FIG. 17 is a top view of an alternative embodiment of my new invention as used on a bowl;

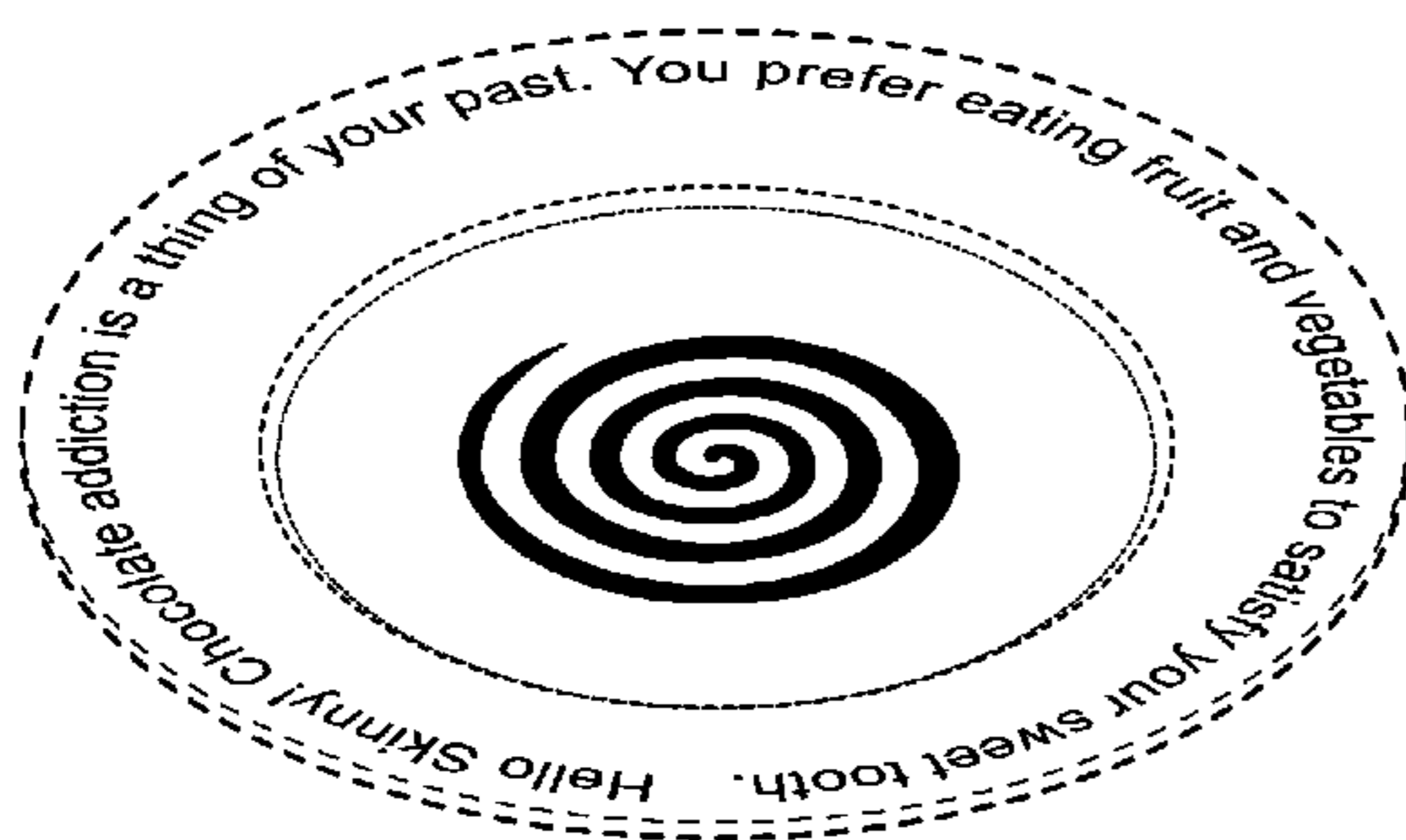
FIG. 18 is a top view of an alternative embodiment of my new invention as used on a bowl;

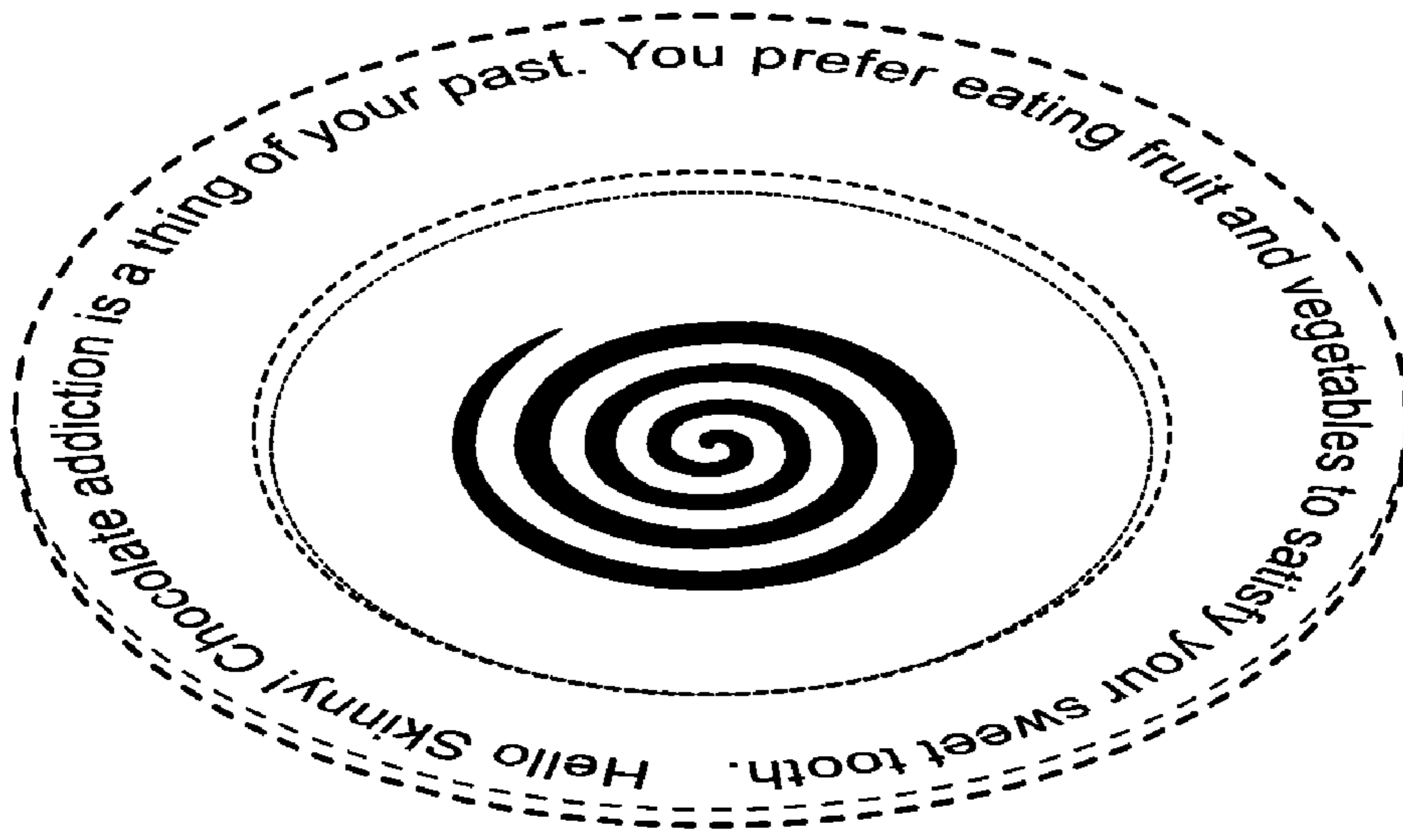

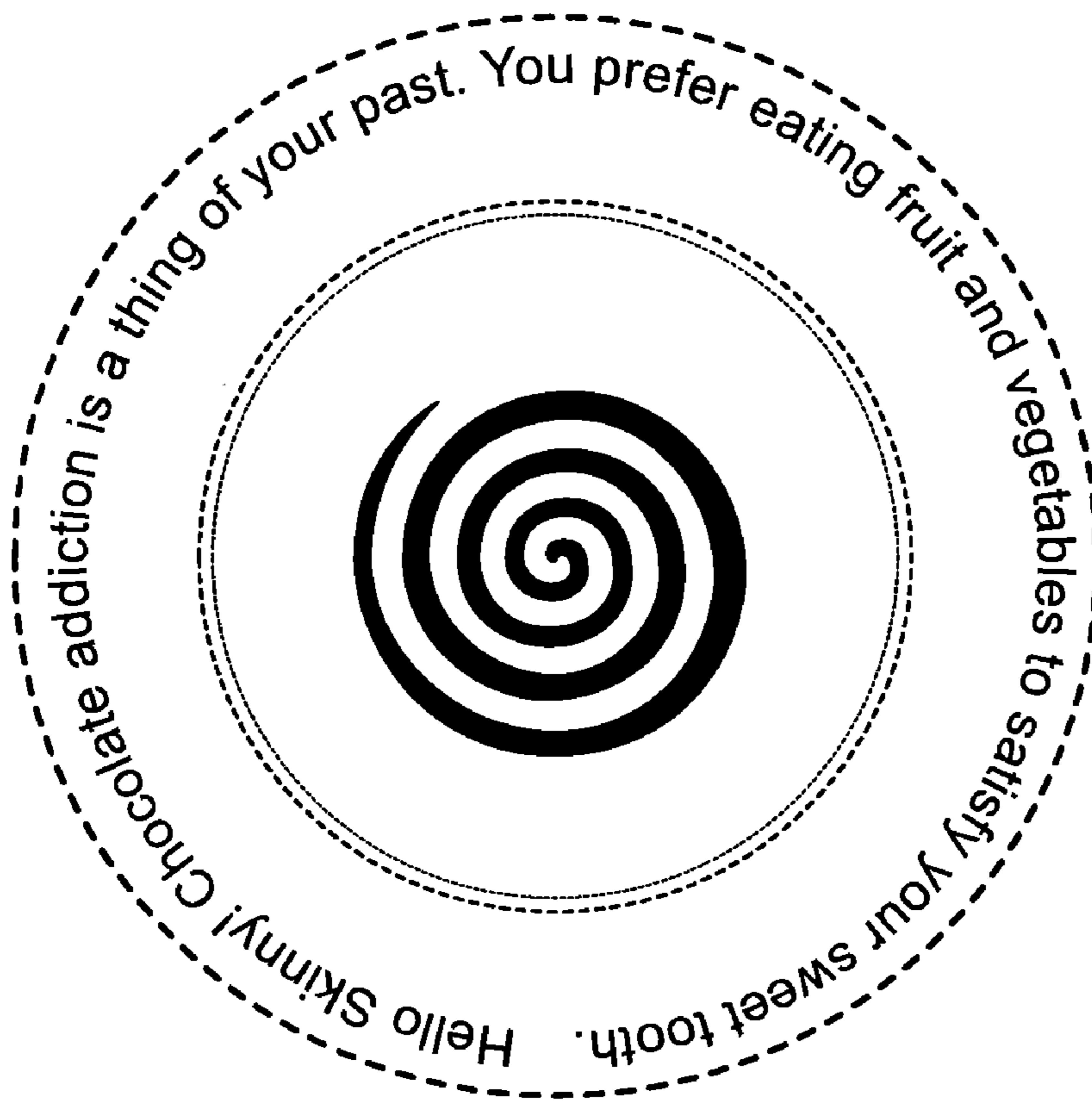

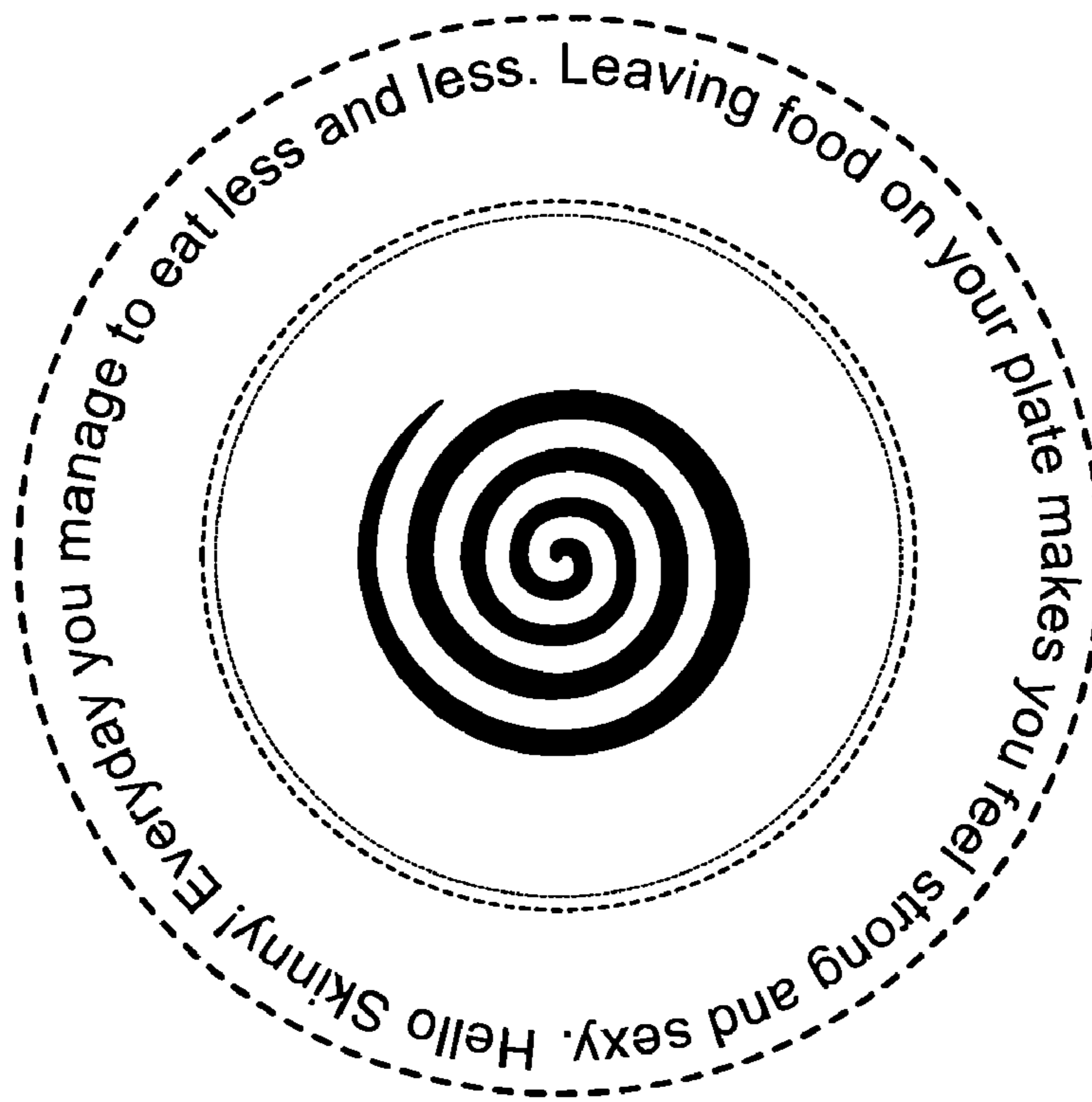

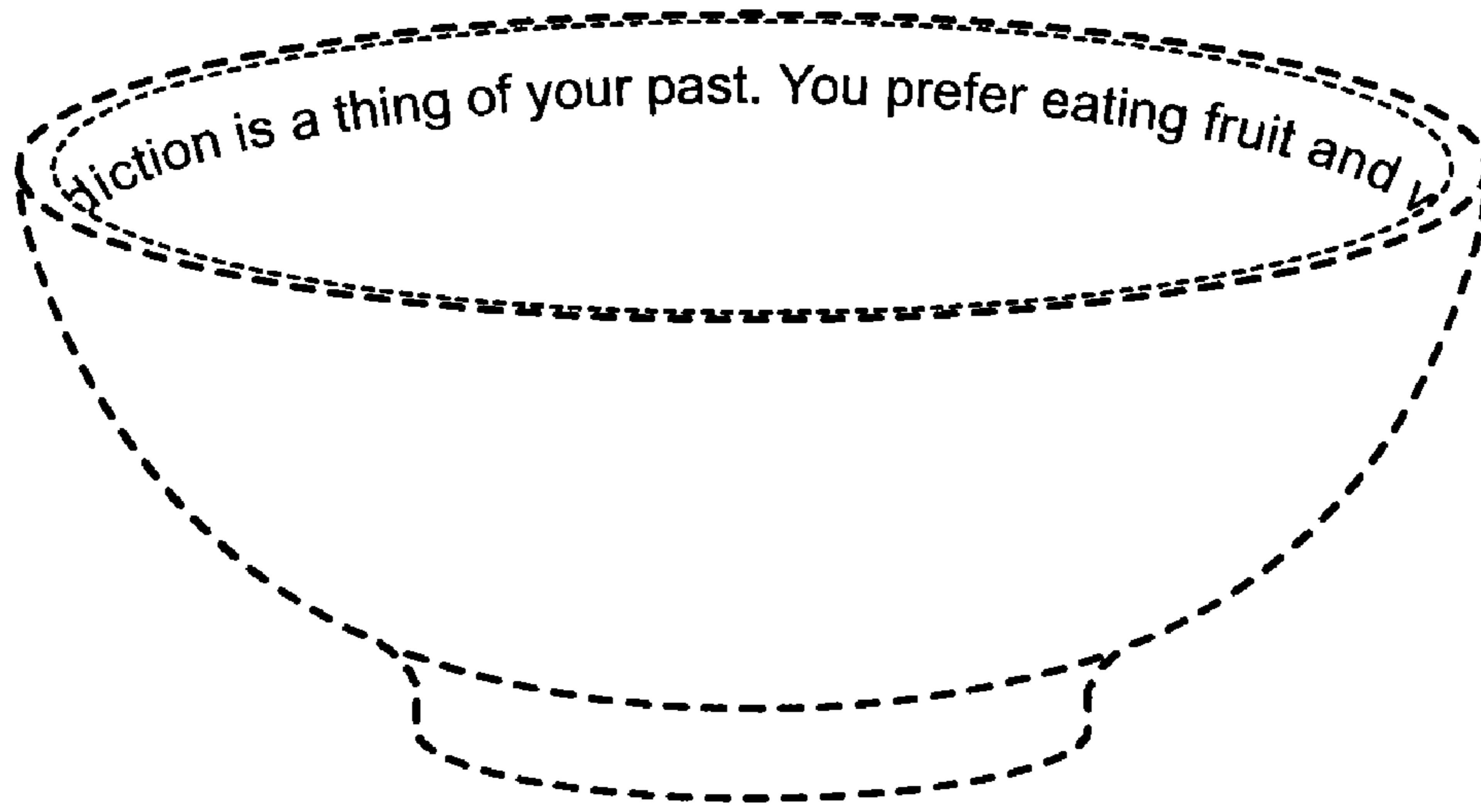
