(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of shoe sole showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof.

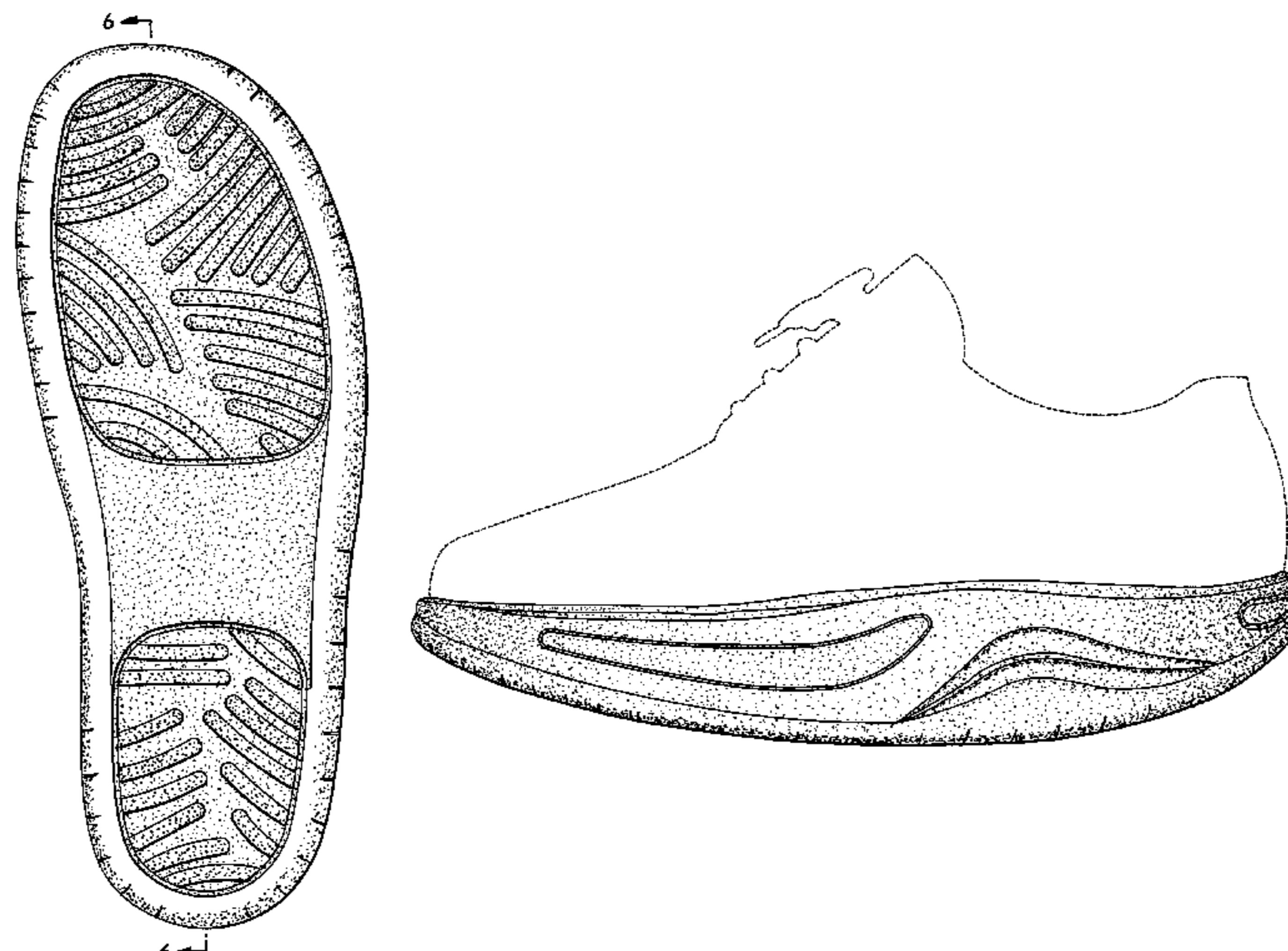
FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view along line 6—6 in FIG. 1, viewed in the direction of the arrows;

FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view along line 7—7 in FIG. 6, viewed in direction of the arrows; and,

FIG. 8 is a cross sectional view along line 8—8 in FIG. 6, viewed in direction of the arrows.

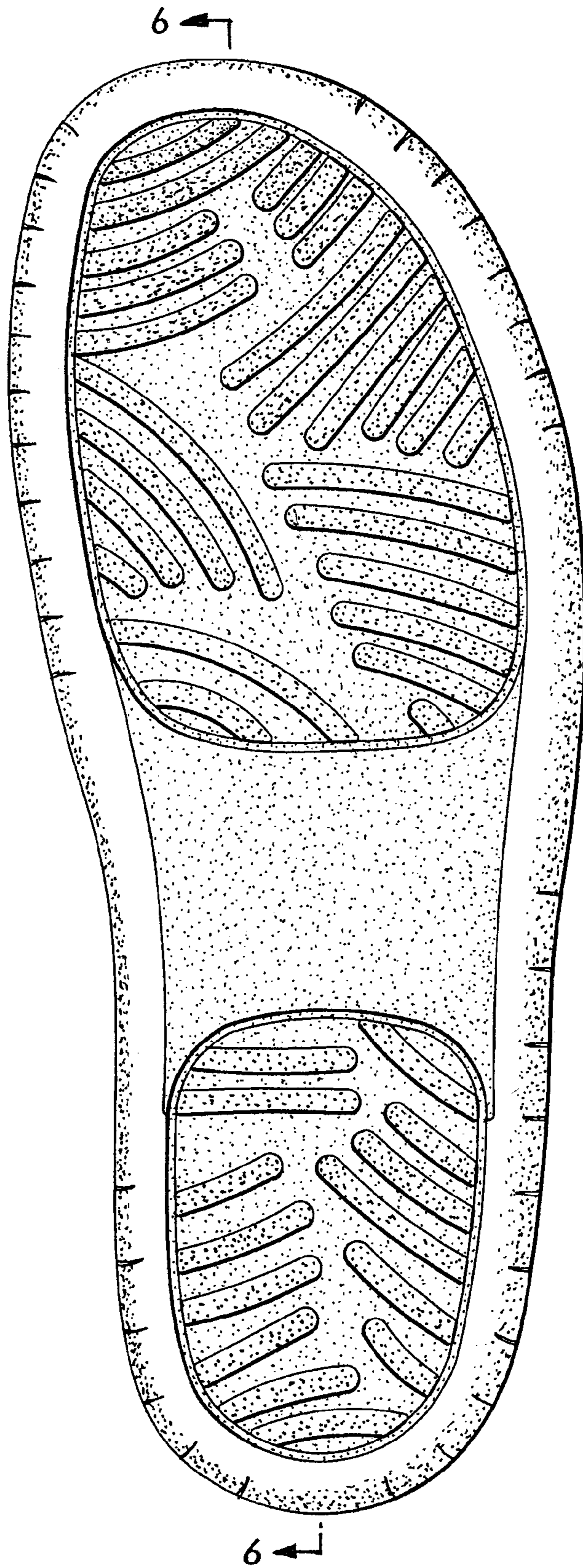

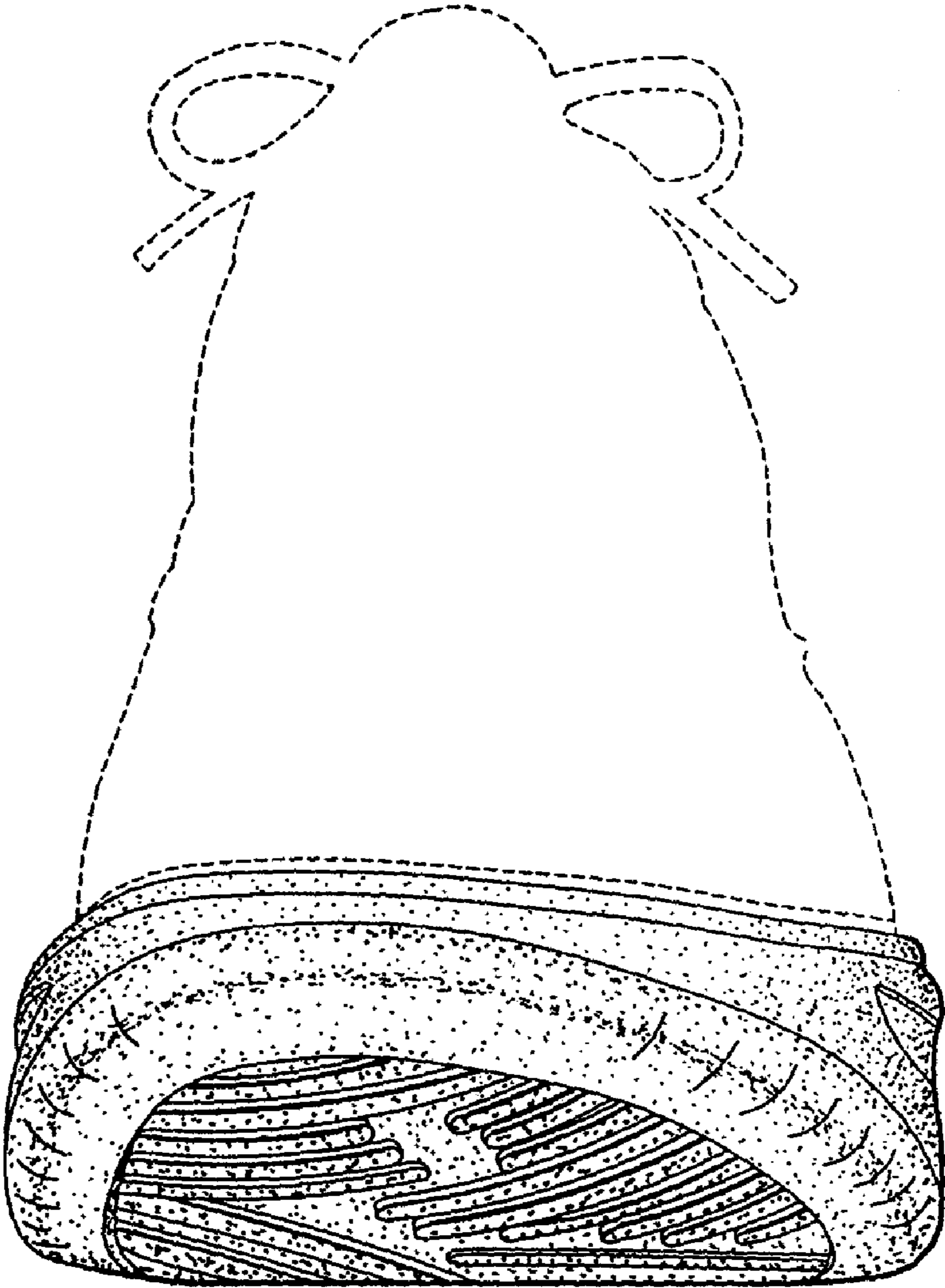

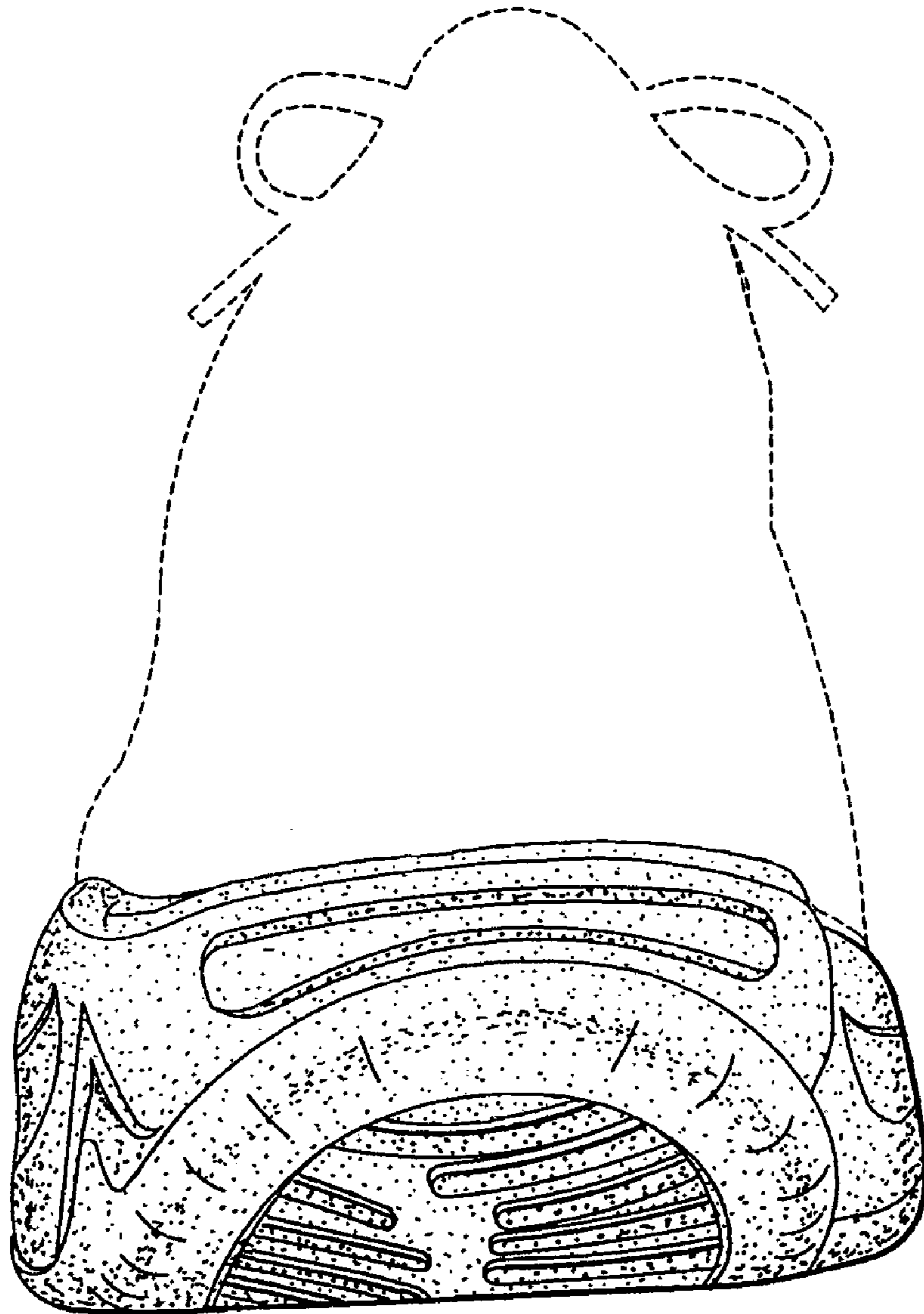

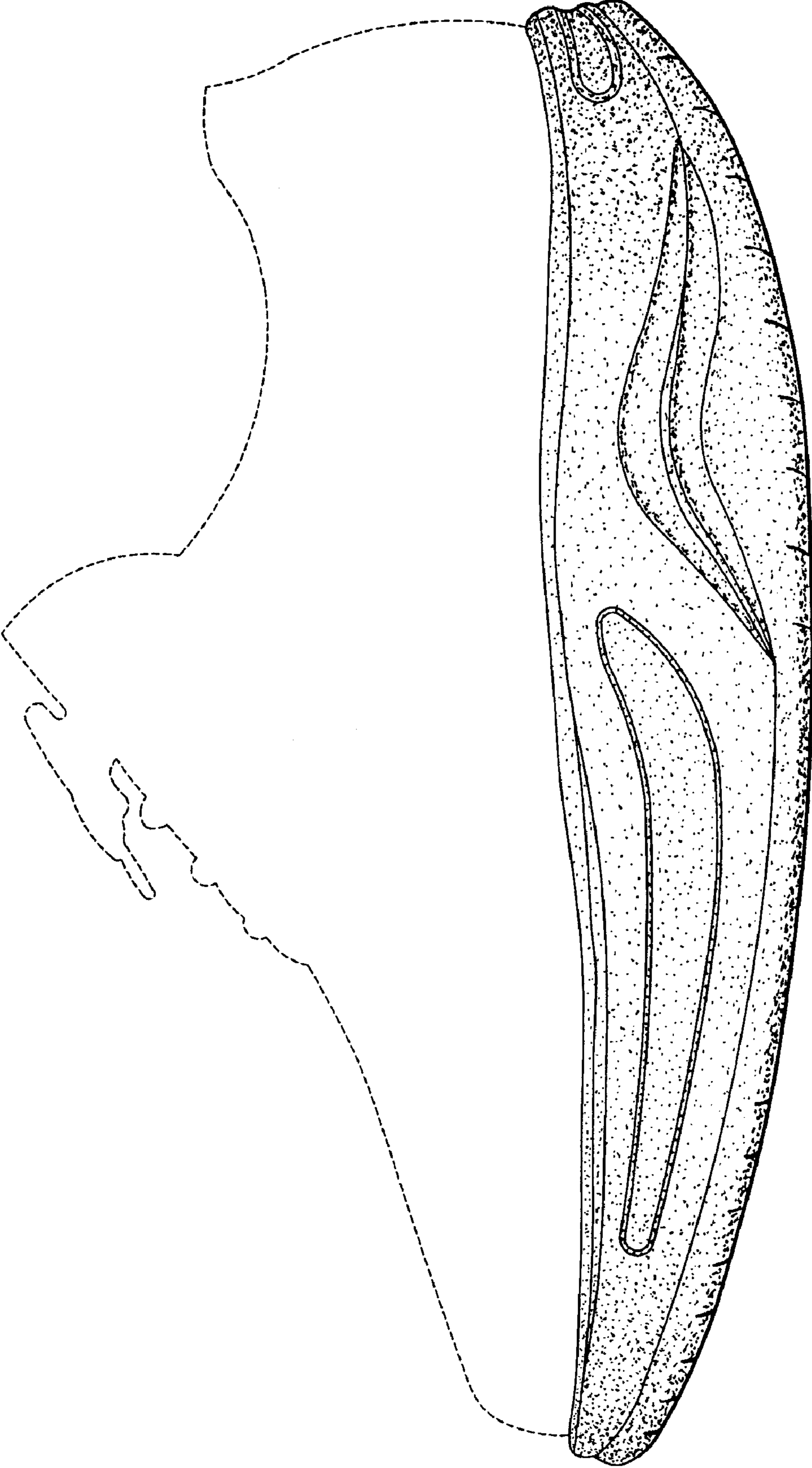

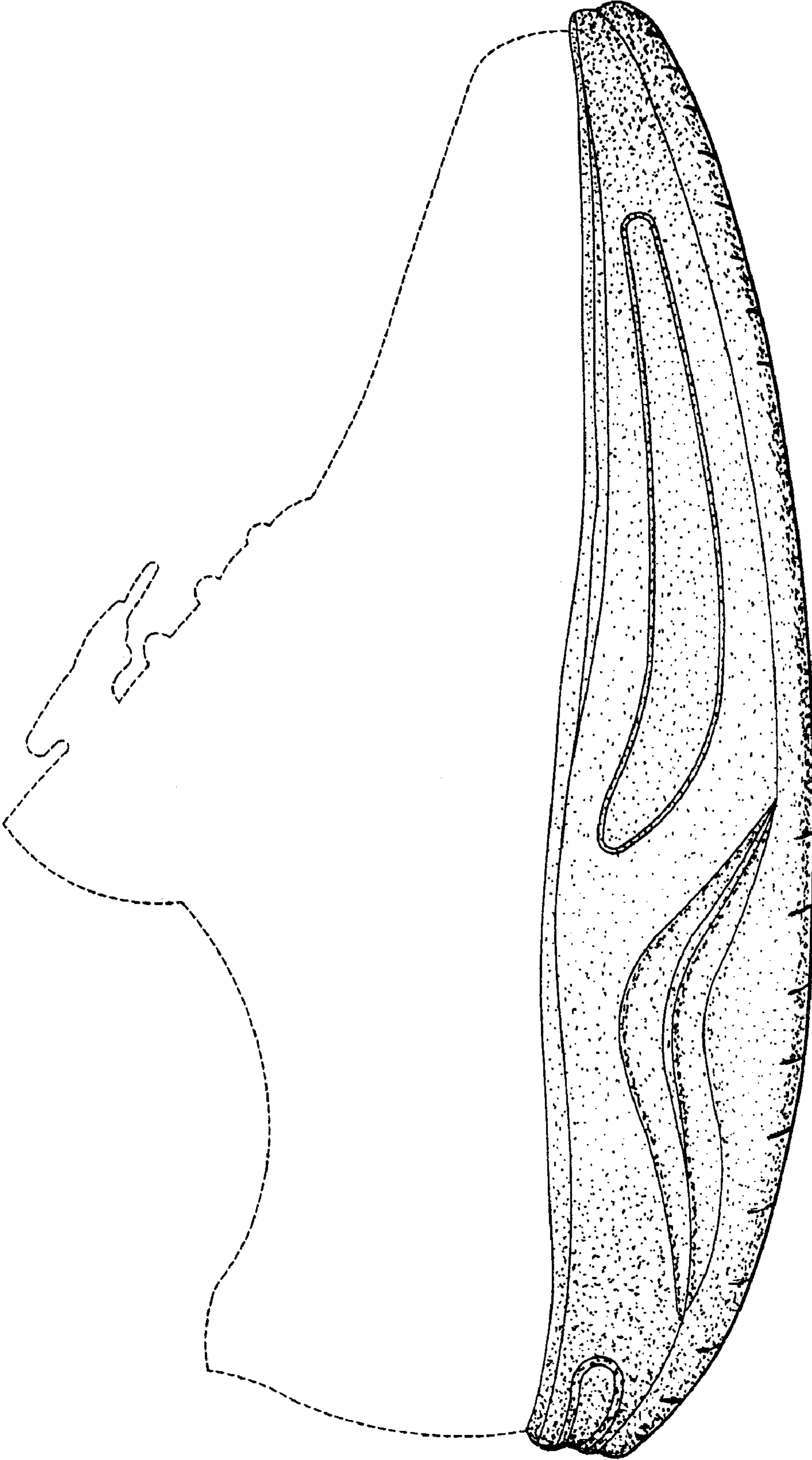

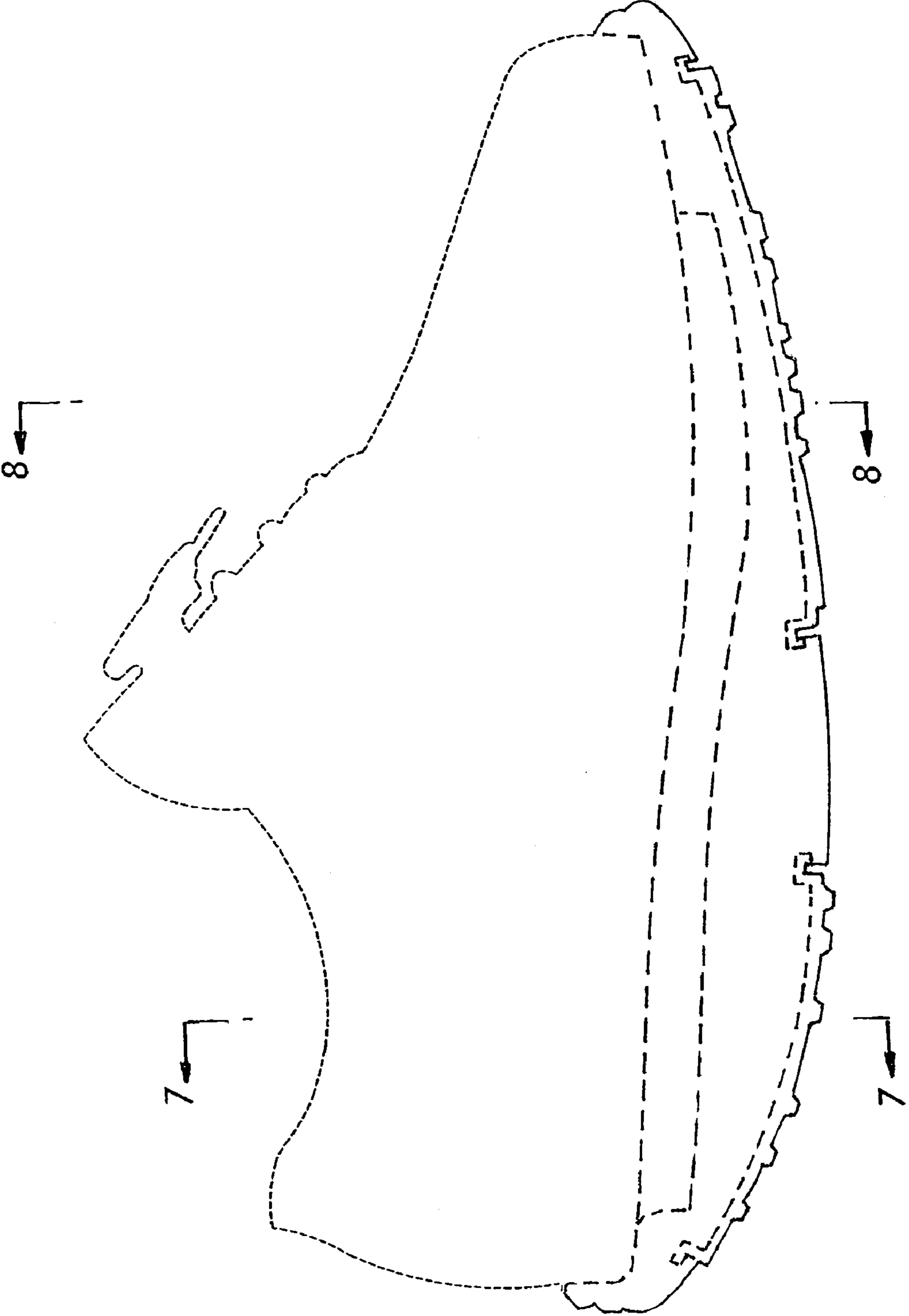

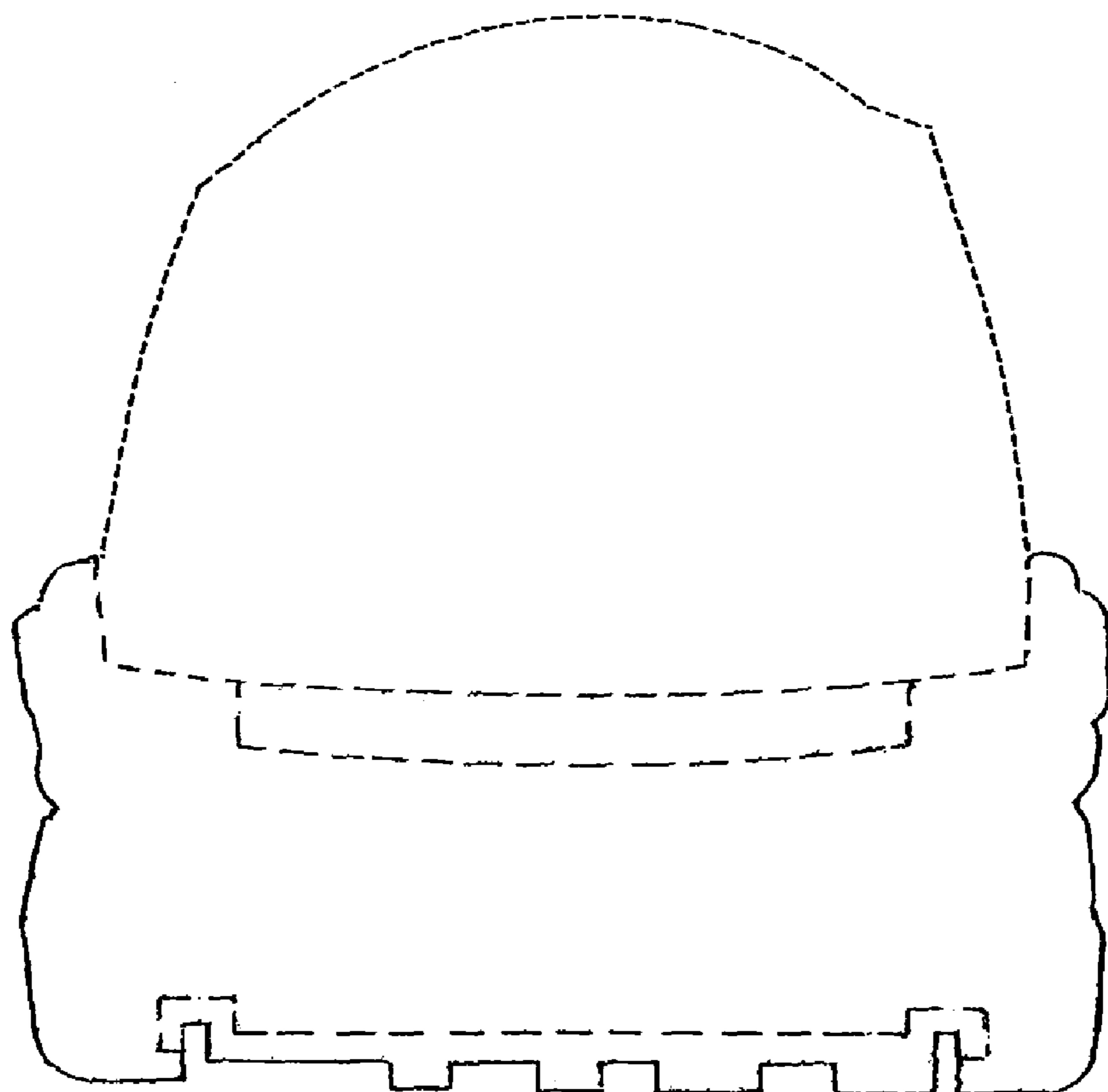

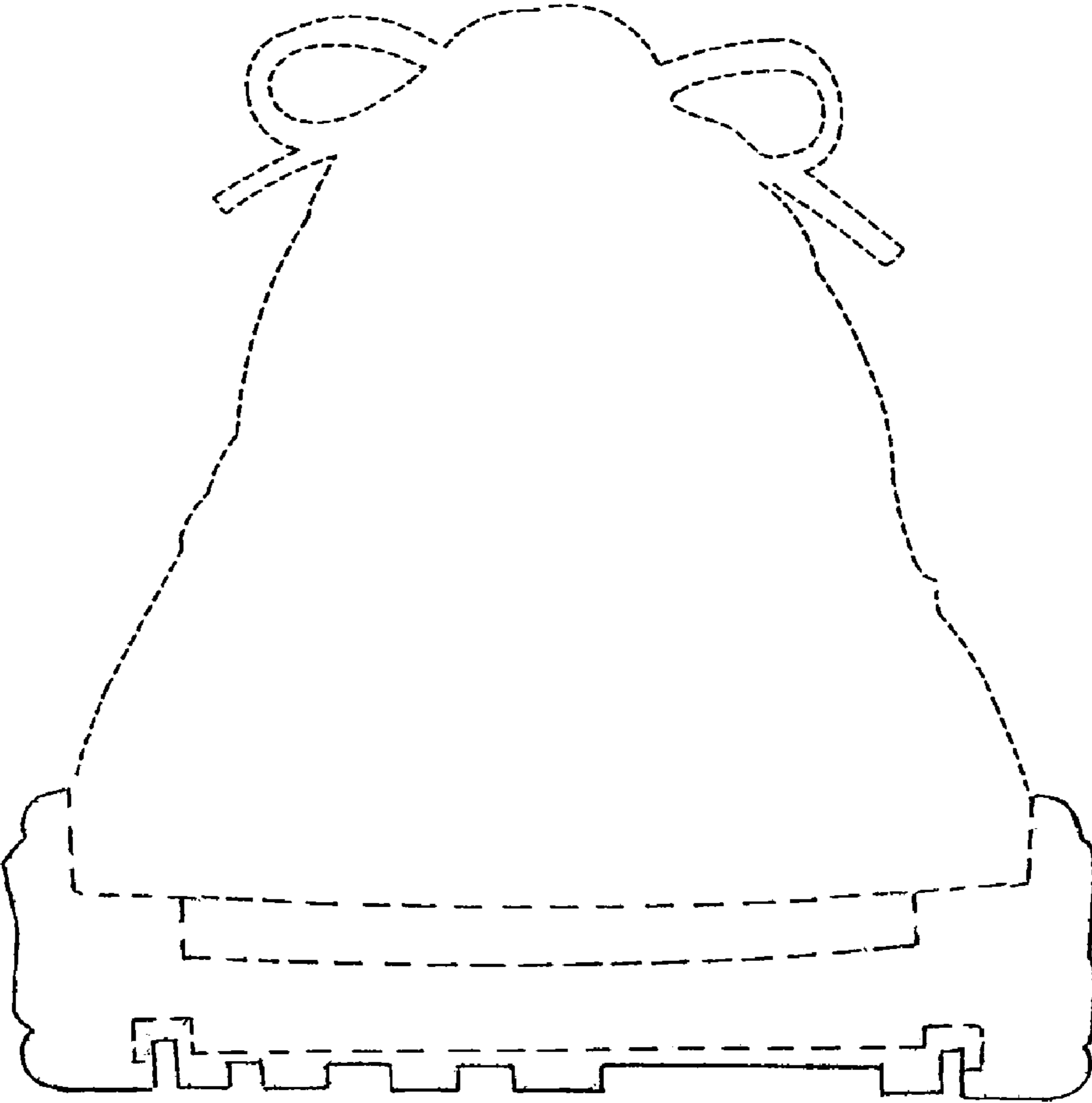
