FIG. 2 is a front view of the foam broom display wisk showing my new design thereof.

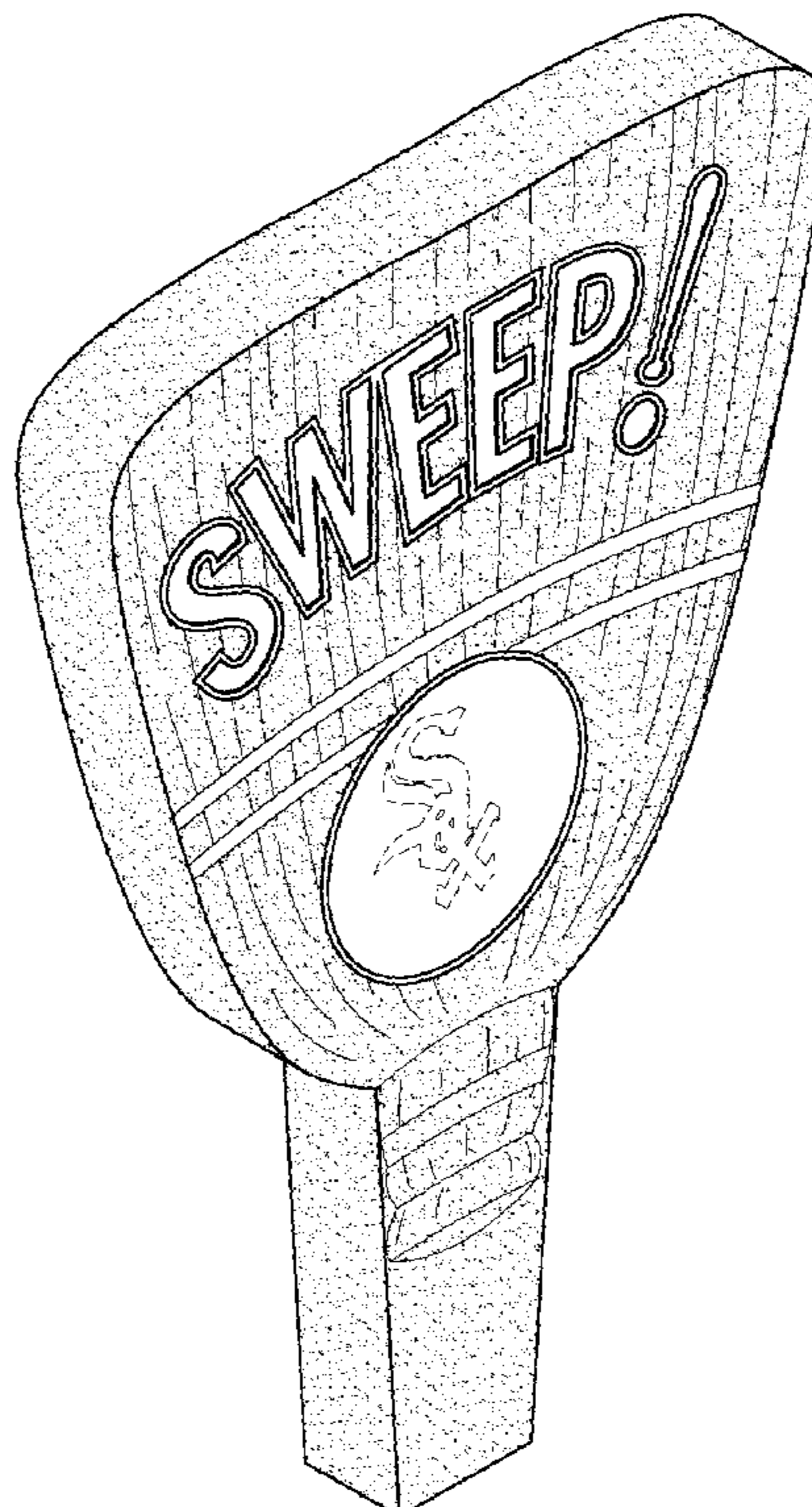
FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the foam broom display wisk showing my new design thereof.

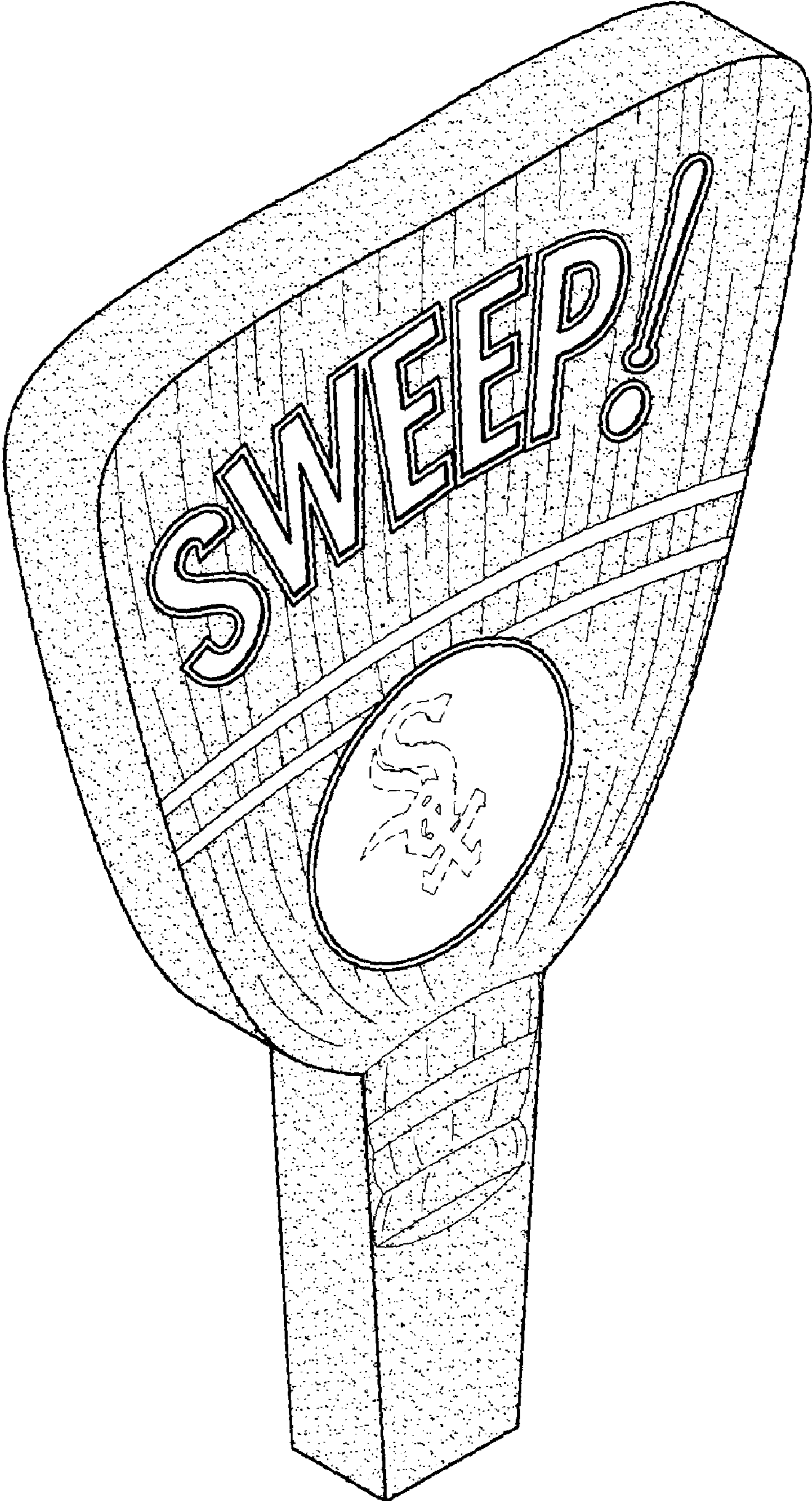

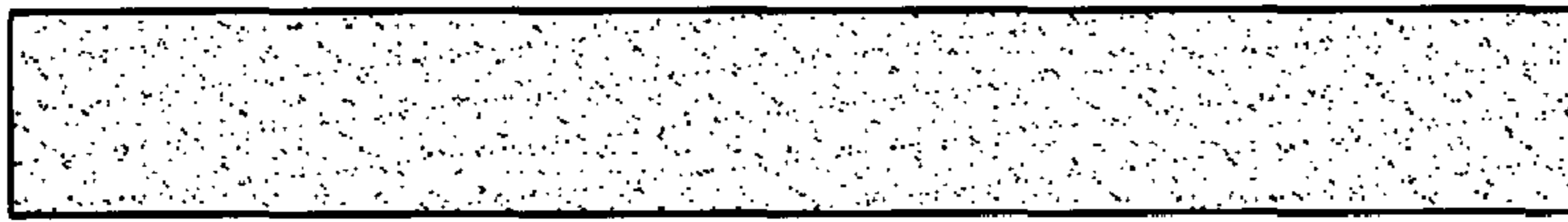

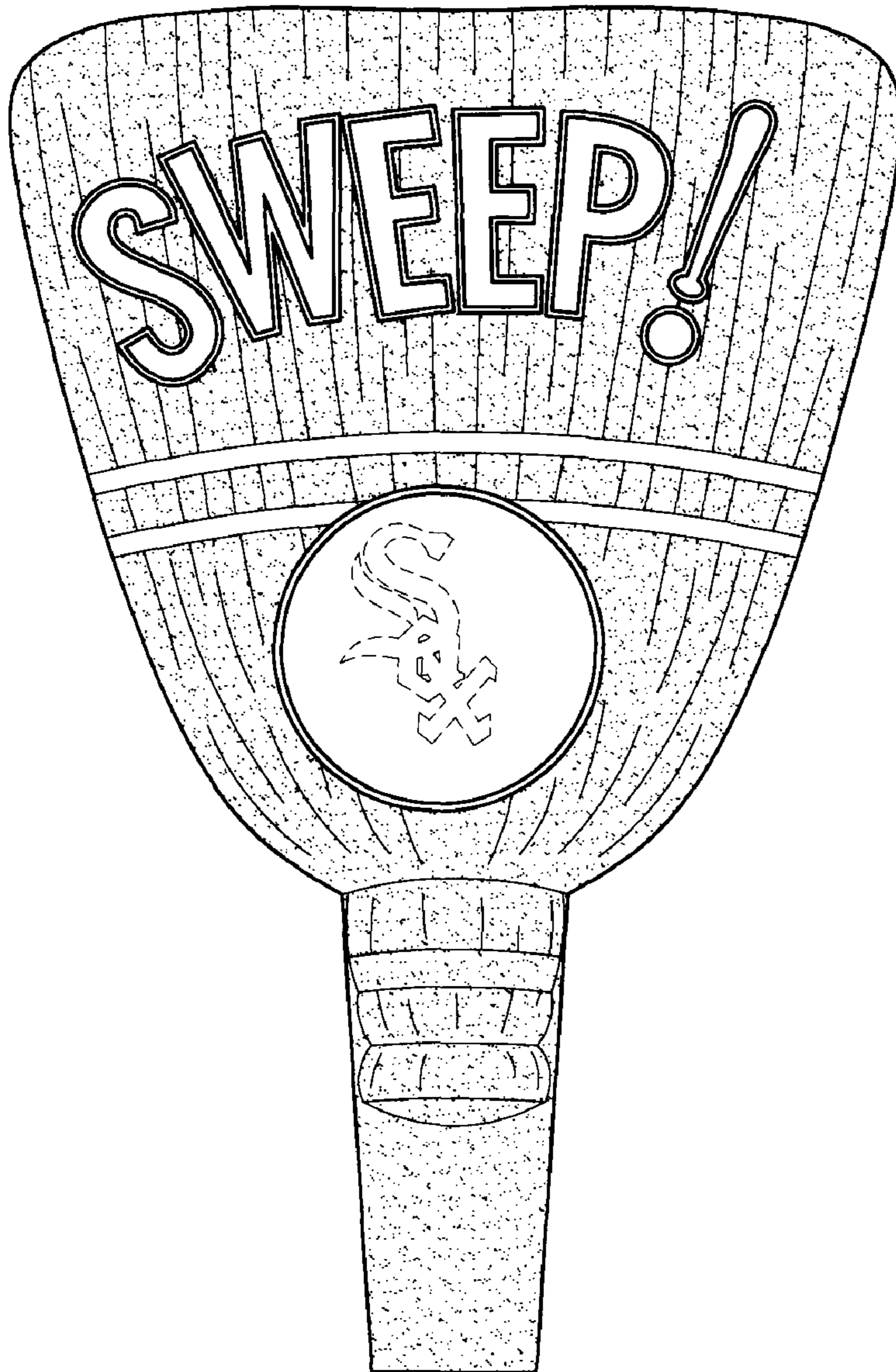

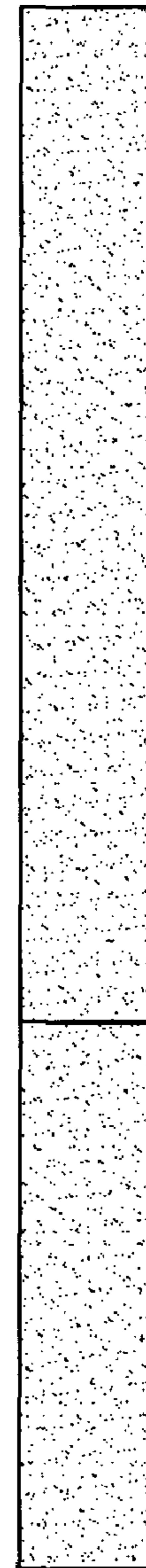

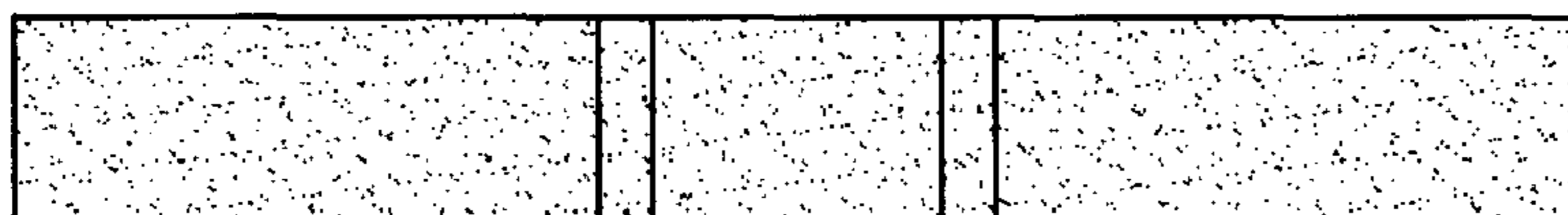
