FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof,

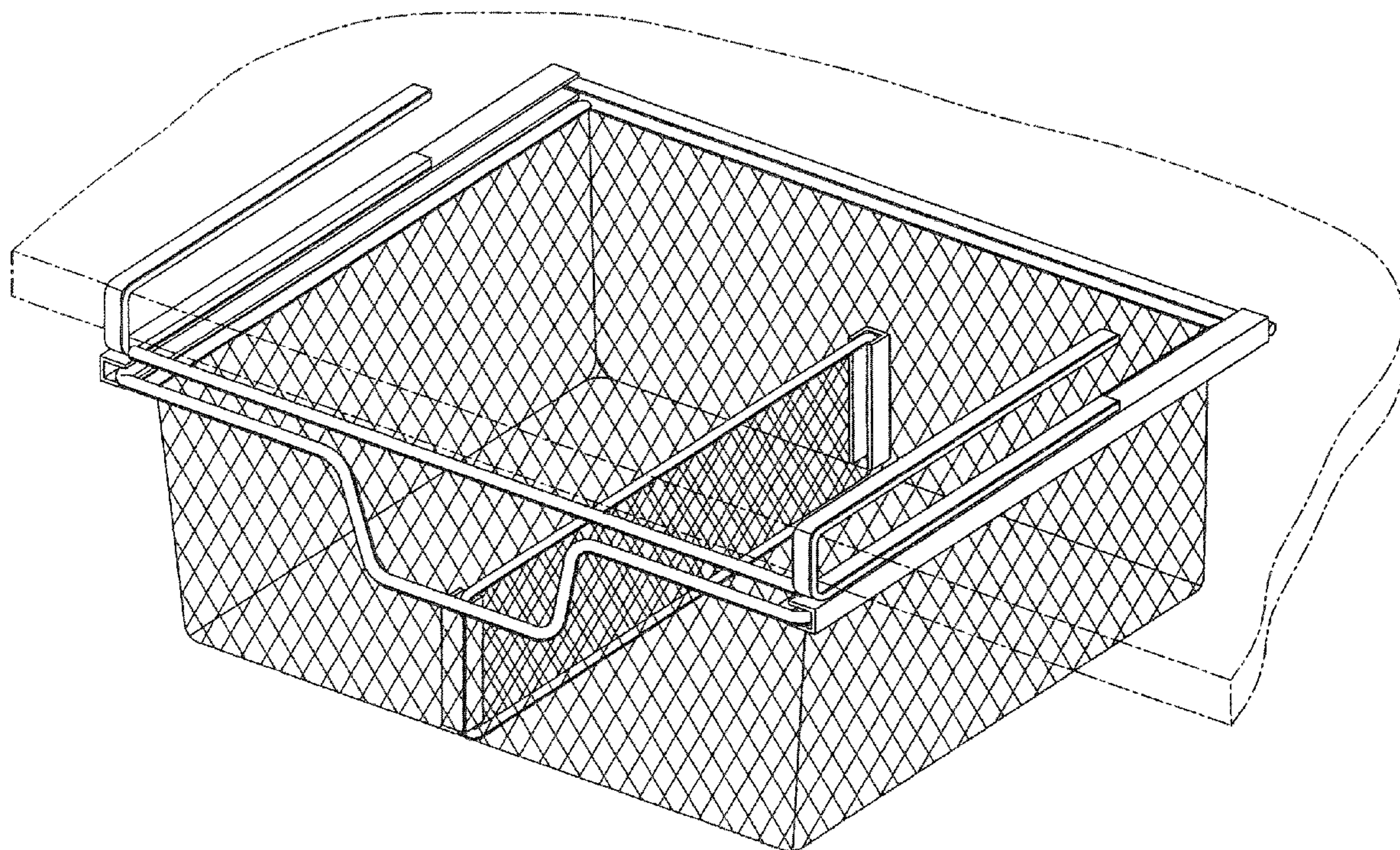
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

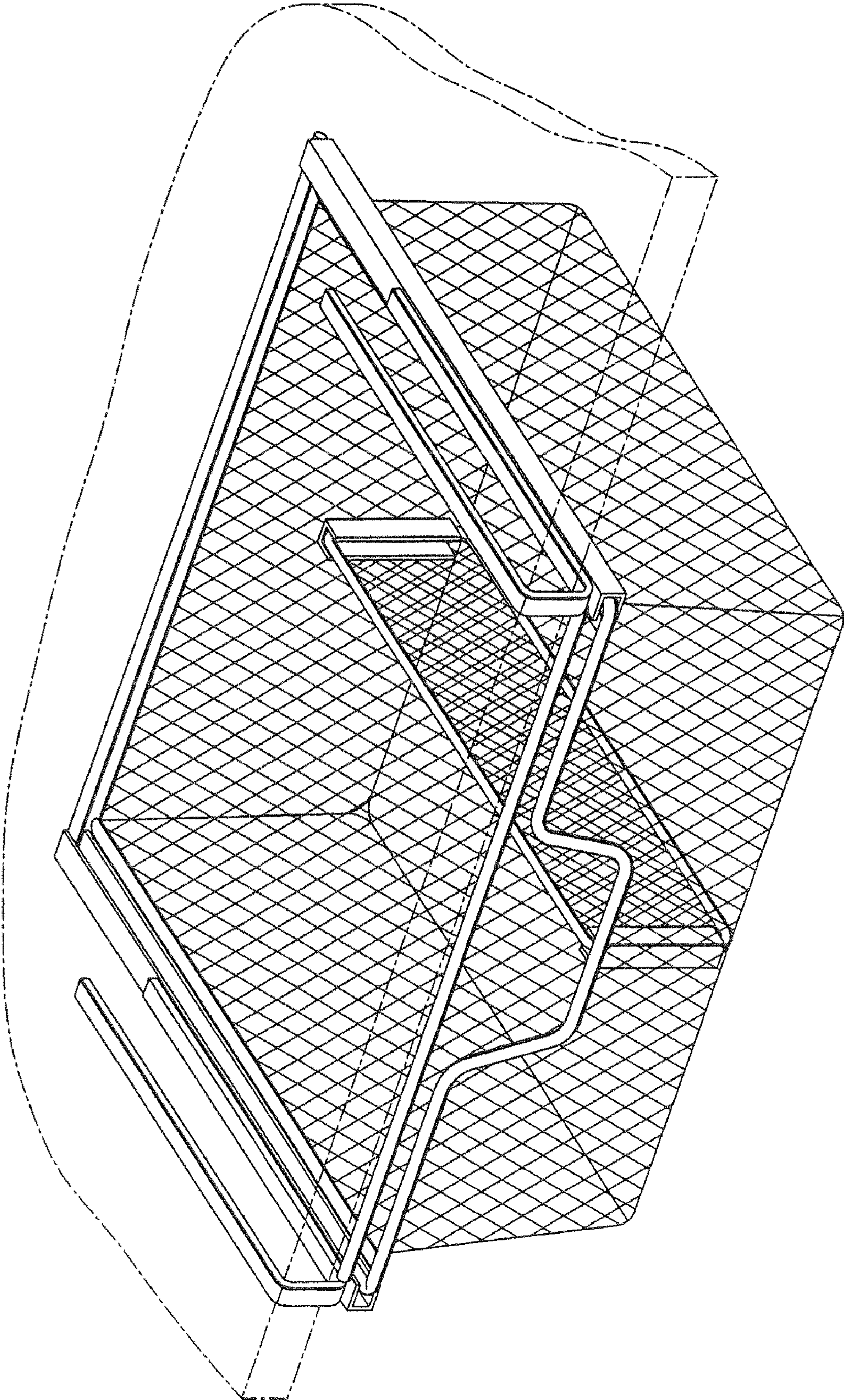

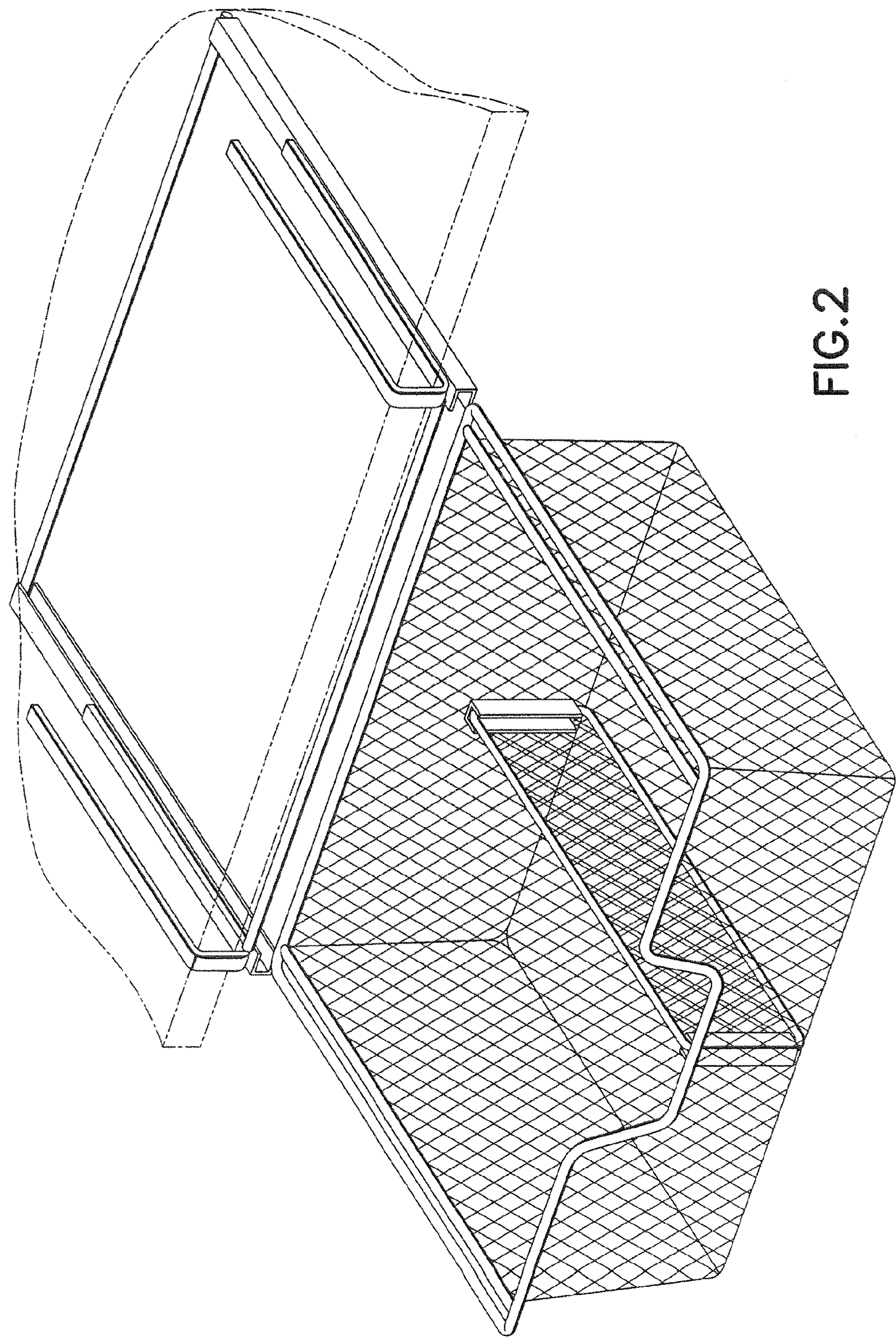

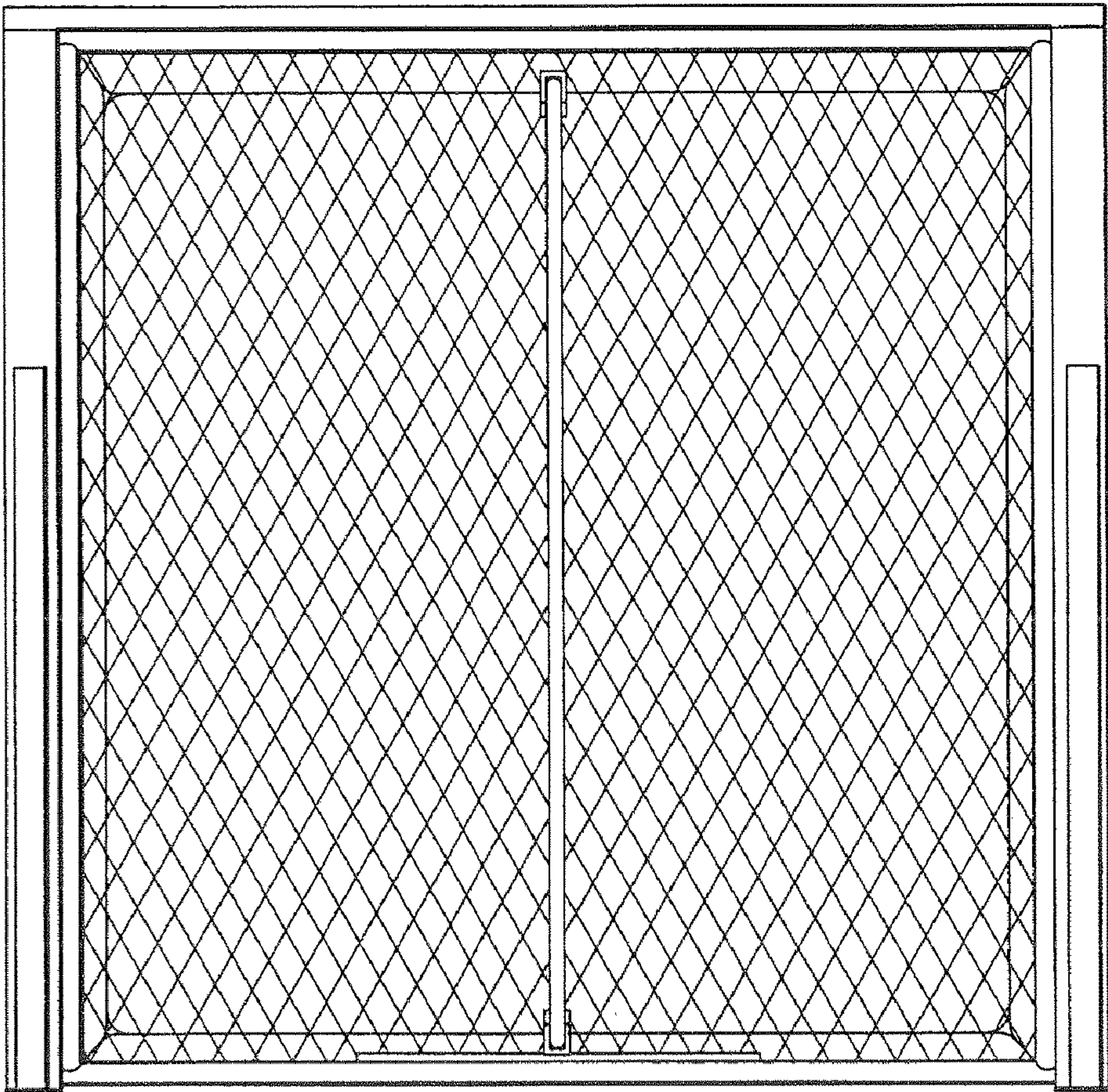

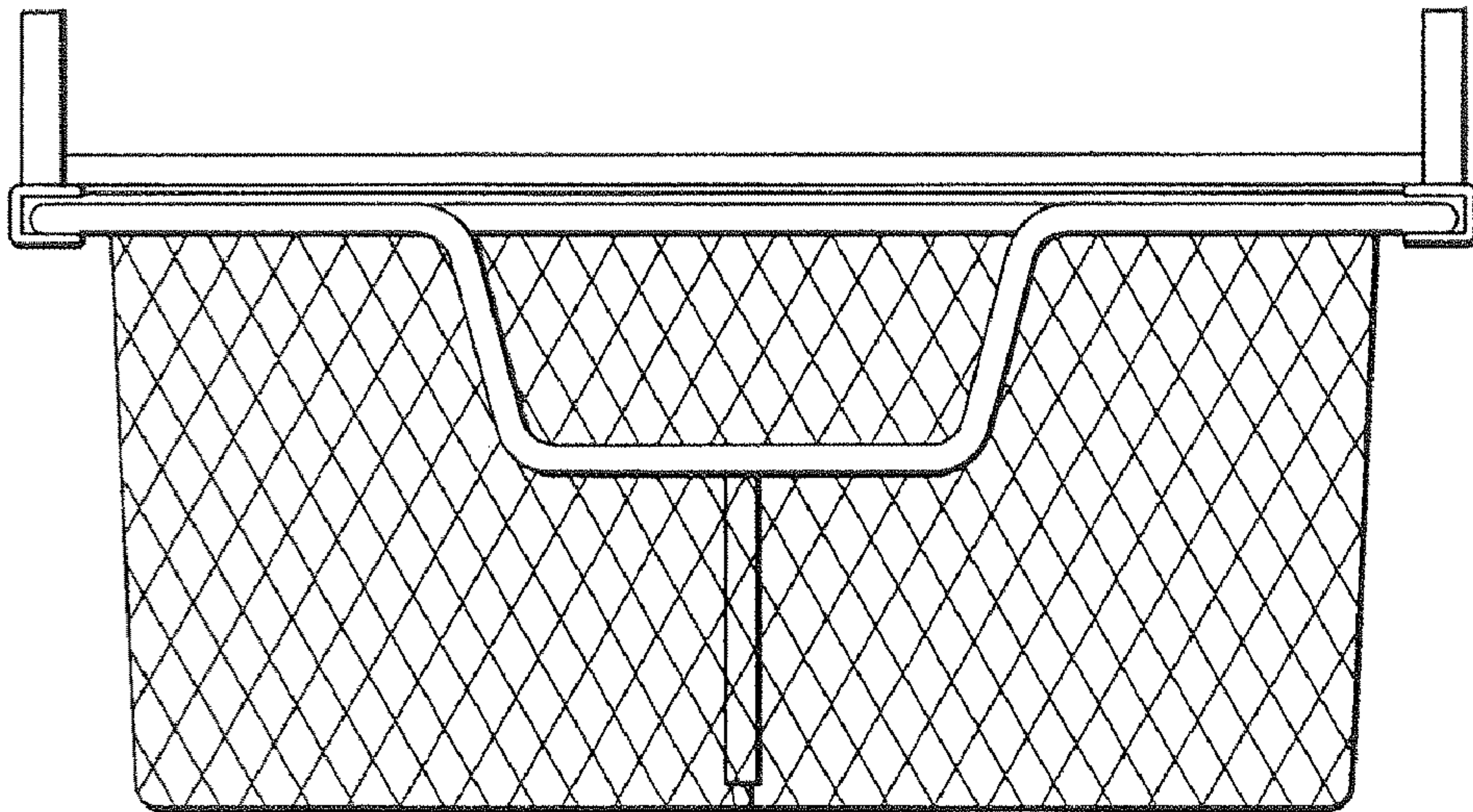

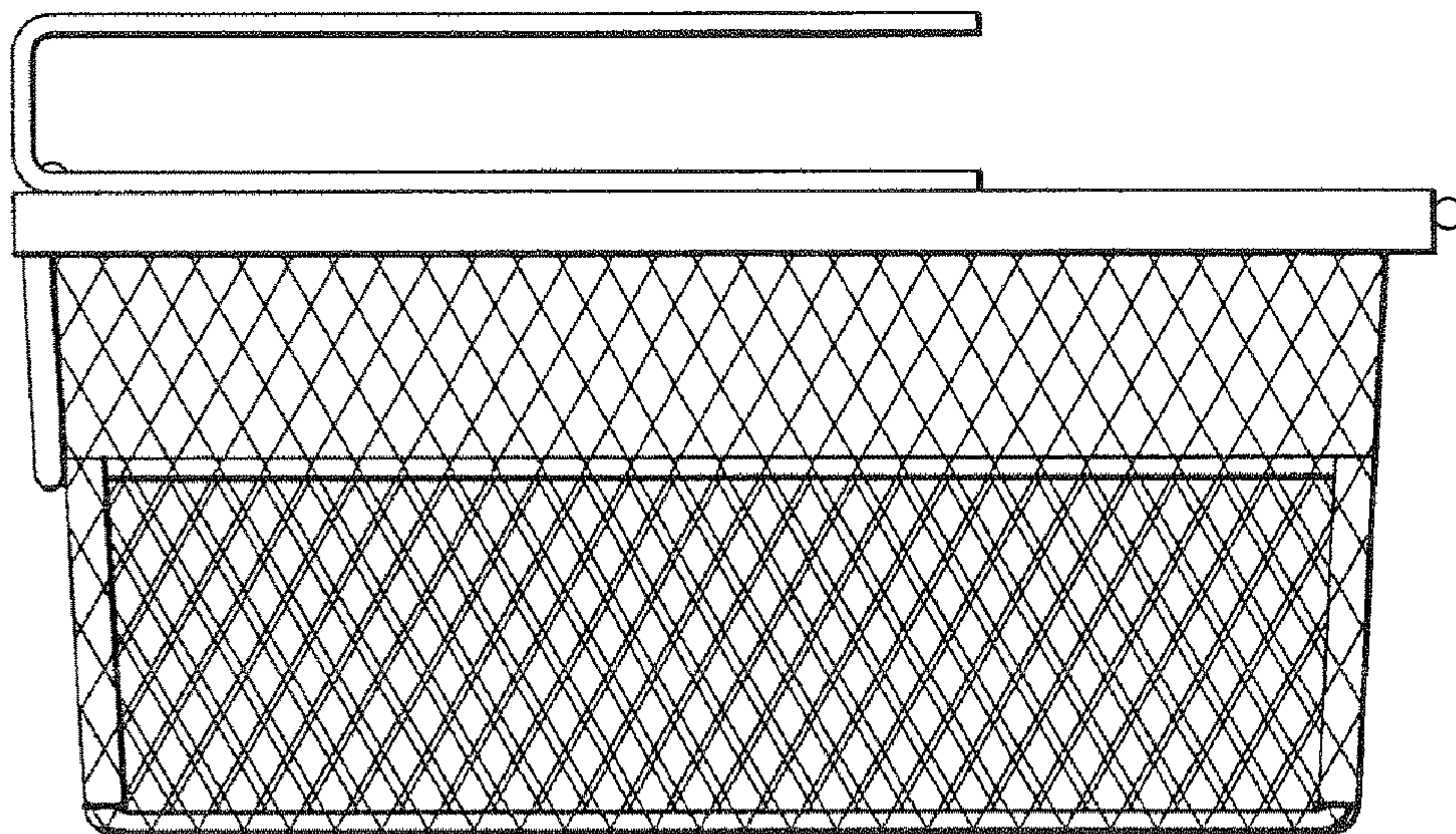

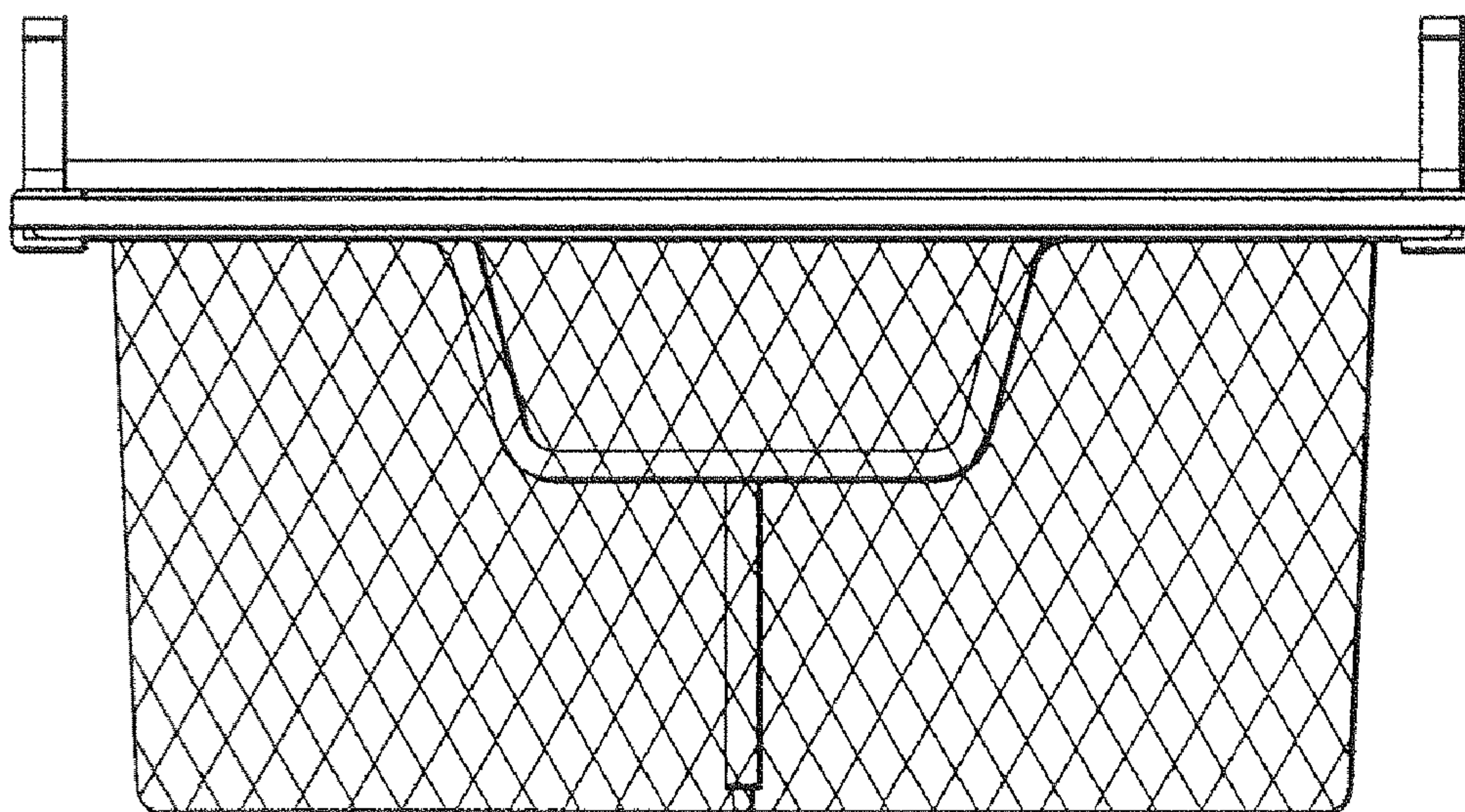

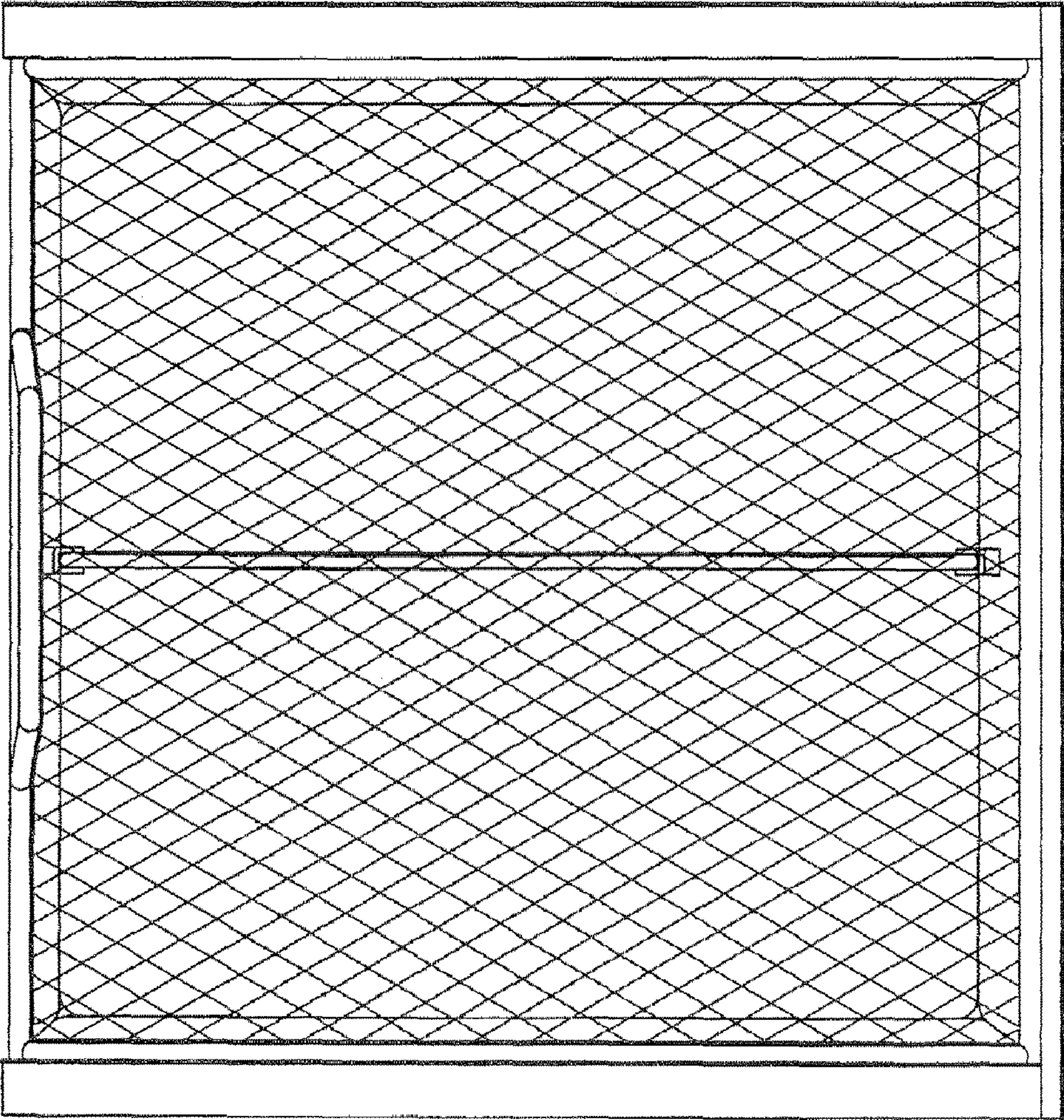
