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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a male toy building block, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front side, left side, perspective view of a male toy building block showing my new design; the top, back side, right side perspective view being an identical image;

FIG. 2 is a top, front side, left side, perspective view from a different view point of the male toy building block showing my new design; the top, back side, right side perspective view being an identical image;

FIG. 3 is a bottom, back side, left side perspective view; the bottom, front side, right side perspective view being an identical image;

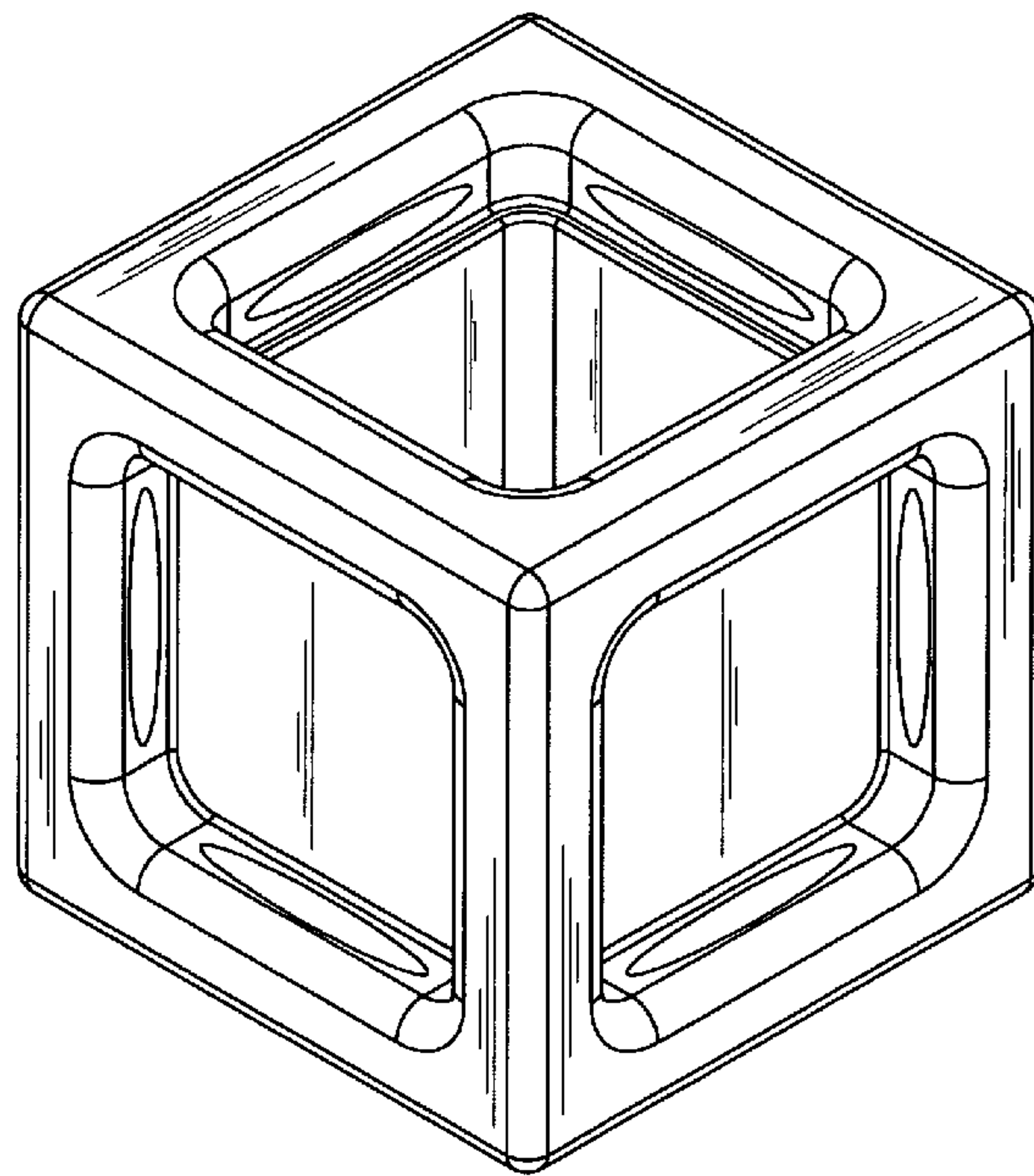
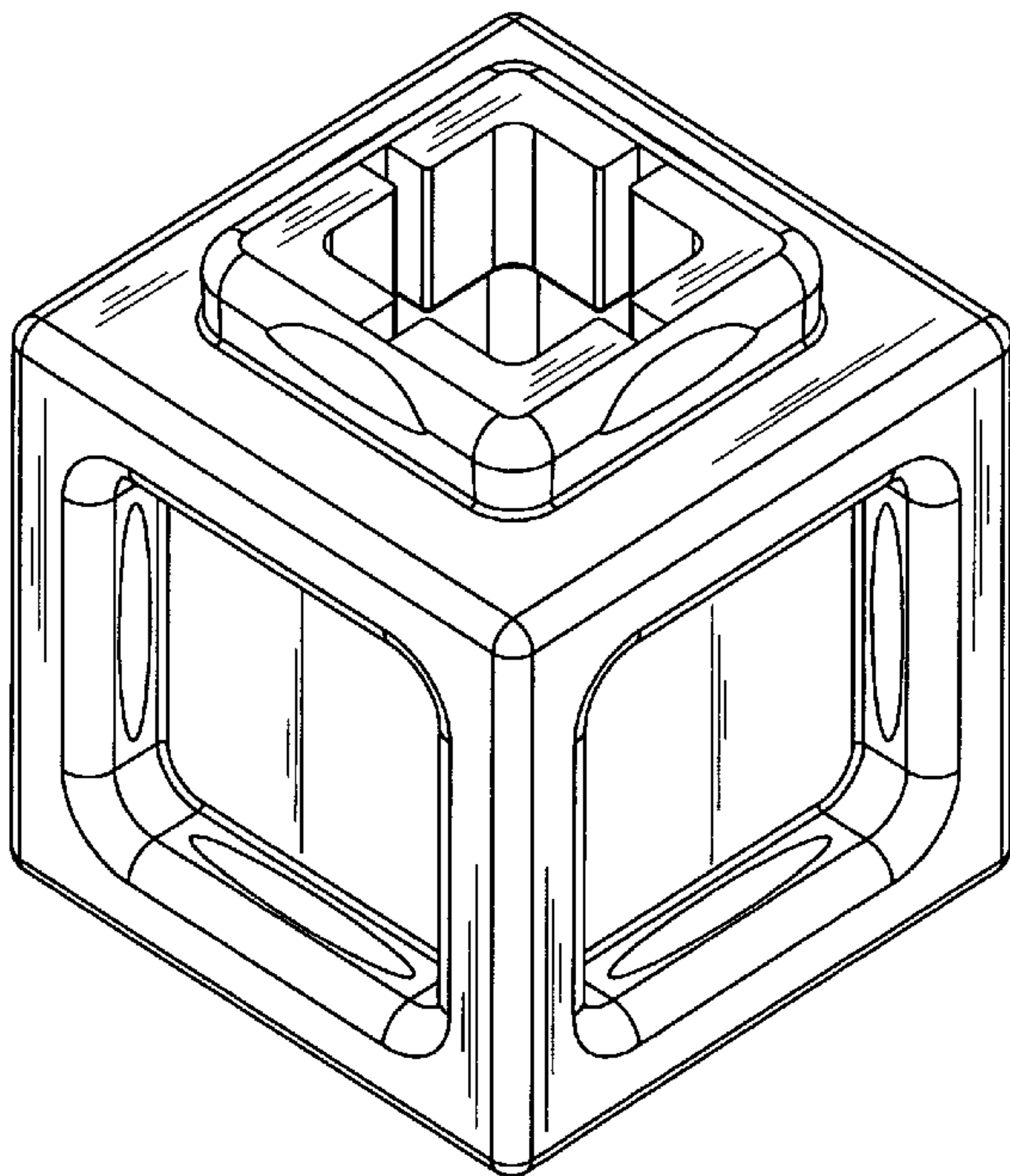
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;

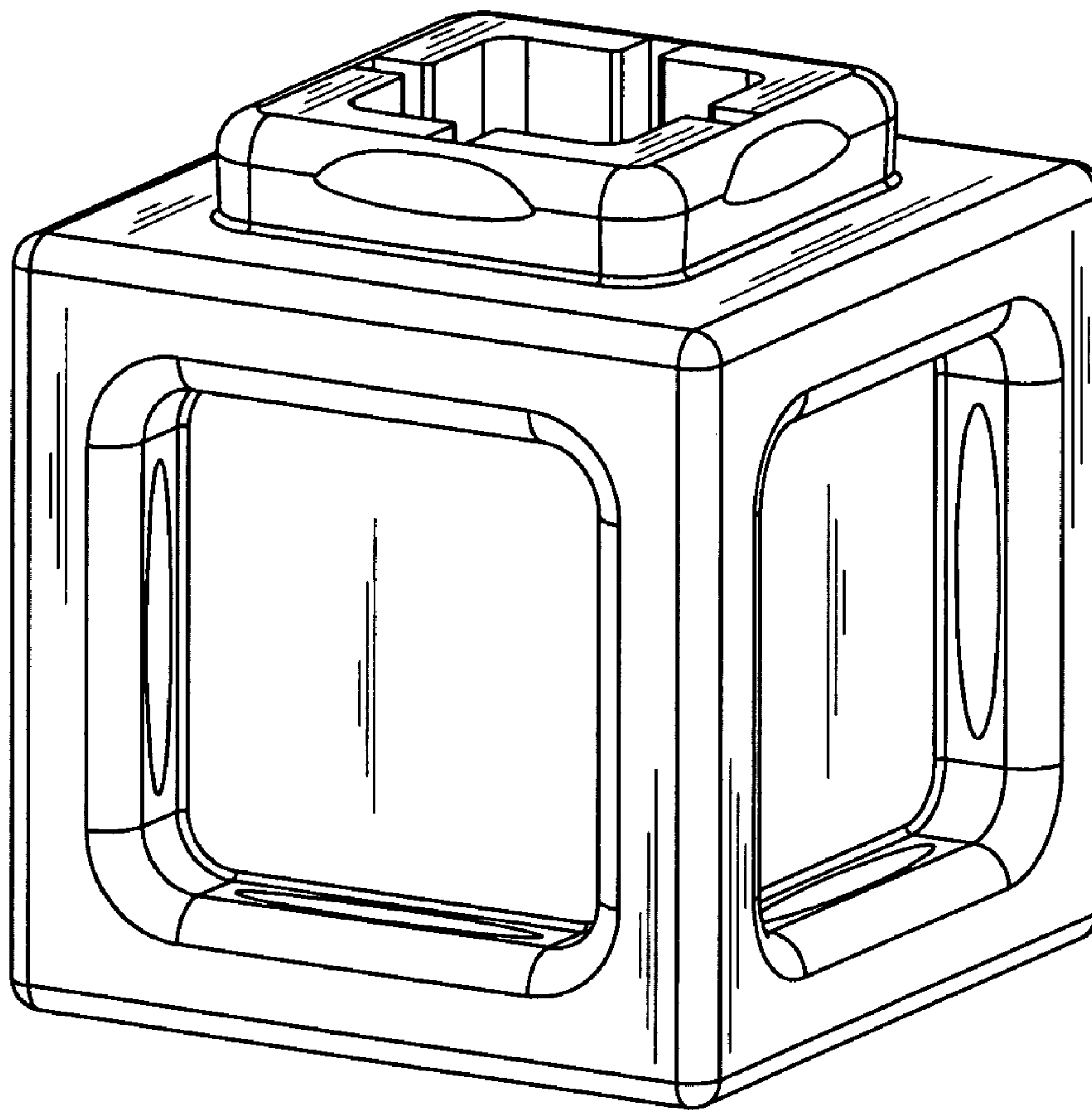

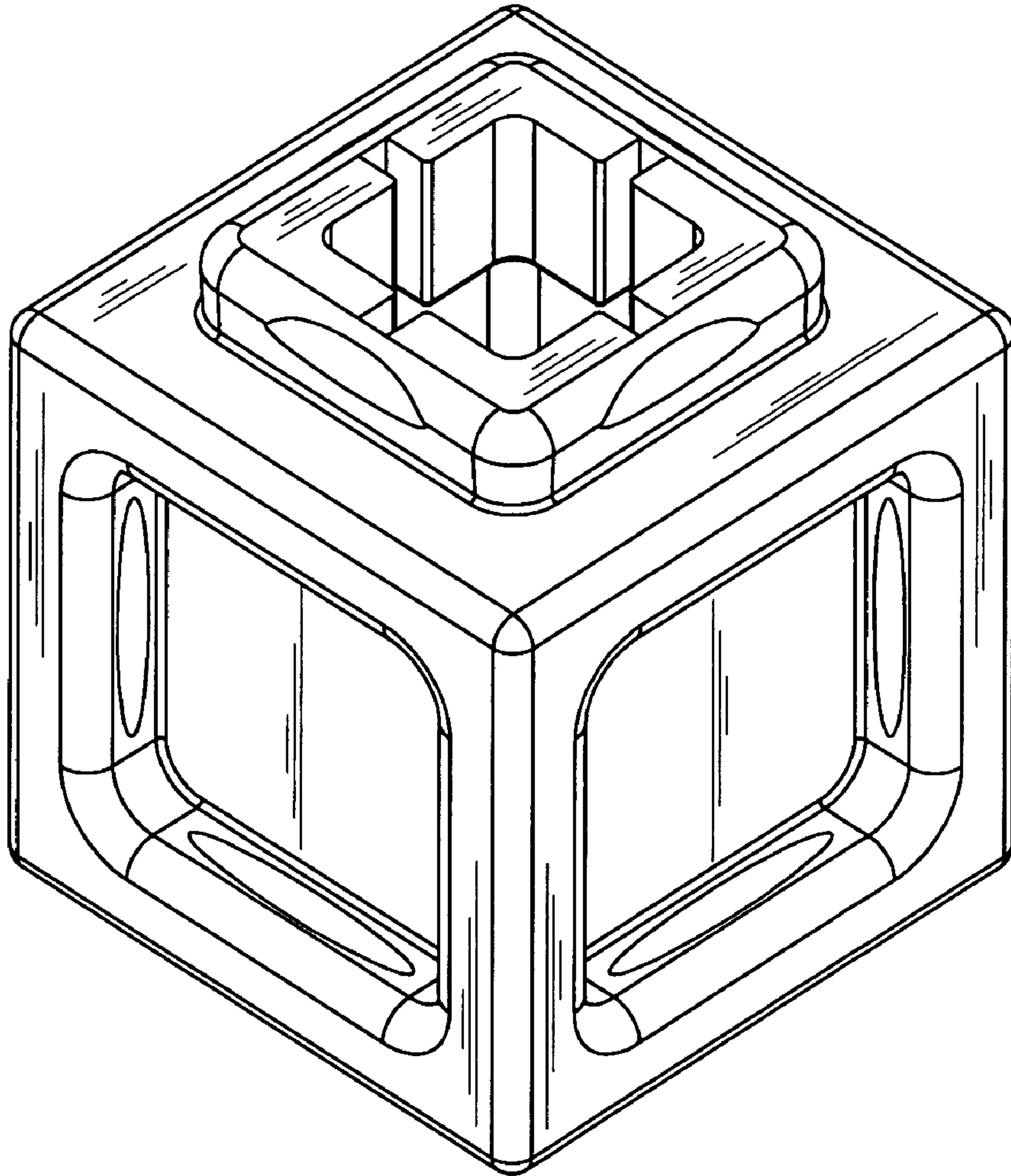

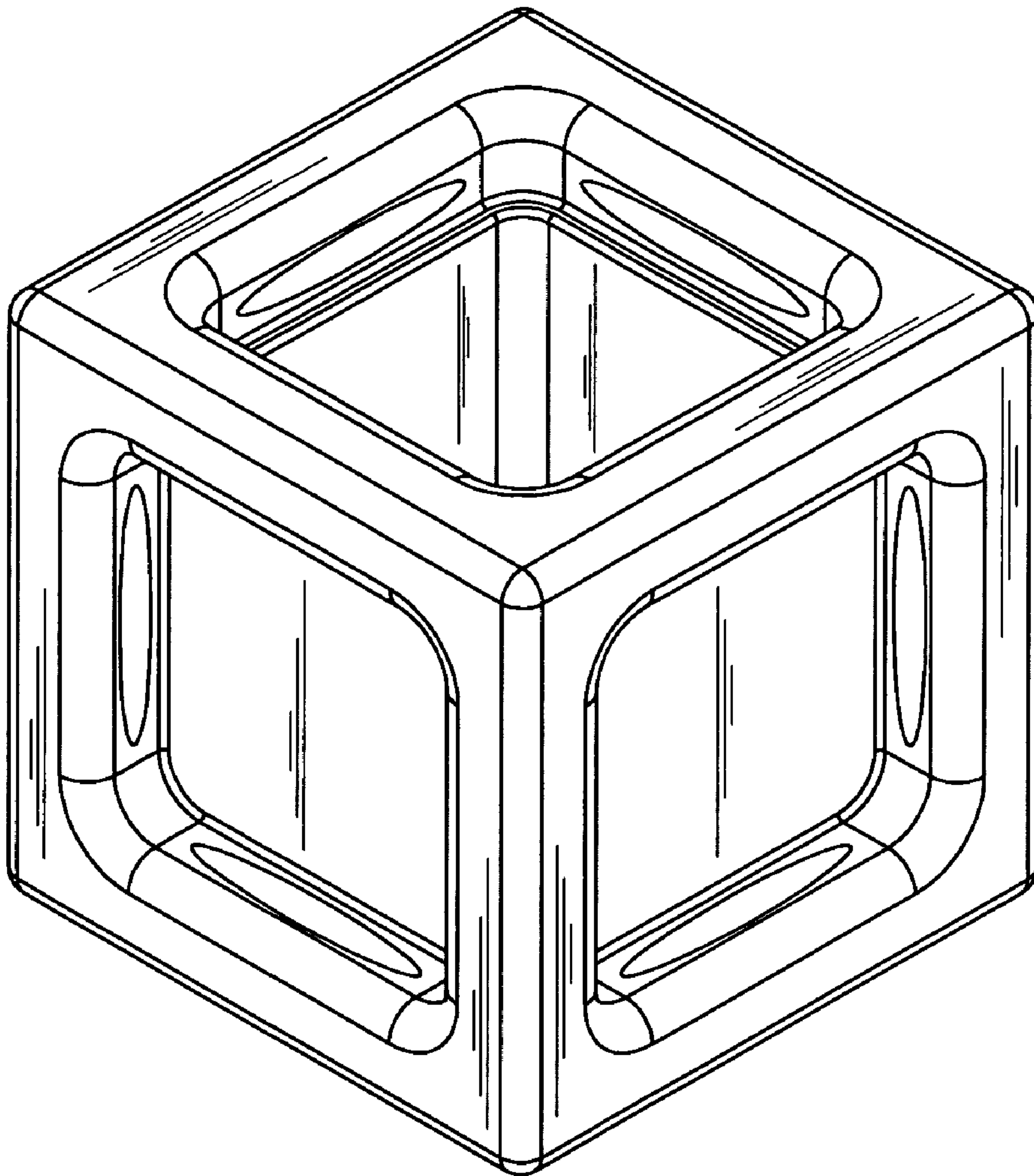

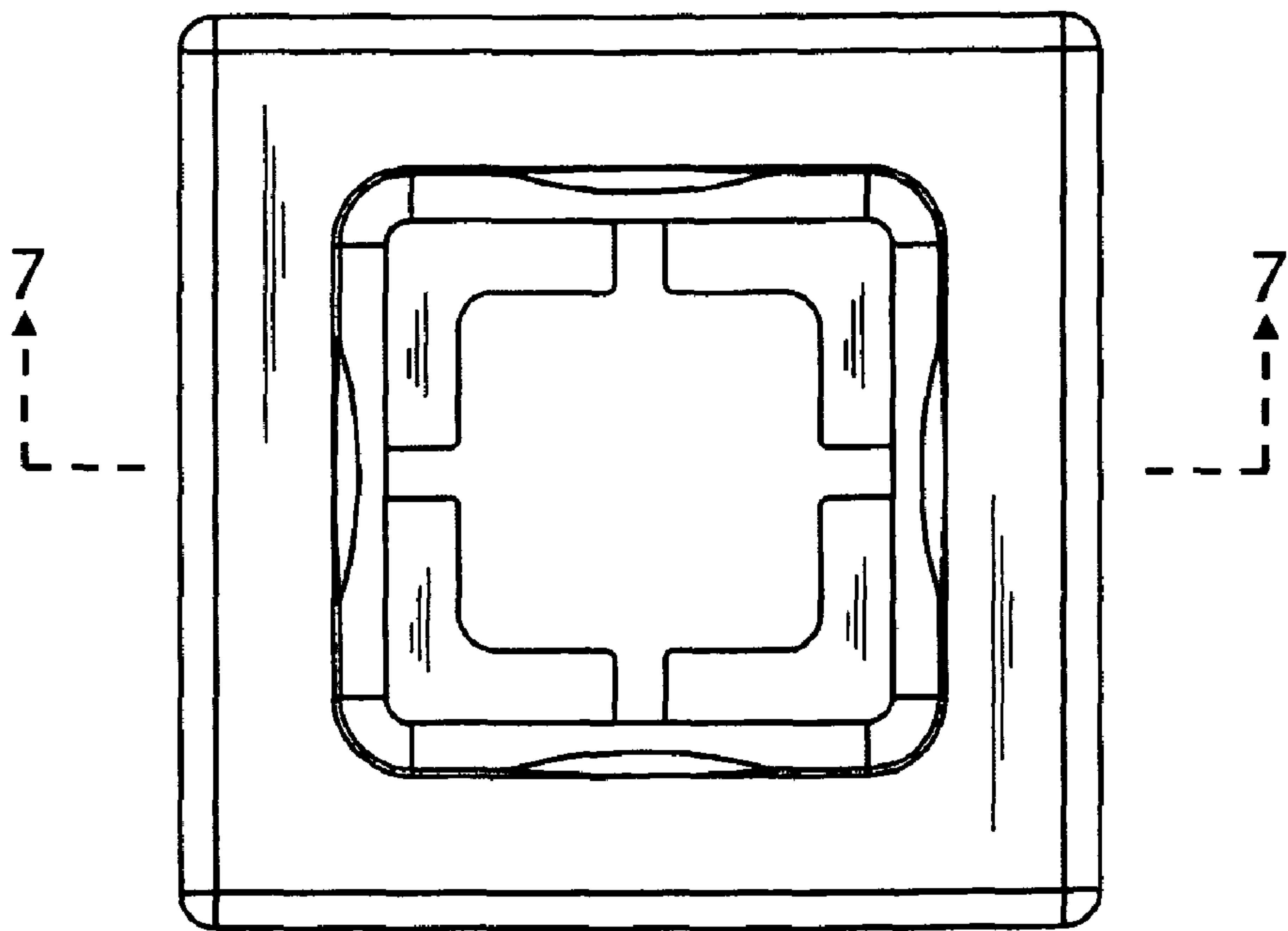

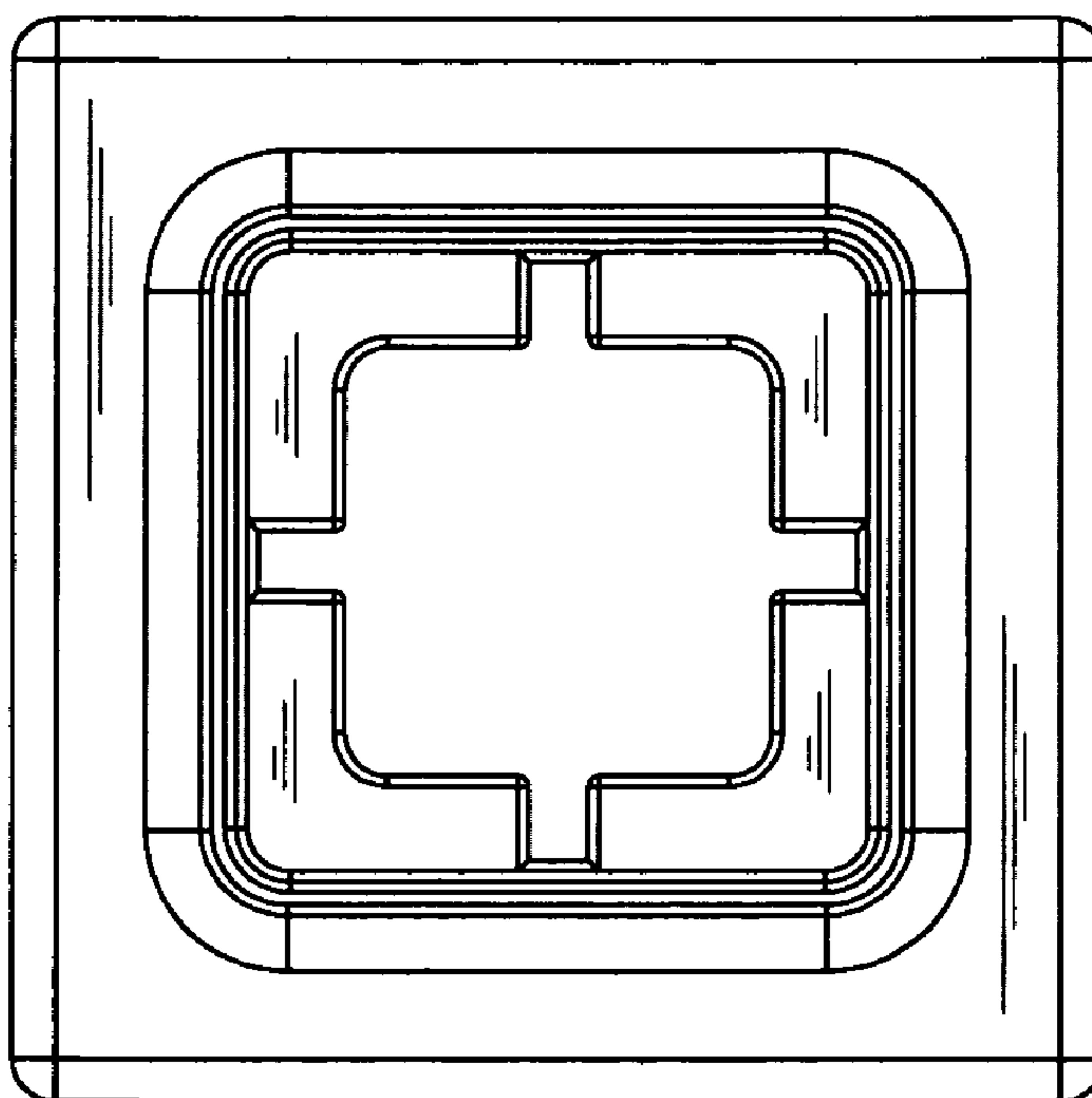

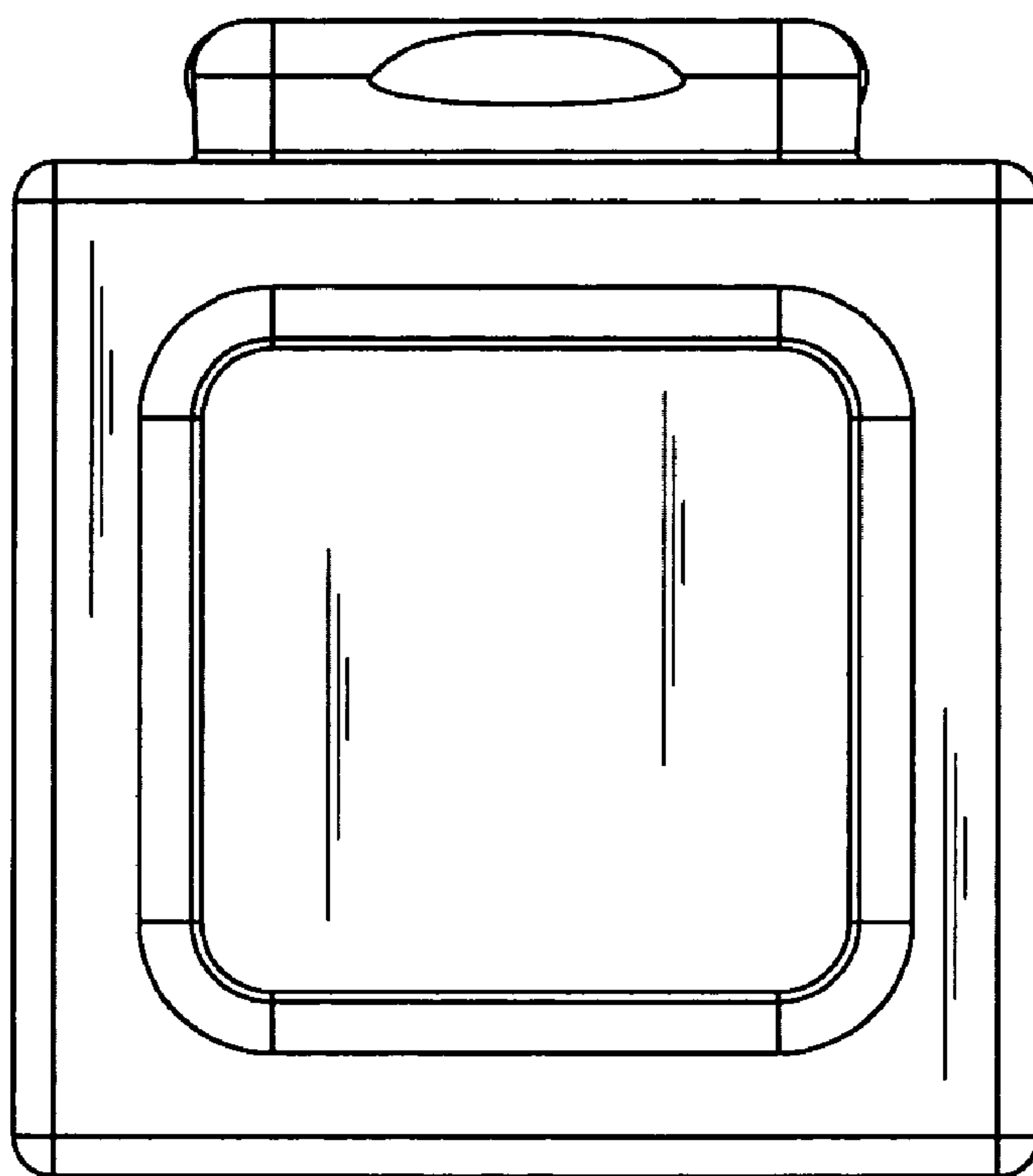

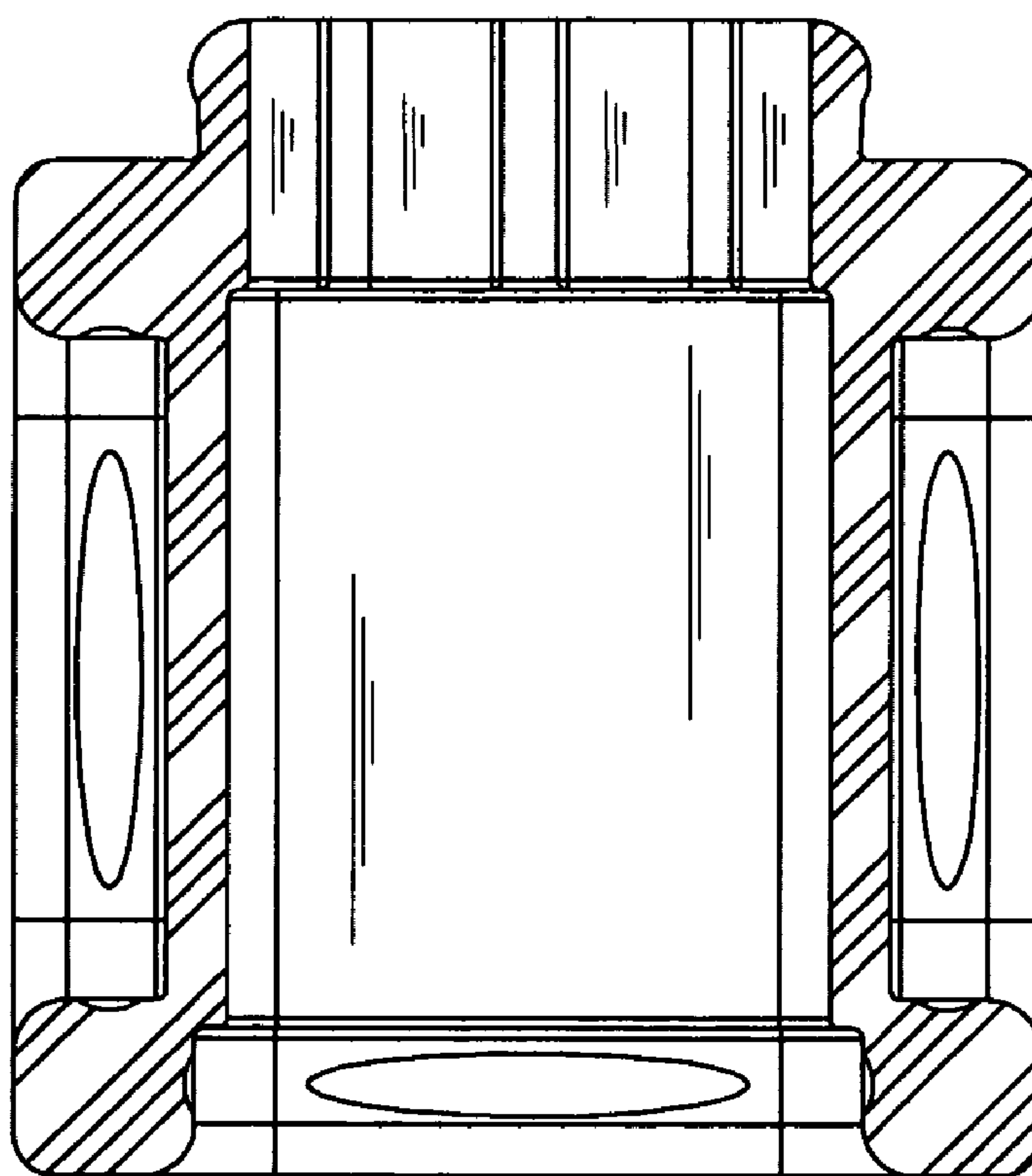
