1;

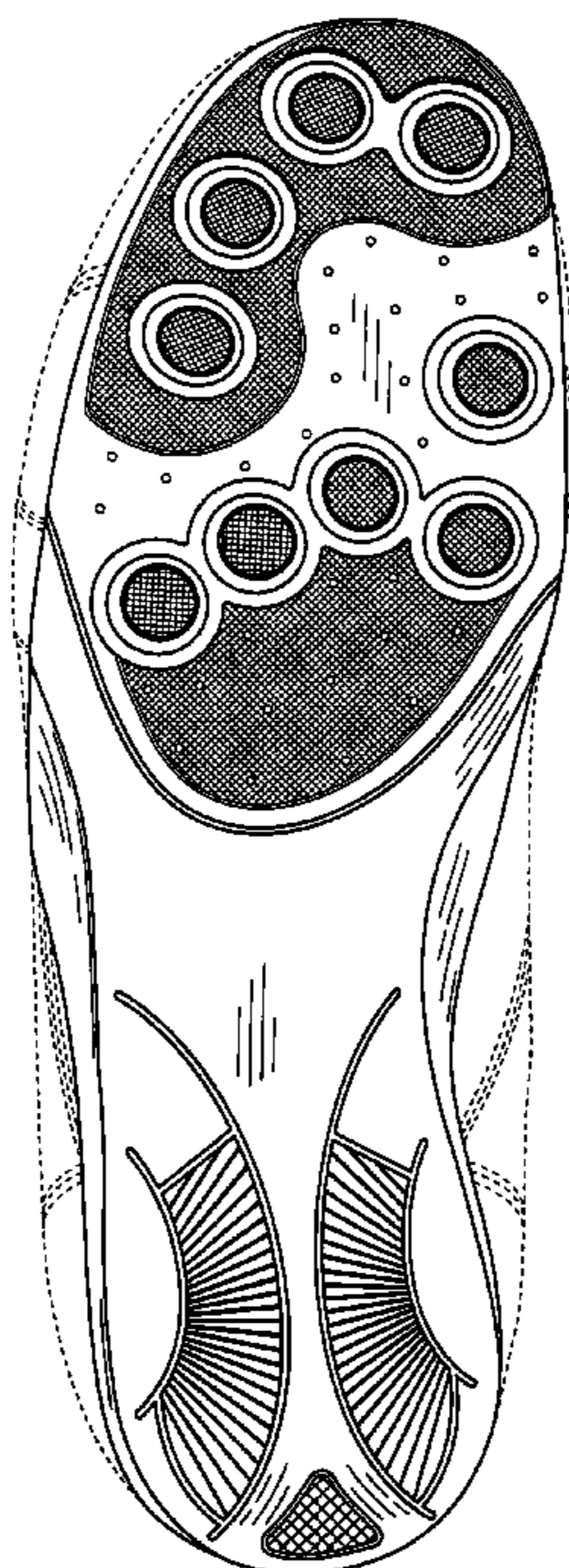
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the sole for footwear shown in FIG. 1;

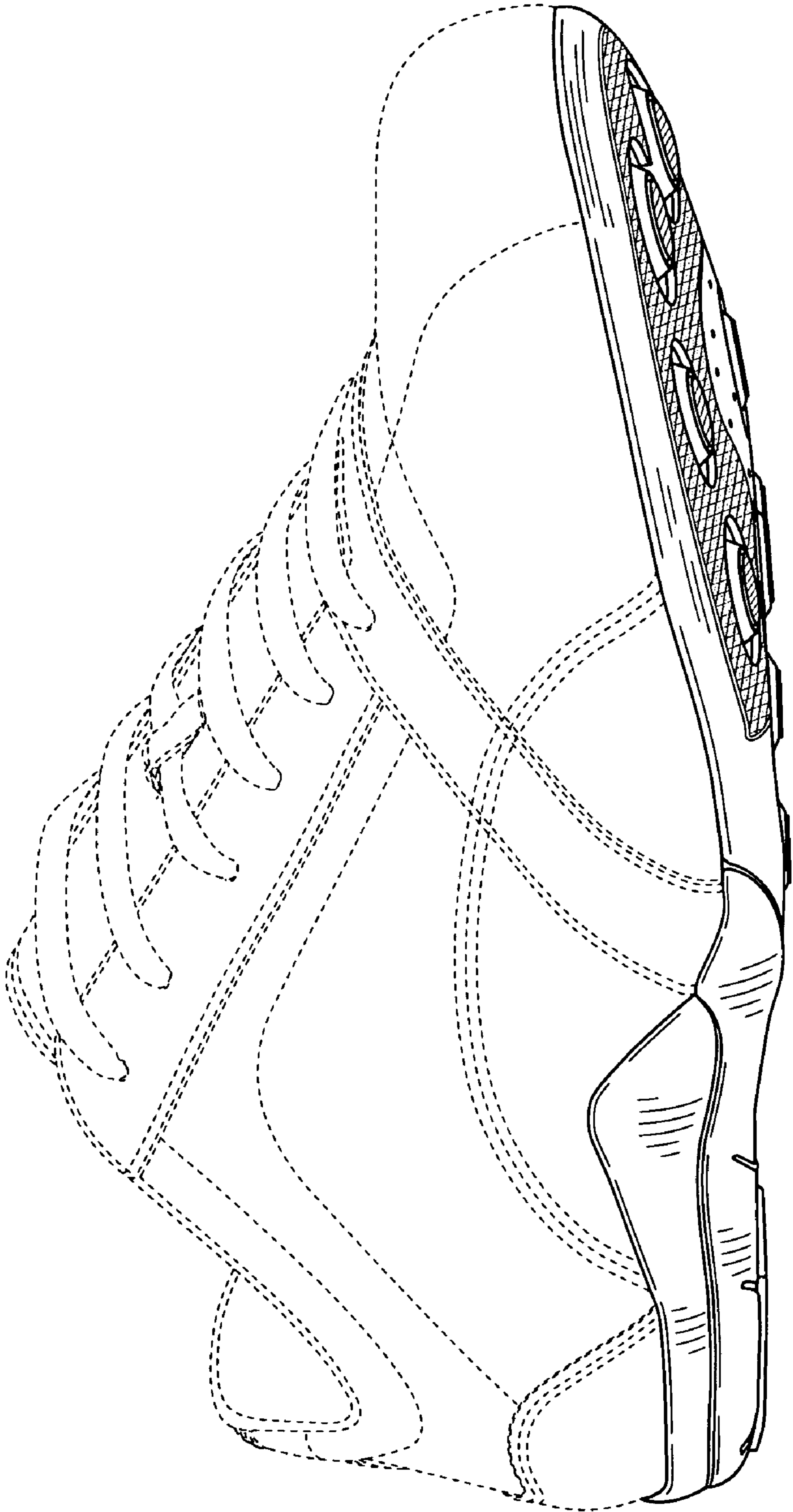

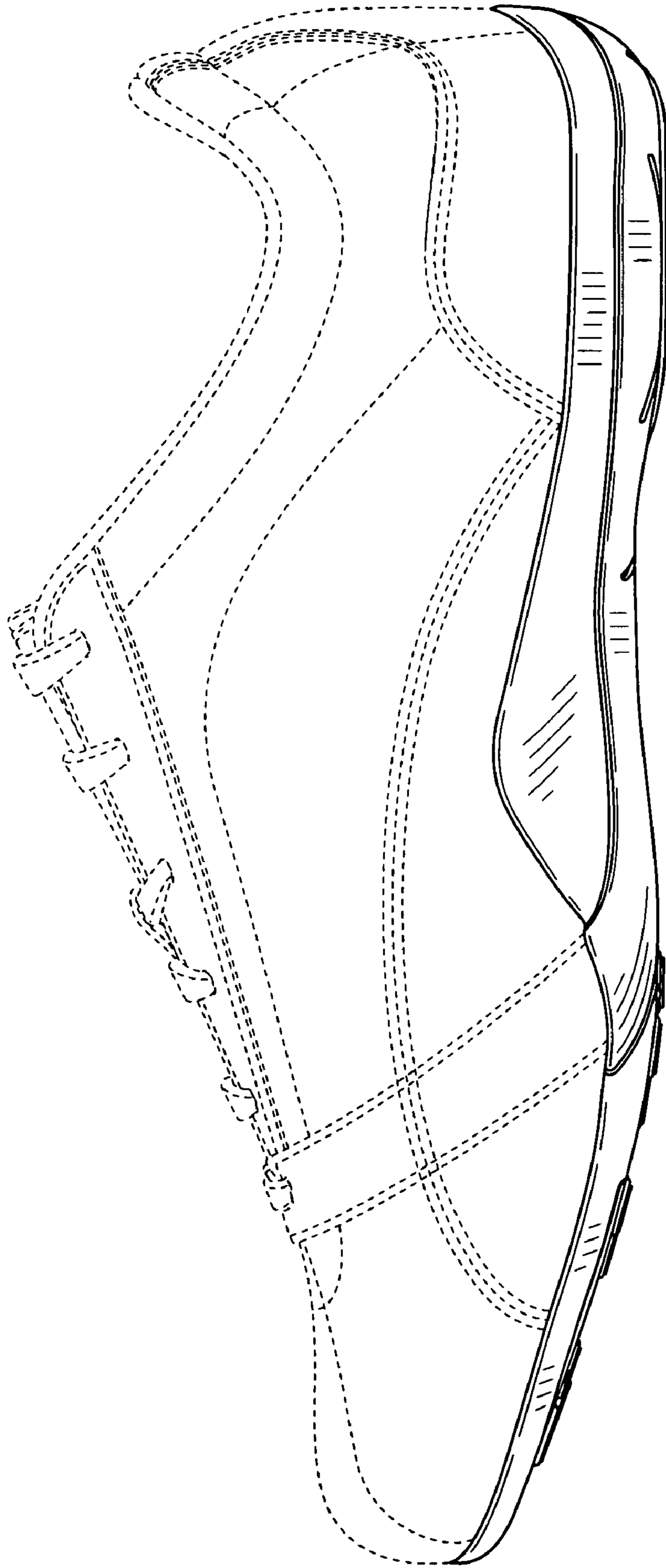

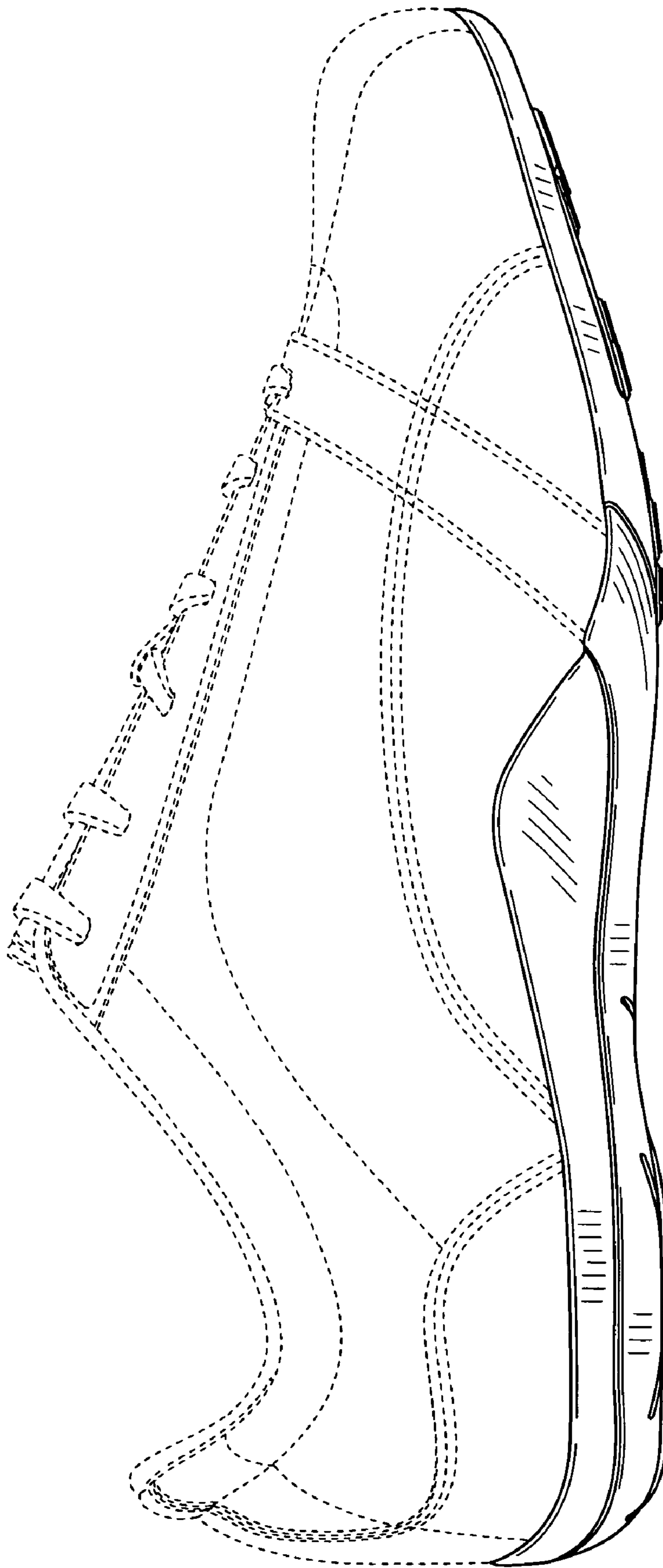

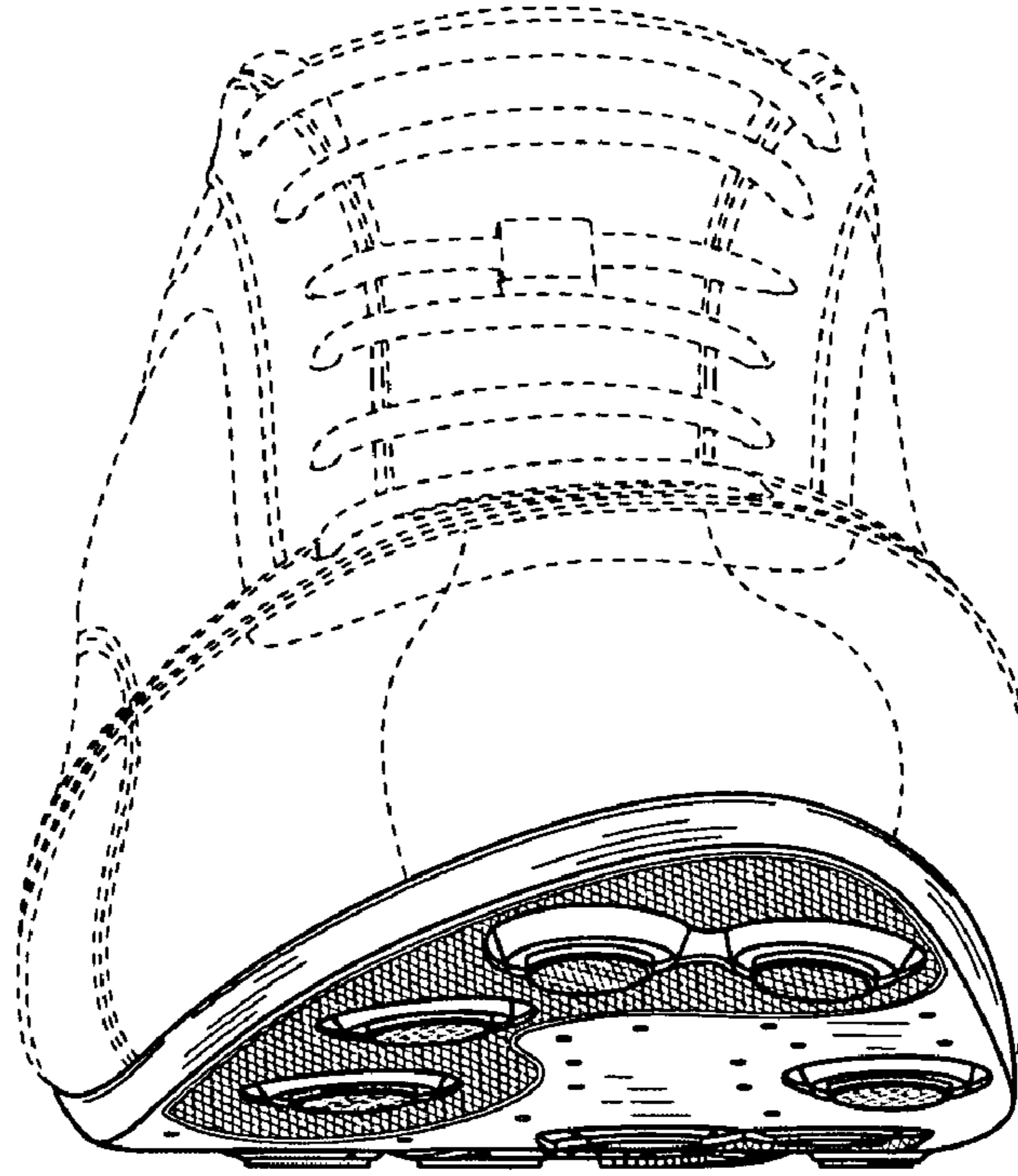

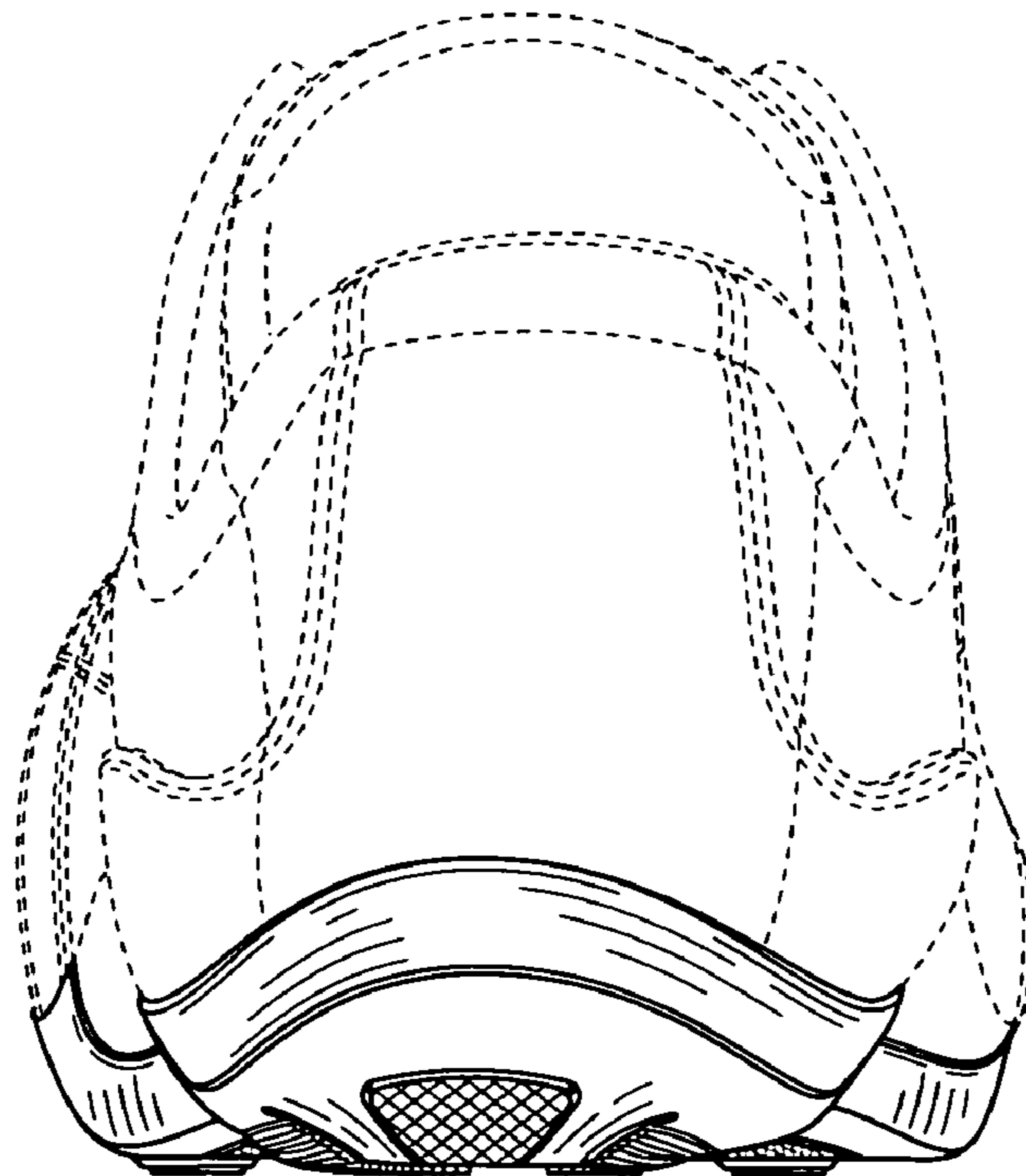

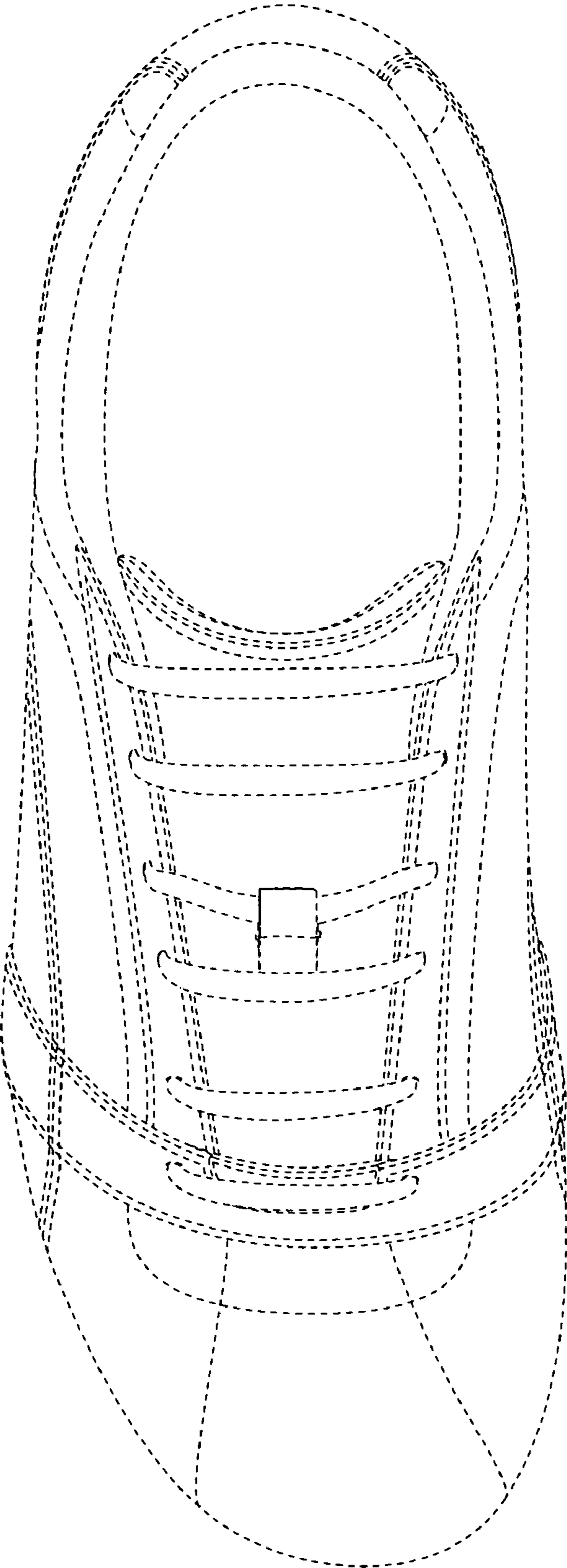

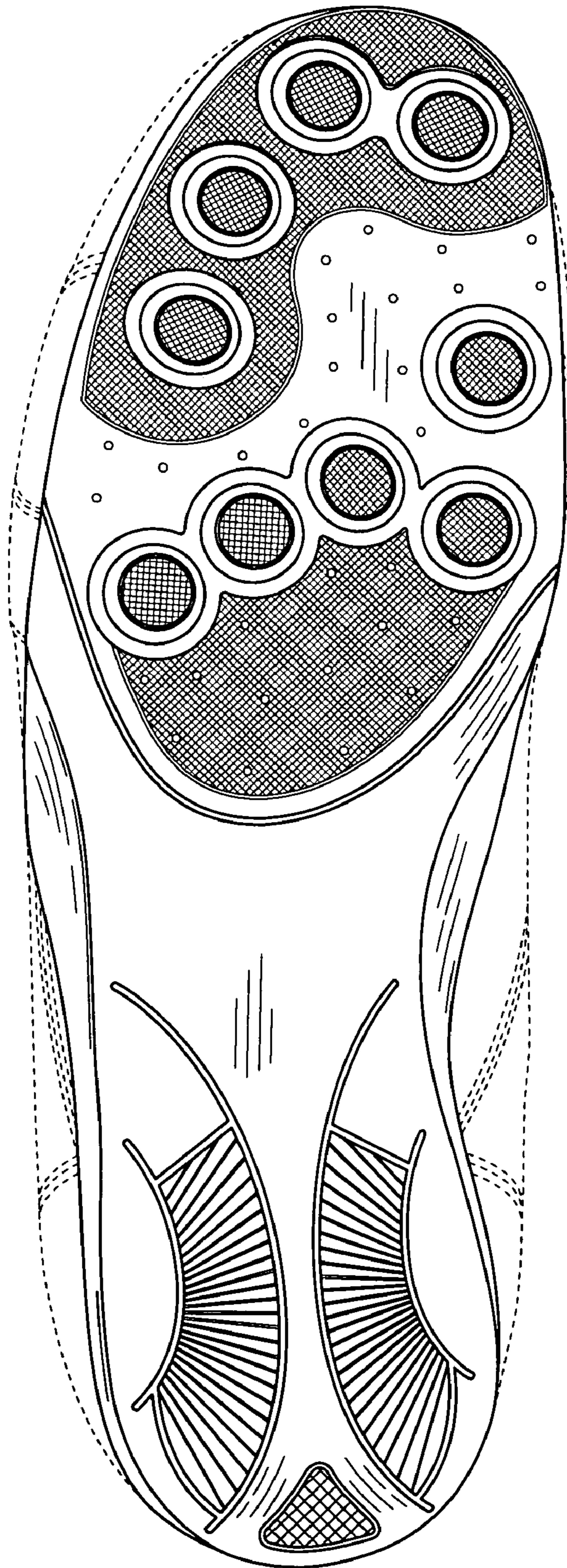
