The ornamental design of a bedpan, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is perspective view of a bedpan according to a first embodiment of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the bedpan of FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof. FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the bedpan of FIG. 1. FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the bedpan of FIG. 1. FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the bedpan of FIG. 1. FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the bedpan of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the bedpan according to a second embodiment of the present invention.
