CLAIM

The ornamental design for the flotation therapy device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the flotation therapy device incorporating my new design;

FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken on line 2-2 of FIG. 1. The broken line depiction of a person positioned on the flotation therapy device is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

FIG. **3** is an end view of the right end of the flotation therapy device as shown in FIG. **2**; and,

FIG. **4** is an end view of the left end of the flotation therapy device as shown in FIG. **2**.
