shaped speaker;

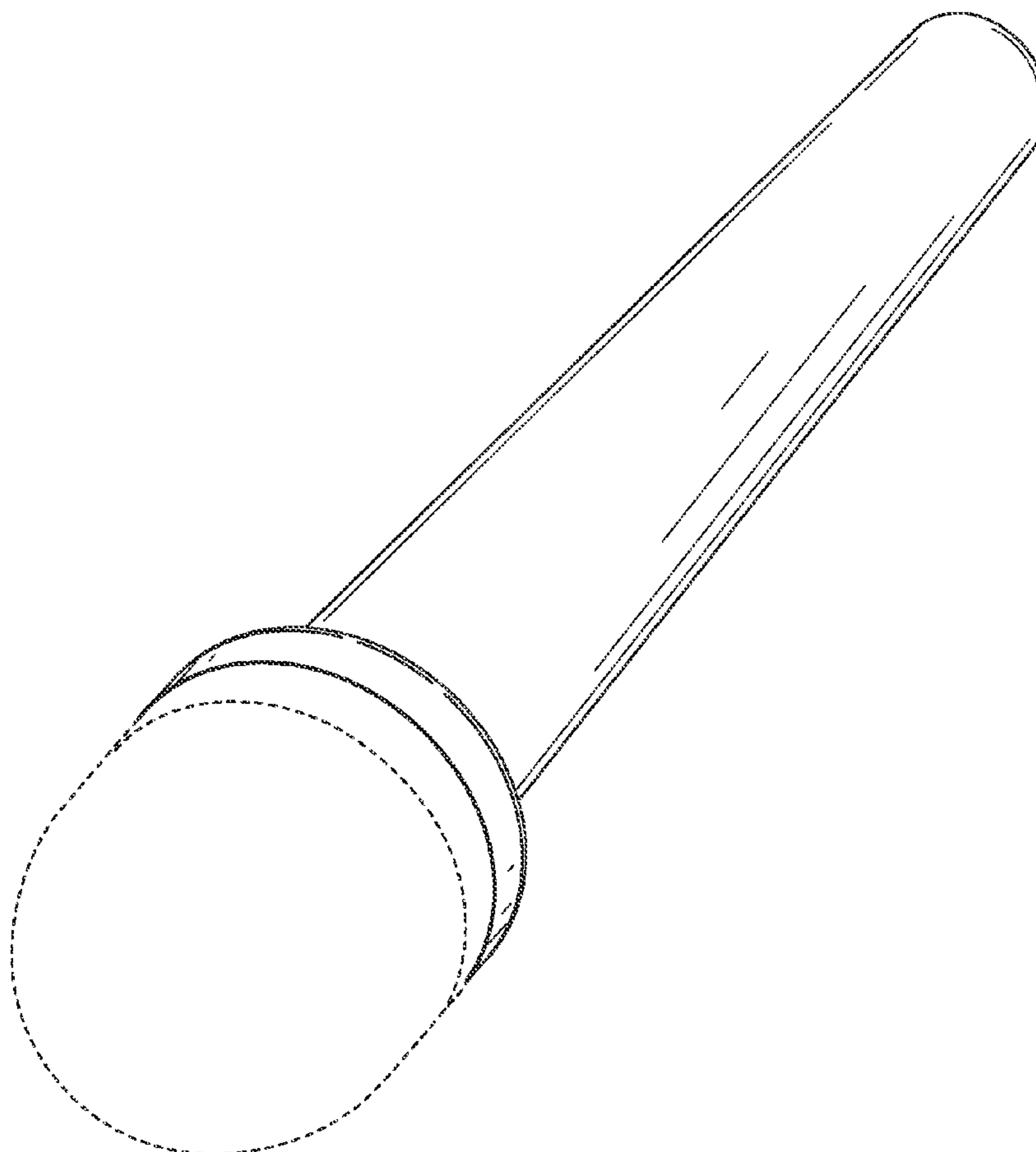
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the invention, with the bottom,

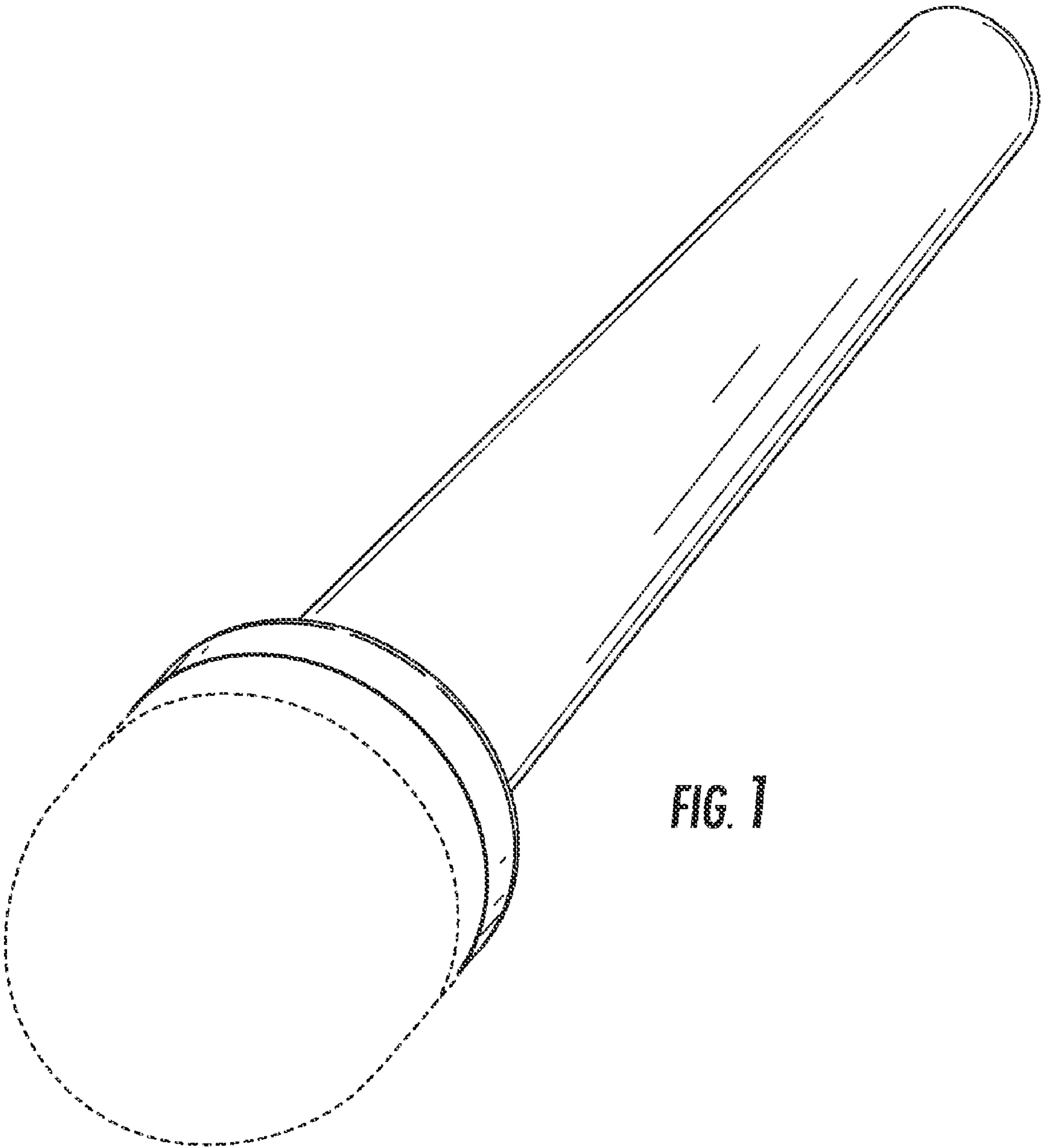

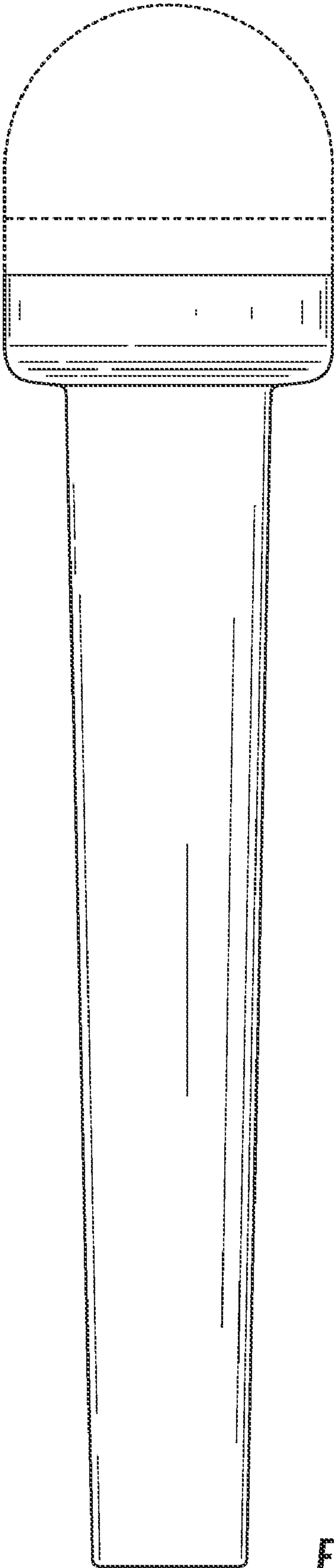

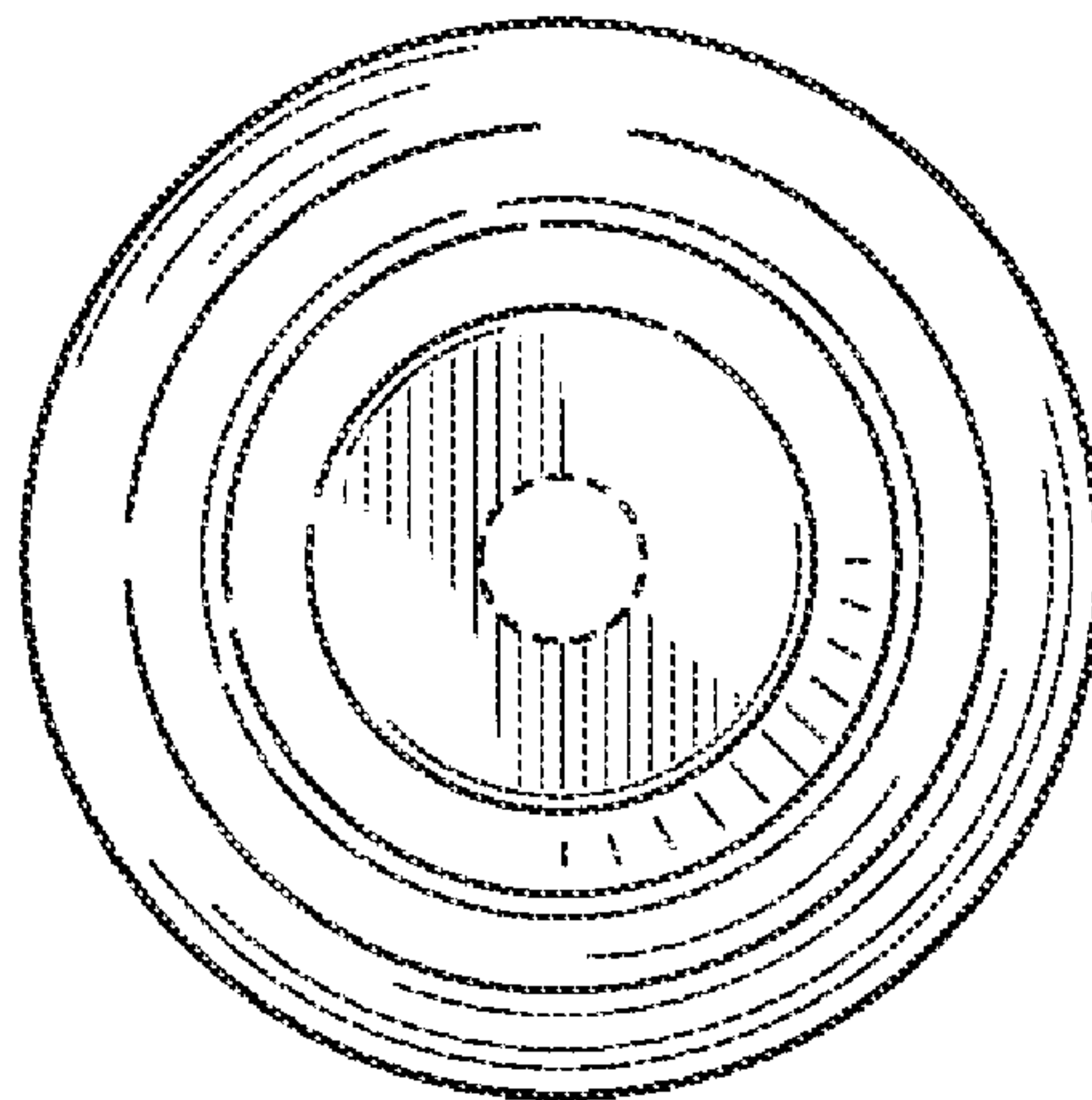

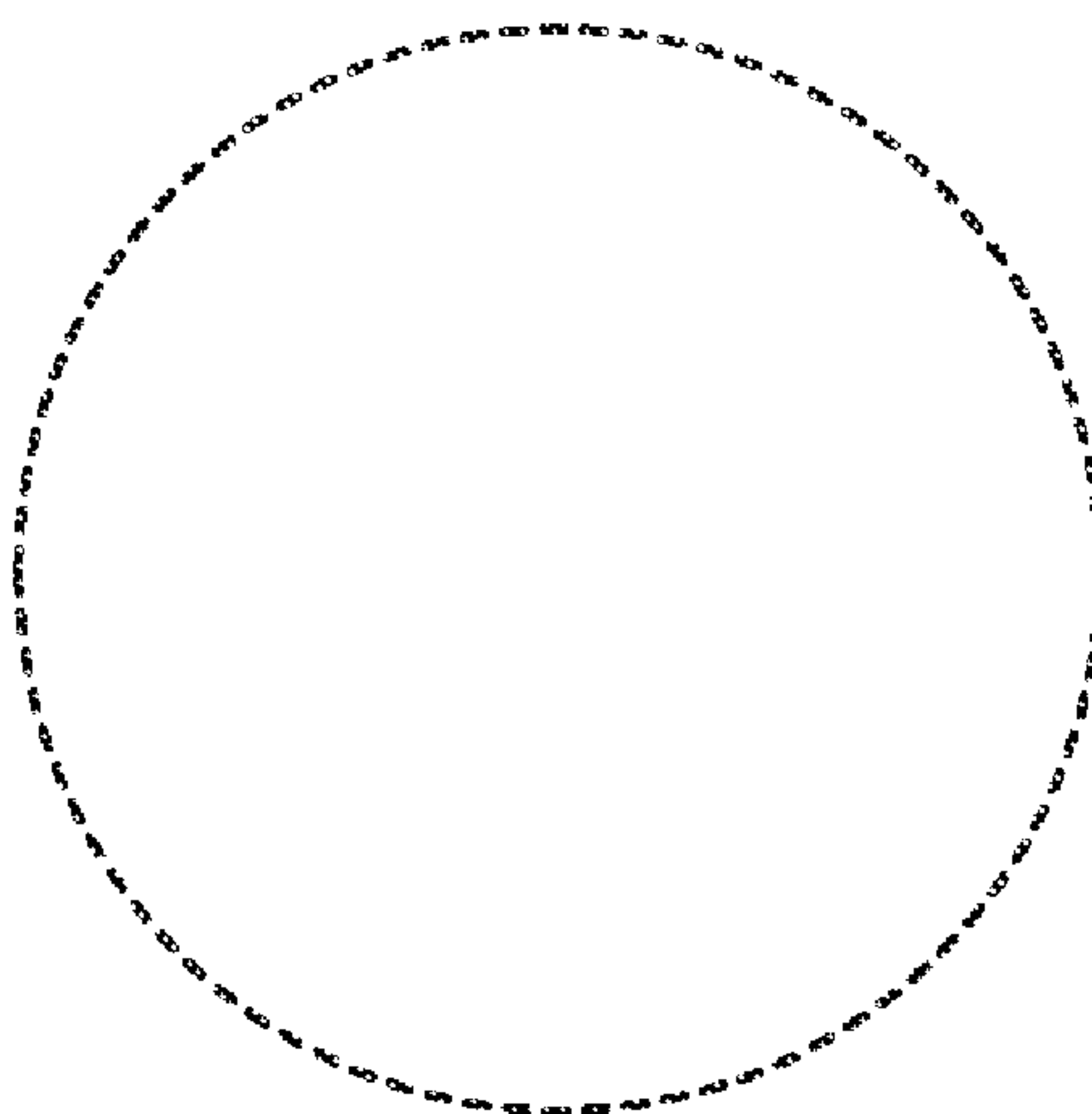
