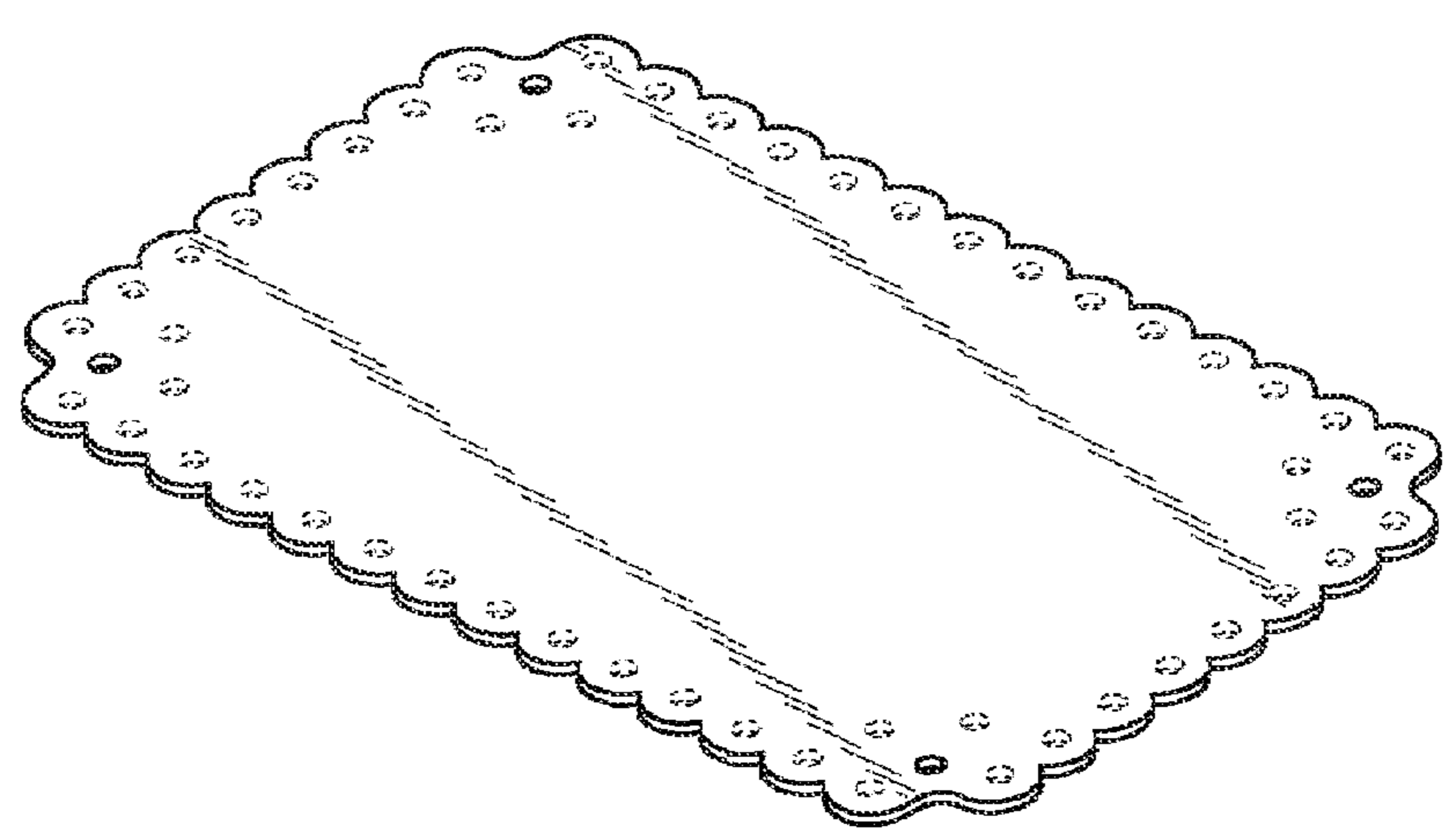

(57) **CLAIM**  
The ornamental design for a financial transaction card, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a financial transaction card, according to a first embodiment of the invention;  
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof; the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view; and  
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view.  
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a financial transaction card, according to a second embodiment of the invention;  
FIG. 7 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 8 is a rear view thereof;  
FIG. 9 is a right side view thereof; the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view; and  
FIG. 10 is a top view thereof; the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view.  
FIG. 11 is a perspective view of a financial transaction card, according to a third embodiment of the invention;  
FIG. 12 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 13 is a rear view thereof;  
FIG. 14 is a right side view thereof; the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view; and  
FIG. 15 is a top view thereof; the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view.  
FIG. 16 is a perspective view of a financial transaction card, according to a fourth embodiment of the invention;  
FIG. 17 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 18 is a rear view thereof;  
FIG. 19 is a right side view thereof; the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view; and,  
FIG. 20 is a top view thereof; the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view.  
The features shown in broken lines depict environmental subject matter only and form no part of the claimed design.

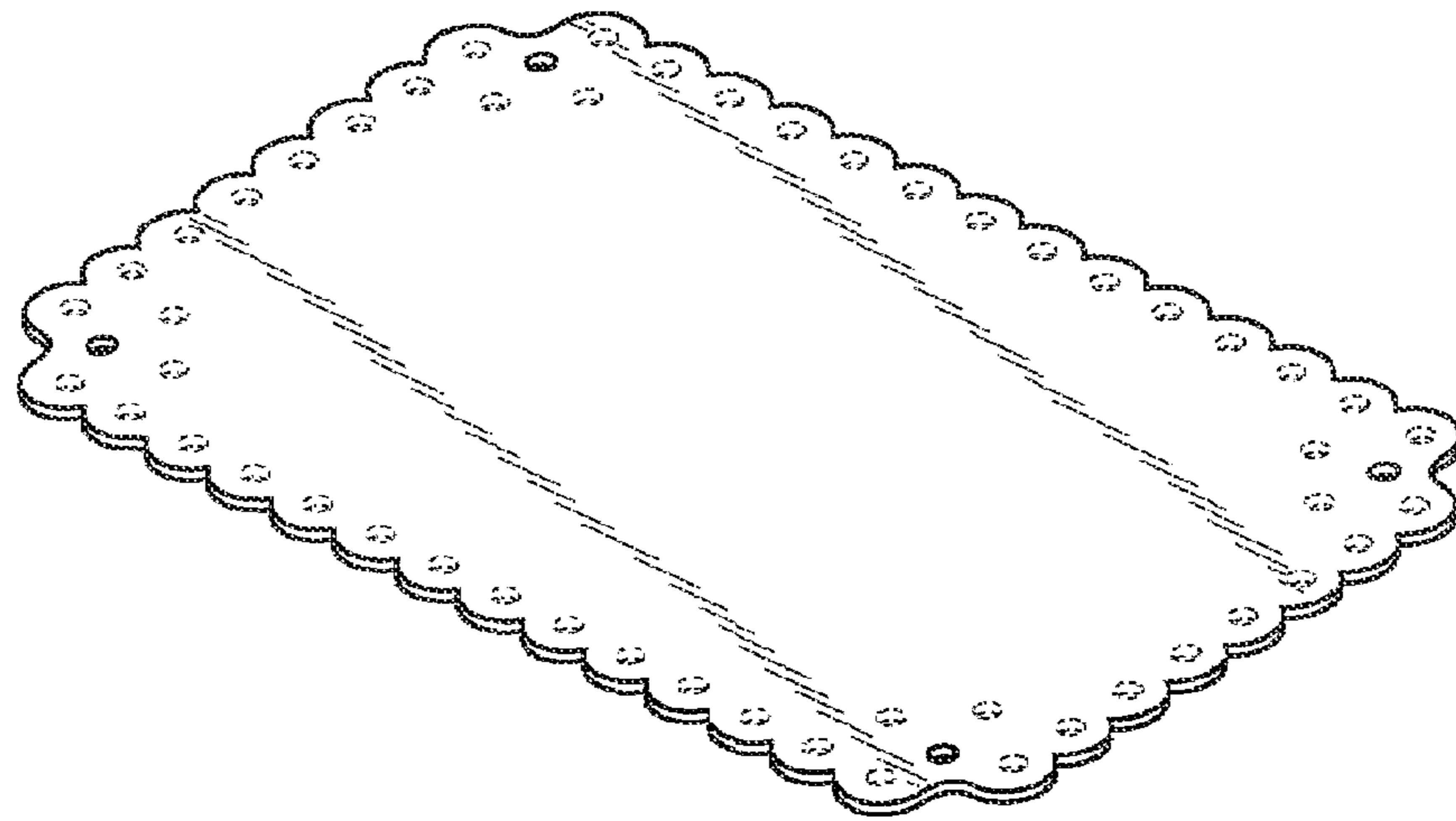

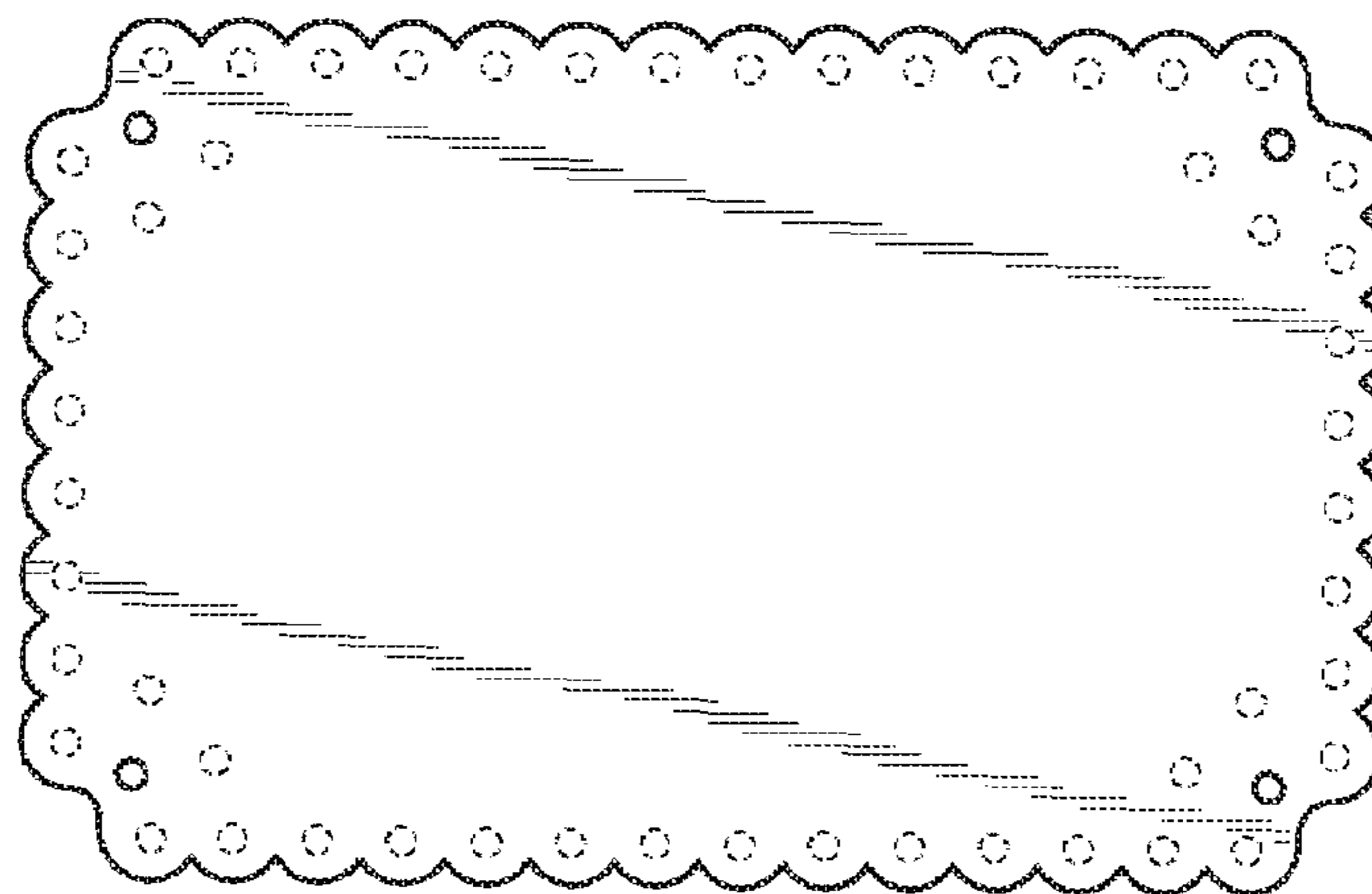

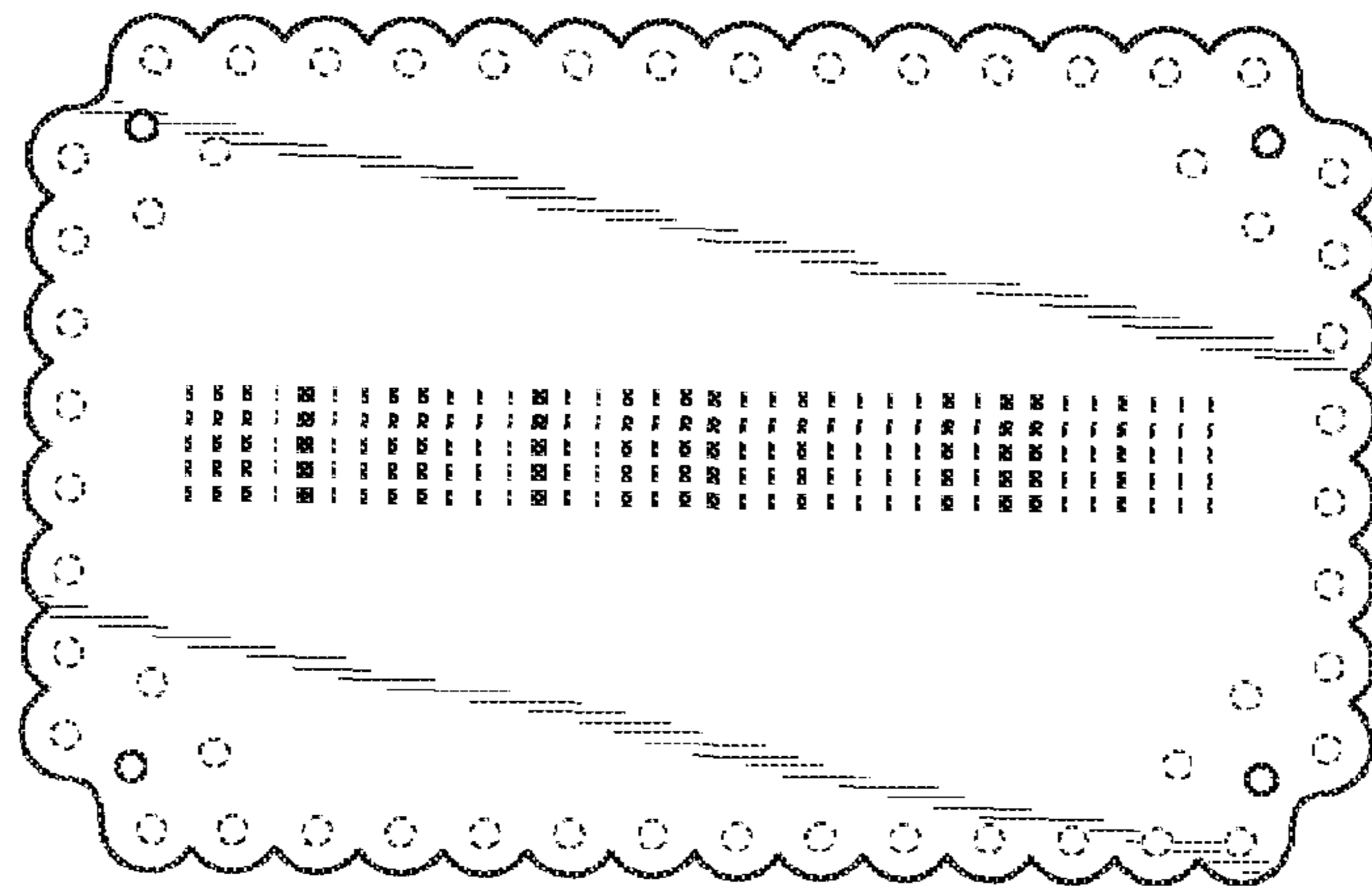

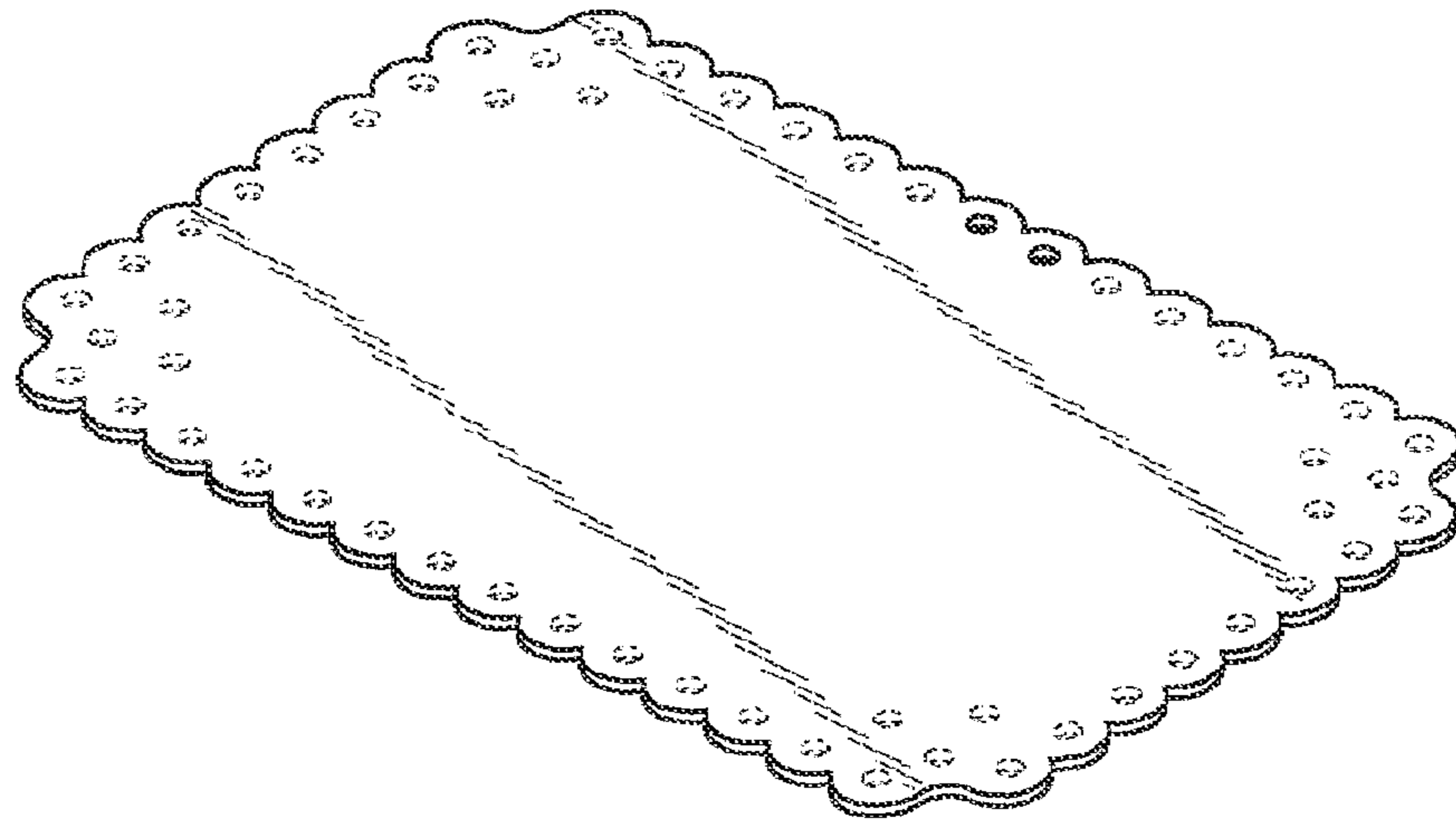

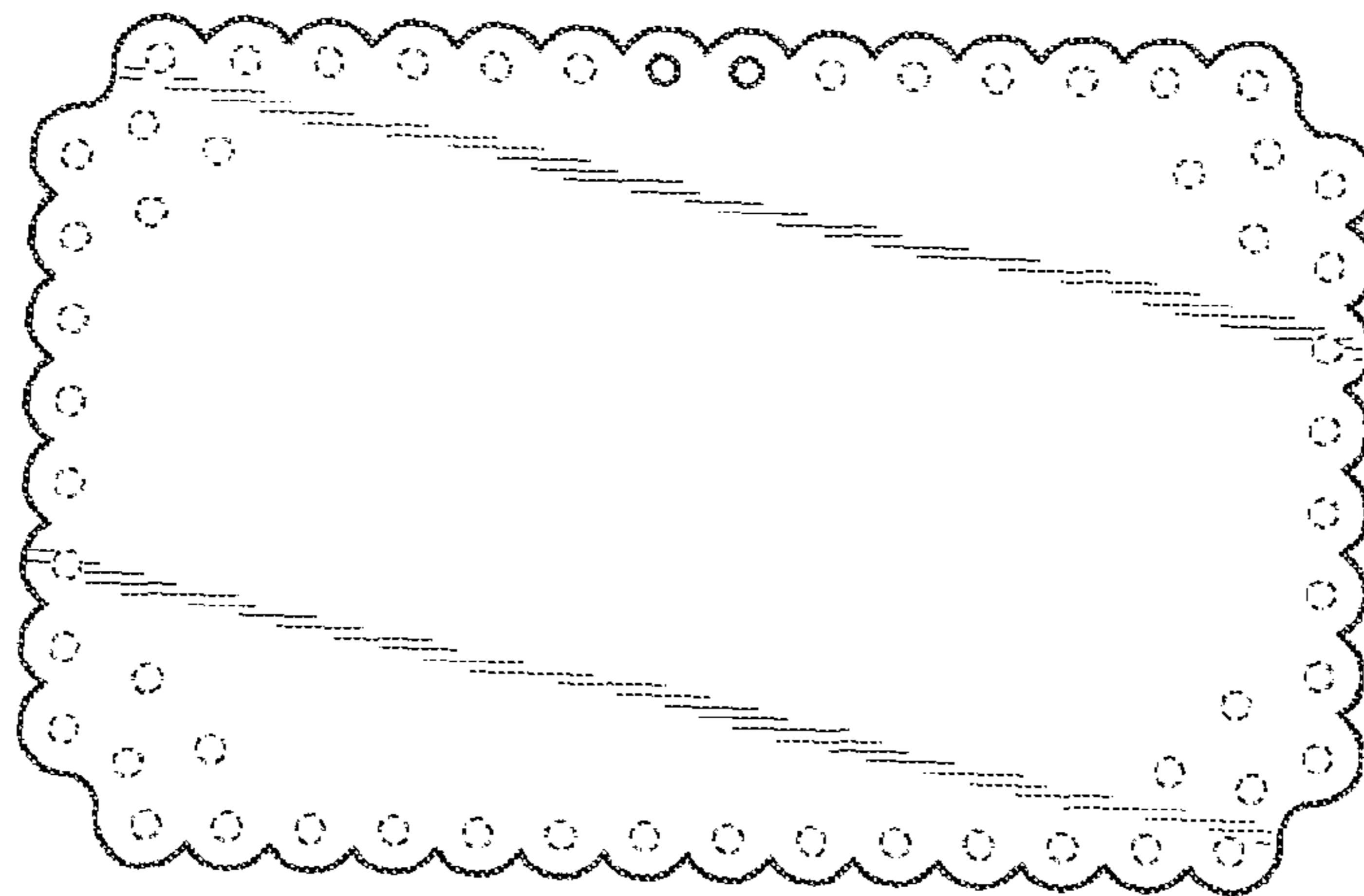

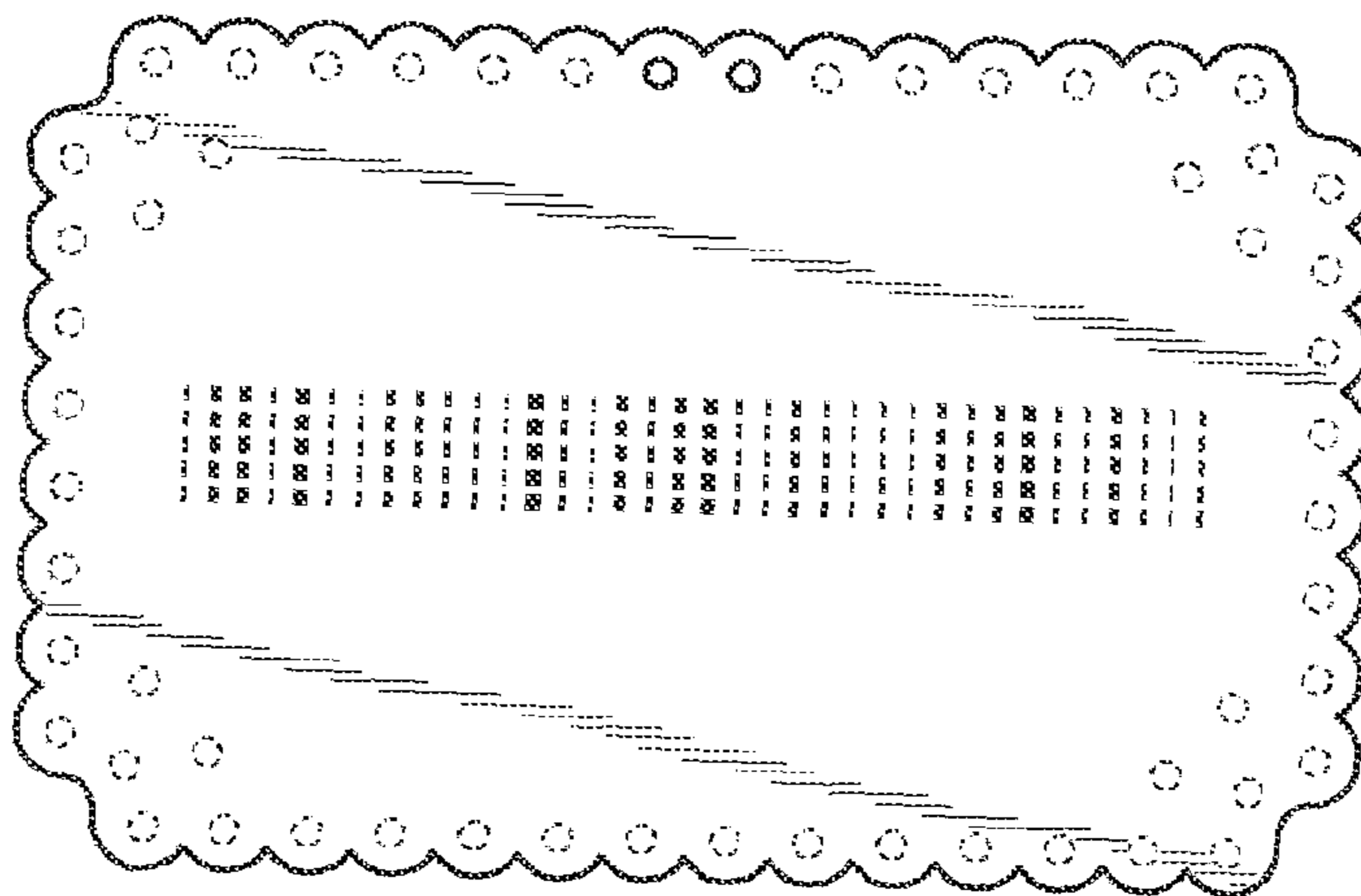

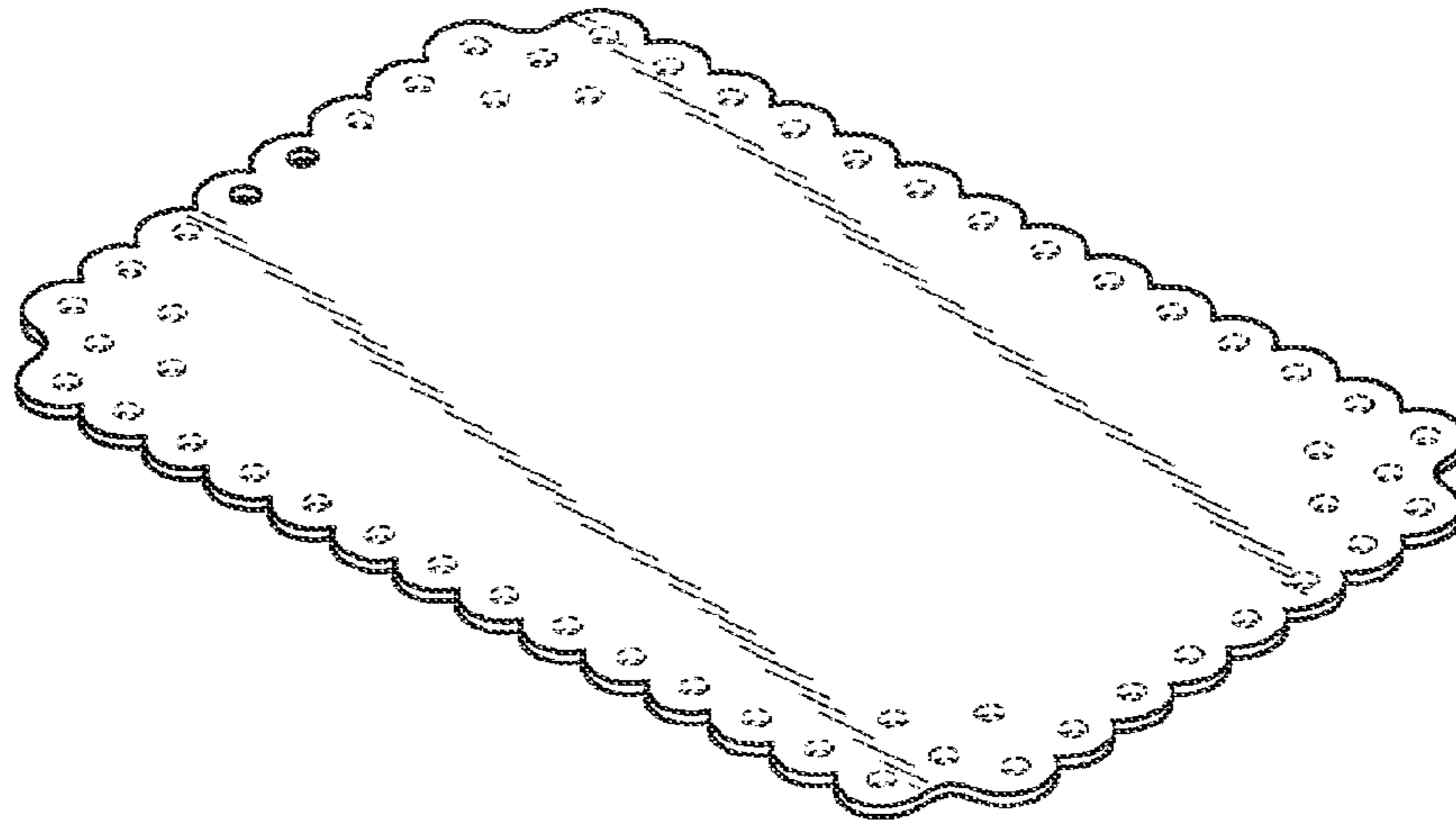

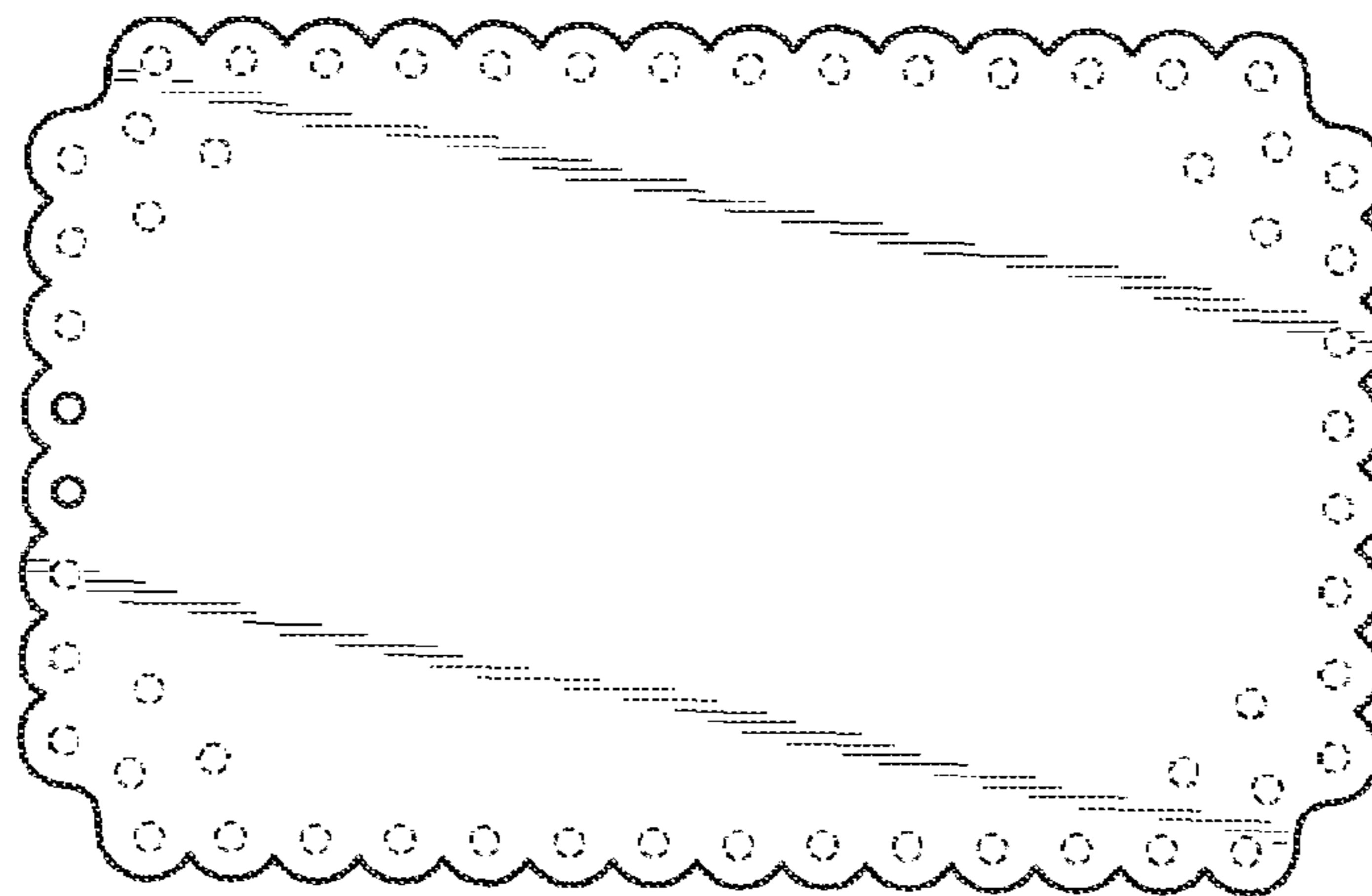

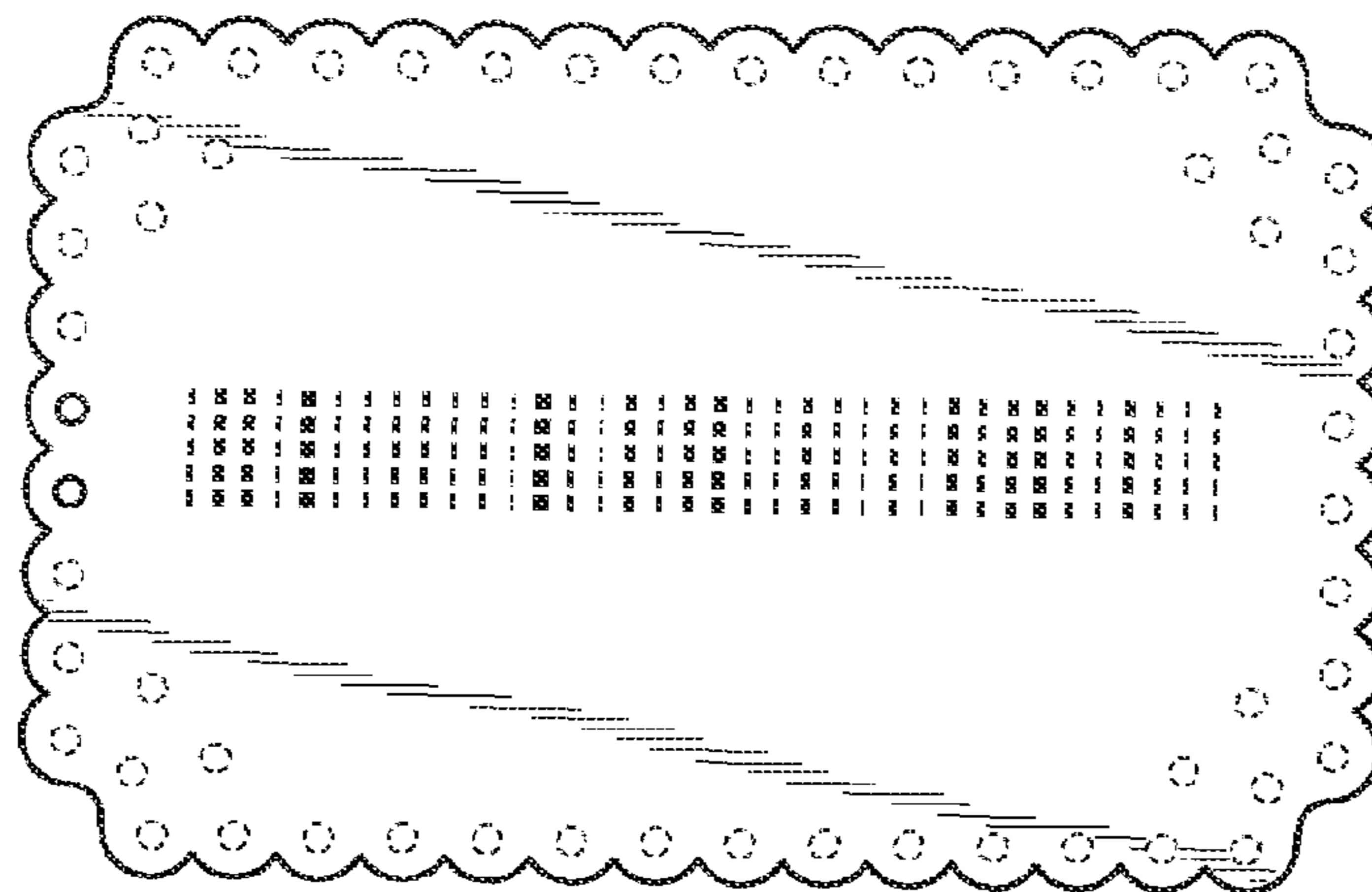

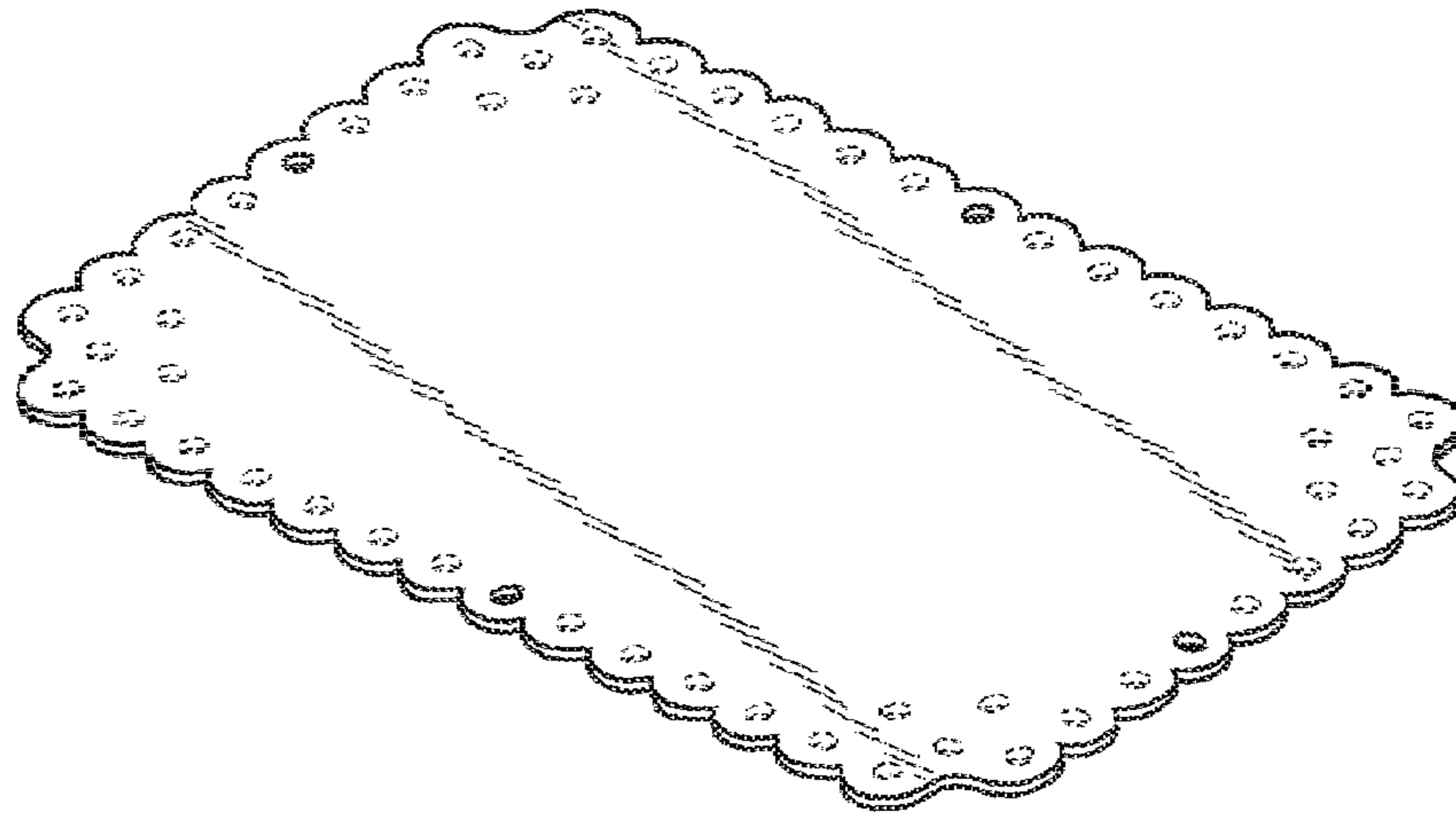

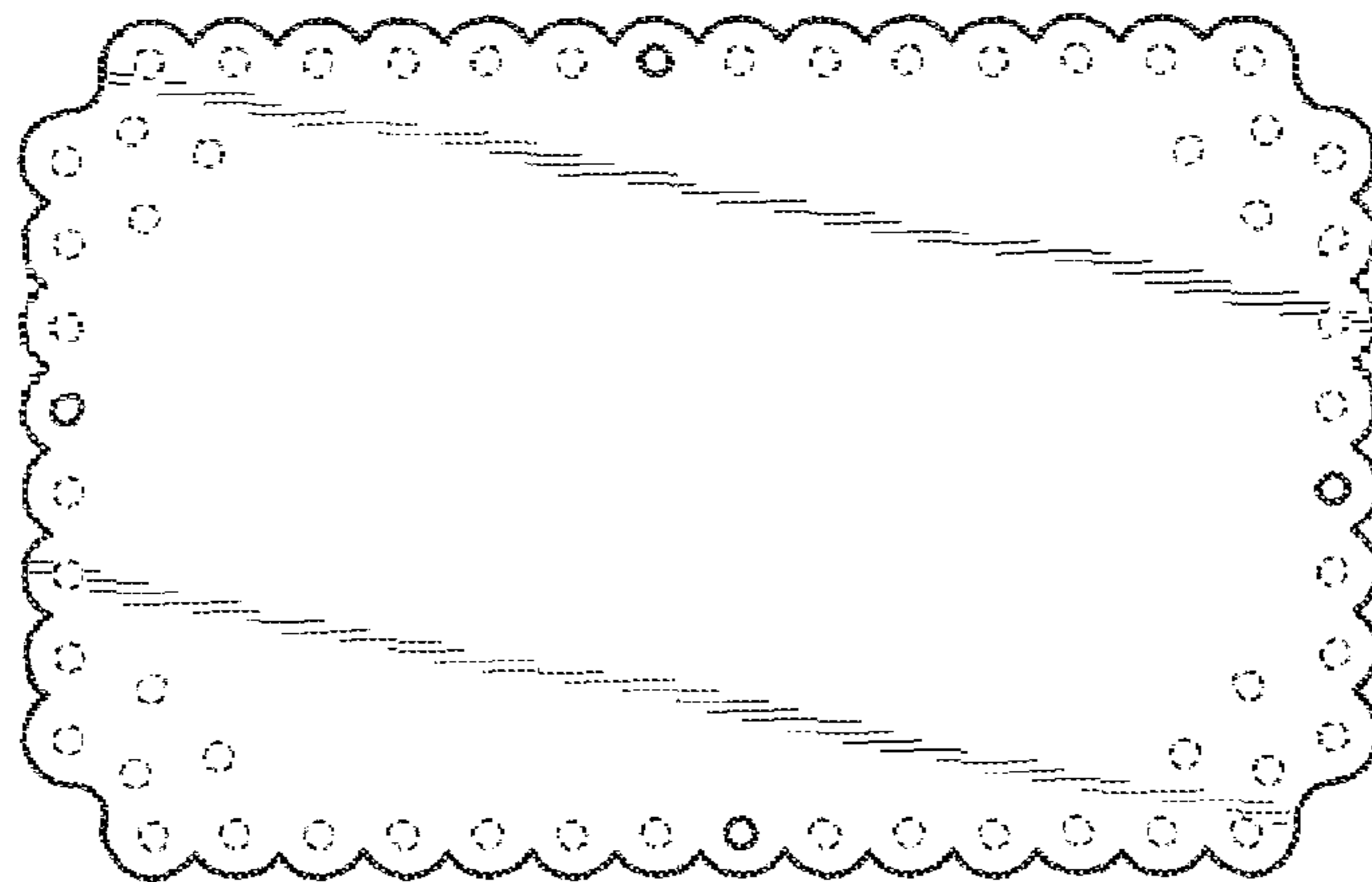

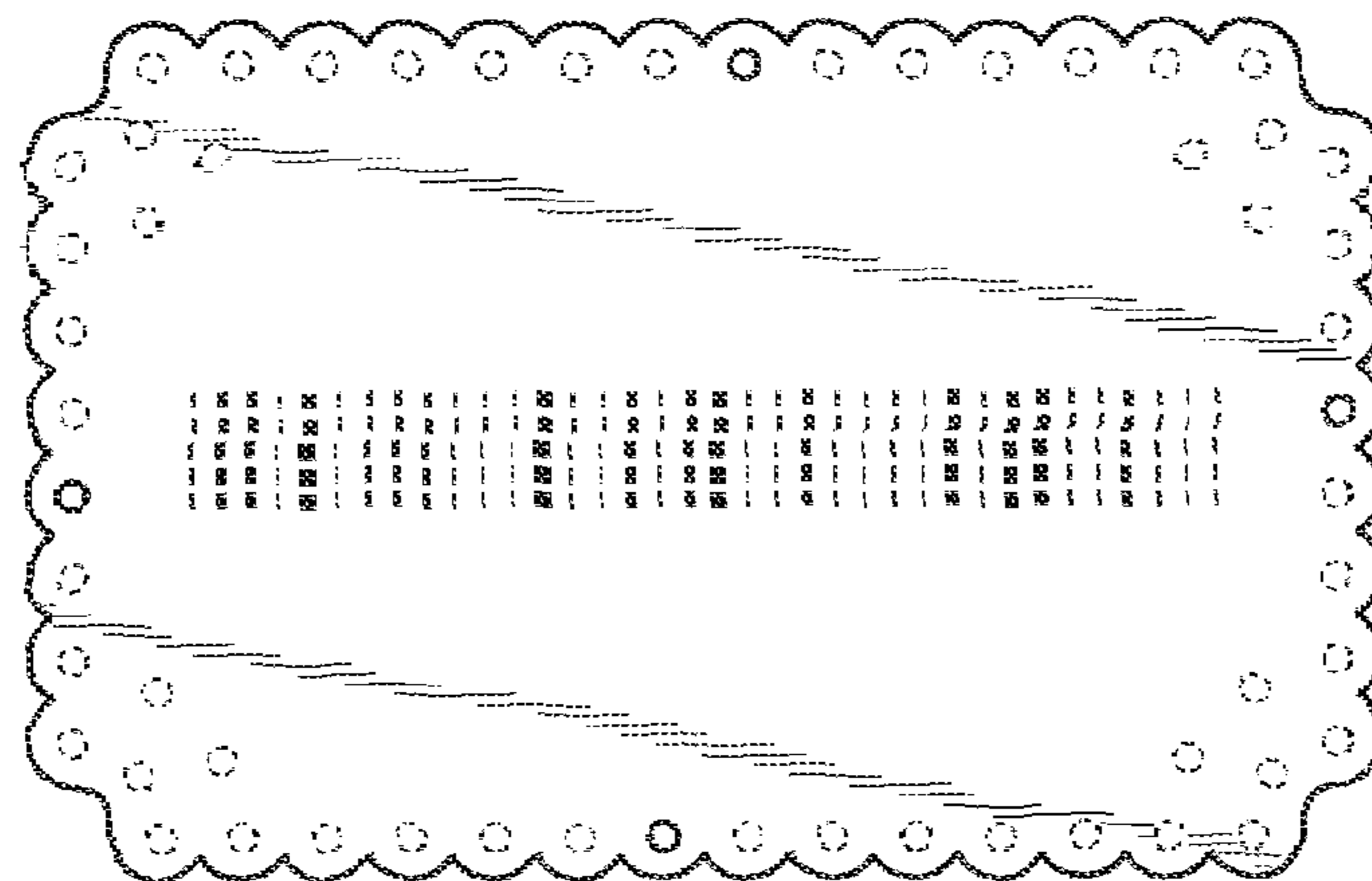
