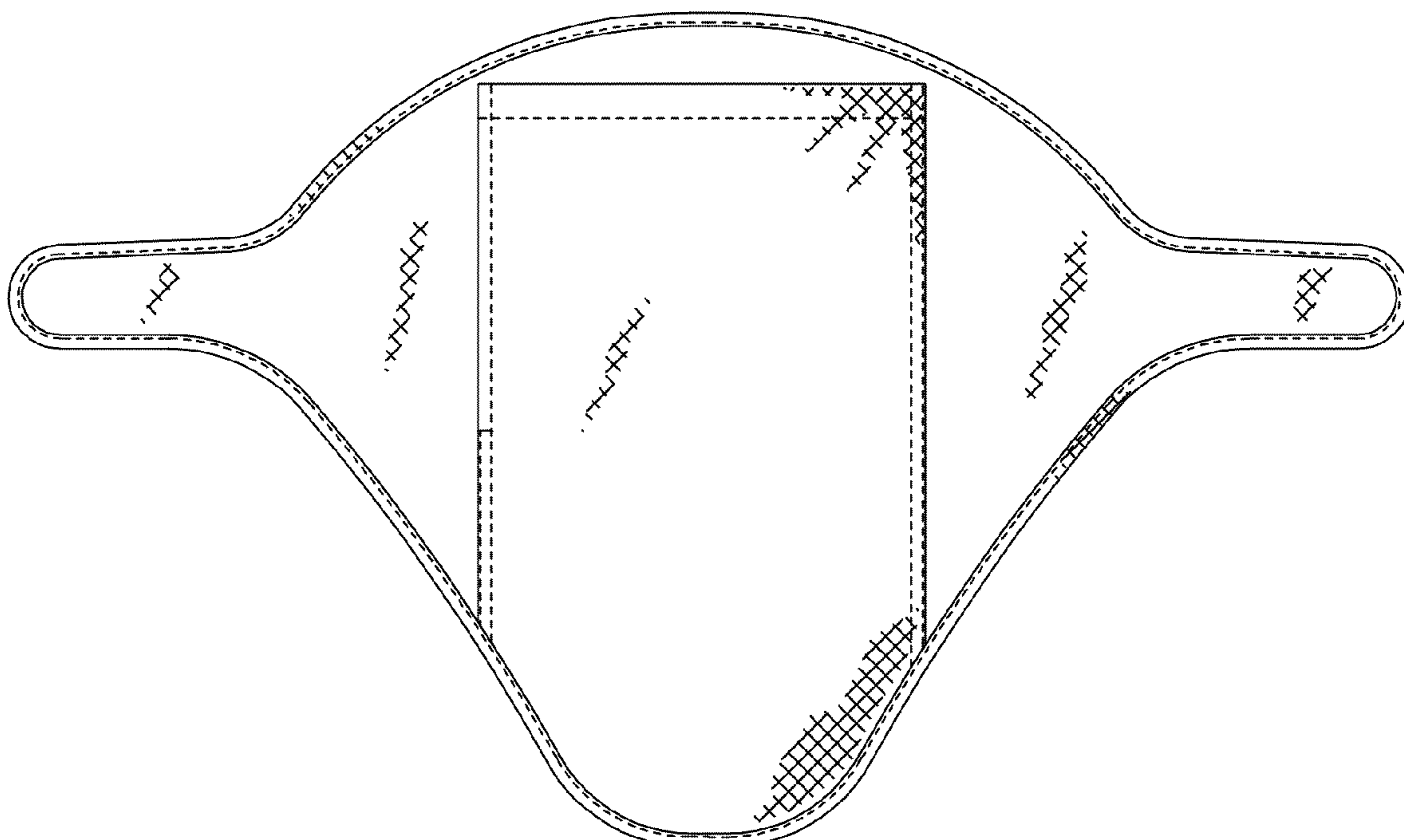
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a swaddle blanket, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the swaddle blanket of the present invention showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a back plan view thereof.

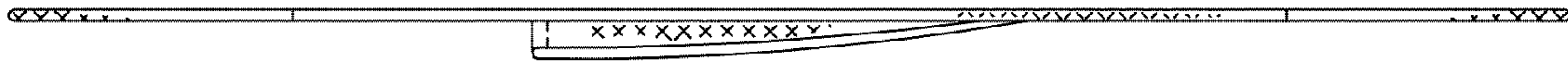

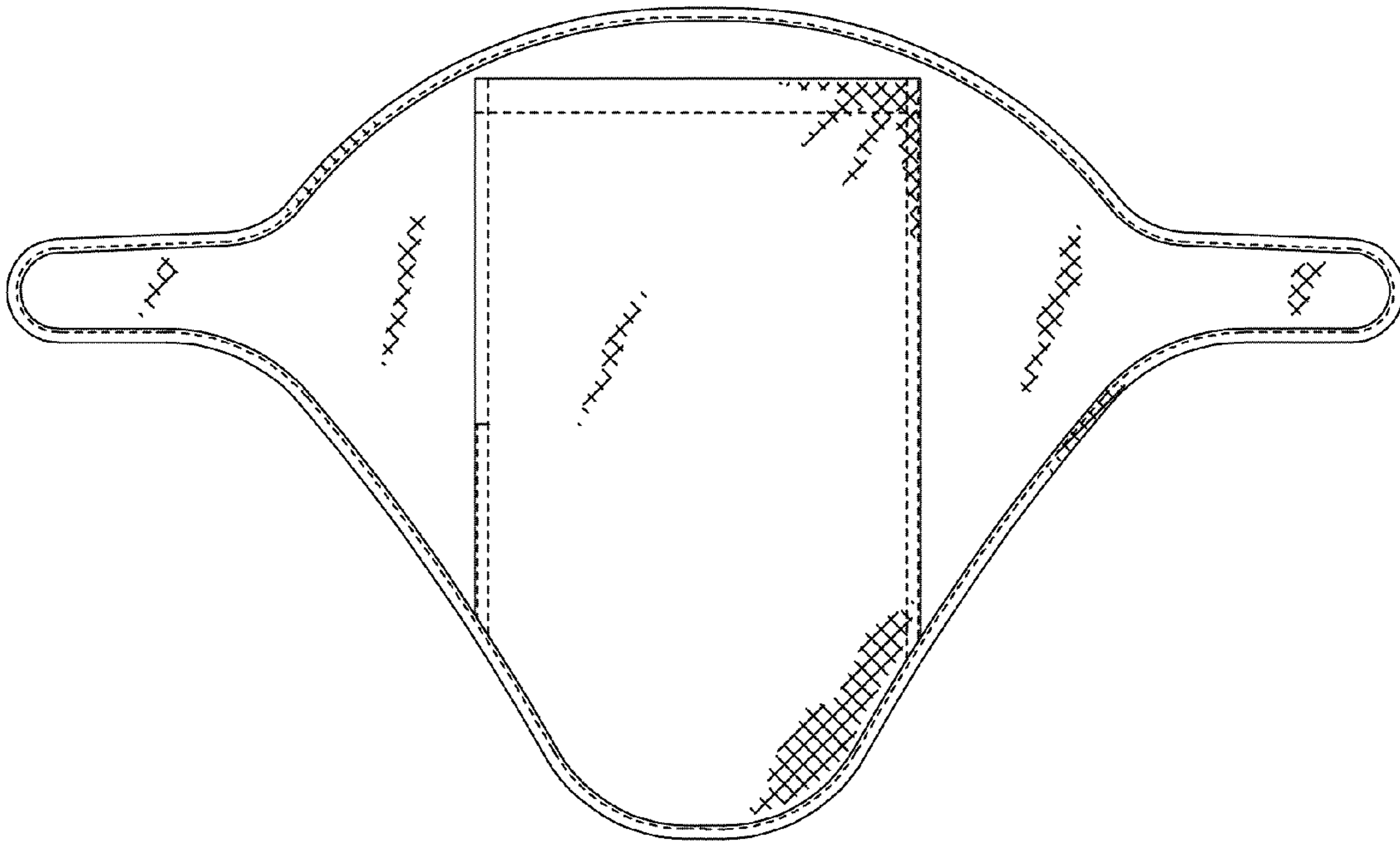

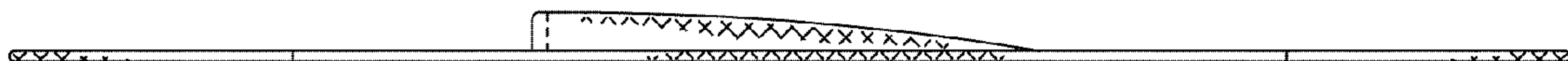

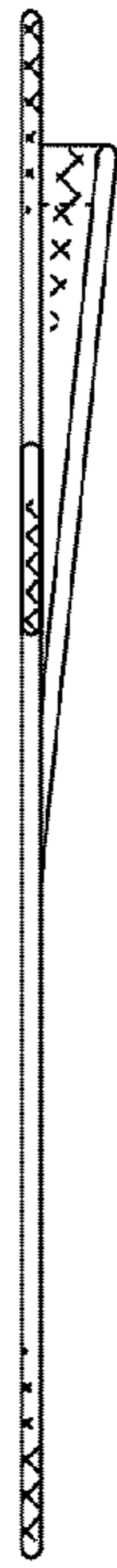

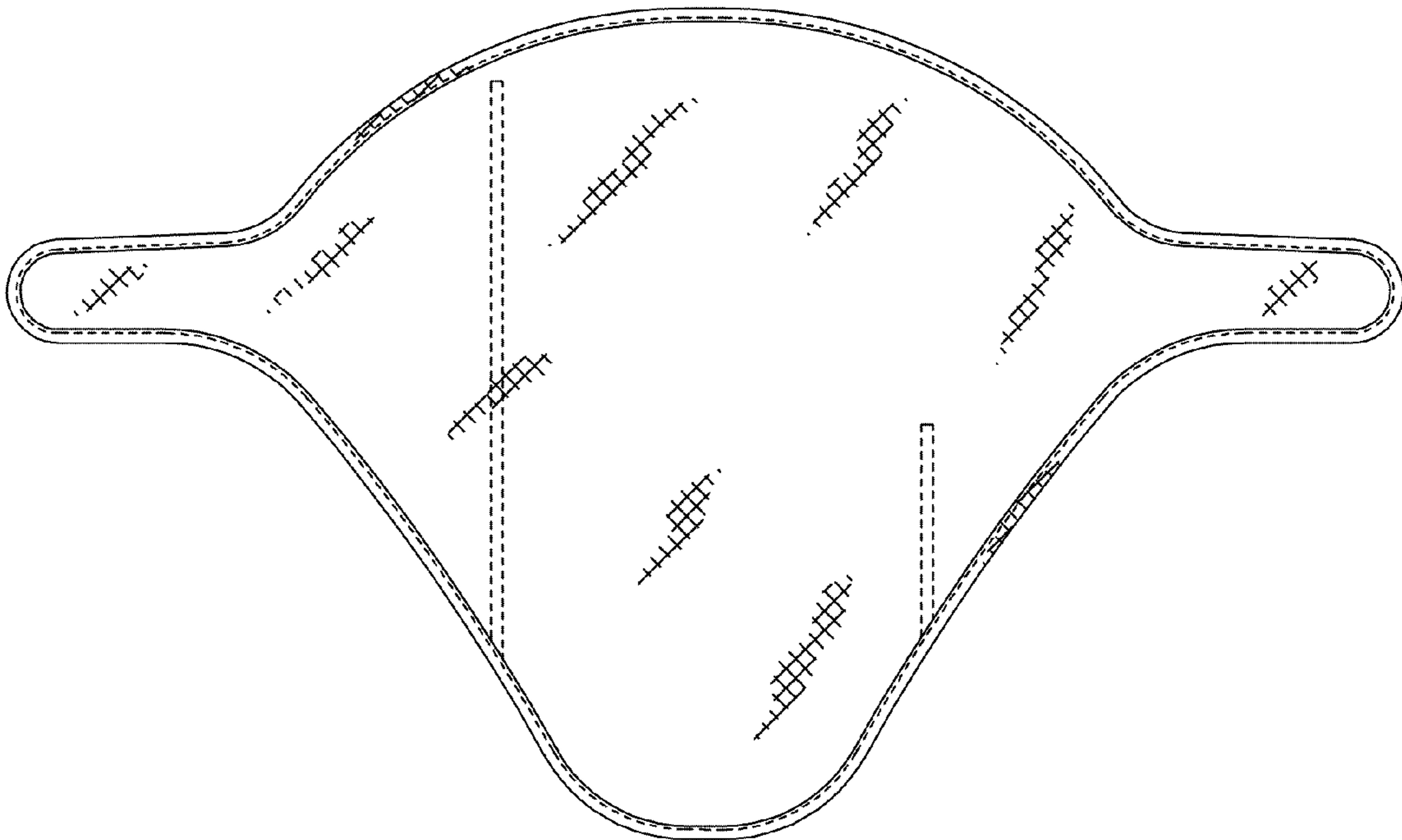
