**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and side perspective view of a first embodiment of ties arranged in a box showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view, the left side elevation view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top, front and side perspective view of the second embodiment of the ties arranged in a box, the front, rear, bottom and side views being the same as FIGS. 3, 4 and 5; and,

FIG. 7 is a top, front and side perspective view of the third embodiment of the ties arranged in a box, the front, rear, bottom and side views being the same as FIGS. 3, 4 and 5.

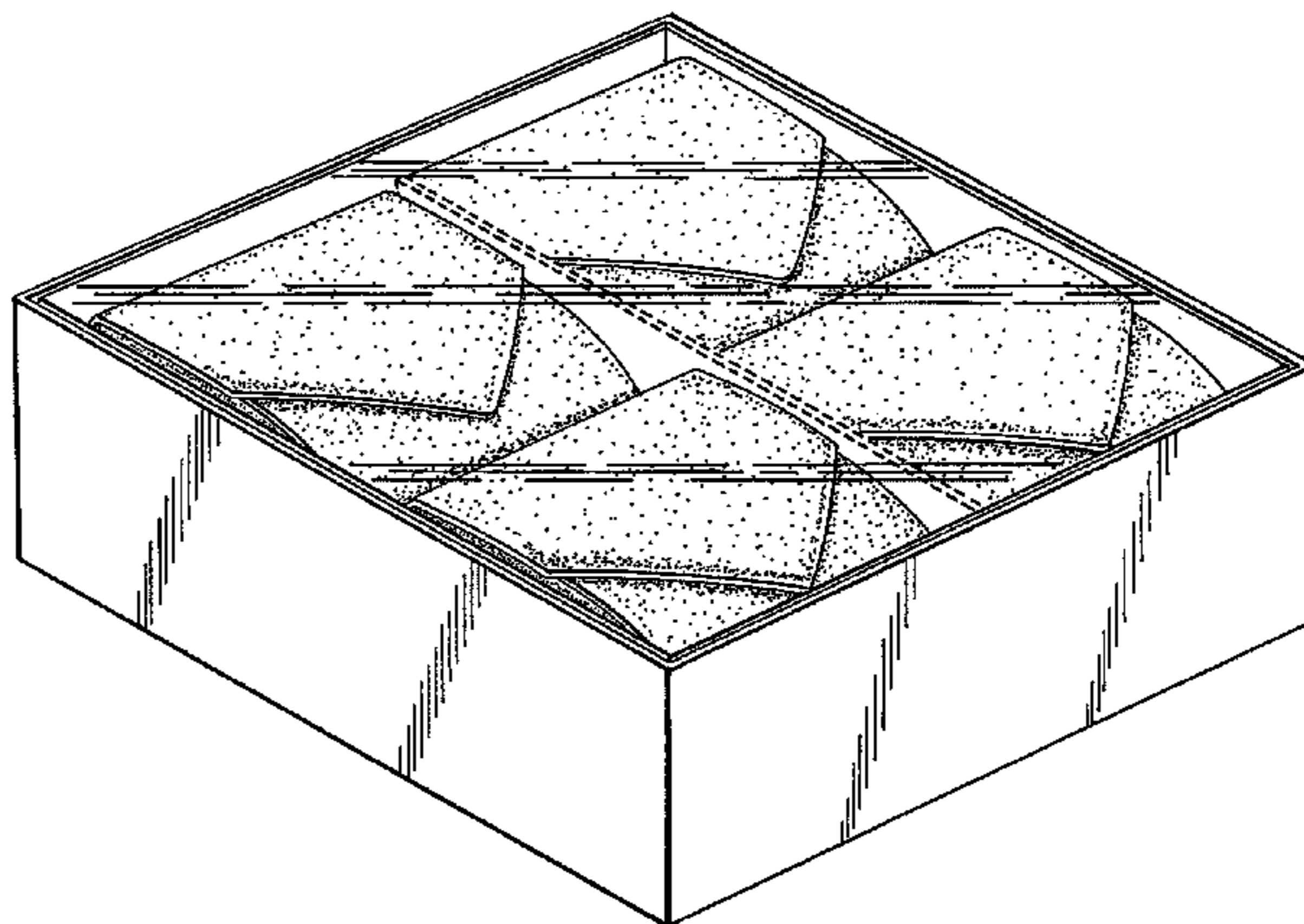
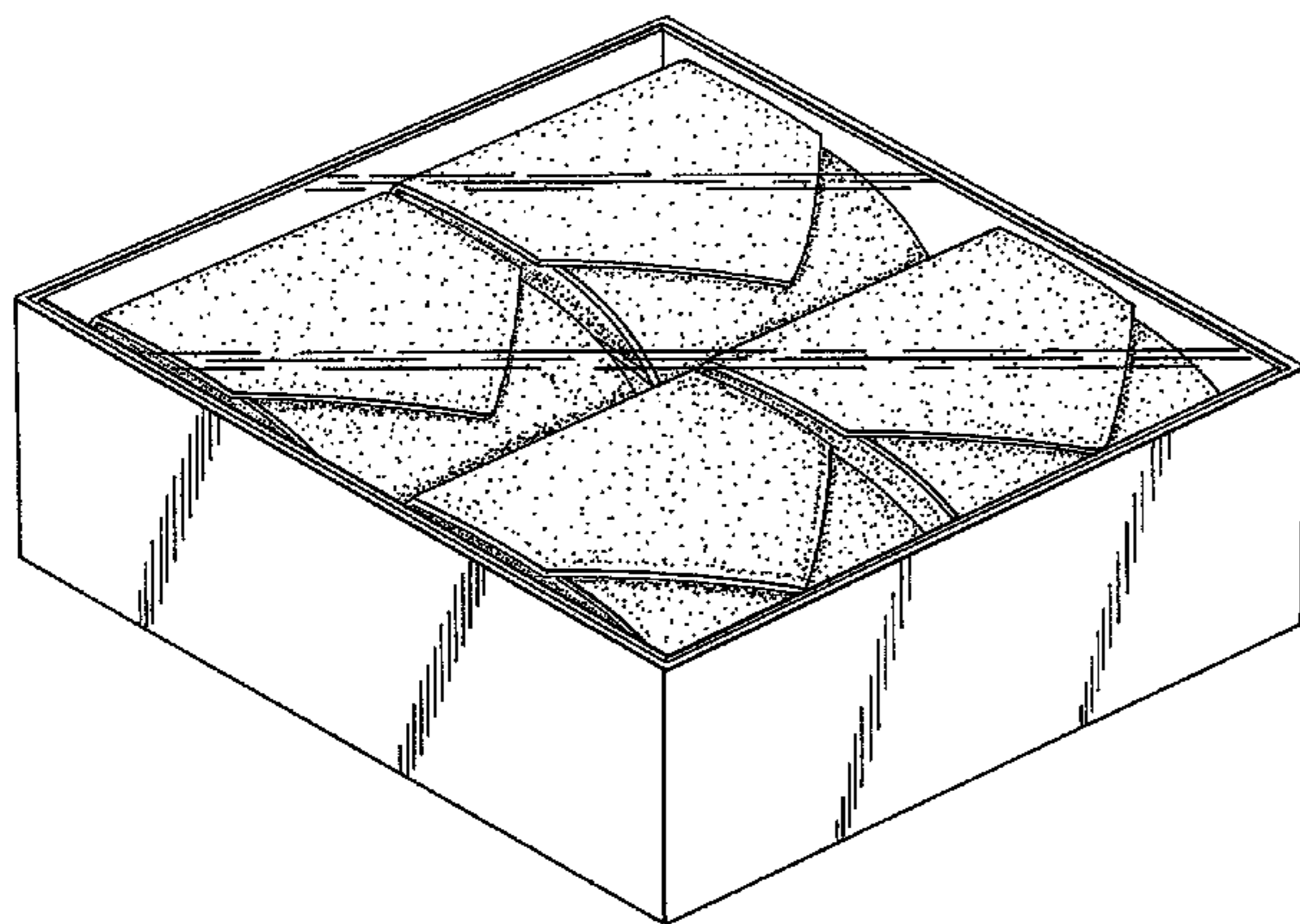

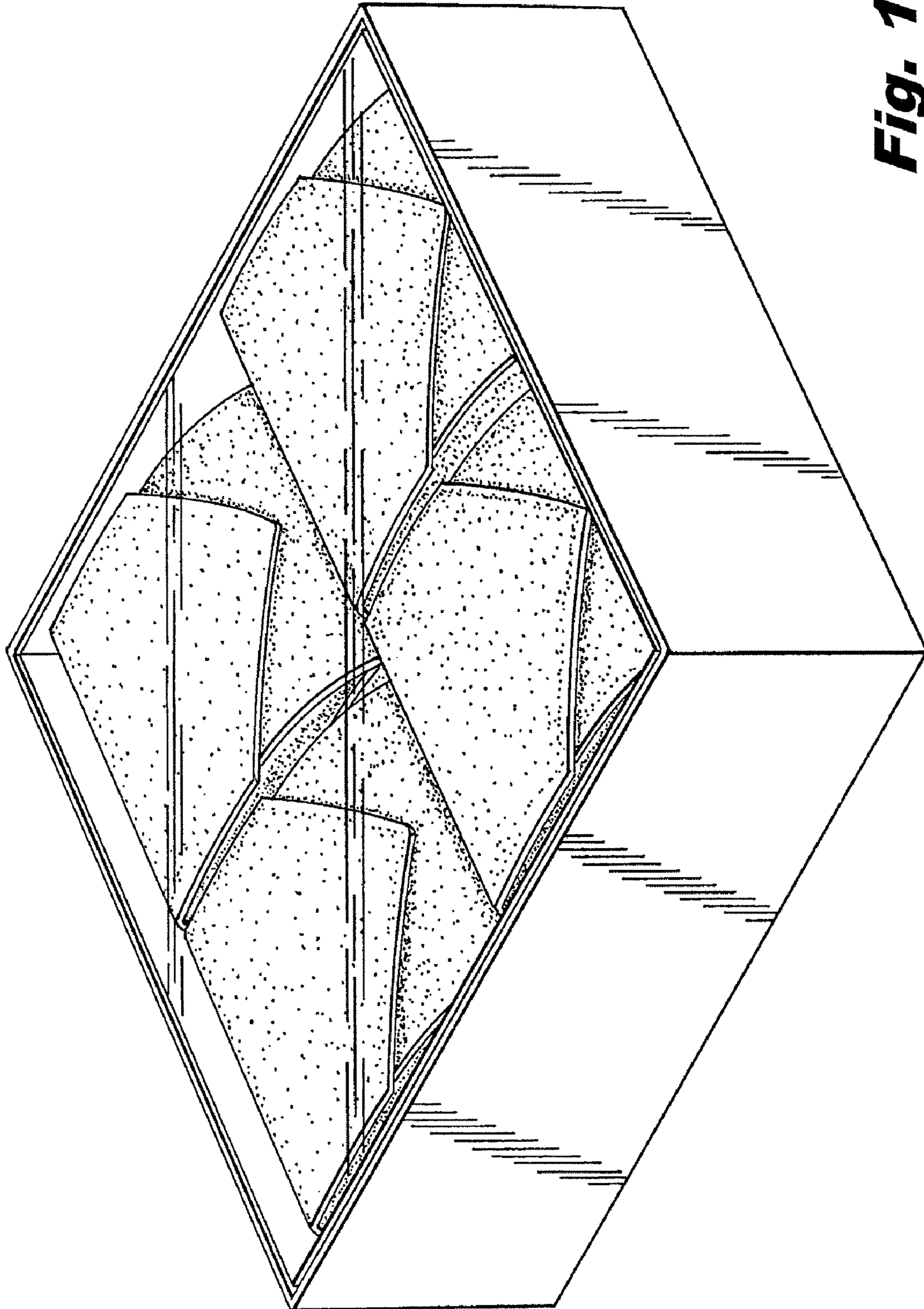

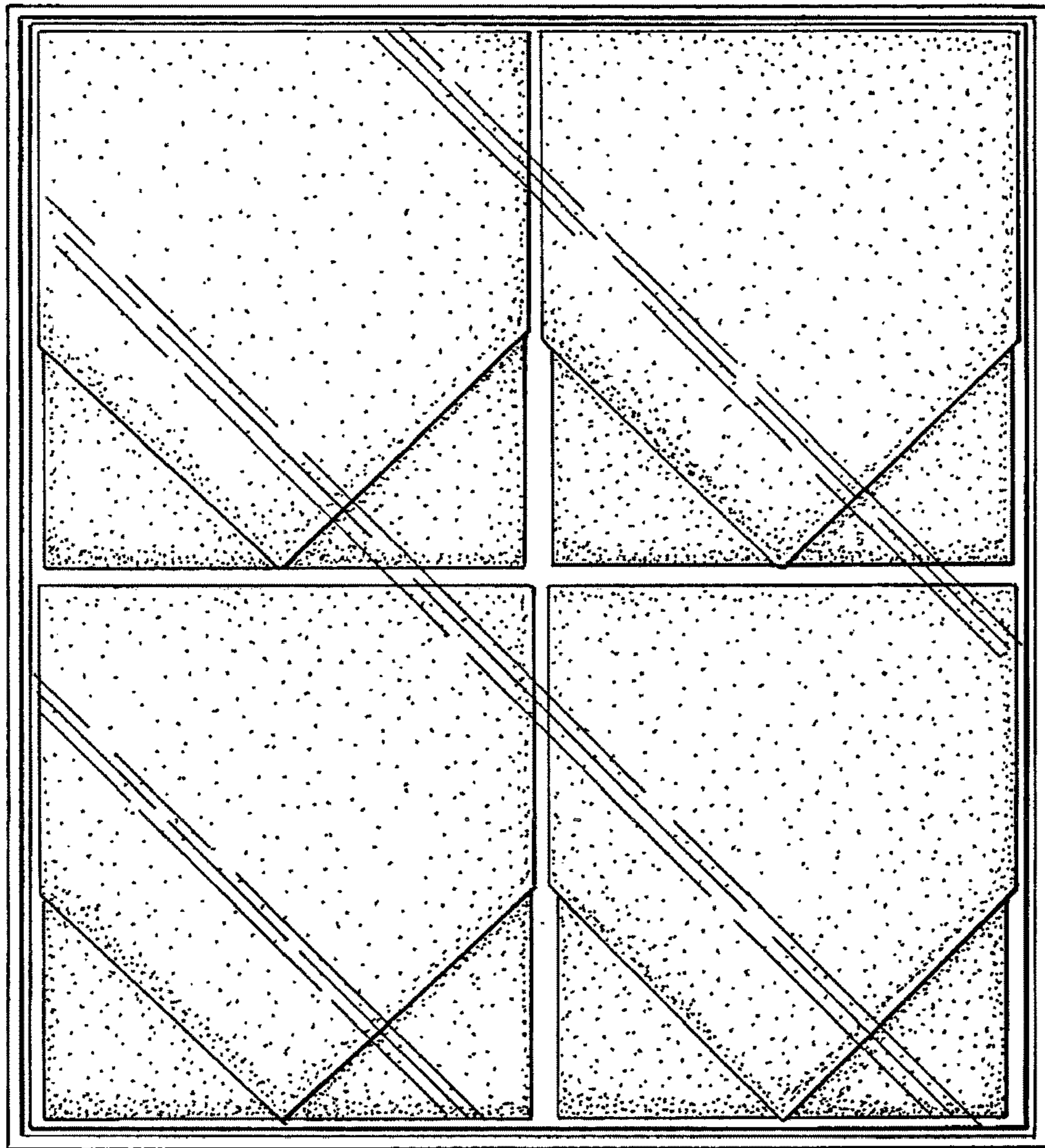

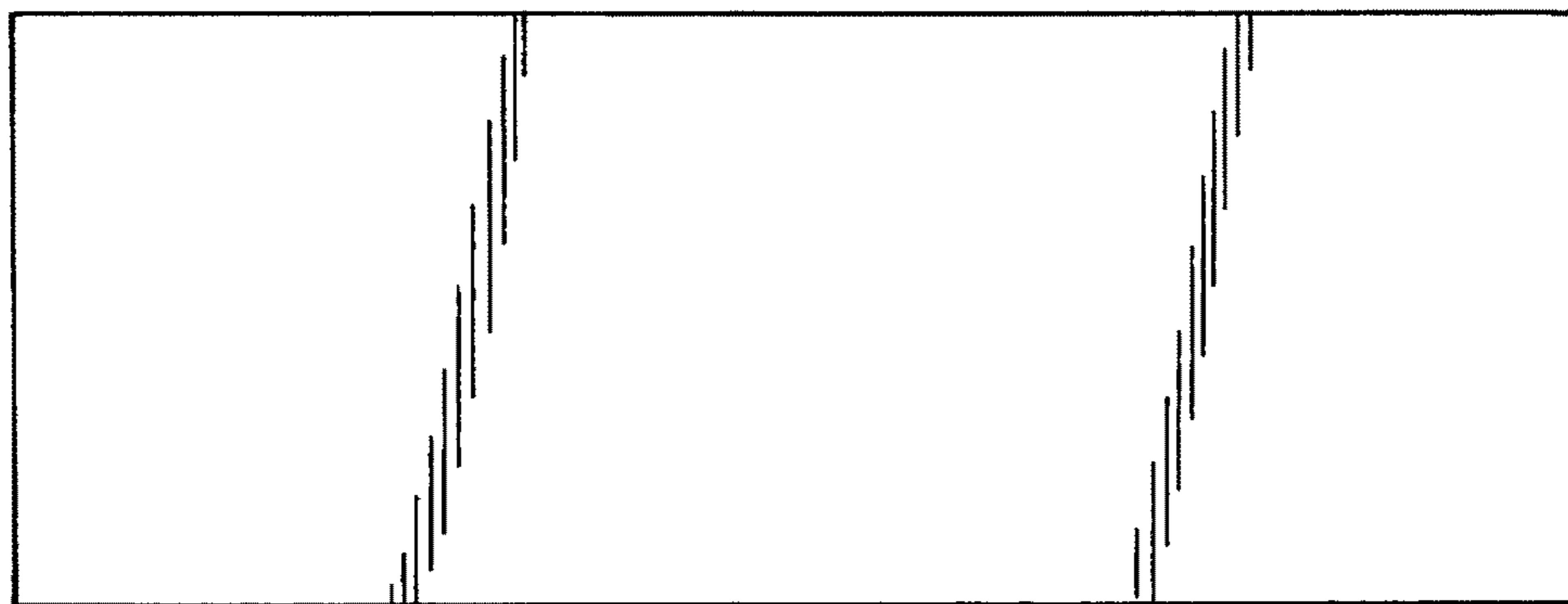




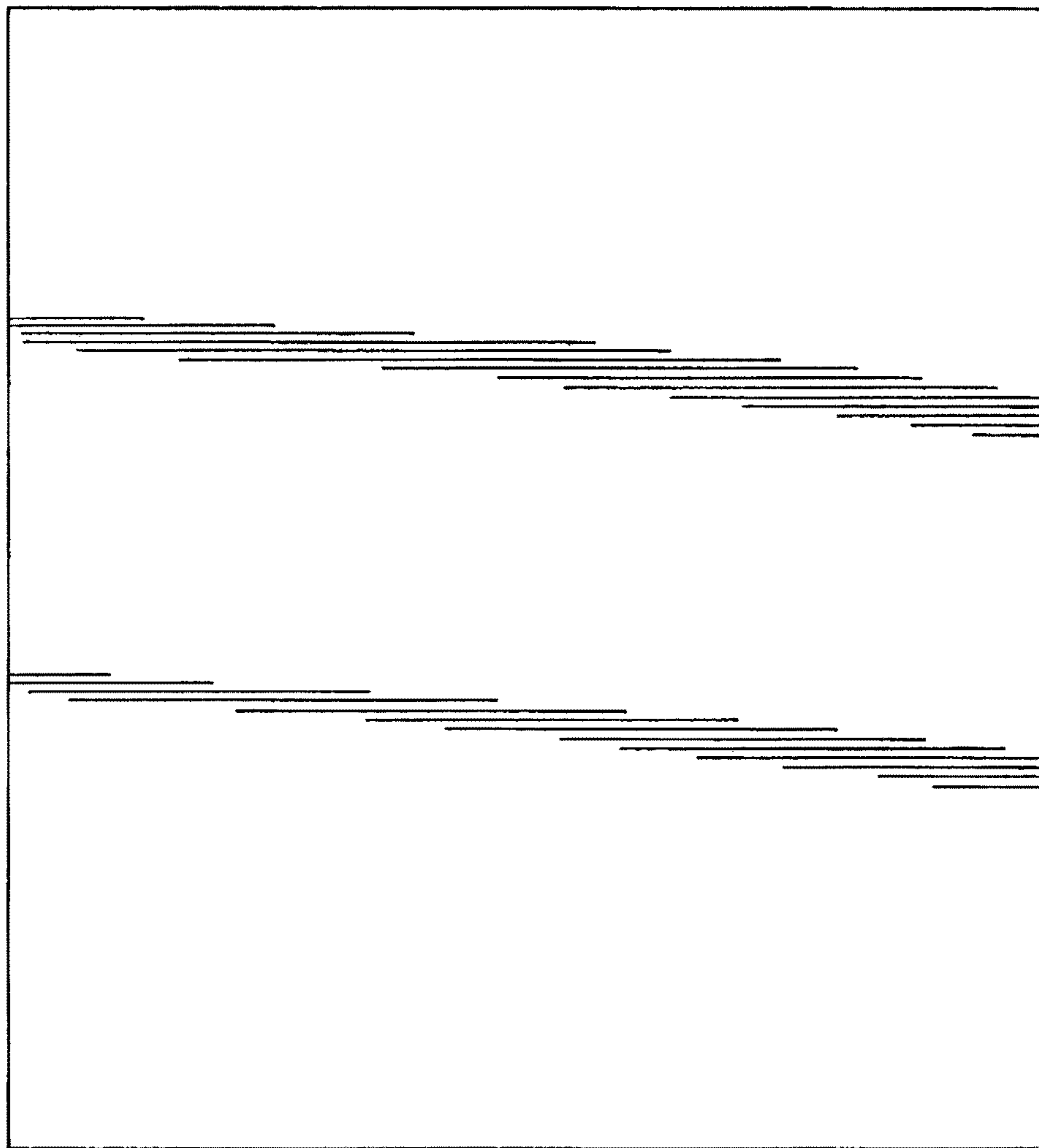

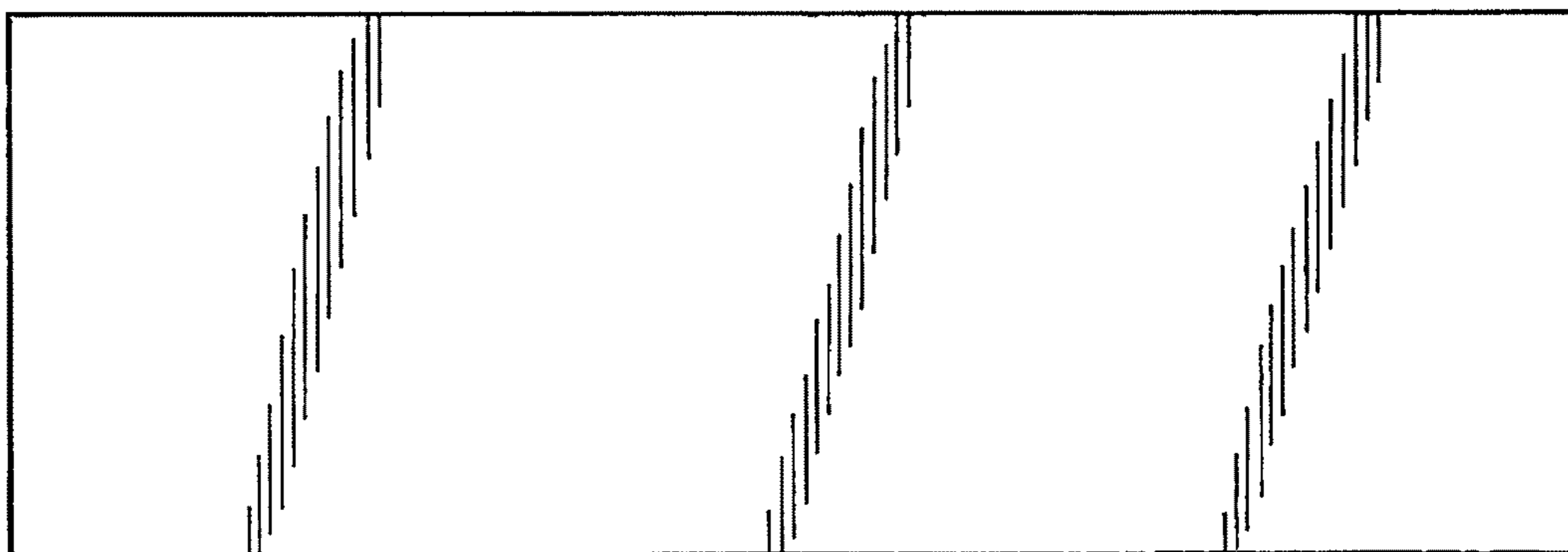

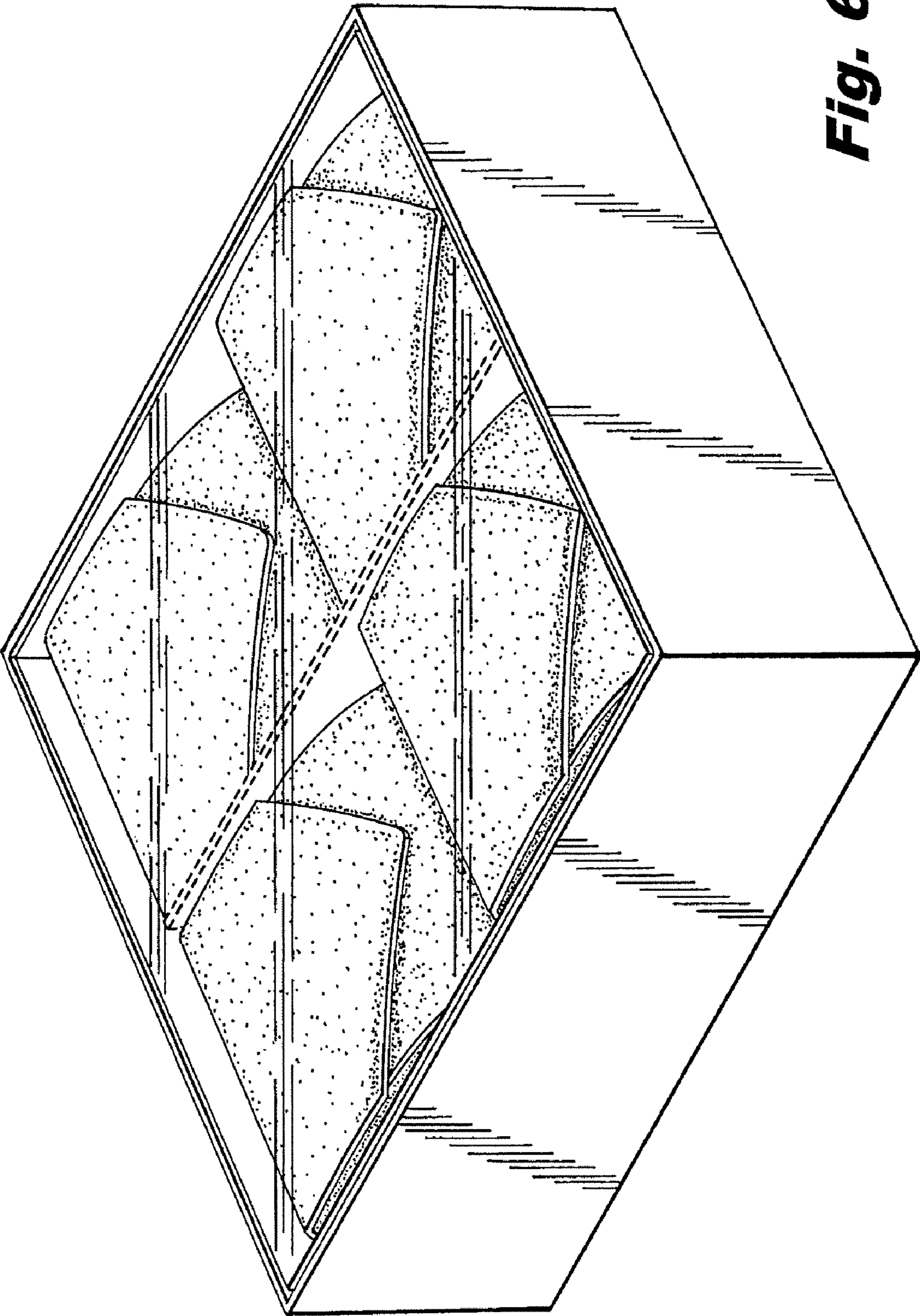

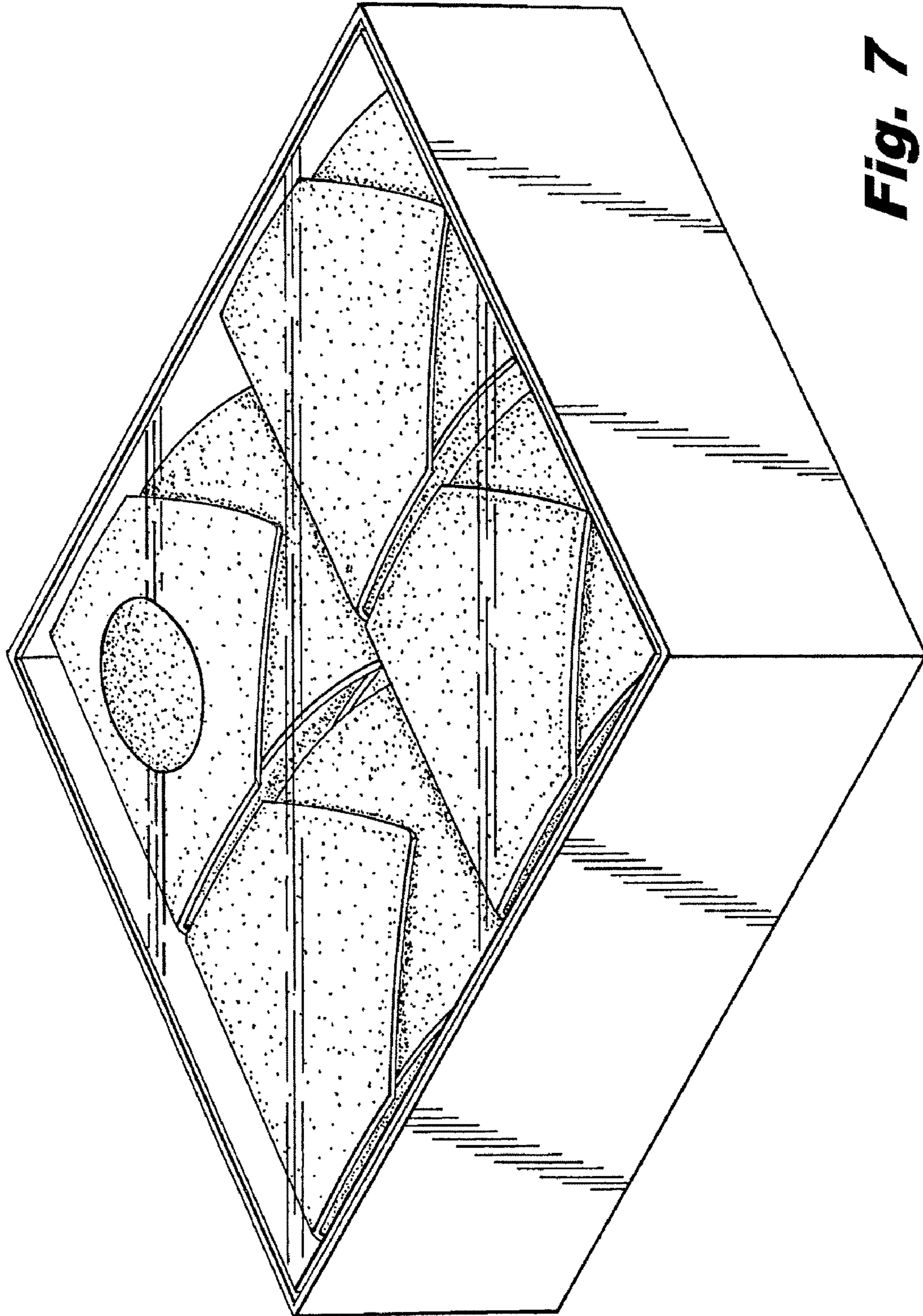
