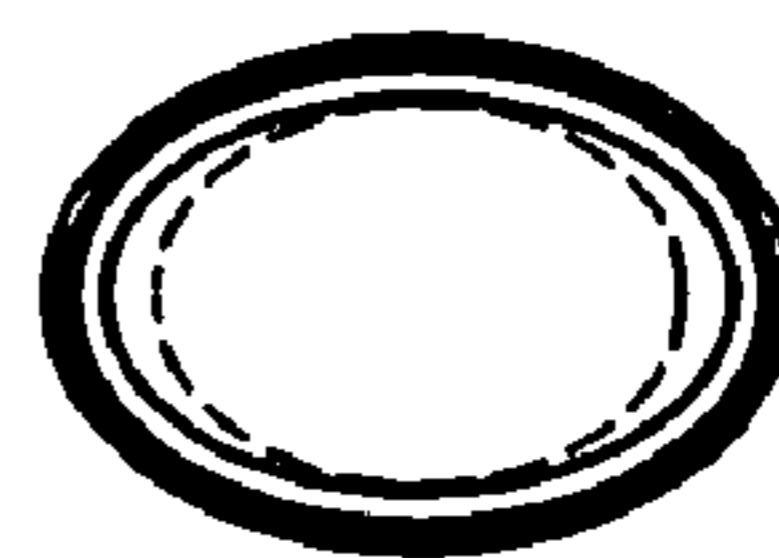
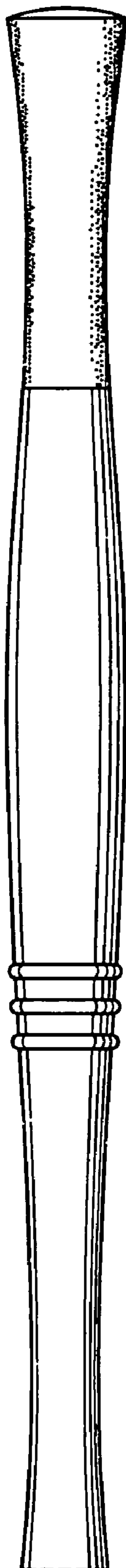
