(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottle for a device to wash nasal passages, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

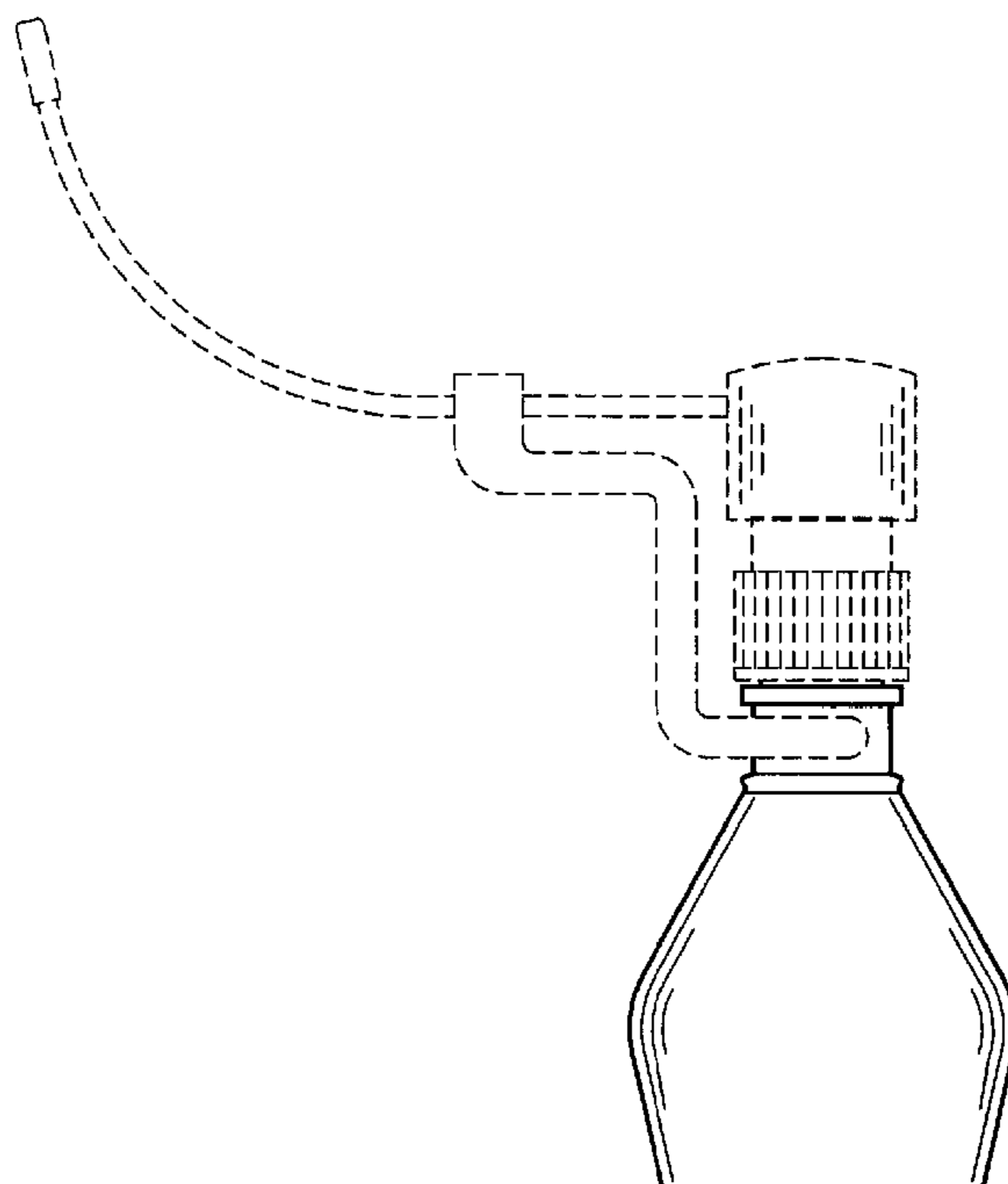
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

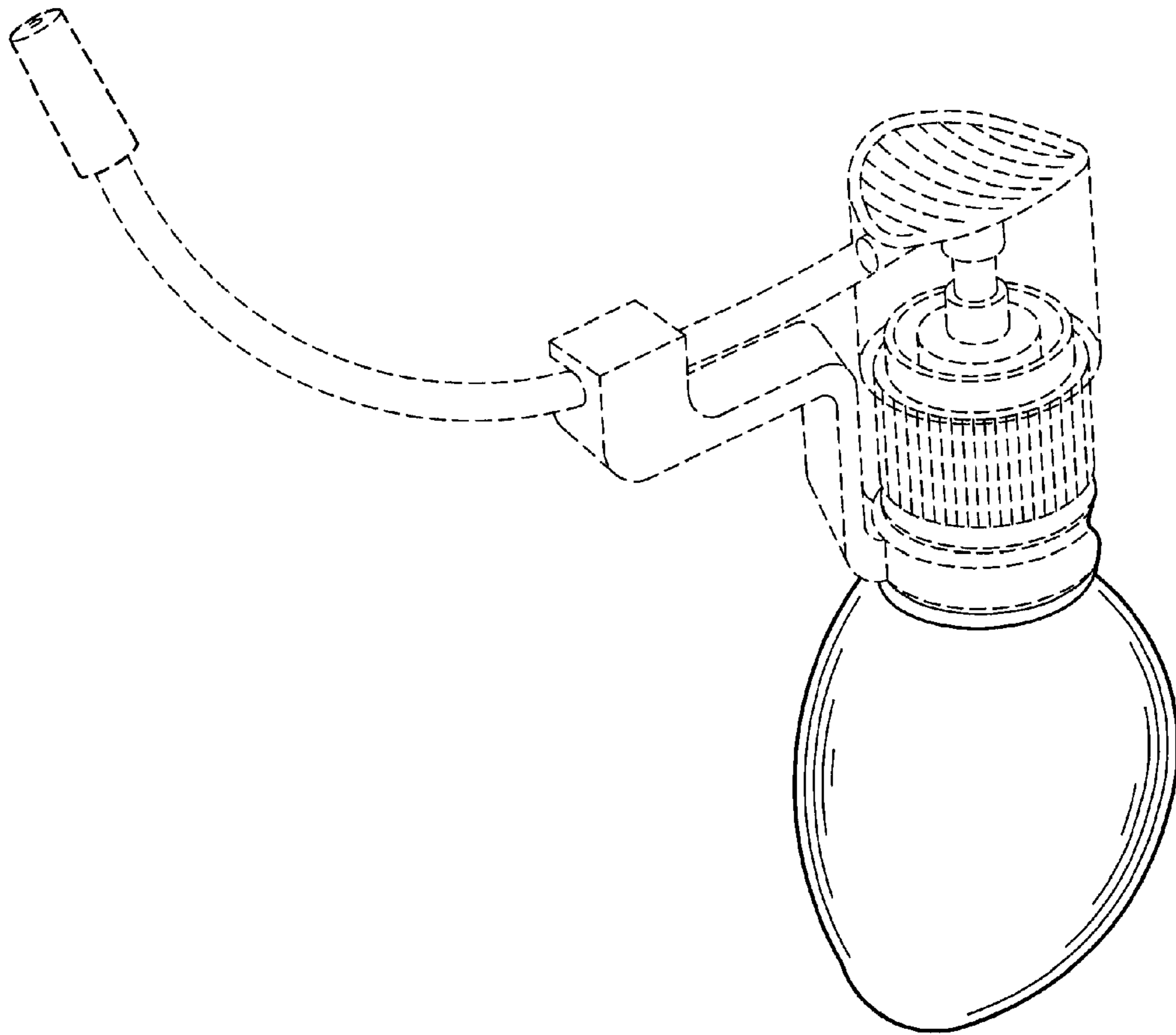

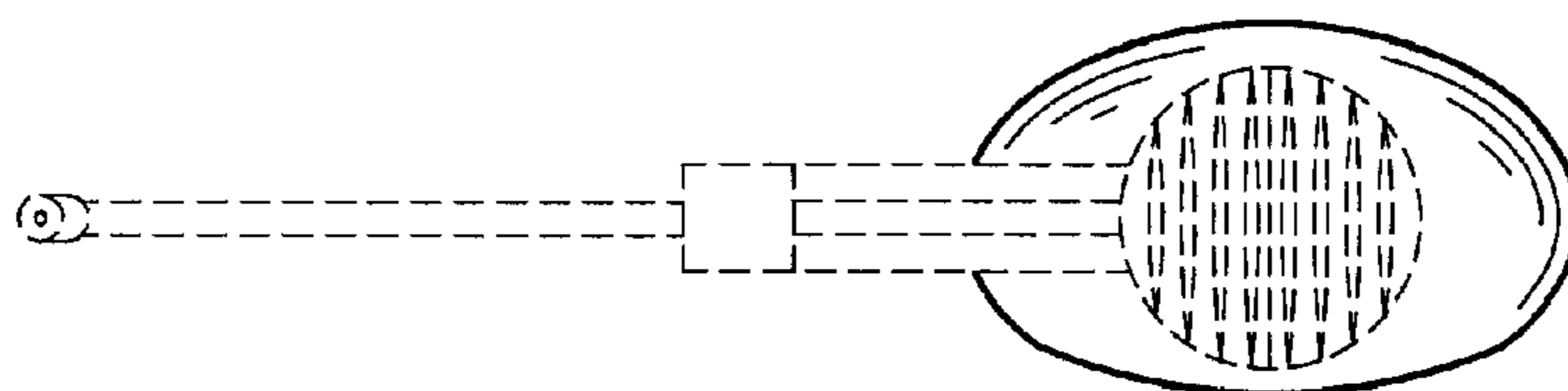

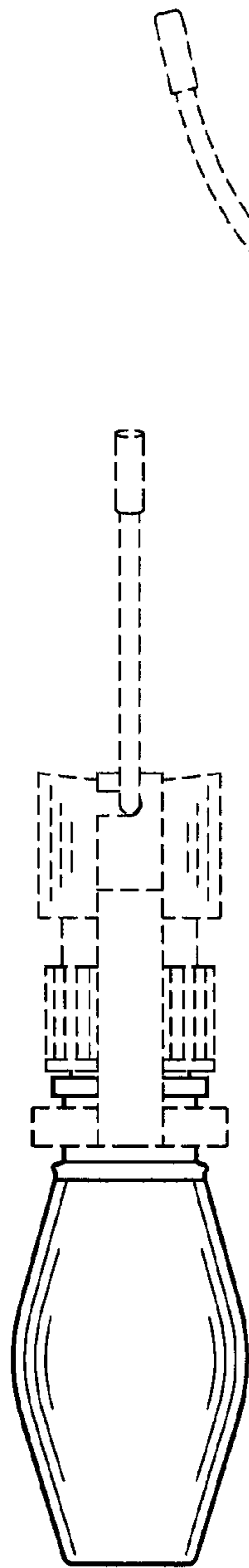

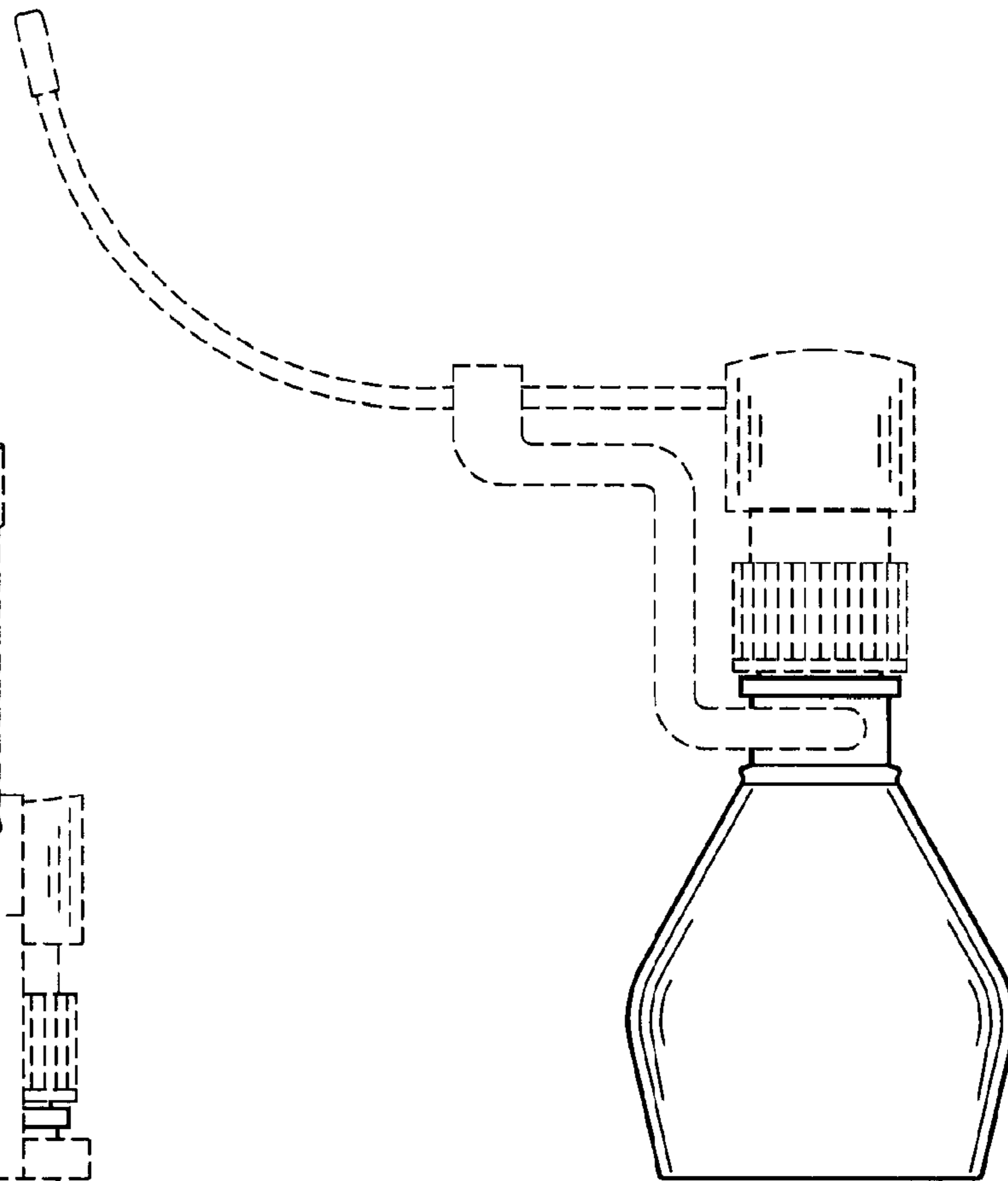

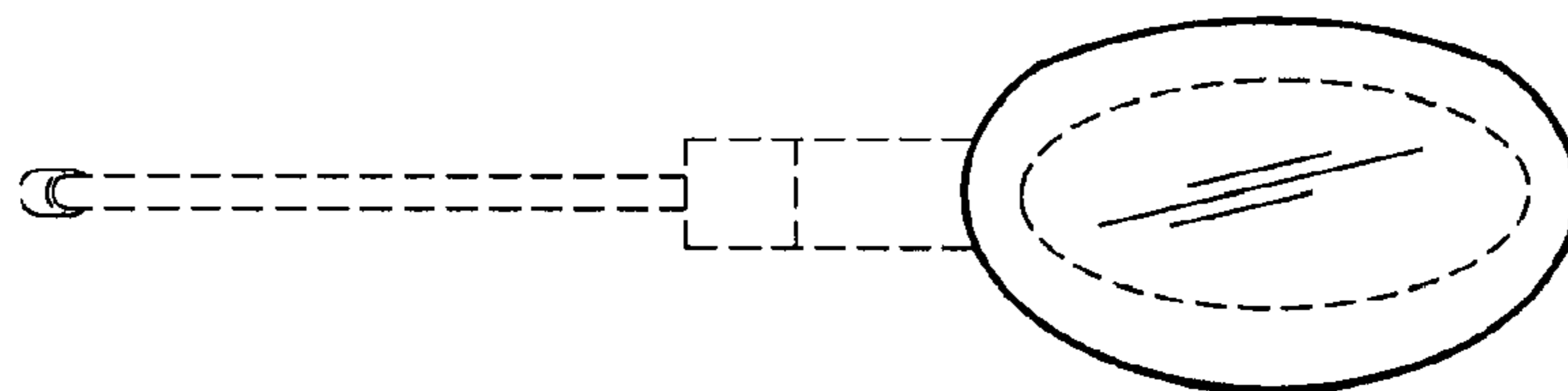

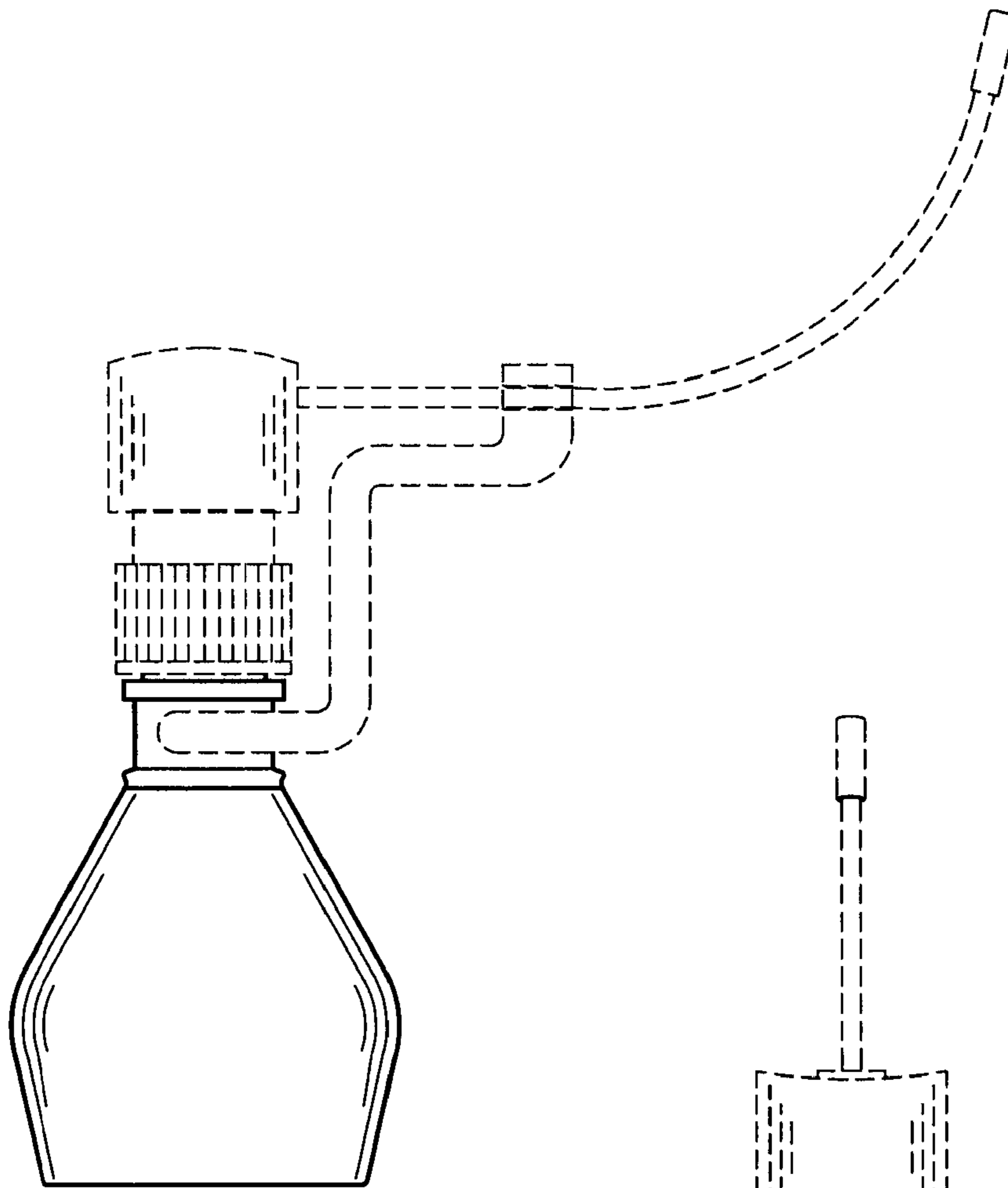

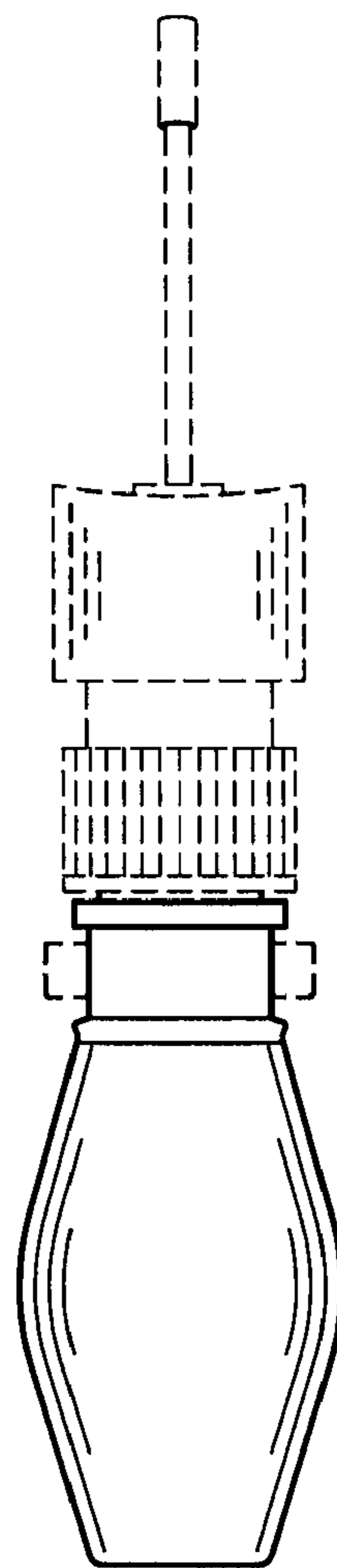
