FIG. 11 is a right side view of the telephone of FIG. 8.

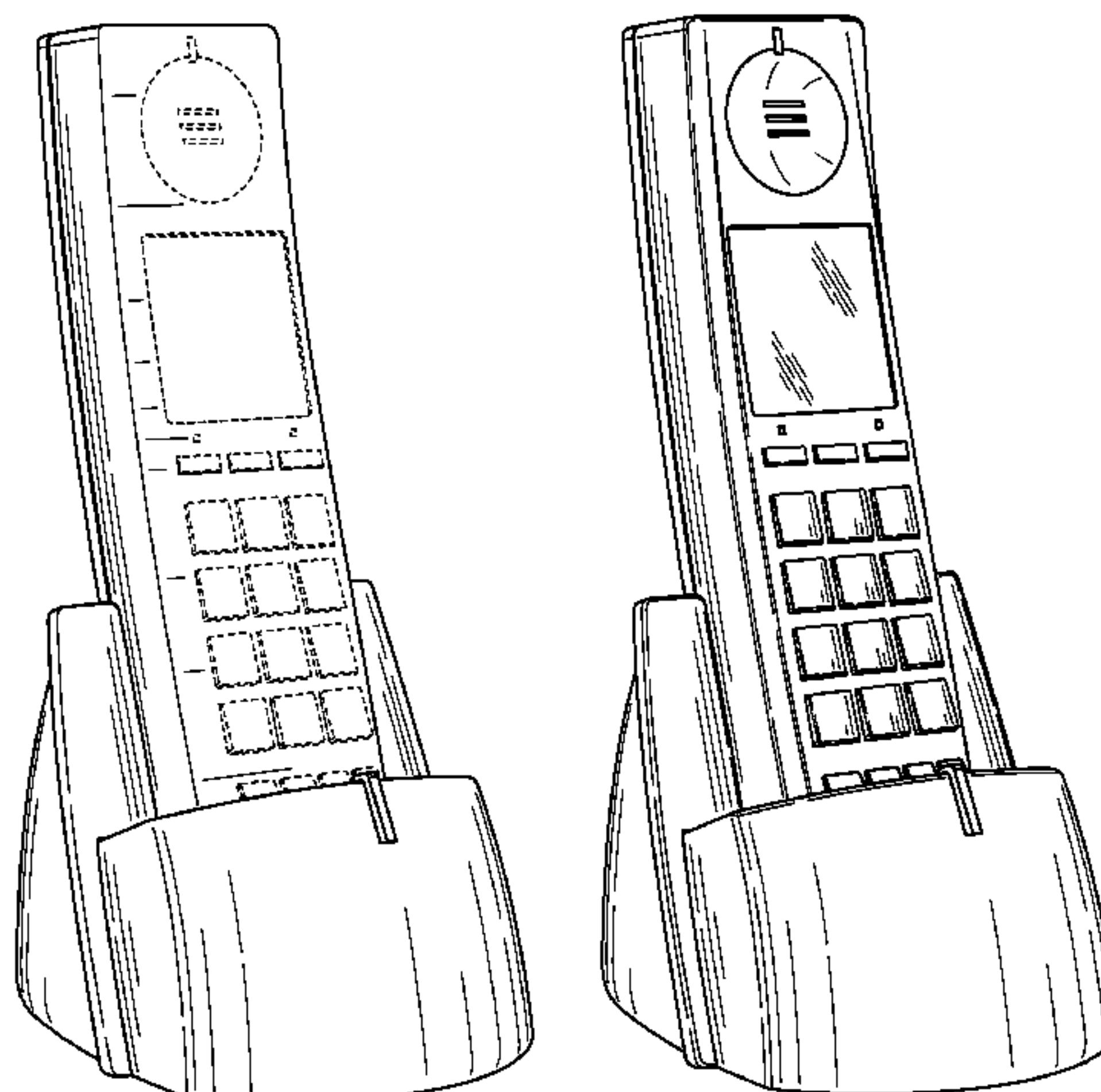
FIG. 12 is a left side view of the telephone of FIG. 8.

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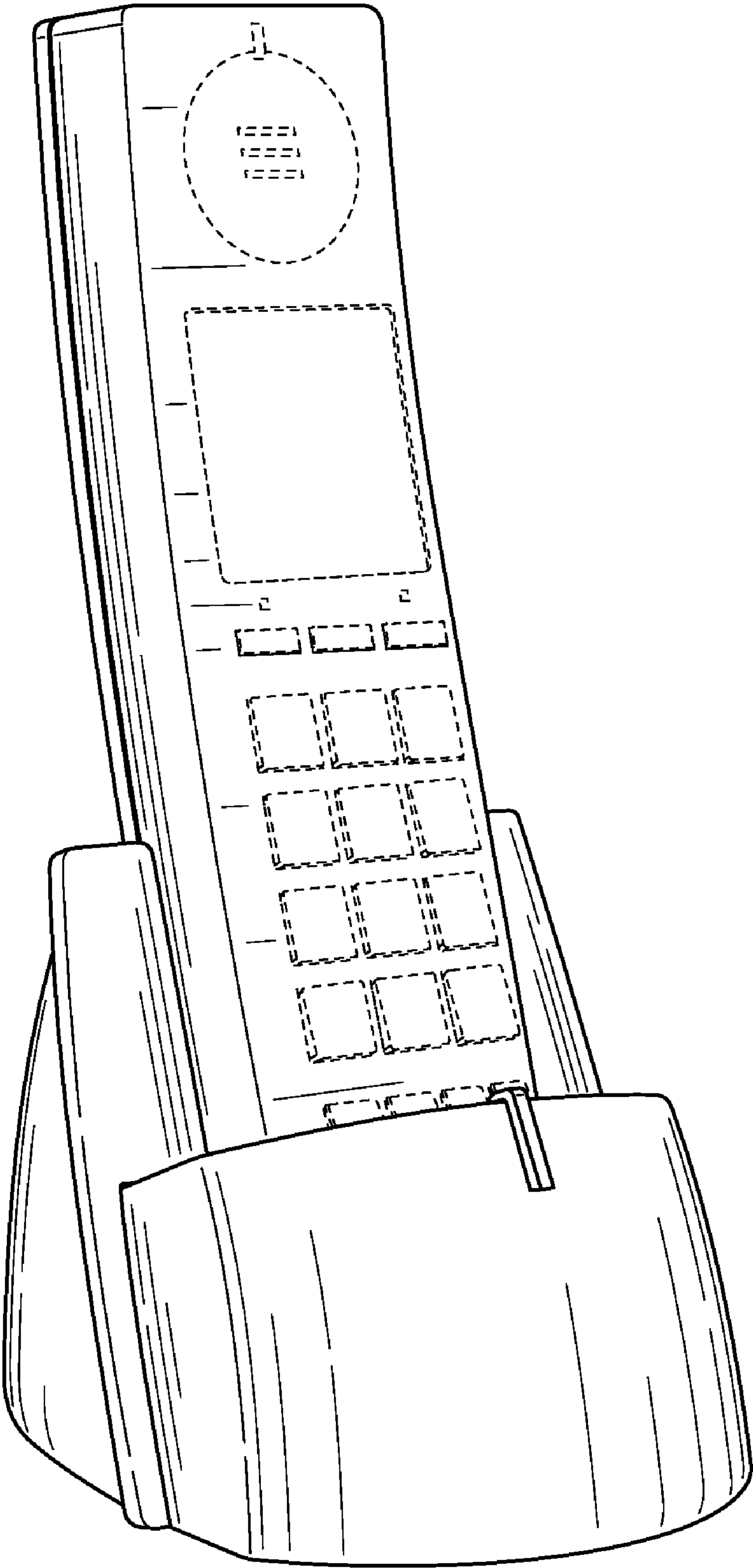

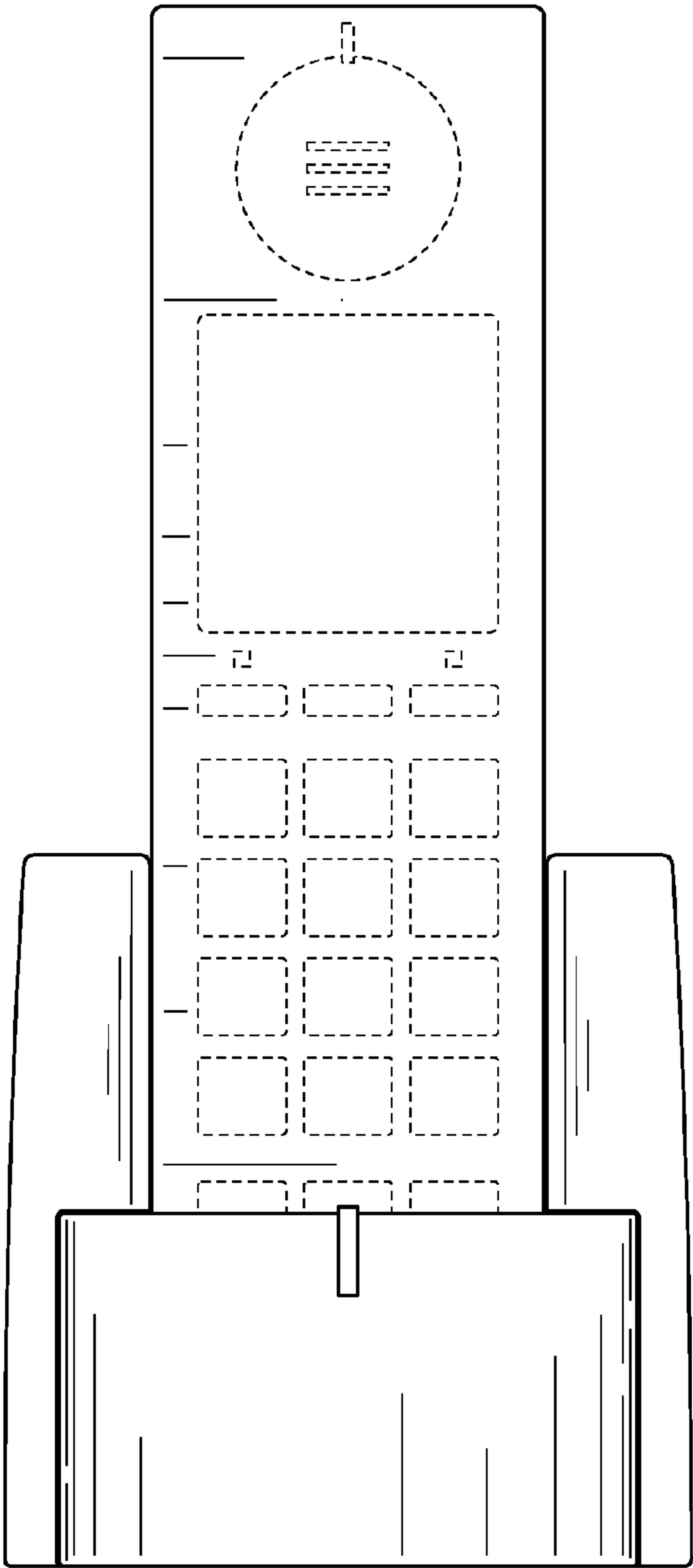

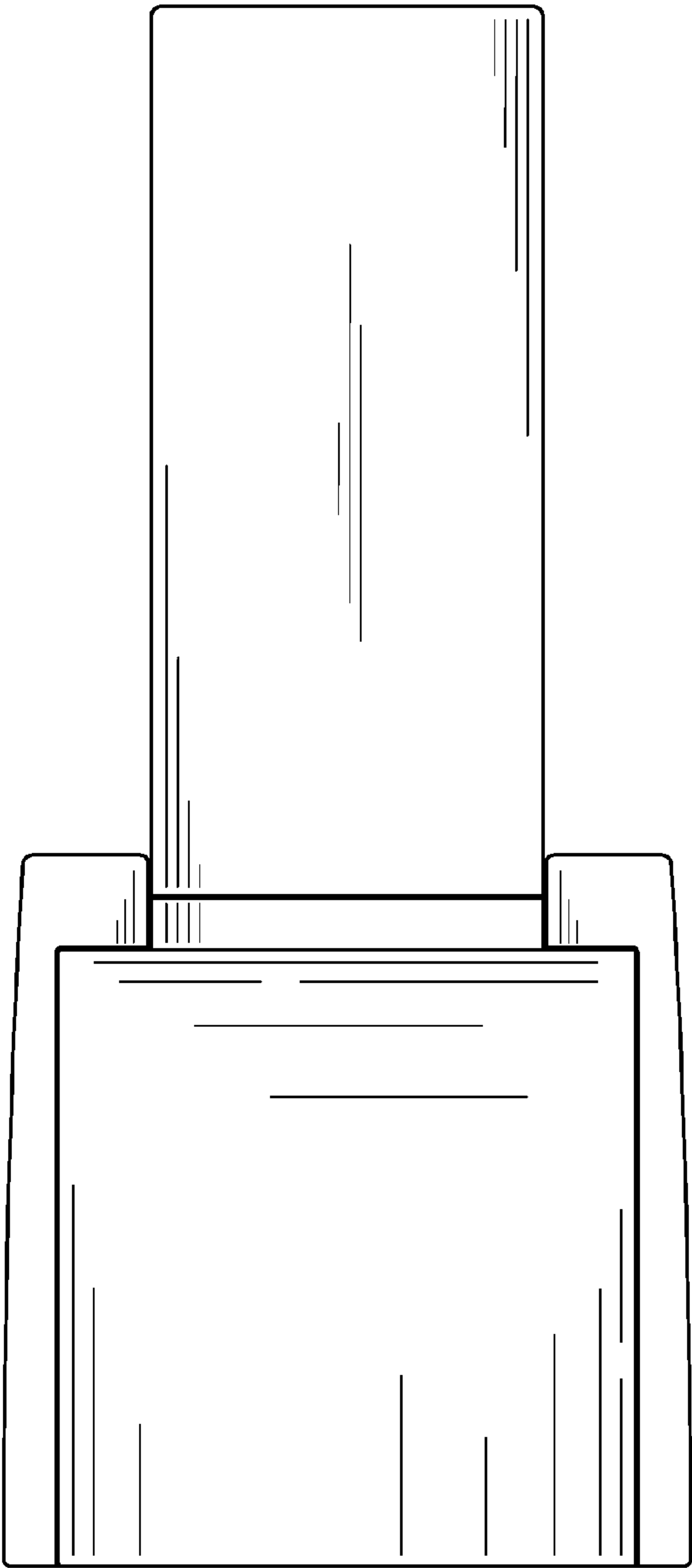

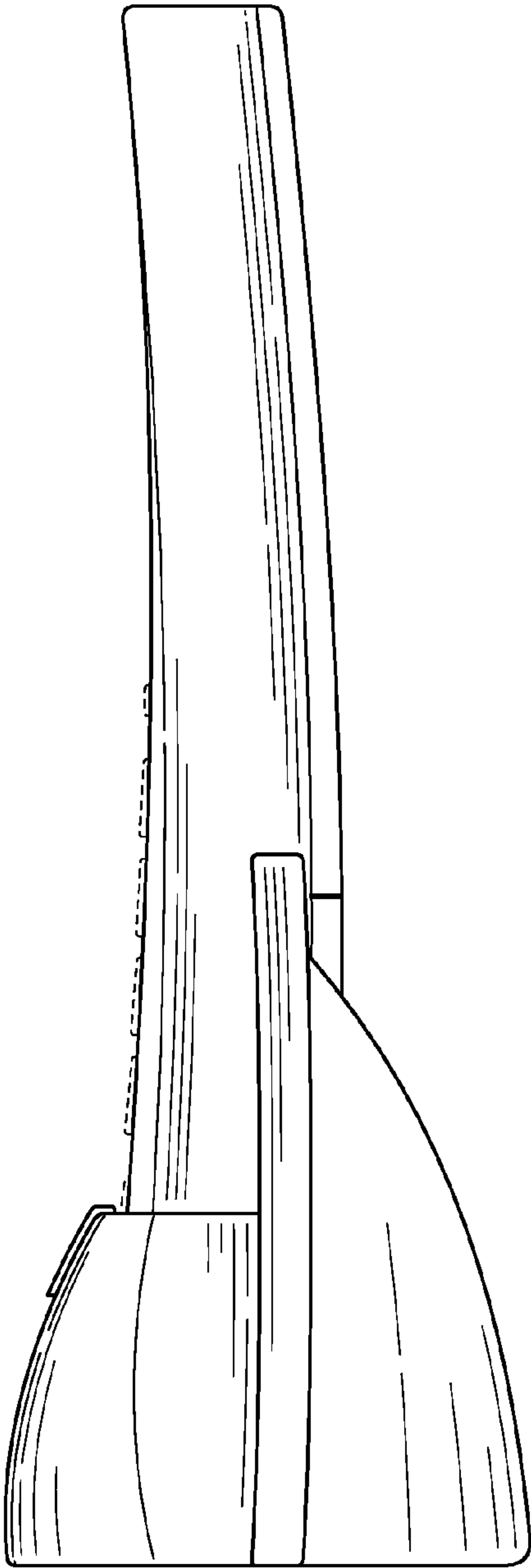

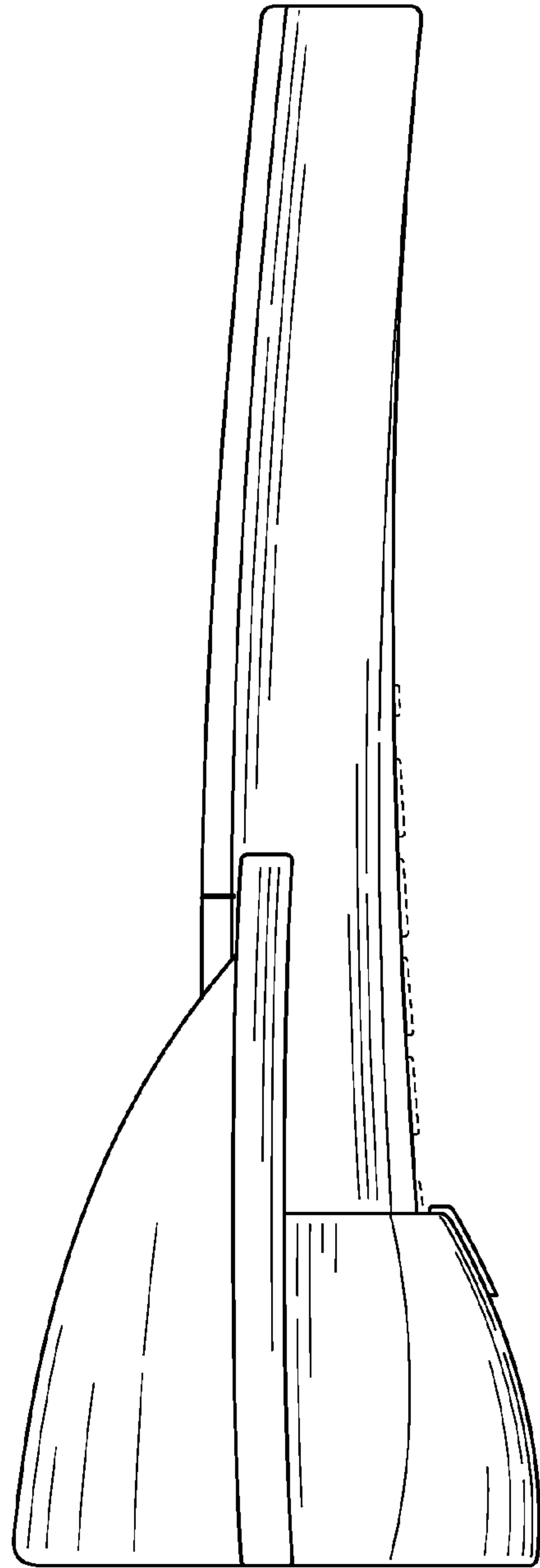

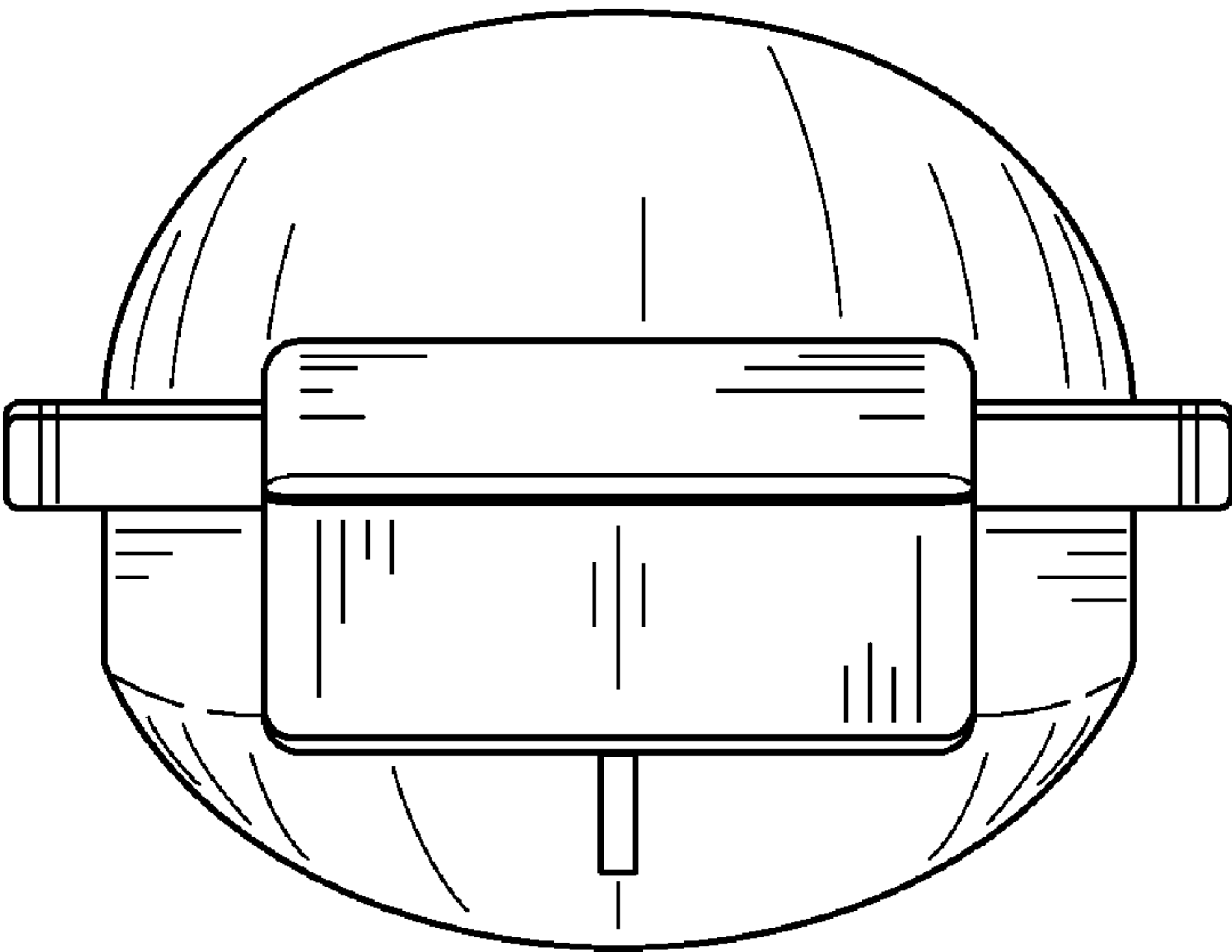

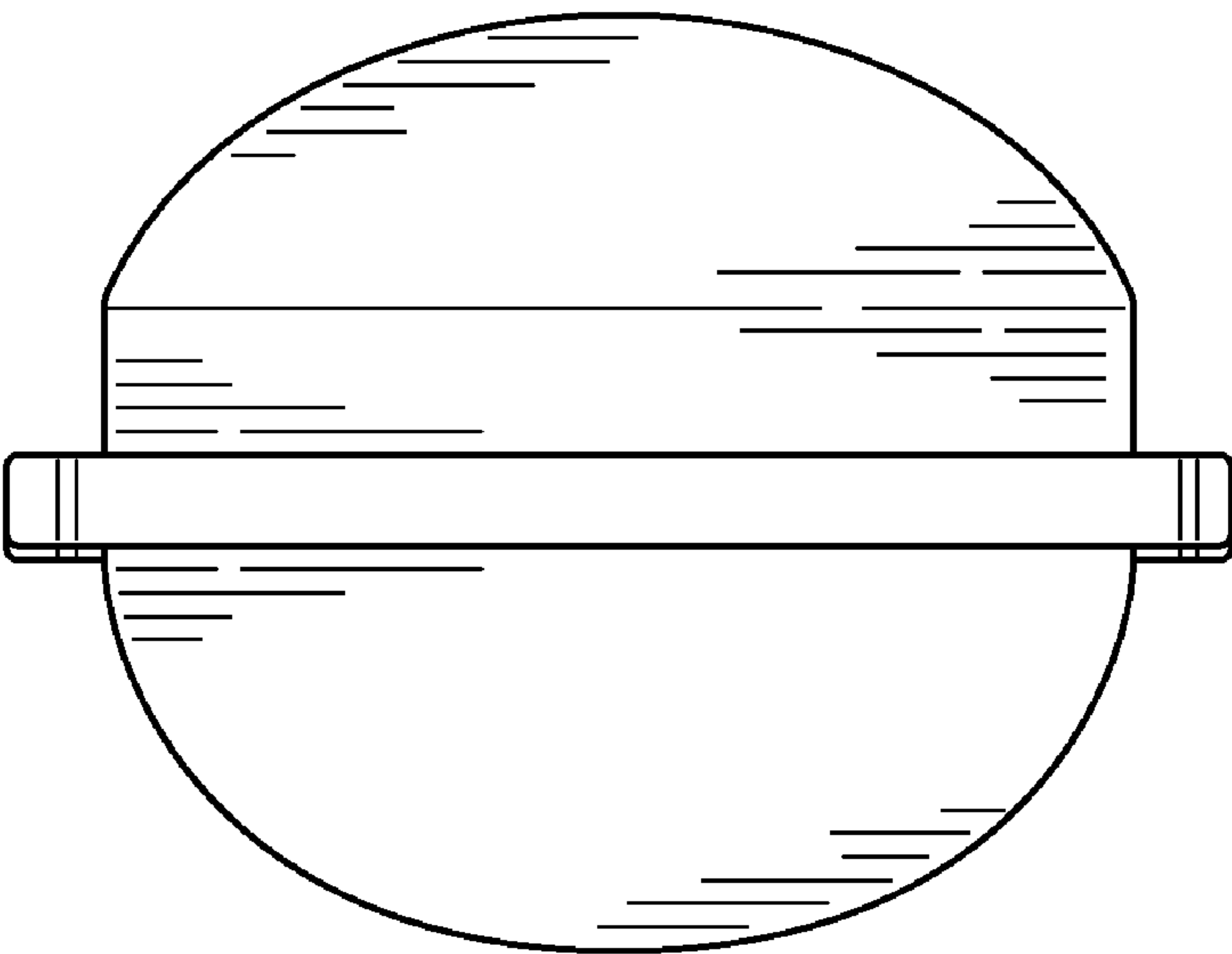

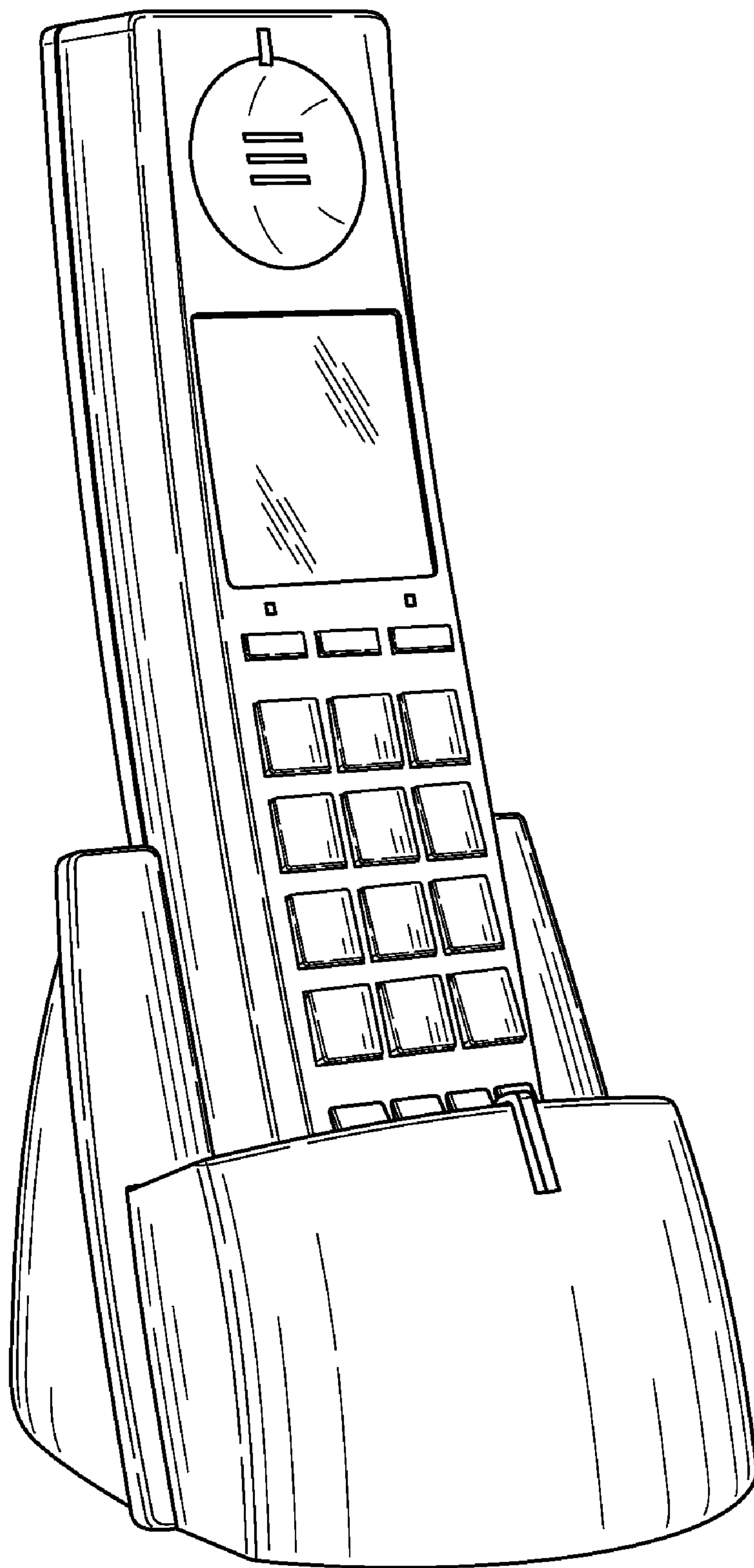

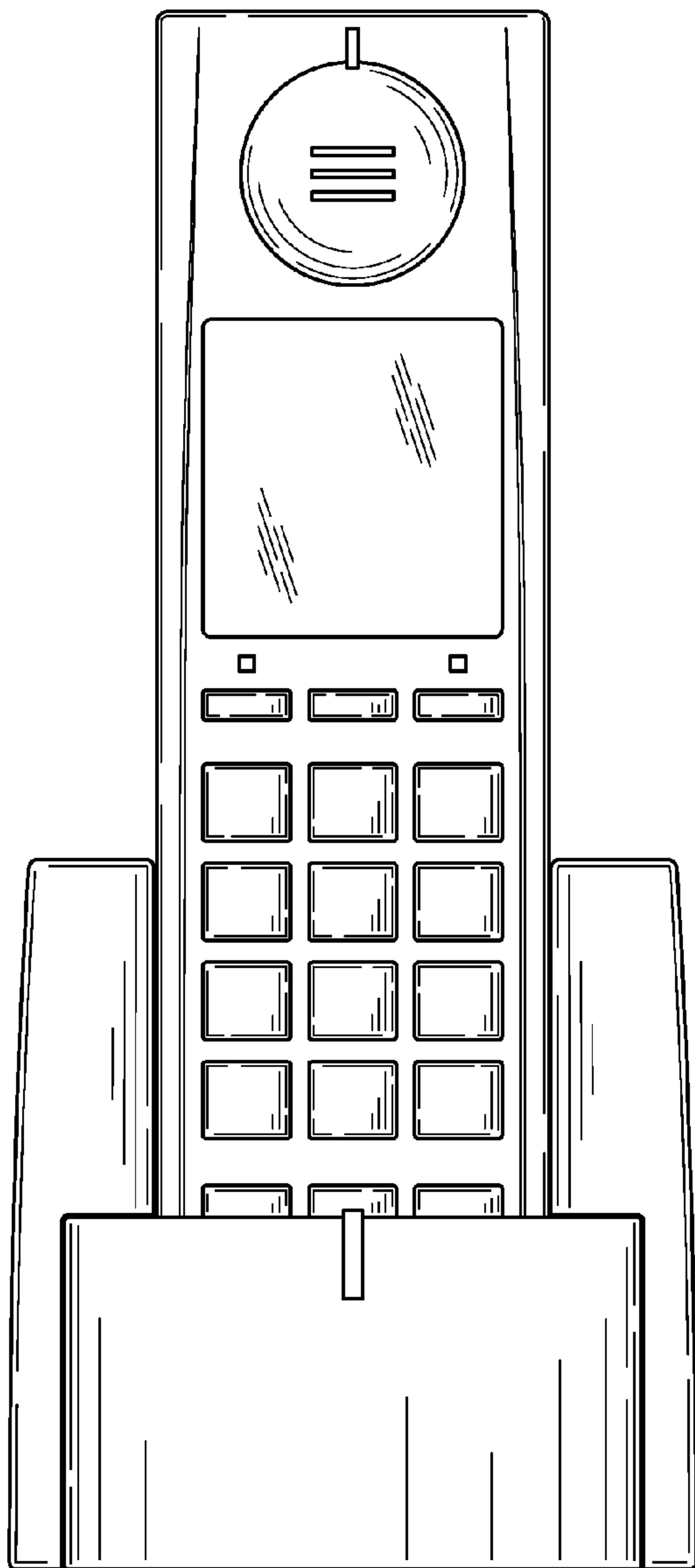

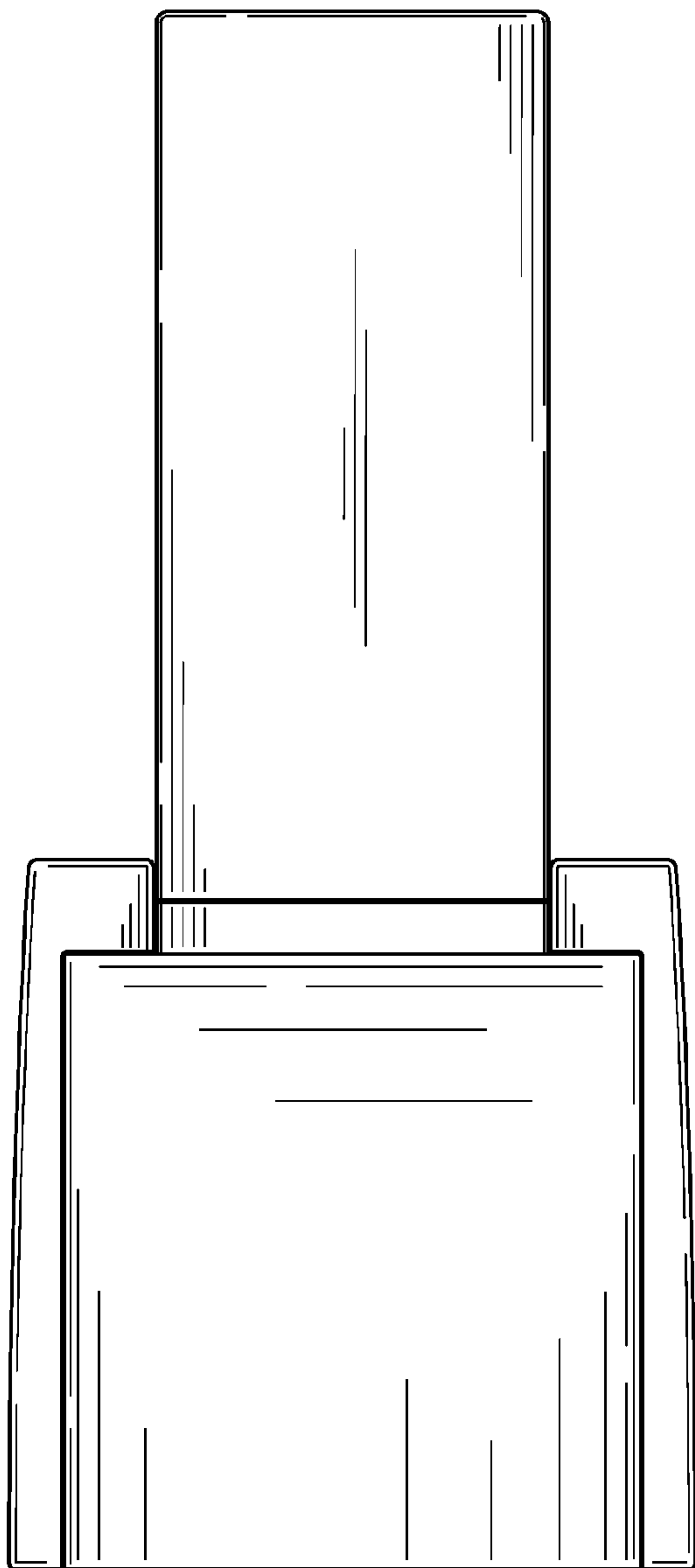

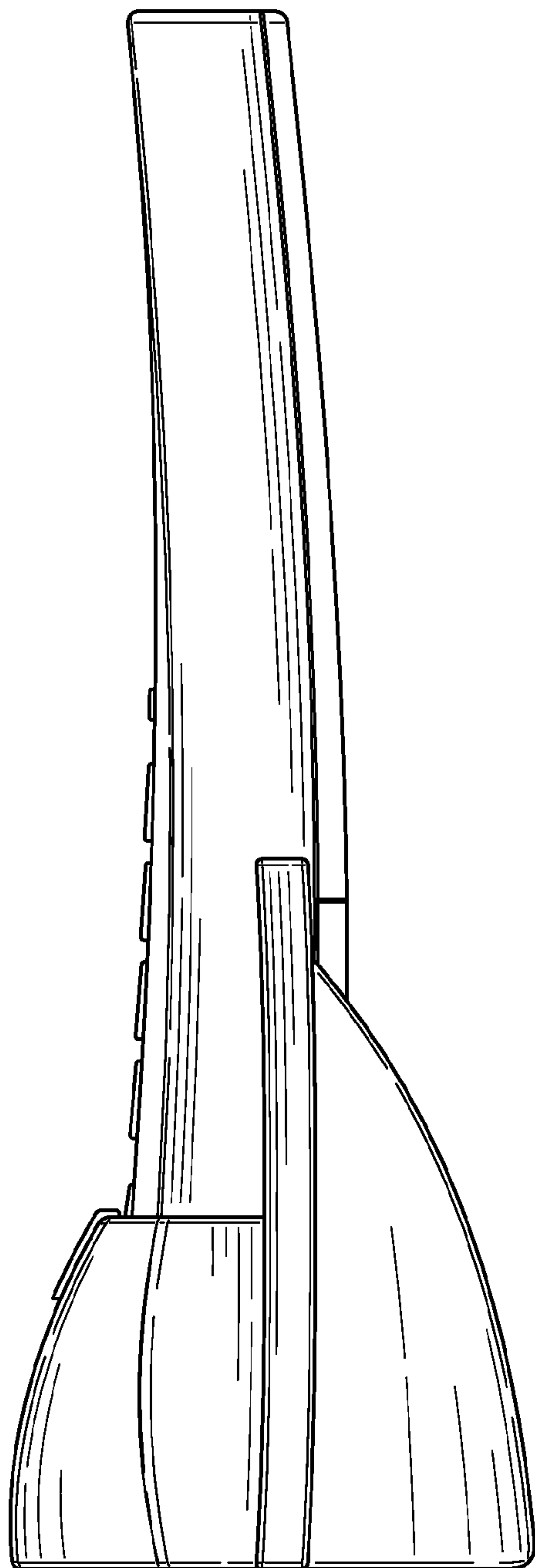

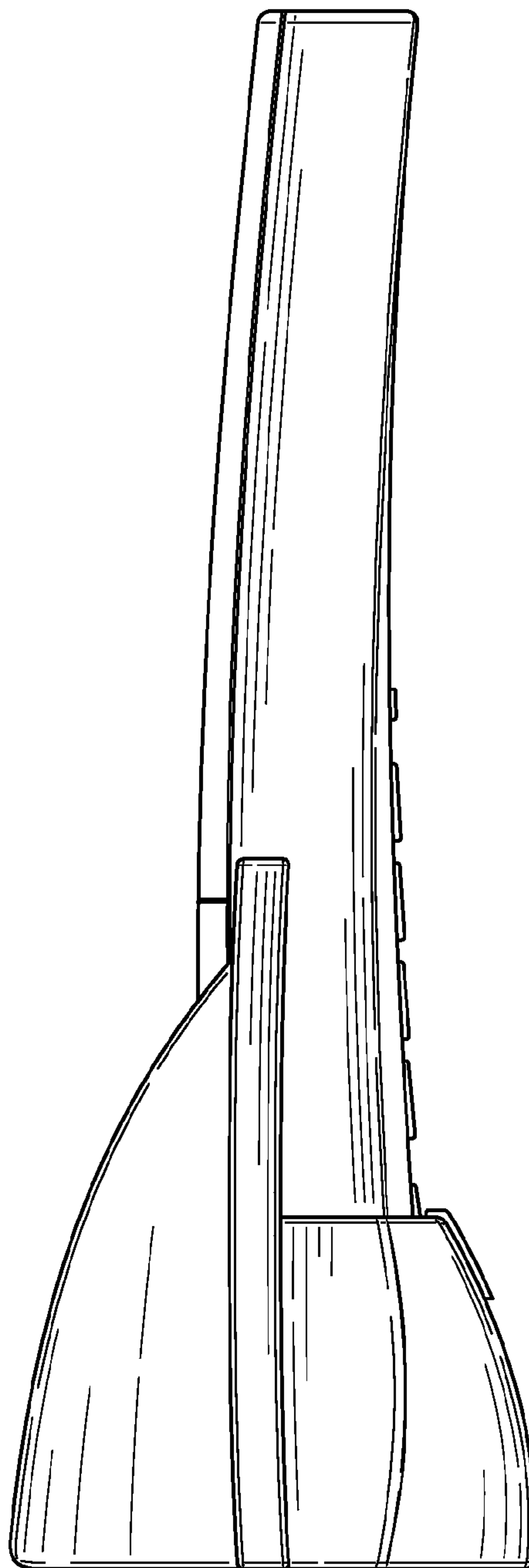

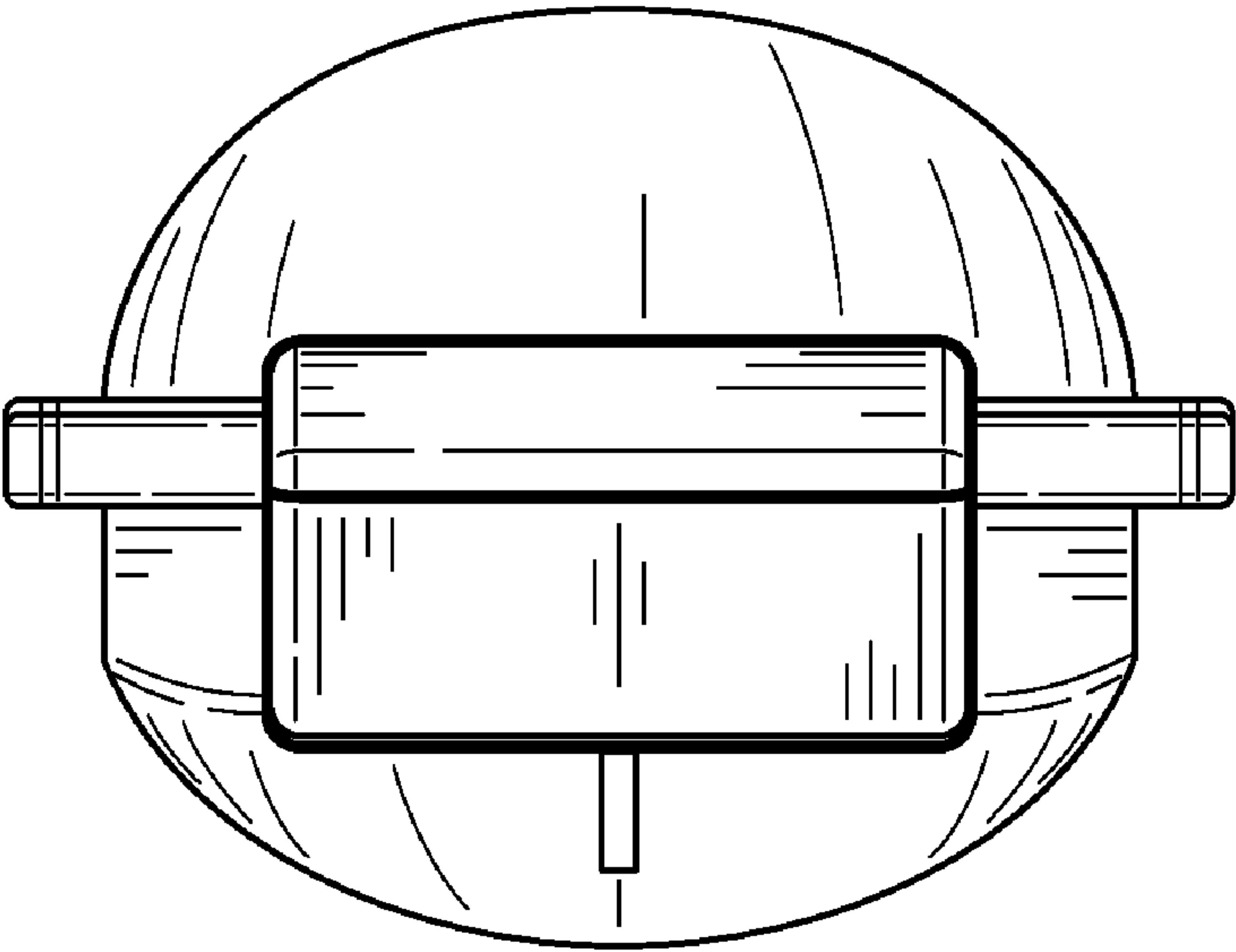

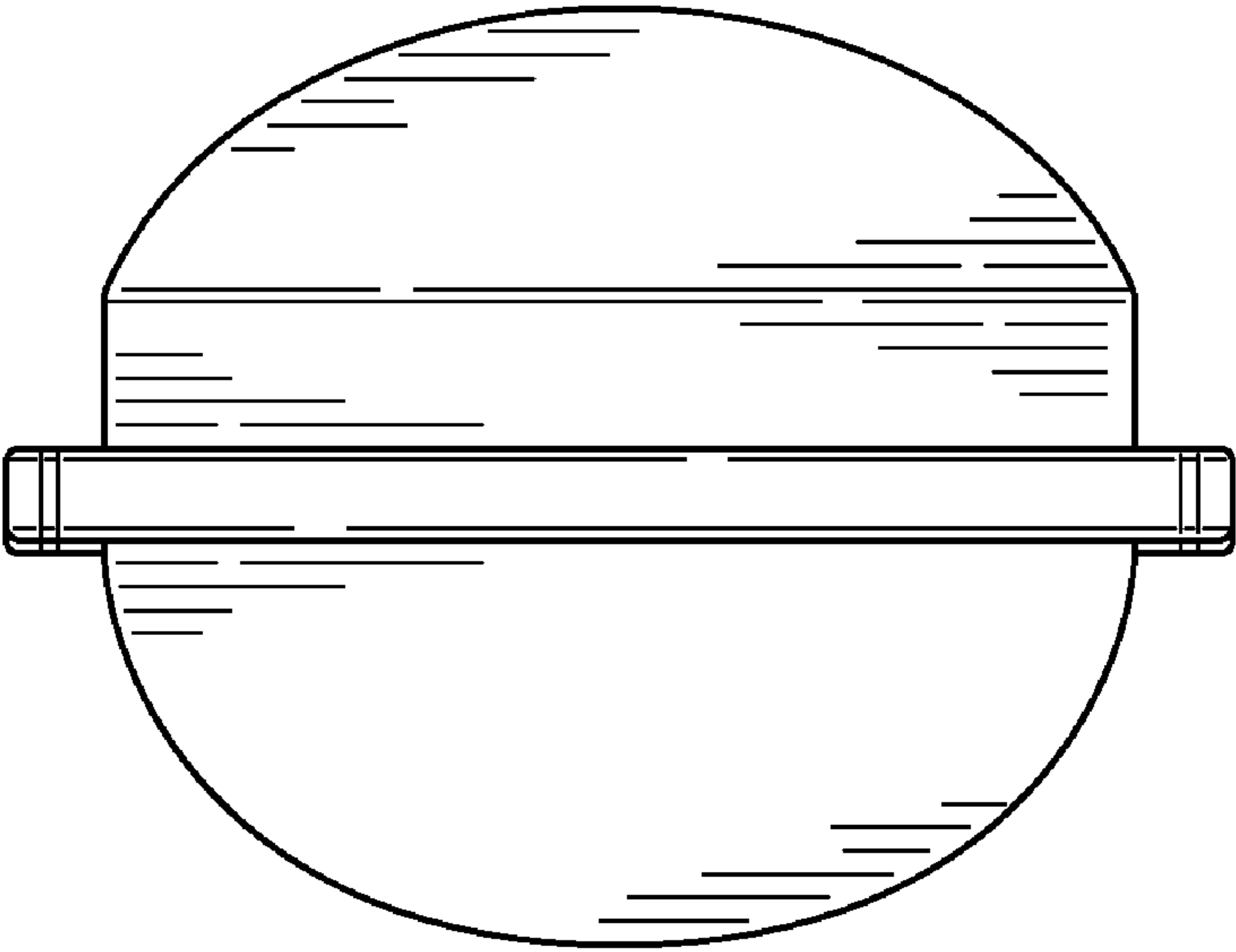
