FIG. 4 is top view of the earphone shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the earphone shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 6 is a rear view of the earphone shown in FIG. 1; and,


FIG. 7 is a front view of the earphone shown in FIG. 1.


The broken lines in FIGS. 5–7 are included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the earphone that form no part of the claimed design.








