The ornamental design for a shelf assembly, as shown and described.

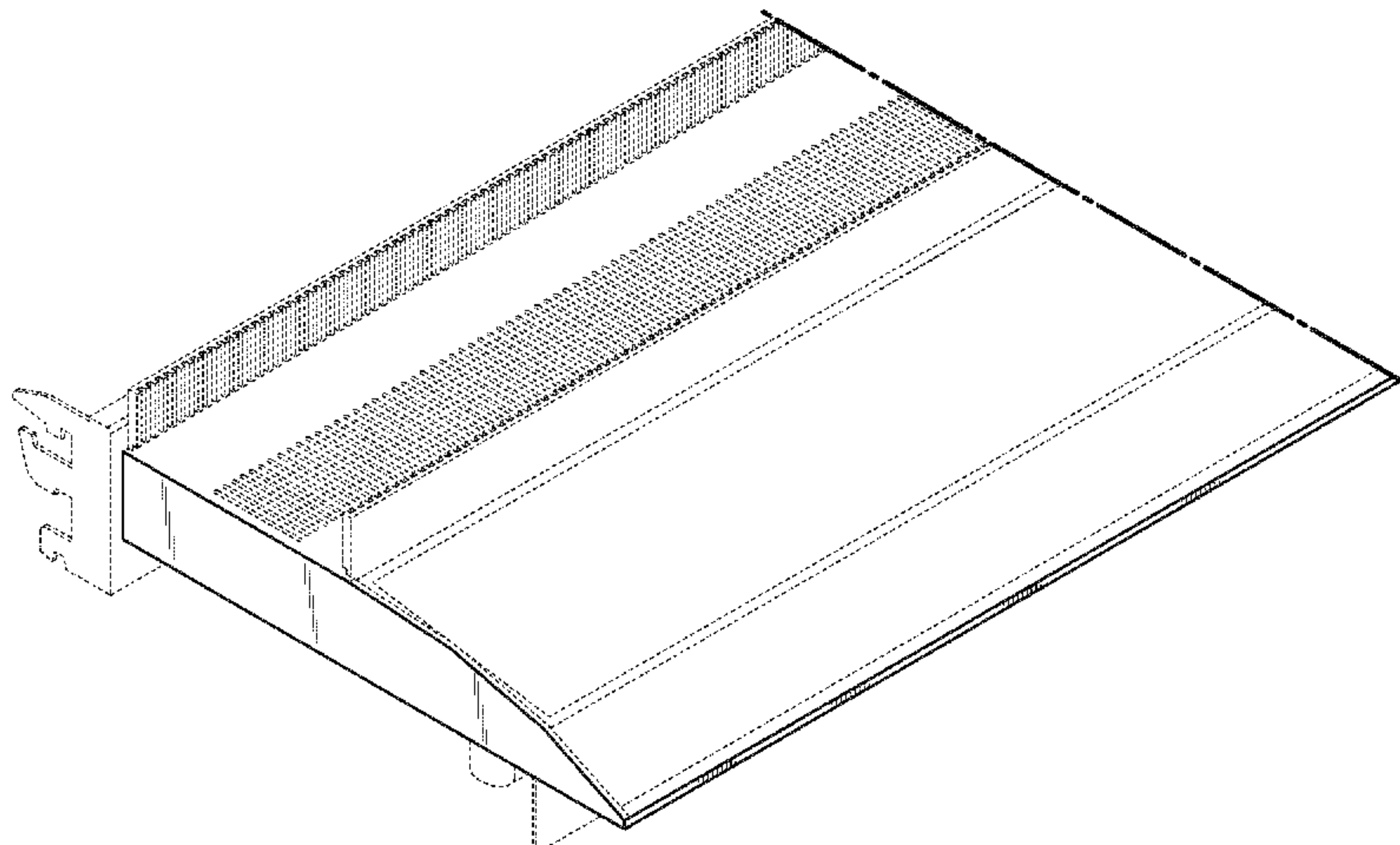
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a fragmentary top, front, and left side isometric view of a shelf assembly, with the right end wall being a mirror image of the left end wall; and,

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the shelf assembly partially illustrated in FIG. 1.

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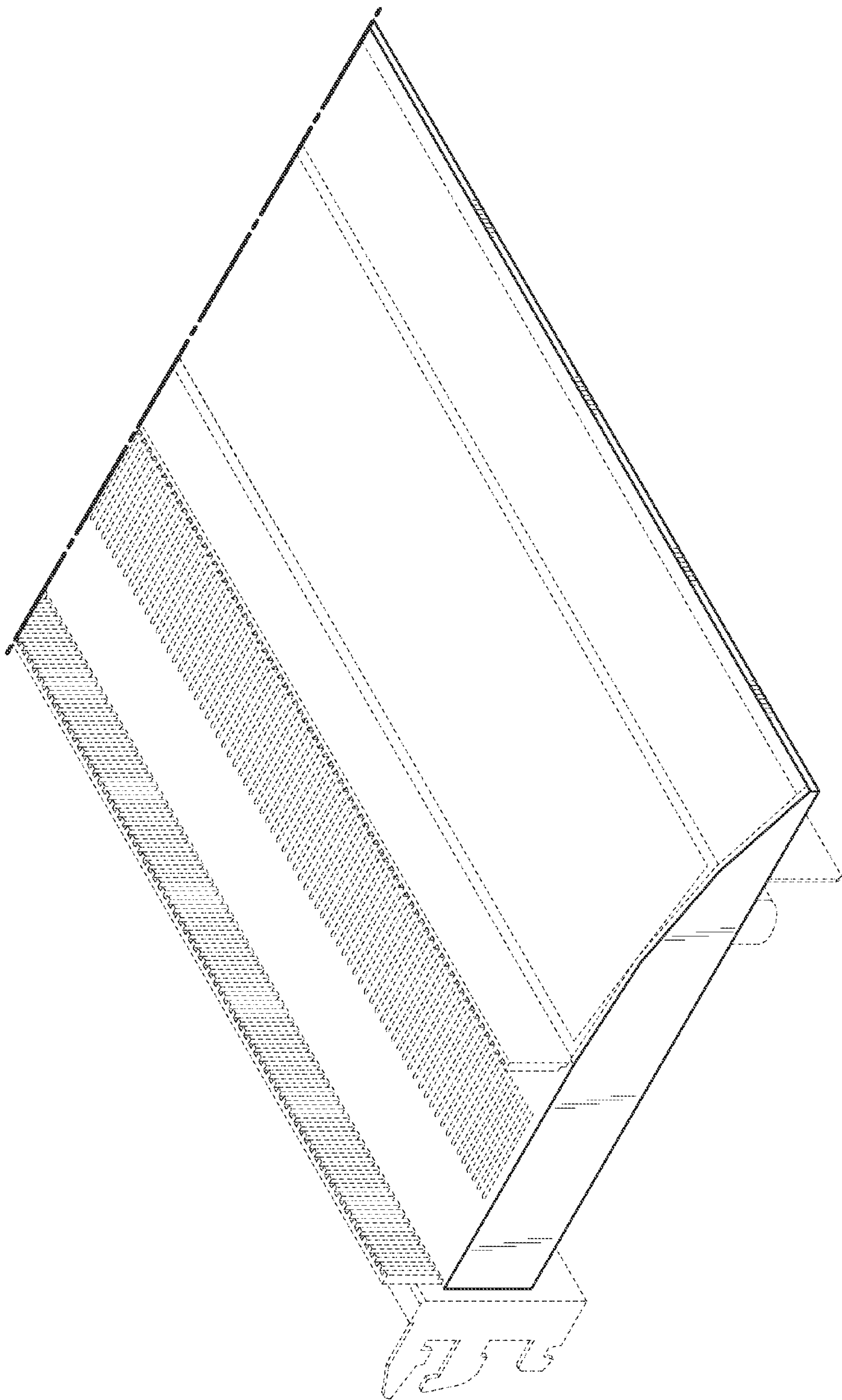

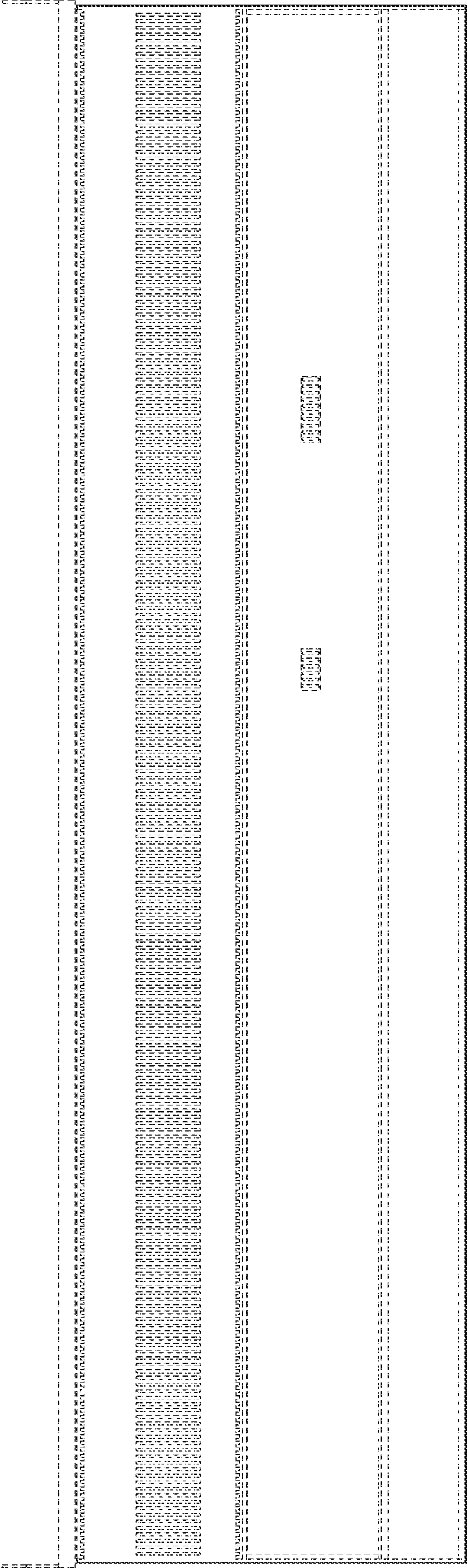
