(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a section of a handrail segment, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, left side perspective view of the section of a handrail segment of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof.

The interior of the handrail is shown in dashed lines and does not form part of the claimed design.

The drawings show a segment of the overall handrail, which contains a plurality of such segments.

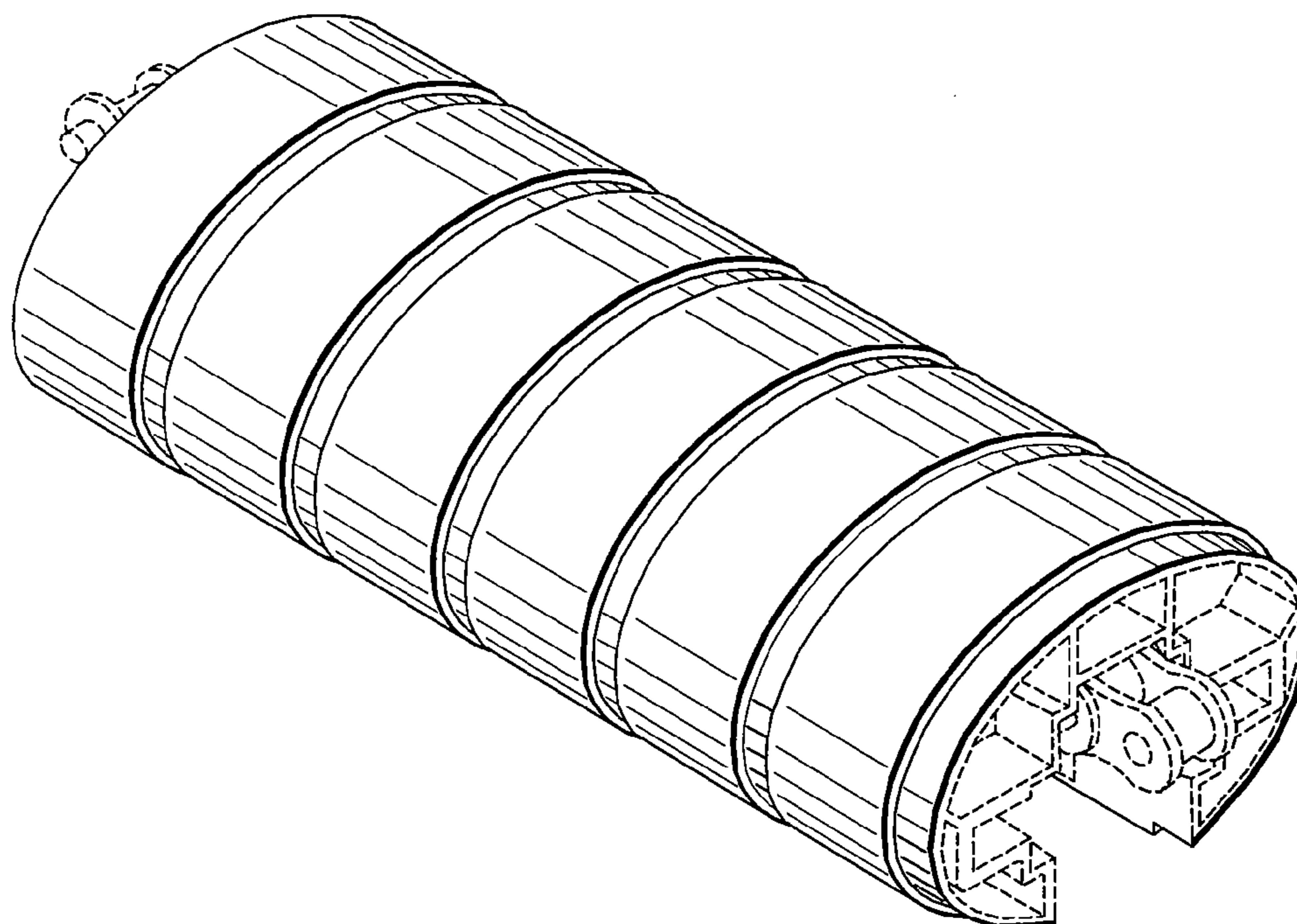

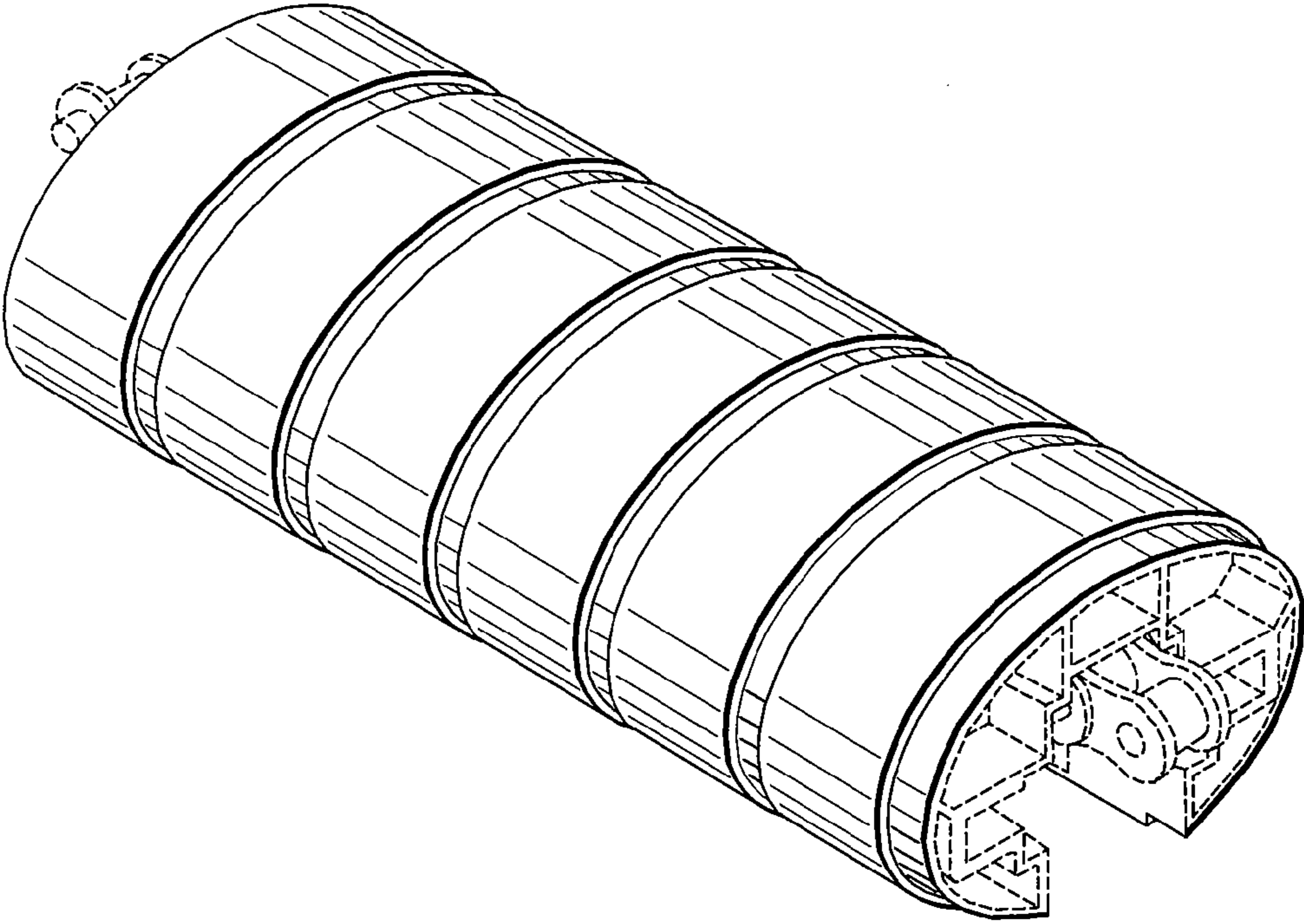

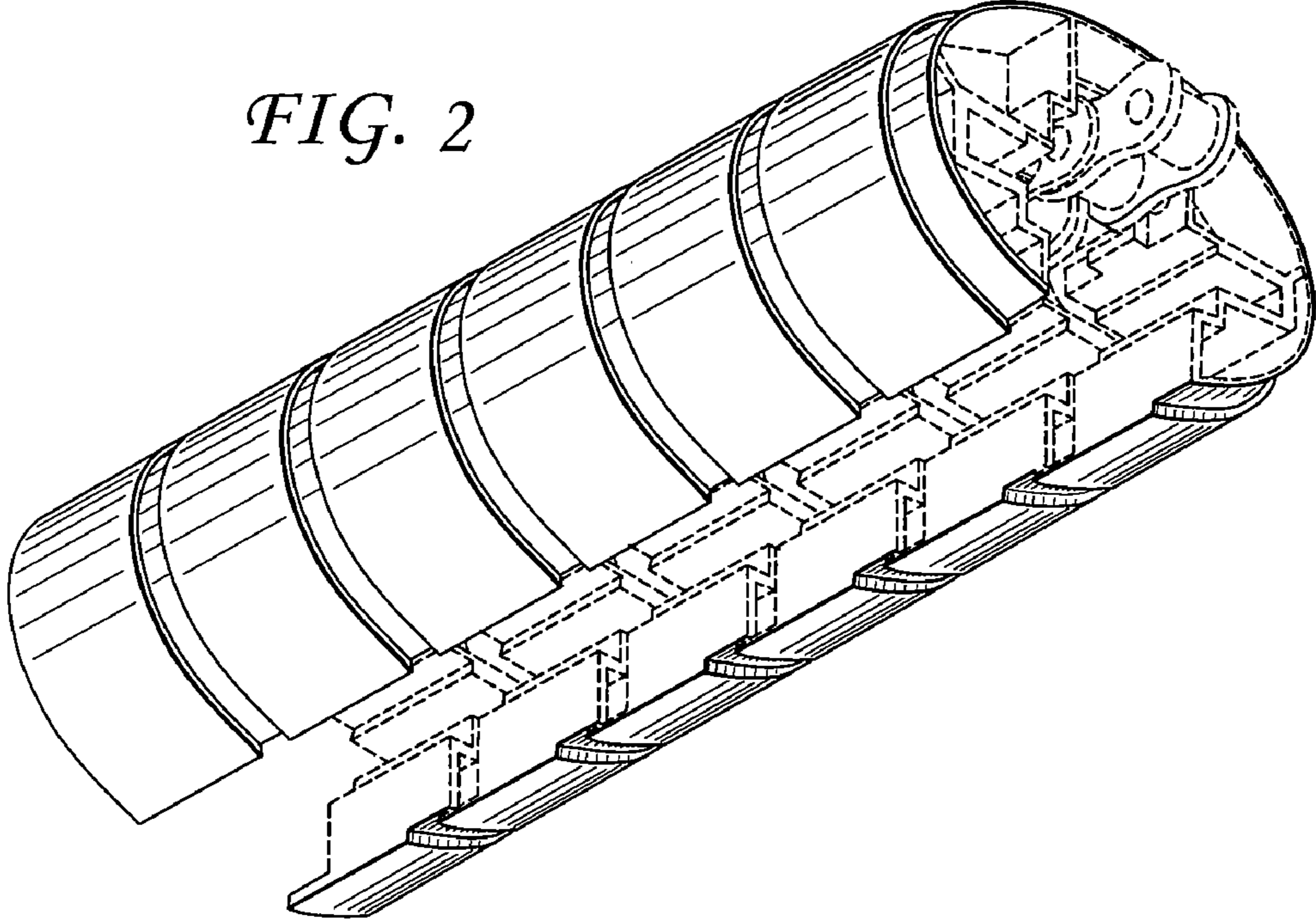

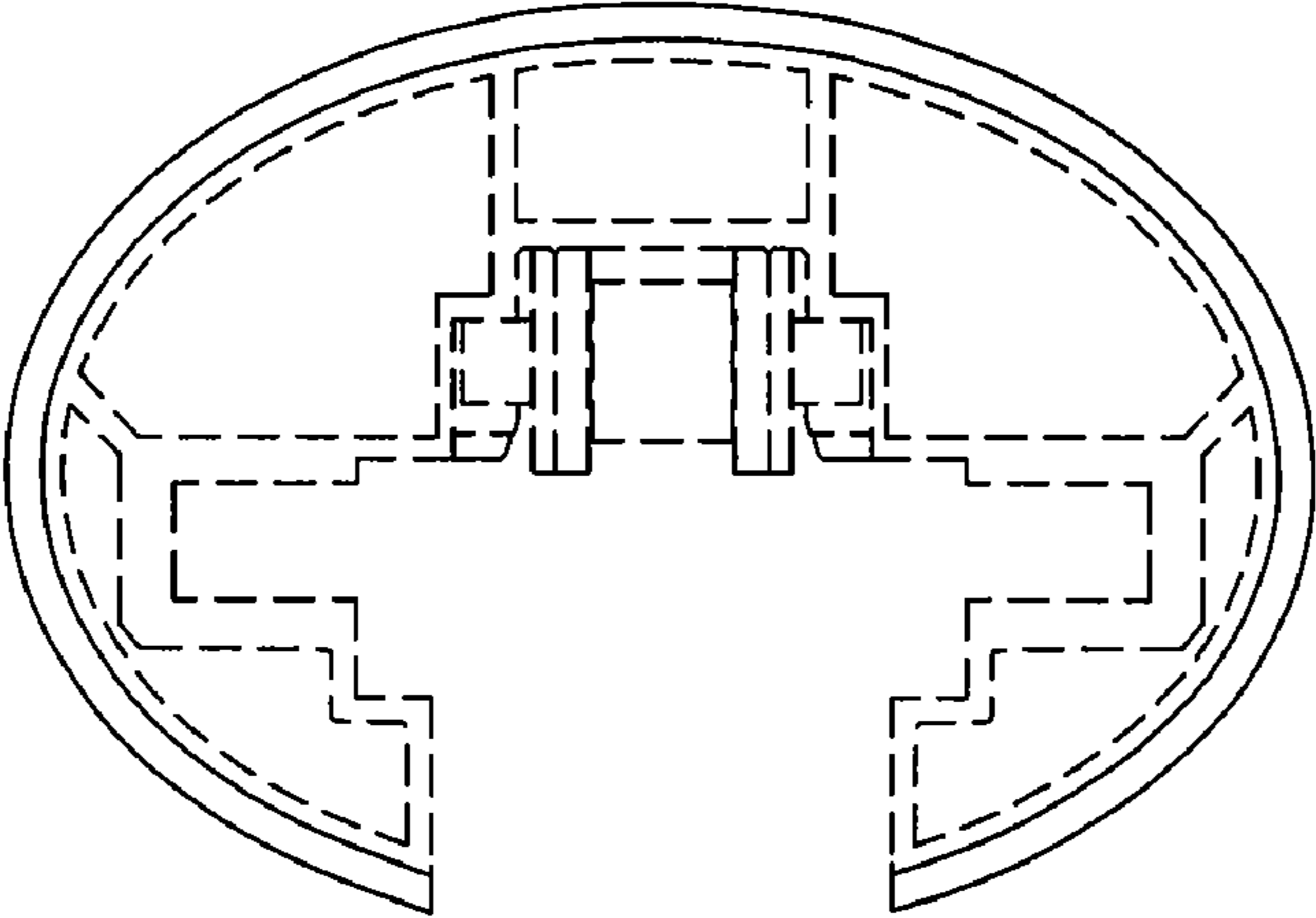

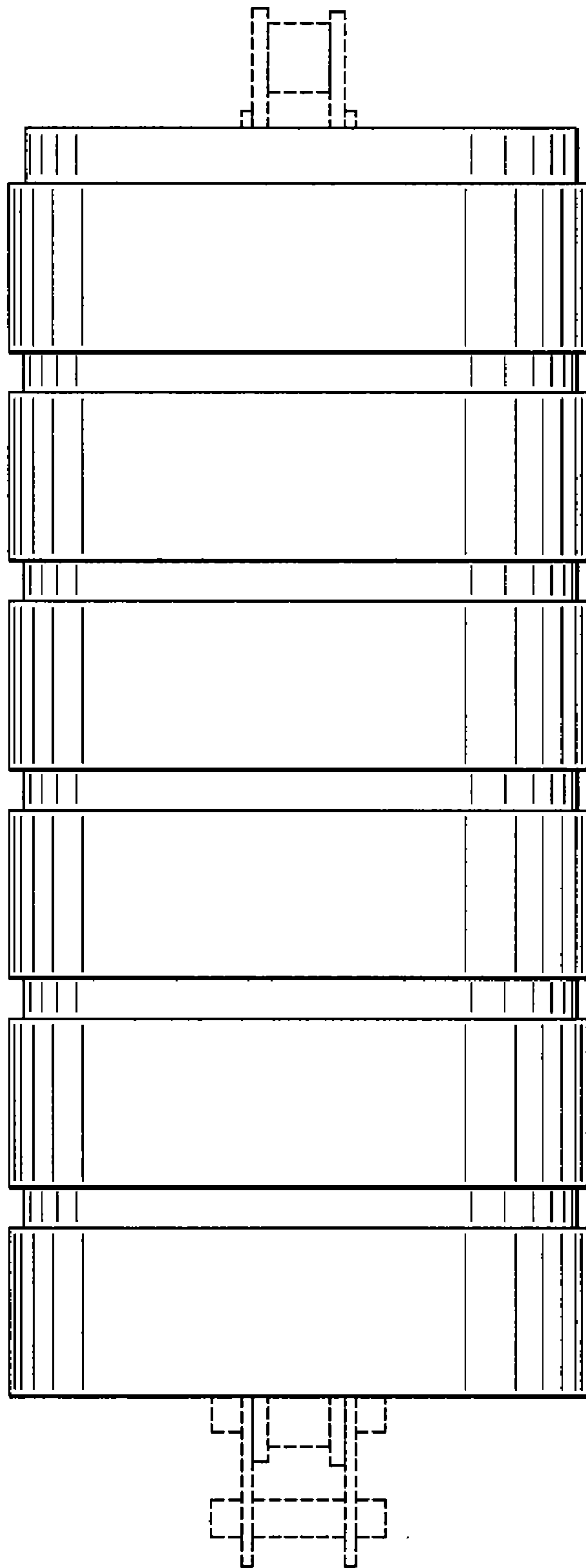

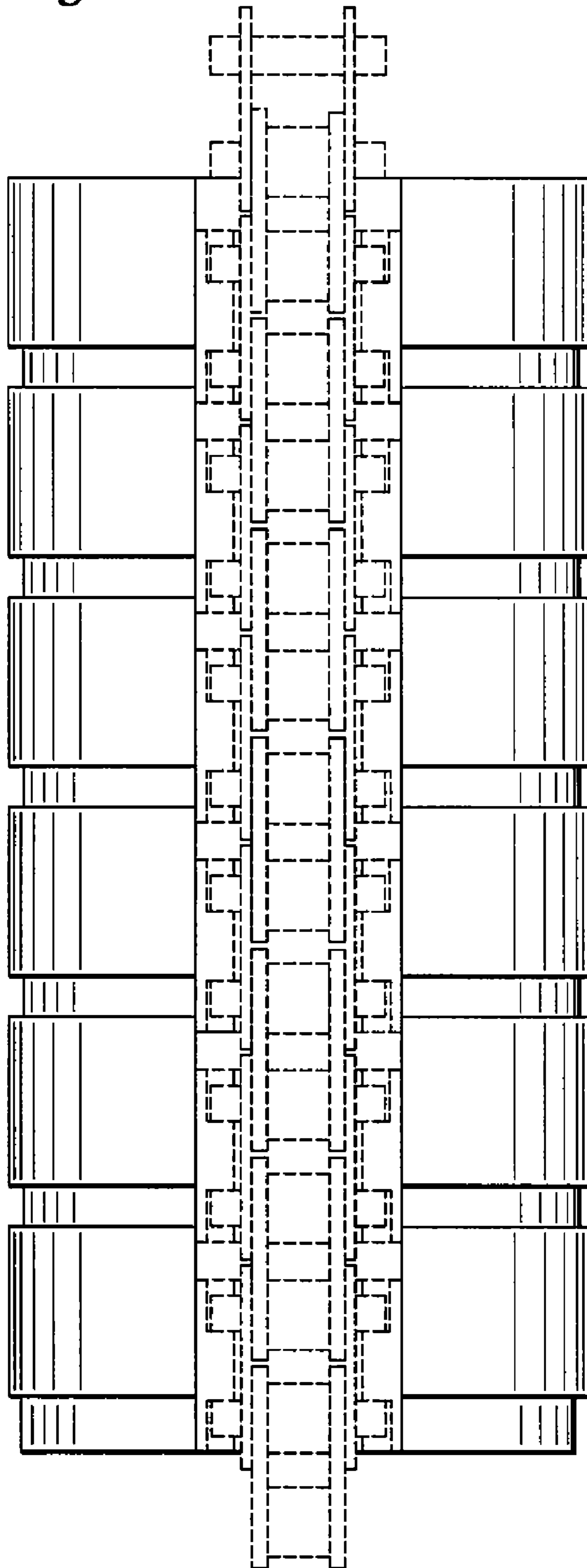

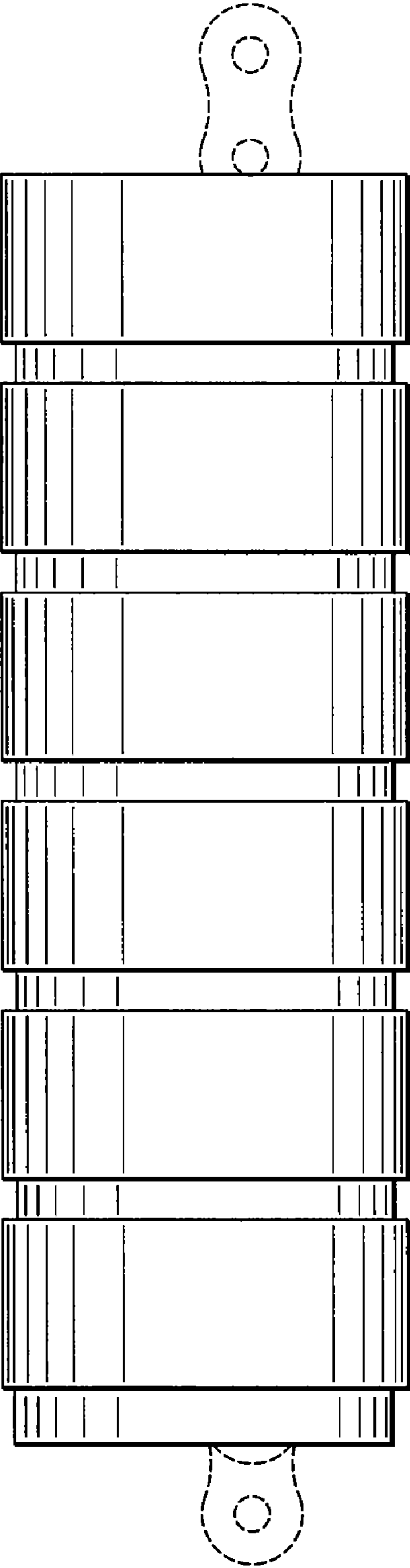
