(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a tire, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of tire according to an embodiment of the design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the tire depicted in FIG. 1;

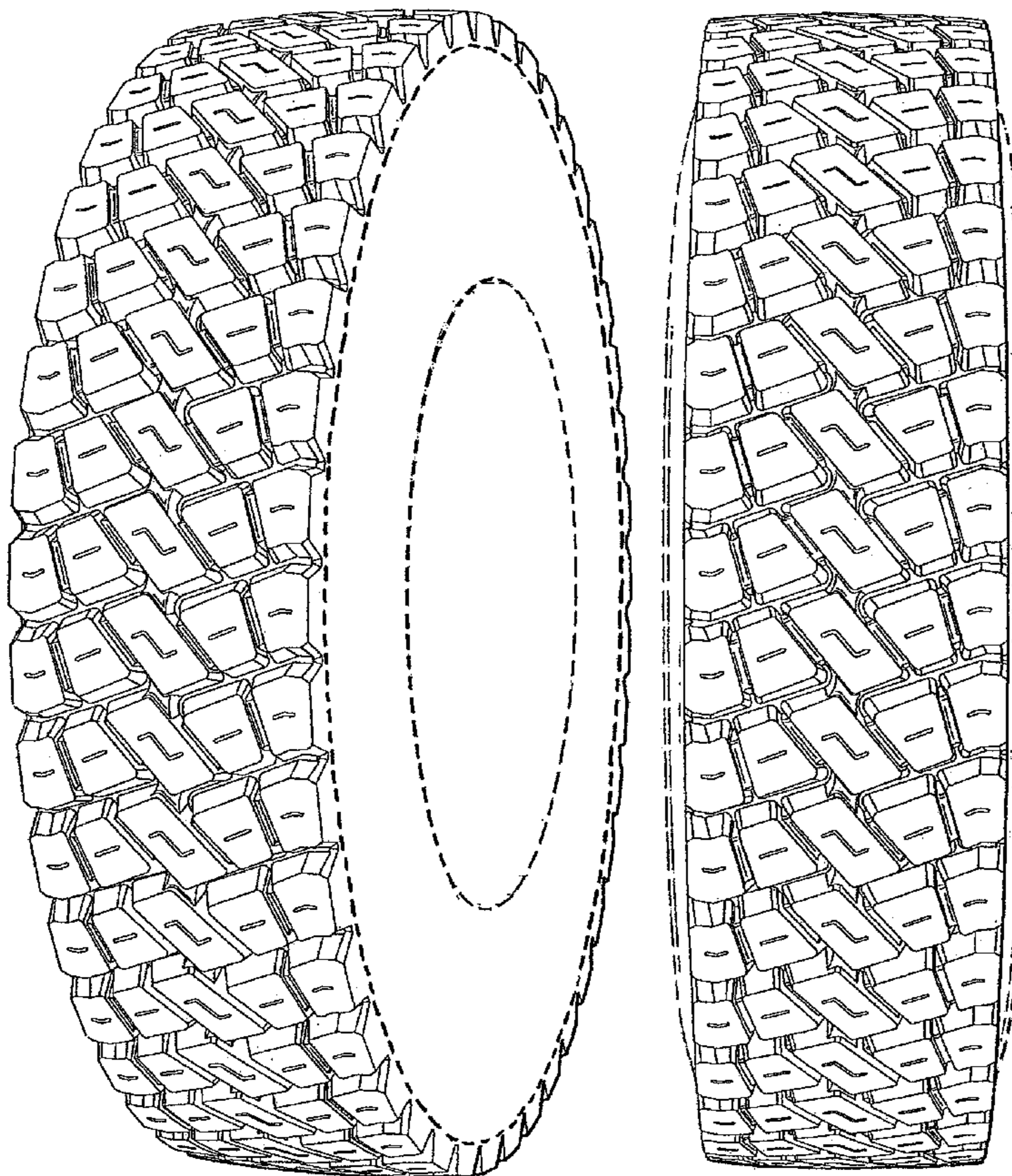
FIG. 3 is a side view of the tire depicted in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged front fragmentary view depicted in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 5 is an enlarged partial fragmentary view of that depicted in FIG. 4.

In FIGS. 1-3, the broken lines defining the sidewall, inner bead and the peripheral boundary between the claimed tire tread and the unclaimed sidewall depict environmental subject matter that forms no part of the claimed design.

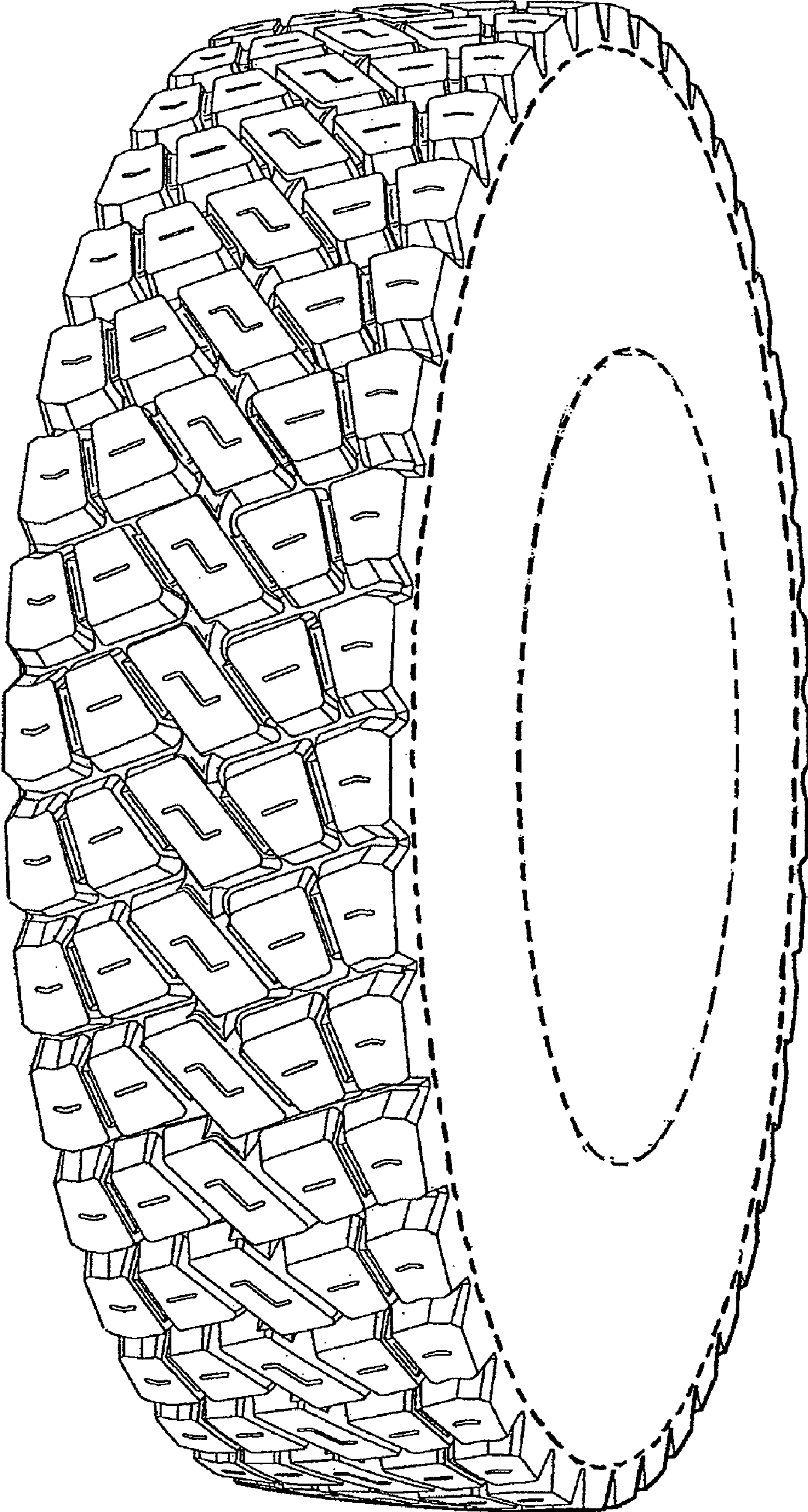

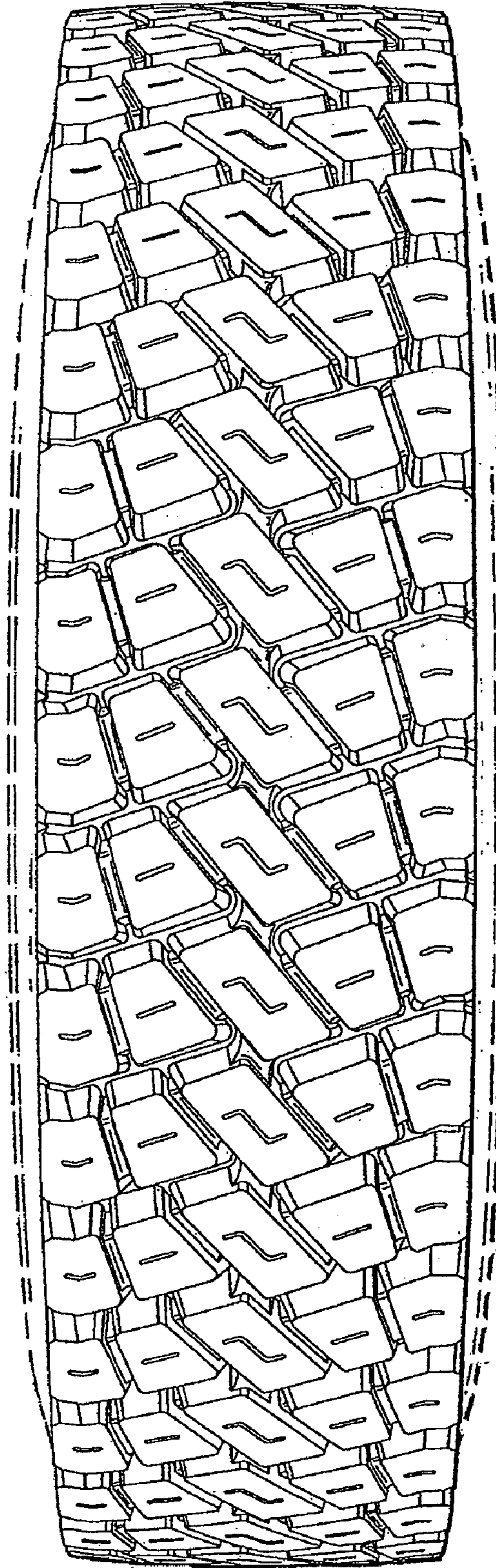

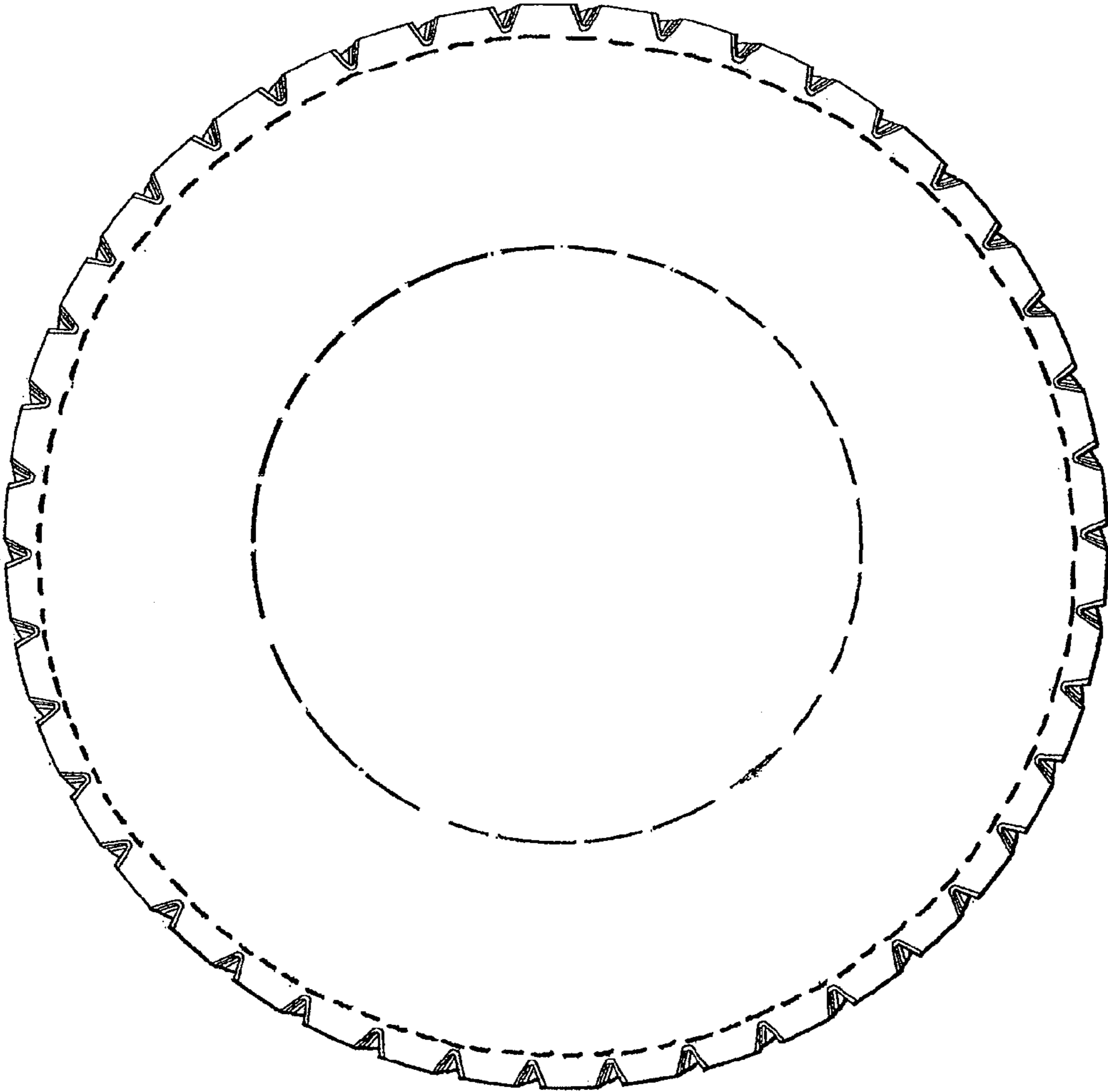

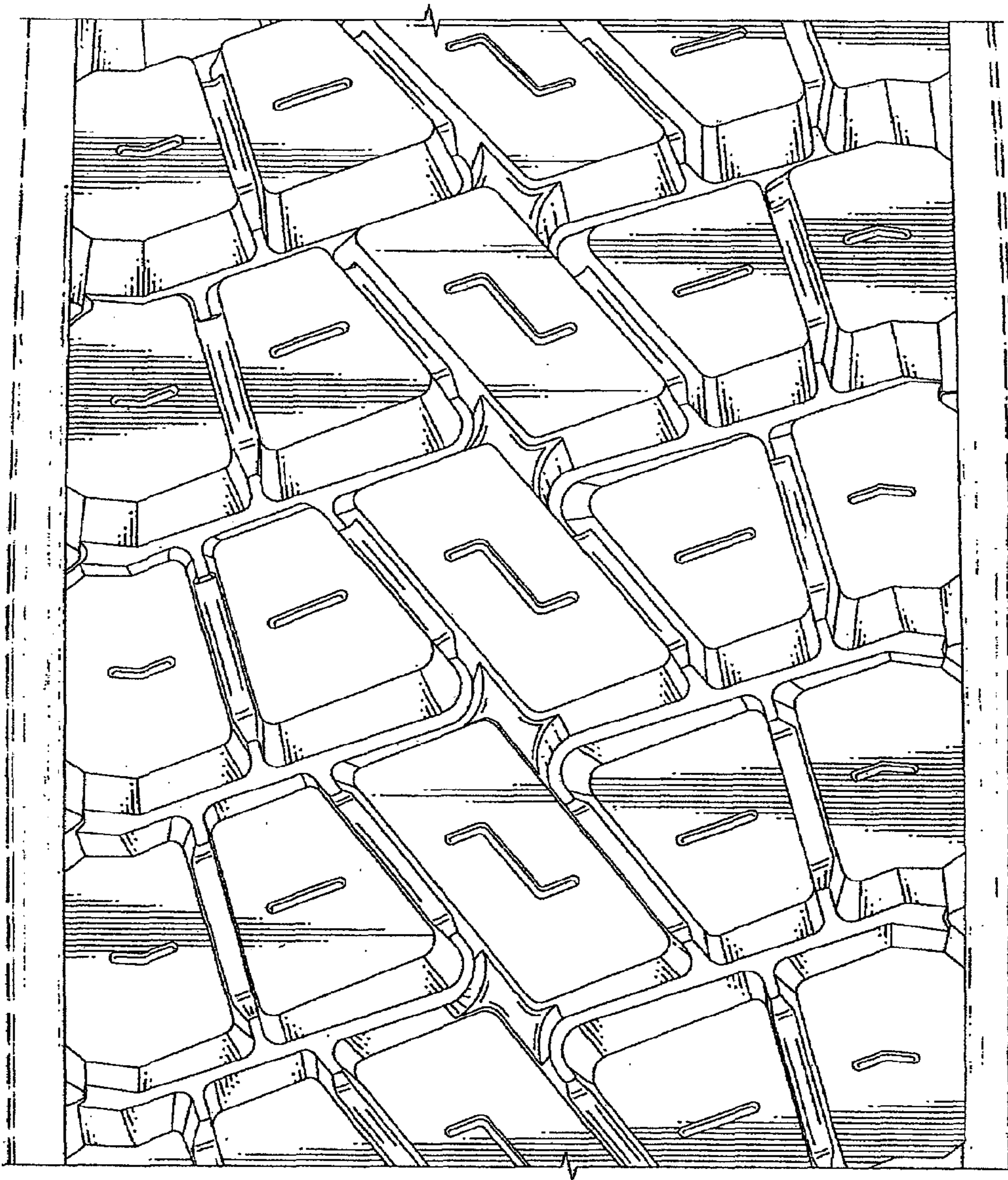

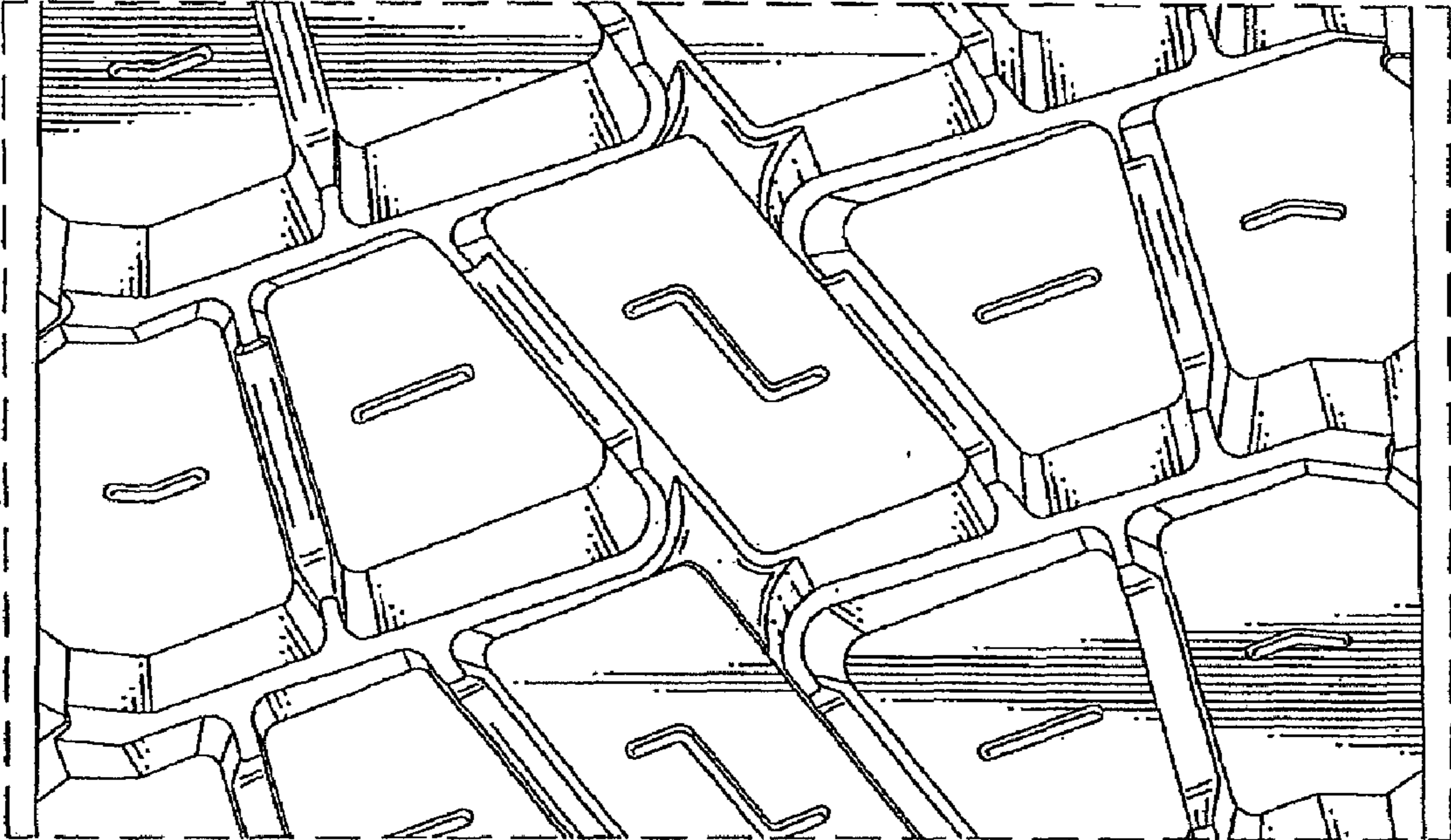
