FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the cookie press of the present invention;

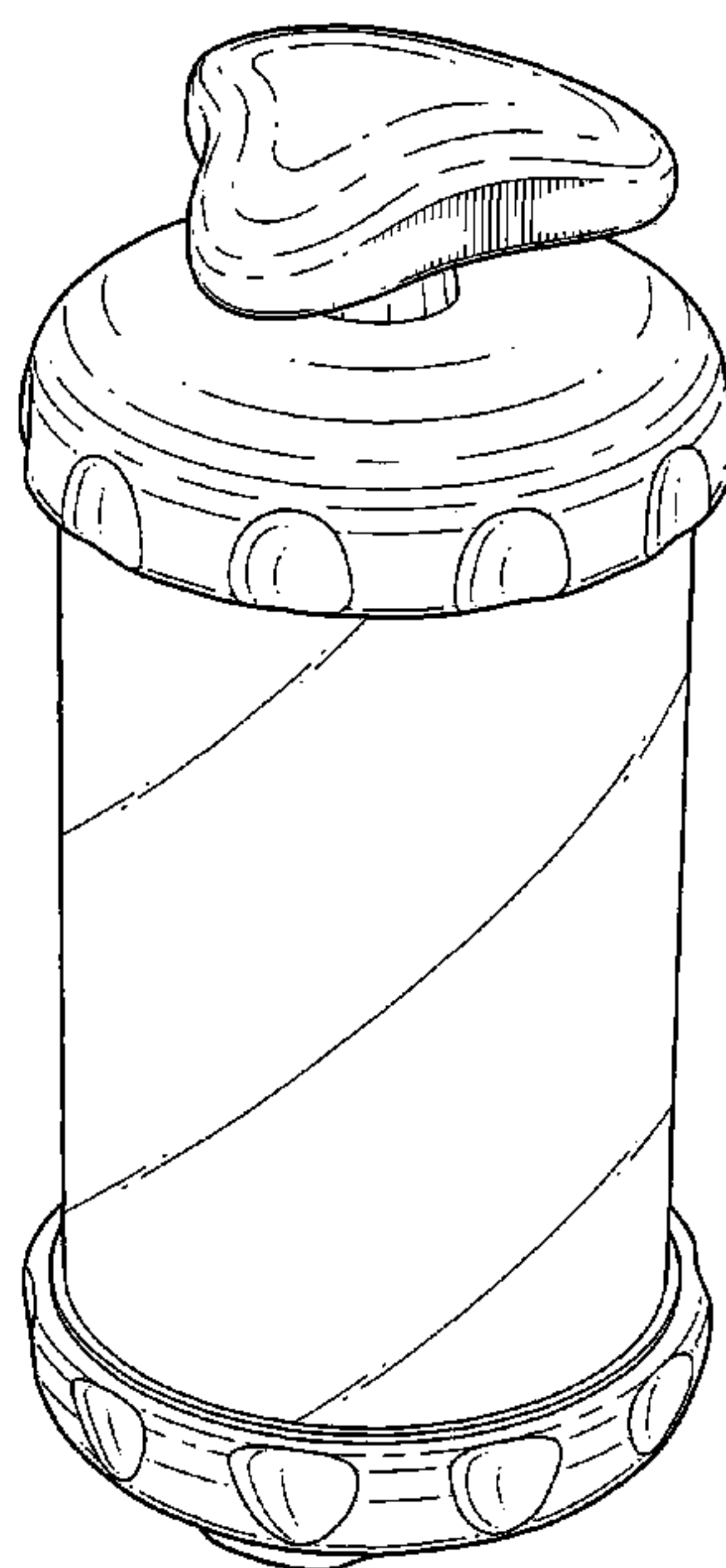
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the cookie press as shown in FIG. 1;

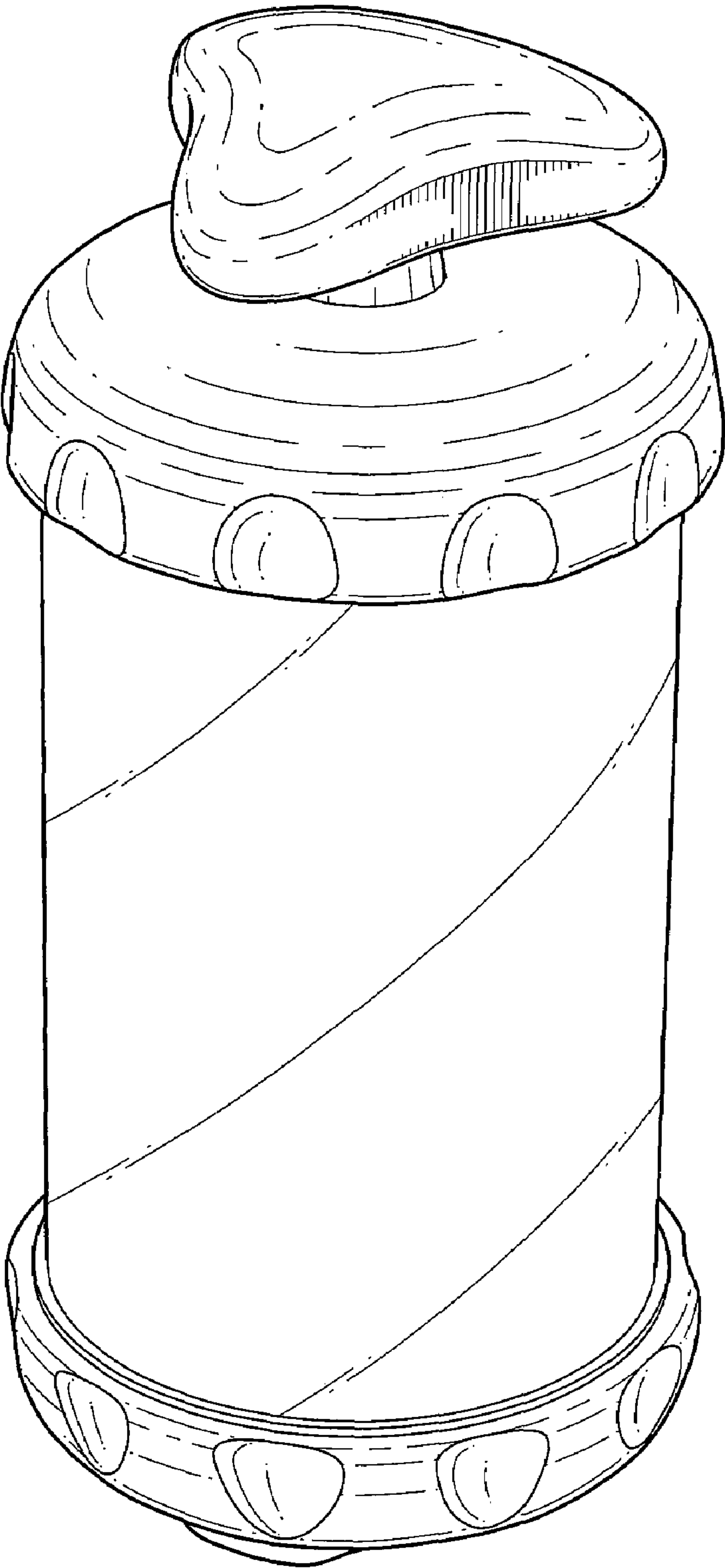

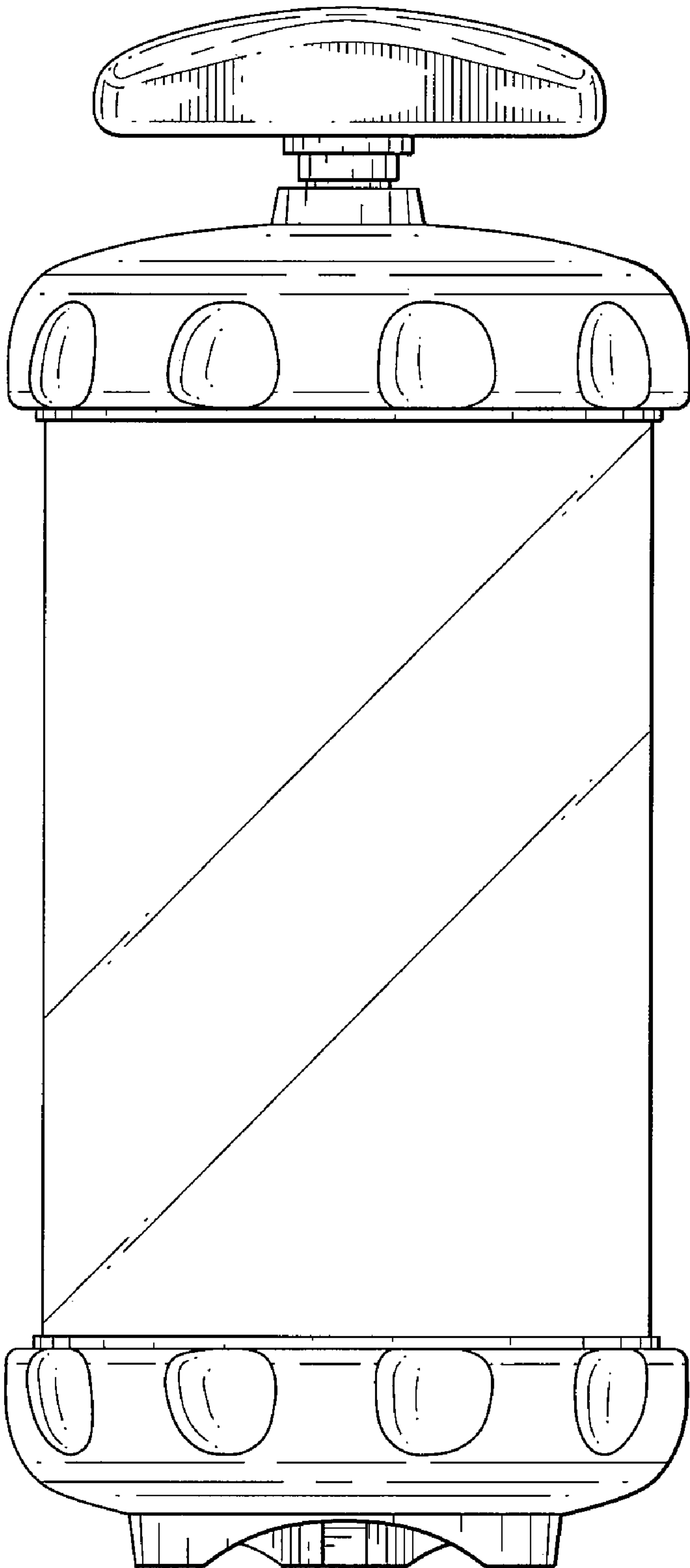

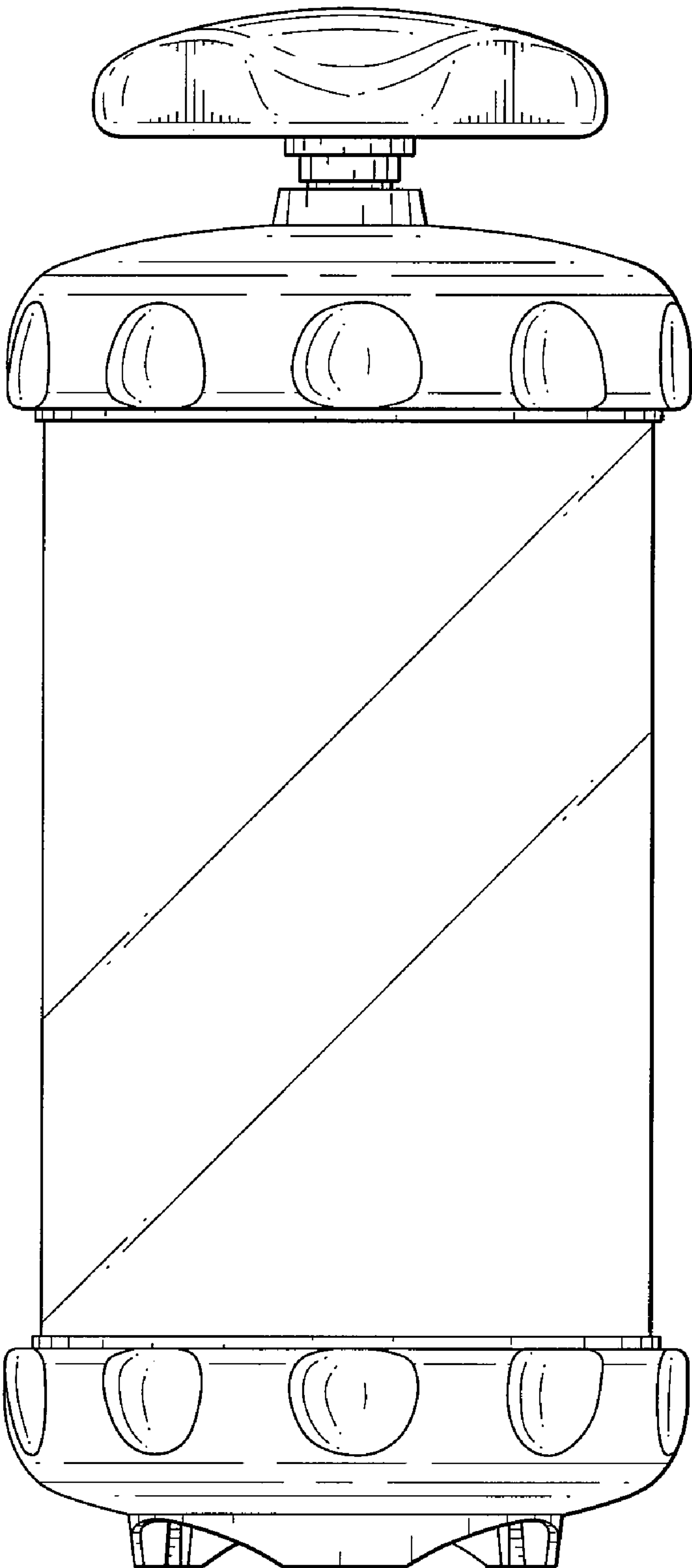

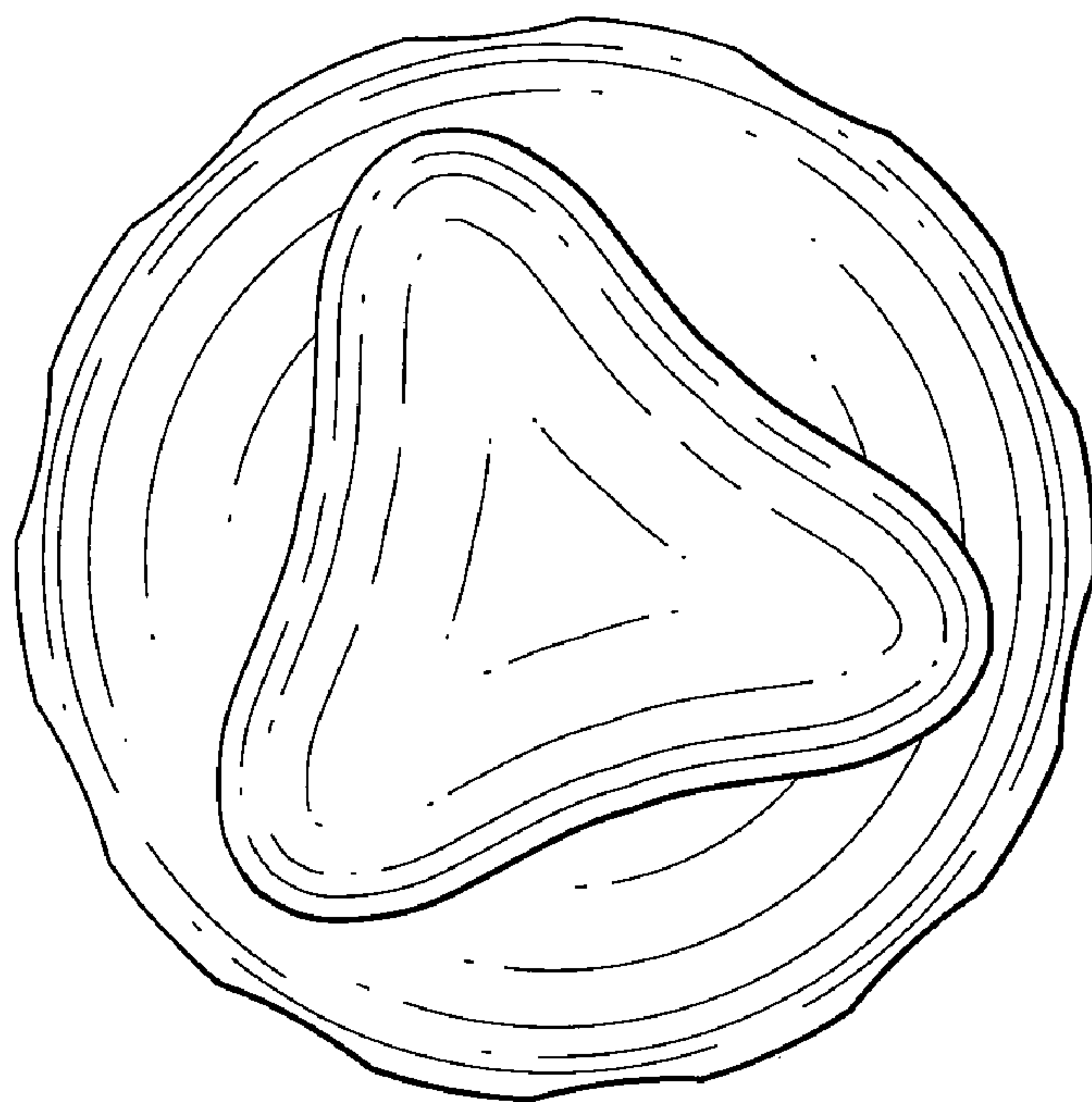

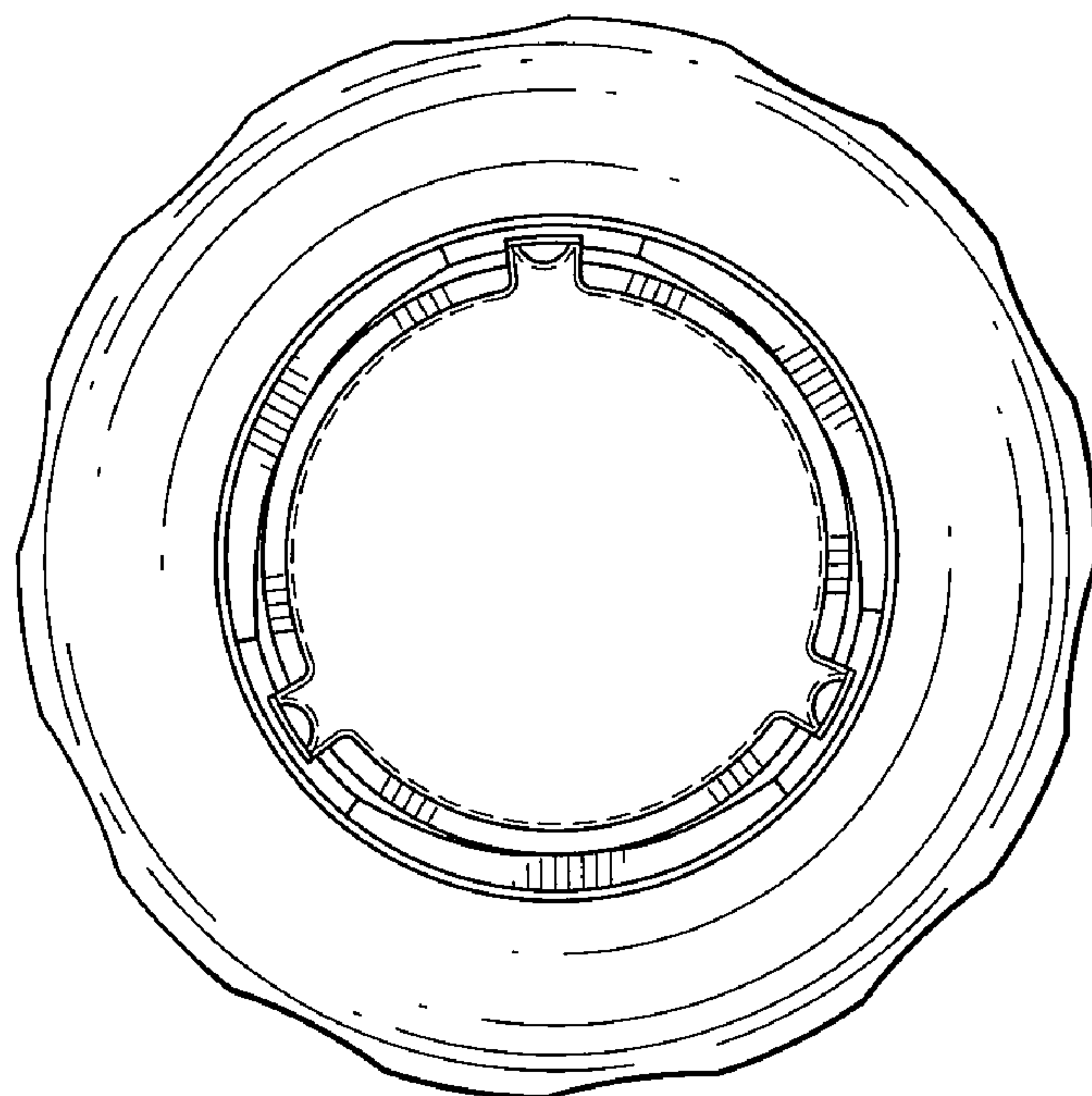
