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(57) **CLAIM**

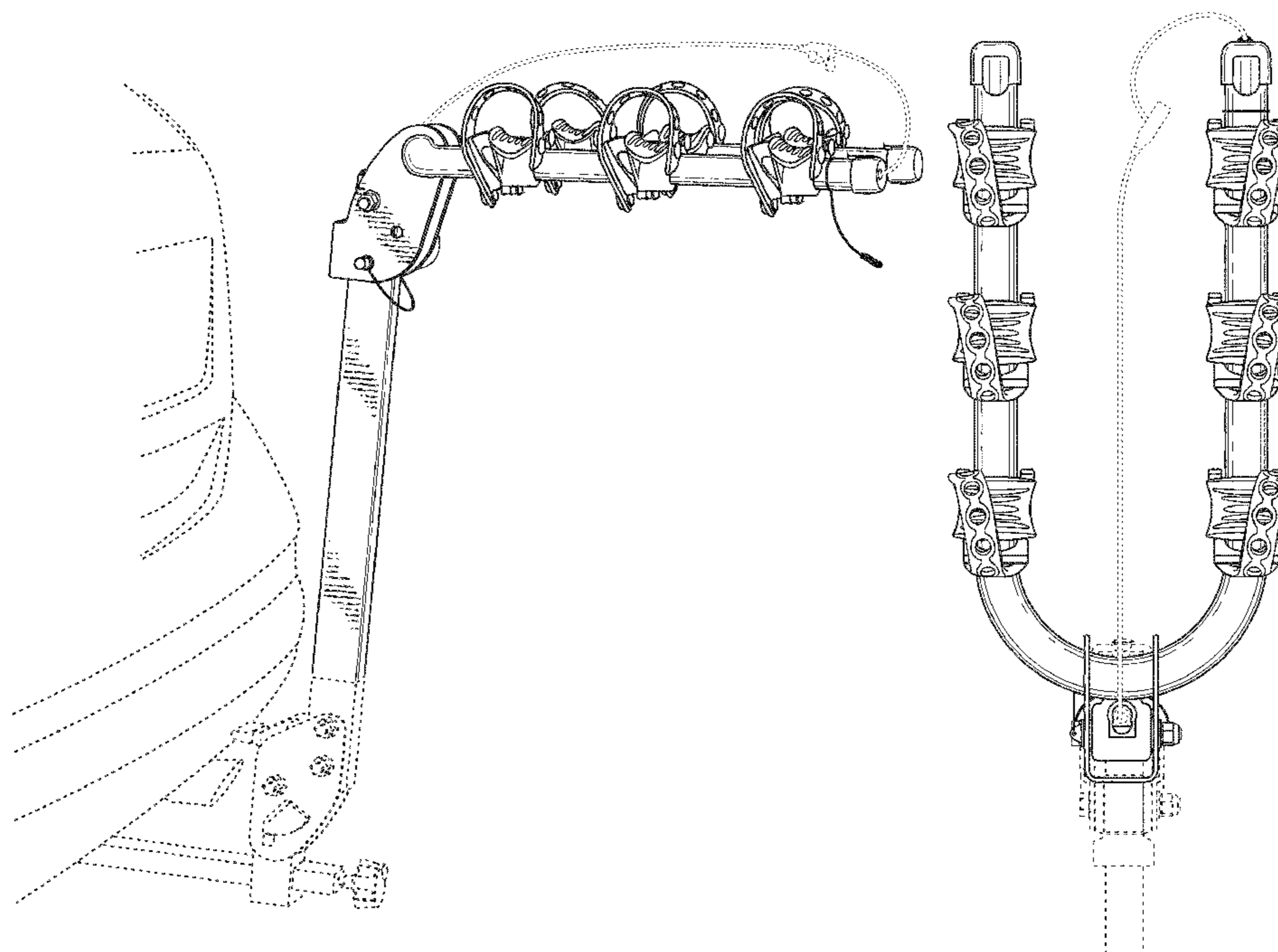
We claim the ornamental design for a bicycle carrier rack, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bicycle carrier rack;
- FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
- FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
- FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
- FIG. 5 is bottom plan view of the left end thereof;
- FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
- FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.

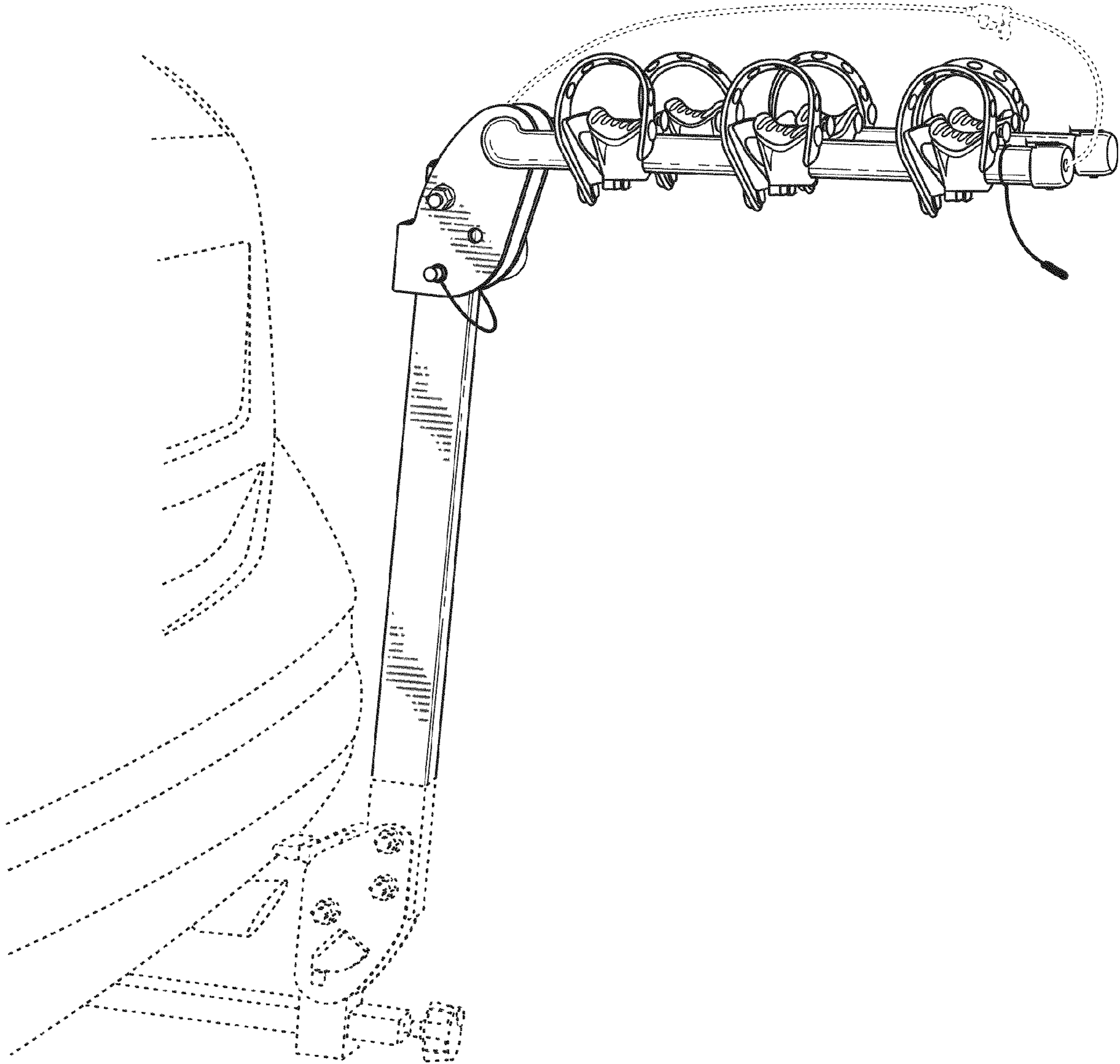

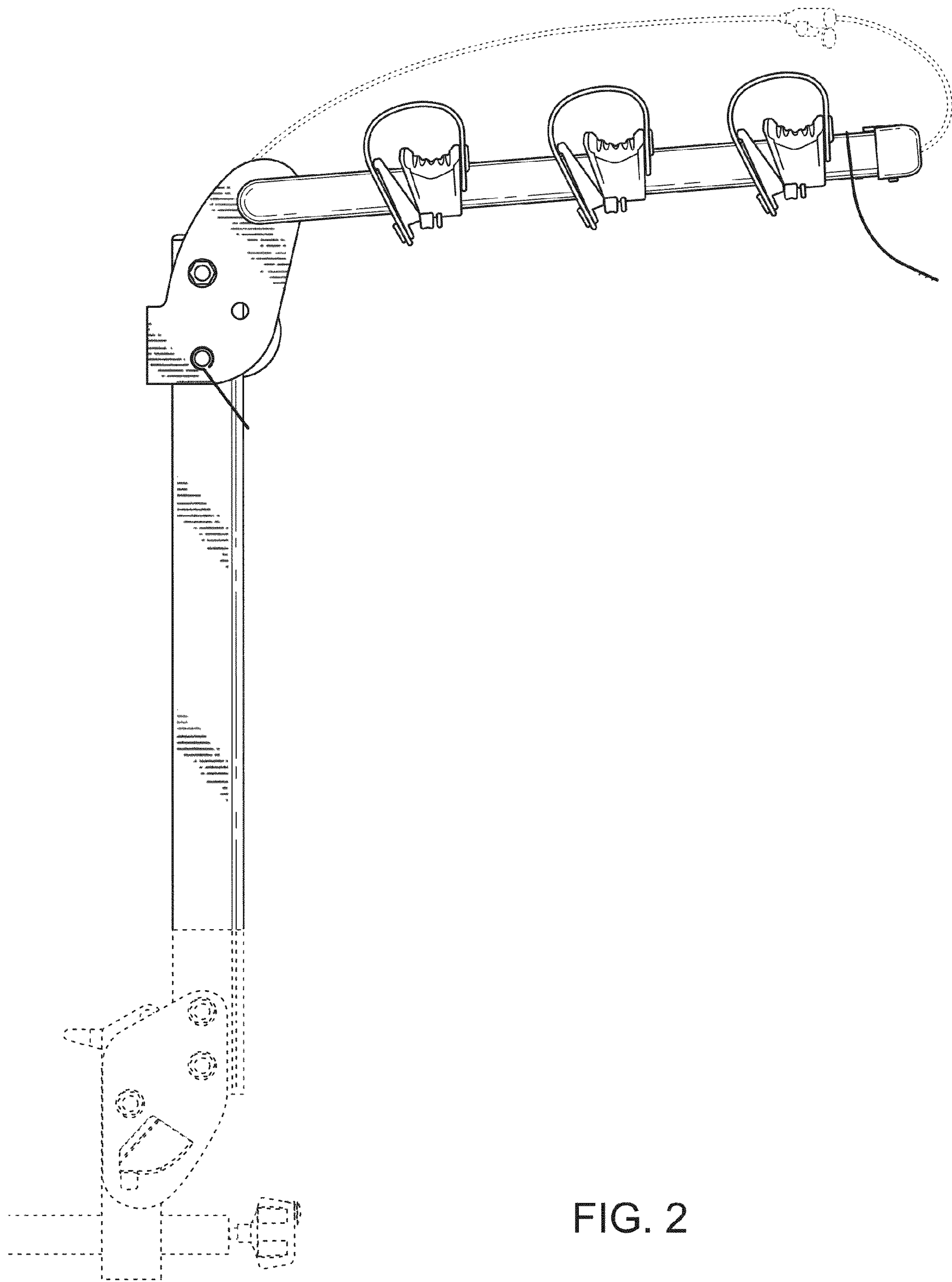

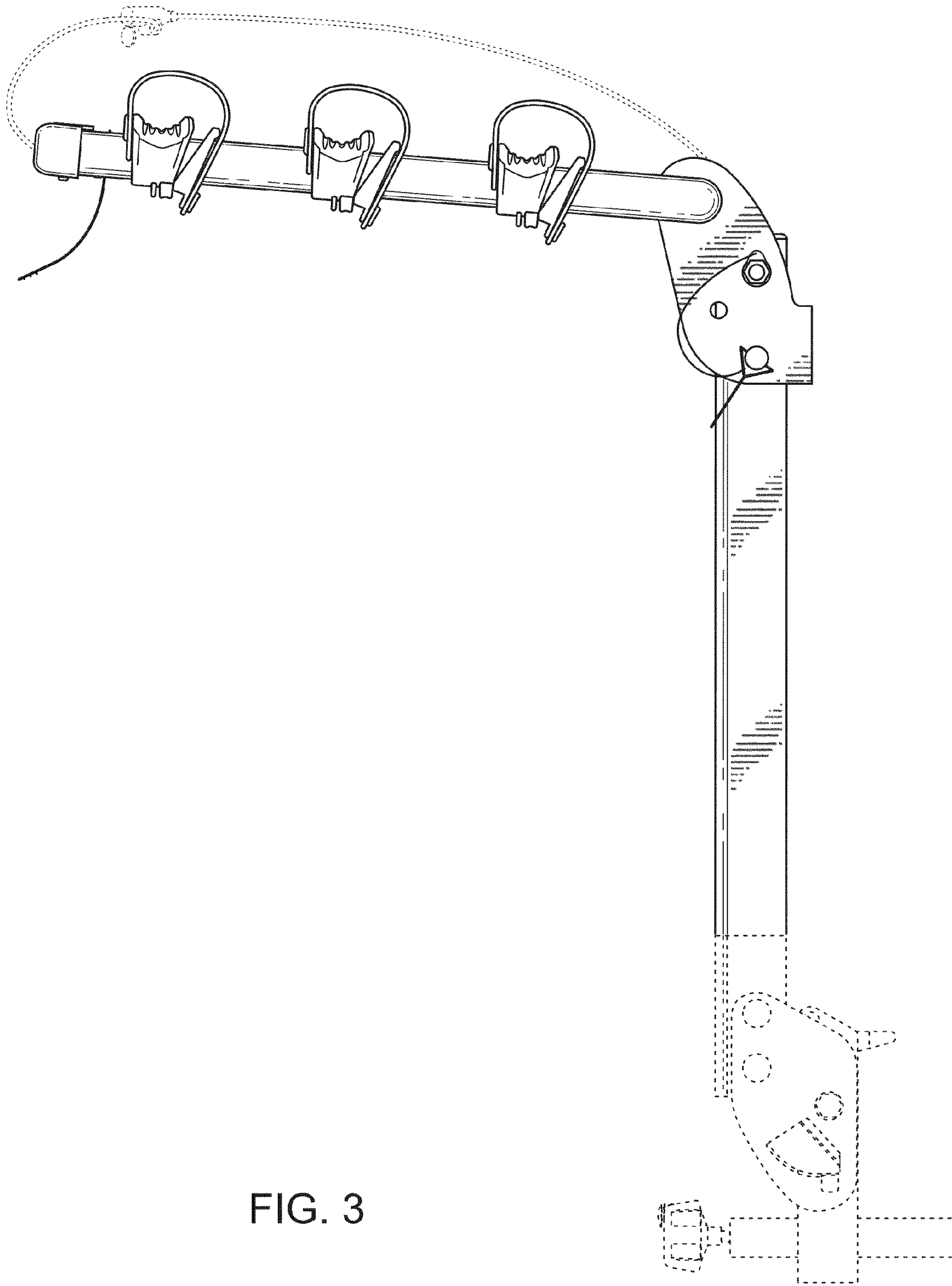

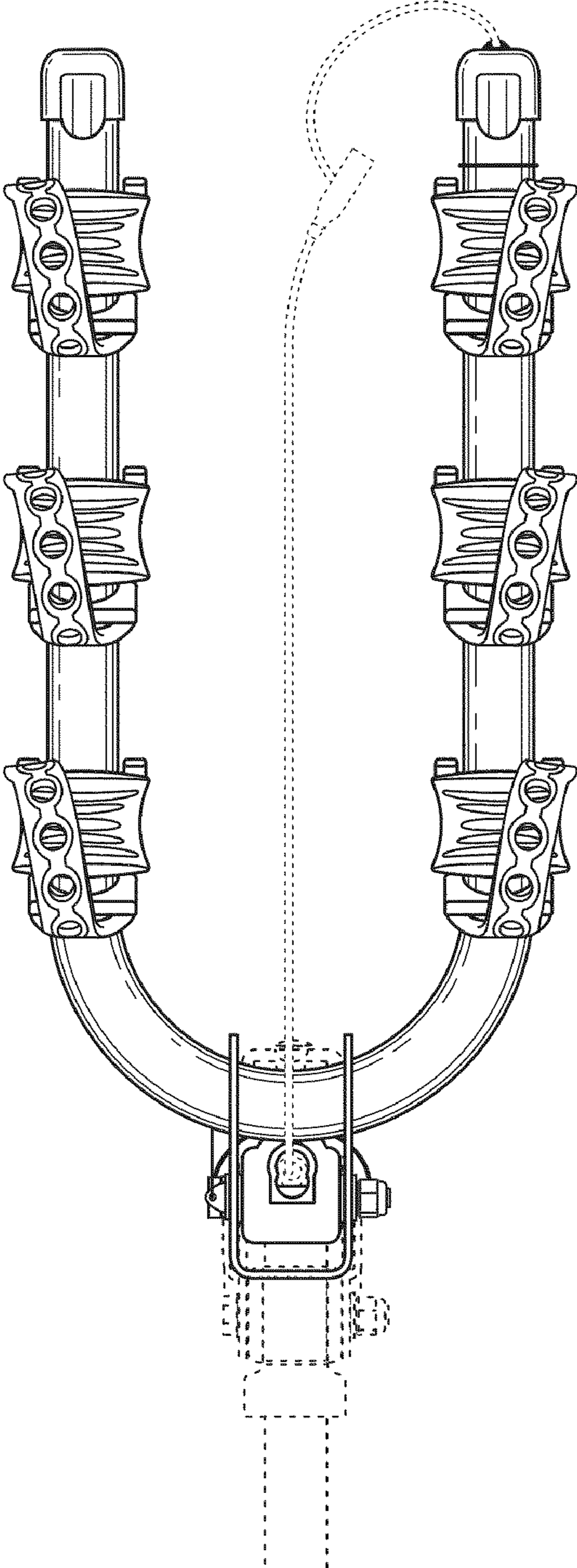

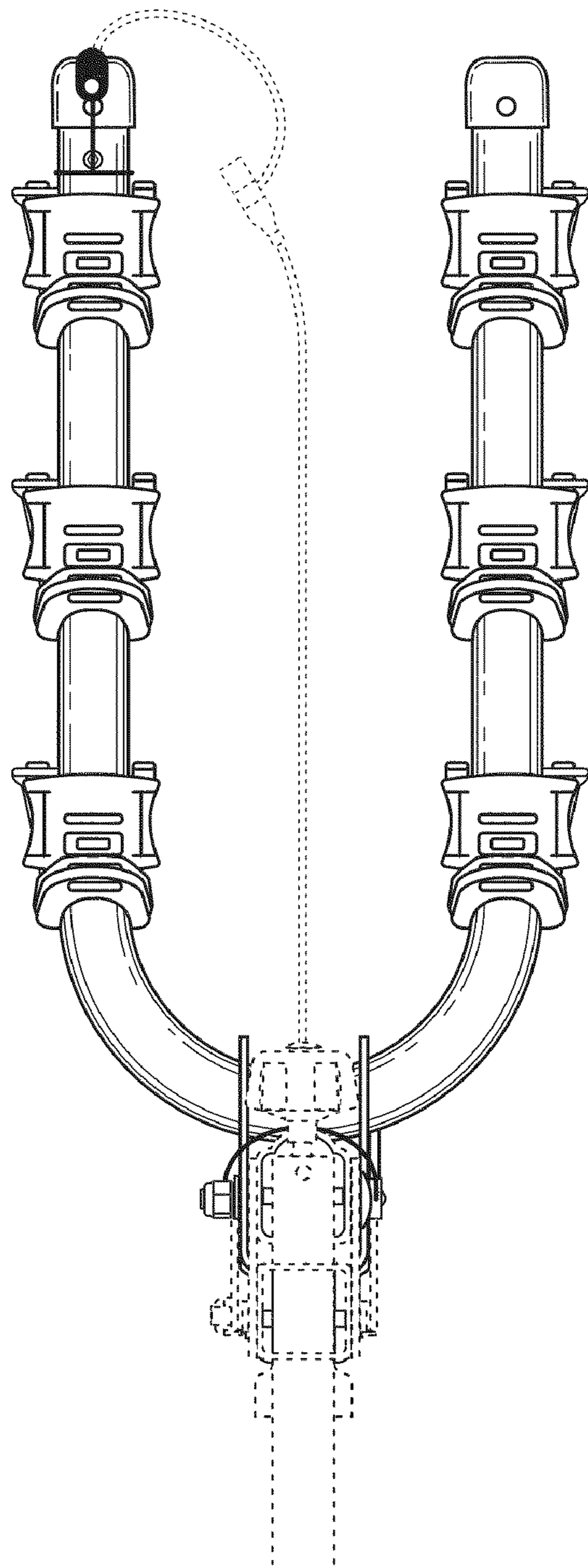

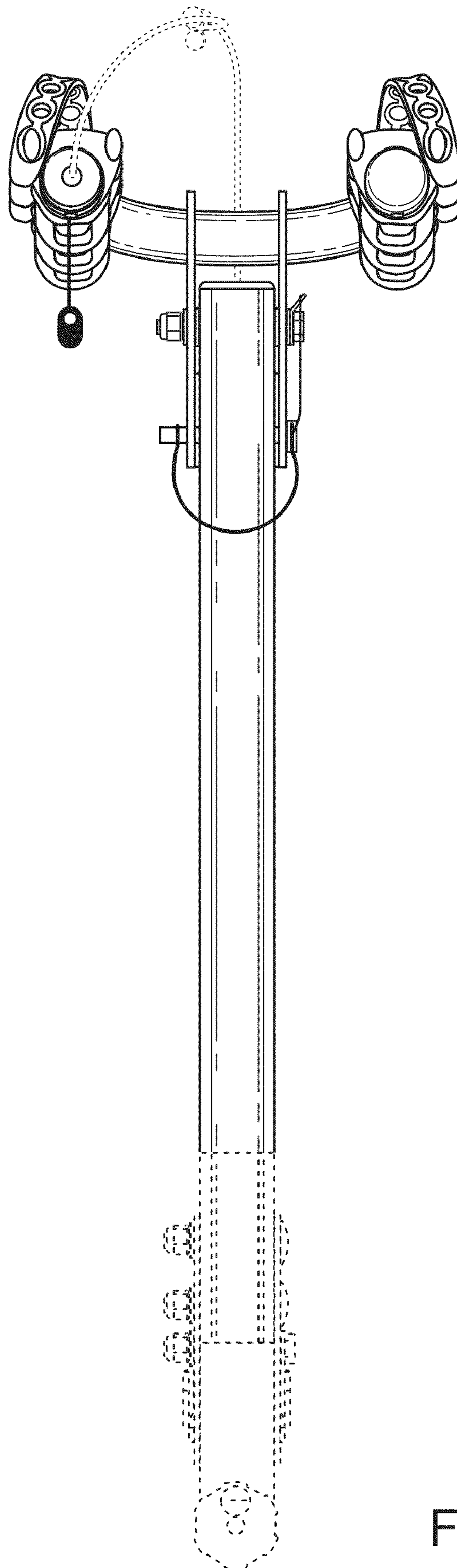

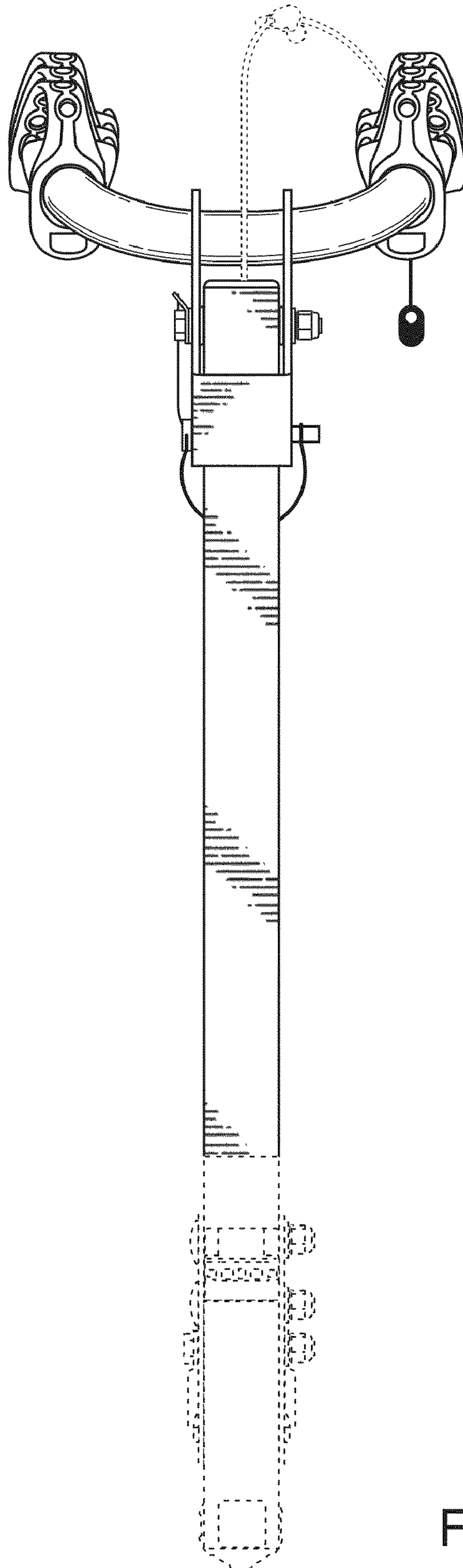
