(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a deck support for flower pot, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the deck support for flower pot as seen from the top right side, the left side being a mirror image;

FIG. 2 is the front elevational view of the deck support for flower pot;

FIG. 3 is a right elevational view of the deck support for flower pot;

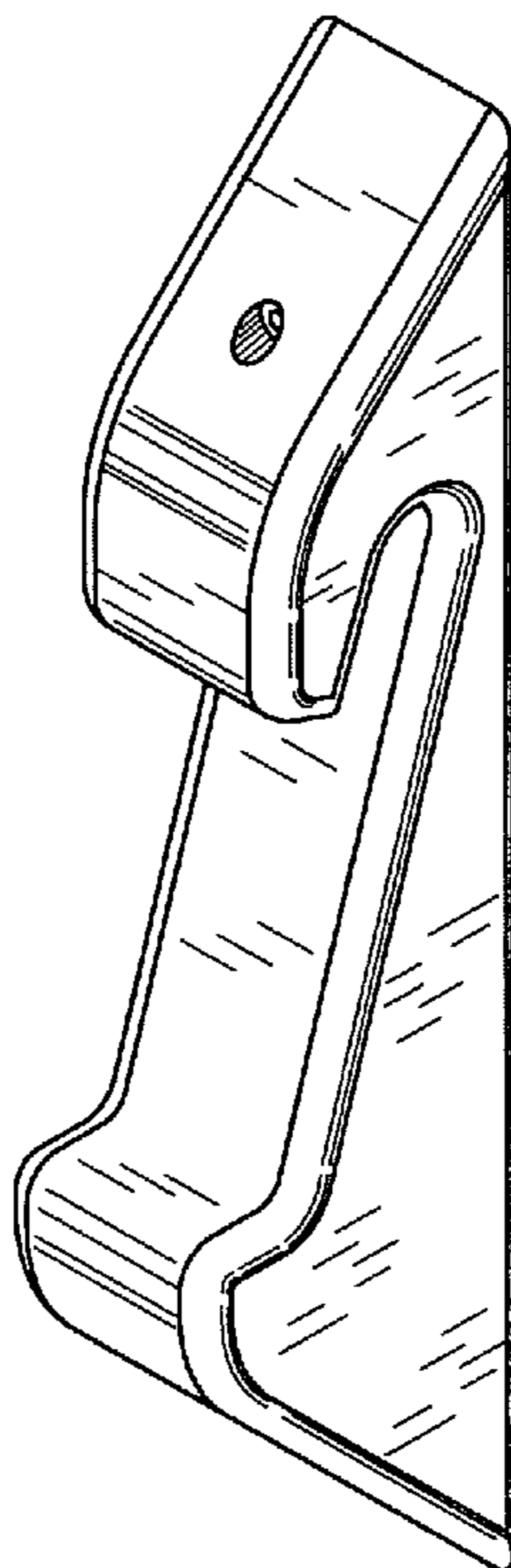
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the deck support for flower pot, including holes for attachment to a vertical surface;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the deck support for flower pot, looking down; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the deck support for flower pot viewed from the bottom looking up.

A support for flower pots is shown in the accompanying drawings. The support may be attached to a deck or other appropriate place where it is desired to hang a flower pot.

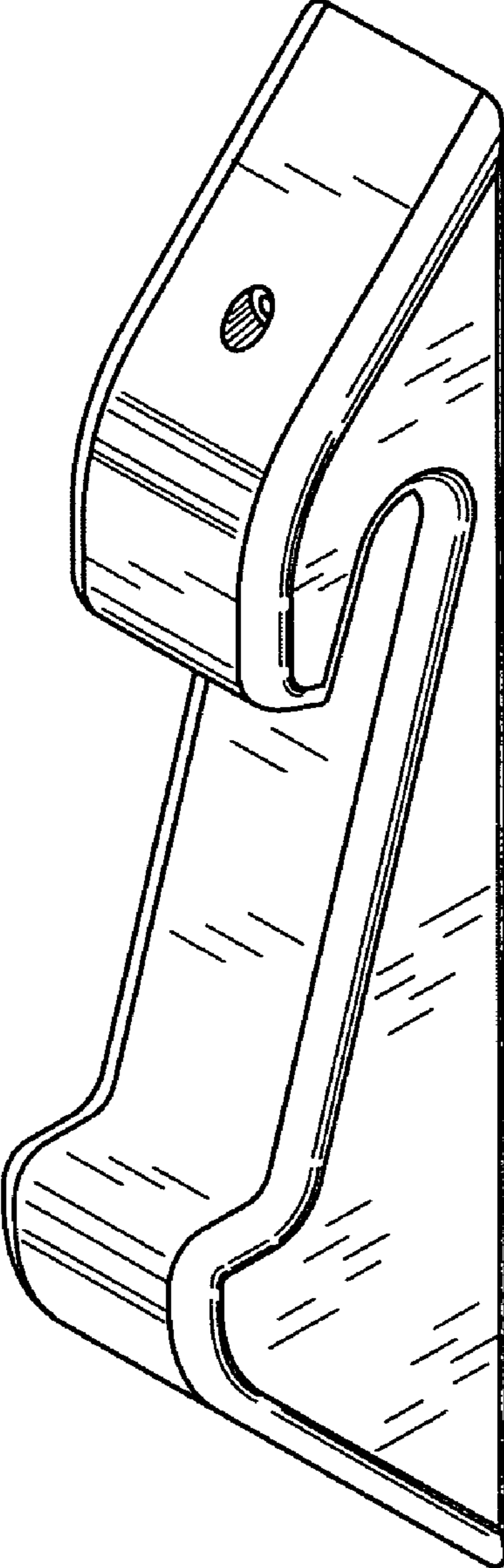

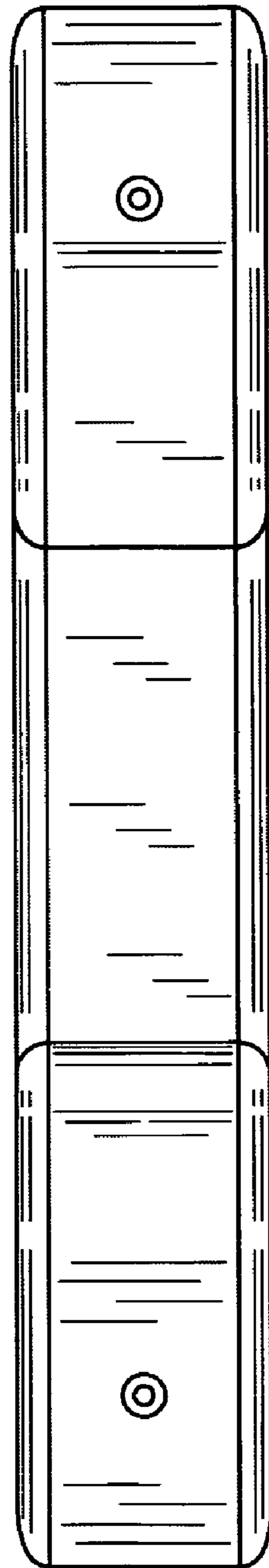

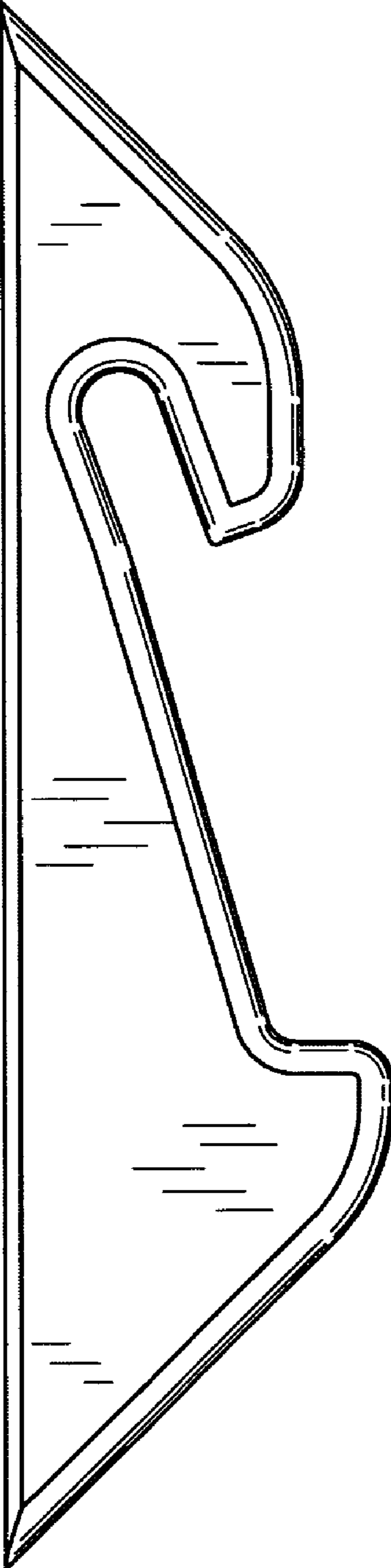

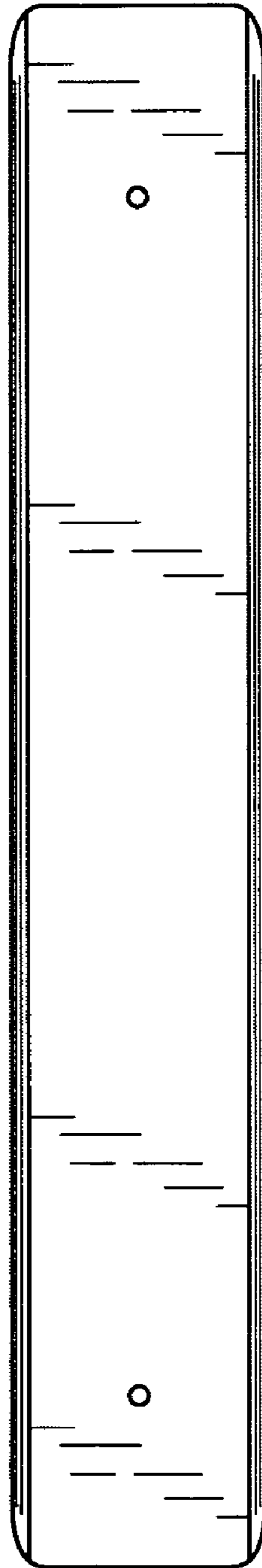

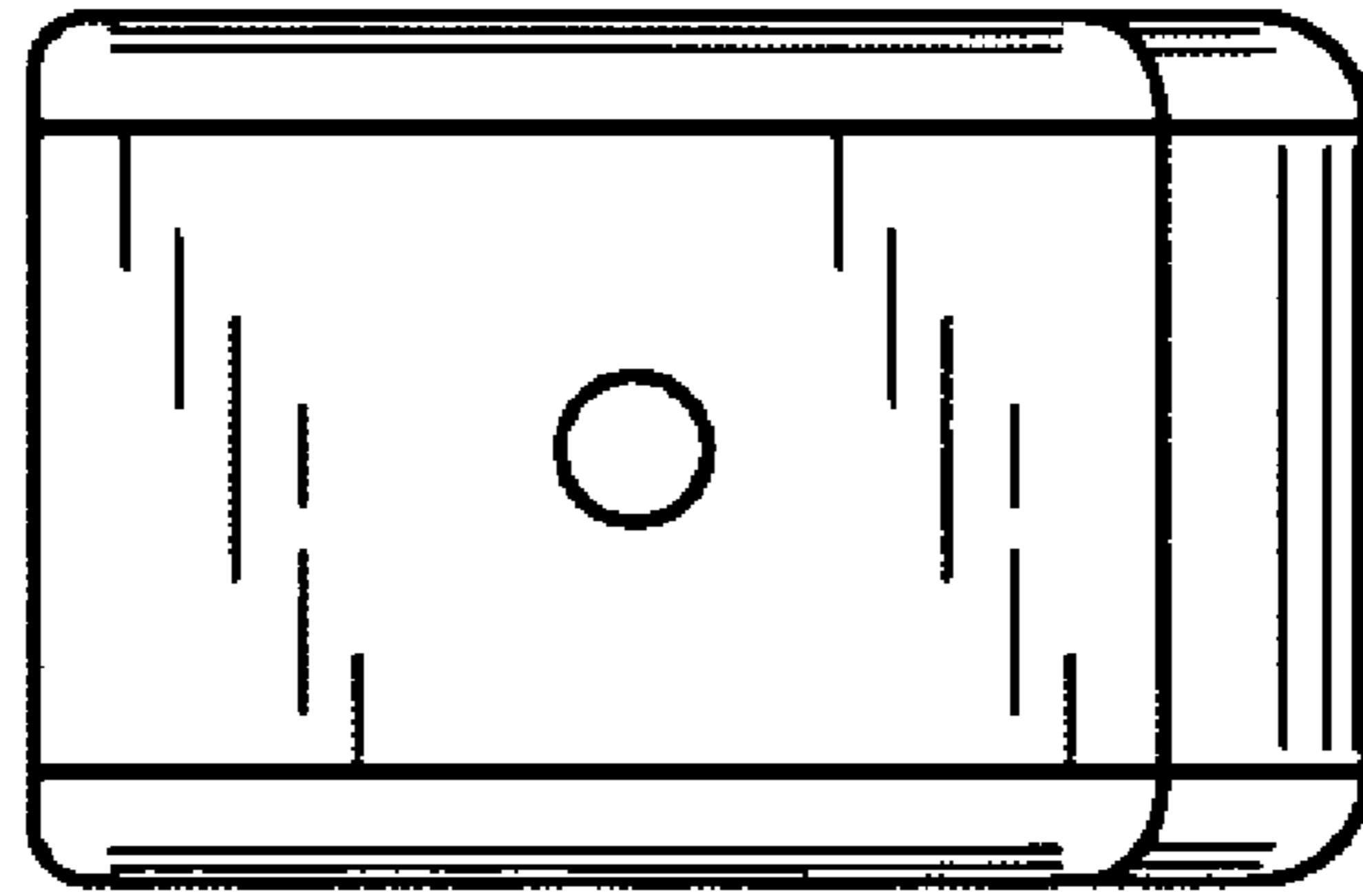

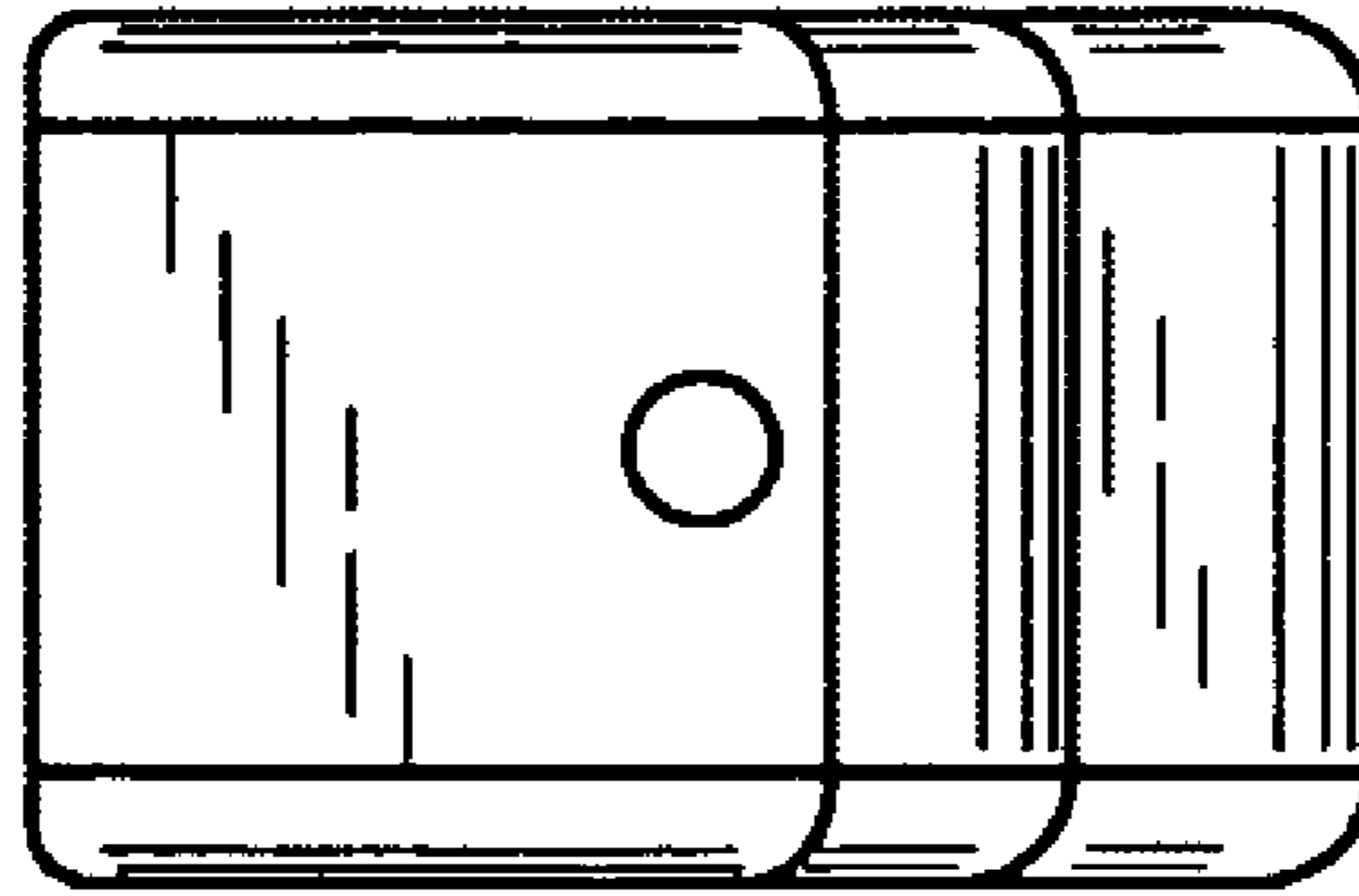
