(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the adjustable skateboard sling, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the adjustable skateboard sling of my design shown in use carrying a skateboard;

FIG. 2 is a second perspective view of the adjustable skateboard sling of my design shown in use carrying a skateboard;

FIG. 3 is a third perspective view of the adjustable skateboard sling of my design shown in use carrying a skateboard;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view of the adjustable skateboard sling of my design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right elevation view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a left elevation view thereof;

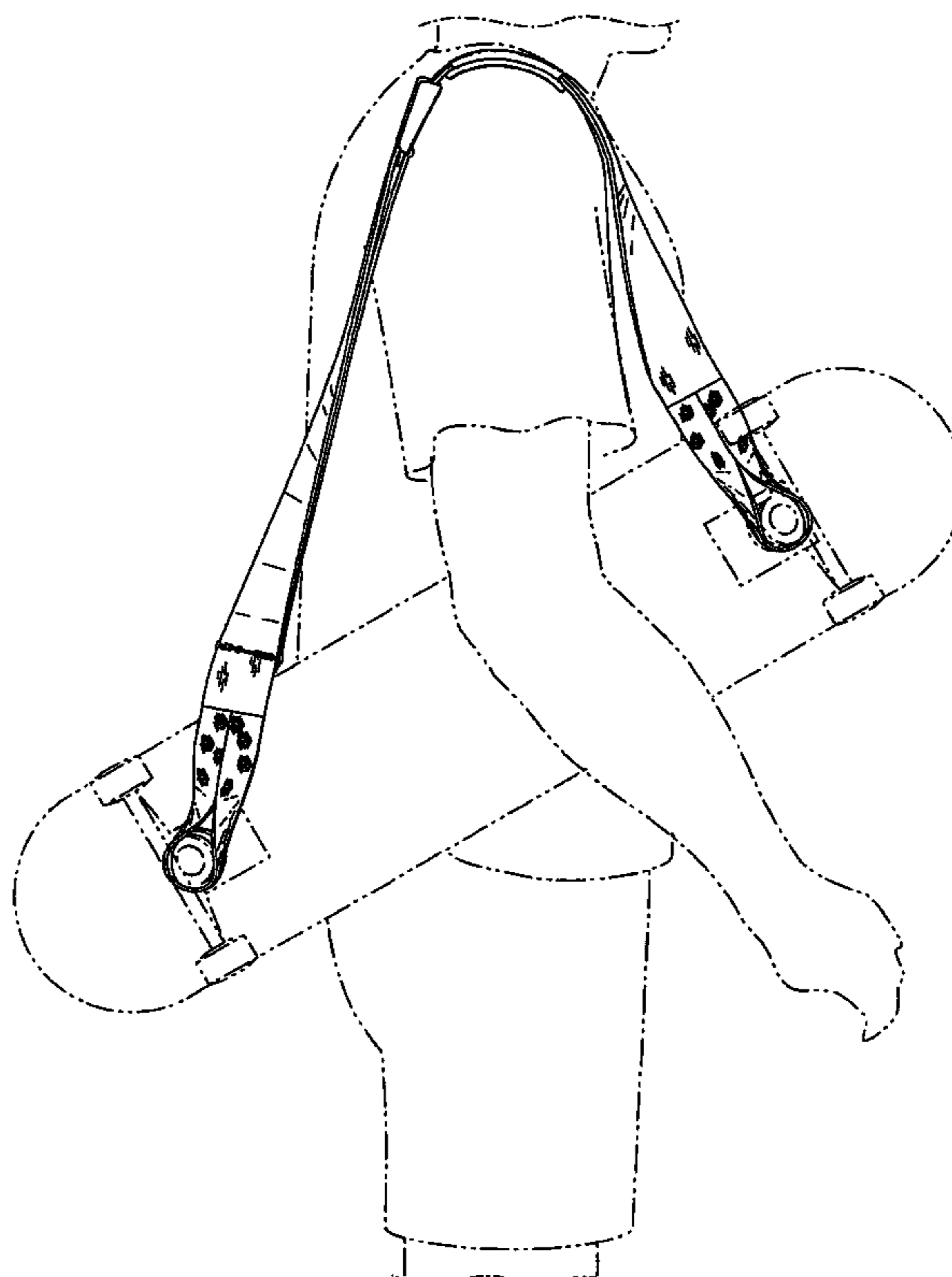
FIG. 9 is a front elevation view thereof; and,

FIG. 10 is a rear elevation view thereof.

The strap is shown broken away in FIGS. 4–8 to indicate indeterminate length.

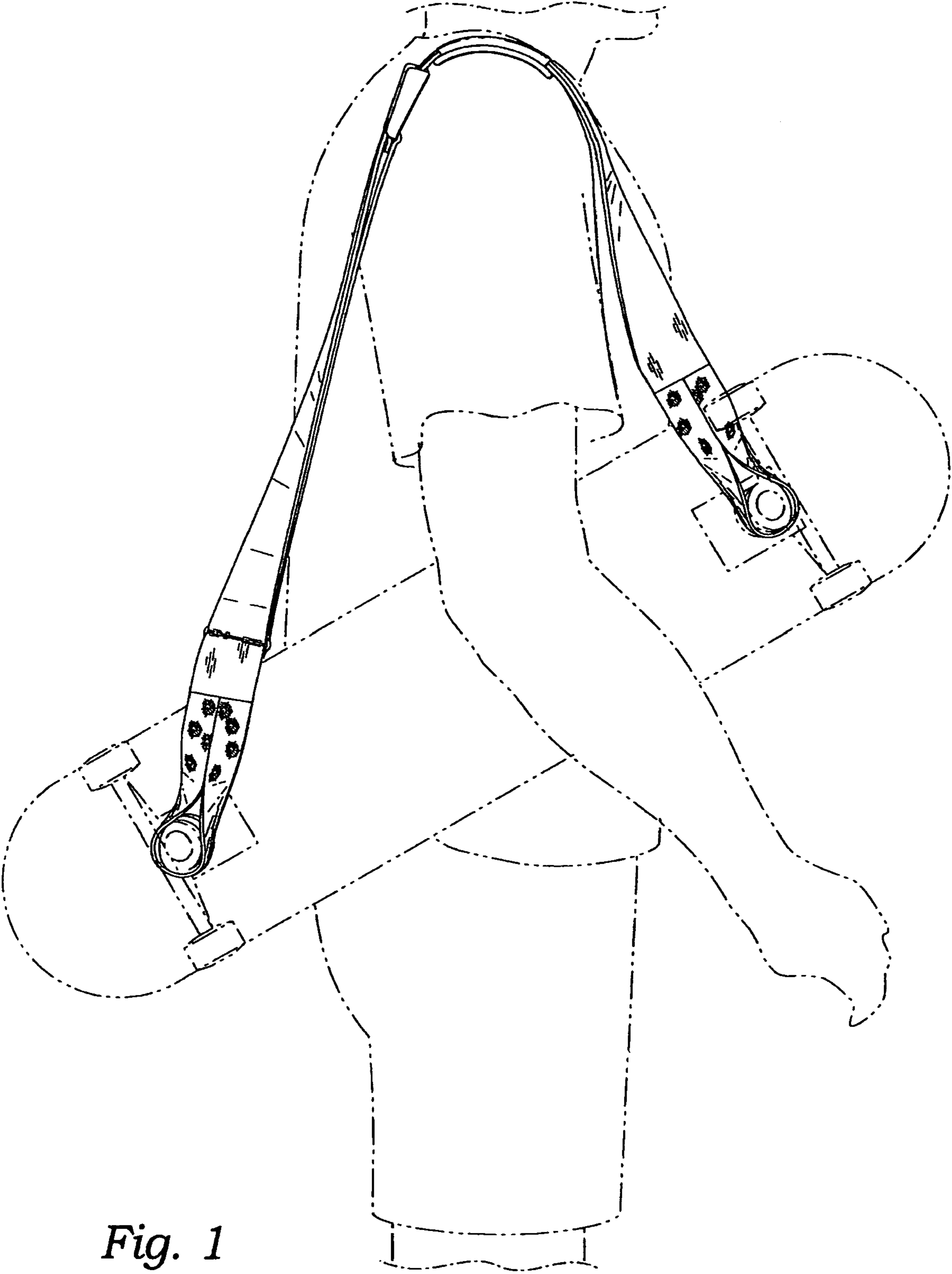

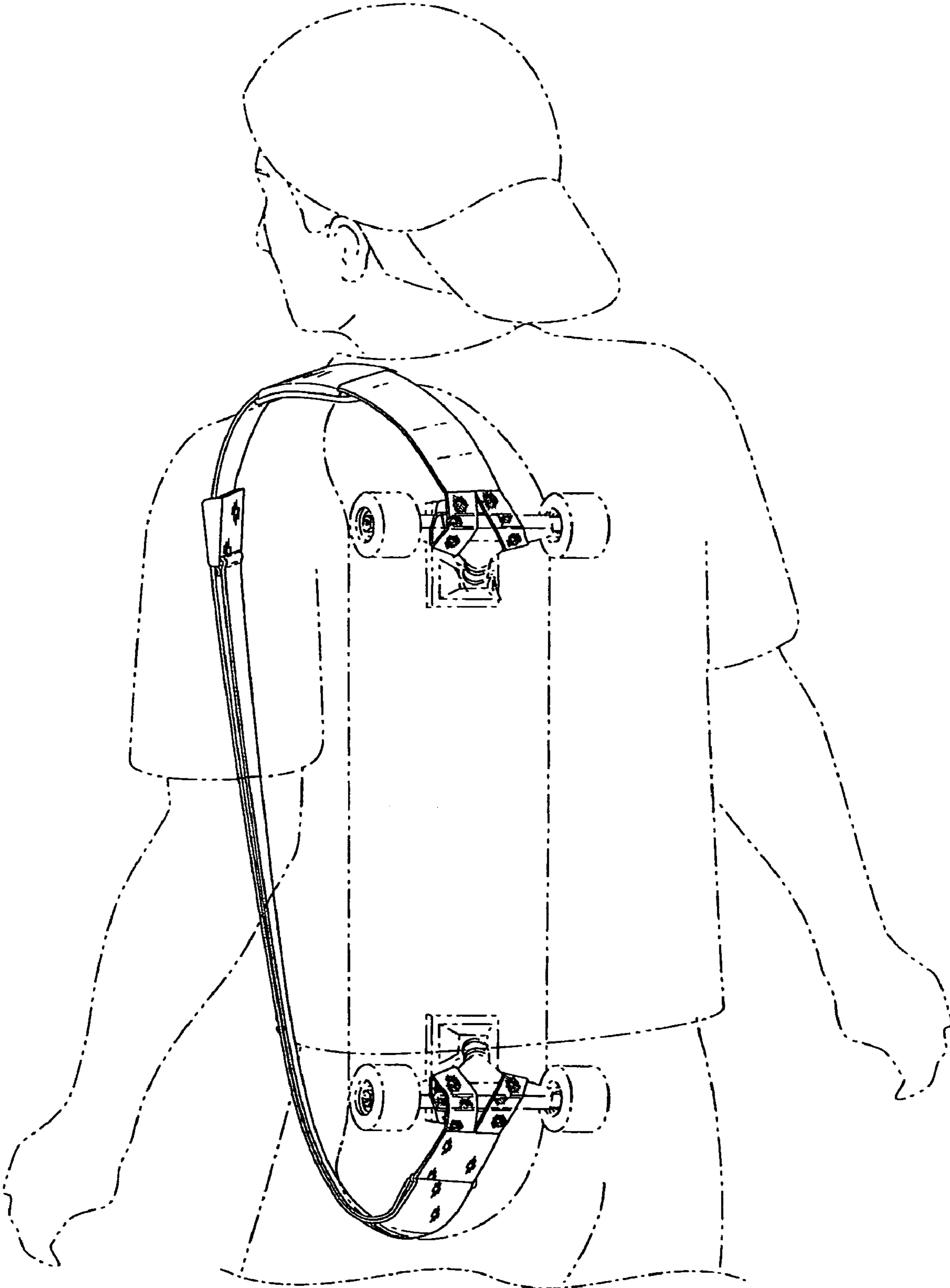

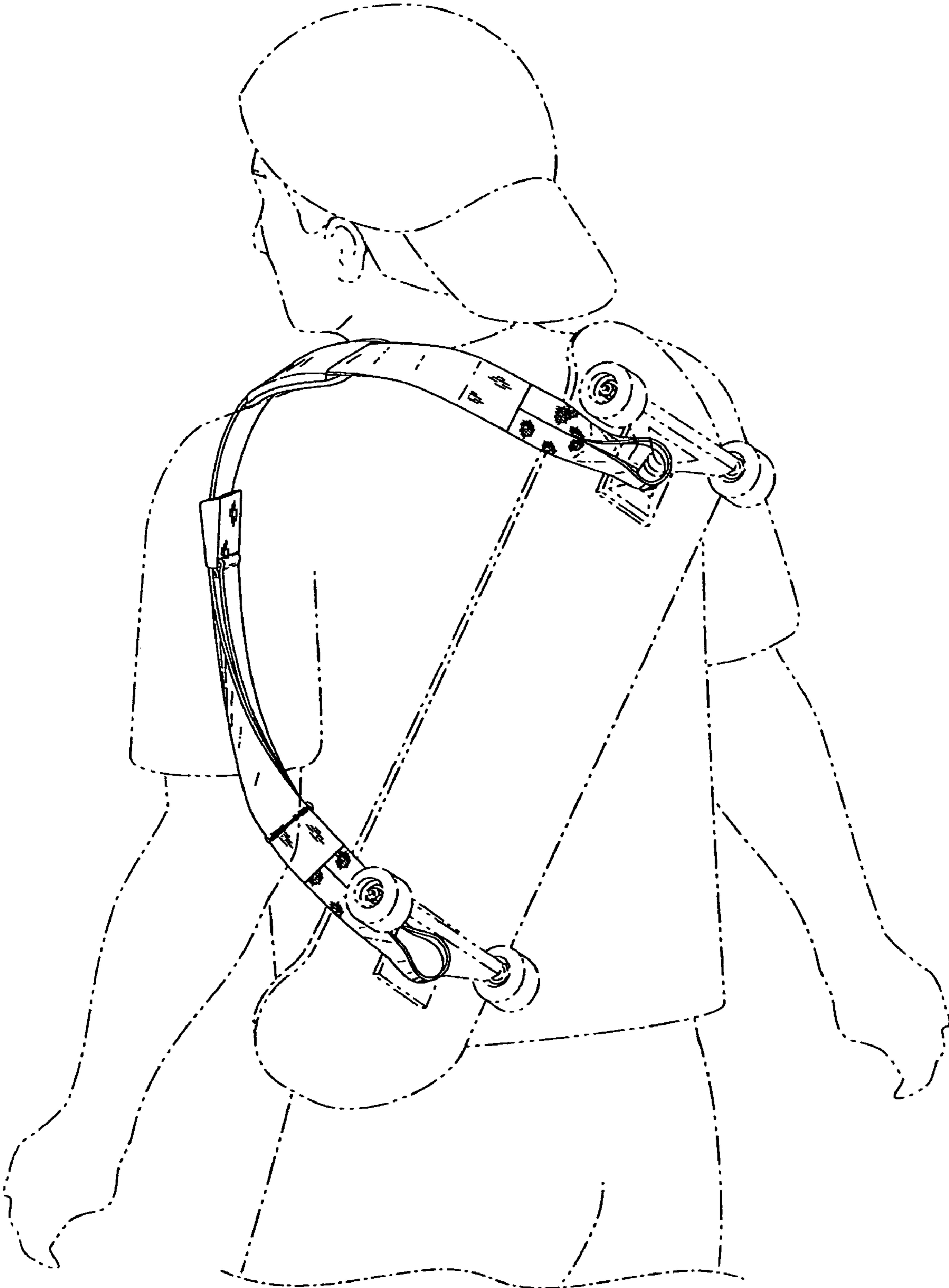

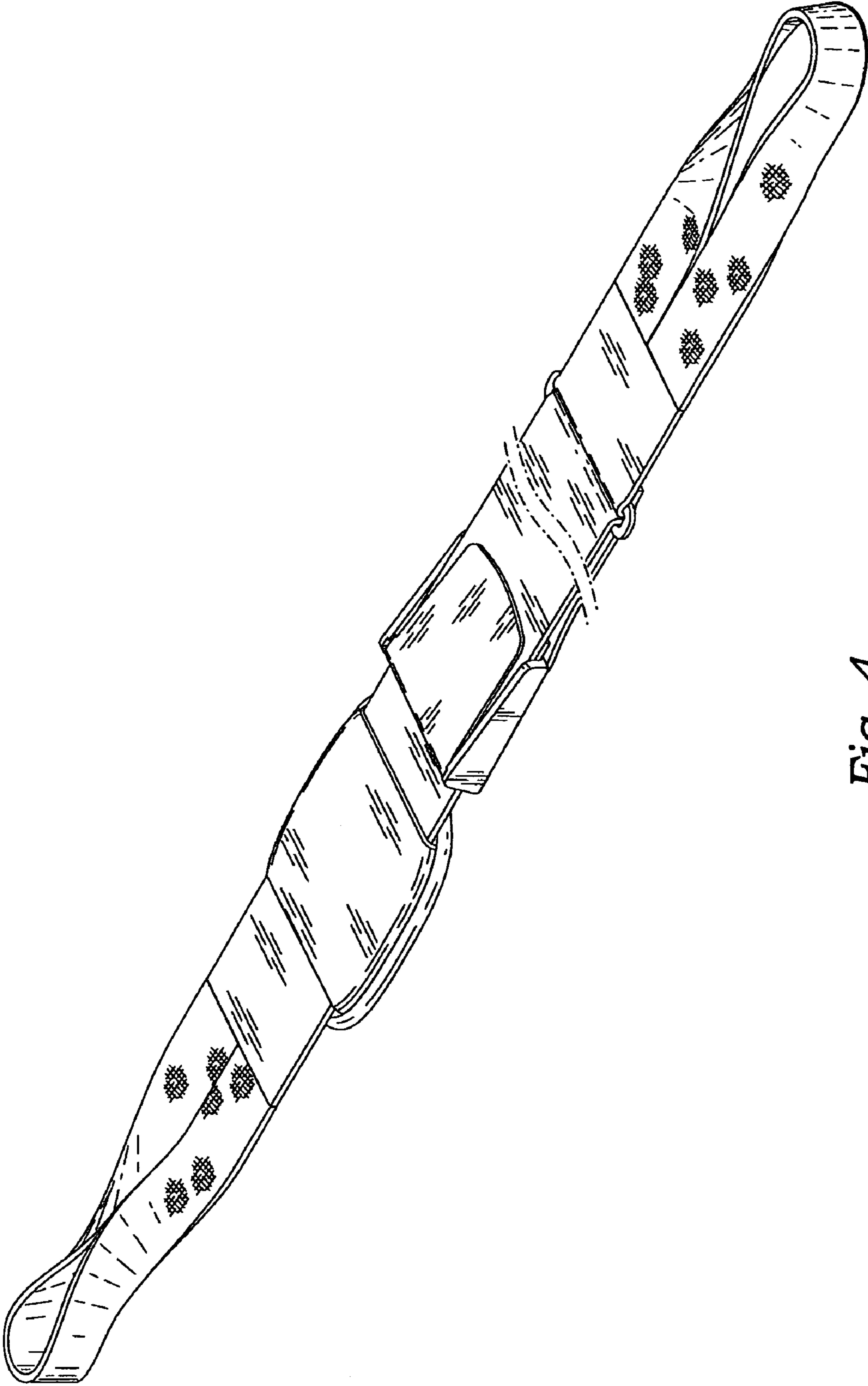

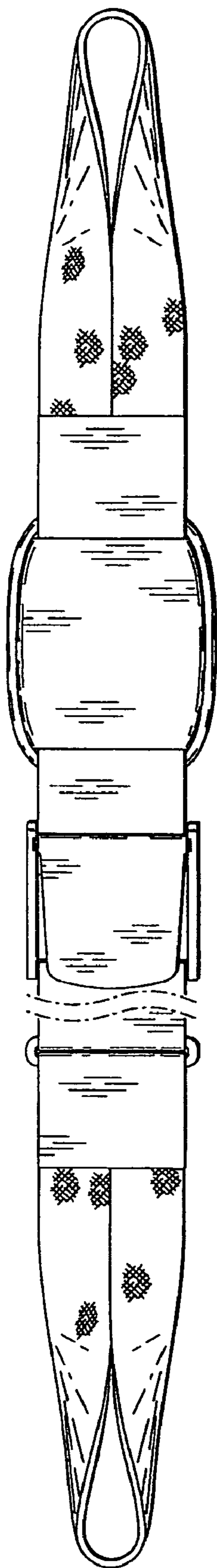

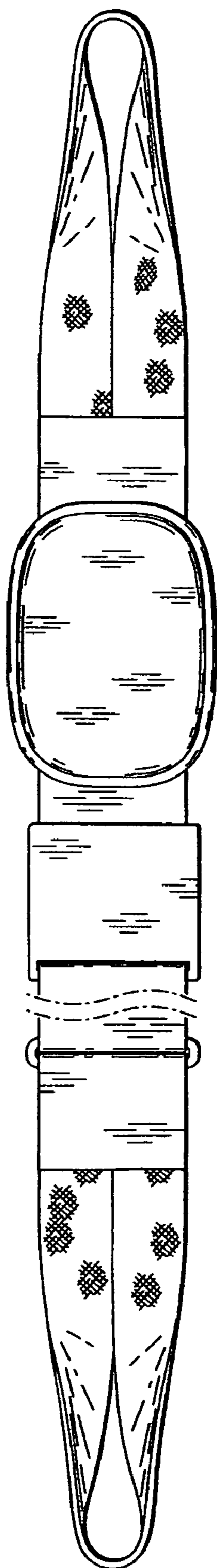

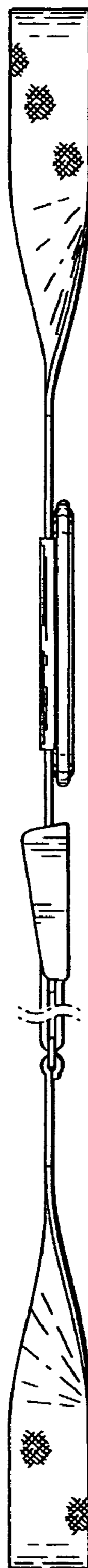

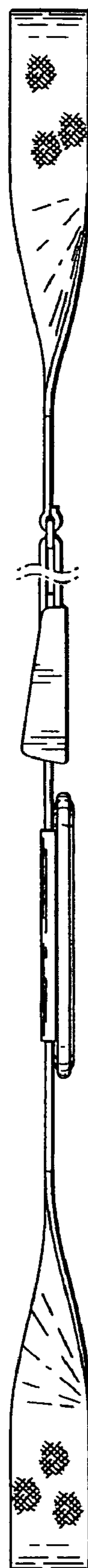

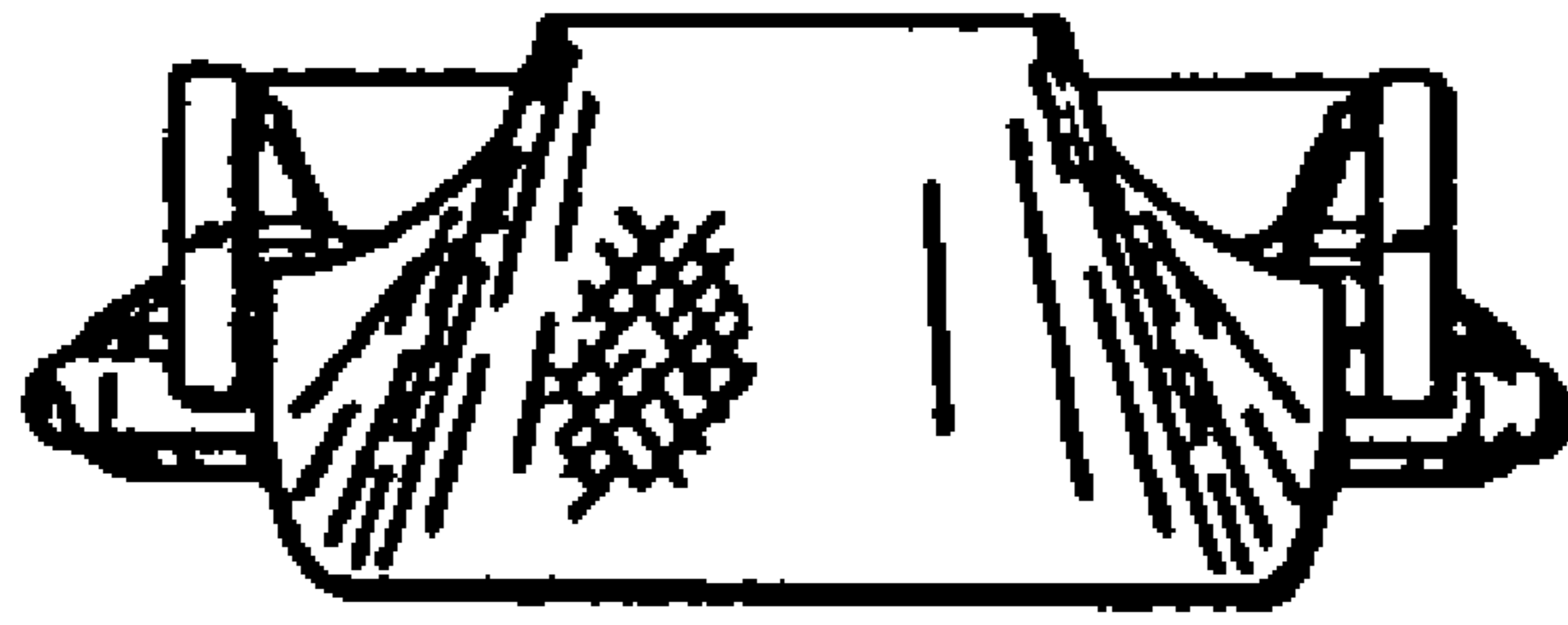
