serving bowl.

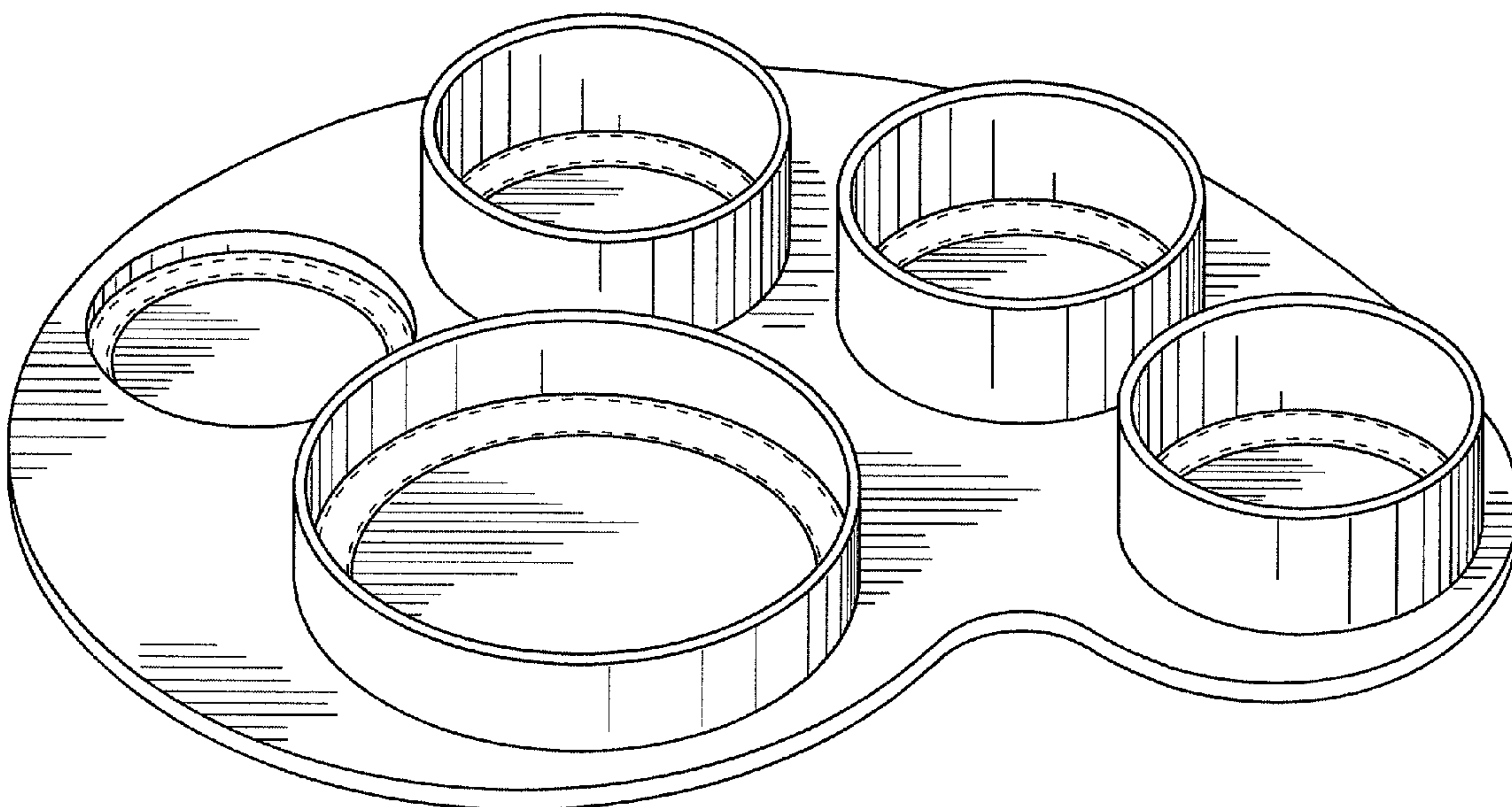
FIG. 2 is a top elevational view of a children's dining set with

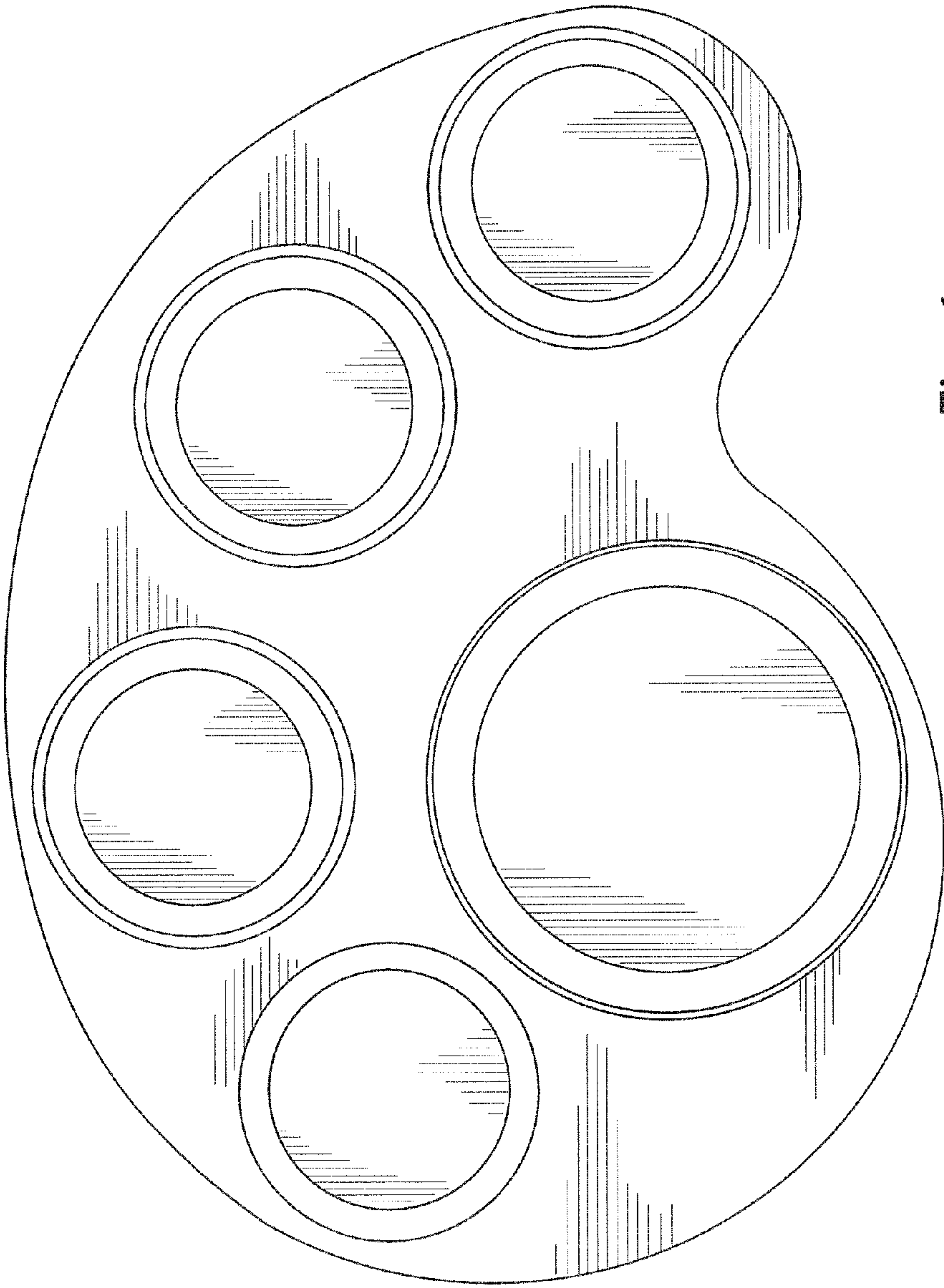

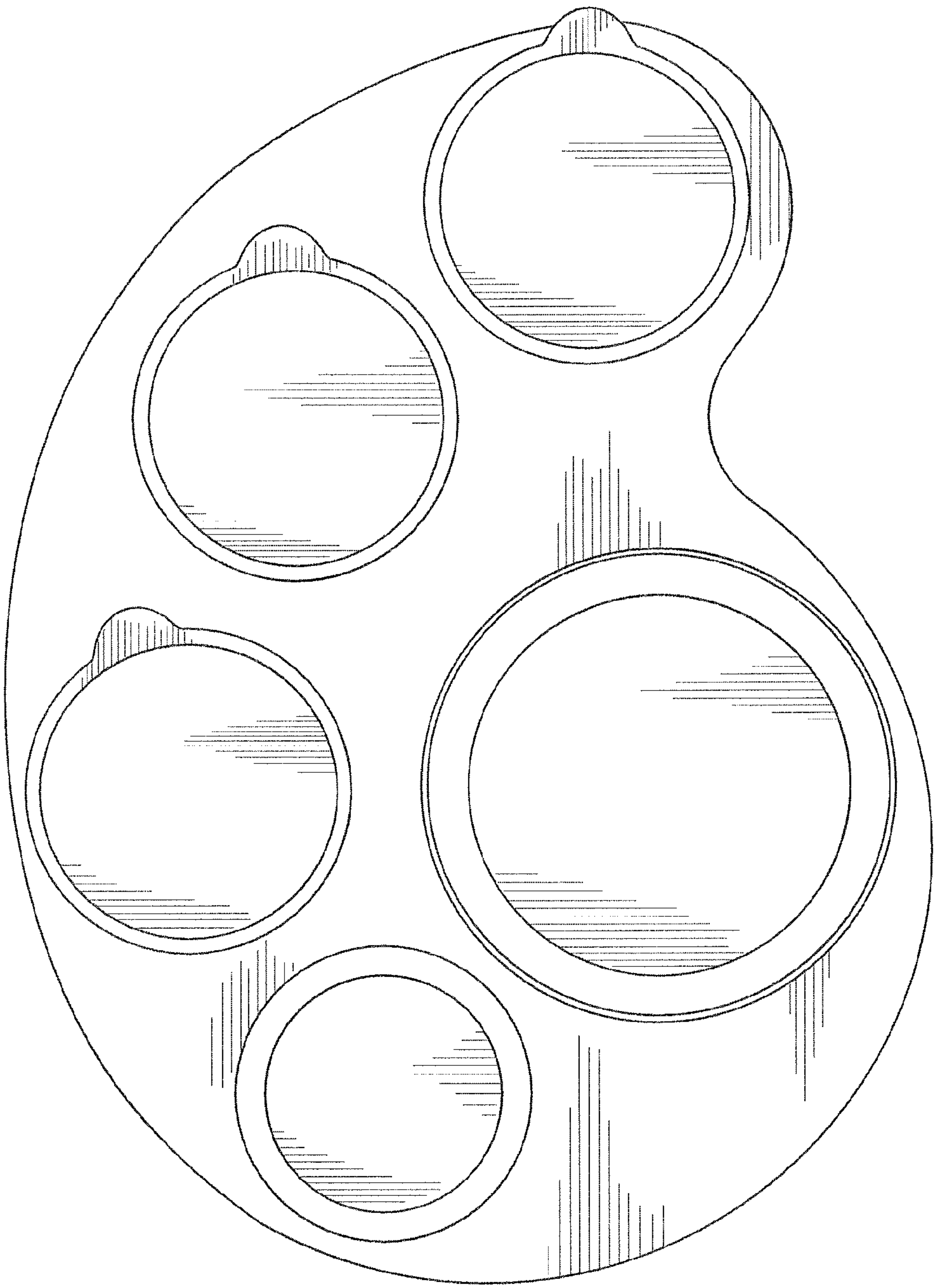

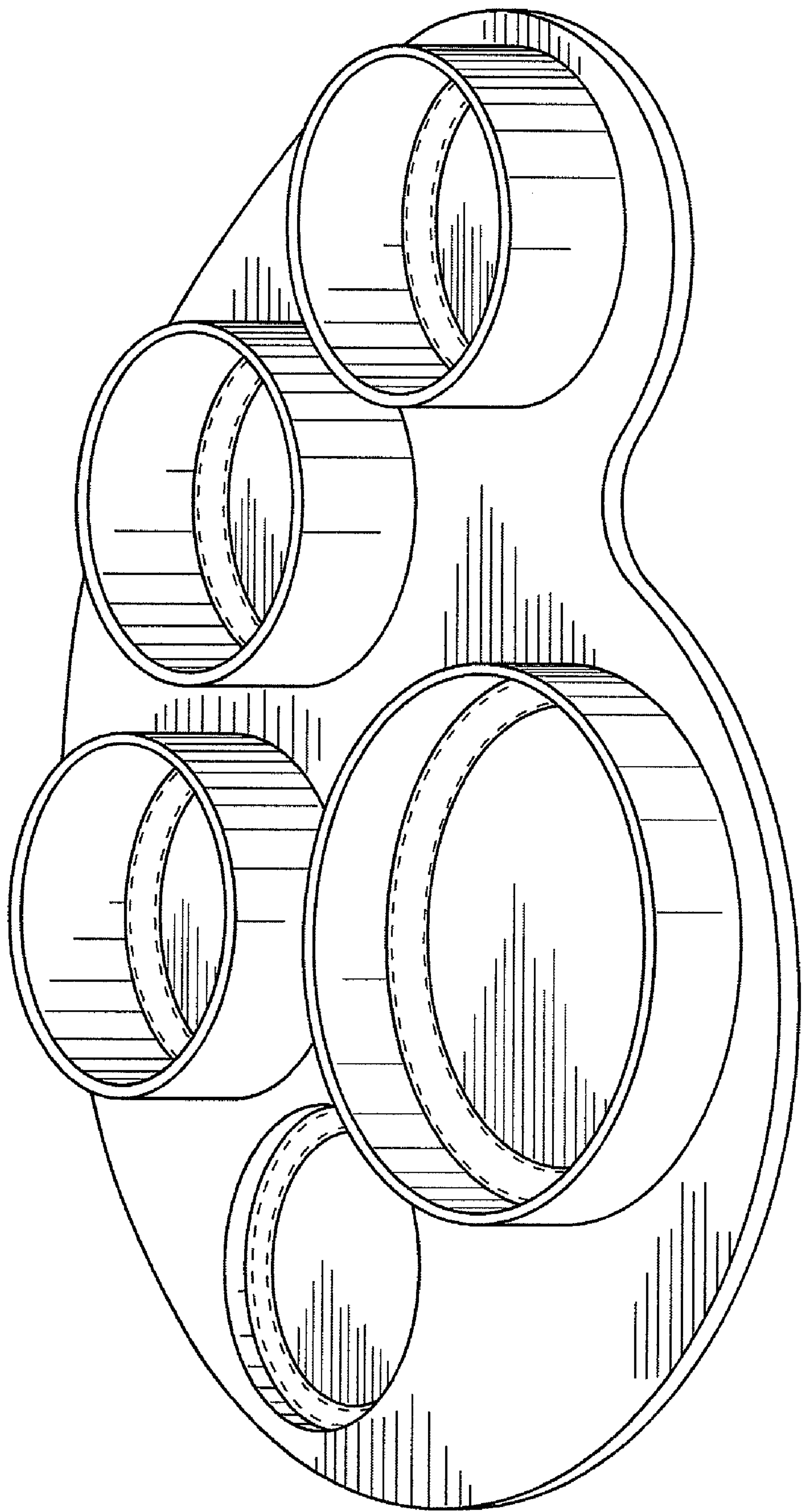

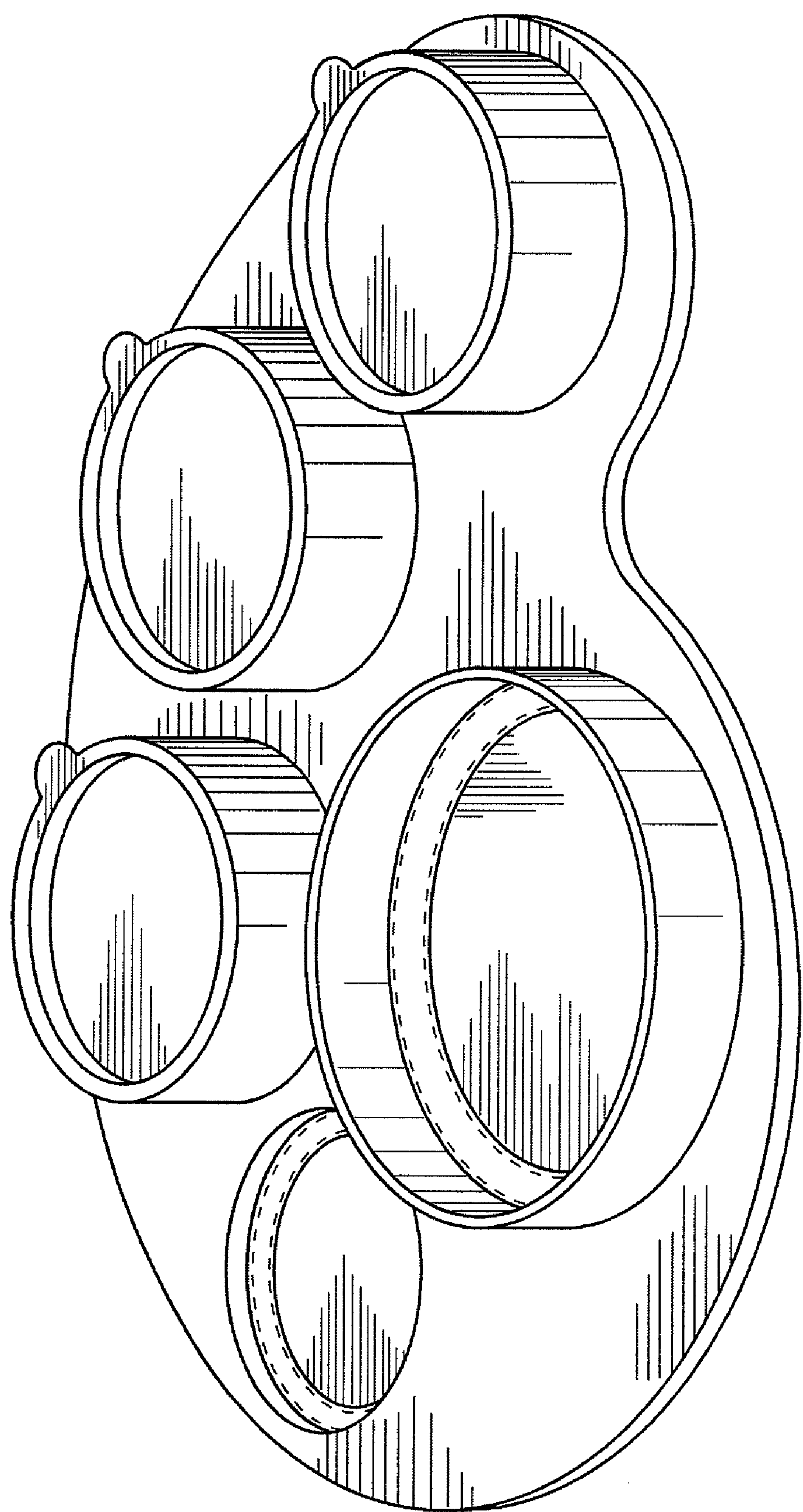
