DESCRIPTION

FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof;

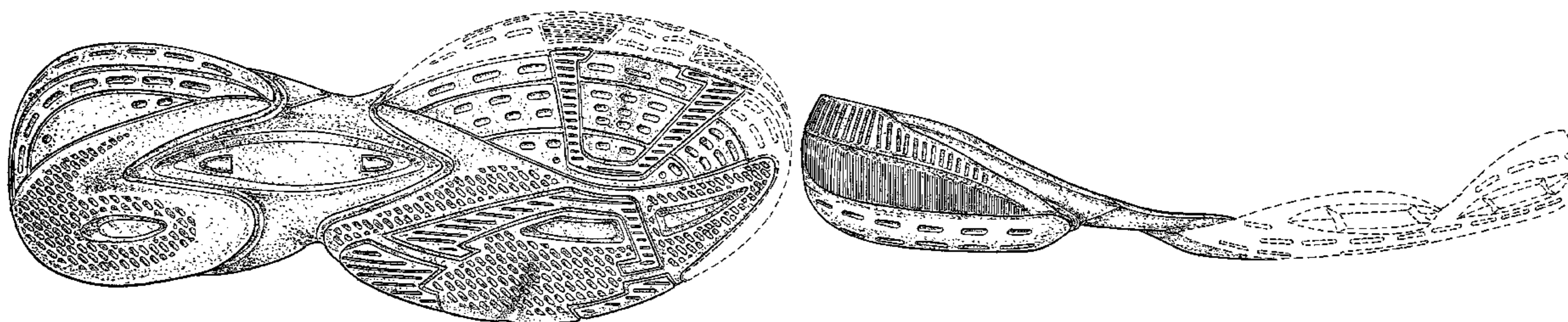
FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;

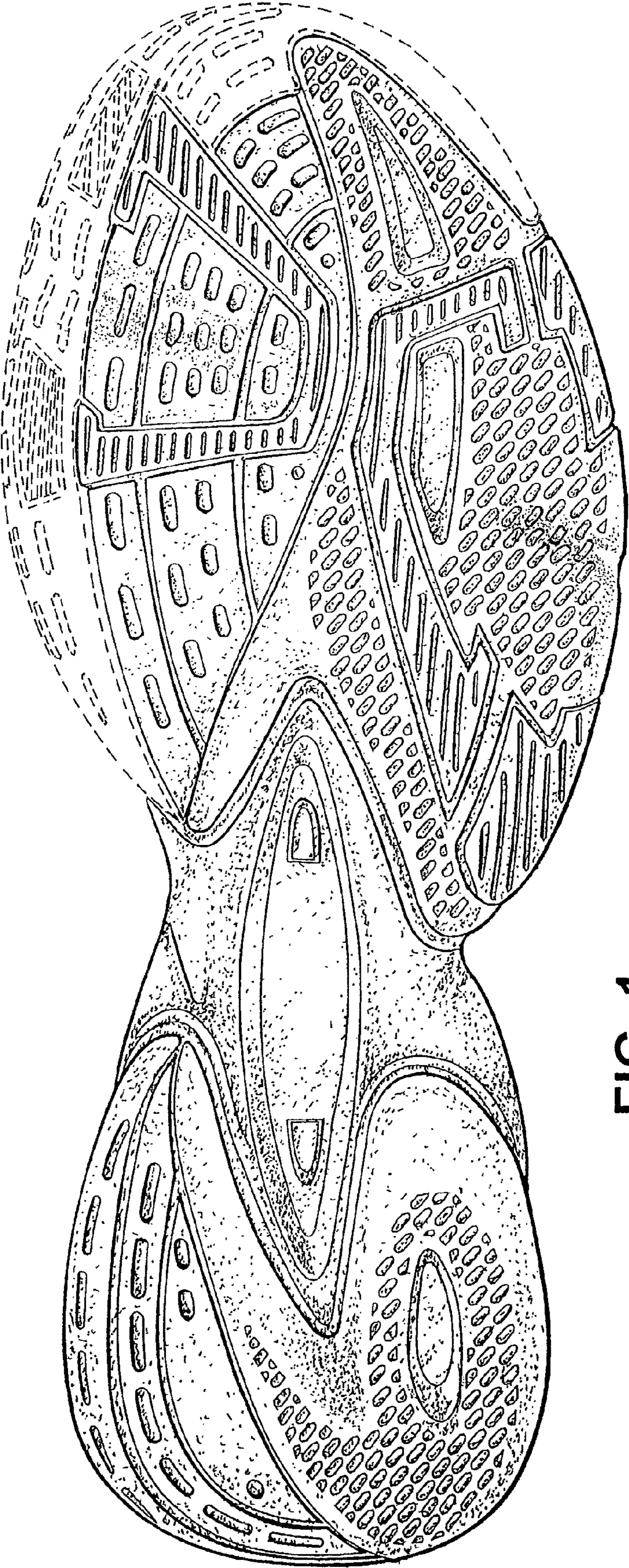

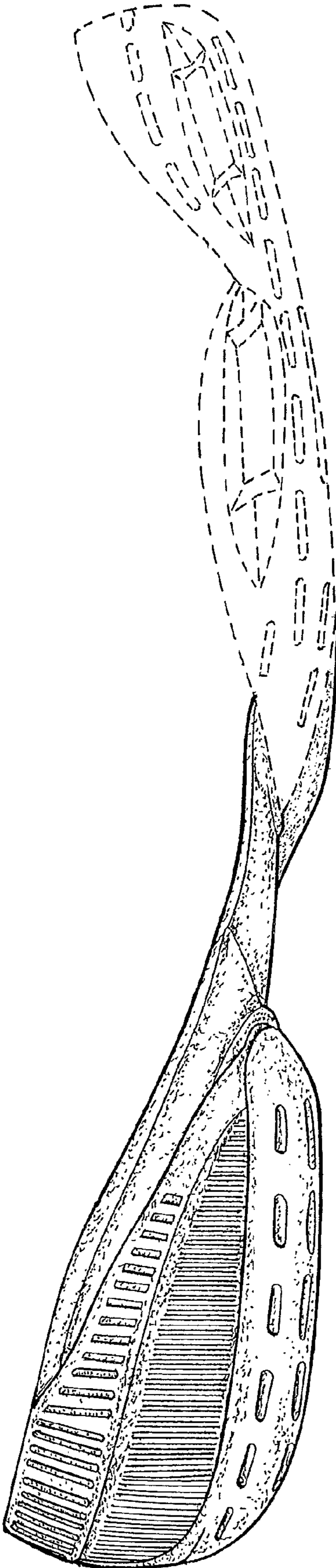

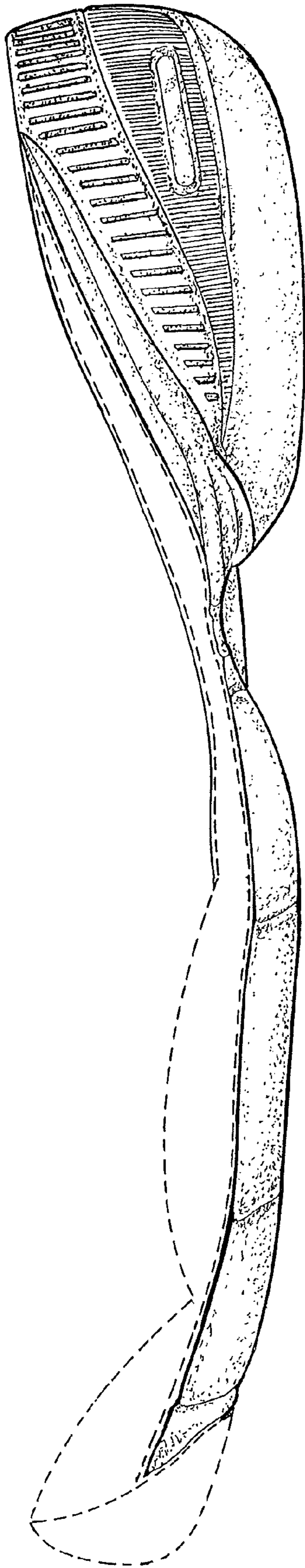

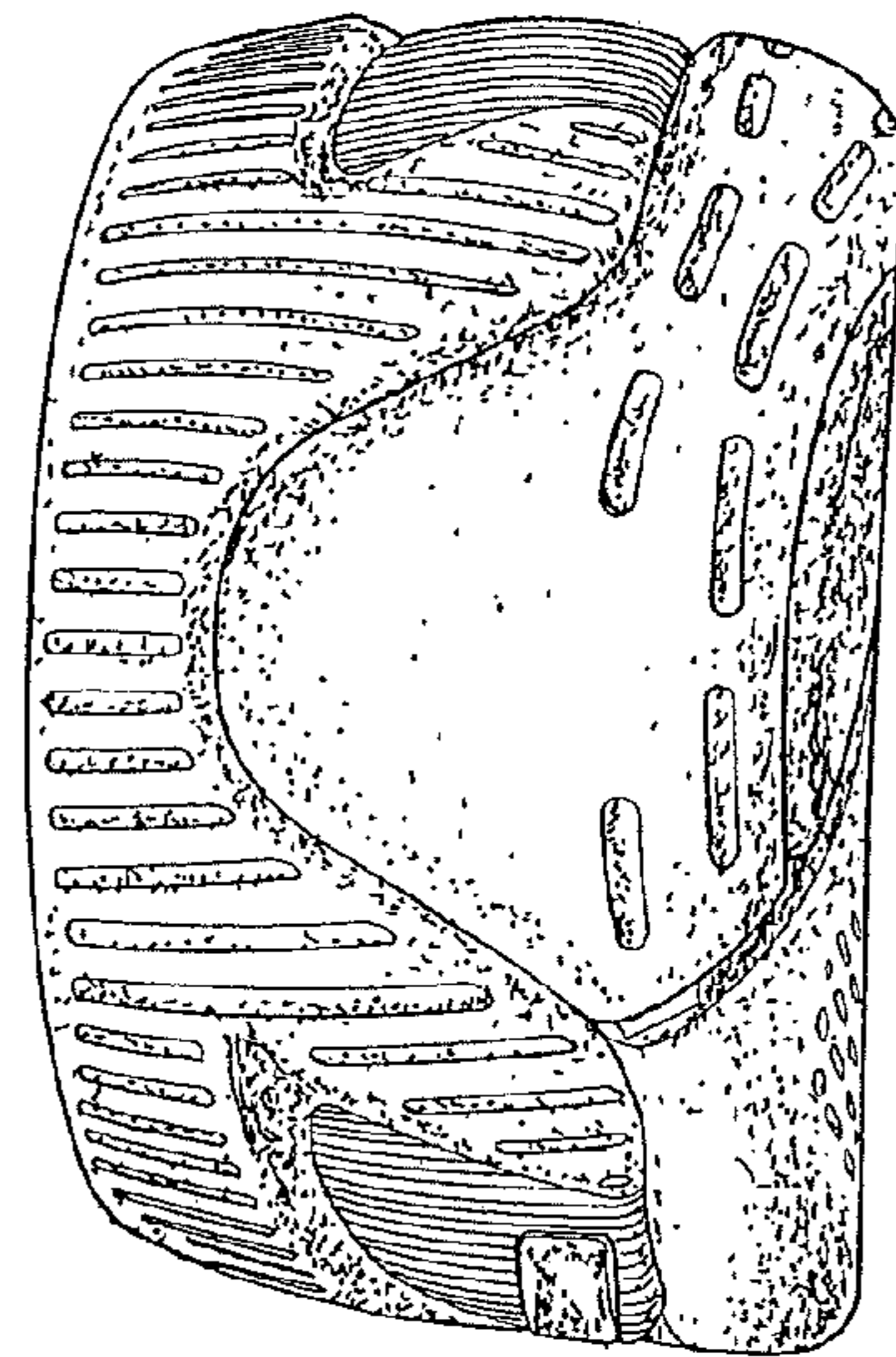

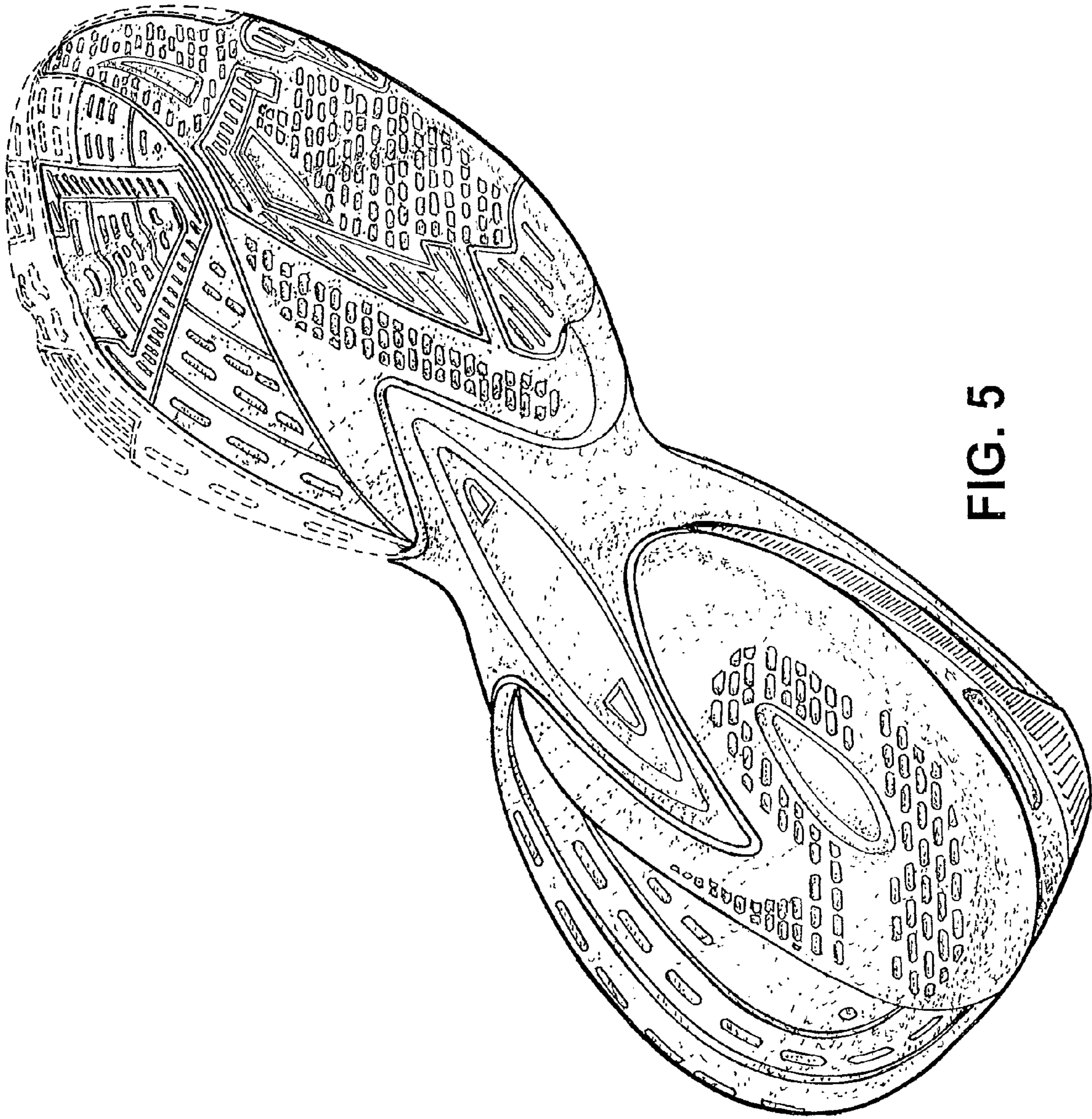
