The broken lines shown in FIG. 1 depict environmental subject matter only and form no part of the claimed design.

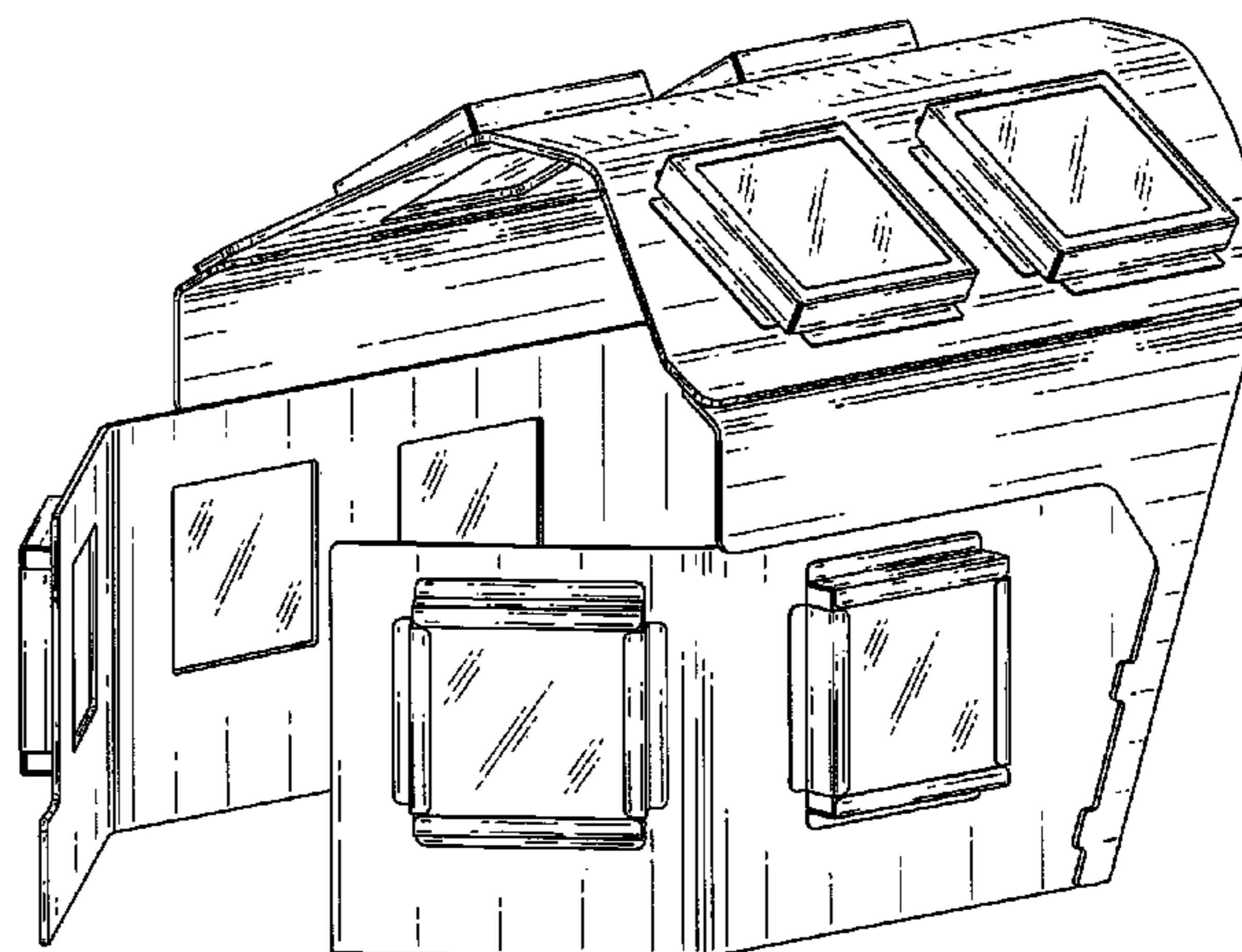
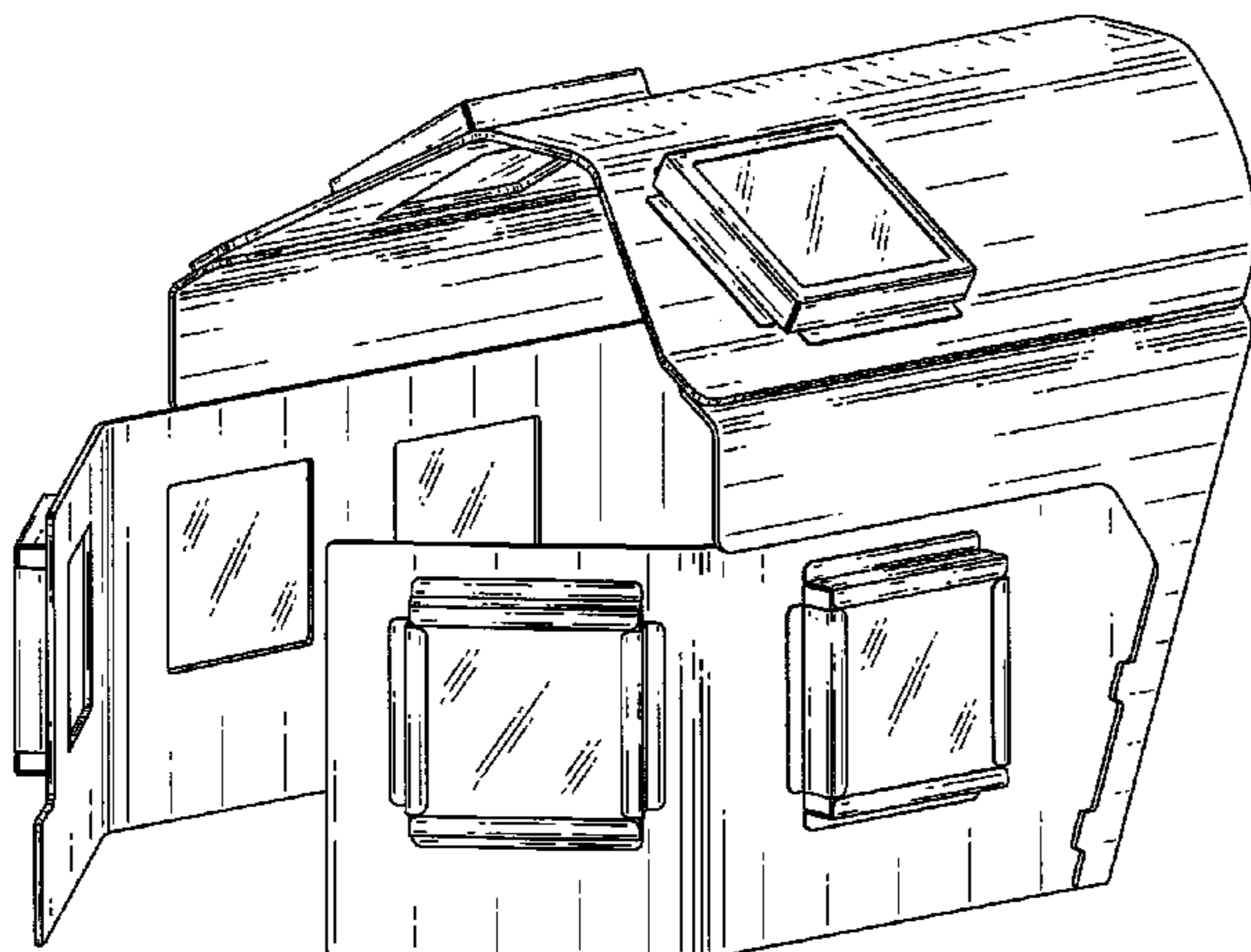

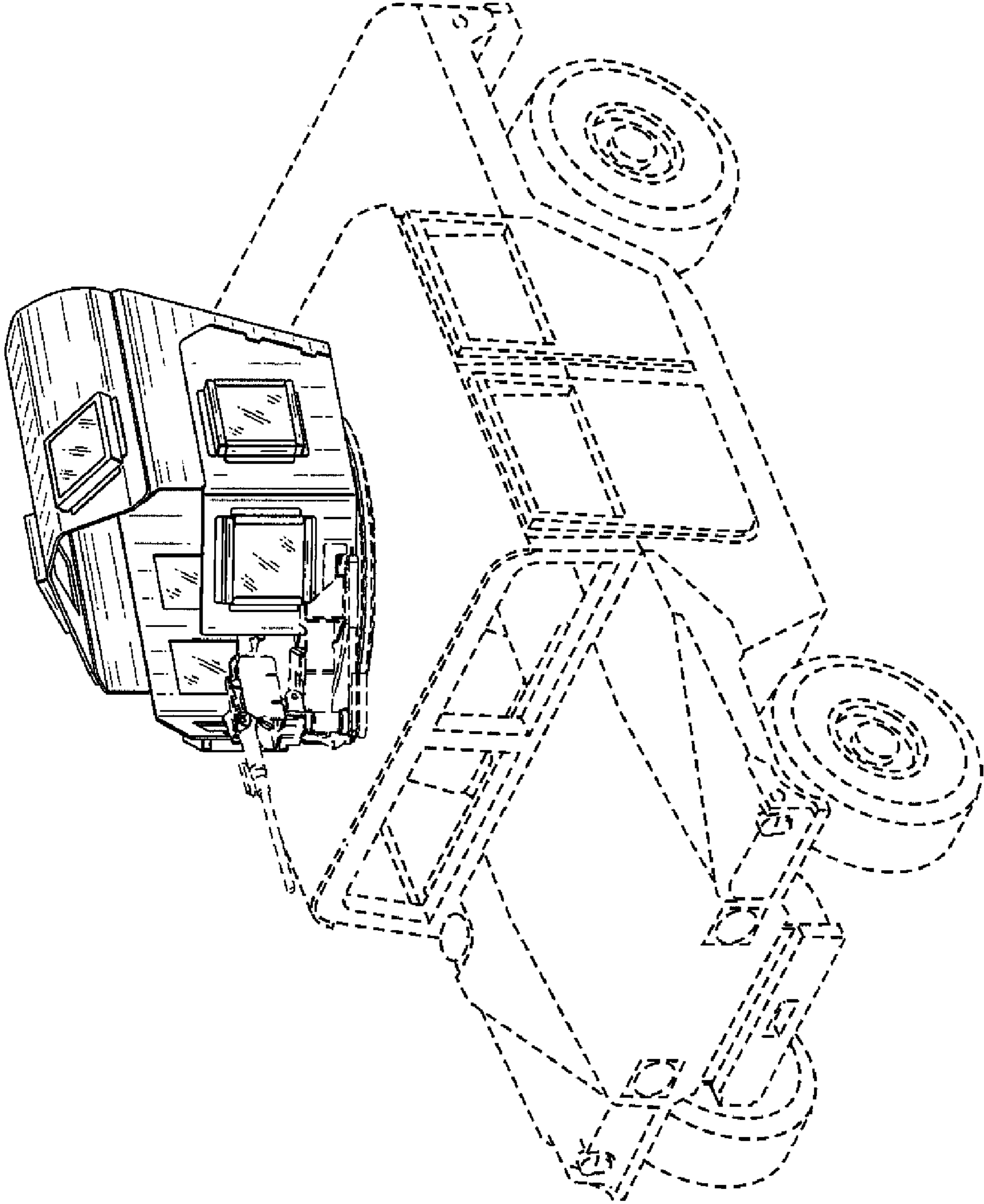
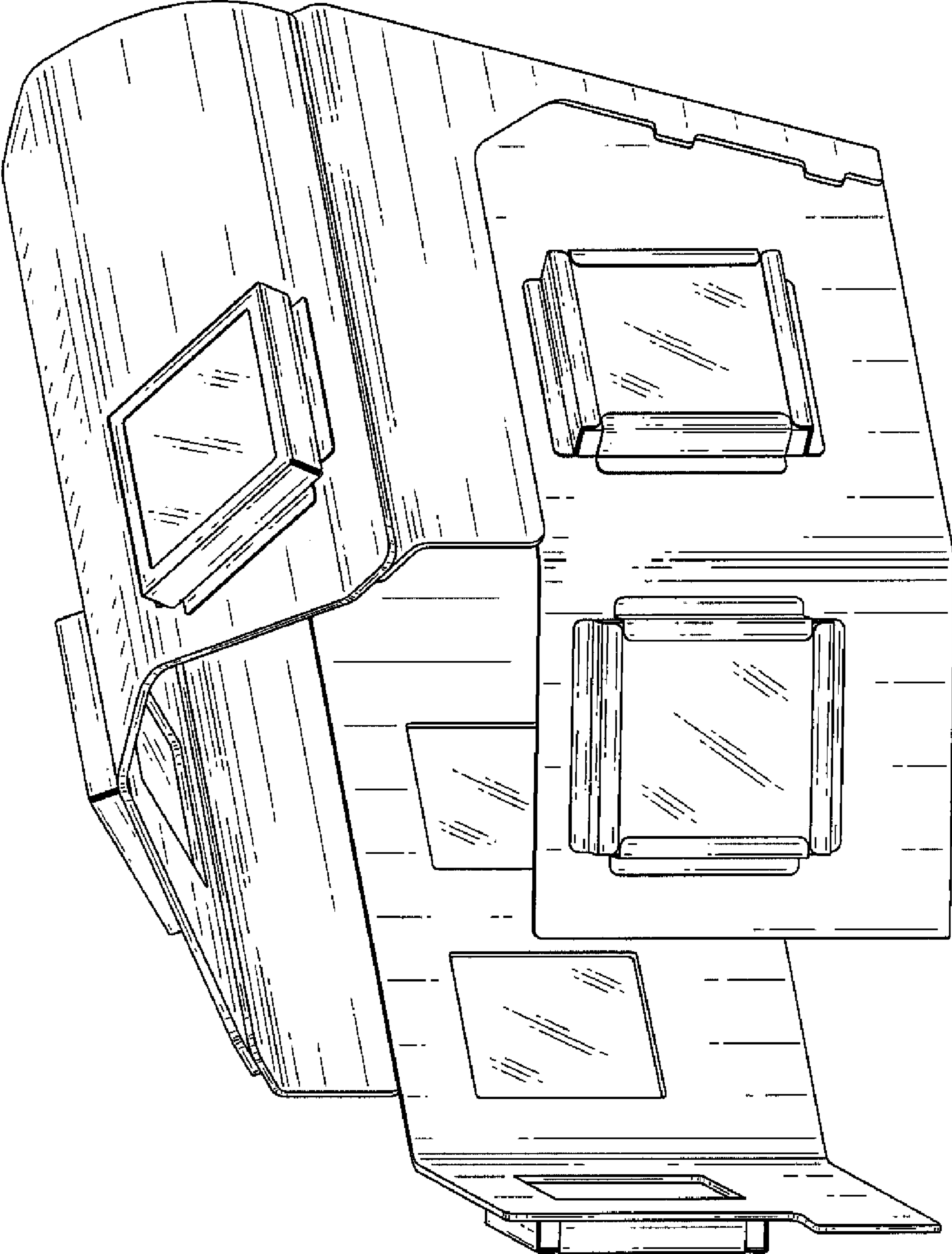

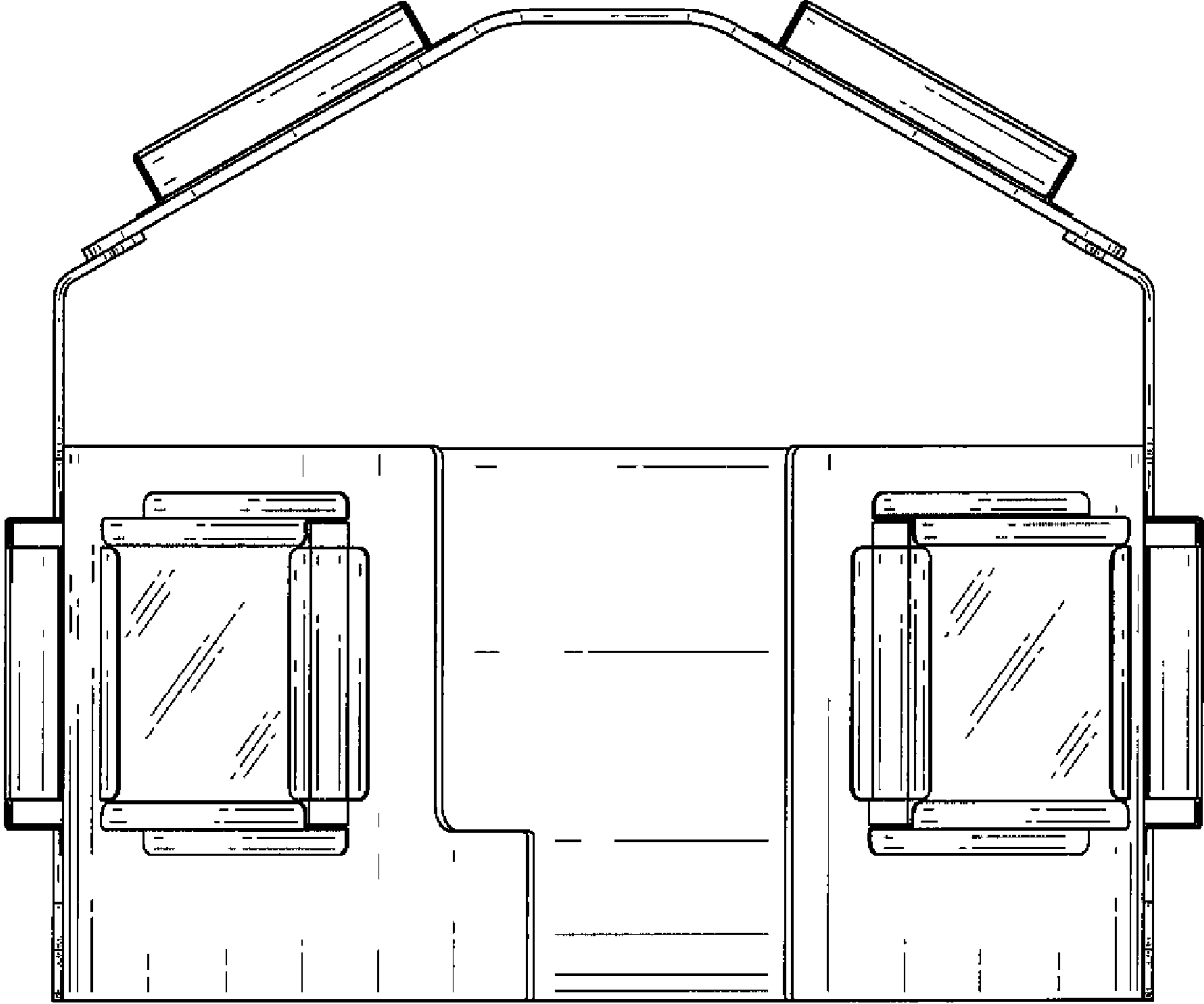

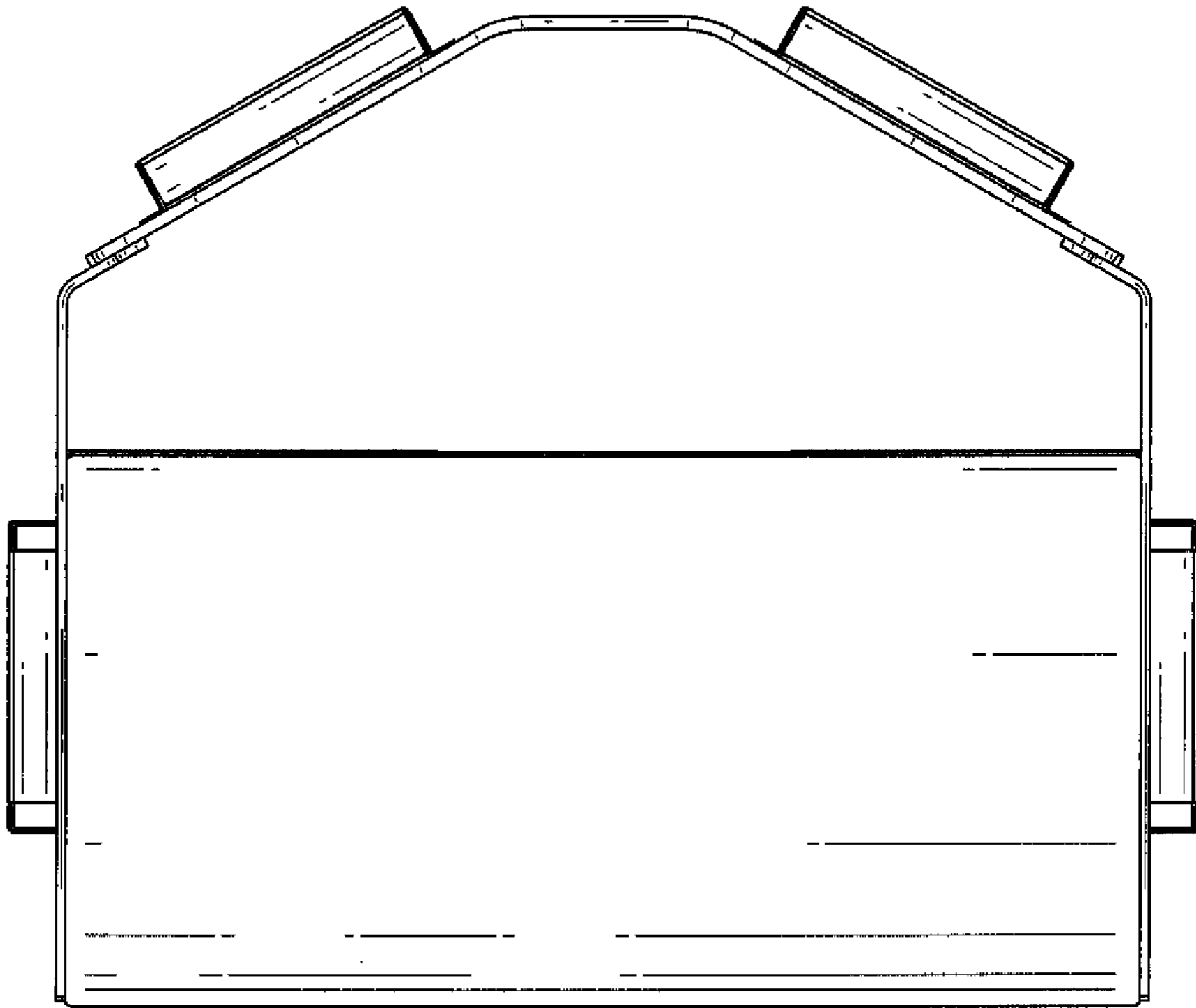

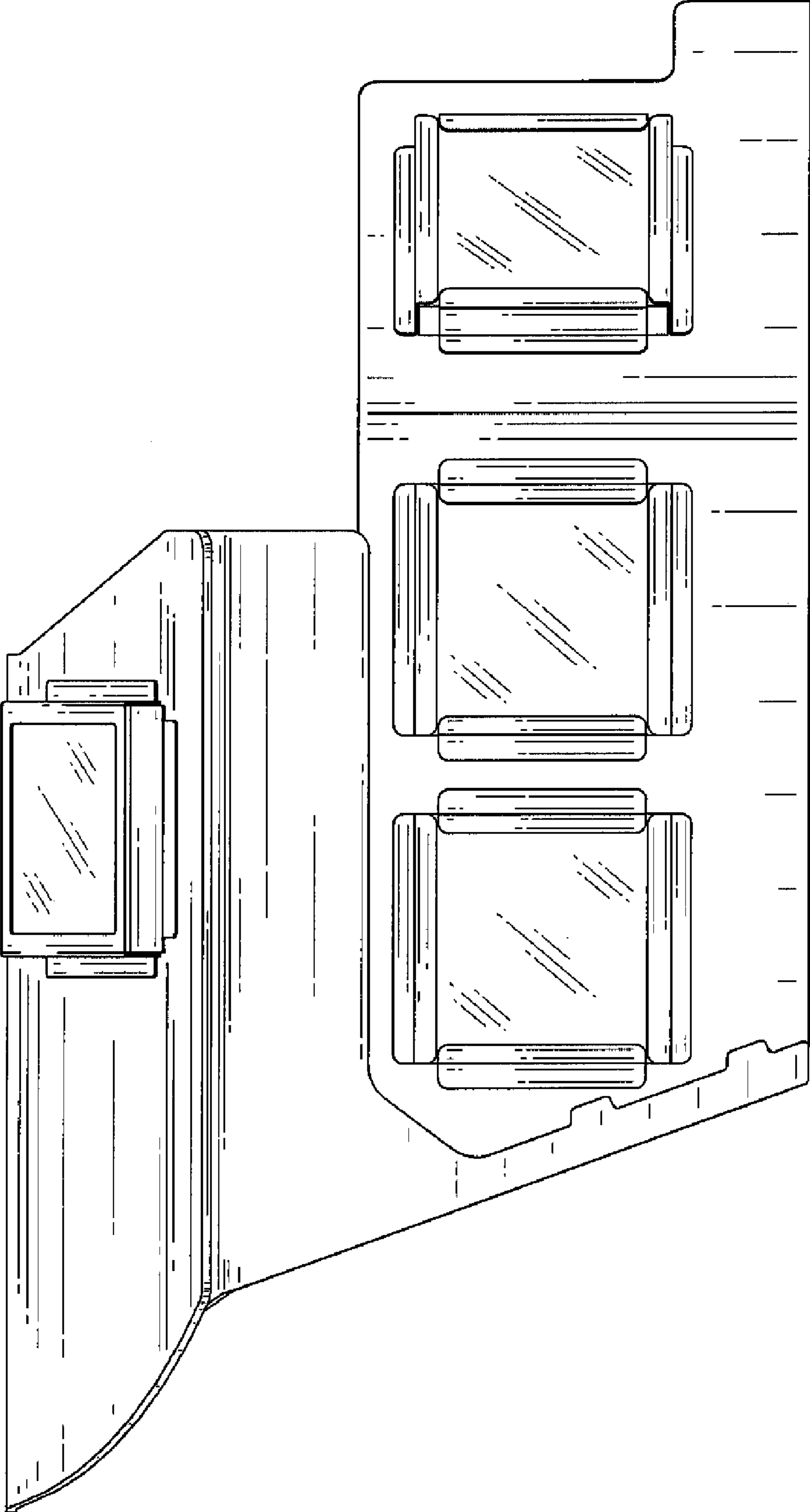

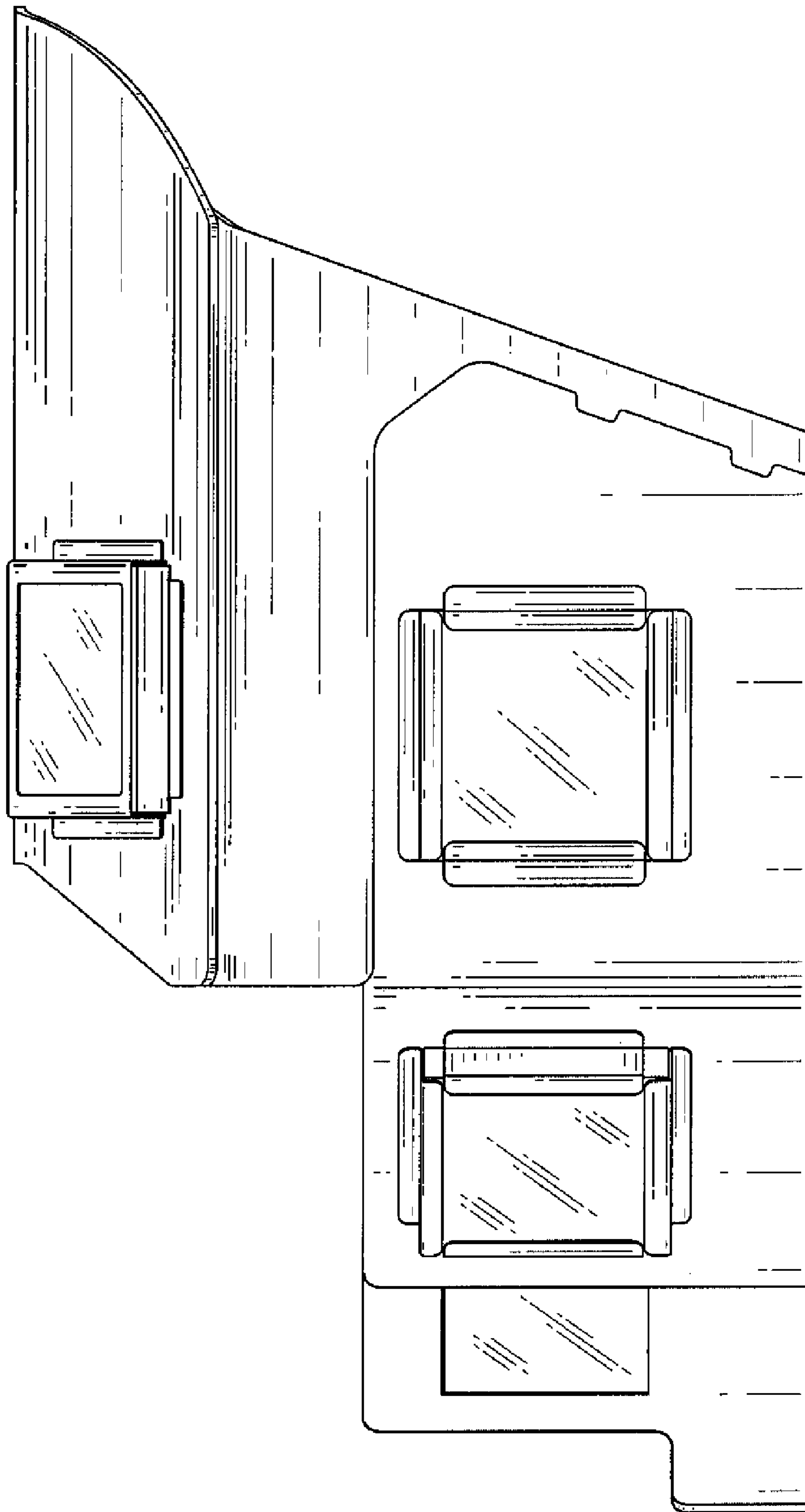

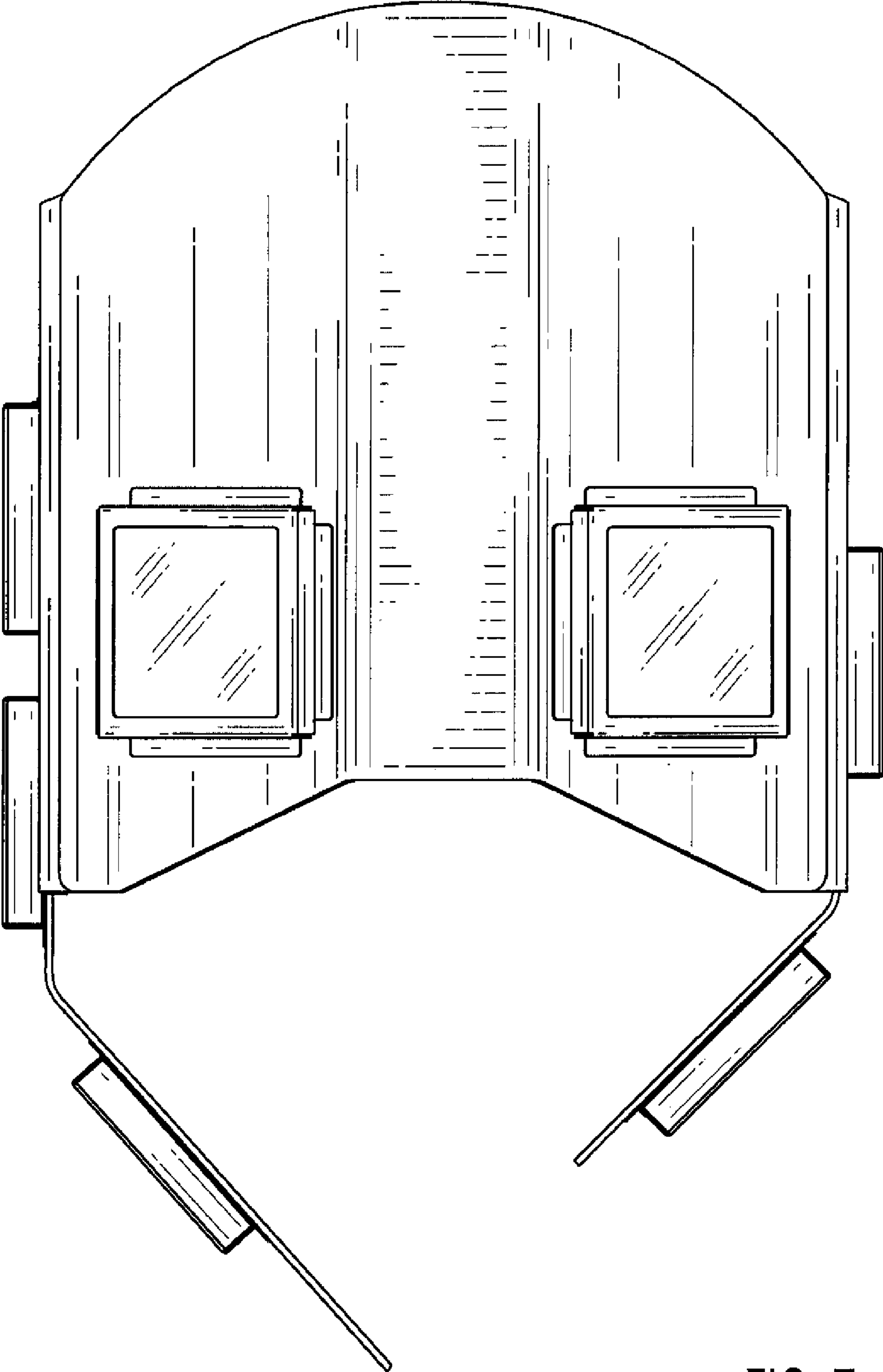

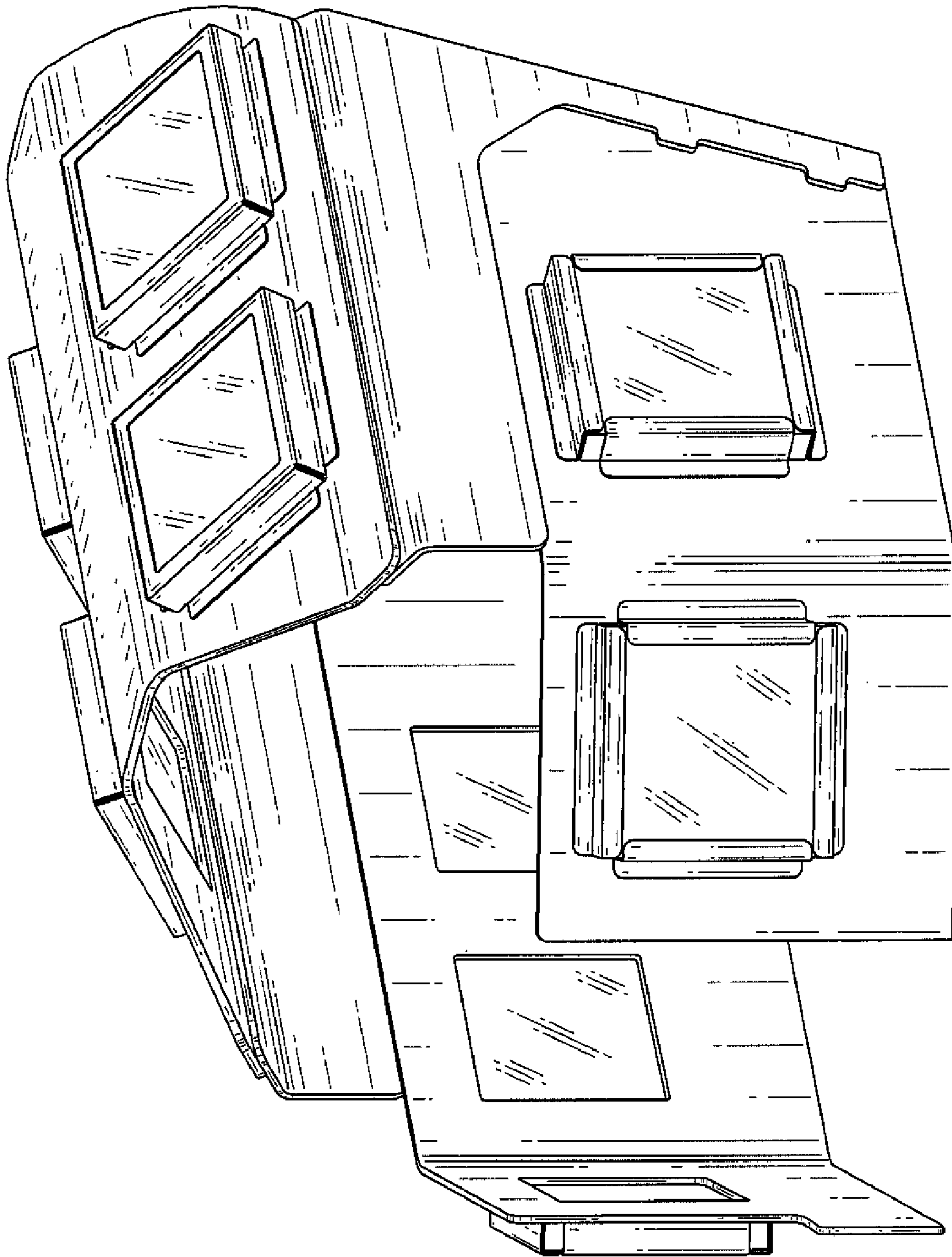
