The article relates to a handle made of plastics for using a cleaning device such as a wiping sheet made of a nonwoven fabric with the wiping sheet held with the handle. 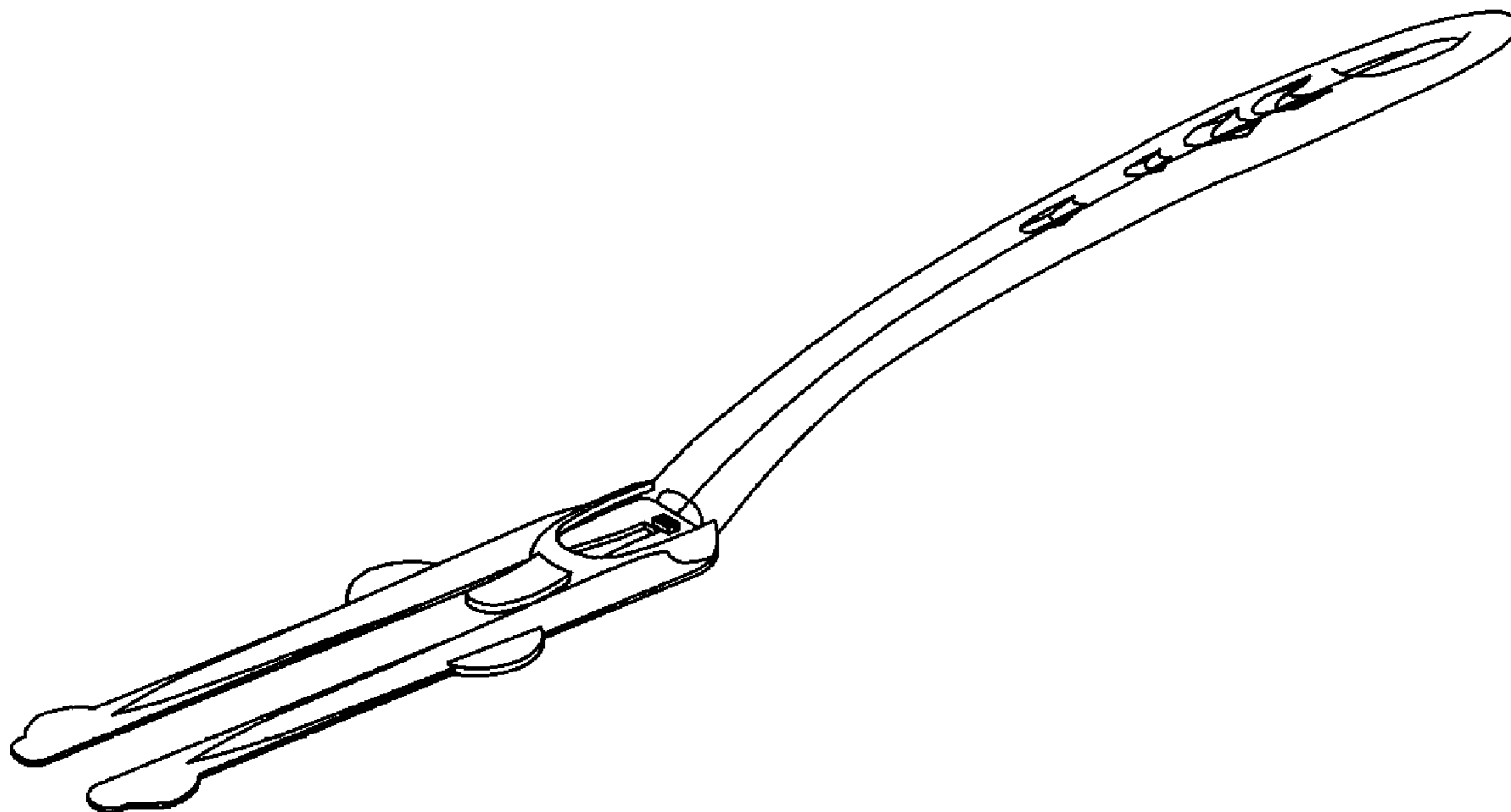

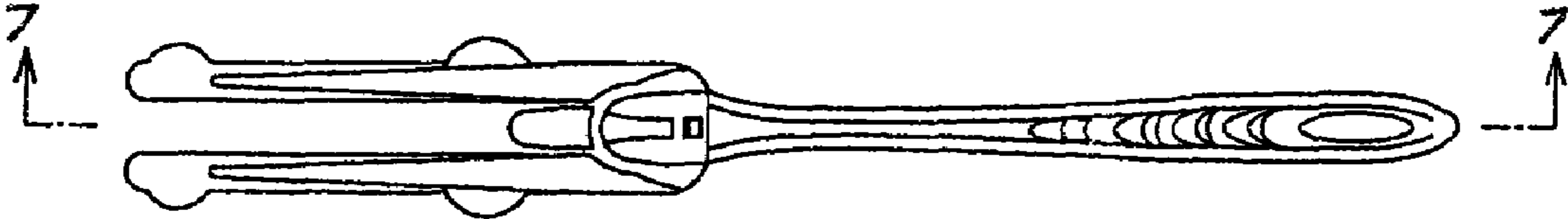

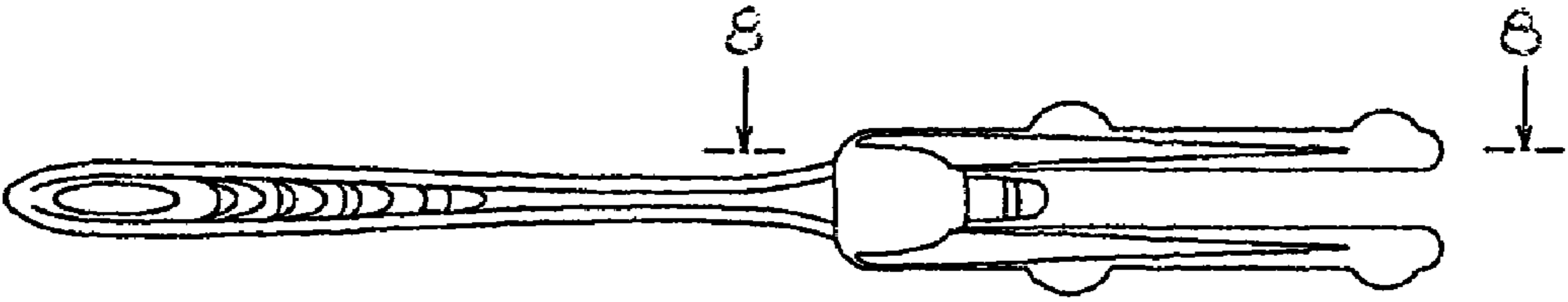

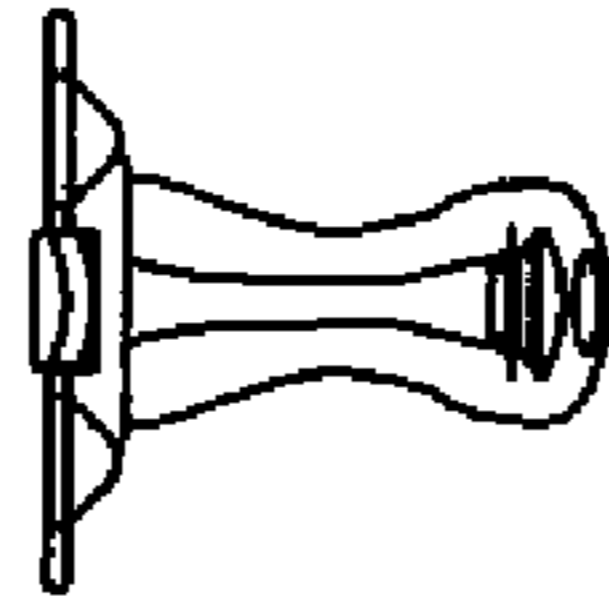

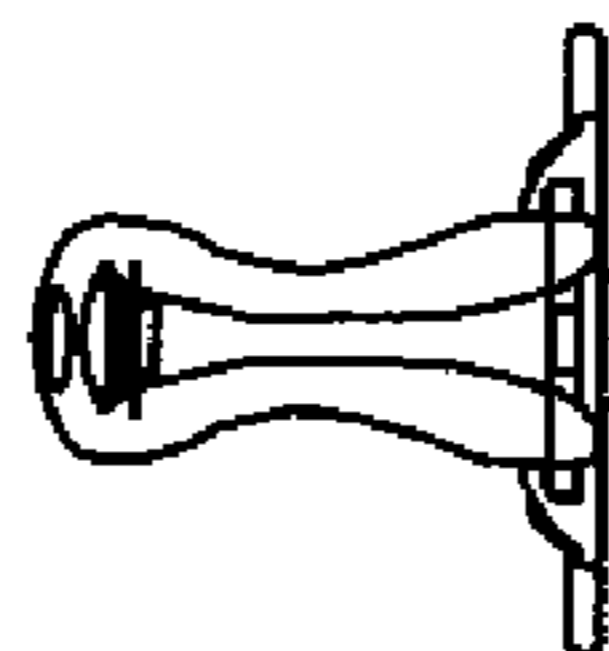

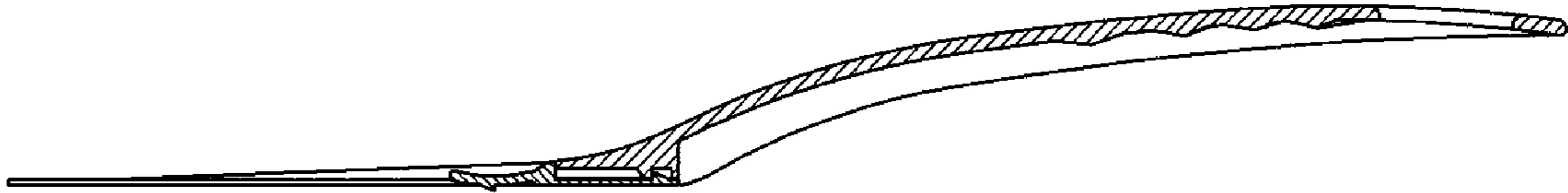

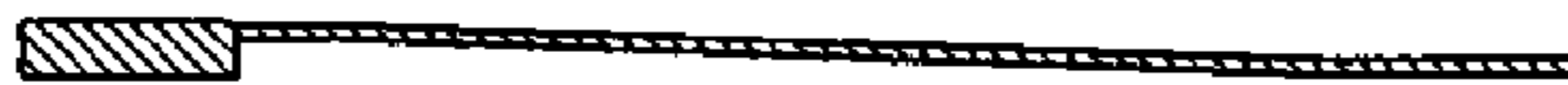

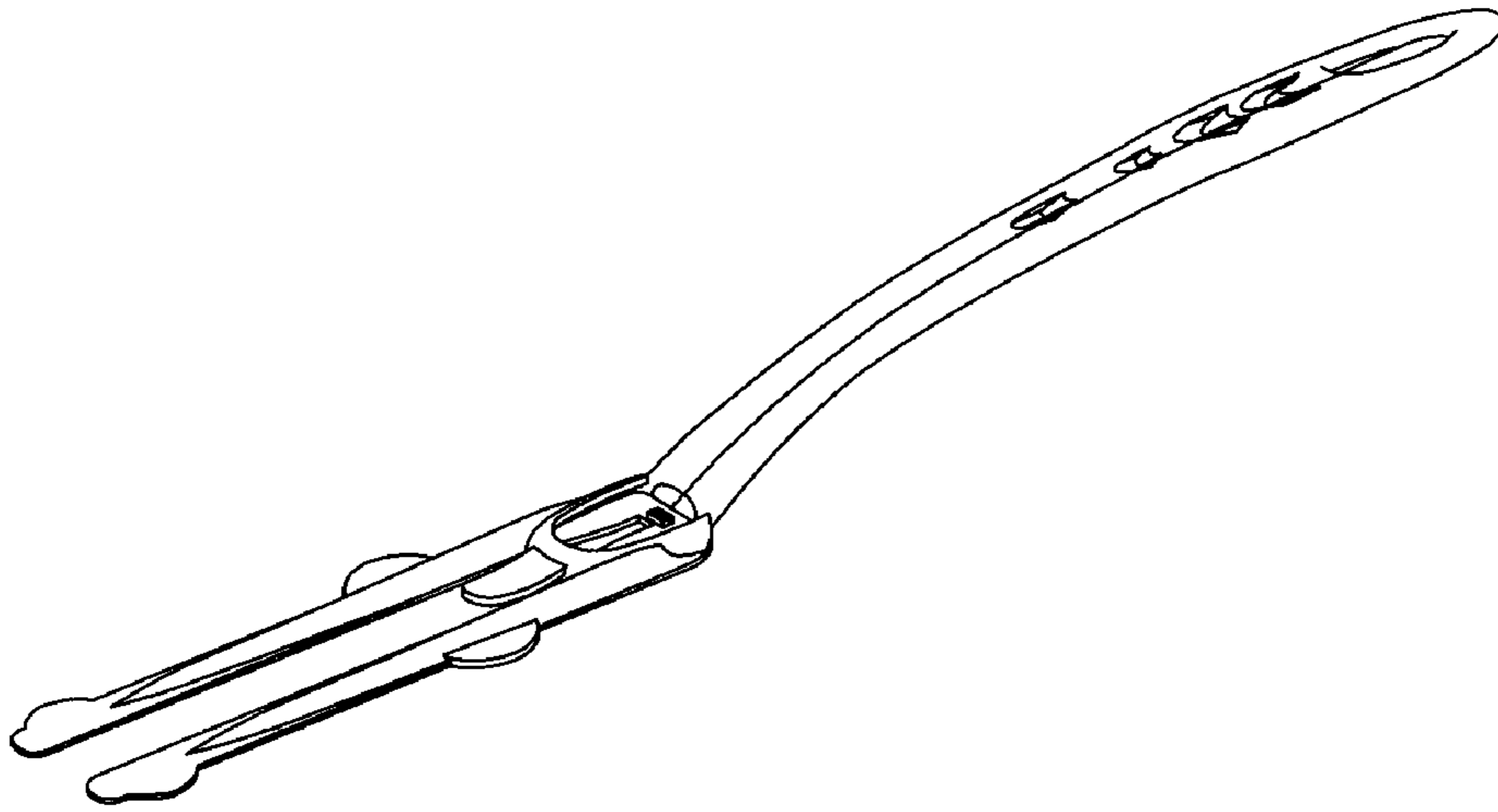
