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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wrist rest for a rotary abrading tool, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wrist rest for a rotary abrading tool shown in a position of use;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the wrist rest for a rotary abrading tool;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the wrist rest for a rotary abrading tool;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the wrist rest for a rotary abrading tool;

FIG. 5 is a left elevational view of the wrist rest for a rotary abrading tool;

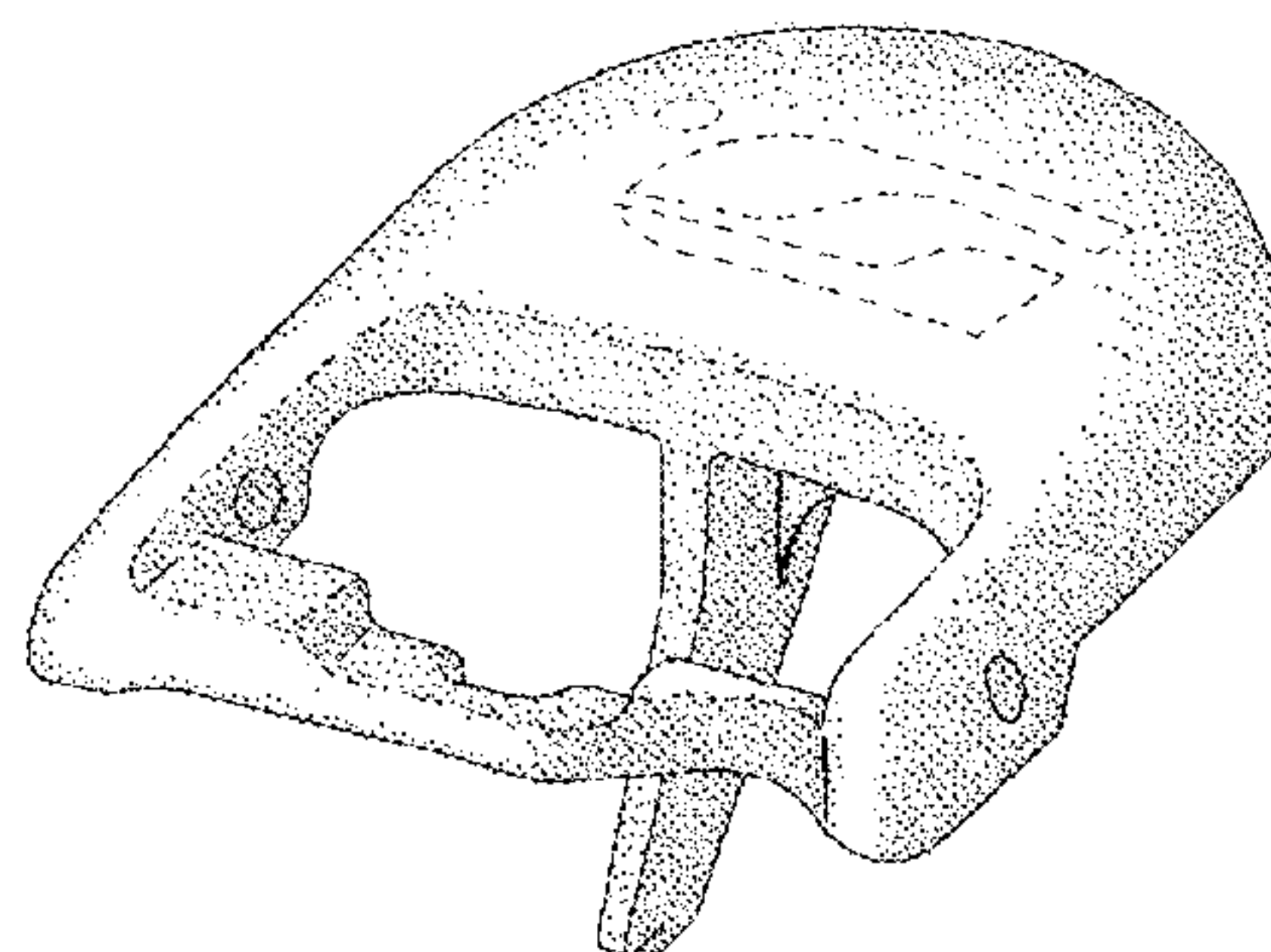
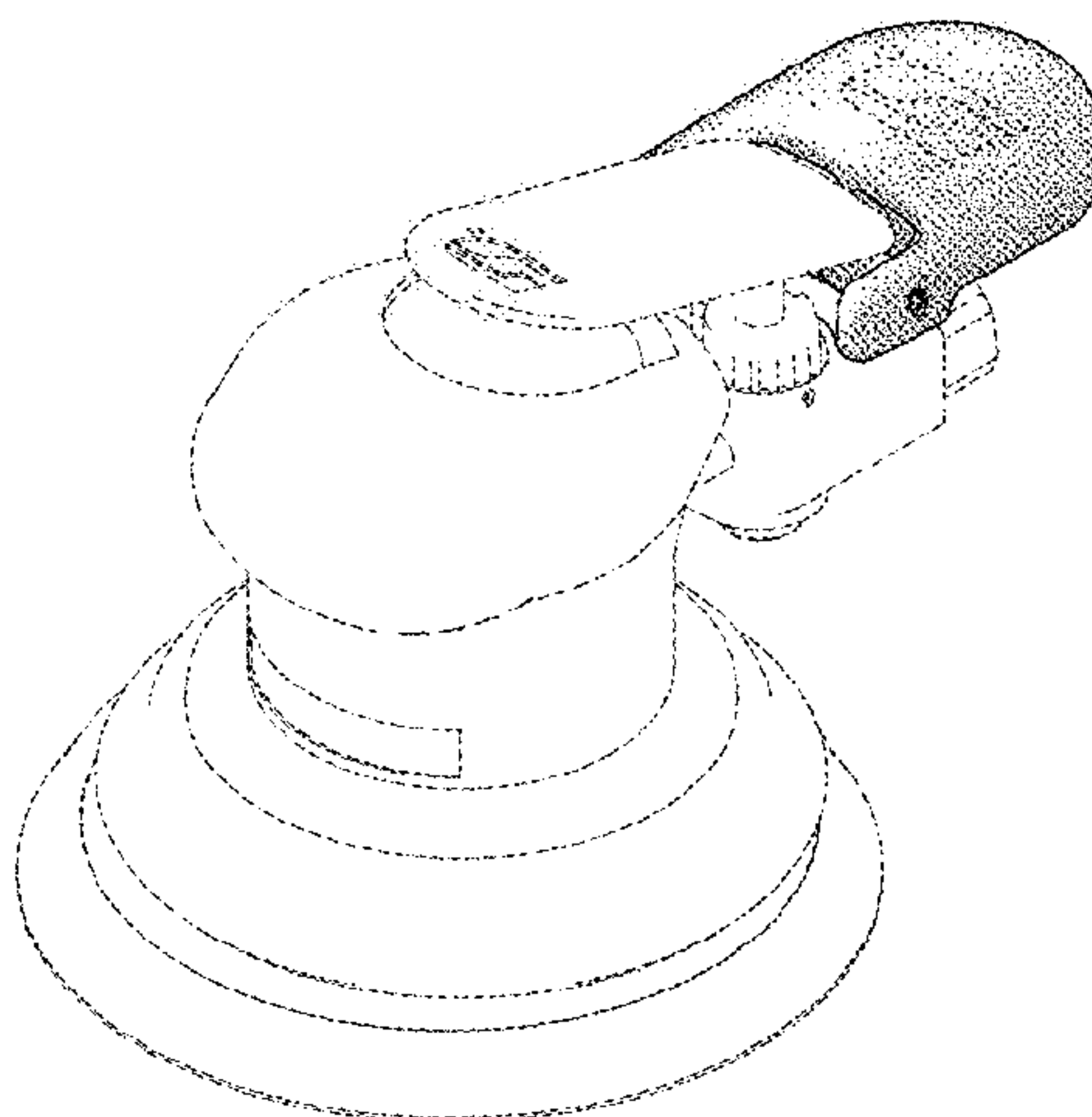
FIG. 6 is a right elevational view of the wrist rest for a rotary abrading tool;

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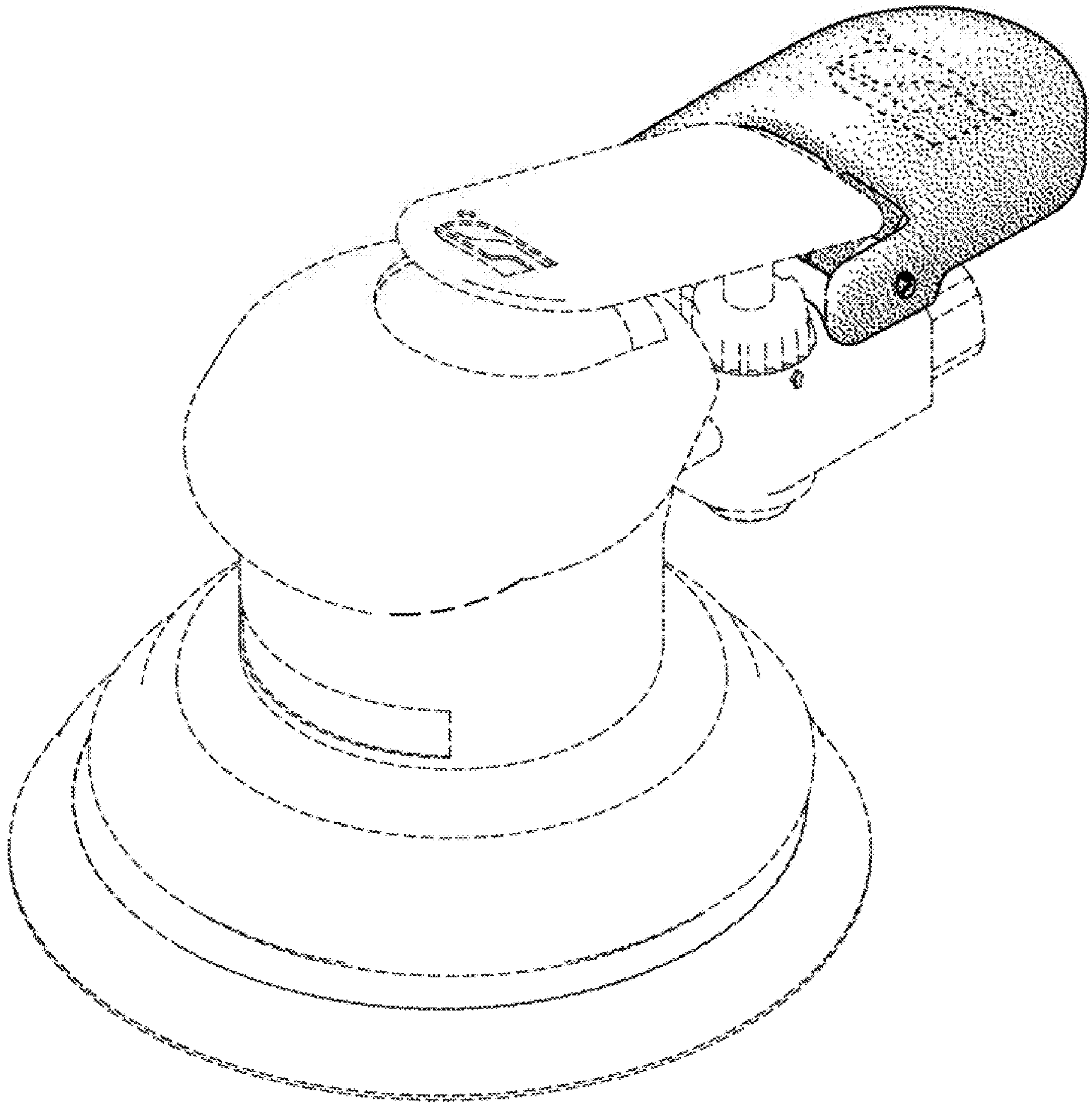

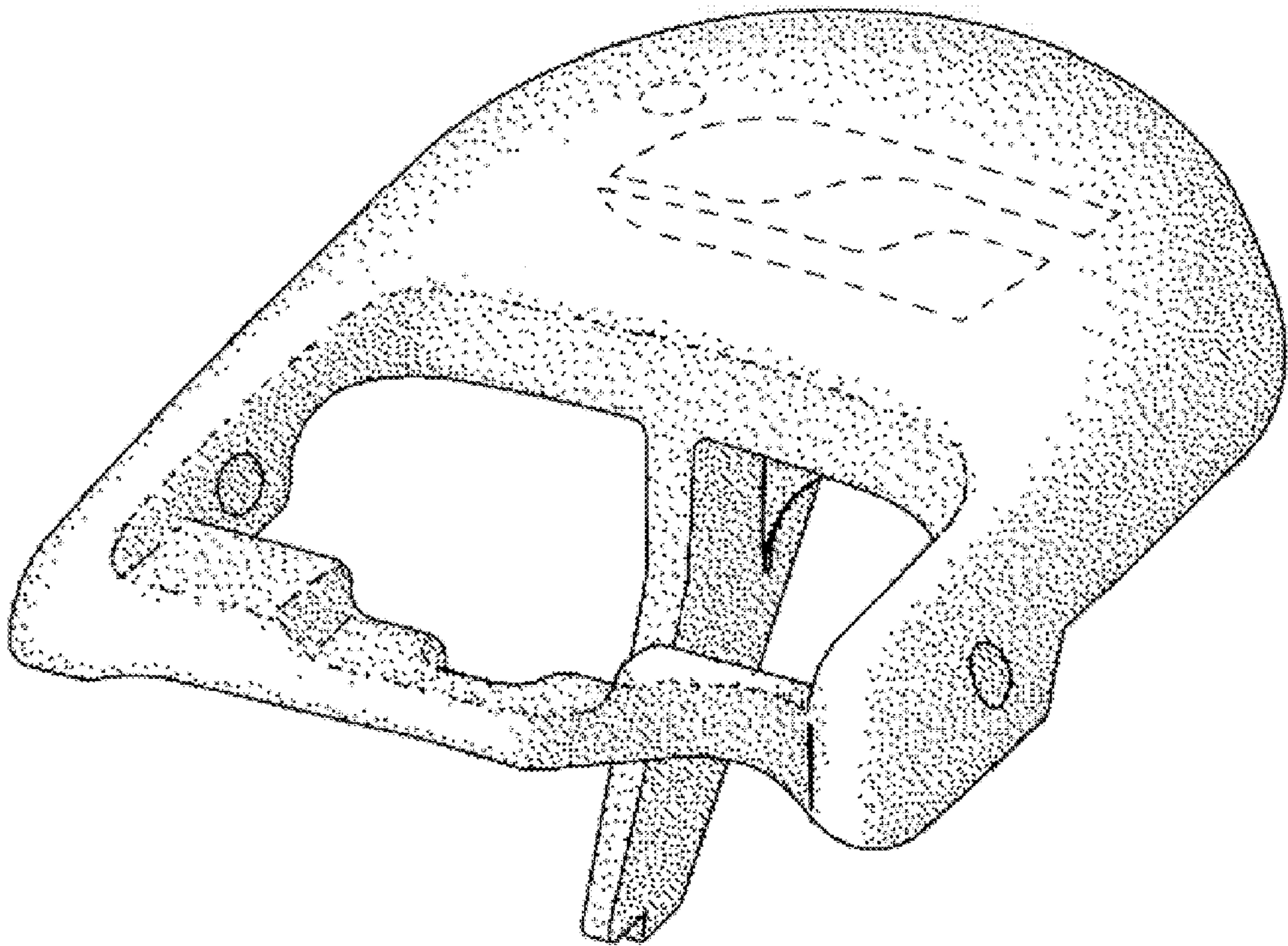

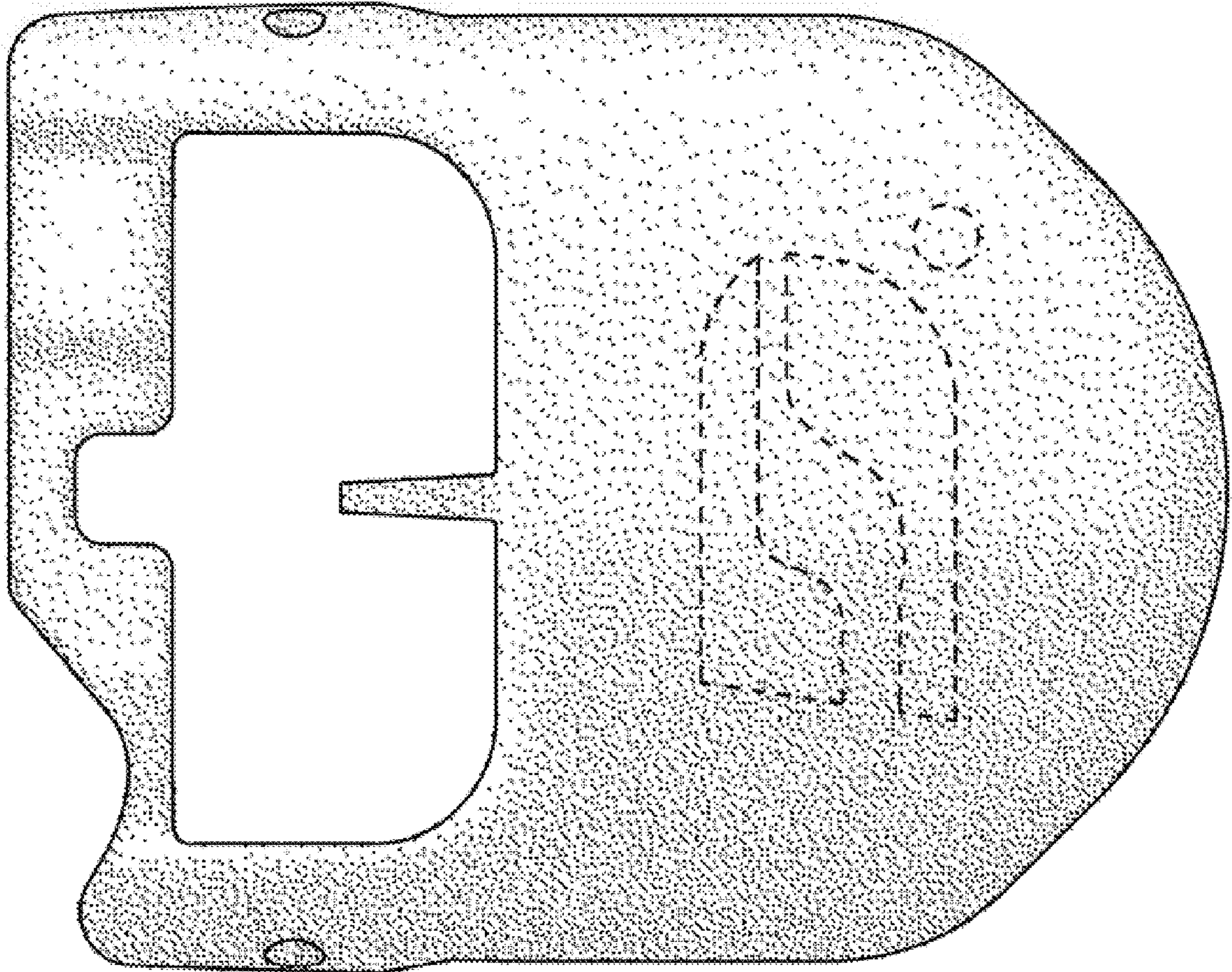

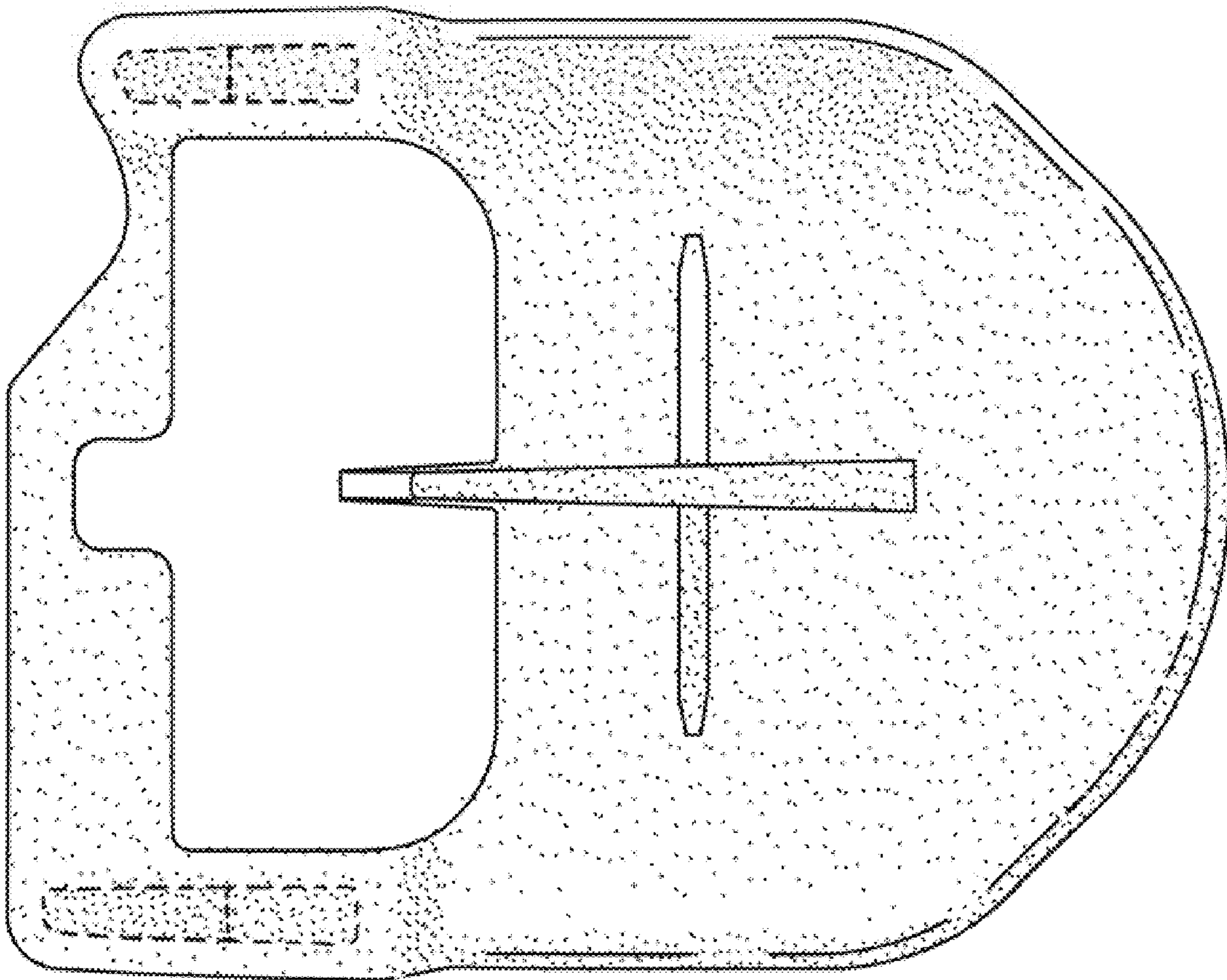

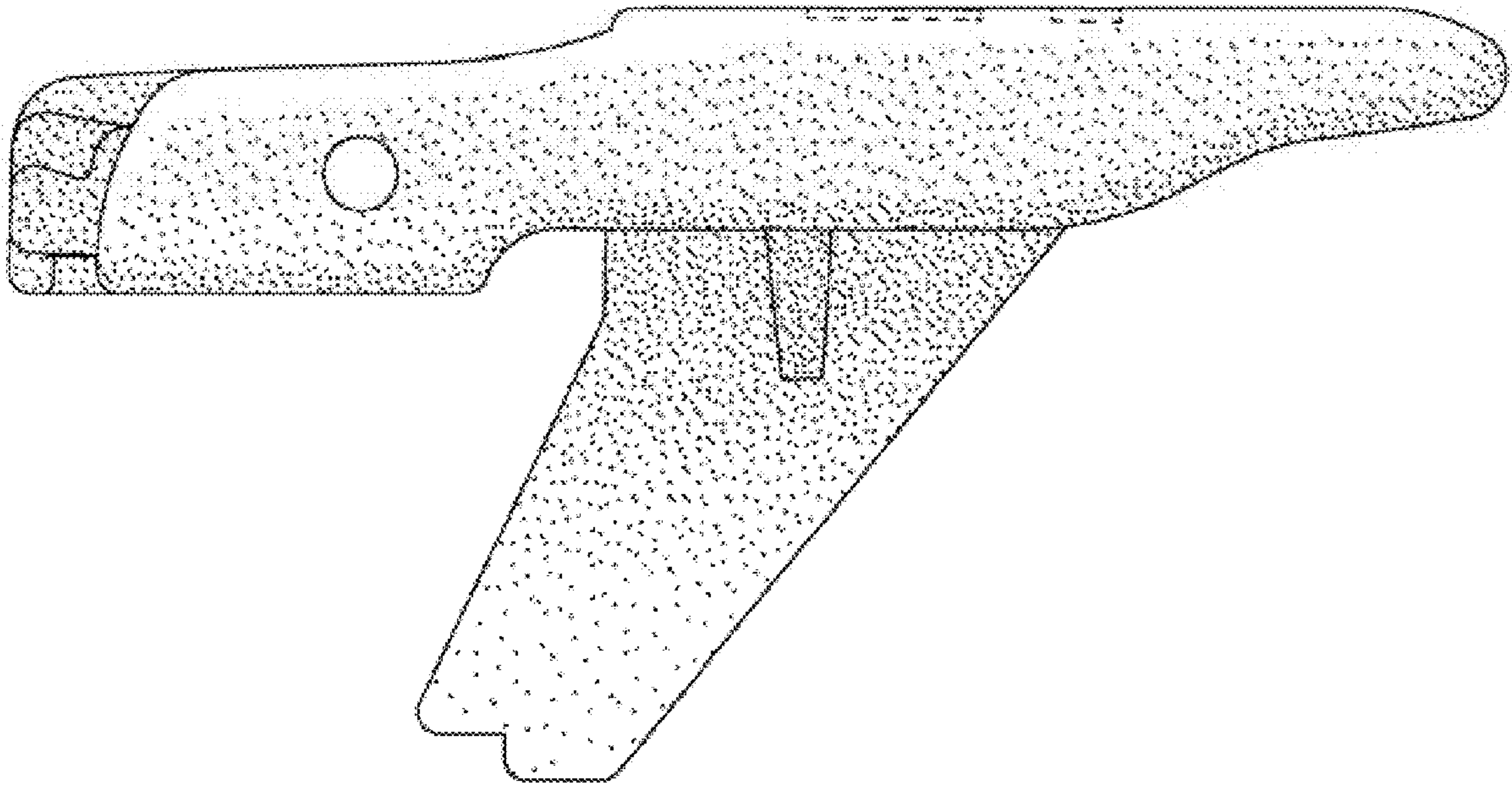

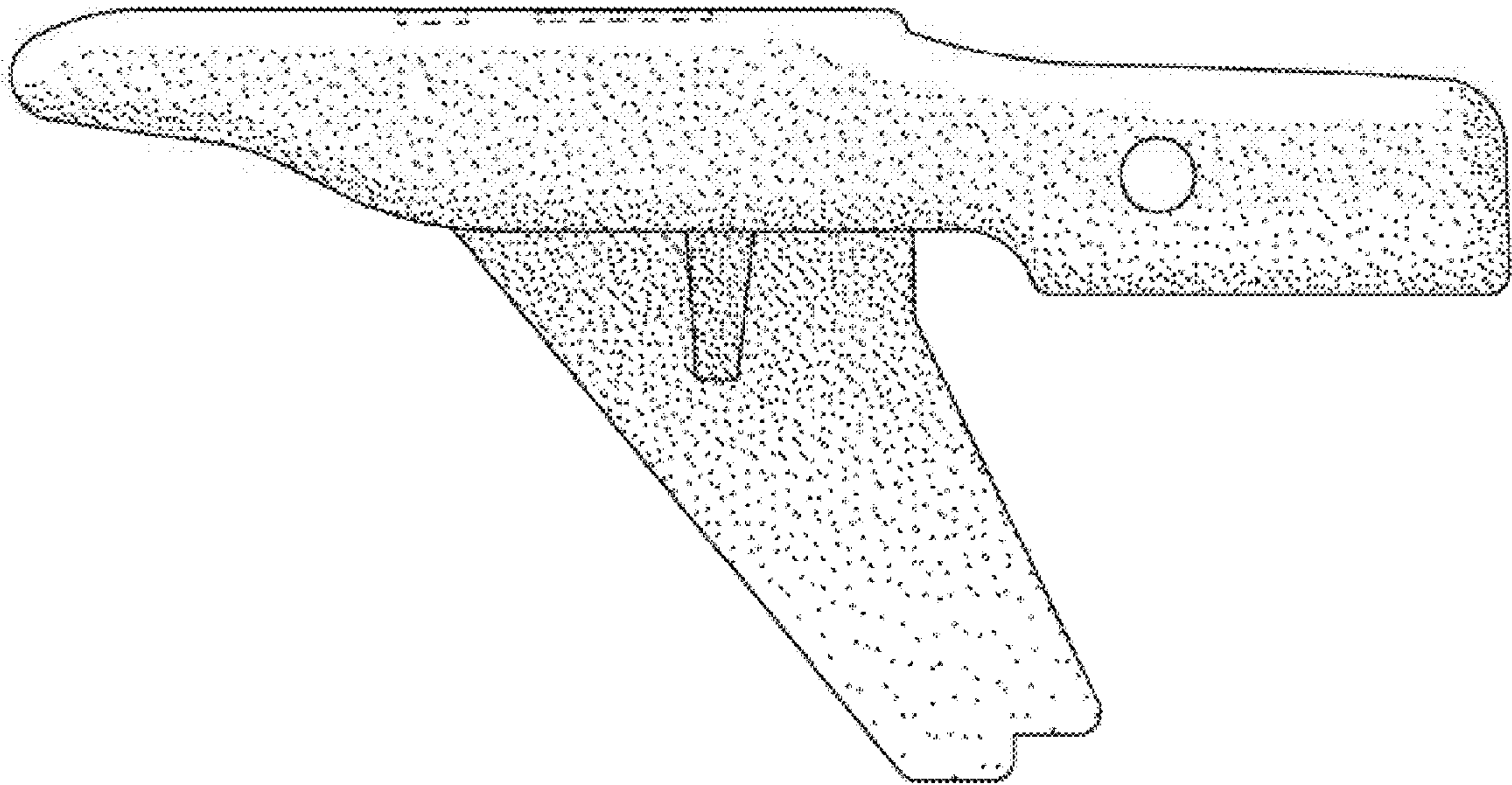

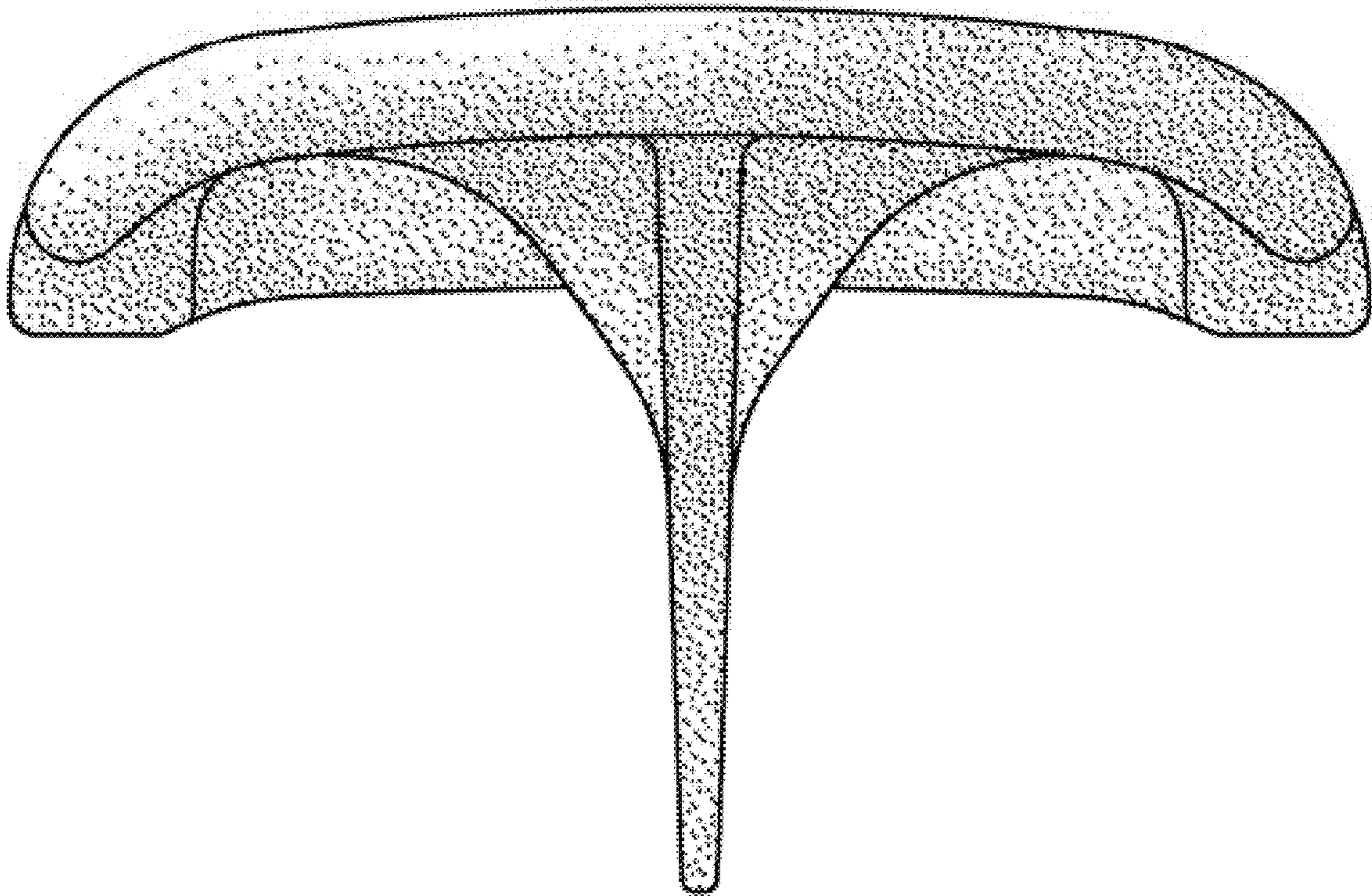

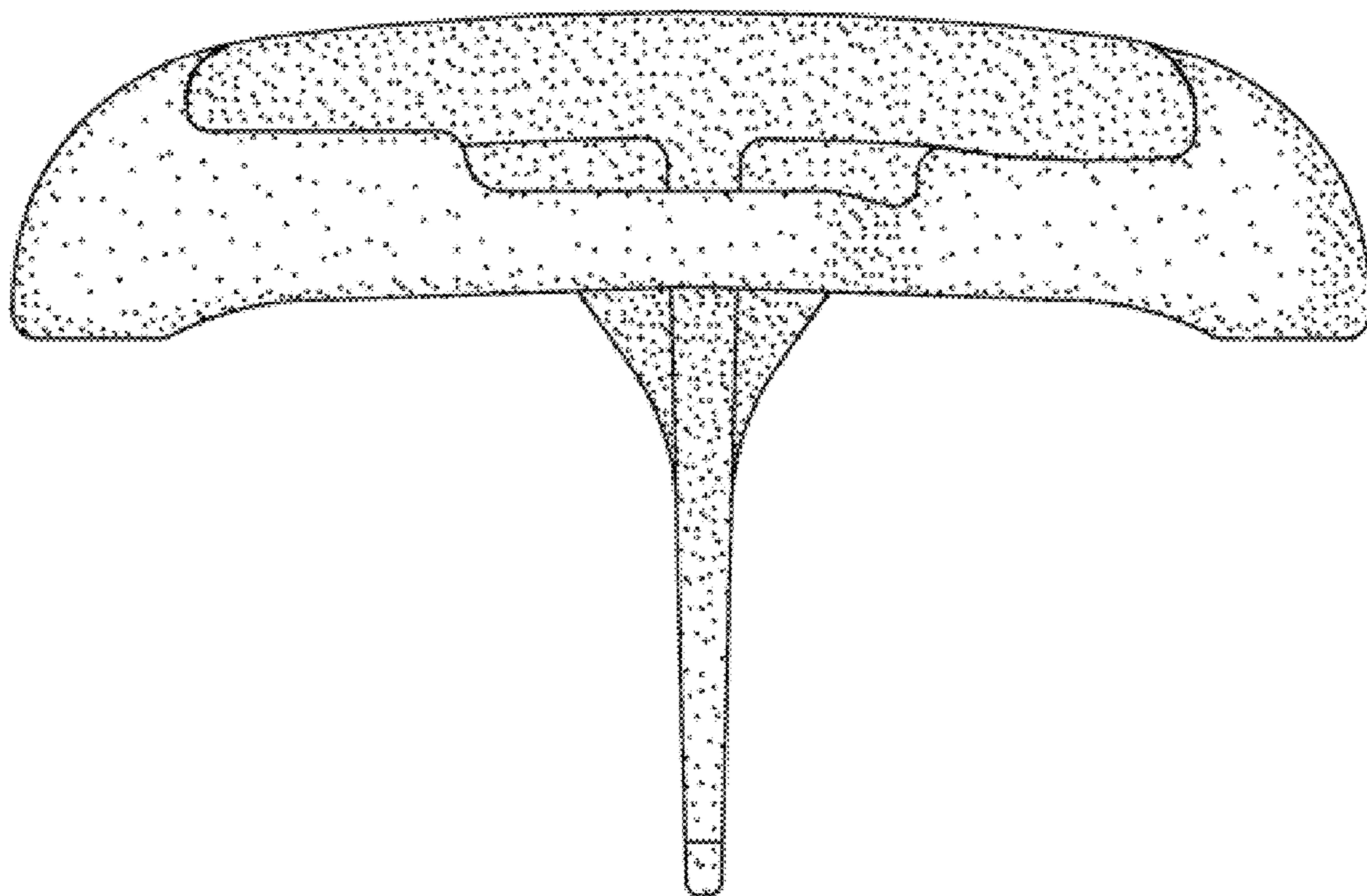
