FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

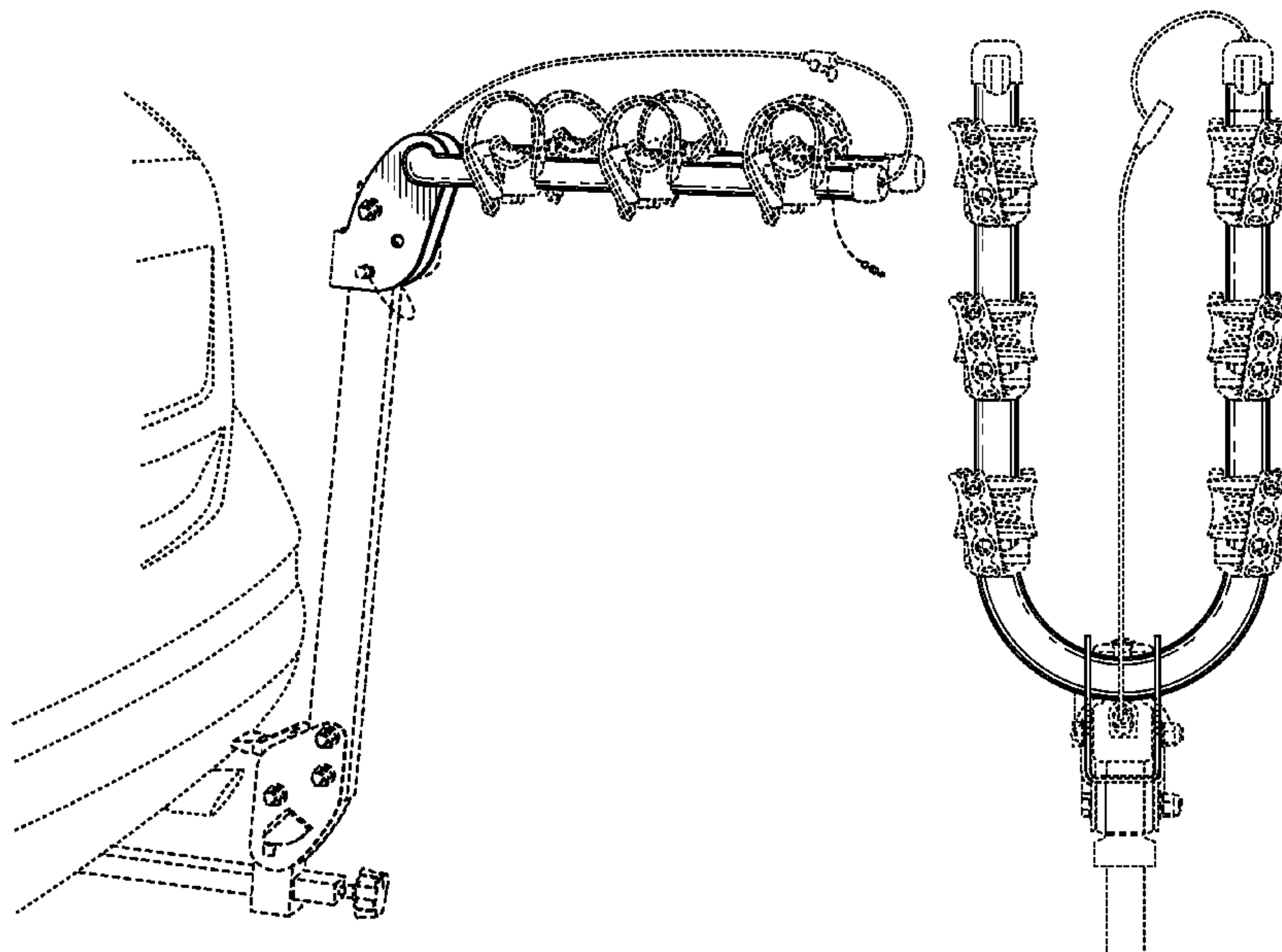
FIG. 5 is bottom plan view of the left end thereof;

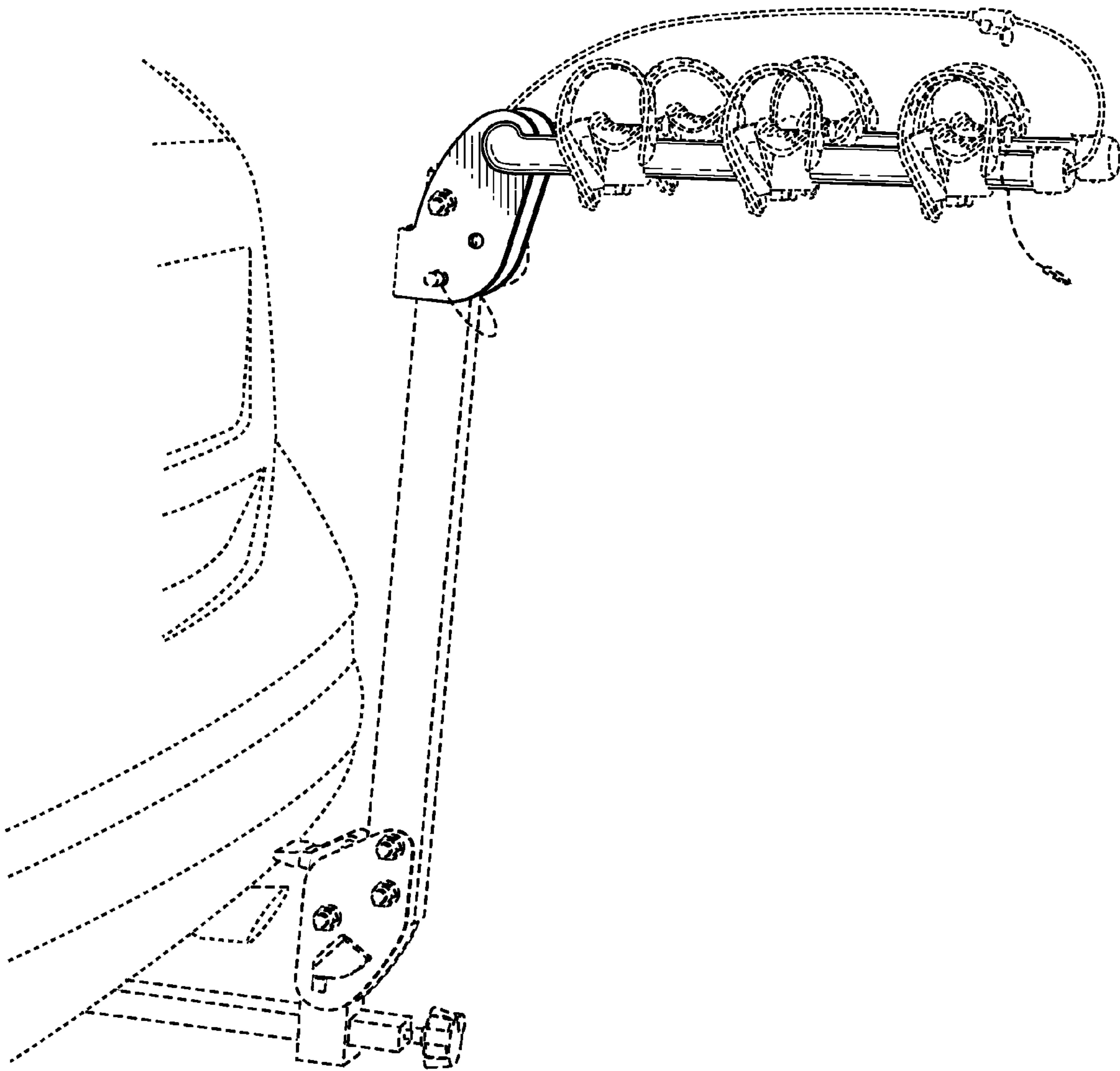

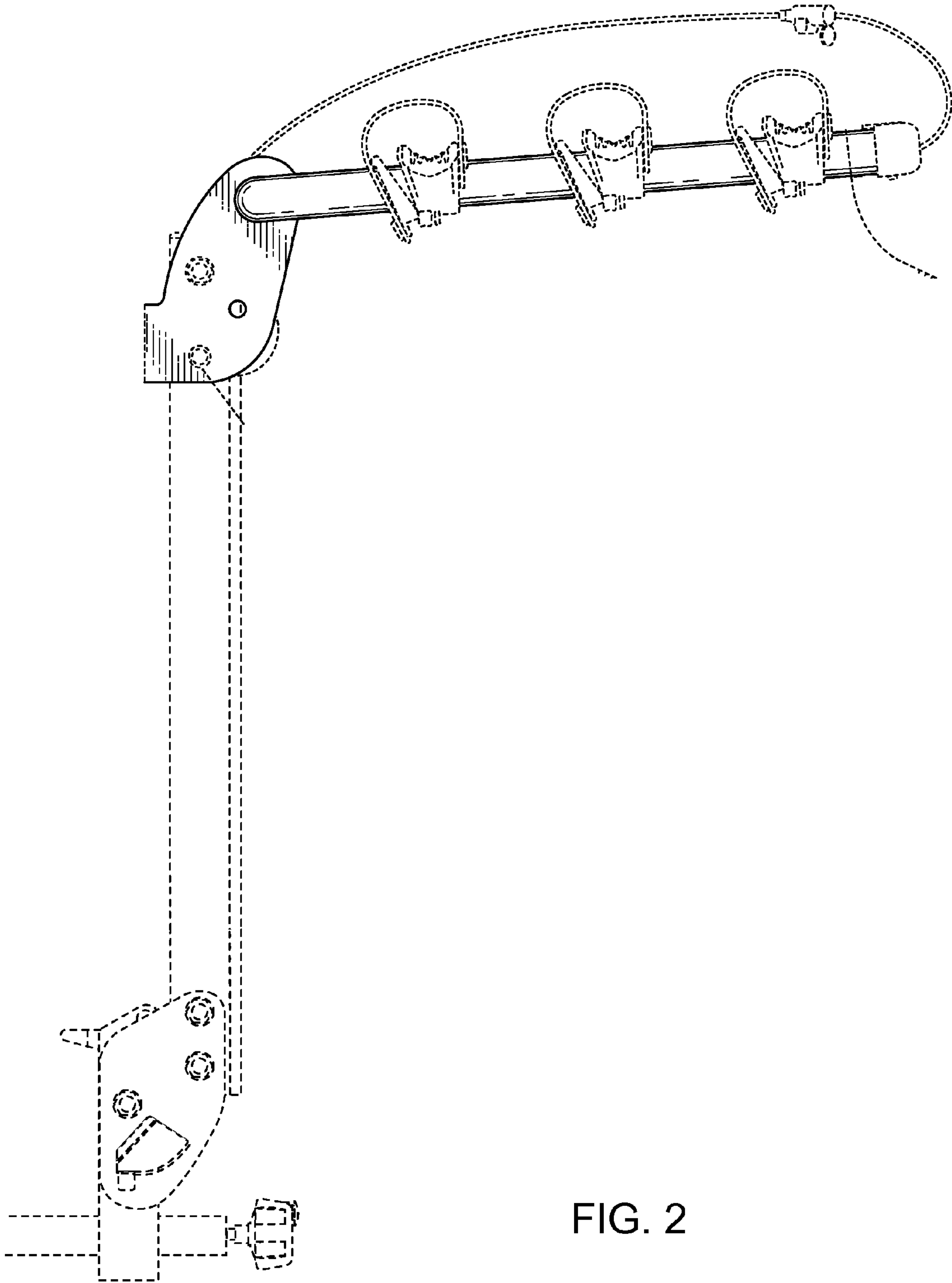

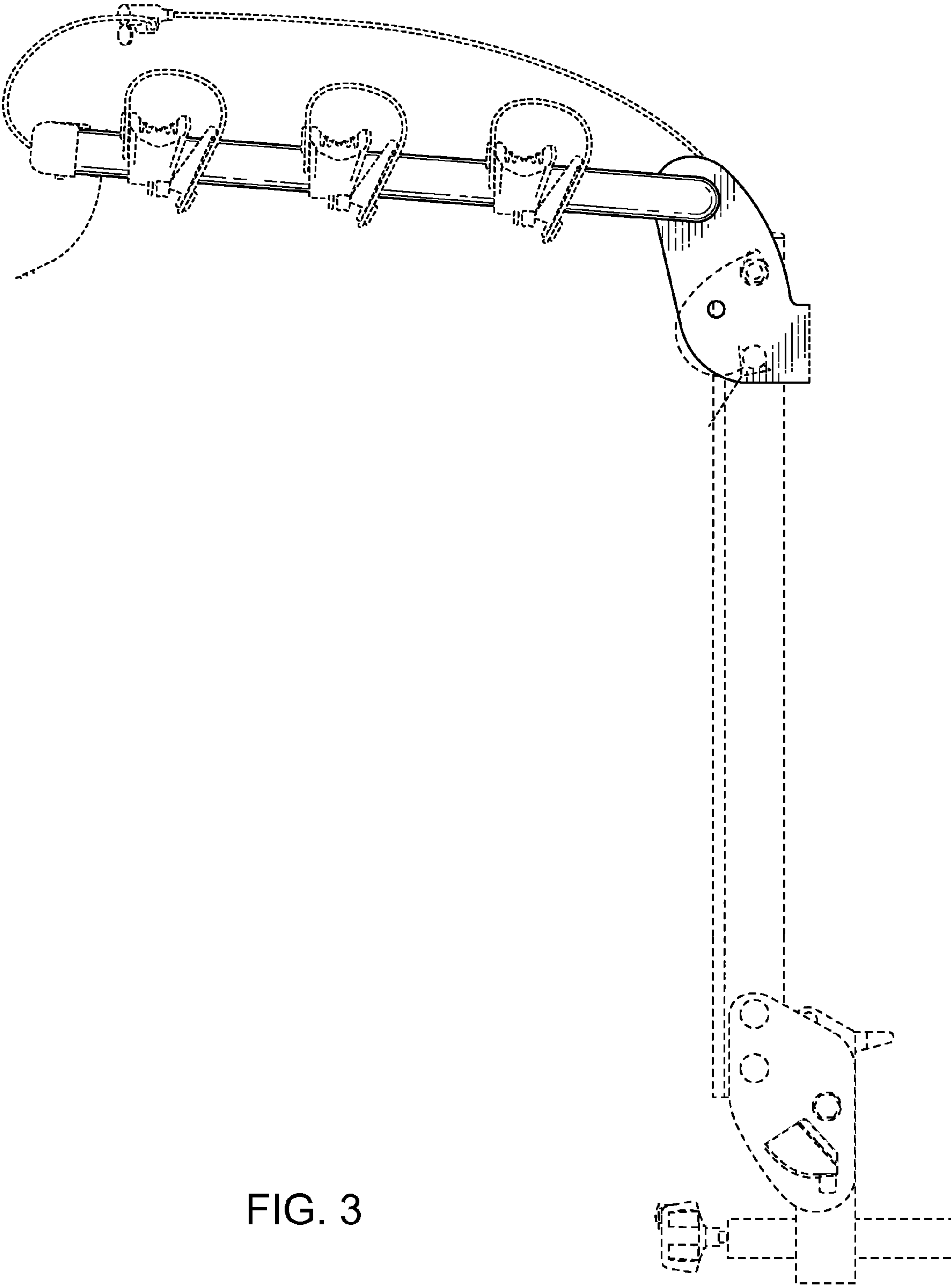

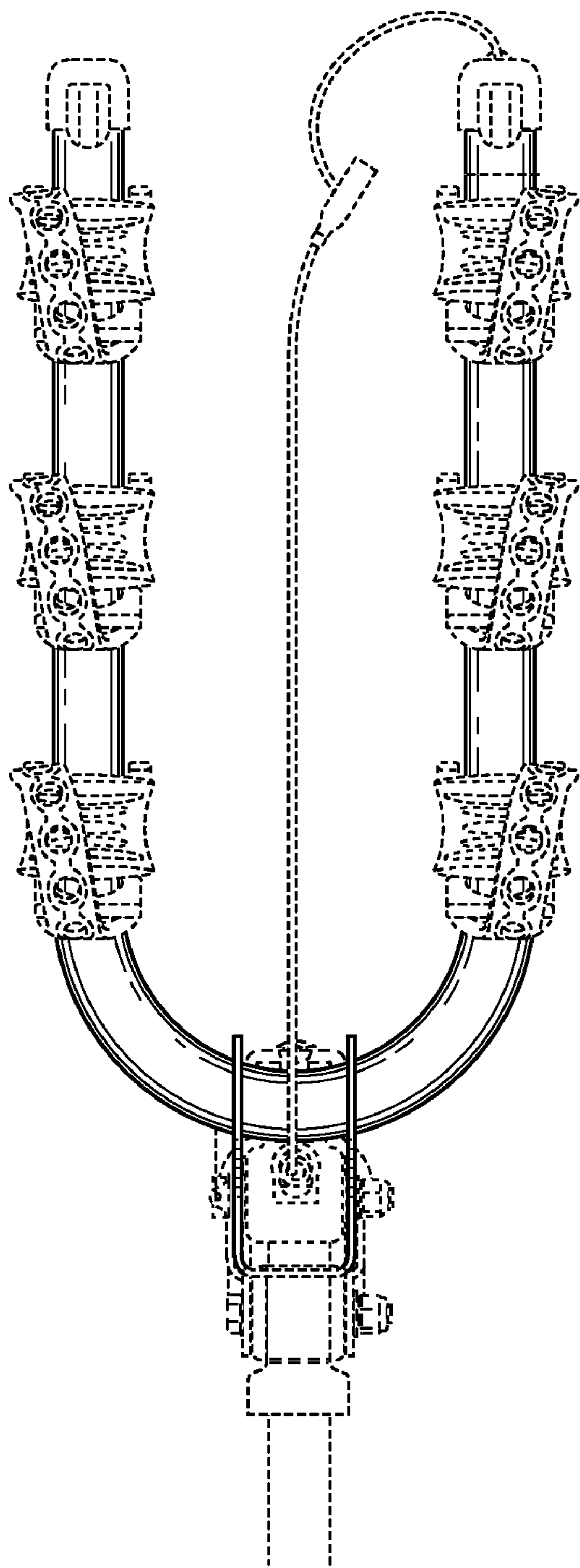

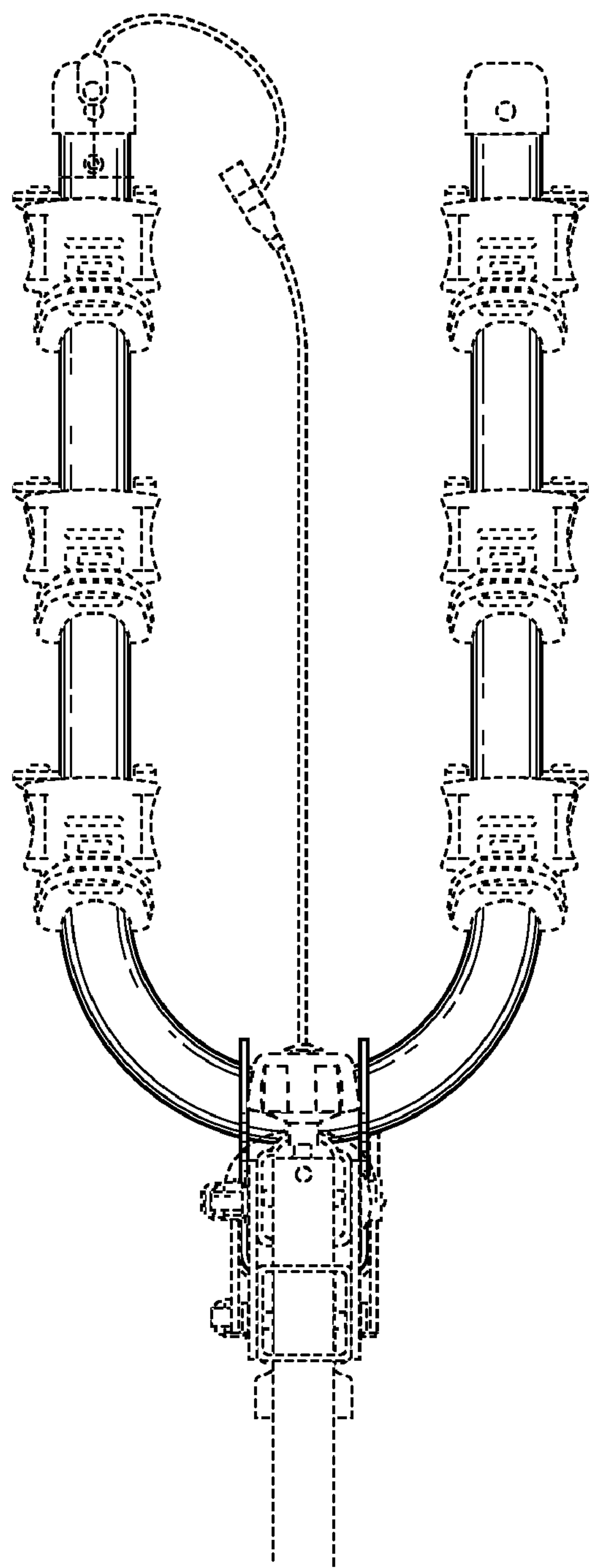

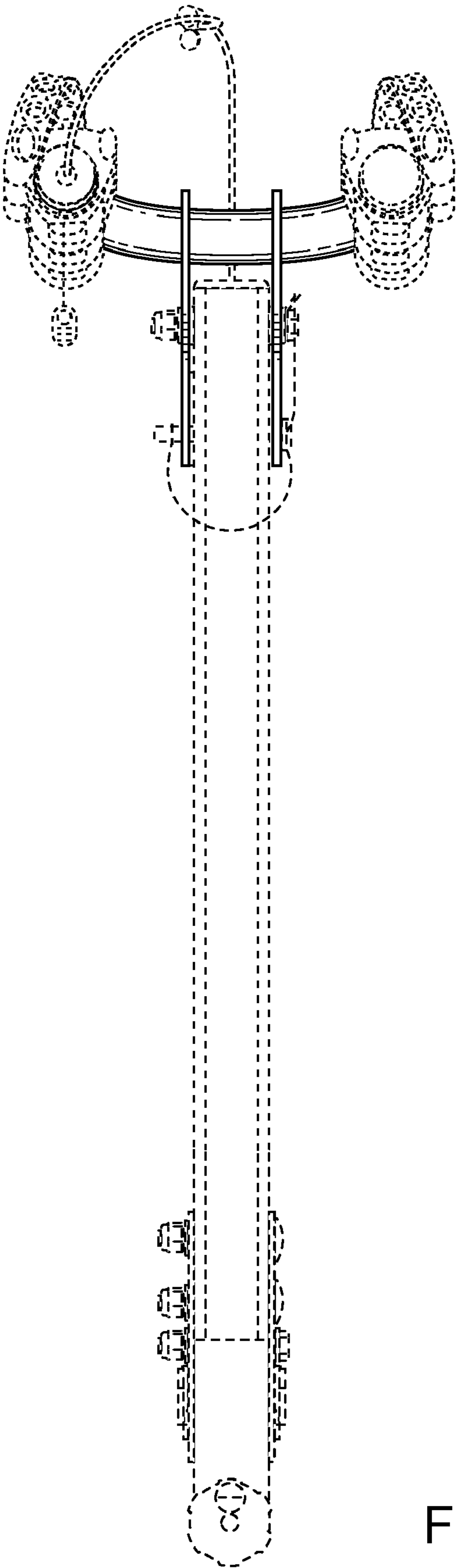

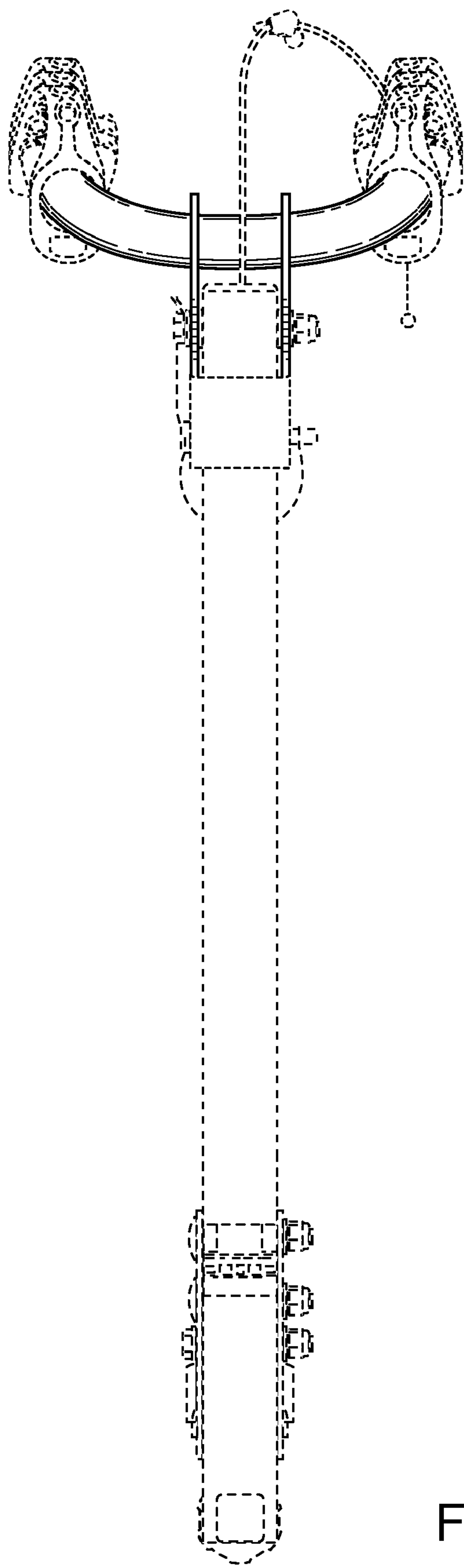
