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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a set of handles with grips for performing exercises, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a set of handles with grips for performing exercises, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the left handle of FIG. 1, the right side elevational view of the right handle being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the left handle of FIG. 1, the left side elevational view of the right handle being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the left handle, the rear elevational view of the right handle being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the left handle, the front elevational view of the right handle being a mirror image thereof;

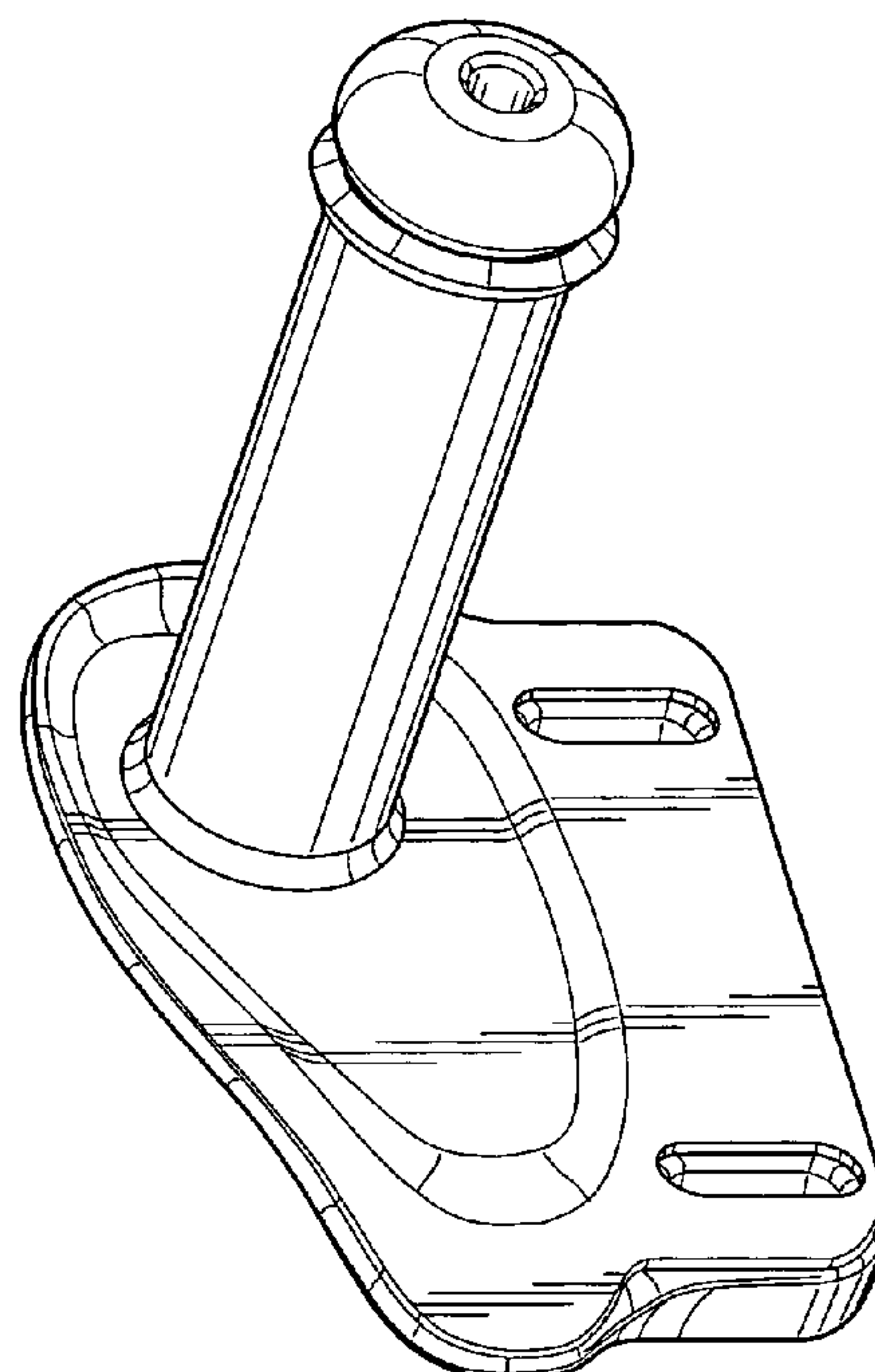
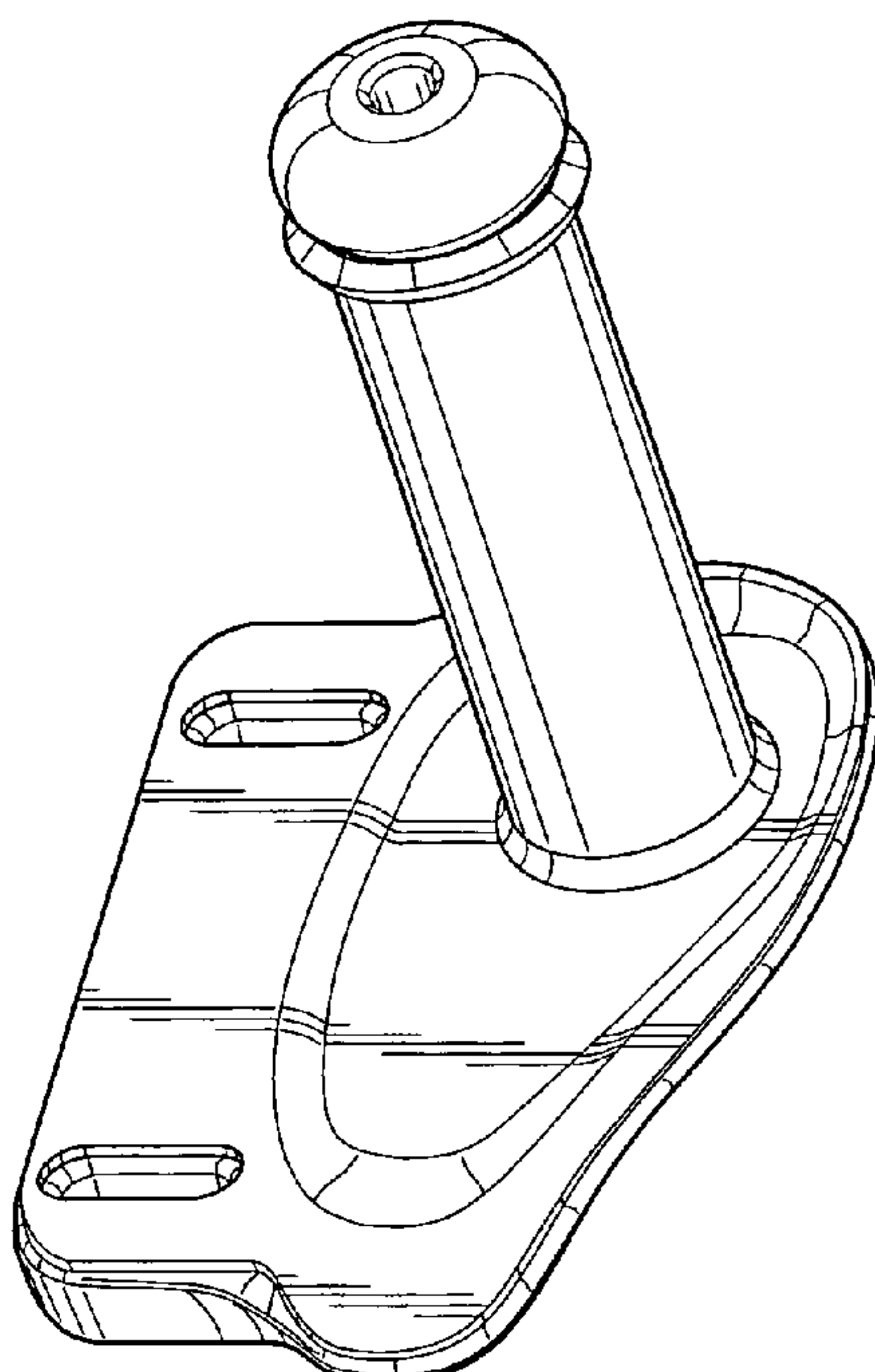
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the left handle, the top plan view of the right handle being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the left handle, the bottom plan view of the right handle being a mirror image thereof; and,

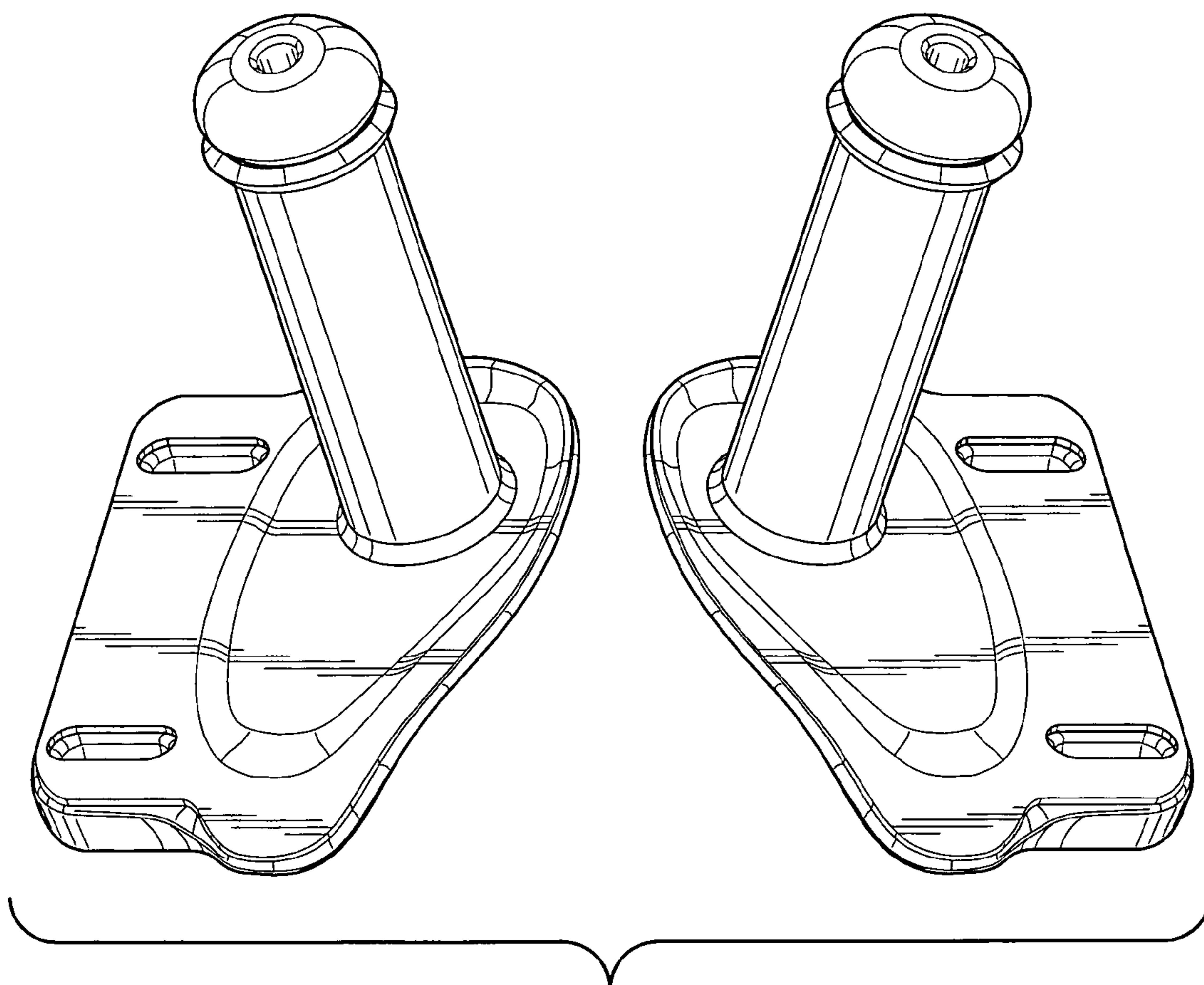

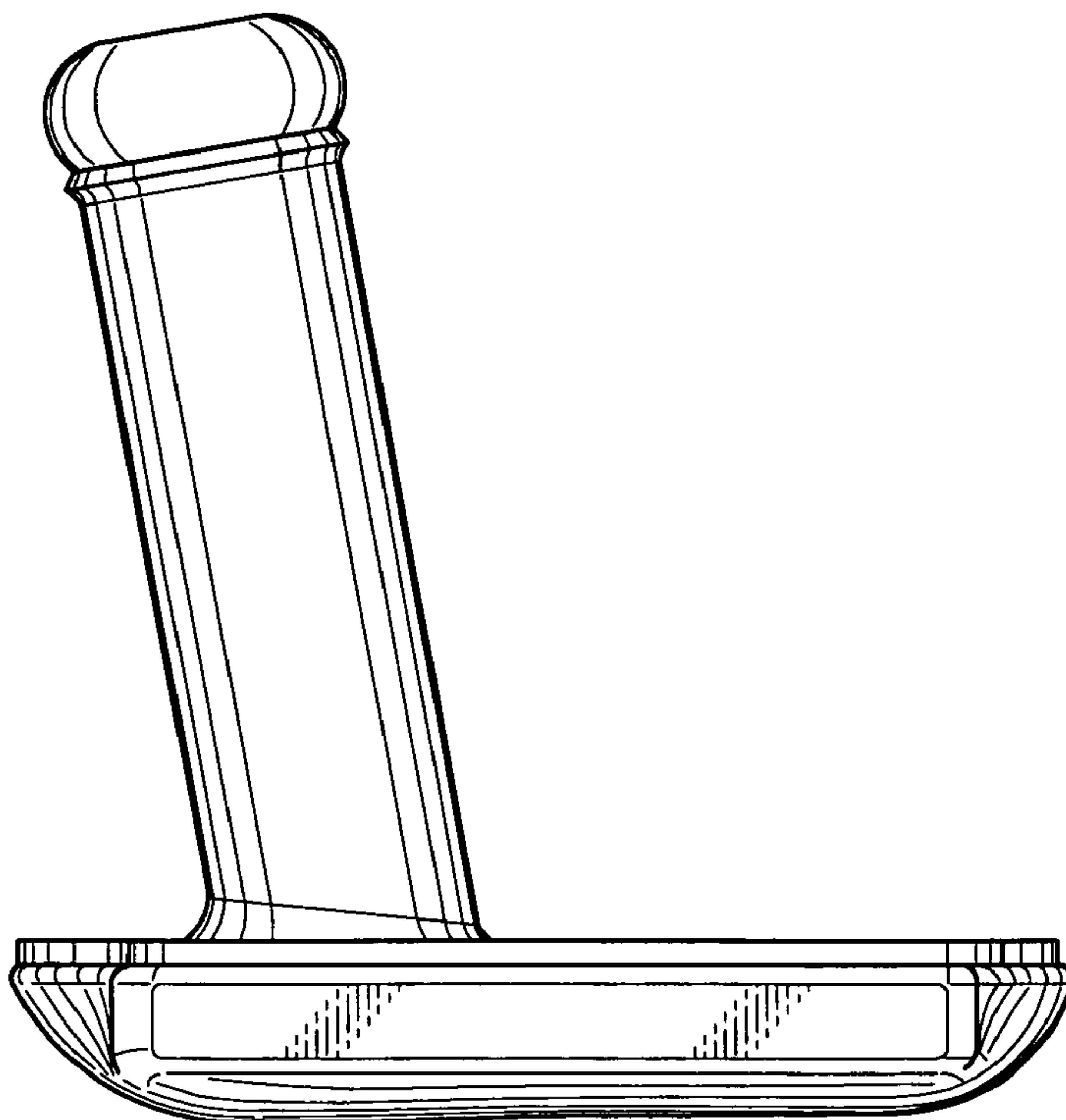

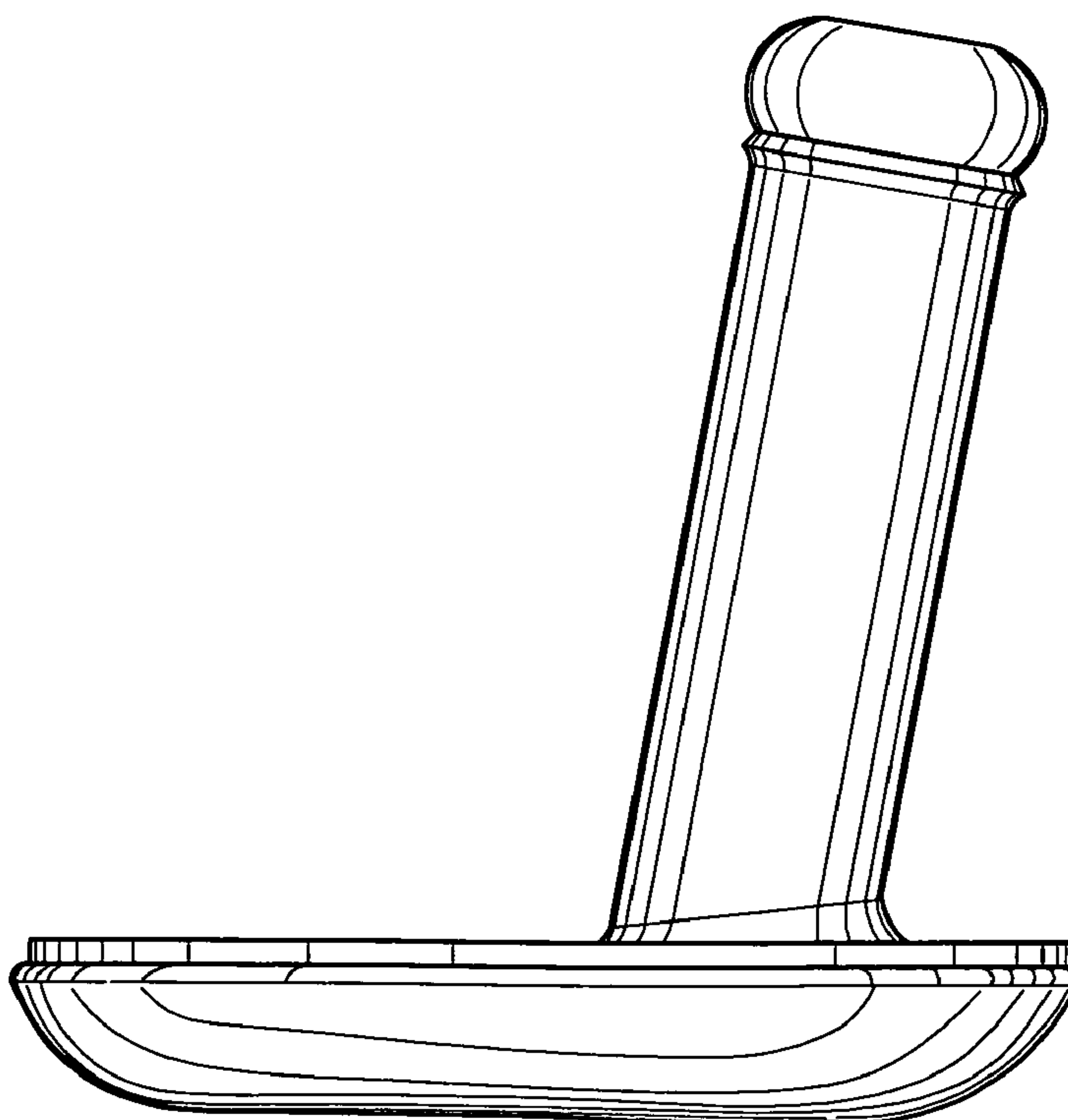

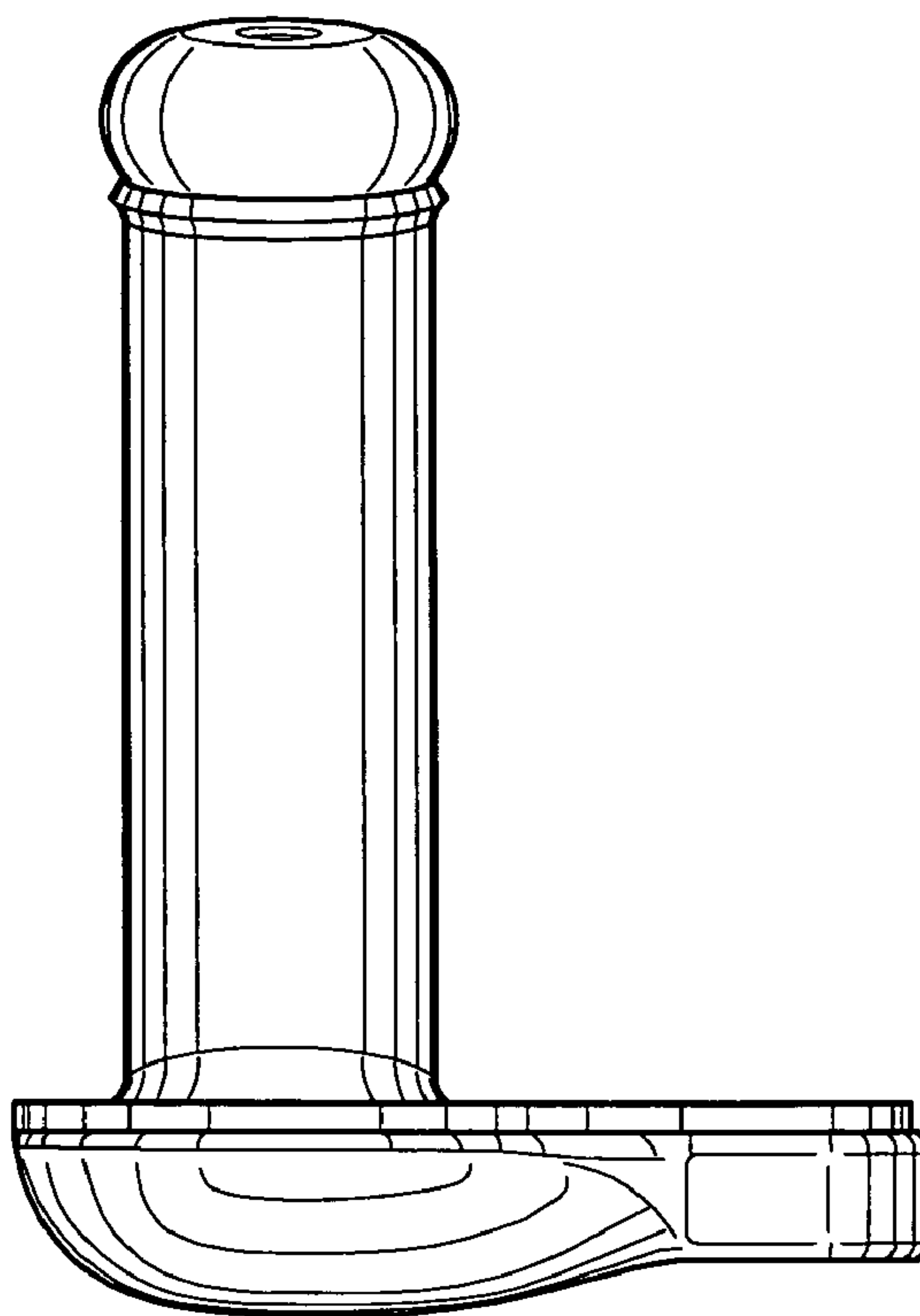

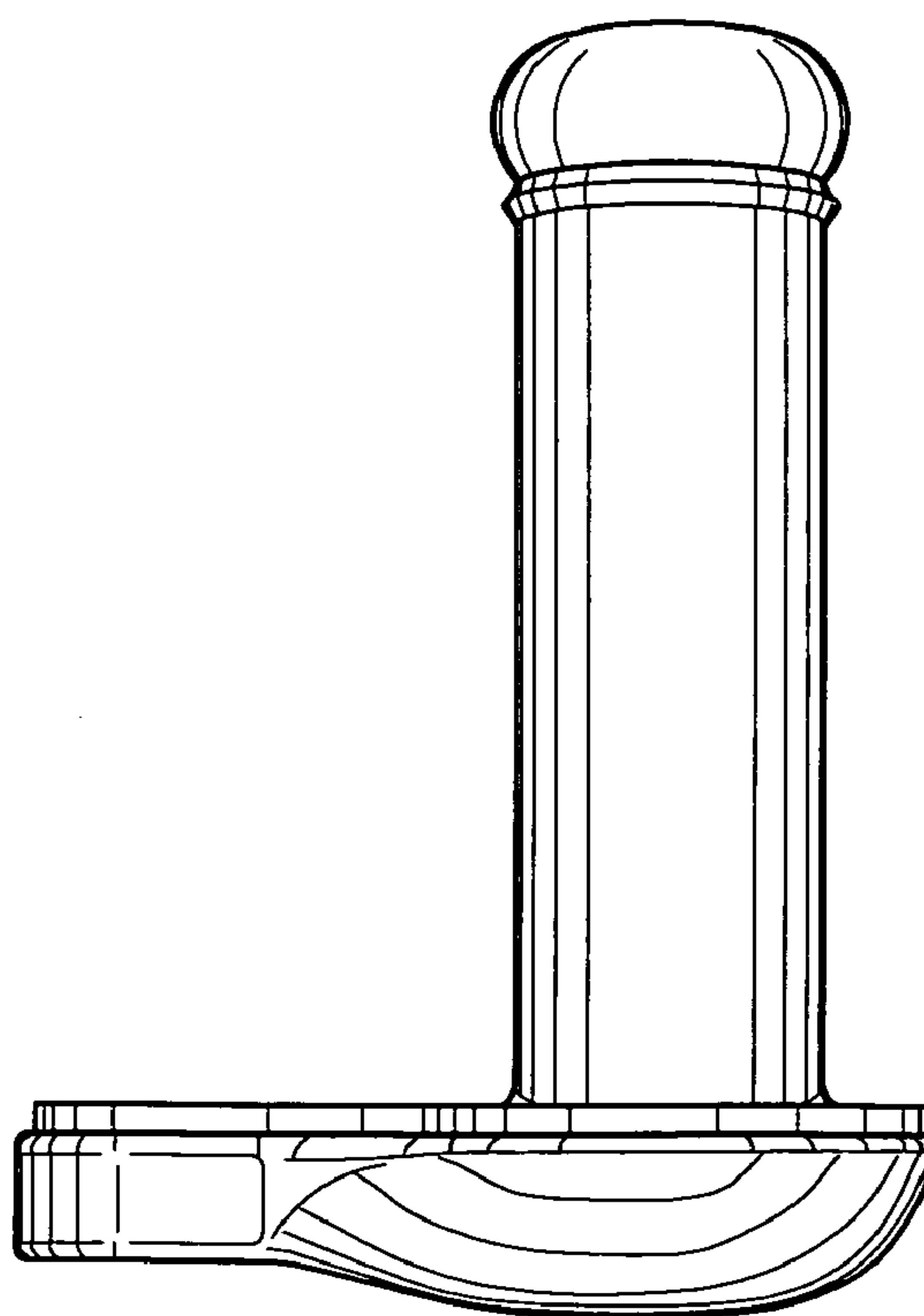

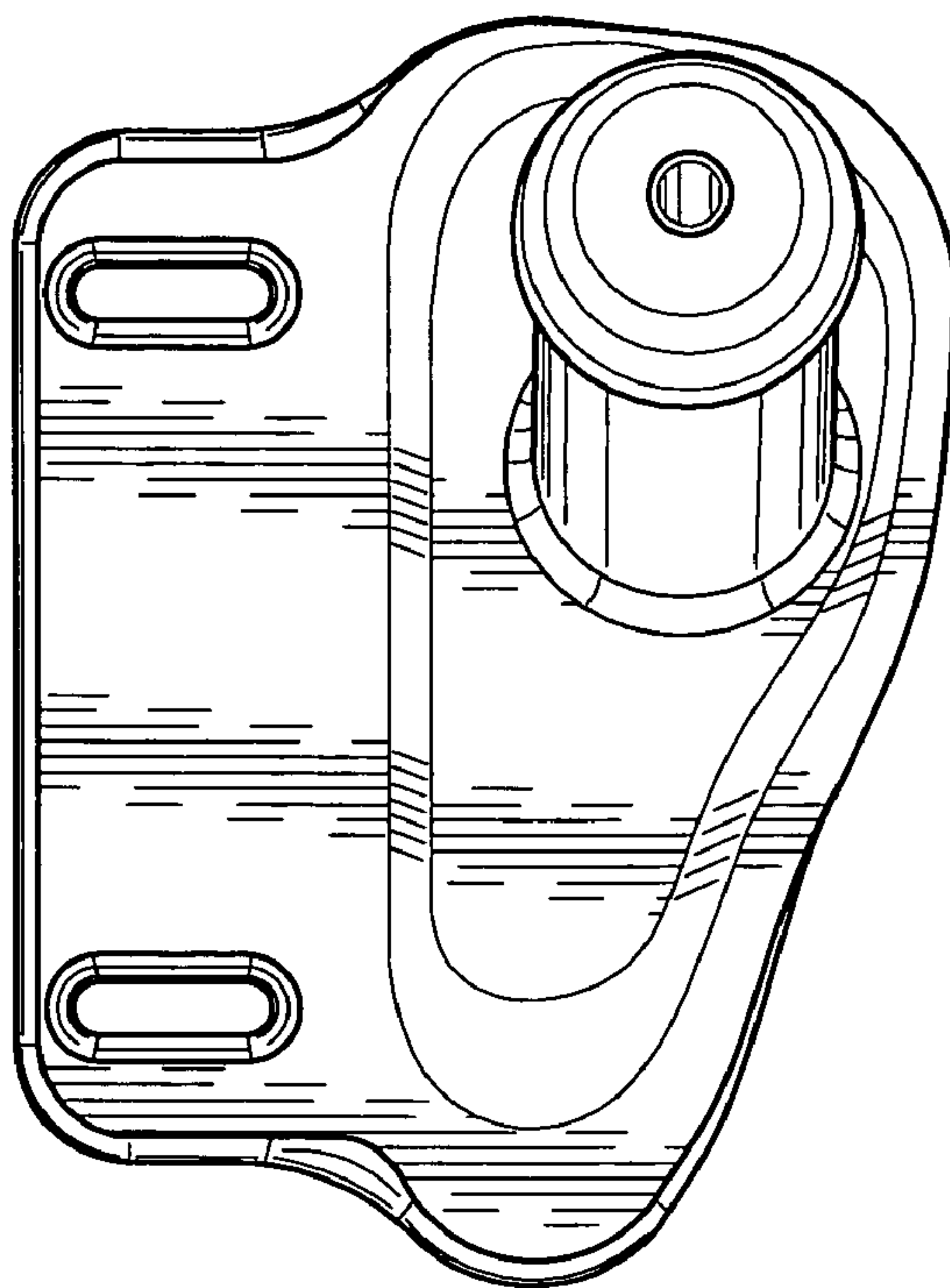

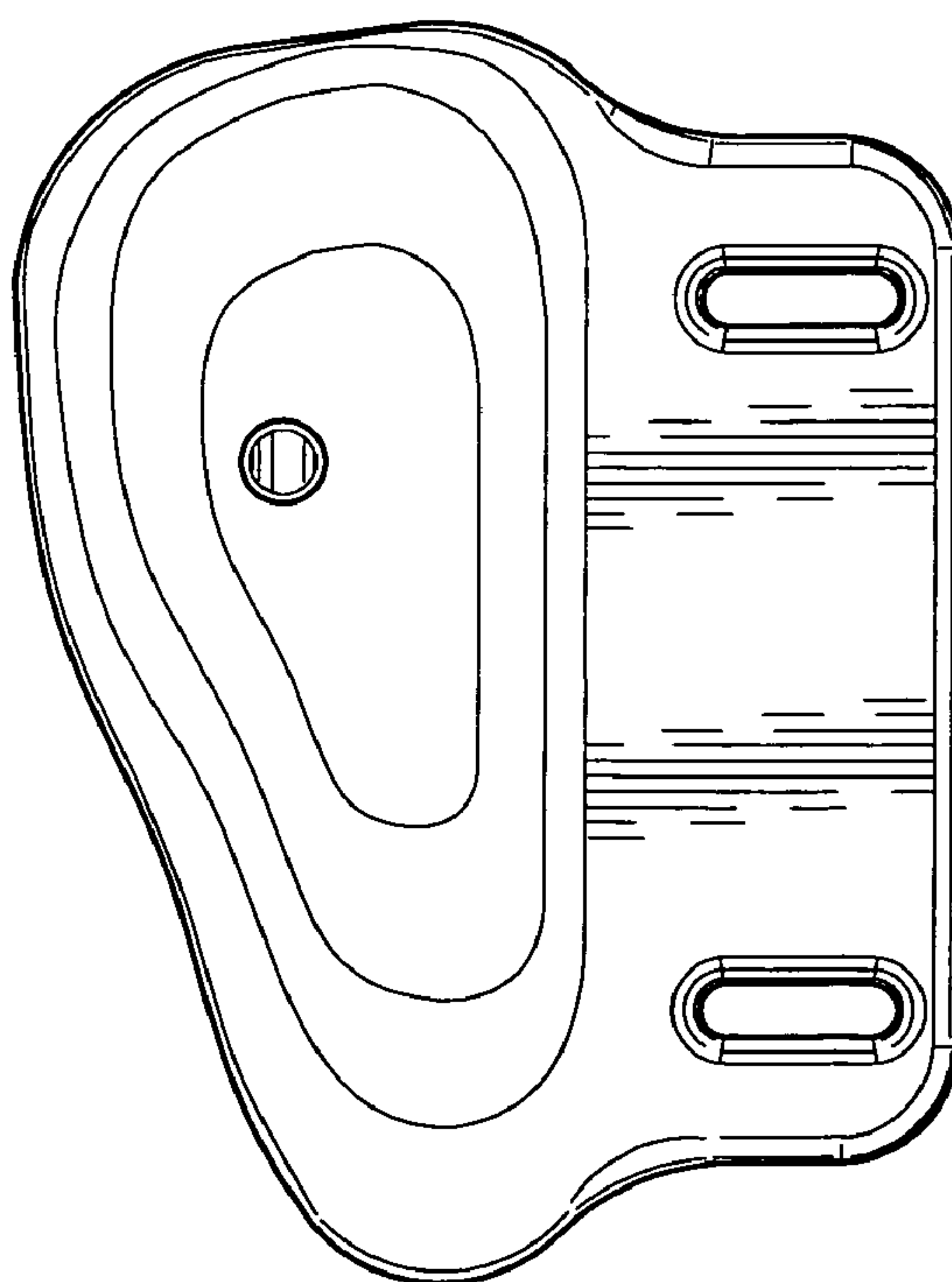

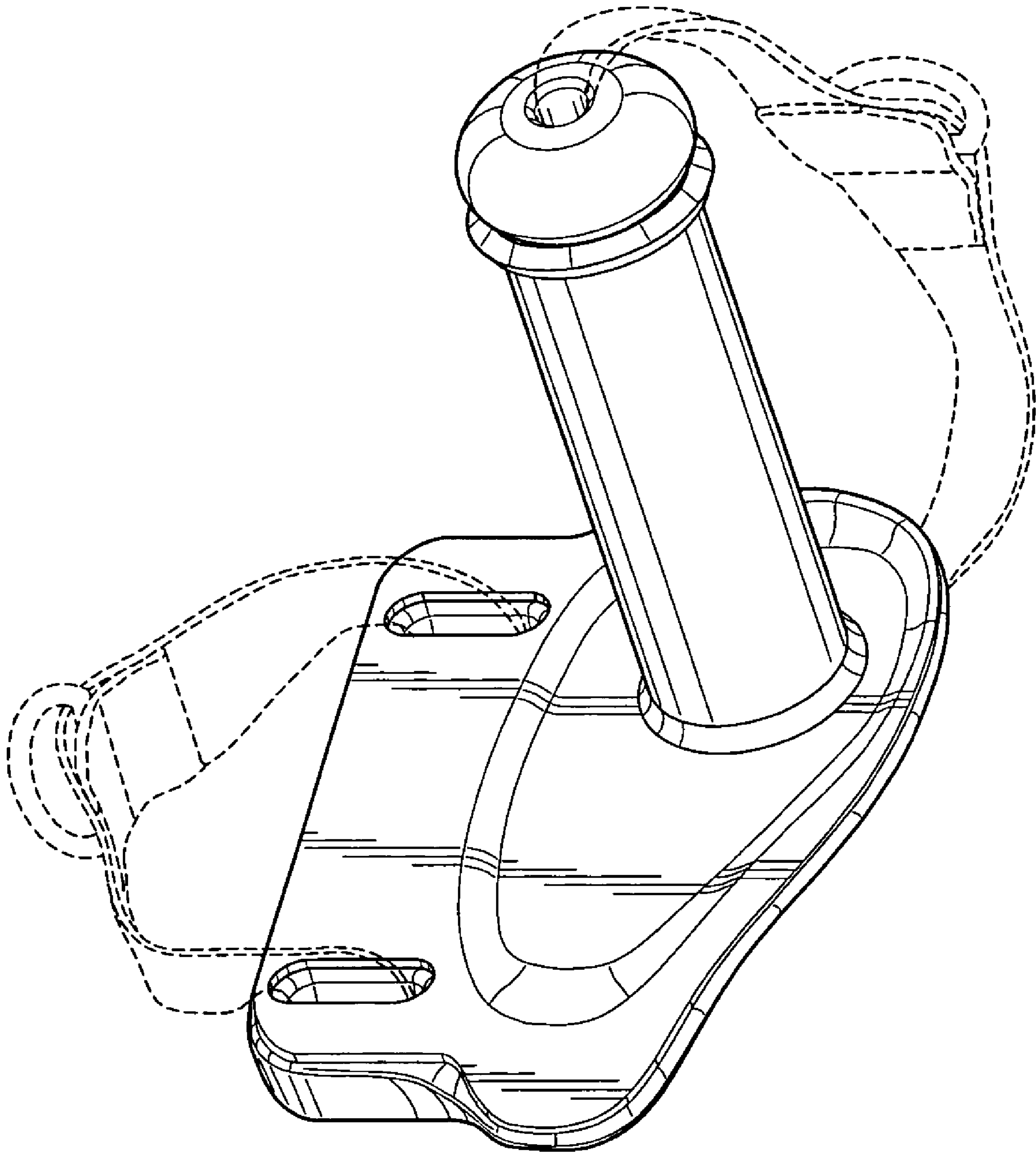
