The ornamental design for a motor switch toggle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a first embodiment of a motor switch toggle, showing my new design in a typical usage environment;

FIG. 2 is a front plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front, bottom, and left side perspective view thereof, without a typical usage environment;

FIG. 5 is a front plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top, front, and left side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a second embodiment of a motor switch toggle, showing my new design in a typical usage environment;

FIG. 10 is a front plan view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a front, bottom, and left side perspective view thereof, without a typical usage environment;

FIG. 13 is a front plan view thereof;

FIG. 14 is a top, front, and left side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 15 is a bottom side elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 16 is a top side elevational view thereof.

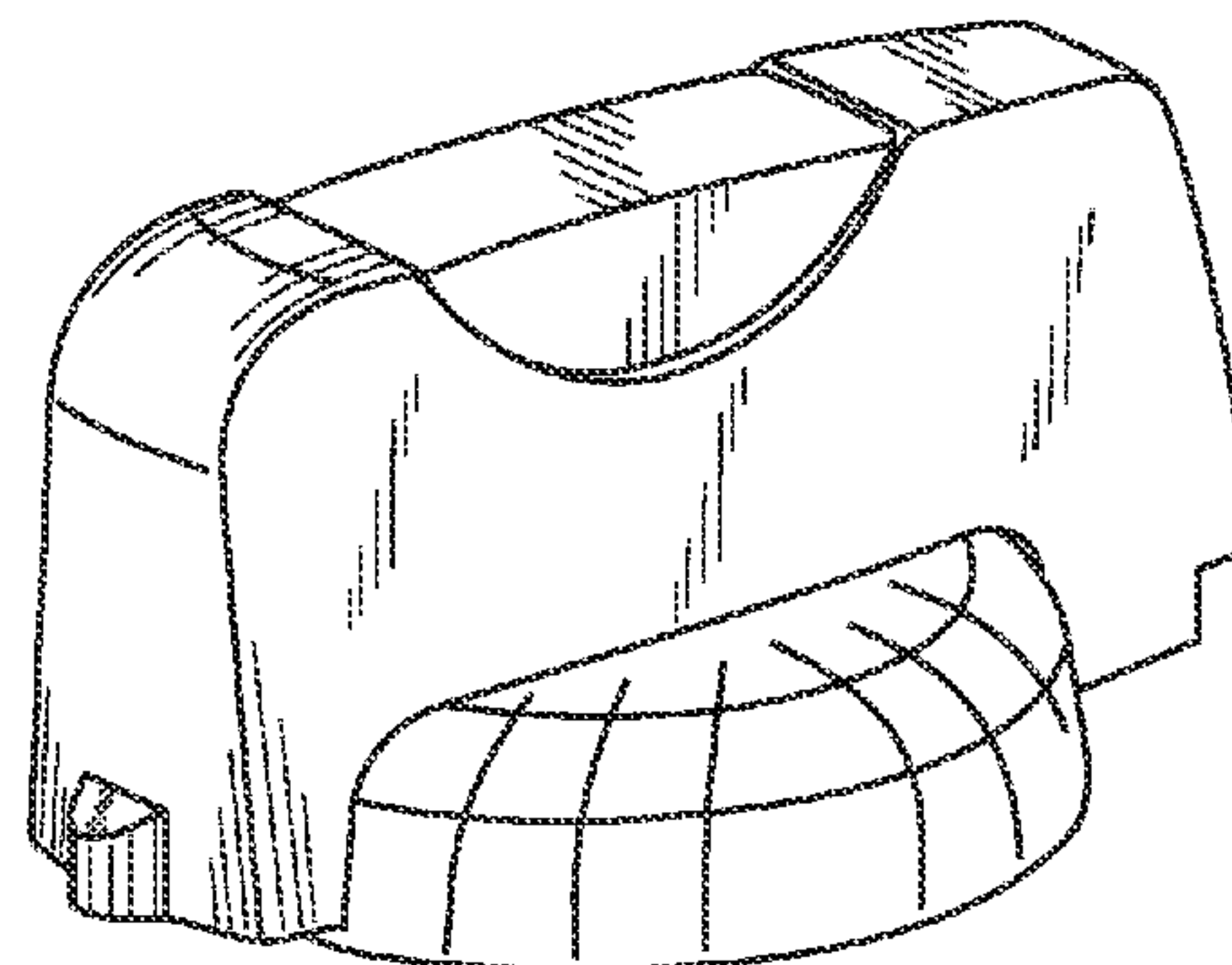
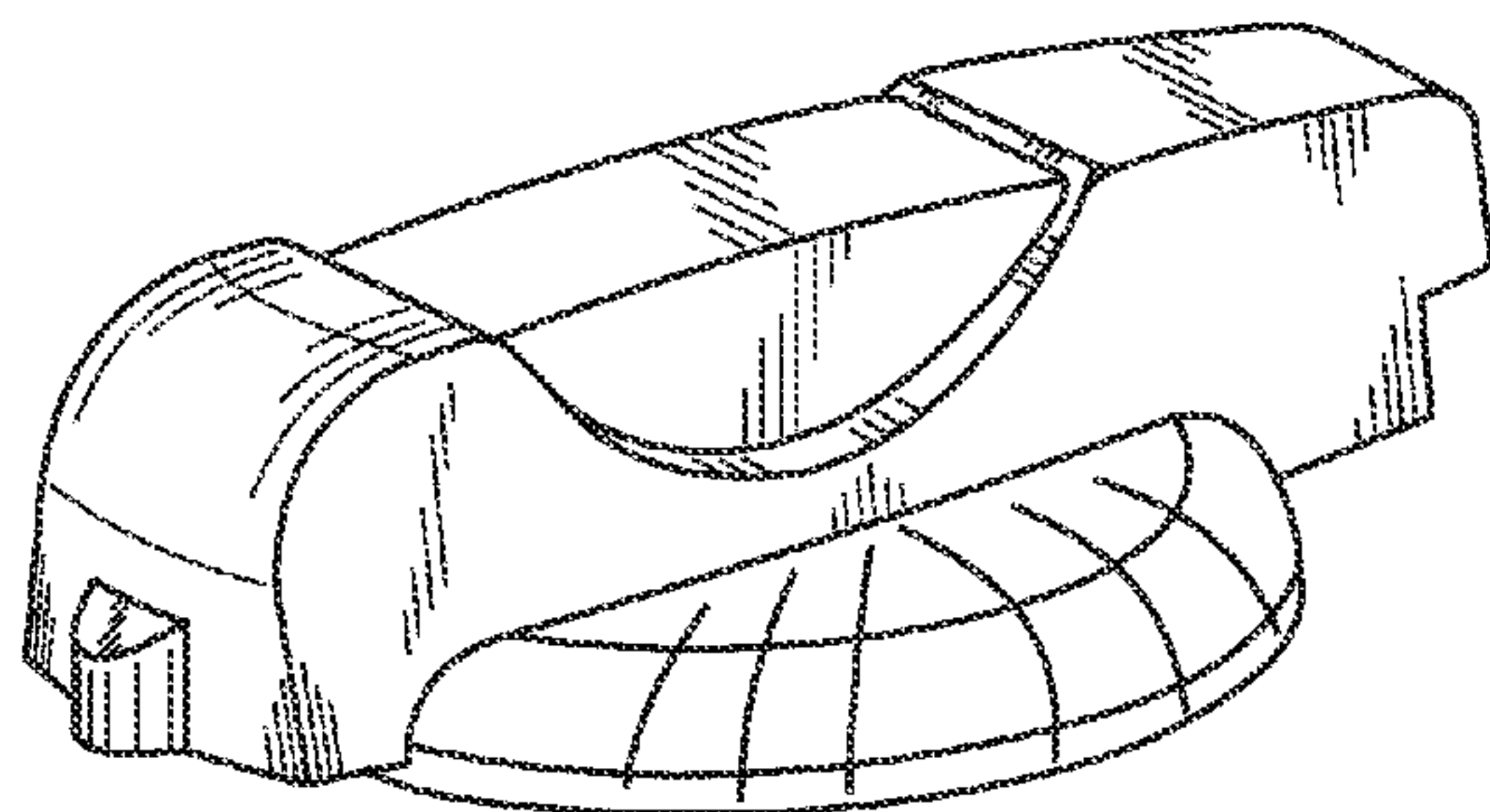

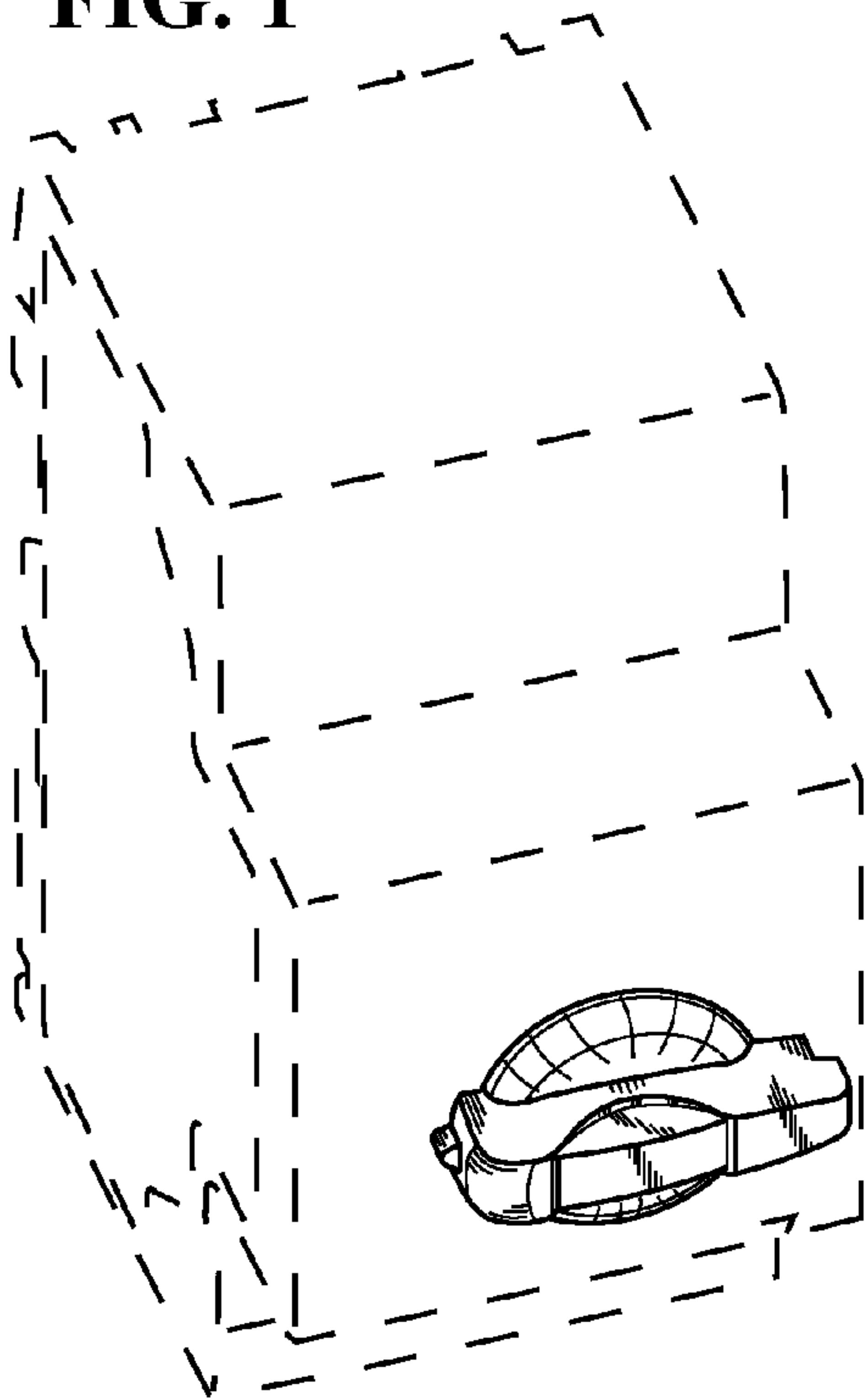

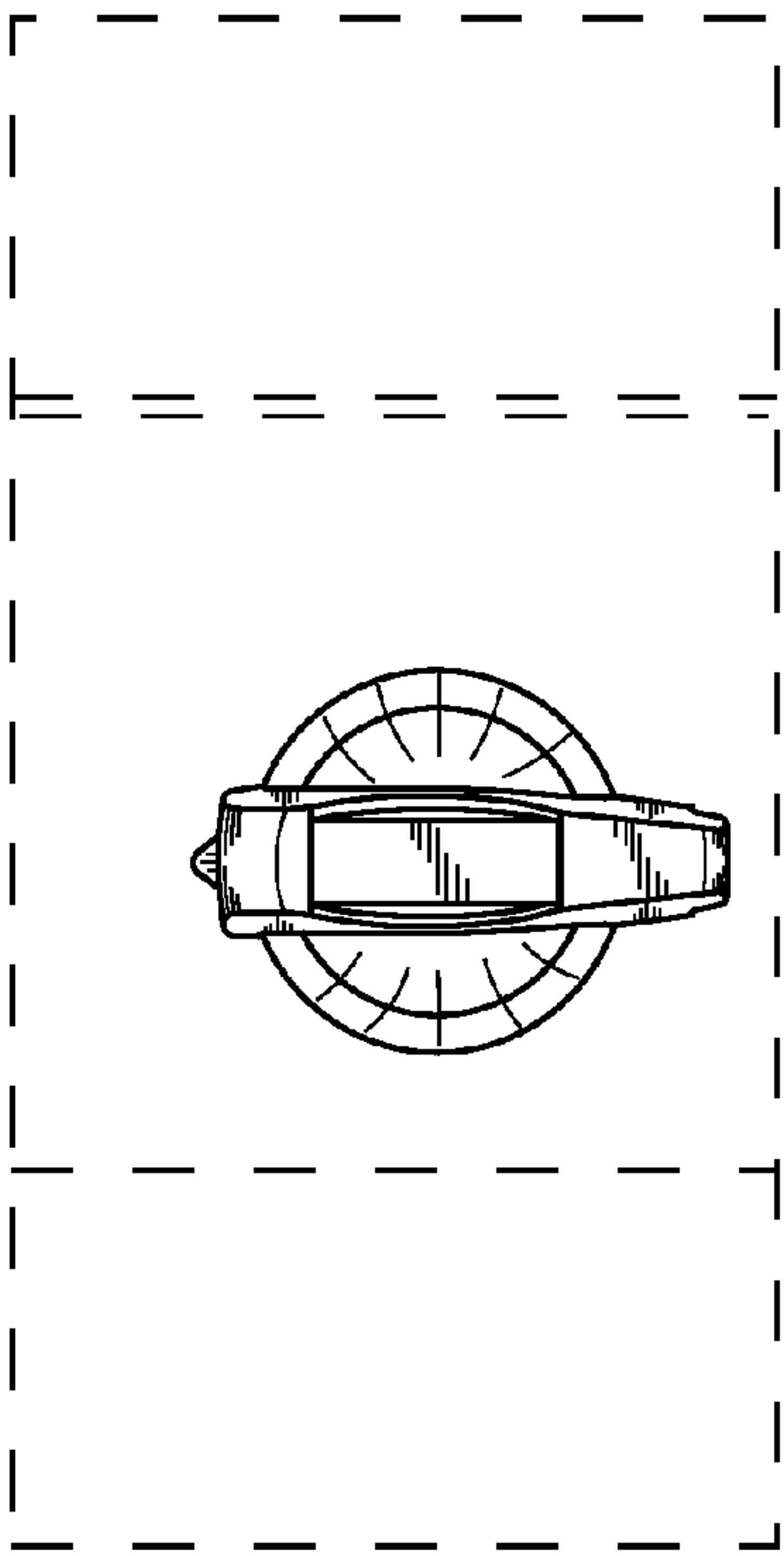

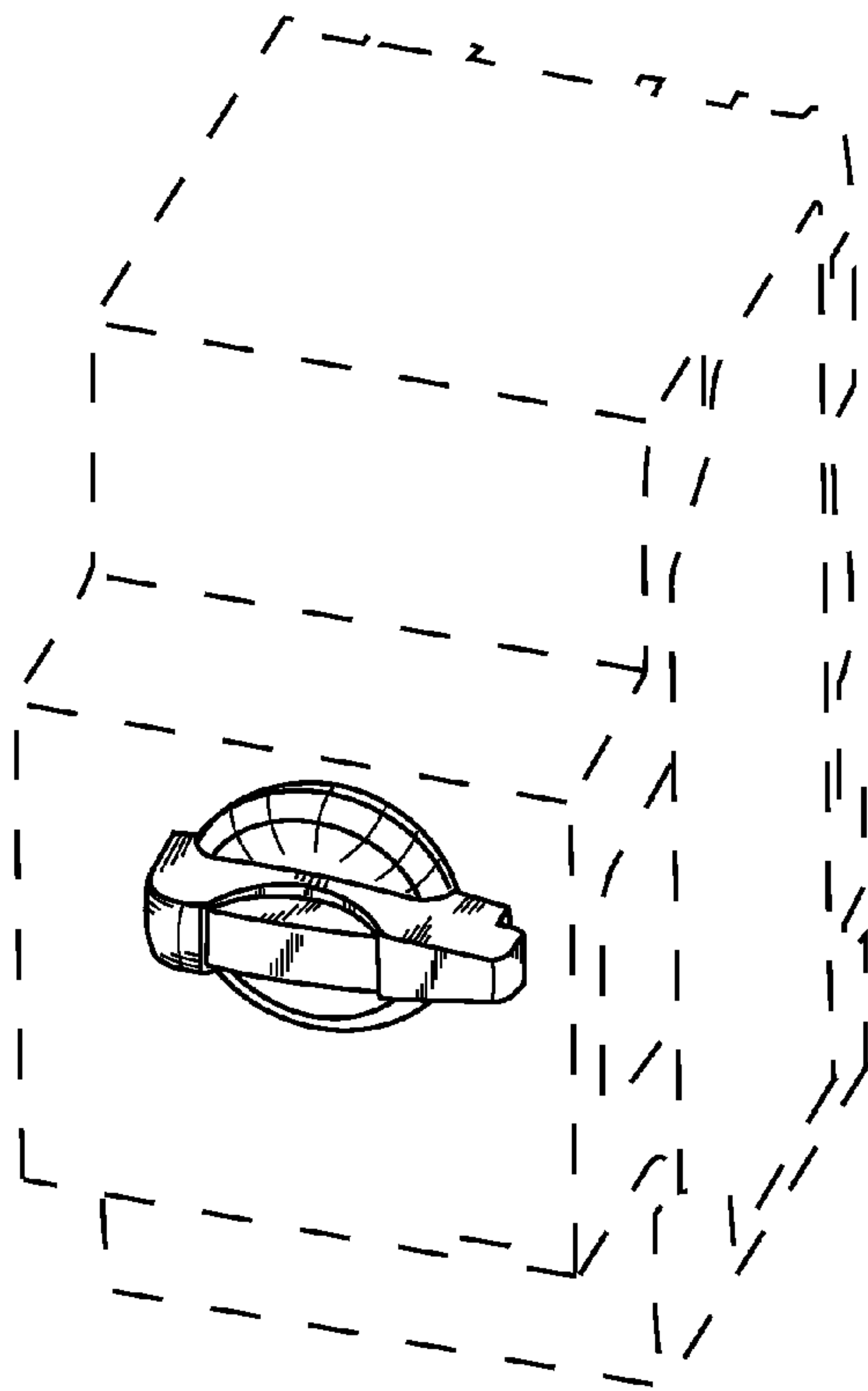

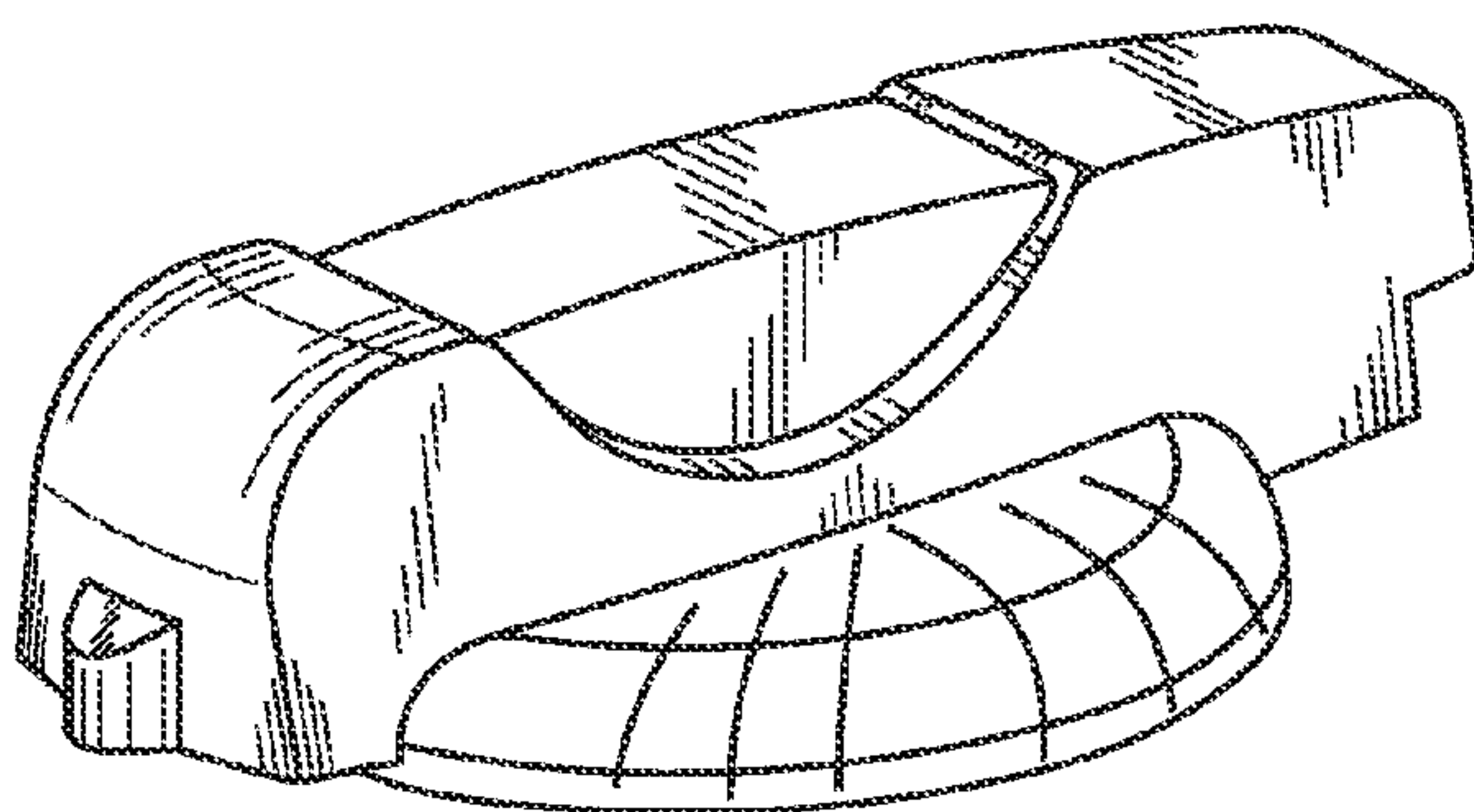

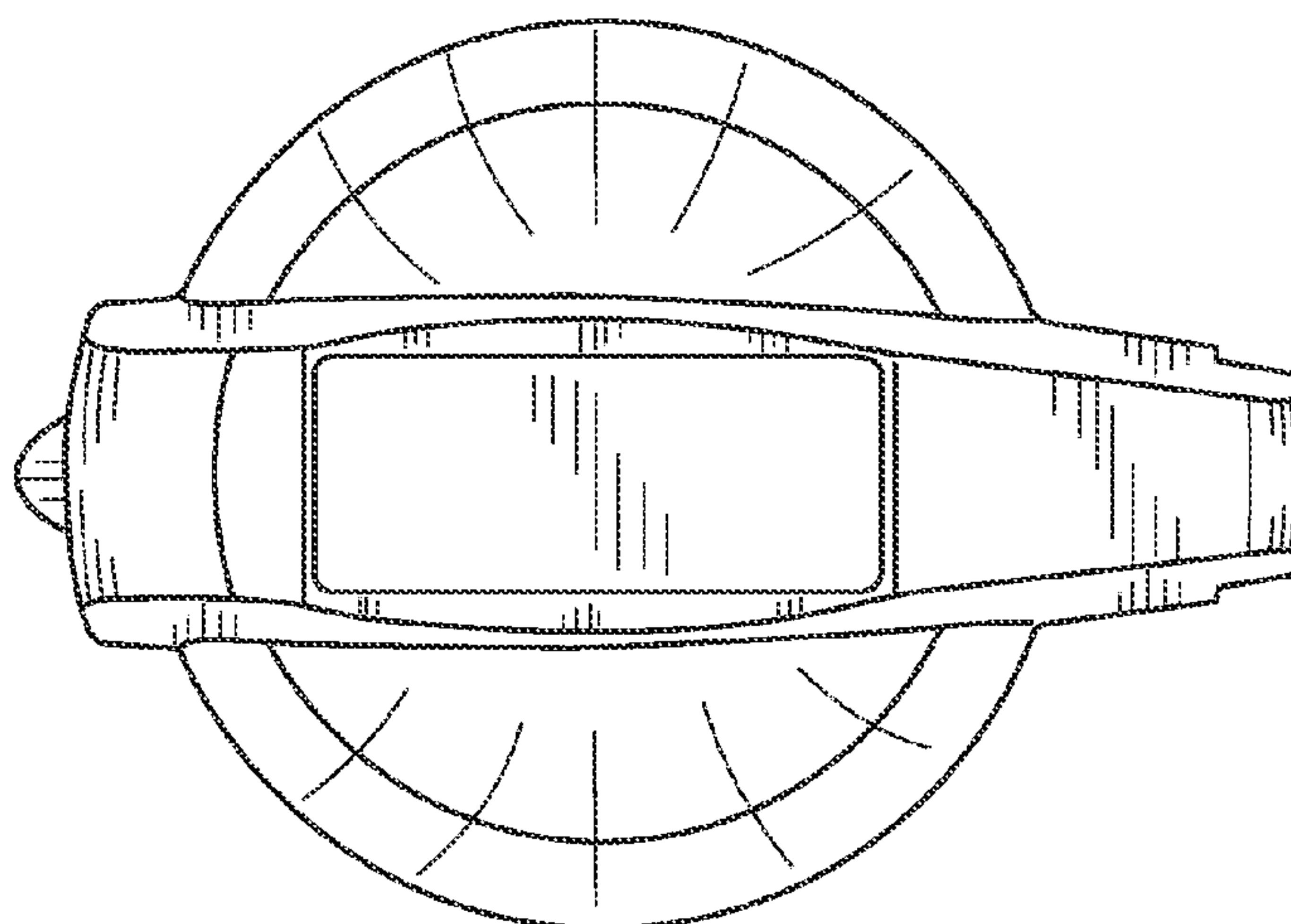

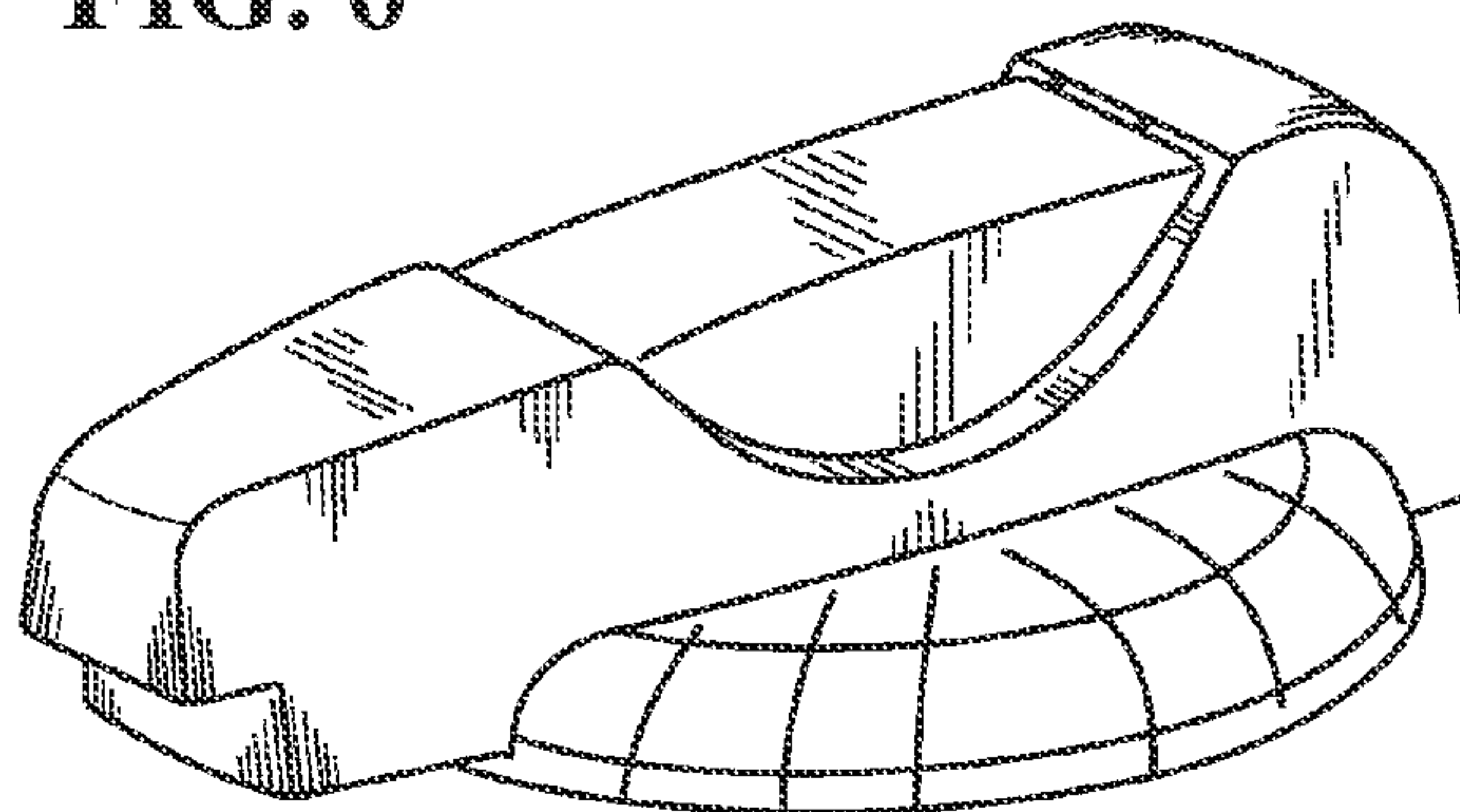

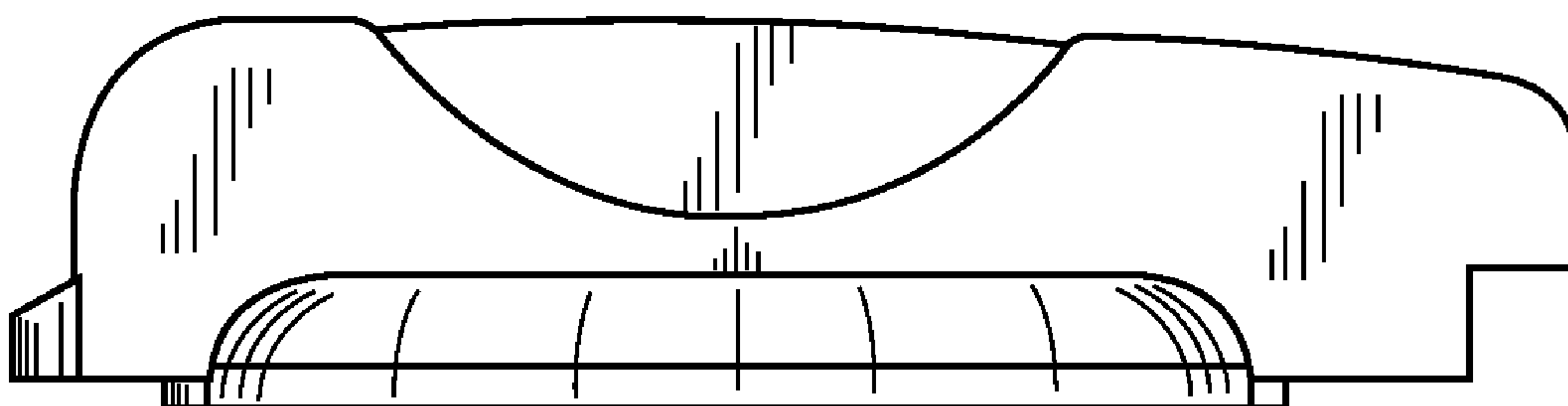

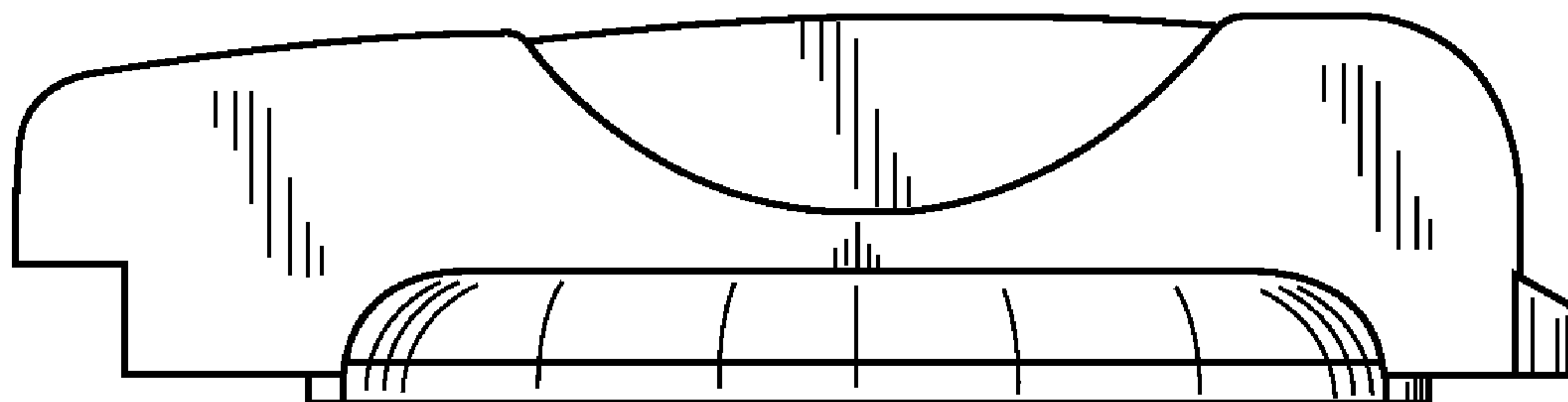

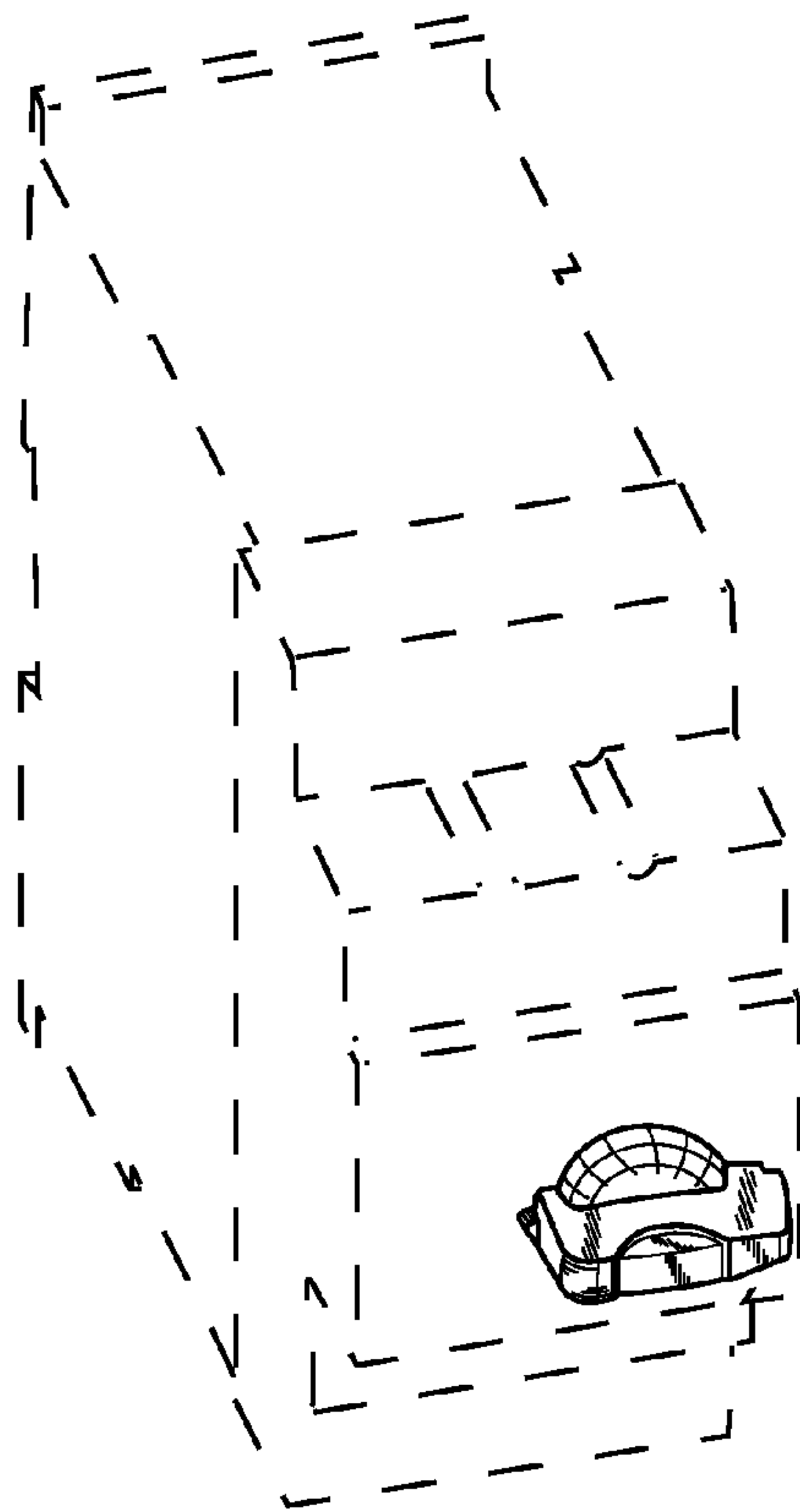

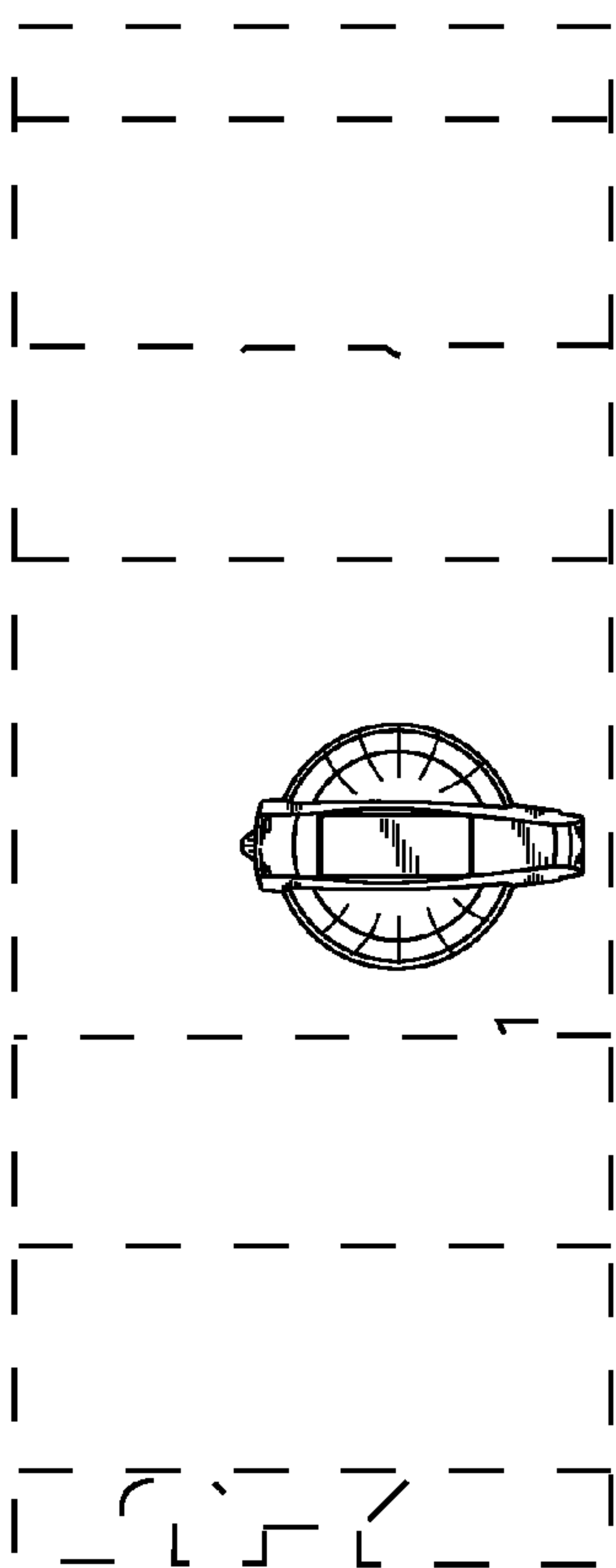

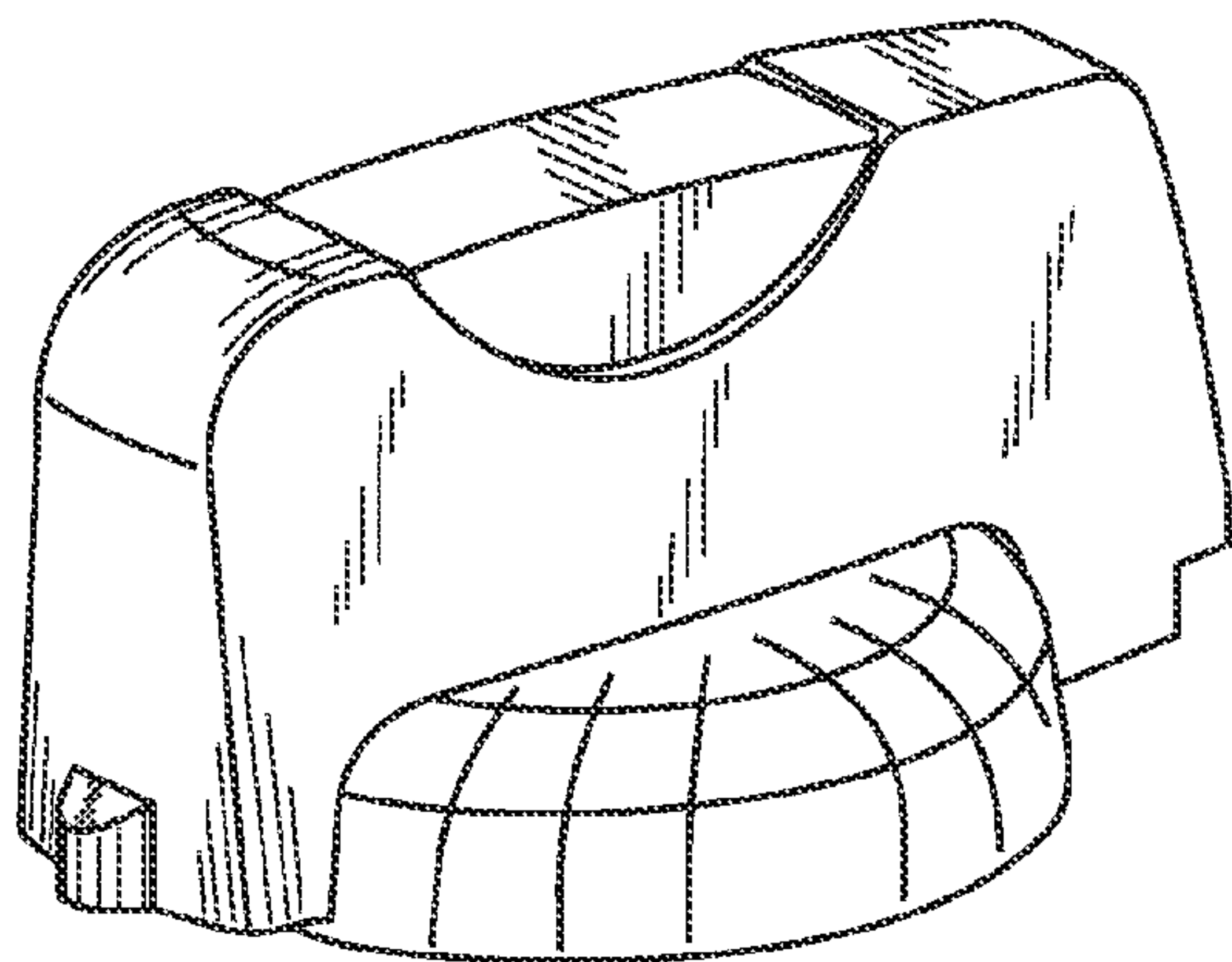

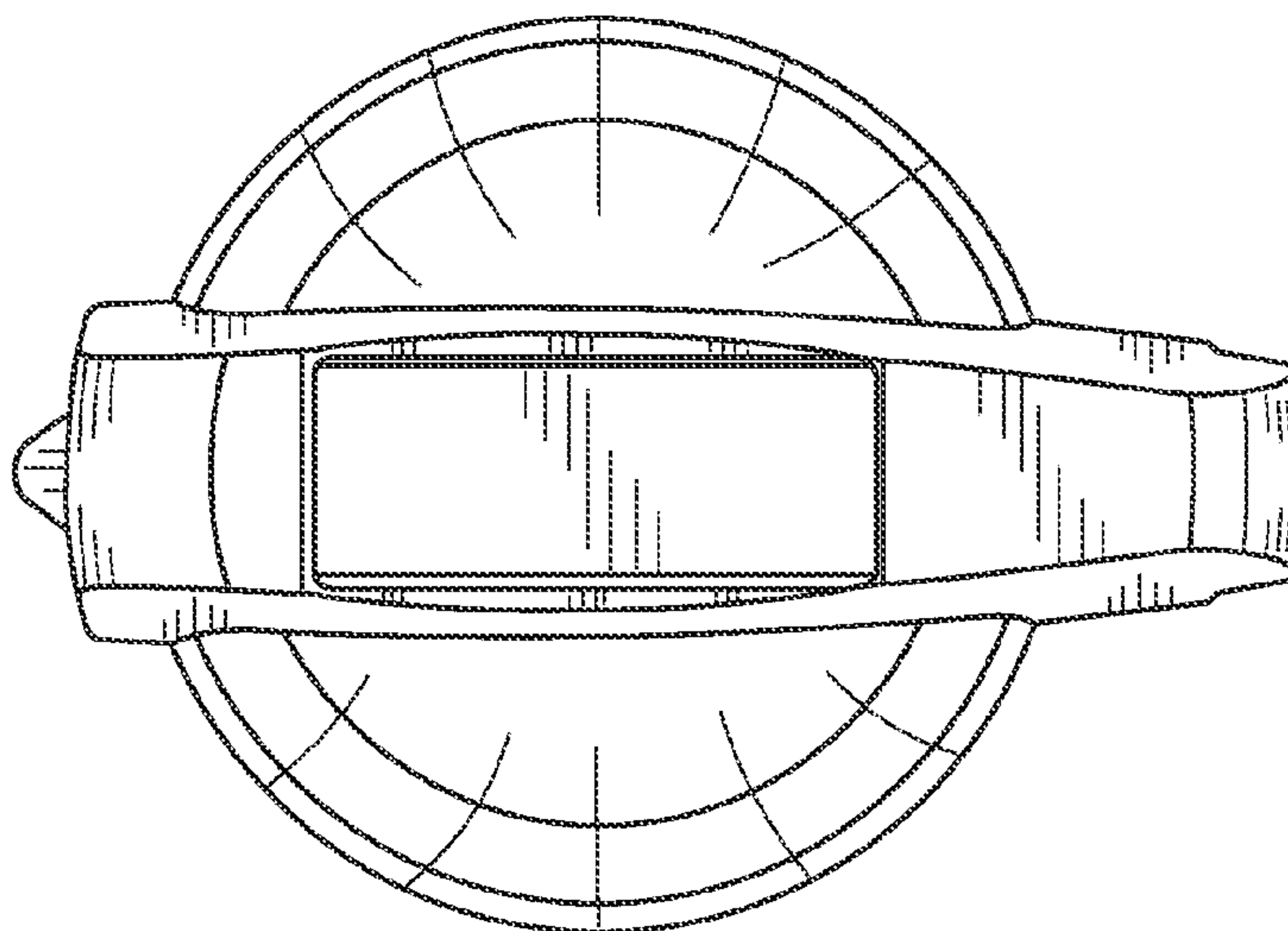

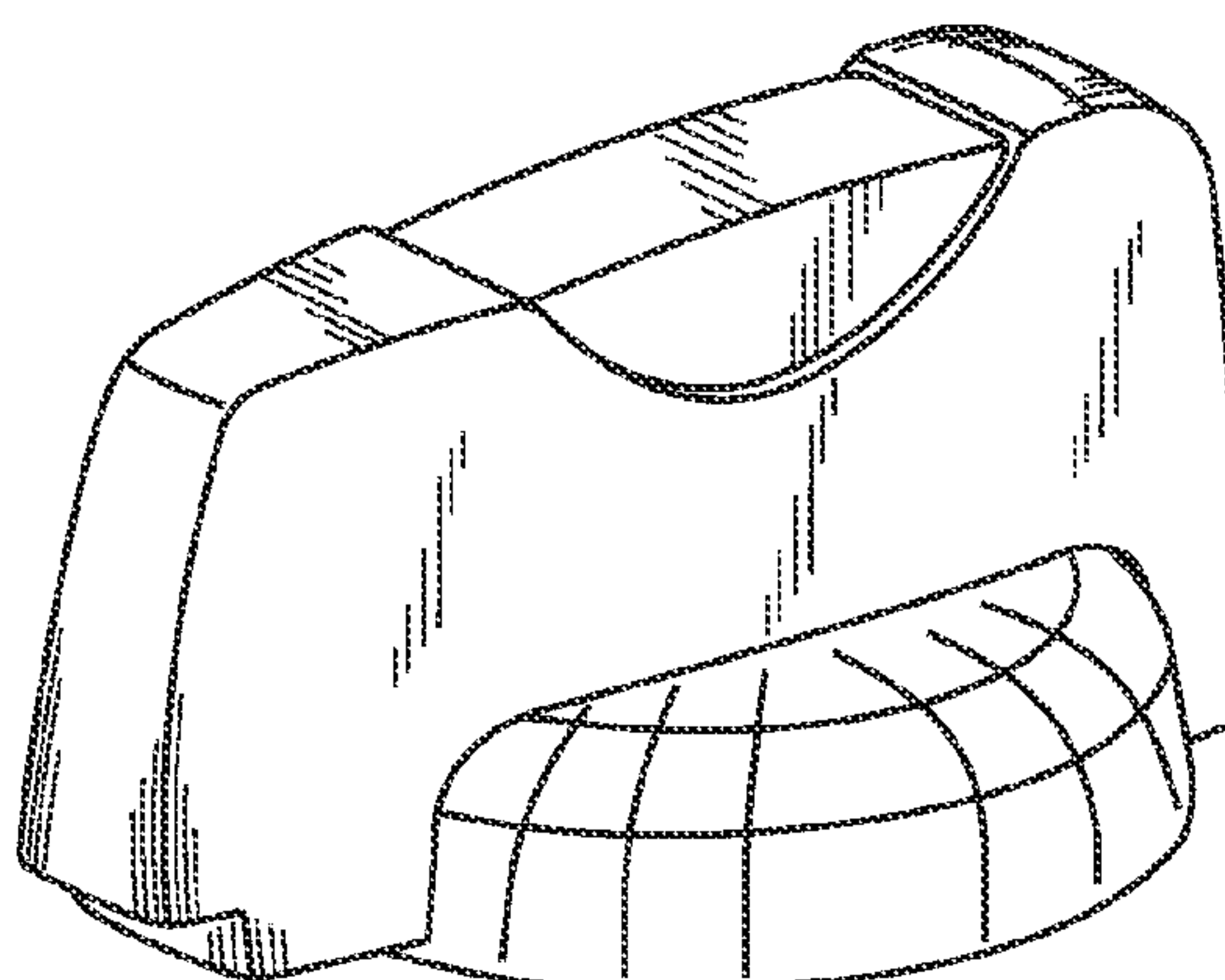

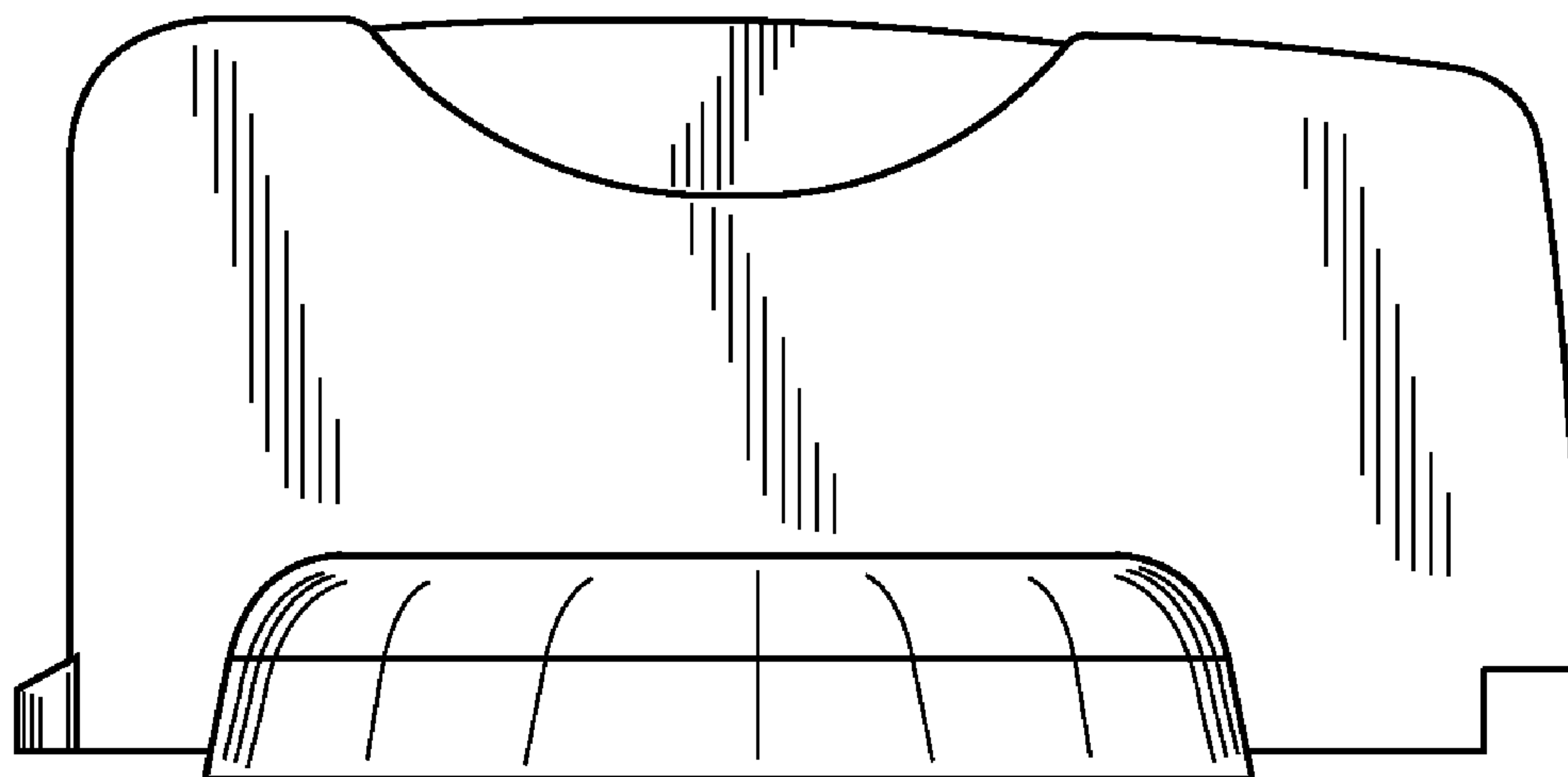
