DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view showing left component of a pair of infant shoe soles, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the pair of infant shoe soles of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a left side view of the pair of infant shoe soles of FIG. 1;

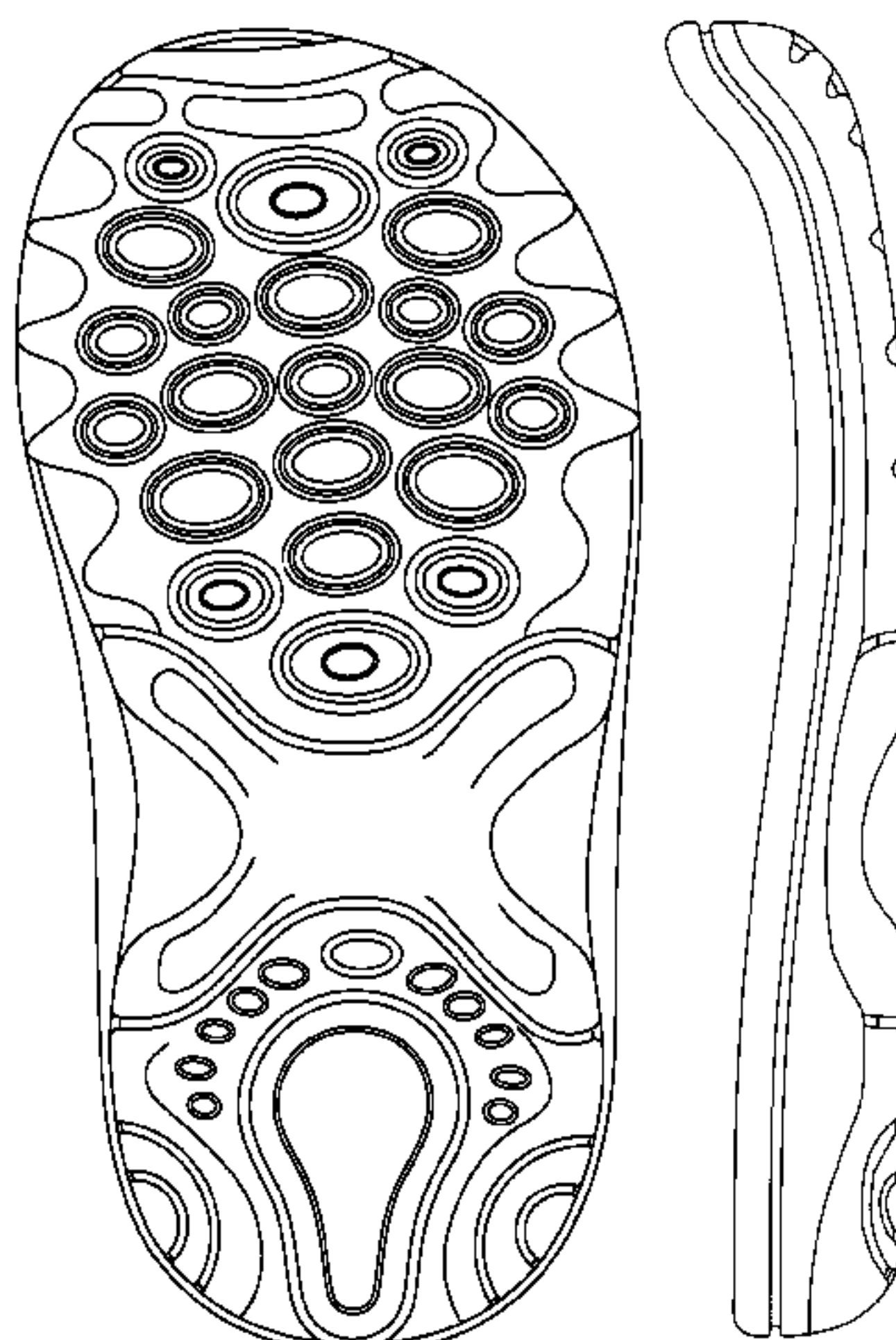
FIG. 6 is a right side view of the pair of infant shoe soles of FIG. 1;

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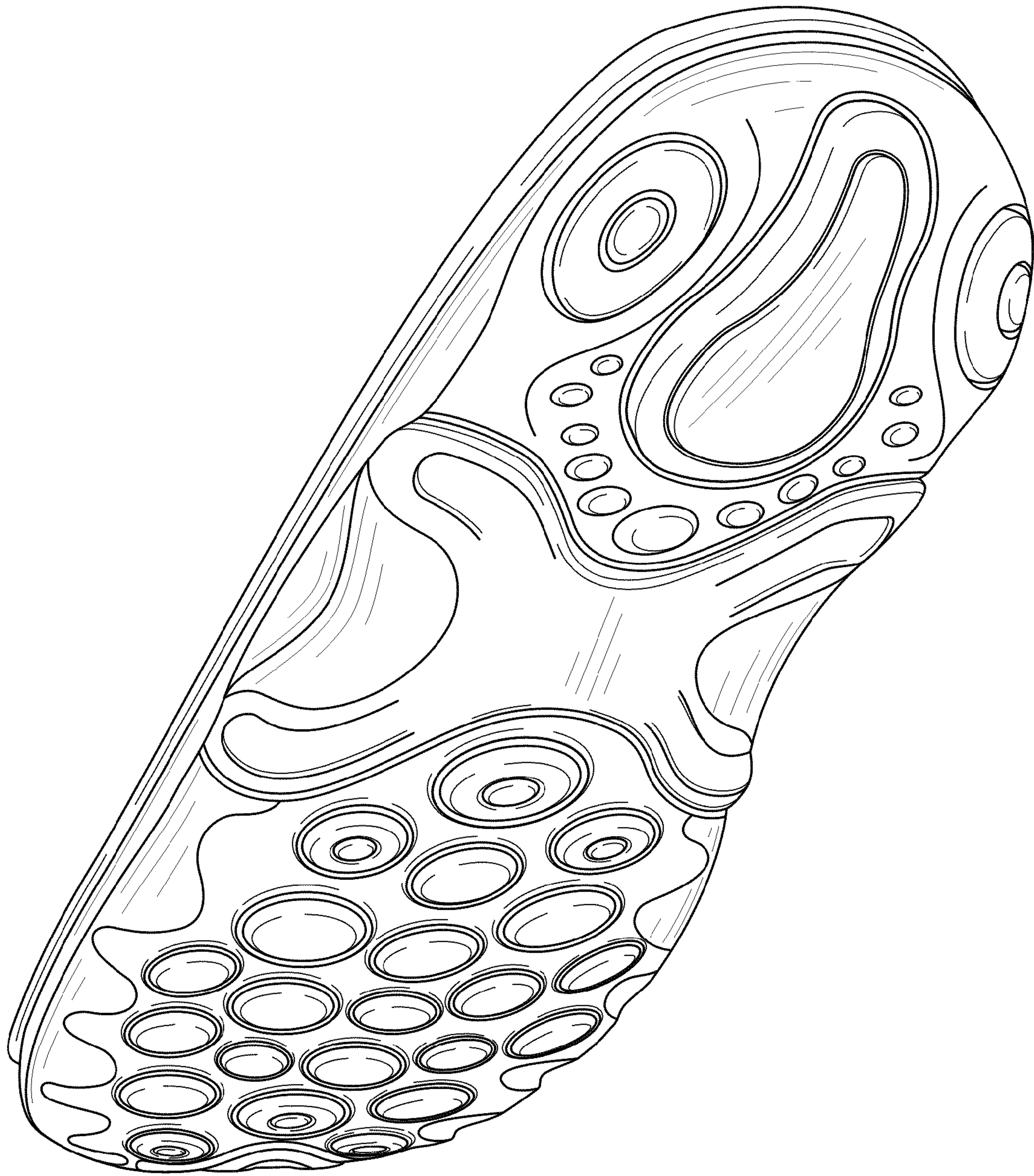

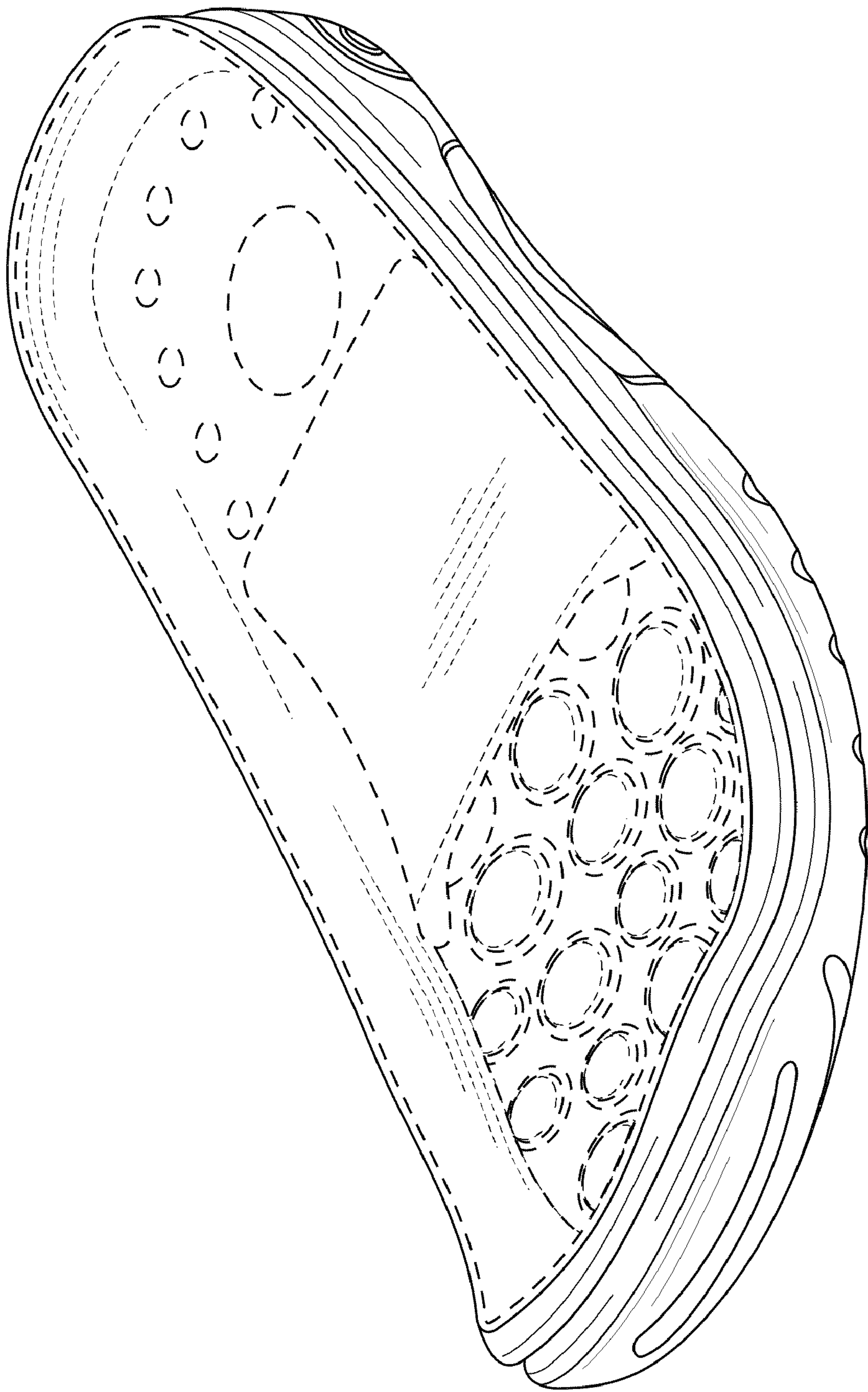

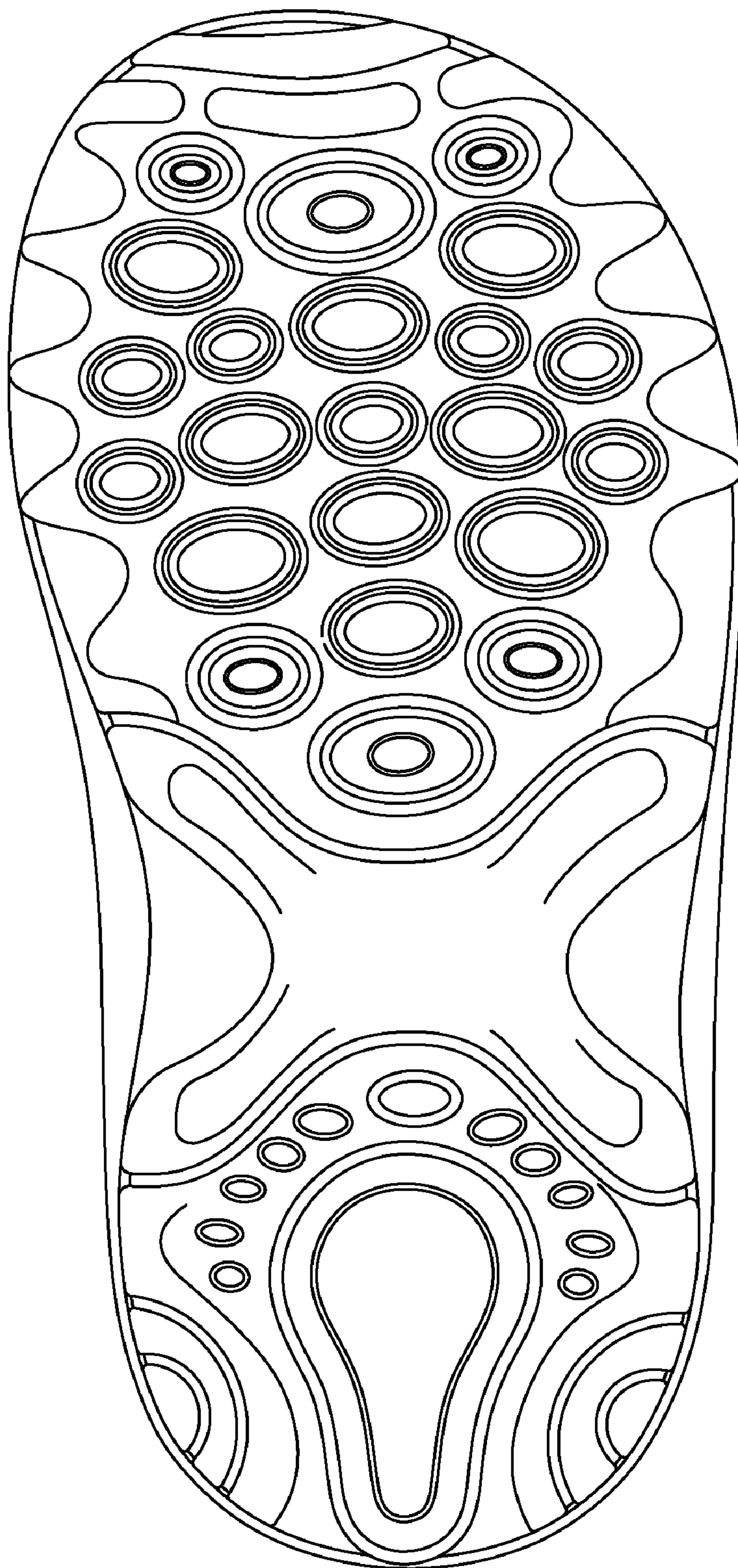

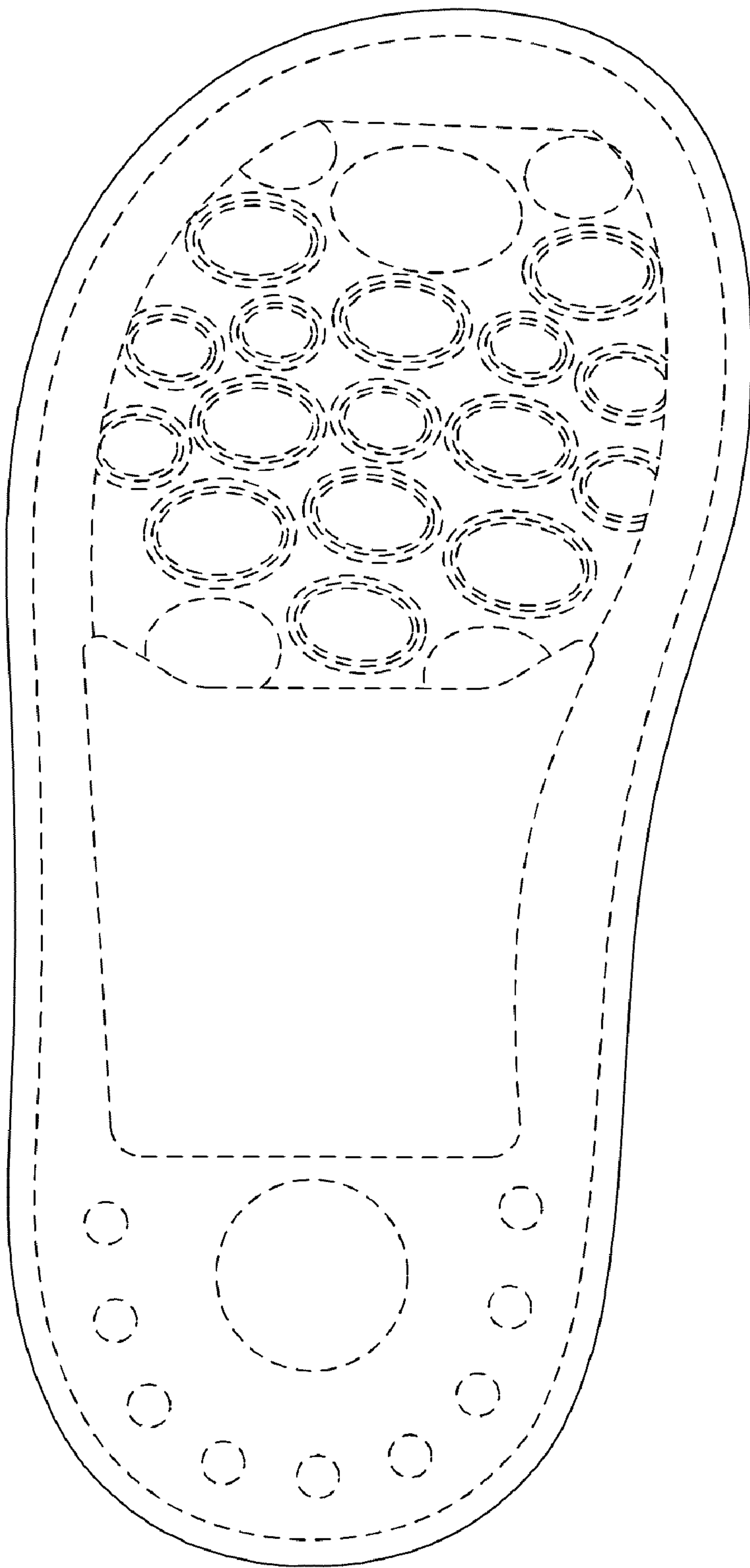

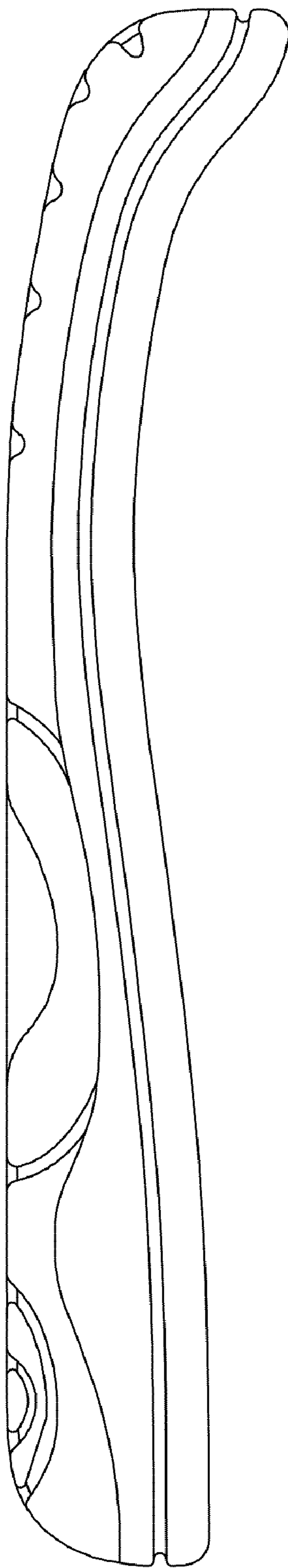

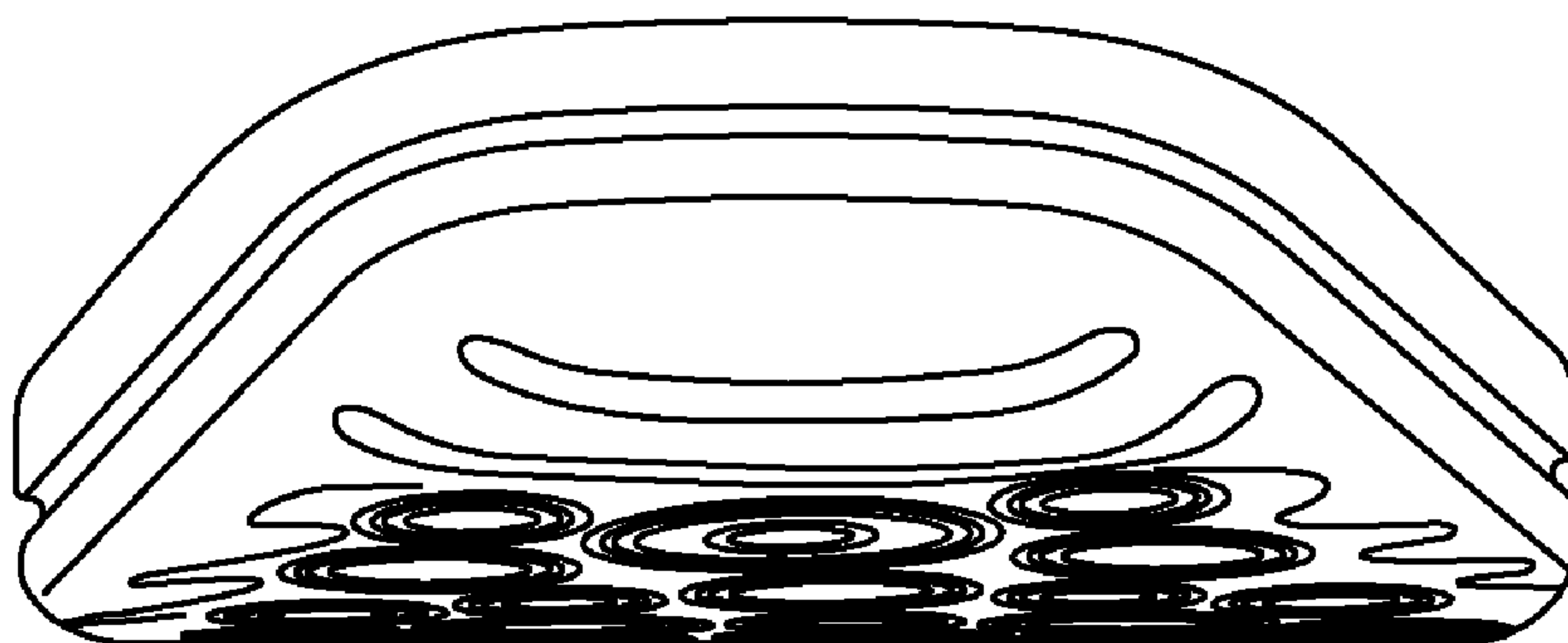

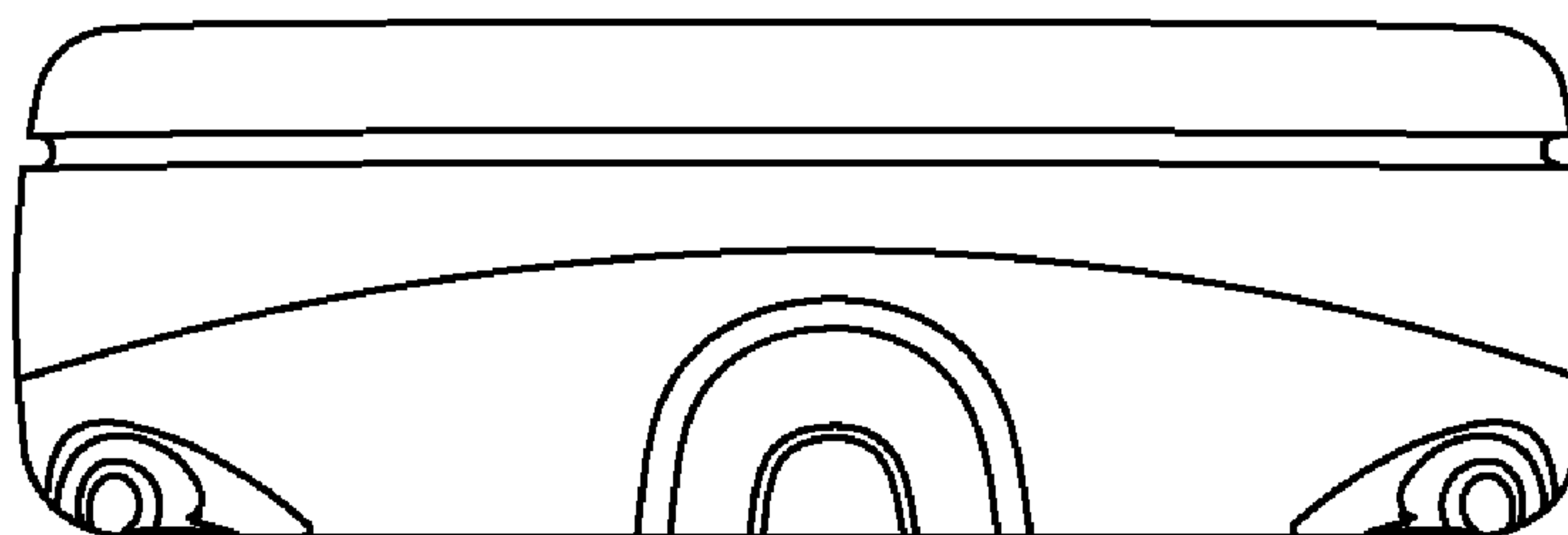
