FIG. 4 is the fourth image thereof;

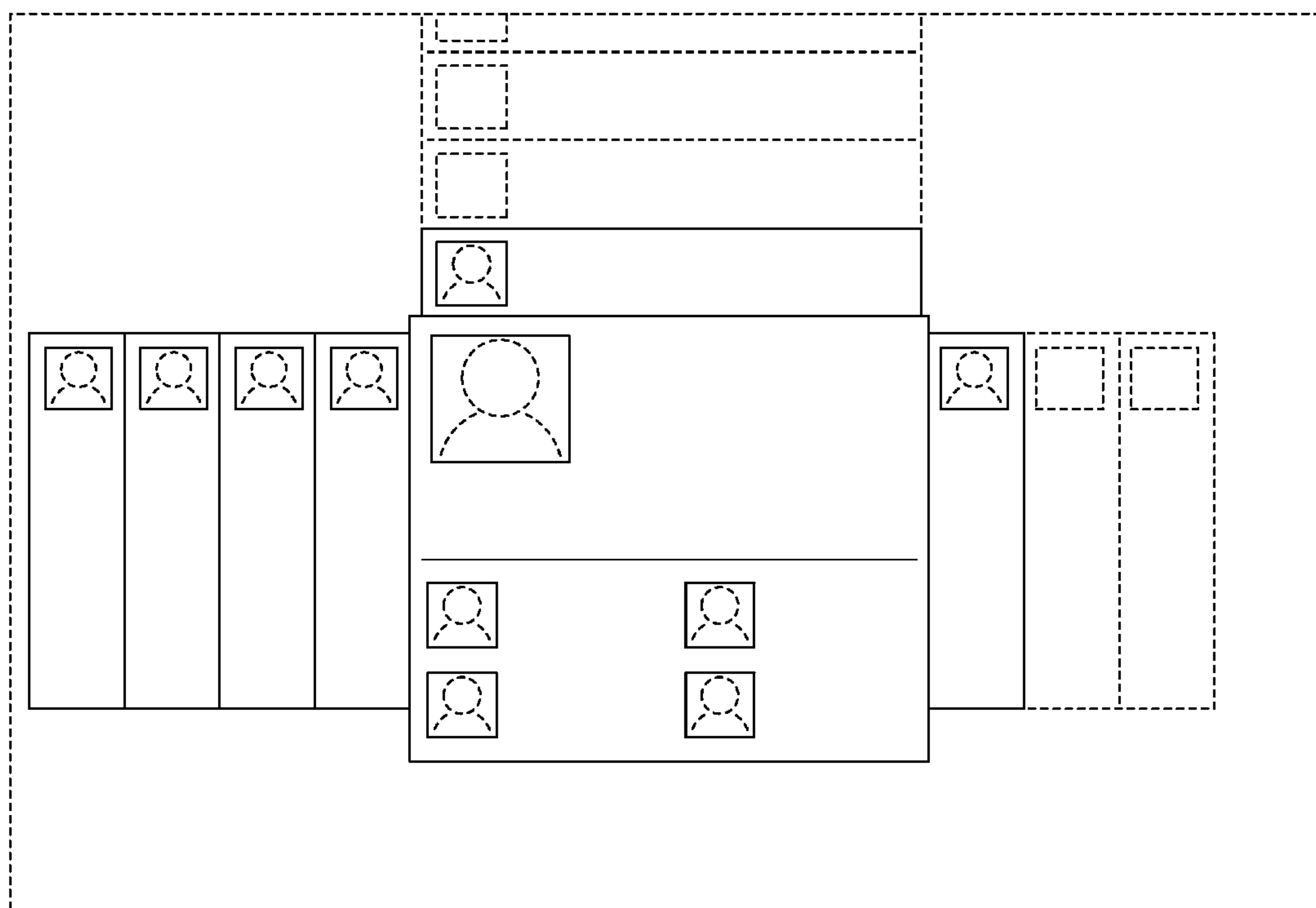
FIG. 5 is the fifth image thereof;

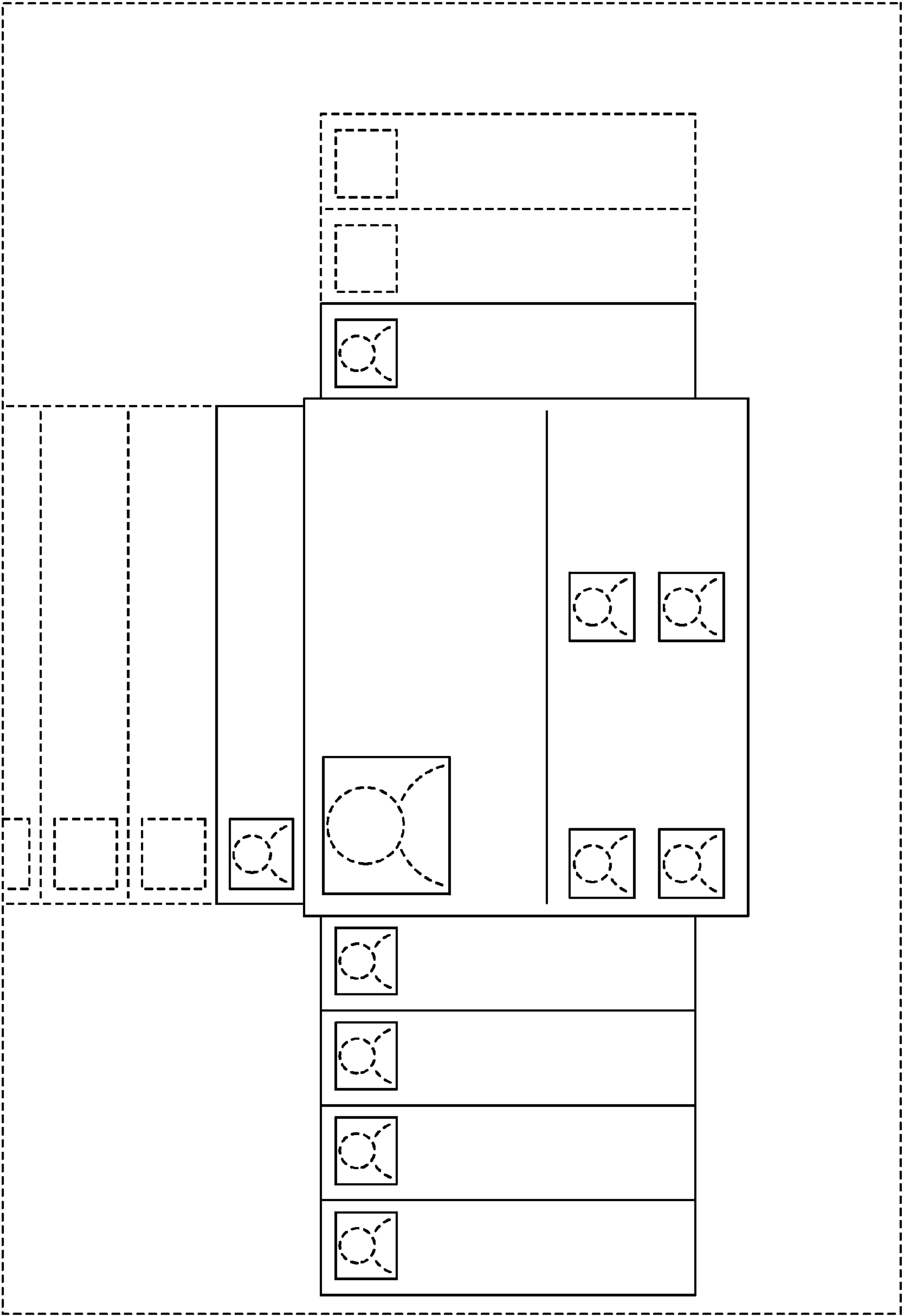

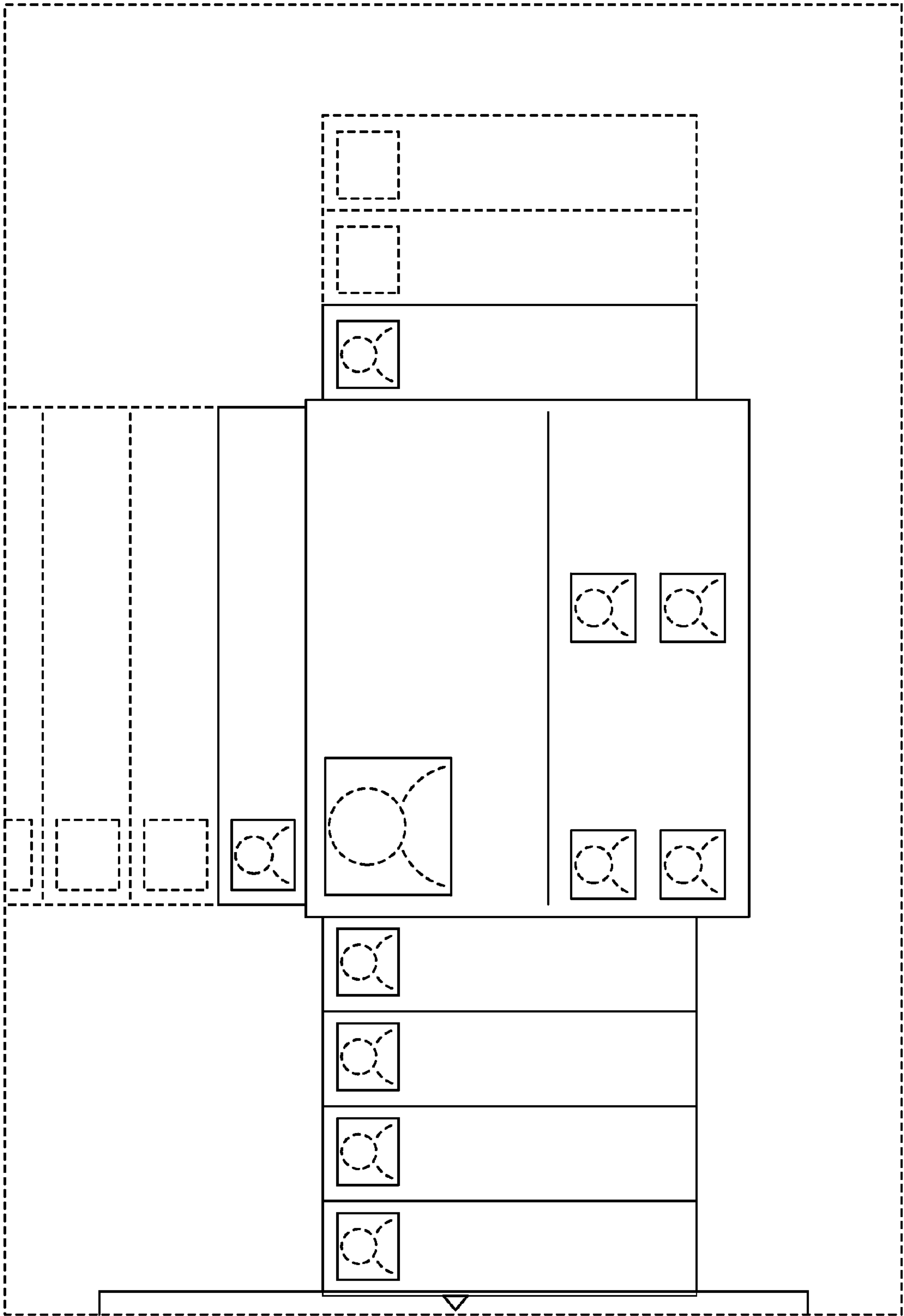

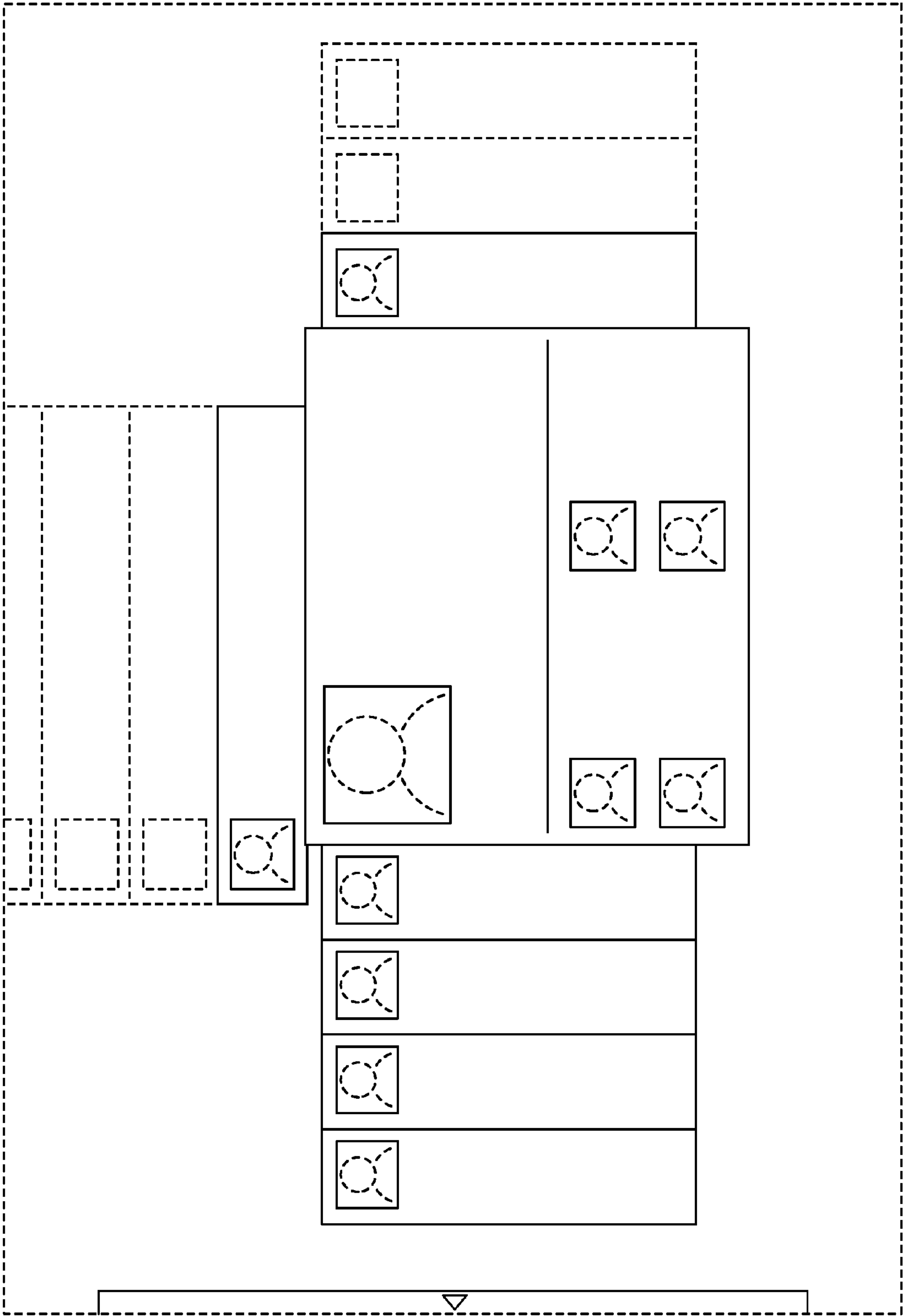

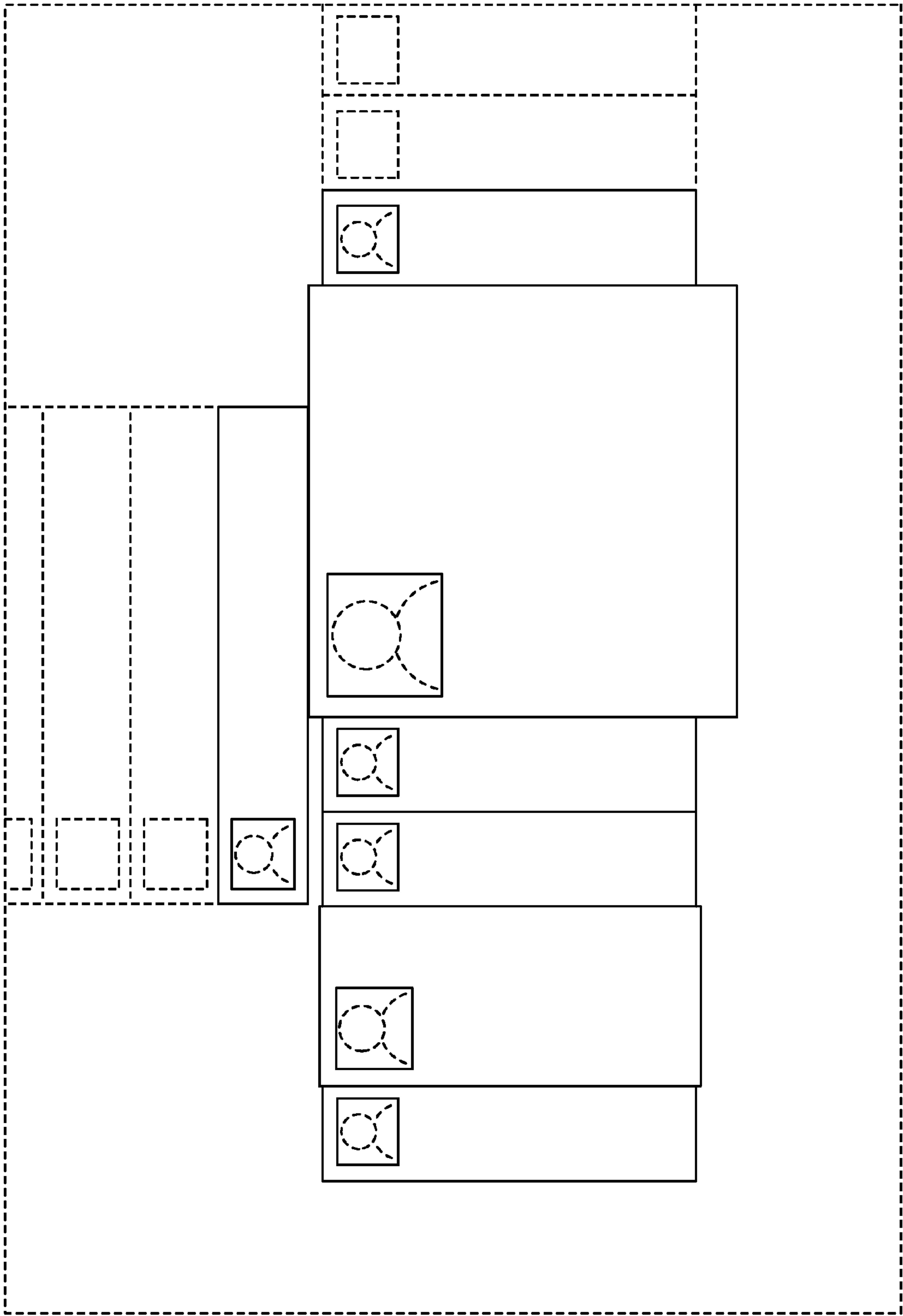

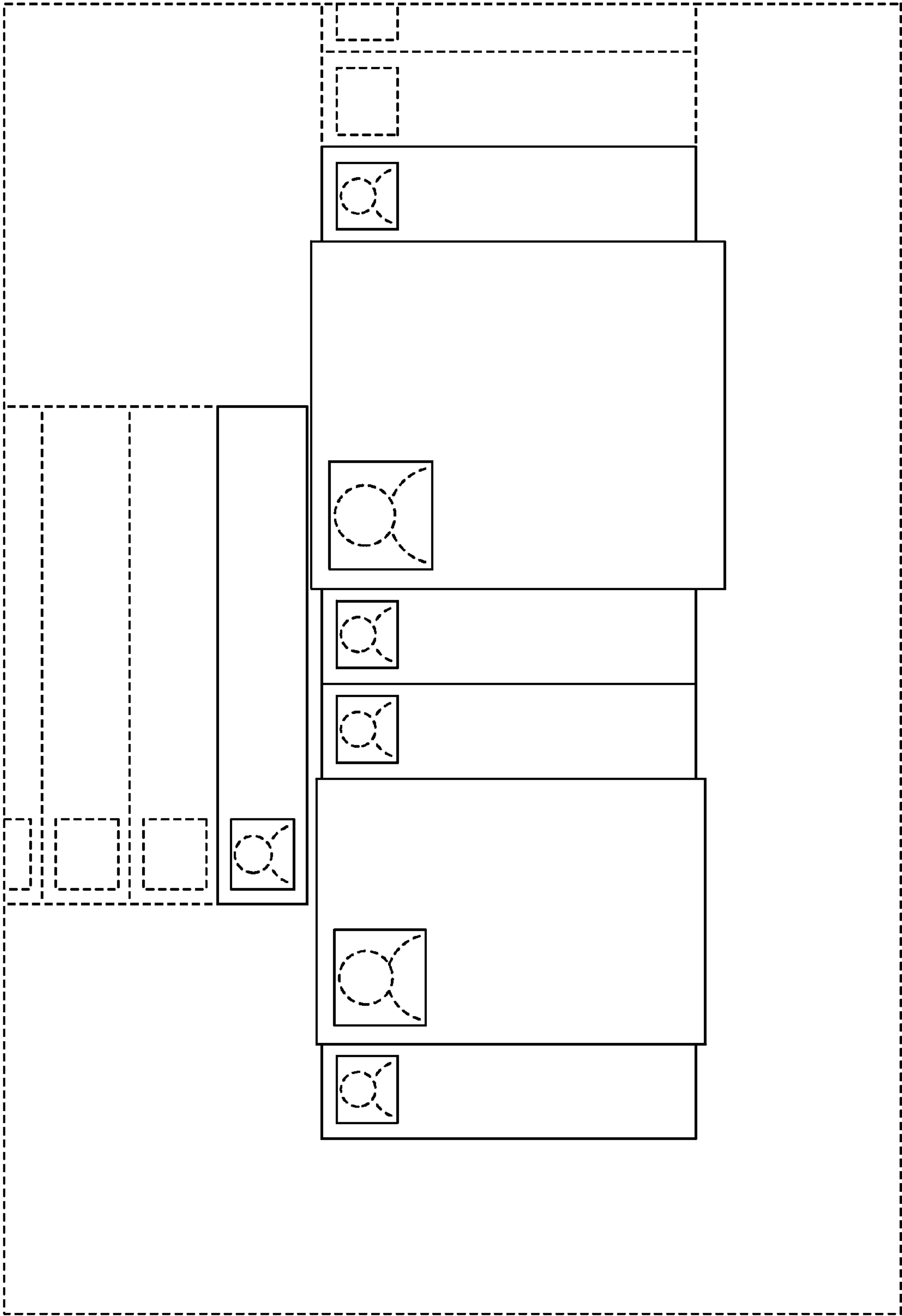

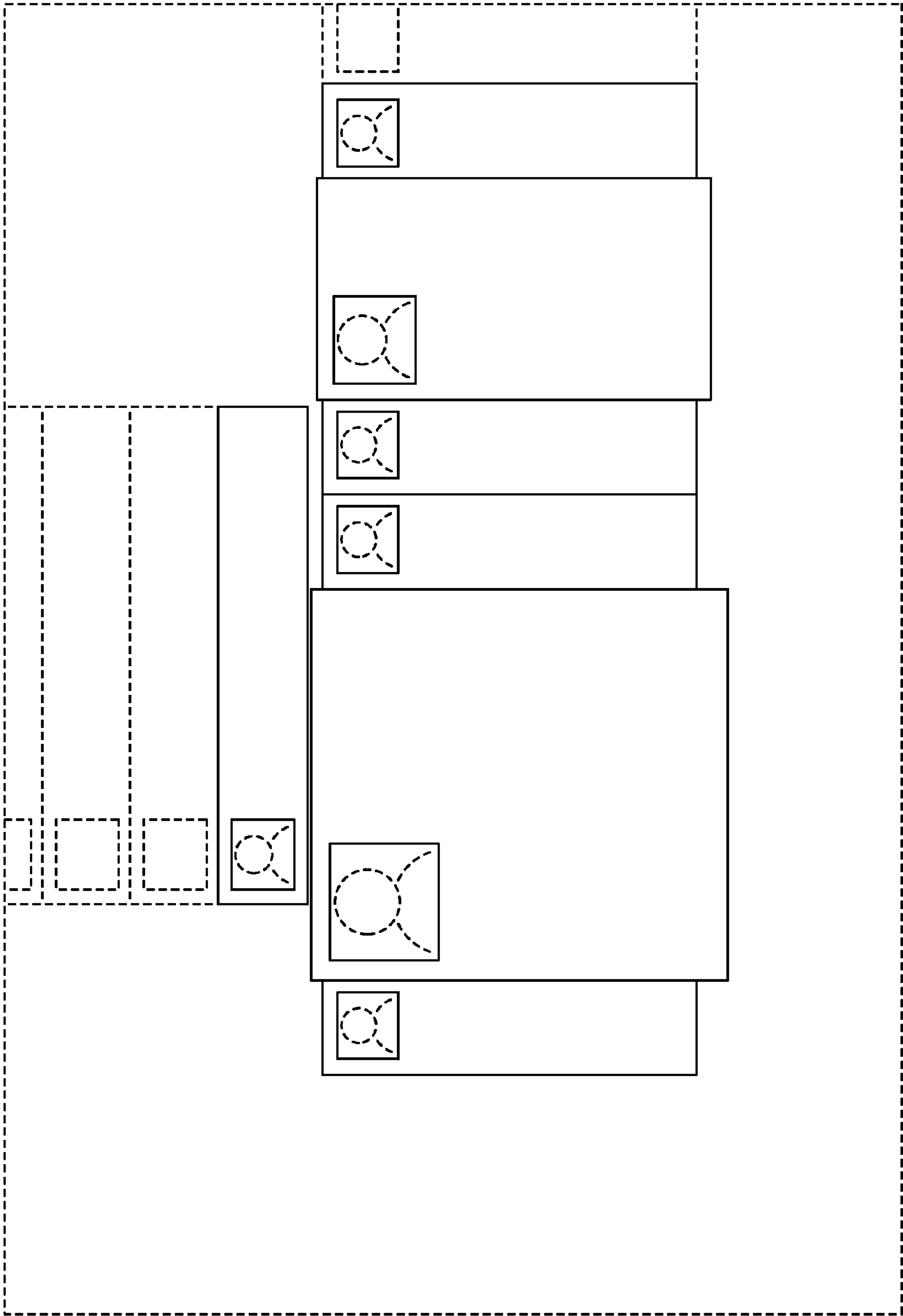

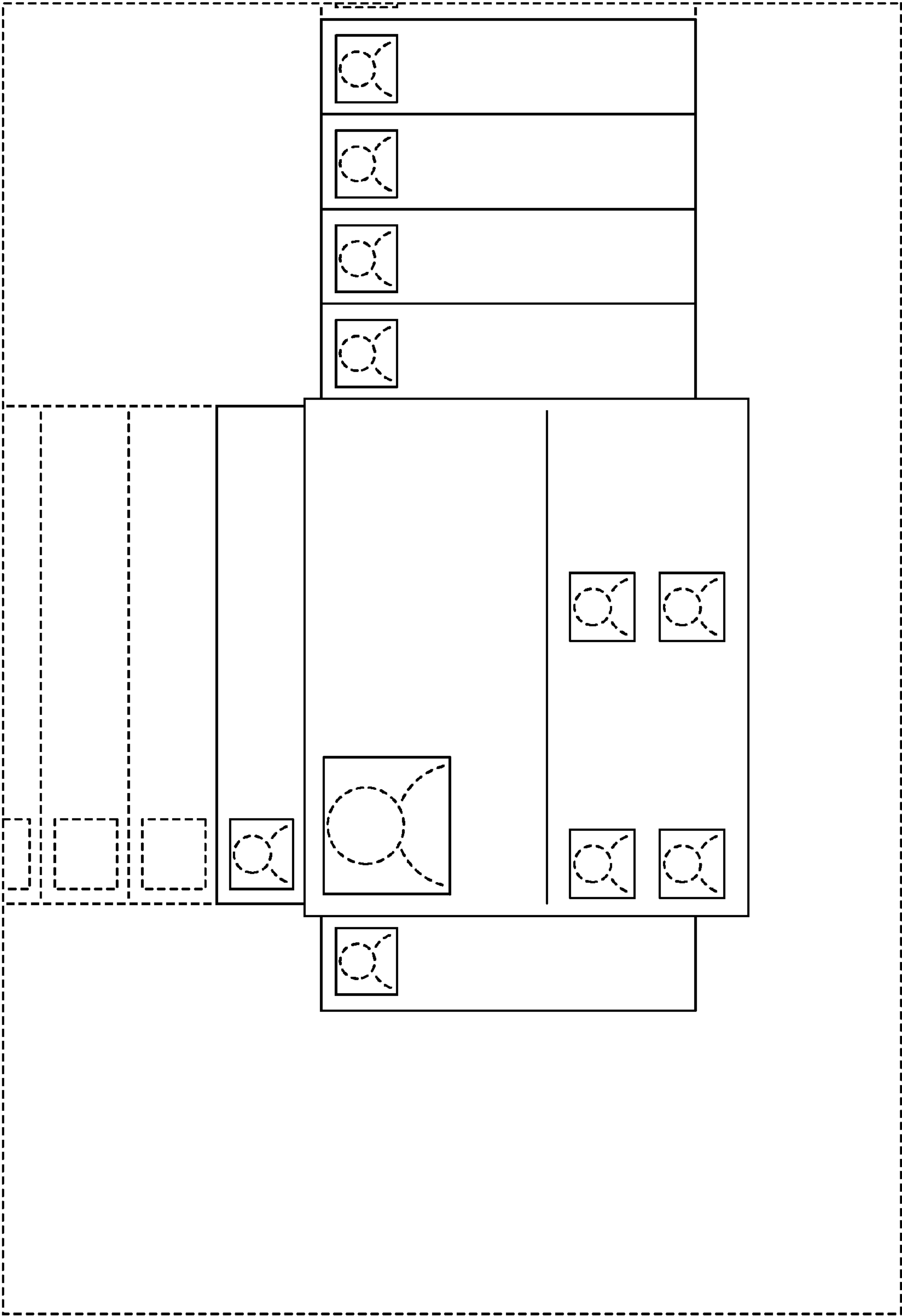
