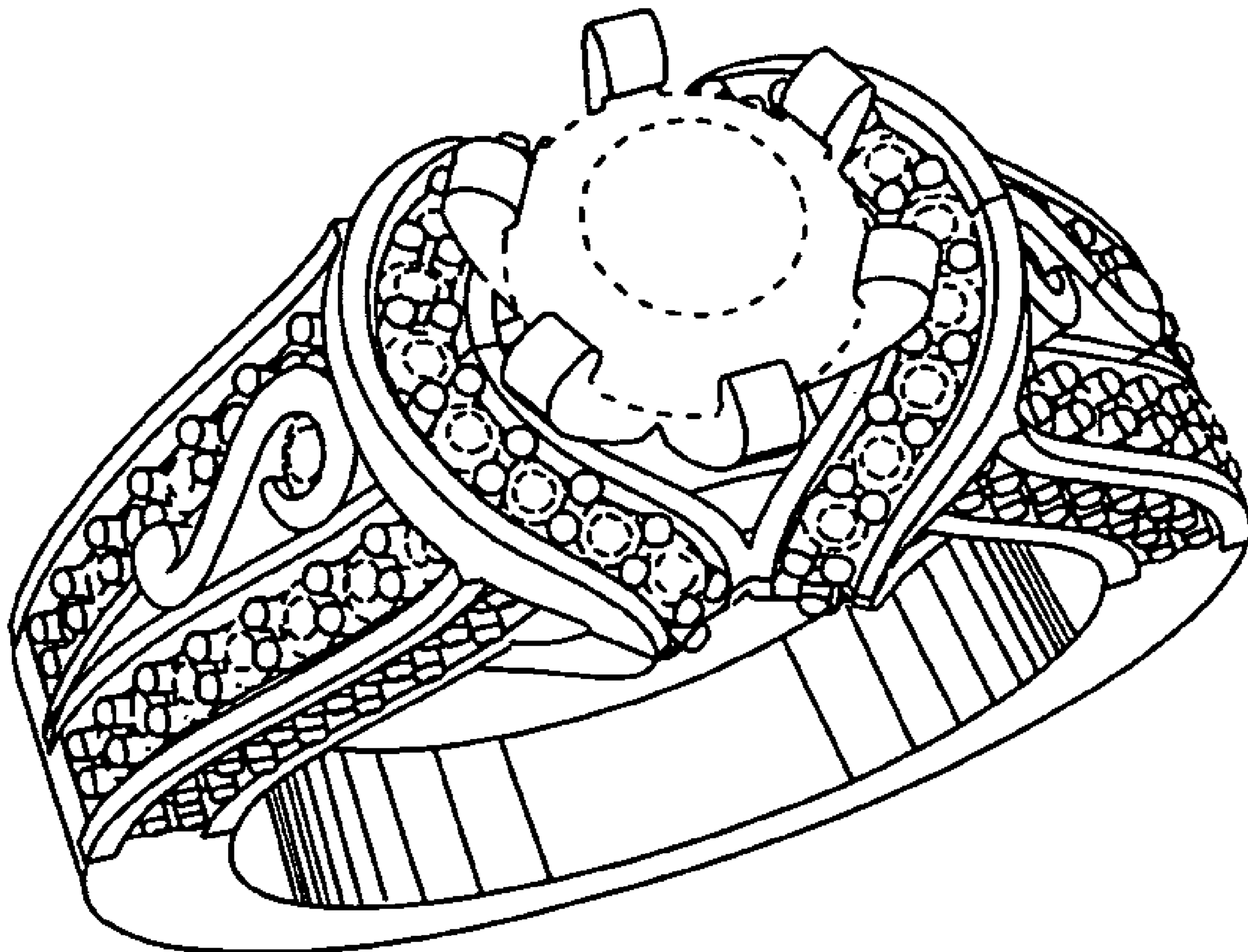
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof when viewed from the left side, the side elevational view from the right side being a mirror image thereof.

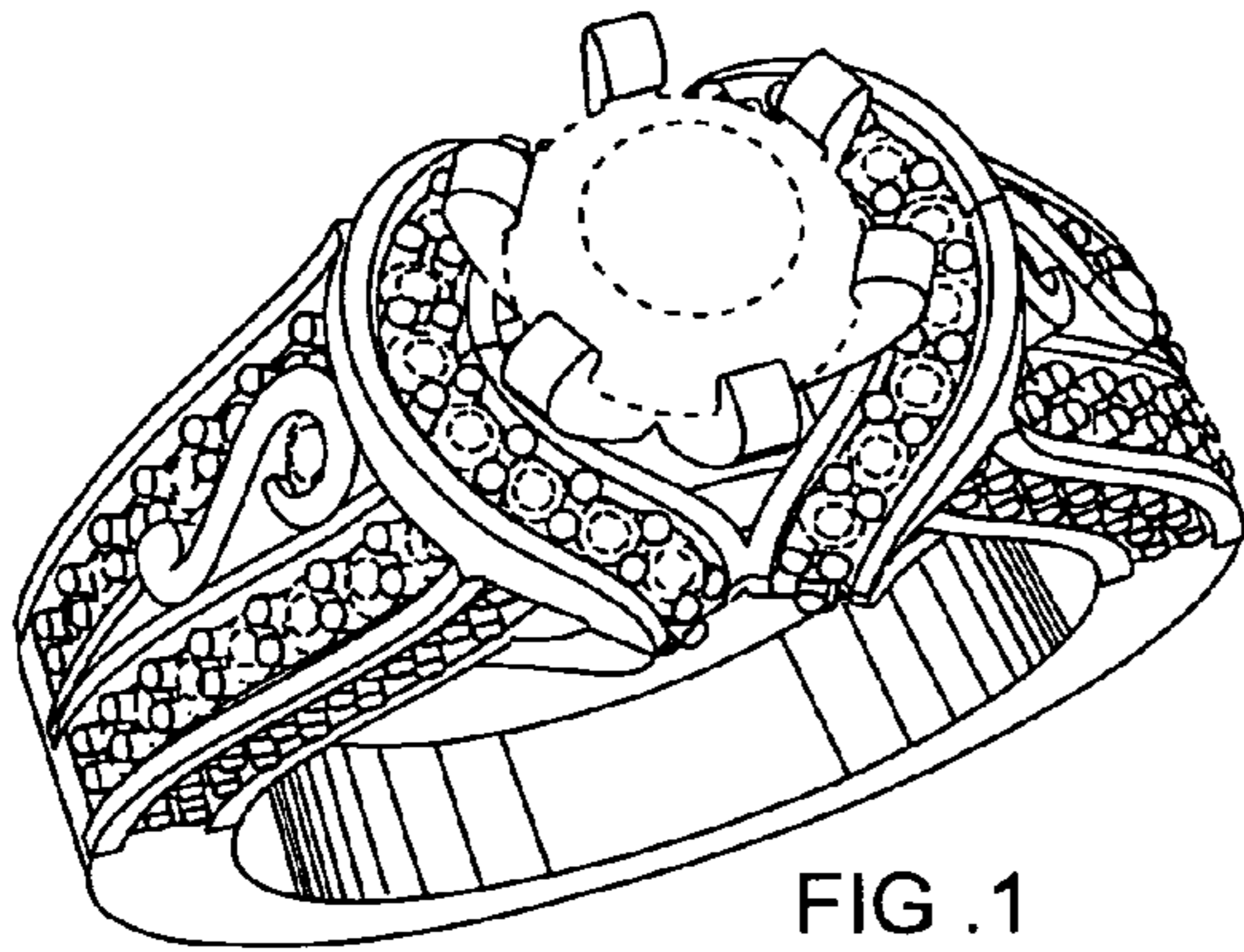

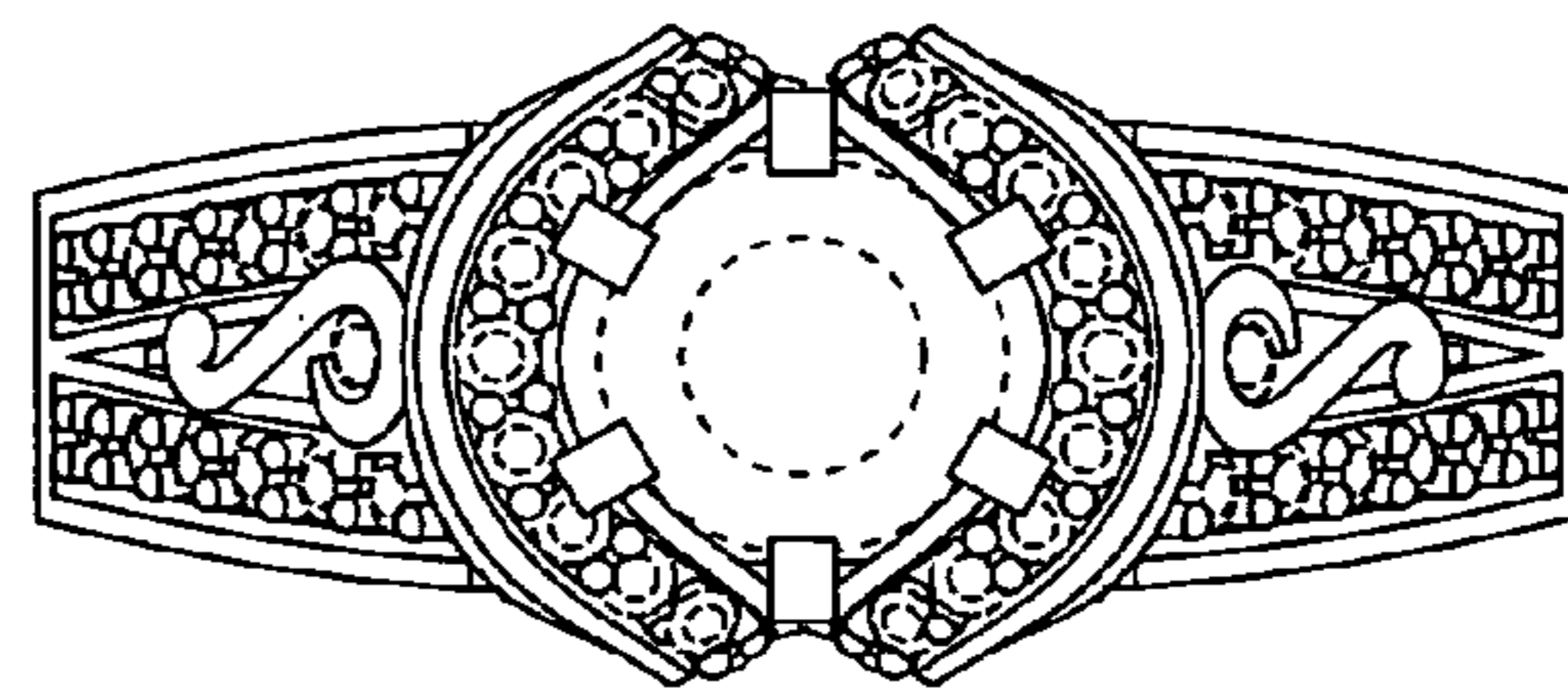

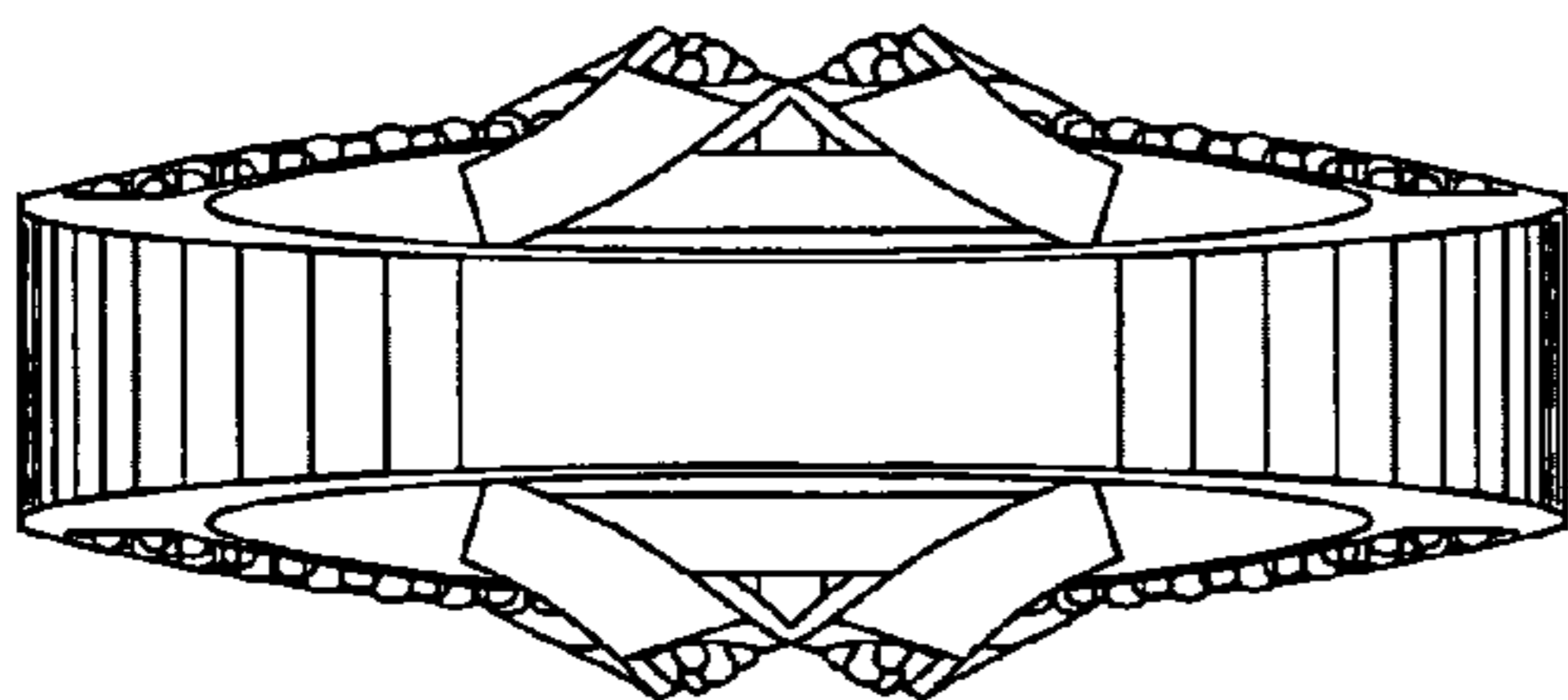

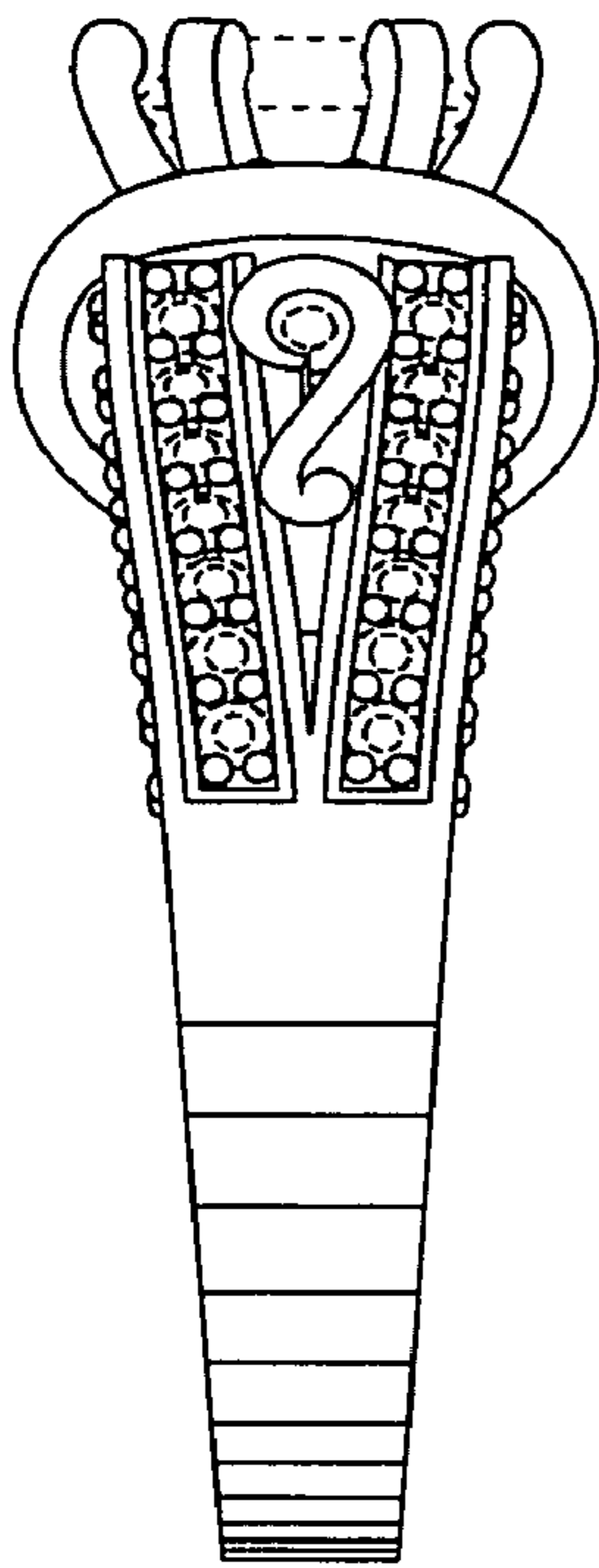

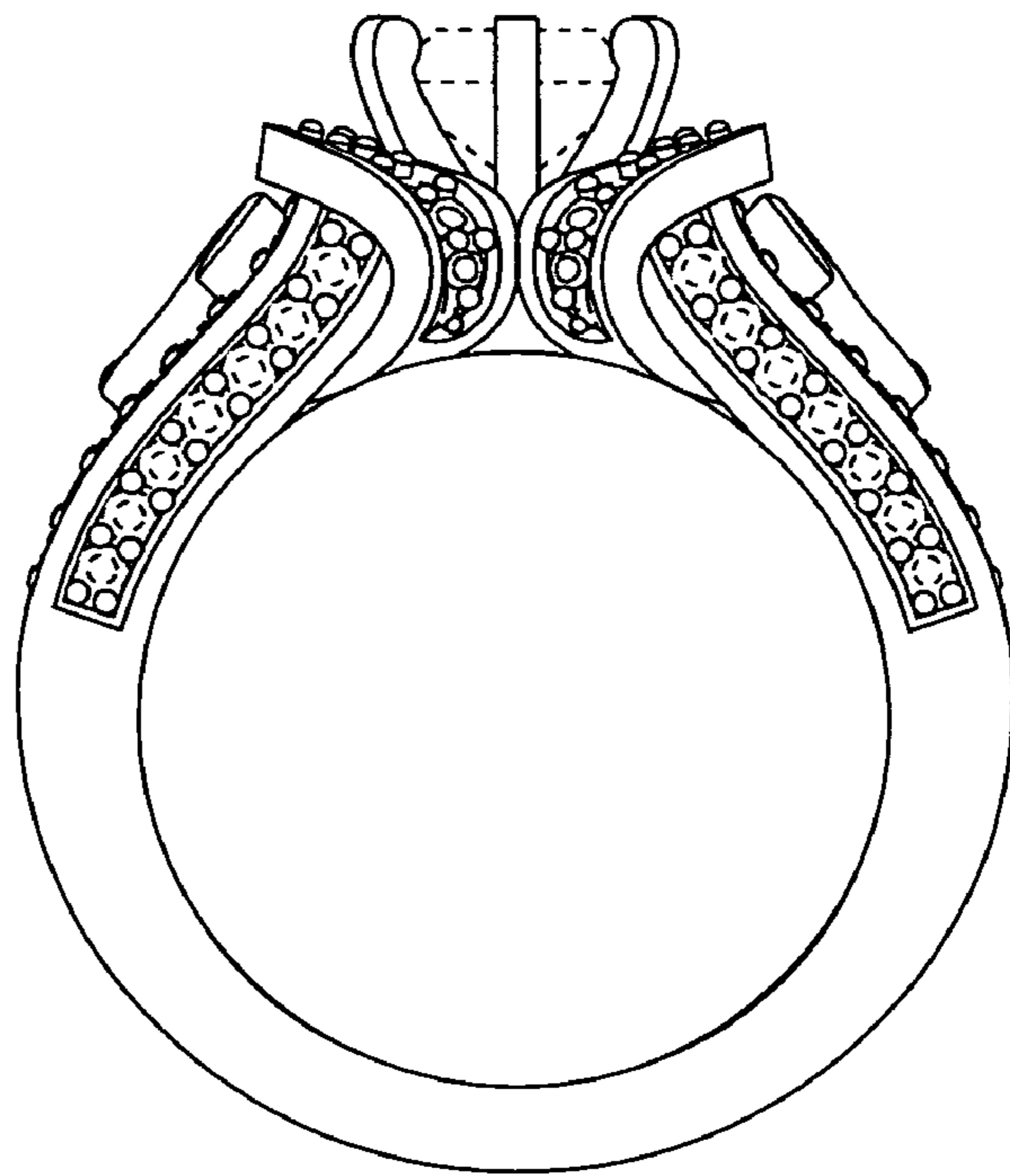
