### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a first embodiment of a handheld dispenser having a transparent container portion;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the first embodiment;

FIG. **3** is a side elevational view of the first embodiment, the other side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. **4** is a front elevational view of the first embodiment;

FIG. **5** is a rear elevational view of the first embodiment;

FIG. **6**. is top plan view of the second embodiment of a handheld dispenser having an opaque container portion;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the second embodiment;

FIG. **8** is a side elevational view of the second embodiment, the other side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. **9** is a front elevational view of the second embodiment; and,

FIG. **10** is a rear elevational view of the second embodiment. In the drawings, the ghost-line portions do not form a part of the design sought to be patented.
